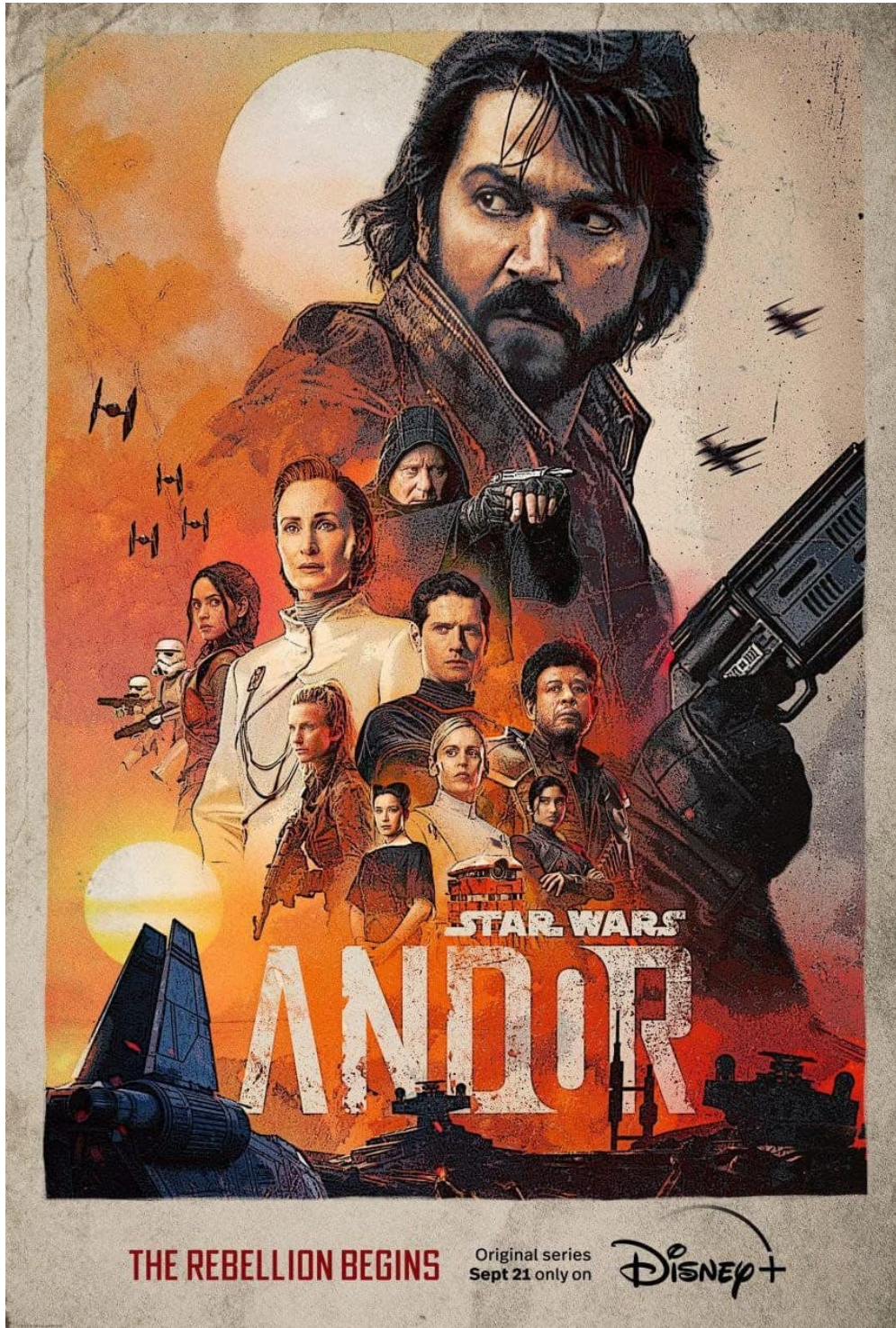

Summary: Cassian Andor's reckless search for answers about his past makes him a wanted man.

Cassian Jeron Andor walks down a dreary causeway. Making his way into the Leisure Zone on Morlana One, he enters a brothel and orders a beverage at the bar. Andor is served by a humanoid female hostess with afro hair. Two Pre-Mor Security Inspection team sentry guards, Verlo Skiff and Kravas Drezzer, take umbrage at the sight of Andor being served first, despite their longer wait. The hostess tells the men to behave, but the older of the two guards, Drezzer, wants to pick

Andor inquires about a woman from Kenari in the Mid Rim, but the only woman by that description left "several months ago." When Andor persists with his questions, the hostess asks about his relationship with the woman. Andor explains that he is looking for his sister. The hostess replies that she disappeared and advises Andor to leave. When Andor asks about his sister's name, the hostess replies that nobody gives their real name.

Andor leaves the brothel and walks through the street. He is followed by the two guards from the brothel, who demand that he produce identification. When Andor doesn't respond, Drezzer of them raises a blaster. Andor raises his hand while the guards quip about abusing their power. Andor allows the guards to search him before fighting back. During the struggle, he shoots one of the guards with a blaster and subdues the second one. He forces the second guard to tend to his comrade Verlo Skiff at gunpoint. They quickly discover that Verlo has died from his injuries. Kravas Drezzer, pleads for mercy by offering up to cover Andor's role in Skiff's death. Andor is unmoved and shoots Drezzer. Andor flees offworld on a WTK-85A interstellar transport.

Later on the planet Ferrix, a red Groundmech named B2EMO travels through a town's dirt streets. The droid encounters a pack of Corellian hounds. One of the creatures urinates on the droid but it drives the hound away with its Electro-shock prod. The Groundmech heads back to Andor's transport and tells Andor that he has brought back what he told him to get.

Cassian experiences a flashback of his sister Kerri and fellow Alpha children watching a starship crashing into the mountains. In the present, B2EMO asks Andor where he went but Andor refuses to share the information. B2EMO tells his master that Jezzi and Femmi brought supper and Maarva's medicine. B2EMO also tells him that his friend Brasso was looking for him and that Maarva is concerned that Andor is mixing with bad company and getting himself into trouble. Andor tells the droid to conceal his whereabouts before fixing one of the droid's wires.

Andor later travels into town and meets Brasso outside of his workplace. He tells Brasso to lie about meeting Andor for a drink the previous night. Brasso agrees, but embellishes the account with a story about Andor getting drunk and injuring himself, to cover for the scrape on his forehead.

At the Corporate Security headquarters on Morlana One, Pre-Mor Deputy Inspector Syril Karn informs his superior Chief Inspector Hyne about the death of two of his colleagues the previous night. Hyne makes a passing remark about the security officer's modified uniform before mentioning that one of the fallen guards was named Kravas Drezzer, a former commander who had been reduced to the rank of corporal. Hyne expresses his distaste for Kravas before turning his attention to the suspect, who is described as a human with dark features asking about a Kenari girl. After learning that the two guards had not been robbed, Hyne opines that it will be a tough case to solve.

After turning off the recording system, Hyne tells Karn that the case bears the hallmarks of "regrettable misadventure." He tells Karn to cover up the deaths of the Pre-Mor security guards and to falsify key details including situating it outside the Leisure Zone. Karn points out that they were murdered but Hyne tells him to report that the men were killed in a brothel fight after drinking Revnog, an illegal beverage. Hyne tells him to write that the security guards died in the line of duty.

Hyne wants to cover up the deaths since he is heading to an Imperial Regional Command review and wants to present a favorable report about criminal activity within Preox-Morlana territory in order to prevent Imperial interference. Hyne's words unnerve the deputy inspector.

Meanwhile, Andor visits the mechanic Bix Caleen at her garage. Bix notices Andor's injury but he is evasive. Andor says that he wants to sell immediate but the mechanic explains that she does not sell single objects but prefers to bundle things. She tells Andor that a Tac Corvette will be visiting this week looking for scrap. Bix suggests scavenging some Imperial technology but Andor is impatient. He explains that he has obtained an untraceable NS-9 Starpath unit and will be meeting with a contact. Bix is reluctant to get involved but Andor is determined to go ahead with his plan.

Timm Karlo enters the garage with news about an upcoming Wobani run and asks Bix if she is interested. Bix says she will get back in touch. Sensing that Bix has feelings for Timm, Andor asks if Timm knows anything about his clandestine work. Bix reassures him that Timm knows nothing. Later, Andor speaks with Timm about finding a life partner. In a flashback scene, Andor and his tribe participate in an initiation ceremony which involves painting black paint stripes on their faces.

Elsewhere, Syril tasks a signals officer with tracking Andor's ship, which landed on Morlana One illegally. Later, Andor is confronted by Nurchi, who wants Andor to pay back his deposit. Andor says he is unable to at the moment. Andor is also cornered by Vetch, who is serving as Nurchi's "muscle." Andor accuses Vetch of selling him out to Nurchi. Andor promises to pay back his deposit before walking away.

Bix tells Timm she is leaving the garage to run some errands. Timm follows her through the streets, bumping into a mechanic on the way. Bix visits a dealer, telling him that she is looking for a Bendine Mesh-Tech filter. He tells her that it is in the yellow racks at the back. Bix heads into the garage and climbs up a ladder where she taps into a circuit box.

In another flashback, the group of children prepare to investigate the fallen ship, putting black smears on their faces and preparing dart weapons. Kassa is originally left out, but a girl, the eldest of the group and the leader, lets him do his disguise, as well.

Sybil asks his team of analysts if they have uncovered any leads on Kenari males on Ferrix.



The analysts have little information about the planet Kenari with the most recent census dating back to six years go. Cyril is determined to pursue the murder investigation and issues an order for Kenari human men on Ferrix to be questioned.

Back on Ferrix, a bearded man named Pegla meets with Andor aboard his transport. Pegla asks Andor what he is doing and tells him that he is in the office. Andor tells him that he has refueled the ship. Pegla notices that Andor has swapped the ship's chip logs. The boss, Zorby, speaks over the overhead projectors and asks Pegla to explain what is going on. Pegla claims that yard rats are back. Zorby tells him to deal with a customer and to set the hounds on the rats. Andor asks if he could borrow his ship but Pegla is unwilling to get involved in Andor's activities. He tells Andor to finish his work and not to return.

In a flashback scene, a young Andor and his tribe gather to retrieve supplies from the fallen ship. Andor's sister Kerri wants to follow but is too young. Andor promises to return.

Summary: Cassian attempts to lay low on Ferrix as agents of the law close in.



In the past, a younger Cassian Jeron Andor accompanies his Kenari tribe as they travel through the jungles towards the wrecked starship. During the journey, Andor gazes down at a large open-cast mine. In the present, a human man beats a large table of stone with two hammers. Pegla powers down a ship that he is working on at a starship lot. Meanwhile, Timm Karlo invites Bix Caleen out for a meal and the two share a kiss. While checking the computer terminal, Timm receives news that the Pre-Mor Author-

ity is seeking a Kenari male for questioning and requests that they contact the Preox Morlana Corporate Security Headquarters without delay.

Cassian Andor visits Maarva Andor and her droid B2EMO at her home. After exchanging greetings, Andor claims that he sustained his facial injury from tripping on a cable while helping Pegla. Andor also claims that he was out last night meeting Brasso and had business to attend in the East. Under Maarva's orders, B2EMO informs Andor that the Pre-Mor authorities are searching for a Kenari male. Maarva asks Andor who else knows that he was born on Kenari. As Andor struggles to answer, Maarva reminds Andor that he needs to maintain the cover story that he was born on Fest.

Maarva chides Andor for spilling his secrets to his lovers and demands to know how the Pre-Mor authorities learnt about his Kenari origins. Andor admits that he was responsible. B2EMO also informs Andor that Bix has been trying to contact him. Before B2EMO can tell him, the droid powers down. When Maarva asks what Andor has done, he replies that he "messed up."

Andor later meets up with Bix and tells her about the incident with the two Pre-Mor Security Inspection team sentry guards Verlo Skiff and Kravas Drezzer on Morlana One. Andor offers to

sell her a piece of technology in return for securing her help in escaping offworld. Bix tells him that the buyer is coming the following day and that it is too late to call it off. Andor replies that he won't forget this. Timm watches from the counter nearby. Bix advises Andor to leave.

After drinking, Timm heads to a communication terminal. Later, several Pre-Mor analysts receive Timm's tip call. Based on this call, the team checks Andor's records and finds that he has committed several crimes including destruction of Imperial property and assaulting an Imperial officer. Deputy Inspector Syril Karn inquires into his subordinates progress as they bring up an image of a younger Andor. The brothel hostess whom Andor met earlier also enters the communications room.

Later that night, Timm is visited by Bix, who has had trouble sleeping and notices his light is on. Bix takes off her jacket before embracing Tim. She then heads to his bed and starts undressing. Meanwhile, Karn is visited by Sergeant Linus Mosk, who has reported for duty at midnight. Karn tells him to act quickly since they have a dangerous suspect. While discussing the planned operation, Mosk thinks that they will need 12 and invites Karn to join the operation in order to boost morale. The two law enforcement officers agree about the need to avenge the deaths of two colleagues. Mosk describes Corporate Tactical Forces as the Galactic Empire's first line of defense and emphasizes the need to mount a show of strength.

While Maarva waits at home, Andor obtains an Imperial transmitter from a derelict wheeled vehicle. While holding his blaster pistol, he experiences a flashback of he and his fellow Kenari tribesmen advancing on the wrecked starship, which has crashed in the middle of the jungle. A young Kenari woman leads the expedition.

In space, Luthen Rael flies his shuttle into Ferrix's atmosphere with the aid of a Fondor Droid Mod. After landing the shuttle in a canyon, he uses a pair of macrobinoculars to survey Timm Karlo's salvage yard from a distance.

While the worker beats the metal slab with his hammer, Bix awakes from her sleep. Timm has had a sleepless night but offers to serve her caf. She asks if Timm can open up the yard for him, claiming that she has few errands to run. Elsewhere, Andor chats with B2EMO, who asks why he needs comms. The droid asks about the location of Maarva's credits. Andor replies that they do not one anyone else finding her money, which the droid agrees. B2EMO tries to advise Andor from running away but Andor tells the droid that he should return less Maarva worry about his whereabouts.

Meanwhile, Maarva searches for B2EMO at her home. While searching Andor's room, she finds an improvised staff from his childhood days. Back in the past, the Kenari female leader approaches the wrecked starship. She checks the body of a fallen yellow-skinned humanoid crew member and then approaches the ship's docking ring. She finds a second crew member's body lying by the entrance. The man's white jumpsuit has a Separatist symbol on it. One of the crew members stirs and shoots the female Kenari leader with his blaster. The tribe retaliate by firing arrows until he falls to the ground. The grieving adolescents and children carry their fallen leader home. However, Andor stays behind and decides to explore the starship.

Back in the present, Xanwan argues with an alien customer named Granik at his transport business. Andor visits. Xanwan has been searching for a planet called Kenari, which was abandoned following an Imperial mining disaster. The planet is considered toxic and travel is prohibited by the Empire. Xanwan also tells Andor that corporate enforcement authorities are looking for someone from Kenari and asks what he can do for Andor. Andor inquires about the costs of traveling to Tassar. Xanwan says that it will cost 900 credits due to the short notice and secrecy. Andor convinces him to settle for 700 credits.

As a Pre-Mor security starship travels through hyperspace, Sergeant Mosk briefs his troops about the fugitive Andor, warning them that he is a dangerous opponent. Mosk divides his forces into three teams with himself and Karn leading the West Team. Their plan is to ambush him with a pincer movement. Mosk warns that some local residents may be uncooperative and to remind them about a monthly Territorial Forum to raise their complaints. Karn addresses the troops, telling them about the dangers of the risk of doing nothing. He tells them that he takes pride in their team and that there is no easy route to success and justice.

Meanwhile, Rael is a passenger on a hoverbus. A fellow passenger tries to chat with him about the docking fees for starships. He grumbles about the spaceport authorities charging them to spend their money. He talked about being able to travel freely on the planet when he was younger. Rael is not chatty but the fellow passenger talks about working in the propulsion

industry. The passenger tells Rael that if he can't find it here, it is not worth finding. The hoverbus flies over an urban settlement on Ferrix.

Summary: Cassian's desperation to avoid arrest leads him to a mysterious man with unknown connections.



In the past, a young Cassian Jeron Andor climbs into the docking rig of the wrecked starship on his jungle homeworld Kenari. He finds the bodies of humanoids dressed in Separatist uniforms. The young Andor enters the ship's engine room where he touches the controls curiously. Andor sees a reflection of himself in one of the panels.

In the present, Andor watches salvage workers and a shuttle dismantling a capital ship at a salvage yard. One of the workers walks to Andor. Andor tells the

worker that he has some money coming today but the worker is skeptical of his ability to pay. Andor refuses to tell the worker where he is going but promises to return.

Meanwhile, Luthen Rael's shuttle hands at the urban settlement on Ferrix. The male passenger tries to recommend a hotel and warns Rael to watch out for pickpockets. Rael is met by Bix Caleen, who tells him that their plan has been complicated by Preox-Morlana, which has issued a bulletin for someone matching Andor's description. Rael is aware of the bulletin and points out that they did not mention Andor by name but are looking for someone from Kenari. Rael says that Andor's prison record says he is from Fest, which Bix agrees.

When Rael asks if Andor has been identified, Bix says not many people know. After Bix confirms that Andor killed the two security officers on Morlana, Rael replies that they need to act fast. The two head to East lot, Building Nine where Andor is believed to be hiding. When Rael asks if she trusts Andor, Bix replies that he will be there.

In space, the Preox-Morlana Corporate Tactical Forces' starship exits hyperspace and dispatches three Mobile Tac-Pods carrying law enforcement personnel led by Deputy Inspector Syril Karn and Sergeant Linus Mosk. B2EMO races through the streets of Ferrix.

In the past, Maarva Andor, her husband Clem Andor and B2EMO undertake a mission to salvage equipment and technology from the wrecked Separatist starship on Kenari. They have twenty minutes due to the radioactive conditions. Maarva believes that there are six brand new



fuel nodules within the ship. Clem thinks they should leave but Maarva wants to investigate a banging sound.

Maarva and Clem soon find the young Kenari boy wrecking equipment and screens in the engine room. Clem remarks that he likes the boy's spirit but warns that he might not want to be here when they come to clean up. Not understanding the strangers' language, Cassian waves his staff at them. B2EMO warns that a Republic frigate is approaching.

Maarva attempts to communicate with the frightened Cassian while Clem warns that they have nine minutes before the Republic starship arrives. In order to save the boy from danger, Maarva gets B2EMO to bring a drowser. While Clem points out that the boy's people are on the planet, Maarva counters that his tribe have already killed a Republic officer and that the Republic would retaliate when the frigate lands. Maarva stuns Cassian with her drowser.

Back in the present, Karn and Mosk's Tac-Pods approach the Ferrix settlement and land outside the scrap yard. West Team joins North Team. The workers believe the corporate soldiers are hunting for someone. Karn and his Corporate Tactical Forces enter the streets of Ferrix from different sides. A team enters Maarva's home and tells the elderly woman that they have a warrant for Cassian Andor. After restraining her, they enter the house. Elsewhere, Bix returns to Timm Karlo's office and asks why the stuff is piled up in the alley. Timm says he forgot and gets to work.

Meanwhile, Maarva chastises Karn as his troops search her home. Karn replies that she can stop the search by helping them find Andor. Sergeant Mosk arrives with B2EMO. Karn orders his troops to pull the droid's power supply in an attempt to force the droid's cooperation. Maarva protests but Karn orders one of his soldiers to silence her. Cassian contacts B2EMO by comlink. Sensing something is not right, Andor cryptically tells B2EMO and Maarva that he is sorry and "to make sure that she keeps the heat." While a soldier attempts to track Cassian's signal, Karn and his troops notice a crowd gathering outside Maarva's home. Karn calls East Team for reinforcements and assigns some of his men with guarding Maarva and B2EMO.

Elsewhere, Rael finds Andor in an abandoned warehouse. As Karn and his troops exit Maarva's home, they are confronted by angry residents including Wilmon, whom Karn tries to calm by explaining that they are executing a search warrant. Andor tells Rael that he plans to sell an intact Starpath unit for 40,000 credits, claiming it can track Imperial coordinates for nine parsecs. When Andor demands payment, Rael insists on trying it before asking Andor if he plans to stick around.

Meanwhile, Bix receives news from Salman Paak that several "Corpos" raided Maarva's home. Salman also tells him about the bulletin for Andor. Bix realizes that someone has betrayed Andor and says she needs to find him. Timm tries to stop Bix from leaving, claiming that Andor can take care of himself. Bix quickly realizes that Timm betrayed Andor since he is one of the few people to know that he is from Kenari. Salman asks Timm what he has done.

Andor shows Rael the Starpath unit. Rael asks Andor how he obtained the unit and ponders with three possibilities. The first possibility is that Andor is an Imperial spy, the second is that he is fronting for the true seller, and the third is that Andor is being genuine. Andor reiterates his demand for payment, prompting Rael to reiterate his question. Rael is aware of Andor bribing quartermasters before they scrap. However, the Starpath unit is far too valuable for that.

Rael asks Andor how he obtained the Starpath unit. Andor claims that he stole the Starpath unit himself but Rael does not believe him due to the tight security at the Imperial Naval Base in Steergard. Andor is evasive but Rael offers to give him another thousand credits if he tells him how he got the box. Andor claims that all it takes to steal from the Empire is getting a uniform and impersonating an Imperial personnel. He mocks the complacency and arrogance of the Empire. Rael agrees, saying that the Empire doesn't think about them.

Andor wants to count the money but Rael talks about the costs of resisting the Empire. Rael then mentions that he is aware that Andor's adoptive father Clem was hanged by the Empire. Rael invites Andor to join him, prompting Andor to ask at gunpoint how he knows so much about him. Rael wants to talk with Andor but warns that the Corporate Tactical Forces are on their way to arrest him for murdering the two security officers. Rael tells Andor he sees potential in him. Andor demands to know who he is, prompting Rael to point out that they do not have a lot of time to escape. Andor asks why he would choose to go with Rael. Rael responds by presenting Andor with the opportunity of fighting back.

Back on the streets, several residents including Salman, Wilmon, and Brasso begin banging

objects in order to intimidate the Corpos. Several businesses close down their rollers. Andor demands to know who Rael is and asks whether he is an Imperial spy. Rael explains that special people are hard to find and that he came to save him from the pyre. Rael asks Andor to trust him and crushes Andor's comlink, warning him never to carry anything he cannot control. The two sense movement around the warehouse and realize that they are surrounded.

Meanwhile, corporate troopers from North Team apprehend Bix in the streets of Ferrix. East Team sets up a perimeter around the warehouse on Rix Street where Andor and Rael are. Their leader contacts Karn, who orders them not to engage until he has arrived. Since Rael's ship is 40 clicks away, he and Andor decide to escape on a speeder bike. Rael has also planted snap charges on the door as a preemptive escape measure. The charges succeed in taking out some of the corporate soldiers but others charge in. A gun battle ensues and the two men are also forced to dodge falling objects. Several of the corporate soldiers are wounded by falling chains and objects.

Despite Rael's objections, Andor attempts to retrieve the Starpath box, dodging debris and enemy fire. Rael shoots a corporate soldier attempting to gun down Andor. The two men escape several falling chains and objects. Andor is upset about failing to retrieve the box but Rael thinks that escaping is more important. While Karn contacts North Team for help, Bix attempts to escape but is restrained by an officer. Timm confronts the North Team soldiers and attempts to aid Bix but is shot dead by a trigger happy trooper. The team leader orders the soldier who shot Bix to return to the pod and summon air support. Bix weeps for her dead boyfriend.

Karn and Mosk learn from the surviving member of East Team that Andor and Rael are approaching their direction. A corporate trooper enters a shop, prompting three aliens to flee. Meanwhile, Maarva notices that the two corporate troopers guarding her are unnerved by the clanging sounds and hints of a coming reckoning. One of the soldier tells her to shut up. Maarva says that when it stops, they will want to fret. One of the soldier asks what will happen. Andor and Rael encounter the fleeing aliens.

While Corporate Tactical Forces converge around the town center, Andor ambushes a Corporate trooper and forces him to surrender his comlink, which he destroys. Andor demands to know how many troops there are while Rael urges him to kill the man. The trooper reports there are twelve men and two officers. Elsewhere, the Corporate soldier who shot Timm returns to his Mobile Tac-Pod and attempts to fly the ship away. However, the ship has been tied to a large piece of wreckage, which causes the ship to lose control and crash into the wreckage.

While Andor and Rael search for charges, a Corporate trooper finds his comrade, whom Andor has gagged and bound. They appear to escape in a blue landspeeder. Corporate soldiers shoot the stolen speeder, causing it to crash. However, they quickly discover it was a decoy with Andor and Rael escaping on a speeder bike. Rael sets the wrecked speeder to explode. Mosk attempt to contact their comrades in North Team while Karn attends to the wounded and dead comrades.

As Andor flees with Rael on a speeder bike, a tearful Maarva experiences a flashback of her and Clem carrying their adoptive son Cassian from the wrecked Separatist starship on Kenari. B2EMO looks up to her with his sensors flashing sadly. Salman and Wilmon free a grieving Bix while Brasso drinks sadly. As Andor and Rael fly over fields, a shell-shocked Karn is roused by Sergeant Mosk who tells him they need to leave. While the young Cassian meets his adoptive parents in the cockpit in the past, Andor leaves with Rael on his starship.

Summary: Out of options, Cassian is recruited for a dangerous mission to infiltrate an Imperial garrison.



The episode opens with Luthen Rael and Cassian Jeron Andor travel through hyperspace aboard a Fondor Haulcraft bound for Aldhani. Andor searches for a medpac and Rael offers him a drink of med nog. Andor is curious about Aldhani. Rael offers Andor two choices: dropping him off on another planet or coming with him to join a bigger fight. Knowing Andor's talent for stealing, Rael offers him the opportunity to "put a stick" into the Empire's eye and get paid for it.

Andor is curious about Rael's identity and wonders whether he is a rebel or partisan. Andor is not interested in Rael's cause and admits he is more interested in survival. He tells Rael that he spent two years in prison and fought on the planet Mimban when he was 16 years old. Andor adds that he was part of a unit of 50 that survived. Rael points out that Andor had spent six months on Mimban as a cook and survived because he fled.

Rael says that Andor should hate the Galactic Empire more for forcing him to fight with others to survive. Rael offers the opportunity to help bring about the downfall of the Empire, emphasizing that he came for him. Rael offers to pay Andor 200,000 credits if he takes part in a mission to steal the quarterly payroll of an entire Imperial sector.

At the galactic capital of Coruscant, Imperial Security Bureau (ISB) Supervisor Dedra Meero attends a meeting at the ISB Headquarters. During the meeting, Supervisor Grandi reports that an increase in quarterly detentions across the Ryloth sector would erode local authority, requiring an increase in their blackline budget. Major Partagaz demands more specifics and is dissatisfied with her answer about increasing Imperial surveillance activities. Partagaz then questions Lagret about the progress of his memorandum about mining on Arvala-Six, which has displaced the local population.

Partagaz asks the ISB officials about the purpose of their agency. Meero responds that their purpose is to further security objectives by collecting intelligence, providing useful analysis, and conducting effective covert action. Partagaz responds that is verbatim from the ISB mission and wrong. He likens the ISB to healthcare providers who treat symptoms and locate "germs" for the purpose of treating diseases. Partagaz reassigns Lagret's task of writing the memorandum to another ISB official.

Partagaz then questions Blevin about an incident on Ferrix in the Morlana sector. Blevin responds that incident is under the jurisdiction of Corporate Tactical Forces and explains that they tried to serve a warrant but encountered more trouble than they anticipated. When Partagaz presses Blevin on the matter, he explains that several personnel were killed and property damaged. Blevin also reports that a stolen Imperial Starpath unit was also recovered from the scene. Blevin offers to investigate but Partagaz says that they will speak before he leaves. Partagaz asks Lonni Jung about protection requests for traffic to the Abrion sector. Jung reports that there is an increase in protected shipping heading towards Scarif. During the meeting, Meero glances down a screen.

On the lush hills of Aldhani, Andor picks the pseudonym "Clem" and shaves his beard. Rael sights their local contact approaching them. Before leaving to meet the contact, he gives Andor a Kuati Signet as a down payment, explaining that it was created to celebrate an ancient uprising against the Rakatan invaders. Rael tells Andor that he wants the signet back if he lives, warning him that it is worth a lot of credits.

The contact turns out to be a human woman named Vel. When Vel asks if something is wrong, Rael replies that he thinks that things are coming together. While Andor watches through the cockpit windows, the Fondor Droid Mod speaks to him. Outside, Rael explains that "Clem" can pilot, shoot, lie and is a polyglot. Vel is skeptical about recruiting an untested new recruit and mercenary for their planned heist. Rael gives her the option of including "Clem" for their mission or calling off the entire operation. When Vel objects, Rael tells her that this is her opportunity to lead and emphasizes that "Clem" is disposable.

At the Pre-Mor Enforcement headquarters, ISB agent Blevin informs Chief Inspector Hyne, Deputy Inspector Syril Karn, and Sergeant Linus Mosk that they are to surrender all comlinks, weapons and documents to the Empire. He says that they will be dispatched to a transfer where they will have their personal effects handed to them. Blevin also informs that them they will also certify confirmation of the official ISB After Action Report detailing their involvement in the "Ferrix Incident."

Hyne protests that they had nothing to do with it but Blevin blames their alleged idiocy, ineptitude and total disengagement for the recent debacle on Ferrix. Blevin refuses to let Mosk speak. He also tells Karn that he will not be replaced. Blevin uses the Ferrix debacle as a pretext for placing the Morlana system under permanent Imperial authority.

Back on Aldhani, Andor accompanies Vel as they walk down a hill. Vel asks about his arm. Andor asks who Rael is but she replies that he should have asked Rael when he had the chance. She also warns Andor not to mention Rael to the others when they return to camp. When Andor asks why they are in a remote location, Vel briefs him about their plan to rob the armory of the Aldhani Garrison. Vel explains that their route avoids a nearby Imperial airfield. With Andor, she says that their team now consists of seven members. During the journey, they avoid a patrolling TIE fighter.

Elsewhere, Attendant Heert briefs Dedra Meero about the Ferrix incident, reporting that one local and four Preox-Morlana security employees died. Meero locates the NS-9 Starpath unit in the database, giving them jurisdiction over the case. Meero says that she does not want to spark Blevin's interest. Later, Rael's Fondor Droid Mod flies Rael's ship to Coruscant. In private, Rael dons a grey wig and ornate purple clothes with rings.

Back on Aldhani, Vel briefs Andor about the history of the Aldhani highlands; explaining that the Empire relocated the Aldhani to a free-enterprise zone in the lowlands. Andor drinks water from a creek. Elsewhere, Meero confronts Blevin for refusing to turn over information relating to the Ferrix incident. Blevin insists that the Ferrix incident falls under his turf but Meer counters that the theft of the Starpath unit gives her jurisdiction in the case. Blevin denies her request a second time and attempts to pull rank. Meero replies that she will refer the matter to Partagaz.

While Vel and Andor continue their travels, a sleeping rebel named Karis Nemik is approached at gunpoint by another man named Arvel Skeen, who chides him for falling asleep on guard

duty. The two soon spot Vel and Andor approaching through a pair of macrobinoculars. The other rebels are unnerved by the presence of the newcomer "Clem." Vel apologizes for not introducing "Clem" earlier and claims that he will give them "critical redundancy" in all areas. Vel introduces Andor to her comrades Skeen, Taramyn Barcona, Nemik, and Cinta Kaz. Tamaryn is uncomfortable about "Clem"'s presence but Vel orders her underlings to make him feel welcome.

Elsewhere, the former Preox-Morlana Deputy-Inspector Cyril Karn visits his mother Eedy Karn on Coruscant. She slaps him before embracing him. Back on Aldhani, Cinta treats Andor's arm injury. Tamaryn objects to "Clem"'s presence but Vel insists that she trusts "Clem." On Coruscant, Luthen and his assistant Kleya meets with Senator Mon Mothma at his ornate gallery. After exchanging pleasantries and talking about art, Luthen and Mothma get down to business. Mothma confides that she suspects she is being spied upon. She also tells him that she has recruited a new ally. Luthen tells Mothma that he can trust her and Kleya.

Senator Mothma arrives home and discusses arrangements for a dinner party with her husband Perrin Fertha. Mothma is uncomfortable with some dinner guests Ars Dangor and Sly Moore that her husband invited. Mothma suggests that Perrin invite some guests from Ghorman since the Empire cut off their shipping lanes yesterday. Mothma is upset that her husband invited these guests and wants to call off the party. Perrin grumbles about everything being "boring and sad."

Meanwhile on Aldhani, Vel's rebels are joined by one of their garrison contacts Lieutenant Gorn. Gorn is suspicious of "Clem" and tells Vel that an Imperial engineer is visiting from Coruscant. Later, Vel briefs her rebel team about the Imperial air base at Alkenzi, which is located near the sacred river of Nasma Klain. She uses a model The Aldhani Garrison is a depot for supplies, weapons, and the Imperial sector payroll. Vel explains that the base contains a runway that leads underground. The vault containing the payroll is located beneath the runway. The garrison is defended by forty troops.

Gorn briefs the team about an Aldhani ceremony known as the Eye of Aldhani. Thousands hike from all over the land to view a meteor shower. Gorn says that he has seen it twice and tells "Clem" that it something he will not forget. Karis explains that the Eye of Aldhani is not really a meteor shower but is a recurrent band of crystalized, noctilucent microdensities. He explains that they are billions of crystals that explode when the planet Aldhani orbits through an asteroid belt, describing it as a thing of beauty. Karis believes that they can use the meteor shower as a distraction for their heist. Vel explains that the meteor shower is scheduled to happen in three days time. Andor is skeptical but Vel believes her plan will work.

Lieutenant Meero brings her case to Major Partagaz, stating that the Starpath unit recovered on Ferrix was traced to the theft from a base in her sector. When Partagaz accuses her of stirring intra-office friction, Meero theorizes that the Starpath heist is part of a conspiracy to steal Imperial equipment for an organized Rebellion. She cites three previous case files that suggest a pattern. Partagaz dismisses Meero's concerns on the grounds of what he regards as insufficient evidence and orders her that she stick to her sectors. Partagaz reminds her that two of her reports are overdue and tells her to focus on enforcement issues including boosting incarceration numbers.

Tamaryn briefs "Clem" about the Rono freighter specs and the base layout. Before "Clem" can eat, Vel orders him to let Cinta check her wounds and to memorize the specs and layout by morning. Vel goes on watch duty.

Summary: Cassian must carefully navigate the distrust inherent in being the new member of a secret operation.



On Coruscant, a despondent Syril Karn spends time with his mother, who counsels him about the challenges of leadership. When Karn asks his mother Eedy Karn why she didn't visit him, she replies that an open invitation is no invitation. Eedy observes that her son lacks job prospects for the future due to the Ferrix incident. Eedy tells Syril that she will contact Uncle Harlo to call a favor for him. Syril is skeptical and asks what Harlo will take him on for. Eedy says that Harlo can put Syril in touch with some-

one who would hire him and reassures her son that Harlo knows what is best.

Elsewhere on Aldhani, Cassian Jeron Andor ("Clem") awakes in his hut to find his weapons missing. Outside, he finds Arvel Skeen has searched his weapons under orders from Vel Sartha. Skeen surmises that "Clem" fled in a hurry and asks about his arm. Skeen notices a weapon belonging to Luthen Rael but Andor is unwilling to provide his name. Skeen also shows the tattoos on his body including a Krayt Head and a "By the Hand," which Andor recognizes. Skeen uses his tattoos to attempt to build a rapport with "Clem."

"Clem" tells Skeen that he went to a Sipo youth center at the age of 13 years old, where he spent three years. Skeen is skeptical of "Clem"'s background story, stating that "the axe forgets, but the tree remembers." Andor surmises that Skeen joined Vel's rebel band to seek revenge. Andor says he was sent to help and admits that he is not a team player.

Skeen talks about his fellow team members, describing Karis Nemik as inexperienced but a true believer, and Cinta Kaz as stone cold and fearless. Skeen says Lieutenant Gorn is key to their plan. Andor asks what if the lieutenant is leading them into a trap. Skeen flips the question back at him. Andor says that he is here to win and walk away.

At Mon Mothma's residence on Coruscant, Mothma has breakfast with her husband Perrin Fertha and daughter Leida. Mothma had made arrangements for the driver Kloris to take Leida

to her morning class. Leida reveals that her dad will be taking her to school since she doesn't have an early class. Mothma orders Leida to get her coat but her daughter refuses to play her role in her mother's plan. Leida accuses her mother of using her for her own agenda. An upset Mothma walks out on breakfast early.

Back on Aldhani, Karis Nemik serves Andor some dray milk for breakfast, which is an acquired taste. He shows Andor a navigational tool that he has been building. Nemik says that he is trying to lessen their dependence on Imperial technology before talking about freedom. Skeeen thinks that Nemik is obsessed with ideas and philosophy. Nemik goes on to talk about the Imperial "thought machine" concealing atrocities. Skeeen asks "Clem" for his input but Andor is not in a chatty mood. Nemik goes on to talk about reconciling technology with freedom.

Taramyn Barcona summons "Clem" for a meeting in his hut. When Nemik asks Skeeen if he distrusts "Clem," Skeeen replies that he doesn't trust him. Vel and Barcona ask Andor about how much weight their escape ship can carry. Andor realizes that they don't know how to get the payrolls out of the Imperial base. Barcona asks "Clem" how he would input the weight. Using his knowledge of machinery, Andor explains that there is a load clutch which has information on the weight. Andor insists on fling the starship carrying the stolen payrolls. Outside, Taramyn uses the hill and surrounding forest to describe the layout of the Imperial base.

At the Aldhani Garrison's base, Lieutenant Gorn chastises two other Imperial officers for not ordering their men to clear a nearby three fingered structure that has been used for target practice. Barcona tells "Clem" that his cover story is that he is an Imperial Private and sentry who has been transferred from the Alkenzi Airbase for special duty. Barcona asks "Clem" if he knows how to walk like an Imperial soldier.

Meanwhile on Ferrix, Imperial Security Bureau Lieutenant Supervisor Blevin watches as workers clear damage caused by the fighting during the Ferrix incident. Captain Vanis Tigo is clearing out guests and furniture from a hotel, which the ISB has requisitioned as their new headquarters. Tigo asks if he could be made a Prefect. Blevin quips that position will allow him to wear a ball gown like his and tells Tigo to get his headquarters up and running by tomorrow.

Taramyn drills "Clem" and the three other male rebels about marching and holding blasters as Imperial soldiers. Their plan is for Lieutenant Gorn to give them entry into the base. Andor observes that Skeeen is left-handed and suggests changing the position of his blaster. The rest of the team are right-handed. Taramyn reluctantly agrees to switch.

Cinta sights an approaching TIE fighter, which circles a nearby forest before swooping down and passing their camp. Nemik reassures "Clem" that they will soon see that "surprise from above is not as shocking as surprise from below." The TIE fighter returns to the local Imperial garrison, which includes a dam wall as part of its fortifications.

Lieutenant Gorn speaks with Corporal Kimzi. Kimzi asks if it is true that they are planning to tear down the panoramic landscape to make way for the expanded Imperial airbase. Gorn confirms this is the case. Kimzi asks about the local Dhani. Gorn instructs the Corporal to get back to business and warns him that he will be making rounds the following day. Cinta tends to Andor's arm. Andor takes offense at Skeeen for checking his pouch. Andor dresses in an Imperial Army uniform with Taramyn watching.

Elsewhere, ISB Supervisor Dedra Meero walks past Blevin and several aides discussing plans for an upcoming conference. Later, Meero gets Attendant Heert to search the Imperial ledgers for the missing objects. Heert checks the Hosnian register but it doesn't report any missing objects. Heert says that the Imperial Navy ledgers are the only thing left to consult but that they never admit any mistakes. Meero allows Heert to leave but he insists on staying with his superior officer. Meero admits that she does not know what she is doing.

However, Heert reassures her that they are onto something. He notices a pattern of stolen items from Kessel, Fondor, targeting consoles from Jakku, proton warheads from Base Cay, and the Starpath Unit from the Steergard Naval Yard. Meero and Heert deduce that the rebels are spreading out their thefts in an attempt to make their attacks appear to be random. Meero proposes that they search two more files each.

On Aldhani, "Clem" and his rebel allies gather at a fire consisting of their model of the Imperial base prior to their planned heist. Vel and her comrades give a toast for the Rebellion. The following day, they travel towards the base. During their travels, Vel gets "Clem" to repeat the various stages and signals associated with their planned heist. Andor asks why they are relying on an Imperial lieutenant. Vel explains that Gorn fell in love with a local Dhani woman and lost

his promotion. He also lost the woman, which caused him to lose his taste for the Empire. She adds that everyone has their own personal rebellion.

Back on Coruscant, Eedy tells her son Syril that Uncle Harlo thought that police work did not fit her son. Syril asks what field Harlo thinks that he should pursue. Eedy tells Syril that she related his experiences on Ferrix as best as she could. She adds that they are counting on Harlo's judgement for Syril's career plans.

At the Aldhani Garrison base, Lieutenant Gorn confronts two of his subordinates about an unpainted wall, stressing that they are expecting a visit by a Coruscant engineer today. When the two corporals tell him that many of the soldiers assigned to Aldhani do not want to be there and are demoralized, he relents and tells them to get the wall painted by the following afternoon.

While the rebel band is resting, Skeen ambushes "Clem" and cuts off his Kuati Signet, which he observes is made from sky kyber. Skeen accuses "Clem" of hiding his past. Vel tries to reassert control but Skeen insists on knowing who Andor actually is. Andor replies that Skeen knows who exactly he is and reaches for his blaster. Taramyn and Vel try to calm things down. Nemik spots a ship approaching from the valley. Vel orders them to pack up and tells Skeen to return the stone. Skeen reluctantly complies. Nemik reports that the ship is approaching the garrison, which helps calm the situation.

Andor admits that he is a mercenary. When Taramyn questions Vel, she tells him that Rael insisted that she include "Clem" or he would call off the mission. Skeen thinks that they should have called off the mission earlier. Andor says that he is only willing to take the risk with the mission because of the money. When he suggests that they are afraid, Skeen counters that maybe "Clem" is afraid. Andor replies that there is a difference between being afraid and losing one's nerve. If they bail out, he tells them not to use him as an excuse. After Cinta confirms that she is unaware, Vel decides to hold off discussing "Clem"'s past until after their mission.

On Coruscant, Senator Mothma and Perrin travel on an airspeeder following their meeting with Gar Tafeed. Perrin says that Tafeed knows more about what Mothma is up to than him. Perrin asks Mothma when she was planning to tell him about her new charitable foundation. Perrin asks the driver Kloris to take the expressway. Meanwhile, Syril studies a hologram of Andor.

Approaching the Aldhani Imperial base, Skeen observes that the Imperial base resembles Nemik's model. Nemik says that he has had plenty of time to study the site. Vel tells them that they need to get a fire up. At the base, Lieutenant Gorn spots the rebels' fire. Skeen tells "Clem" that the Empire killed his brother. He explains that an Imperial Prefect flooded his brother's land. In despair, his brother committed suicide by filling his pockets with stone and jumping into a river. Skeen says this is what motivated his hatred of the Empire. When Andor asks what his brother was growing, Skeen explains that his brother had been growing pepper trees, which had lived for centuries. Skeen says this is as close to apology he will be getting, which Andor accepts.

Vel tells Andor that Taramyn will now be in charge of the mission. Vel says that she will reunite with them the following night if the mission succeeds. Taramyn asks Andor if he can accept his leadership, which Andor accepts. The rebels get to work.

At Galactic Antiquities and Objects of Interest, Luthen Rael waits to hear for a transmission on a transmitter. His assistant Kleya tells him that he has been waiting for over an hour and tells him to switch it off. Rael confides that he is worried about the mission and recruiting Andor. Rael thinks that he took a risk in including Andor for the Aldhani mission. Since they have clients tomorrow, they decide to close shop for the night.

care about them. Nemik hopes to put his ideas into action tomorrow but Andor warns him to be careful about what he wishes for. While Andor doesn't share his idealism, Nemik is grateful he is here.

Meanwhile, the Imperial Commandant Jayhold Beehaz briefs his fellow officers about how the Empire managed to manipulate the indigenous Dhani people by giving them false choices. He also talks about manipulating their cultural pride and stubbornness. In an attempt to discourage Dhani pilgrims from going on their religious trek, Beehaz had established shelters and taverns to discourage them from continuing their pilgrimage. Lieutenant Gorn reports that the Empire's policy has reduced the number of pilgrims over the years from 15,000 to 60.

When Colonel Petigar asks Beehaz if they have informed the Dhani that this will be the last year that they will be permitted to travel through the sacred valley, the Commandant responds that there is no profit in that. He hopes to draw away the pilgrims to an Imperial viewing festival in the Enterprise Zone. When Petigar points out that the valley is sacred to the Dhani, Beehaz quips about recruiting the Dhani as soldiers for the Imperial Army. Petigar asks Gorn if the locals will permit them to use their valley for military purposes. Gorn concedes that the locals will have no choice. Beehaz describes The Eye of Aldhani as a beautiful sight and invites Petigar to drink. Gorn watches with trepidation.

Later, Beehaz asks Gorn what he thinks about Petigar. Gorn replies that it will be hard to charm the engineer and informs the Commandant he has brought in 30 sentries from Alkenzi and will be supervising them. Beehaz warns Gorn that everything must go perfectly tonight.

Meanwhile, Taramyn Barcona attempts to contact Vel Sartha (who is using the codename "Echo-One") using a battle radio. After some tinkering by Nemik, Taramyn manages to contact Vel. While walking down the hill, Arvel Skeen tells Andor that Taramyn was a former stormtrooper

and that Vel lost her family to stormtroopers. As pilgrims arrive on the route, comets begin firing through the sky, beginning The Eye of Aldhani. Lieutenant Gorn orders the garrison to welcome the pilgrims. After reaching the Aldhani Base, Andor and his fellow rebels remove their Aldhani robes and pose as Imperial Army troopers welcoming the pilgrims.

Elsewhere, the overweight Beehaz struggles to fasten a belt. He asks his wife Roboda Beehaz, who is dressing their son Leonart Beehaz for help. Though Beehaz blames the compressors for damaging his clothes, Roboda points out that he has gained weight. Leonart refuses to don his Imperial tunic but Beehaz orders his son to do so.

The leader of the pilgrims greets Gorn, wishing that there is still some good in him. Andor and his fellow rebels arrive at the base where Gorn assigns them with serving as bodyguards for the Commandant and his family. Meanwhile, Vel and Cinta Kaz don diving gear and swim through the river under the base's dam. Meanwhile, Commandant Beehaz and his family receive a hide of goat skin from the leader of the pilgrims. Beehaz does not like the smell of the goat hide but complies.

While Vel and Cinta infiltrate the Imperial base, the Commandant and his family attend a ceremony with the leaders of the pilgrims. Taramyn, Andor and the rest of the rebel team stand at attention while the leader of the pilgrims begins the ceremony. He passes the goat hide to Beehaz, who passes it to his son Leonart. During the ceremony, Taramyn makes contact via comlink with Vel and Cinta. Vel orders them to go ahead with the mission.

While comets streak over the skies, Vel and Cinta abseil down the dam. Following the ceremony, Beehaz says he will pass the goat hide before departing. The leader of the pilgrims burns the goat hide. After Gorn establishes contact with Taramyn and his team, they enter the base with Beehaz and his family. Once inside, Andor seals the entrance and the rebels ambush Beehaz and his family, forcing them down to the ground at gunpoint. Colonel Petigar points a gun at Nemik and demands that the rebels release Leonart. Andor tries to calm the situation but Cinta shoots Petigar from behind, taking him out. Outside, Gorn tells a soldier that he and his men can rest for the night. The pilgrims light a fire with the goat hide to mark the celebration.

Vel demands that Commandant Beehaz unlock the vault but he claims he doesn't know. Cinta and Vel place hoods on his wife Roboda and son Leonart. Roboda implores Behz to cooperate and he reluctantly allows the rebels to enter the base. Andor and his comrades disarm the guards and Imperials technicians at gunpoint. The rebels disable all communications except the one for Alkenzi Air Base. The Imperials have their mouths and hands bound with duck tape. In the command room, Vel tells Beehaz to cooperate or they will kill his family. She promises to spare them if they cooperate.

When the Imperial officer Kimzi notices that the communications are down, another Imperial soldier believes that the Eye of Aldhani is interfering with the communications. Taramyn and the rebels proceed deeper into the base with the captive Beehaz. Beehaz convinces several personnel to lay down their arms and cooperate with the rebels in order to prevent further bloodshed. Skreen orders several Imperial soldiers to assist with loading the payroll register while Beehaz unlocks the vault. Since Beehaz doesn't have full access to the vault, explosives are used to unlock the rest of the vault.

The rebels force the Imperials at gunpoint to load large cylinders containing the sector payroll onto a parked freighter. Back in the command center, Cinta dons an Imperial officer's uniform while the intercom receives a transmission about a breach in the vault. Cinta switches off the transmitter and the lights. Outside, the pilgrims sing and worship in Dhani. The worshippers lift a dome over a pyre while watching comets fly through the sky. Suspicious about the base's lights and transmitter shutting down, Corporal Kimzi leads several Imperial Army soldiers down a flight of stairs into the vault.

Beehaz realizes that Lieutenant Gorn is working with the rebels and denounces him as a traitor, saying that he will hang. Gorn replies that he deserves far worse for serving Beehaz for seven years. At the Alkenzi Air Base, several TIE pilots climb into their TIE fighters. Corporal Kimzi and his men discover Gorn and his associates loading payroll cylinders into their freighter. Gorn claims that he and his men are working on a classified mission. Kimzi asks Commandant Beehaz for clarification but the Commandant collapses from an injury.

A gun battle breaks out between Kimzi's men and the rebel infiltrators. Kimzi is killed during the gun battle. Gorn is also killed by one of Kimzi's soldiers. Andor enters the cockpit but is attacked by an Imperial soldier, who holds him in a headlock. During the struggle, the soldier

is shot by Nemik. Taramyn attempts to reach Vel but is killed by a blaster bolt. Once Kez and Skeen have boarded the freighter, Andor flies the freighter through a launch tunnel into the comet-covered night sky.

During the ascent, Nemik is crushed by several cylinders. Skeen and Vel manage to free Nemik but his leg is crushed. Kez sedates Nemik with a med-spike. Andor asks for hyperspace coordinates as they fly through the comet-covered night sky. They are pursued by three TIE fighters. Nemik guides Andor as he flies the freighter and gives him the coordinates "Vector six-five-five-five-one." The TIEs attempt to keep up with the fleeing freighter but two of them are struck by meteor debris.

On the ground, a disguised Cinta exits the base, walking past pilgrims and Imperial soldiers who are mesmerized and awed by the comet display. In space, Andor asks Skeen and Vel where they are heading. Vel asks about Nemik's wellbeing, promoting Skeen to ask if she is disappointed. Andor asks his question again. Vel thinks that Nemik is dying but Skeen disagrees, saying that they have a doctor built into the contingent. Skeen says that Nemik is the reason they are here. Andor asks how they will get to the doctor.

Later, Nemik is treated by Quadpaw, a four-armed humanoid doctor who wears goggles on his eyes. The doctor operates on his back. Outside the hut, Skeen and Andor wait. Skeen tells Andor that the vault is worth 80 million Credits and proposes splitting the profit and hiding it. Andor realizes that Skeen is not a genuine rebel but a soldier of fortune. When Andor questions Skeen about his brother, Skeen reveals that he made up the story. Skeen suggests hiding the stolen payroll on a moon eight parsecs away and pocketing the loot. Disgusted, Andor shoots him dead with a blaster.

Despite the alien doctor's efforts, Nemik succumbs to his injuries and dies. Vel thanks him. Andor enters the hut wielding a blaster and offers to buy the doctor's ship for 30,000 credits. Andor reveals that Skeen is dead and that he wanted to take the money and leave them behind. Vel doesn't believe him and describes Andor as a "disgusting bastard." Andor demands his share of the money but offers to leave the freighter and the stolen payroll. He says that he is done and also returns the Kuati Signet. Before Andor leaves, Vel confines him to take Nemik's manifesto.

At the ISB Central Office on Coruscant, Major Partagaz summons all Imperial Security Bureau personnel including Lieutenant Dedra Meero for an emergency meeting. He says that he wants every Star Sector and Planetary Emergency Retaliation plan in the building ready for presentation by midnight. At the Imperial Senate, Senator Mon Mothma urges a fact-finding committee into the blockade of Ghorman but is ignored by the other senators. Elsewhere, Luthen Rael serves a customer at Galactic Antiquities and Objects of Interest when he hears news about a massive rebel attack on Aldhani. In private, Rael laughs with joy at the rebel victory.

Summary: The repercussions of the Aldhani heist reach all the way to Coruscant, while Cassian returns home.



In the morning, Syril Karn dresses for an interview with the Imperial Bureau of Standards. His mother Eedy Karn questions his decision to don a brown suit, reminding that his Uncle Harlo has pulled favors for him. While having breakfast, the two hear news on HoloNet about a terror attack and robbery at the Imperial Armor on the planet Aldhani with multiple fatalities. The broadcaster announced that the Galactic Empire has imposed a blockade and launched an investigation. Eedy remarks that the conspirators will

regret it.

Meanwhile, Imperial Security Bureau (ISB) Colonel Wullf Yularen addresses other senior ISB officials, vowing that the Empire will retaliate swiftly against the rebel attack. He asks them to consider how tight they will close their fist and talks about the ISB's stringent recruitment standards. In retaliation, Yularen imposes a tribute tax five times the amount stolen from Aldhani on any sector harboring partisan activity. Yularen emphasizes that they will make it clear that nobody steals from the Empire. He adds that the use of any local custom, festival or tradition as a cover for rebel activity will trigger permanent revocation of Imperial tolerance.

Yularen assures his officers that he has spoken with Emperor Palpatine this morning and that the Emperor has granted the ISB access to Imperial Army and Imperial Navy resources. He also announces that the Emperor will be convening an emergency session of the Imperial Senate

to propose a legislative package of bills and amendments that will give the ISB unlimited powers of surveillance, search, and seizure.

Yularen also announces that they will be invoking the Public Order Resentencing Directive (PORD) later today. Any criminal act, with even indirect effect on the Empire, will be classified as a Class One offence. All prison sentences will be evaluated and all outstanding fines and levies are to be paid in full. Dedra Meero listens but is visibly upset, which ISB Attendant Heert notices. Later, Heert speaks with Meero, who expresses concerns that Yularen's policies are playing into the rebels' hands. Meero remarks that the Empire is treating the Aldhani incident as a robbery when it is in fact an announcement.

Elsewhere, Luthen Rael listens to a transmitter where he receives news that 80 million credits was stolen during the Aldhani heist and that all military personnel have been replaced and are being interrogated by the ISB. The broadcast also reports that the ISB confirmed that all tracking devices in the escape craft were disabled prior to it reaching hyperspace. In addition, 134 Aldhani residents have been taken into custody under suspicion of abetting the terrorists. Kleya Marki informs Rael that Mon Mothma has come for a visit and tells him to wipe the smile off his face.

Outside Galactic Antiquities and Objects of Interest, Mothma apologizes for the abrupt visit and says she was on her way to the Senate. She announces that she wants to exchange gift she previously got for her husband Perrin Fertha with a different artifact since she isn't sure he loves it. Inside, Mothma asks if Rael was responsible for the Aldhani heist. Rael is evasive and replies that revolutions are expensive. They then move to the matter of Mothma's family funds, which Mothma has had trouble accessing. Mothma reiterates her question and Rael reminds her that he had explained the risk of new faces but that she persisted.

Mothma asks if Rael has realized the gravity of what he has done. Rael asks about the upcoming meeting and says that they may have to reschedule. Mothma tells Rael that she was planning to build a network but Rael reminds her that "turning back will be impossible." He counters that she knew the risk and describes the network as a weapon. Rael says that they have waited long enough. Mothma is concerned about the repercussions of the Aldhani heist but Rael explains that his plan was to get the Emperor to overreact.

When Rael remarks that the events on Aldhani will invigorate their struggle, Mothma replies that people will suffer. Rael replies that is the plan and adds that there will be no rules going forward. Returning to business, Rael tells Mothma that the rebellion will need every credit they can get their hands on and to let her know how the meeting goes. When Mothma says that she won't be purchasing any pieces this morning, Rael laughs and says that he will have more pieces coming in soon. Kleya listens to the conversation with interest. After Mothma leaves, Kleya remarks that she hopes Mothma is worth it. Rael says that they will see and adds that they can't hide forever. Mon Mothma's airspeeder departs Rael's store and flies into the Coruscant skyline.

Sybil Karn tours the Bureau Of Standards on his first day of work. His supervisor talks about the work that the Bureau does including weights and gauges, redundancy, and verification. The supervisor questions Karn about his prior employment on Morlana One. Karn explains that a "rebel murderer" is running free due to corruption and laxity in the corporate authority. Karn believes that he was punished for trying to uphold the law and do his job of upholding public safety.

He talks about the loss of two colleagues and his belief in the law. Karn says that he seeks to clear his name and have his record expunged. The supervisor offers to help by suggesting a job opening in Fuel Purity. The supervisor ushers Karn towards a desk.

Elsewhere on Coruscant, a hooded Kleya walks past Imperial security in a foyer into a public walkway. She follows several symbols on the walkway. Meanwhile, Dedra Meero visits the ISB datavault and requests access to two years worth of data from an unkempt Attendant Felzonis via a Multi-Sector Data Blend. She explains that her survey pool are Imperial Naval facilities and resources. She seeks a record of all missing avionics, comm, navigation, and targeting equipment. When Felzonis asks which star systems, Meero requests all star systems. Meero also asks that the report be kept confidential and that a copy be sent exclusively to her office. Meero asks Felzonis to be discreet.

On Aldhani, Cinta Kaz is about to mount her speeder bike as she watches an Imperial Star Destroyer flying over the sacred valley. Back on Coruscant, Kleya meets with a disguised Vel Sartha. She asks about the whereabouts of Andor and says that she shouldn't even be here. Vel replies that neither of them should be here and reassures her that the money is safe. Kleya

praises Vel for hiding the money securely and for her success in recruiting Taramyn Barcona. Vel says that Arvel Skeen

When Vel asks about Cinta, Kleya replies that she is doing what she has been told. Kleya warns her about the danger of receiving and sending messages. She then turns to the matter of "Clem" whose real identity is Cassian Jeron Andor. Regarding him as a loose end, Kleya tasks Cinta with killing Andor to conceal the knowledge of Andor. Before leaving she promises to send what she has on Andor.

Meanwhile, a hooded Andor returns to his adopted family's home on Ferrix. He is greeted by his adoptive mother Maarva Andor and droid B2EMO, who are delighted to see him. Maarva warns Andor that he cannot stay here since the Empire has expelled Preox-Morlana and taken over Ferrix. Maarva reiterates that he should not be here and reveals that Timm Karlo betrayed him. Maarva reveals that Timm was killed by the Corps and that Bix Caleen tried to warn Andor. Timm tried to stop her but was killed in the process.

Maarva tells Andor that the Empire is here to stay. Andor invites his mother and B2EMO to flee with him, claiming that he has won enough credits to leave. Andor wants them to leave tonight for a warmer world. As the kettle hisses, Andor talks about his plans of escaping offworld with his family. Andor decides to delay their plans to the following day so that he can speak to Bix one last time.

Elsewhere on Coruscant, Mothma attends a party, taking care to avoid two ISB officers. She meets with a visiting Chandrilan man named Tay Kolma, who is an old friend and banker. Tay talks about Mothma's political career and says that he cannot imagine living on Coruscant. Peerin Fertha is nearby talking with some ladies. Mon Mothma is about to talk about something confidential with Tay when they are joined by Mothma's daughter Leida Mothma, whom Mothma introduces. She tells Leida that Tay is an old family friend who runs the Bank Of Kolma and is close to her sisters.

Not wanting to be in her mother's shadow, Leida quickly gets permission to take leave from the party. In private, Mothma tells Tay that she needs his help for a political plan. Tay is cautious about getting involved in anything political despite his views on the Empire. He warns that some of his colleagues have taken their political allegiances too far. To avoid arousing suspicions, Mothma encourages Tay to pretend to drink more punch. Mothma talks about putting up the front of a maverick senator advancing unpopular causes including advocating for Separatist "do-gooders" and battle Imperial overreach.

Mothma asks if she can confide in Tay. He replies that he doesn't know what she is talking about. Mothma explains that her public persona is a front. She is concerned that the Grand Vizier has infiltrated her Separatist Coalition meetings. Mothma is aware that her driver is an ISB plant who monitors her humanitarian activities. Mothma wants the Empire to think that she is an irritation in order to conceal her true purpose which is raising money. Mothma seeks Tay's help in accessing her family accounts for establishing a Chandrilan charitable outreach foundation. Tay will serve as chairman of the foundation.

Tay replies that she has not answered his question. Mothma thinks that Tay is not suitable for the role since he does not share her politics. As Perrin approaches, Mothma warns Tay that he is unaware of Mothma's true activities and that he is not to be trusted. Perrin reminds them about an upcoming reunion and returns to serving some guests. Mothma tells Tay that their meeting is to be continued before joining Perrin.

Elsewhere on Ferrix, Andor visits the Caleen Salyard. He speaks with Bix Caleen via an intercom on the door. Andor attempts to regale her with a memory of meeting her father while climbing over the wall. Bix tells him that he should not be here because it is not safe. After opening the door, Bix briefly mentions the death of Timm and blames Andor for putting the entire town at risk by killing two Corps and returning home to hide. Andor tries to blame Timm but Bix points out that Andor cheats, lies and steals. Andor accepts that he has to leave and asks about the buyer.

Caleen says that she does not know the identity of the buyer but only encountered the man through Paak. She explains that they communicate via comlink. When Andor asks Caleen how Rael knows so much about him, Caleen says that she did not share information about Andor to Rael. Andor tells Caleen to tell Rael that he held up his side of the deal and that he needs to forget about him. Andor gives Caleen the 12,000 credits that he owes to Xanwan, Nurchi, Brasso, and Deema. Before leaving, Caleen warns Andor to be careful.

While walking through the streets of the Ferrix town, he avoids a pair of stormtroopers. Andor experiences a flashback of he and his adoptive father Clem watching Clone troopers parading. Clem attempts to break up a fight between a Republic supporter and opponent. Someone throws stones at the Clone troopers. Their commanding officer believes Clem was the culprit and orders his men to aim their blasters at him.

Back at the Vaneer family home, Andor greets B2EMO. Maarva tells her adoptive son that she is not leaving. Andor points out that the Empire has set up a stormtrooper barracks on Rix Road but Maarva counters that the Empire is everywhere. Andor suggests fleeing to a place without an Imperial presence but Maarva describes her mind as her last refuge. When Andor asks what is keeping her here, she replies that it is the Rebellion. Andor thinks his adoptive mother is crazy but Maarva says that she is willing to wait it out.

Maarva and Andor are still haunted by the memory of Clem's body hanging in the square and confronting Clone troopers. Maarva asks Andor about the rebel attack on the Aldhani Imperial garrison. She tells Andor that she was encouraged by the attack to remain on Ferrix. Hiding his role in the Aldhani heist, Andor dismisses it as a robbery but Maarva believes that people are standing up. Andor thinks that fighting against the Empire is futile but Maarva thinks that running away is not the best way of fighting them.

Maarva accepts her son has a different path due to his traumatic childhood. She counsels him to run away and find peace. Andor says that he won't have peace because he will be worried about her all the time. Maarva replies that is just love and that Andor can do nothing about that. Maarva expresses her love for Andor but surmises that their paths are different. B2EMO tries to speak but Maarva shushes him. She tells Andor that he will understand. As Andor takes his leave, Maarva counsels him to stop searching for his sister because she believes there were no survivors on Kenari. She says that what happened there was not his responsibility because he was a child. Before exiting, Andor vows to return one day.

At the ISB Central Office, Lonni Jung proposes three theories for the lack of progress in his sector. Major Partagaz orders Jung to conduct a full audit of all Hyperspace routes to Ord Mantell. Lieutenant Supervisor Blevin lodges a complaint against Supervisor Meero for overreaching into her sector. Partagaz asks Meero to explain. Meero counters that Blevin seems more interested in her conduct than advancing integrated Imperial security and shifts the spotlight back to Blevin.

Partagaz questions Blevin about the recovery of the Imperial N-S9 Starpath Unit on Ferrix and reminds him that Meero sought access to his crime reports. Blevin claims that Meero's actions violated the chain of command. Dedra contests his account, pointing out that he advised her to reinforce her suspicions with data and to be careful of her work going forward. Blevin counters that Dedra found a way to access sector data without filing a request.

Meero acknowledges obtaining the data using the Imperial Emergency Act in the wake of the Aldhani heist to gather data across multiple sectors without official sanction. Meero argues that the Rebellion ignores the artificial sector boundaries which Major Partagaz created. Partagaz is defensive about his sector boundaries and asks Meero to explain. Dedra argues that there is a focused organized rebel effort to obtain restricted Imperial military components across sectors. When Partagaz asks for evidence to support her claim, Meero says that unfiltered crime reports support a link between the theft of their most secret equipment and its distribution to rebel groups across the galaxy.

Partagaz questions her methods. Dedra responds that Blevin is aware that she has a documented file ready to go and accuses Blevin of being more concerned with self preservation. Blevin accuses Meero of ignoring the rules and protocol. Partagaz is impressed by Meero's endeavour and says that he will have to think about that. He reassigns the Morlana sector and Ferrix to Supervisor Meero and orders Grandi and Jung to accelerate their efforts. In private, Partagaz compliments Meero for playing the game well but warns her to watch her back.

Elsewhere, Andor has adopted the pseudonym Keef Girgo while hiding on the beach resort world of Niamos. He is sharing a room with a human woman named Windi. While Andor is in the shower, she asks Andor to buy more Peezos and Revnog.

Later, Andor is stopped by a shoretrooper, who thinks he is acting suspiciously. The shoretrooper calls for back up as several individuals flee on the beach. The shoretrooper asks if those are friends of his. Andor claims he is a tourist but the shoretrooper does not believe him and calls a KX-series security droid for backup. The droid has finished apprehending other suspects. Andor attempts to reason with the droid but it holds him in a necklock.

Andor is hauled up before an judge. As Keef Girgo, he faces charges of disruption, anti-Imperial speech, fleeing the scene of an anti-Imperial activity, and damaging Imperial property. Andor protests but the judge counsels him against that to avoid risking a "Resisting Judgement" charge. The judge sentences him to six years in prison, citing new Imperial guidelines. Despite his protests, Andor is hauled away by two shoretroopers. On Coruscant, Cyril Karn browses through records along with countless other employees.

Summary: The Empire catches up to Cassian, but are as yet unaware of his identity and past.



On Niamos, Cassian Jeron Andor, who is still posing as "Keef Girgo," and other prisoners are herded onto various prison transports. When asked his homeworld by a Shoretrooper, Andor claims that he is from Deris-plata. He is ordered to board a transport heading to Narkina 5. Other prisoners board transports heading to various locations including Bel-savis. Andor and his fellow prisoners are ordered to remove their shoes and have their hands shackled to their seats.

Meanwhile on Coruscant, Syril Karn is working at his computer monitor at the Imperial Bureau of Standards when he is visited by two



Imperial Security Bureau (ISB) officers. Later, Karn is greeted in an interrogation cell by Lieutenant Dedra Meero, the ISB Supervisor for the Morlana sector. Meero seeks Karn's assistance in filling gaps about the Ferrix Incident. Meero tells Karn that she has found out that he has filed six false requests to the Bureau of Standards' Data Center for information suggesting that Andor worked in the fuel refinery industry.

Meero asks Karn what he is doing. Karn explains that he has been using the tools and resources available to search for Andor, whom he regards as a murderer and threat to public order. Meero tells Karn that he has engaged the curiosity of the ISB and asks what he is up to. Karn explains that he is trying to clear his name following the events on Ferrix. When Meero asks about any omissions in Lieutenant Blevin's report, Karn explains that he was not allowed to read the report despite signing it. Regarding Karn as an asset, Meero exits the room and instructs her staffers to hand Blevin's report over to Karn.

The Imperial prison transport descends into the atmosphere of Narkina 5, which is covered in ocean. Peering through the viewports, Andor sees several large maritime ships. Back on Coruscant, Meero delivers her full report on the stolen Imperial N-S9 Starpath Unit that was recovered on Ferrix to several high-ranking ISB officials including Colonel Wulff Yularen and Major Partagaz. Meero argues that the thefts of Imperial technology is occurring on a galactic scale. Meero also briefs the audience about Andor, informing them that he murdered two corporate security personnel.

Meero believes that Andor was in the act of transferring the Starpath unit to a person code-named as "Axis", whom she thinks is central to an organized rebel effort to acquire specialized Imperial gear. Yularen goes through a list of items that Meero requests for her investigation including a full planetary comnet, full garrison tech package, Series Nine Spectrum surveillance, local agent funding, and a Code Droid. Yularen thinks this is an expensive investment but Meero counters that it is a fraction of the price of the lost technology.

Besides apprehending Andor, Meero plans to capture "Axis" next. Partagaz backs up Meero, saying that "Axis" has been nimble in spreading his activities his activities around the galaxy. They are unaware of the scope of his activities. Meero describes the events on Ferrix as "Axis"'s first mistake. Meero plans to search for Andor on Ferrix as part of wider hunt.

On Narkina 5, Imperial corrections officers order Andor and the other prisoners to disembark. The warden informs the prisoners that they have been assigned to an Imperial factory due to their labor abilities. He informs the prisoners will be assigned to their duties and shifts. The warden then tells the prisoners that they maintain control over the prisoners by incapacitating them with a painful sonic disruptor. The warden explains that this was merely the first level of the sonic disruption and that the floors are made of tungsten alloy.

Back on Coruscant, Karn has finished reading Lieutenant Blevin's report. He informs Meero of several omissions including criminal negligence by his commanding officer Chief Inspector Hyne, a total lack of Imperial authority on Ferrix, and the fact that Andor was assisted by local accomplices. Meero also questions Karn about the description of Andor's accomplice, whom he describes as a tall, older man wearing a grey cloak and dark boots. Karn recalls that the accomplice had a distinctive voice. In return for Karn not filing any more requests for information, Meero promises to tell the Bureau of Standards that he was of good service to the Empire today.

Before leaving, Karn emphasizes that he was a competent deputy inspector who solved a double murder and found the killer in two days. Karn offers to help her find Andor and his handler. He emphasizes that he could be a valuable asset to the Empire going forward. Meero warns him not to raise the ISB's attention and to forget this happened.

At the Narkina 5 prison, Andor, who is now dressed in a white and orange uniform, is led by his captors into the prison. Following a brief delay, Andor is led down a lift into his factory floor, which is called Unit Five-Two-D. Andor is greeted by a fellow prisoner named Kino Loy, who is the manager of the unit. Andor introduces himself as "Keef." Loy tells the prisoners that this is a twelve hour shift and assigns Andor to table five. Loy tells Andor that the prisoners are competing against each other and the other floors. Loy has 249 days left in his sentence and says that he has a free hand in running this floor. He emphasizes that he wants to maintain a high level of productivity and tells Andor to come to him if he has problems with the other inmates or is sick.

At Table Five, "Keef" meets his fellow inmates including Jemboc, Xaul, Taga, Ulaf, Ham, and Ruesscott Melshi. The prisoners are short on one man. Since the floor's productive level has been deemed unsatisfactory, Loy orders the other prisoners to rush production with the slowest table

being punished. The prisoners accelerate work on their machinery.

Elsewhere, Senator Mon Mothma has drinks with her husband Perrin Fertha but admits she is only putting up a show. She tells her husband that she is planning to muster votes to oppose the new Imperial legislation. The couple are joined by Tay Kolma. Fertha explains that Mothma is trying to promote the message that she is saving the Empire from the Emperor. Mothma briefly mentions Perrin's days as a cadet. Tay says that the Empire's new legislation is having a chilling effect. After Perrin leaves, Tay warns that the Empire's new banking regulations are hampering their operations.

Mothma and Tay are joined by Leida Mothma, who notices that Tay is around. Mothma distracts Leida by telling her that her father is looking for her. Mothma speaks with a purple-robed senator who has come to talk about her efforts to muster votes. On Narkina 5, Andor and the other prisoners queue up. Kino Loy tells the other prisoners to keep it down. A dark-skinned human begins gesticulating to another prisoner on a bridge.

Back on Coruscant, Mothma and her allied senators discuss Emperor Palpatine's new laws including the Public Order Resentencing Directive. A bearded senator expresses concern about the dangers of Palpatine's unlimited new security powers. A female senator says they are living in dangerous times while another male senator makes remarks about Chandrilan hospitality. On Narkina 5, the inmates Xaul and Jemboc briefs Andor about how his electronically-monitored cell works. The cells are equipped with refreshers while food is fed through tubes. The cells are spotless white.

Jemboc asks Andor what he did to end up in prison. Andor is evasive. Jemboc reveals that the Imperial authorities doubled everyone's sentences following the events on Aldhani. Taga talks about the Public Order Sentencing Directive. Andor feigns ignorance of the events on Aldhani. The other prisoners claim that the rebels slaughtered an entire garrison but other dispute that claim. Another prisoner tries to tell Andor to ignore the numbers but Kino asserts his authority and threatens the other inmate. The intercom system orders the prisoners to go to their cells. Andor is the last to comply and enters his cell before the floors begin flashing red.

At the Coruscant banquet, Perrin asks Mon Mothma to consider how often they spend their time admiring the view. After some flattery, Mothma tells her guests that she and Perrin came as teenagers when she became a senator at the age of 16 years. Per Chandrila custom, they were married at a young age. Mothma asks about Tay and Perrin says he left early for a function in the morning.

Over the course of 30 shifts, Andor adjusts to life in his automated prison cell which comes with food dispensers and a retractable toothbrush. The prisoners also undergo an automated shower before being given fresh clothes. They then work together on assembly mechanical components. When Andor slows down, Kino tells him to hurry up.

On Ferrix, Bix Caleen and Brasso tend to the ill Maarva Andor, who fell while observing the former hotel, which the Empire has reappropriated as their headquarters. B2EMO is also present at the Andor residence. Despite her old age and missing her adoptive son Cassian Andor, Maarva is still a rebel at heart. Meanwhile, Vel Sartha and Cinta Kaz have a reunion. Cinta reaffirms her commitment to the Rebellion as well as her love for Vel. They watch Bix and Brasso opposite the street.

Bix visits Salman Paak at his repair business Repaak Salyard. Losing the hotel has made it hard for the local rebels to conduct their business. She tells Paak that she needs to look for something at the back. Paak tries to discourage her but she says it is urgent. Bix climbs up a ladder and activates a radio transmitter. Hard decisions

On Coruscant, Kleya Marki receives a message from Caleen, who is trying to find Andor because his mother is ill. Kleya informs Luthen Rael and opines that they should not respond in order to avoid endangering their operations. Rael disagrees and says that their contact on Ferrix can help show them the right direction. Rael responds that Bix knows so much more than they do and that she might have a lead. Kleya thinks that the ISB may have taken over her radio. Kleya wants to shut down all contact with Ferrix but Luthen is unwilling to abandon him.

Rael also asks where Vel and Cinta have reached Ferrix. He tells Kleya that the woman's named is Bix and says that Vel can check whether the situation on Ferrix is safe. Rael emphasizes that he is not slipping but is coming out of hiding. Kleya disagrees and warns about the danger of exposing themselves to vulnerability. Rael reluctantly orders that the transmission be shut down. Back on Ferrix, Bix reacts with frustration and despair as the radio line is shut down.

Later, Rael flies his Fondor Haulcraft into space. He tells the ship's computer to coordinate alternatives for Segra Milo. The ship computer identifies four routes and Rael opts to take the longest route. Trouble on different fronts

At the Narkina 5 Imperial factory facility, a prisoner named Veemoss commits suicide by jumping out of his cell onto the electrified floor. The other prisoners grumble about the loss of a colleague and several show little sympathy for the deceased man. Kino orders the prisoners to calm down before the announcer orders the prisoners to return to their sleeping platform.

On Ferrix, Bix watches a crowd gathering outside Repaak Salyard. Imperial officers have arrested Salman Paak after summoning him to the reappropriated hotel. His son Wilmon Paak is visibly outraged and is restrained by an Imperial officer. The lead Imperial officer Captain Vanis Tigo orders stormtroopers to disperse the crowd. Tigo recognizes Bix Caleen but she flees at the urging of Brasso, who is detained by Imperial personnel. Bix runs through the narrow and winding streets of Ferrix.

Meanwhile, Rael lands his Fondor Haulcraft at a Partisan base on Segra Milo, which is guarded by Benthic. Luthen asks Saw Gerrera if he was involved in the Aldhani Heist but he neither confirms nor denies that he was involved. Getting down to business, Luthen offers to trade several pieces of stolen Imperial technology including a full set of Imperial drive adapters and three sealed Steergard targeting deflectors. After Rael confirms that he has the items with him, Gerrera asks Rael to set his price.

Rael tells Gerrera that he wants him to meet Anto Kreegyr, a contact who has been probing the Imperial power station at Spellhaus. Rael says that Kreegyr has found some weaknesses in the defense but that he has an angle. Gerrera is dismissive of Kreegyr's capabilities but Rael insists that Gerrera hear out Kreegyr's plan. Unwilling to work with Kreegyr, Gerrera offers to buy the three targeting deflectors but Rael states that they come on the condition that he works with Kreegyr. If he doesn't, Rael warns that he will go to someone else.

When Gerrera insists on working alone, Rael tells him that has got to change. Gerrera is unwilling to risk his people for someone else. Rael tells Saw that they need to work together to bring down the Empire, saying that oppression leads to rebellion. Gerrera insists that he is not a mercenary but Rael asks him to imagine Spellhaus in flames. Gerrera labels Kreegyr a Separatist and Maya Pei as a neo-Republican. Gerrera reminds Rael of the various rebels factions that lost including the Partisan Alliance, Sectorists, Human cultists, and Galaxy Partitionists.

He asks Luthen what he is. Rael responds that he is a coward and a man who is terrified that the Empire's power will grow beyond their means to stop it. Rael says that they need to put aside their differences. Gerrera counters by claiming that he is the only one with clarity of purpose. Rael laughs and says that anarchy is a seductive concept for a man hiding in cold caves and begging for spare parts. Gerrera laughs and refuses to buy parts from Rael, telling him to find someone else to help Kreegyr.

On Ferrix, Bix is captured by Imperial officers and led away in handcuffs. At the repurposed hotel, Captain Tigo informs Lieutenant Meero that Bix is on her way up and asks if they should remove the battered Paak, who is bound to a chair. Meero says that she wants Bix to see Paak. After Bix sees Paak, Meero permits the stormtroopers and Tigo to remove Paak from the room. Meero introduces herself to Bix before a burly Imperial guard ushers her towards the chair. Elsewhere on Narkina 5, Andor and his fellow prisoners continue assembling machinery.

Summary: Under intense scrutiny while imprisoned, Cassian makes allies plan an impossible escape.



Lieutenant Dedra Meero interrogates Bix Caleen, telling her that she doesn't like wasting time. She disagrees with her Imperial Security Bureau (ISB) colleagues' investigation practices, likening it to trawling for fish. Meero instead proposes telling Bix the facts of the case while she fills in the rest. If she fails to cooperate, Meero threatens to hand Caleen to Dr. Gorst, who has a more ruthless method of questioning.

Meero tells Caleen that they tracked Salman Paak to a radio hidden in his repair yard. Meero said that they had hope to secure Paak's cooperation but that he proved unusually resistant, leading to a longer interrogation session. Meero opines that Paak's resistance was futile. Based on the information from Paak's interrogation, they learnt that he attended a separatist meeting two years ago in Jondora where he met a woman who recruited him as a liaison for Ferrix when he returned. Meero explains that Paak was sent the fractal radio unit that she used yesterday afternoon.

Meero remarks that the mysterious woman was interested in using Ferrix to acquire stolen Imperial technology and equipment. Paak was paid to keep the radio alive. She informs Bix that

she was the only one to use and that the buyer met Paak once before being turned over to her. Meero asks Bix if she is motivated by money since she is business owner with no recorded history of trouble-making. Meero gives Bix a second chance to cooperate.

Bix asks Meero if she is ISB, describing her as the "worst of the worst." Meero says that she wants to know everything that Bix knows about the buyer as well as Cassian Jeron Andor and their relationship. Bix says that Andor doesn't have a relationship with the buyer. Meero also seeks information on every piece of stolen Imperial equipment that Bix passed along including origins, customers, and destination. When Bix claims that she doesn't know who the buyer is, Meero counters that Paak told her that she had at least six meetings with the buyer.

Meero says that Bix also sits on the radio for hours, prompting Bix to admit that she contacts the customer. Meero tells Bix that the customer and Andor have blown up buildings and killed security guards. Meero recalls that Bix was injured while trying to warn them and that her co-worker Timm Karlo was killed trying to free her from the Preox-Morlana security forces. Andor and the buyer escaped together, leading Meero to surmise that this was a "mess of relationships." Bix refuses to answer whether she had anymore contact with Andor. When Meero taunts Bix about boring her, Bix counters that she won't believe her. With Bix uncooperative, she allows Dr Gorst and his men to interrogate her.

At the Narkina 5 Imperial Prison Complex, Andor and the prisoners work on assembling various pieces of machinery. Andor and his colleagues discuss the arrival of a new prisoner, the long shifts, and food. One of the prisoners Ulaf has an injured hand and needs some help. Andor volunteers to swap shifts with Ulaf. When Kino Loy inspects their table, he compliments Andor for swapping shifts with Ulaf and asks if it was his idea. Andor credits Taga with coming with the idea. Jemboc praises Andor for his wise move and says that Ulaf will be going home.

Later, Andor goes on break and heads to the refresher. There, he attempts to cut a pipe. However, the intercom announces that a new man has arrived on the floor. Andor joins the other prisoners in holding their hands as the guards force a new prisoner into their factory floor, stinging him with stun batons when he refuses to cooperate. As he is lowered down a lift, Andor and Birnok discuss their escape plan. Andor proposes attacking the guards and stealing their weapon while the lift is on Unit Five-Two-D's floor. Loy welcomes the new prisoner, briefing him about the inner workings of their factory floor.

Meanwhile, Andor and his fellow prisoners continue working on a machine. Jemboc tells them that they are up a rack and have an hour left. Ulaf is determined to press on for the sake of the team. Later, Andor and his fellow prisoners queue up. The queue is taking unexpectedly long, causing some grumbling among the prisoners. Loy tries to calm them down. Birnok begins signalling by hand to a prisoner in Level Two. Loy quietens the men just as the lights go out briefly. He explains that the prison guards cut the power after someone did not load in properly. The alarms begin blaring and Birnok tells them that something is wrong on Level Two. Loy dismisses the prisoners for trying to communicate just as the intercom orders all prisoners to proceed to their stations.

While the prisoners are resting in their cells, Andor asks the new prisoner if he ever thinks about escaping. Loy responds that he will not answer that. He warns Andor against attempting to escape and ignores his question about the number of guards on the floor. He tells Andor that the best way to survive is not to think of escaping. Loy tells Andor that he has 217 shifts left and refuses to share his knowledge about the prison's secrets. Andor says that the guards don't care about them and likens their predicament to being worse than droids. Loy goes to sleep while Andor continues his questioning. The new prisoner watches in silence. Andor cries out in frustration that nobody is listening.

Back at Narkina 5, the prisoners discuss news that 100 men spread across two shifts on Level 2 were electrocuted to death. Kino Loy asks where they heard the news. The prisoners turn to a dark-skinned prisoner who says that Zinska heard they were making trouble. Over the intercom, the prison authorities order the prisoners to put their hands over their heads. Ulaf asked what happened on Level 2. When the new prisoner claims that Zinska freed them, Loy assaults him. Andor tells Loy that they need to be careful and to make the guards think that they know less about the prison than they actually know. Loy asserts control over the other prisoners and dismisses the deaths on Level 2 as a rumor. He tells them to work as normal until they know what is going on.

Later, Andor and his fellow prisoners including Ulaf work on assembling a piece of machinery.

Ulaf is visible exhausted and struggles to keep up with his colleagues.

Back on Ferrix, Dr Gorst tells Bix that the restraints are not to be feared and that it is safer for her to be tethered. While preparing his tools, Gorst tells Bix about an Outer Rim moon called Dizon Fray, which was home to a sentient species who were exterminated for opposing a local Imperial airfield. Dr Gorst emphasizes that the massacre of the Dizonites was broadcast as proof of mission. He says that the aliens make a choral, agonized sound when they die; which he describes as something unique. He recalls that three communications officers who were monitoring the broadcast were emotionally traumatized by the recordings.

Dr Gorst explains that the Imperials have modified the recordings, taking an interest in the recordings of children which he describes as having a particular effect. Dr Gorst places an electronic headset on Bix's head. He tells her that he can make the sonic torture end when she is willing to cooperate. Meeko warns Bix to be willing to cooperate since repeat listenings can cause the most damage. Dr Gorst forces Bix to wear the headset. Bix attempts to remain strong but soon finds herself screaming in torment.

Following a session with the torture headset, Meero asks Bix when was the last time she spoke with Andor. Meero touches her face. Later, Meero tells Captain Vanis Tigo to keep Bix alive since she is the only one who can identify the enigmatic "Axis". They agree to hang Salman Paak as a reminder to the locals of Imperial authority. An exhausted and battered Bix rests in her cell.

At the Imperial Senate, Senator Mon Mothma voices opposition to the Emperor's new public safety legislation. An opponent shouts long live to the Galactic Empire. Mothma describes the Public Order Resentencing Directive as governmental overreach and part of a march to authoritarianism. Supporters and opponents of the bill exchange insults. Mothma reminds her fellow senators of their duty to the people and the need to preserve the independence of the Senate. As the heckling continues, Mothma appeals to the senators to come with open minds rather than treating the Senate as a temple. Later, Mothma's driver Kloris informs her that her cousin has arrived from Chandrila and is at the Chandrilan Embassy.

Back at the Chandrilan Embassy, Mothma and her daughter Leida Mothma meet with Mothma's cousin Vel Sartha, who has brought Leida a new golden dress from Tassio Moon. After briefly speaking with Leida about her fashion tastes, Mothma asks Vel where she has been. Vel tells Mothma that she has been travelling for the past six months and hints at her work for the Rebellion. Mothma asks Vel if she will be returning home to Chandrila since their relatives are worried about her whereabouts.

Mothma asks Vel about her work with Luthen Rael but she is evasive. She tells Mothma that things are happening. While it is risky, she is devoted to the rebel cause. Mothma wants to ask more questions but Vel reminds her of their vow. Leida shows her new golden dress to Mothma and Vel.

Later, Perrin Fertha asks Vel if she is returning to Chandrila today. Vel claims that she is heading back for The Pilgrimage. When Perrin asks if Vel will find a husband, Vel says it is not on her list of priorities. Perrin quips about Vel being past the ideal age of marriage. He then mentions that there is a large Chandrilan diaspora on Coruscant and suggests Tay Kolma, whom he describes as Mothma's former school boyfriend.

In private, Mothma advises Vel to pretend to be a spoiled rich girl in order to hide her rebel activities. Vel says that she will try and reminds Mothma that they have chosen a side and are fighting against darkness. The two cousins hug each other. Shortly later, the driver arrives and ushers Vel to the airspeeder while carrying her luggage bags. Mothma stands silently in the hallway of her home.

At the ISB Central Office, Meero delivers her report to Major Partagaz about Bix Caleen's interrogation. She admits that Caleen yielded no information about the identity of the mysterious buyer "Axis." Meero states that Axis runs a large operation that is not dependent on any one network or supplier. Caleen provided them with a list of every piece of gear that came through Ferrix and she believes that they have a match to a targeting unit recovered from a safe house operated by a rebel cell associated with Maya Pei.

When Supervisor Lonni Jung remarks that Andor is involved, Meero emphasized that is what she wanted to highlight. Partagaz describes Andor as a local thief and murderer. Meero tells the other ISB officers that Andor returned to Ferrix three nights after the events on Aldhani with money in his pocket. When Captain Lagret asks if the money was derived from the theft of the Imperial N-S9 Starpath Unit, Jung recalls that they left it behind.

Partagaz is skeptical of Meero's theory that the Aldhani heist is connected to the Ambush on Ferrix. Attendant Heert recalls that Andor has shaved his beard, which matches reports that the rebels on Aldhani were clean-shaven. Two Imperial Army troopers from the Andor garrison recalled that the unshaven Andor matched their reference picture. Partagaz agrees to allow Meero to investigate the Aldhani connection further. When Partagaz asks why Meero did not interrogate Andor's mother Maarva Andor, Meero says that they could use her as bait should Andor return. She confirms that Imperial authorities are monitoring Maarva.

Elsewhere on Coruscant, Eedy Karn notices that her son Syril Karn always goes to work early and returns home later. When Eedy talks about her son's neatly groomed appearance, Syril reminds his mother that he told her not to leave dinner out for him last night. Eedy is concerned about her son's abrupt message and admits that she has been searching his room. When Syril objects to his mom going through his personal belongings, Eedy reminds him that she got him a job and cooks two meals a day.

Eedy thinks that her son is being ungrateful and accuses Syril of neglecting her while working on Preox-Morlana for several years. Syril informs his mother that he has been promoted and adds that his work hours will be increased. Eedy remarks that Uncle Harlo will be pleased. While Eedy is jubilant about her son's success, Syril resents his mother and remains silent.

In her cell on Ferrix, Bix waits in silence despondently. Meanwhile, Syril makes an unscheduled visit to the ISB Central Office on Coruscant where he congratulates Meero for her role in securing his promotion. Meero tries to minimize her role, saying that she only gave him a clean bill of health. Viewing Meero as a means of restoring his fortunes, Syril attempts to curry favor with Meero. Believing that Syril is stalking her, she warns him that further unsolicited visits could land him in trouble. Meero does not think a lot about their earlier meeting, regarding it as a routine interrogation. Syril tells Meero that he admires her for the work that she is doing. Meero is visibly uncomfortable and warns him that she can make his life difficult if he doesn't leave her alone.

Elsewhere, Tay Kolma and Mothma discuss the matter of donations for her secret rebel charity. Kolma says that the authorities are noticing suspicious transactions such as a 400,000 credits donation that mysteriously disappears off the ledger. To provide a plausible explanation, Kolma suggests masking it as a deposit. Kolma asks Mothma if she is in trouble. Kolma reassures her that she is not in trouble unless they scan the accounts but warns that time is limited. Mothma asks for a loan. Kolma advises Mothma to seek a Chandrilan banker named Davo Sculdun with treasury relationships and a business book that is huge.

Mothma points out that Sculdun is a wealthy criminal. Kolma says that they have little choice due to the tough new tax laws. Mothma is concerned that Sculdun will notice that 400,000 credits is missing. Kolma reassures her that he does not concern himself with what his customers do. Kolma tells Mothma that Sculdun wants to meet him. Mothma is reluctant to meet the criminal. Kolma offers to keep looking.

Later at her office, Attendant Heert informs Meero that Imperial authorities have apprehended a rebel pilot who was using a stolen Imperial masking unit. The prisoner is being detained aboard a Star Destroyer above Steergard. Meero tells Heert to dispatch Dr. Gorst to interrogate the prisoner. Heert says that he has already sent Gorst on his way. Meero says that she will conduct the interrogation remotely and thanks Heert for his initiative.

At the ISB Central Office, Meero and Heert brief Major Partagaz about the captured rebel pilot with the stolen Imperial masking unit. The prisoner claimed that he did not contact anyone during his escape attempt. Heert adds that the masking unit was a device stolen from the Imperial naval yard in Lozash the previous year. Supervisors Jung and Lagret enter the room. Partagaz informs them about the capture of the rebel pilot, who is part of Anto Kreegyr's group. Partagaz believes that Kreegyr is unaware of the pilot's capture and that the prisoner is telling them that Kreegyr is planning to raid the power station at Spellhaus.

When Jung learns that the pilot was heading to Kafrene, he warns that Kreegyr's group will soon realize that he is missing. Lagret proposes destroying the ship and making his disappearance look like an accident. Jung disagrees. Meero proposes "fouling" the ship, killing the pilot, and planting his dead body aboard the ship. Jung says that the rebels would have to find it and would probably tow it into Kafrene. Meero suggests staging the accident quickly and allowing the ship to drift into traffic. Partagaz agrees to Meero's plan and tells her to make it top priority. He warns her to leave no trace before scheduling a meeting with Military Intelligence to discuss the

planned raid on Spellhaus.

At the Narkina 5 factory facility, Andor pushes a trolley carrying pieces of machinery that he and his fellow prisoners have been working on. As Ulaf begins tiring, the intercom informs the inmates that the low yield tables are in position. Loy orders Table Two to take the shift by six racks and three. He orders to Table One to get in the box. During a drill, Ulaf almost collapses from exhaustion and is held up by his fellow inmates. The prisoners are subject to a debilitating audio sting.

As the prisoners return to their bunks, one of the inmates informs Loy that Ulaf needs a doctor. Andor and the others help carry the weakened Ulaf. During the journey, Ulaf collapses. Loy calls Zinska to call for a medic before telling another prisoner to get going. Loy tries to reassure Ulaf that it is only a few more shifts before he can go home. Later, a medic named Rhasiv, who is a fellow prisoner, attends to the exhausted Ulaf and applies an oxygen mask. Loy vouches for Ulaf, telling Rhasiv that he only has 40 shifts left and is as tough as a screw.

After examining Ulaf, Rhasiv realizes that Ulaf has suffered a massive stroke. Lacking the resources to treat him, Rhasiv calls the guard for a bag and a trolley. Rhasiv instructs Loy and Andor to hold Ulaf's shoulders and legs while he administers drugs that will euthanize Ulaf. Rhasiv is evasive about the events at Level Two and tells Loy to keep his men in line. Ulaf passes away. When Loy asks about the events on Level Two again, Rhasiv reminds the guard to bring a bag and trolley. After the guard leaves, Rhasiv tells Loy that a man who was just released on Level Four ended up back on Level Two the following day. When word got out, they killed them all.

Andor and Loy realize that nobody will be leaving the prison before a guard orders them to leave the corridor. As they exit, Loy tells Andor that there are no more than twelve guards on each level.

Summary: A rare opportunity opens and the time for Cassian and his fellow inmates to act is now.



At Narkina 5 Imperial Prison Complex, the medic removes the corpse of Ulaf under the supervision of an armed guard. The other prisoners watch with their hands raised. Later, Cassian Jeron Andor tells Kino Loy that they have to escape tomorrow. He says that the guards know that they are outnumbered and killed a hundred men. Cassian points out that the 5,000 men are doomed never to leave. He reasons that whatever they are working on is important to the Galactic Empire.

Kino is unwilling to commit since he is skeptical of Andor's lack of a plan. The two get into a physical tussle. Andor tells Loy that his plan is predicated on the new man coming to replace Ulaf the following day. He urges Kino to grab the opportunity before it is too late. Andor tells Loy he is ready to die in the escape attempt. As they walk through the corridor to their cells, the other men ask what happened to Ulaf and what happened on Level Two.

Andor confirms that the prison guards fried the entire Level Two after mistakenly sending back a man who had been released. Kino confirms Andor's story and tells the other prisoners that they are not releasing anyone. He tells them to return to their cells and start figuring it out.

Elsewhere, Imperial Security Bureau Supervisor Dedra Meero and her colleagues receives news that Anto Kreegyr's group have taken the bait and retrieved the dead pilot and are asking for a landing bay. Kafrene authorities claim that the pilot died as a result of a hydraulic failure after exiting hyperspace. Supervisor Lonni Jung convinces Major Partagaz that Imperial forces should not wait but should make their presence felt. Meero exits the command room.

On Ferrix, a lady informs Doctor Mullmoy that Maarva Andor has not been taking her medicines. They are being watched by Cinta Kaz who is in turn being watched by a man. At the Chandrilan Embassy, Senator Mon Mothma and Tay Kolma meet with the Chandrilan banker Davo Sculdun, who talks about his taste for architecture. Davo is acquainted with Mothma's husband Perrin Fertha. After exchanging pleasantries, they discuss Mothma's efforts to secure alternative funding arrangements for her foundation.

Davo offers to help Mothma bundle her transactions in ways that can make it hard for outsiders to detect. He agrees that the Empire's new financial regulations have made it harder for certain transactions. Davo views the situation as a game they can play. Mothma says that this is charitable foundation and asks how much he is charging. Davo offers to do it without a price but Mothma insists. He replies that a drop of discomfort is the price of doing business with him.

Davo sets his price, which is a return invitation. Mothma is amenable until Davo reveals that he wants to introduce his 14 year old son to Mothma's 13 year old daughter Leida Mothma. Mothma expresses her disapproval of the Chandrilan tradition of child betrothals. Davo replies that their social positions sometimes makes decisions for them and that they lead lives that encourage conformity. When Mothma asks if this is his only offer, Davo gives an affirmative. Mothma tells Tay to usher Davo out and claims she won't consider his offer. Davo replies that is the first untrue thing she has said before leaving.

Elsewhere, Kleya Marki informs Luthen Rael about a mark found on the fountain. She believes this was a message that "he" wants a meeting since the rail downstairs is gone. Kleya dislikes the timing and advises Rael to go to Fondor while she takes care of business on Coruscant. Rael says if has been a year since their contact has reached out to them. He is willing to take risks even if it is a trap.

The following day, Kino speaks to the prisoners and convinces them that they should escape. While walking through the sky bridge, the announcer announces over the intercom that all skybridge transfers will be on program and silent until further notice. The prisoners report to their shifts as usual.

Later, Andor and his fellow prisoners including Jemboc put their escape plans into action. Andor grabs a wrench and proceeds to cut a water pipe while Loy barks orders. The prison guards prepare another prisoner to be let down onto the factory floor. While waiting for Andor, the other prisoners arm themselves with tools. The prisoners raise their hands while the new prisoner is escorted down the lift. Alarms begin ringing due to the burst pipe.

As the floors flood due to the burst pipes, two prisoners stage a fight which soon engulfs the floor. Andor jams the lift carrying the new prisoner and his guard. The prisoners climb on the lift and take out the guard. Other prisoners hurl objects at the other guards while Andor climbs the disabled lift. A guard issues orders to spark the floor, prompting Loy to tell the prisoners to climb onto the tables. The water causes the metallic floors to short-circuit.

With the electric field disabled, Kino leads the prisoners on 5-2-D in revolt. The guards attempt to use their higher ground to hold back the prisoners but are overwhelmed. Some prisoners are killed but they succeed in storming the control room and taking out the guard posted there. The prisoners in 5-2-D begin climbing the disabled lift. The flooding spreads to other floors while Andor, Loy and the other prisoners help themselves to weapons.

Other guards receive news about the flooding and riot in 5-2-D. The revolt soon spreads to other floors with prisoners from 5-2-D encouraging the other prisoners to fight for their freedom. They fight and kill the guards they encounter. The announcer issues orders to activate the sonic countdown and to isolate Level 5. Kino Loy forces his way into the Level Eight command center and demands the announcer stop the countdown. When he refuses, he shoots a correction officer, prompting a third to say he will comply.

Andor also tells the guard to deactivate the hydro generators. The guard claims the announcer

has access to the hydro generators. Loy forces the announcer at gunpoint to deactivate the hydro generators, shutting down power across the prison. When the backup power supply activates, Andor forces the two guards out of the console at gunpoint.

Andor tells a reluctant Kino to address the other prisoners. Kino tells the prisoners that they have deactivated every floor on the facility and urges them to escape. He says that the guards are outnumbered and to take their chance to escape even if it means death. Loys tells the prisoners that they fried a hundred men on Level 2 and reveals that the prisoners are not being released after serving their sentences but are being transferred to other prisons. He tells the prisoners to run, climb, and kill in order to escape the prison. Andor and Kino then leave the Level Eight command center, sparing the two surviving guards.

The prisoners charge through the sky bridges and stairs. The remaining guards hide in a bunker in fear. Reaching the top of the prison complex, the prisoners jump into the sea. Loy reveals that he cannot swim while Andor and the other prisoners take the plunge. Later that night, Andor and Melshi run on a beach under the cover of night. Three moons shine in the night sky.

Elsewhere, a disguised Lonni Jung walks through a crowd on Coruscant, brushing past a Gotal and a Quarren. He walks through a series of tunnel and enters a turbolift where he retrieves an earpiece. Luthen instructs him to press the buttons for 215 in the event of a trap. As the lift descends, Rael congratulates him that his daughter is healthy and beautiful, and that he must be pleased. Jung is uncomfortable that Luthen has been spying on him and his family.

Jung warns Luthen of a new rising supervisor named Dedra Meero, who is investigating a rebel figure called "Axis" whom she believes is building a rebel network. Meero is looking at stolen Imperial naval equipment in order to find a link to Aldhani. He tells Luthen that Meero is interested in the Ferrix Incident and has been tearing the place apart. He adds that they are searching for the thief and the "middle man."

Luthen tells Jung to encourage Meero since she is "wasting" time. Jung asks if Luthen had anything to do with the events on Aldhani but he is evasive. Luthen asks Jung why he is here. Jung explains that Meero captured a rebel pilot running supplies for Kreegyr. He explains that they turned him immediately and staged an accident. The Empire is also aware of Kreegyr's plans to raid the power station on Spellhaus. Luthen is willing to sacrifice the lives of Kreegyr and his 50 men to mislead the ISB into thinking that there is no leak in security. Luthen emphasizes that he is doing Jung a favor.

The lift door opens and Jung is created by Luthen, who asks why they are really here. Jung tells Rael that he can't continue being a double agent since he is a father now. Luthen reminds him that they took a vow. Jung offers to trade Meero, Spellhaus, and Ferrix to Rael. He says he has been working his way up the ranks of the ISB for six years but can't do it anymore. Luthen asks Jung if he is planning to betray him to the ISB. Jung mentions his health and his wife's import business. Luthen is unwilling to let Jung go since the rebels have invested a lot in him. He tells Jung that he is trapped.

When Jung asks if his sacrificed means nothing to Rael, Luthen responds that his investment in the Rebellion is epic due to having to lead a double life. He describes Jung as a hero that the Rebellion needs. Jung asks Luthen what he sacrifices. Rael replies calm, kindness, kinship, and love. Having given up peace, Rael says that he is condemned to use the tools of his enemy to defeat them. Luthen tells Jung he has sacrificed everything and implores Jung to continue his work.

Summary: A fugitive once more, Cassian must make his next move before it is too late.



On Narkina 5, Cassian Jeron Andor and fellow escaped prisoner Ruescott Melshi have climbed high up a cliff and are struggling to keep their grip while hiding from a TIE reaper patrol, waiting for it to leave. Elsewhere on Ferrix, Andor's adoptive mother Maarva Andor has passed away. Brasso speaks with a despondent B2EMO, who is grieving his master's death. The droid watches as Brasso, JeZZi, and others carry her wrapped remains outside. Cinta Kaz is among the townspeople observing the

procession while Imperial Security Bureau (ISB) Attendant Corv, disguised as a civilian, watches at a distance from inside the bar.

With the Imperial craft gone, Andor and Melshi have scaled the cliff and spot a quadjumper parked next to a nearby lake. The fugitives also notice the vehicle's owners, a pair of fishers, talking amongst themselves in Narkinian. They attempt to steal the ship but are caught when they trigger a net trap. Meanwhile, Captain Vanis Tigo informs Supervisor Dedra Meero about Maarva's death and local plans to hold a funeral procession as she was a prominent local figure. Meero commands the local Imperial officers to provide the locals a permit for the event. Corv tells Meero that the funeral will occur in two days time, explaining that this is the time it takes to perform the Ferrix custom of cremating the deceased's ashes and storing it as a brick.

Back on Narkina 5, the escapees' new captors, Dewi Pamular and Freedi Pamular, toy with the prospect of collecting a thousand credits bounty on each of them. Dewi, a Keredian, speaks to the men in Basic, lamenting how the Empire's prisons have ruined their planet's water, killed the squiggles, and made food scarcer. Andor and Melshi retort that they are not to blame. Speaking Narkinian, Freedi expresses interest in the bounty on the prisoners. Dewi has a change of heart and releases the two humans from the nets, deciding to aid them in their quest for freedom. The Keredian asks where they are proposing to run; Andor says Niamos. All four depart the planet on the aliens' quadjumper.

Meanwhile on Coruscant, Vel Sartha visits Luthen Rael's Galactic Antiquities and Objects of Interest. Kleya Marki is unhappy that Vel has broken protocol and refuses to divulge Rael's

whereabouts. Vel replies that she will be leaving Coruscant tomorrow. Vel tells Kleya that she has come to bring news about Maarva's death and funeral preparations. Kleya agrees to let Luthen know.

On Ferrix, Cinta and ISB Attendant Corv observe Brasso walking with B2EMO. Corv tells his contacts over the comlink that he wants information on the "big target"'s whereabouts. Back at the Andor family home, Brasso and B2EMO discuss attending Maarva's funeral service. Brasso insists that the droid come along since he is part of the family.

Meanwhile, Bix Caleen reflects on her interrogation and torture at the hands of Dr Gorst. Keysax escorts her out of her cell into an interrogation chamber with Attendant Corv and Prefect Vanis Tigo. Corv asks her if Anto Kreegyr was the man who introduced her to Cassian Andor. He warns that if she doesn't cooperate he will bring Dr Gorst again. Bix remains silent but struggles to hide her emotions.

At the Chandrilan Embassy on Coruscant, Mothma and Vel watch Leida Mothma participating in a courtship ritual which involves chanting a vow. There are several Chandrilan girls dressed in blue and an elder. Mothma tells Vel that Leida is supportive of the custom, which Vel considers archaic and is doing it with the approval of her husband Perrin Fertha. Mothma explains that Leida was the one who found the elder.

Later that night, Mothma tells Vel about her plans to channel funds to Luthen by setting up multiple accounts. Mothma explains that a Chandrilan banker Tay Kolma warned her a few months earlier that the Empire would be scrutinising Chandrilan accounts. She transferred the money into the main account. However, there was one empty ledger at the end of the line that was off balance. She says that it was so obscure that she didn't know what to do so she sought help from Luthen Rael.

Vel asks Mothma if she trusts Tay Kolma. Following the Mission on Aldhani, Mothma explains that all the funds were frozen. She thought Tay could help her fill the missing funds but that he discovered she was in much more trouble. When questioned by Vel, Mothma admits that 400,000 credits is missing. Mothma fears that the Imperial authorities will be investigating soon and admits that Luthen is unaware of the full situation. Vel and Mothma agree that the financial hole cannot be exposed. Mothma tells Vel that she has found a solution. They are joined by Leida, who has finished the courtship ritual. Leida is surprised and delighted to see her aunt here and the two embrace.

Elsewhere on a Coruscant, Syril Karn chats with his former Preox-Morlana colleague Sergeant Linus Mosk via video conference. Karn's mother Eedy Karn is watching in the background. Mosk is on duty on Morlana One and brings news that Andor's mother Maarva has passed away. He thinks Andor might show up at the funeral. Karn wants more information but the transmission terminates. Eedy makes a snide remark about her son's former triumph being vanquished.

Meanwhile Niamos, Andor retrieves a case containing a blaster and Nemik's manifesto from a hotel room while an alien sleeps. Elsewhere on Segra Milo, Luthen Rael approaches Saw Gerrera's Segra Milo Partisan base. Two Tubes orders the sentries to search him. Rael insists on bringing his blaster. He finds Gerrera telling Anto Kreegyr's group that he will be supporting the raid on Spellhaus on his own terms. Rael warns Gerrera that the ISB knows Kreegyr's plan and not to join in the raid.

When Gerrera asks Rael about his source, he refuses to divulge. Gerrera realizes that Kreegyr is unaware of the trap and asks Rael how he knows he won't tell him. Gerrera is shocked that Rael is willing to sacrifice Kreegyr. He asks if Rael is working for the ISB or if he is protecting someone on the inside. Rael is evasive and says he is a good listener. Rael admits he is willing to sacrifice Kreegyr, which prompts Gerrera to ask if he can trust him. Rael says his contact with Kreegyr is minimal and limited to passing supplies.

Rael tells Gerrera that he can make the decision to warn Kreegyr. He warns that warning Kreegyr will mean throwing away a source they have spent years cultivating. Saw says Kreegyr has people everywhere and asks if he spies within the ISB of his Partisans. Rael tells Gerrera to consider his choices but Gerrera demands to know who the spy is. Rael claims that the spy is Tubes, who protests his innocence. Tubes charges at Rael and Gerrera but Rael grabs his blaster and points it at Gerrera.

Tunes backs away and Gerrera demands to know what game Rael is playing. Rael tells Gerrera to sacrifice Kreegyr in order to mislead the ISB into thinking that they are invincible. This will give the rebels a clear playing field. Warning Kreegyr will lead the ISB to be more vigilant about

spies within their ranks. Rael says that if he were working for the ISB he would have allowed Gerraera to walk into a trap. Gerraera reluctantly agrees to sacrifice Kreegyr for the war.

On Coruscant, Karn unlocks the safe and retrieves something. Later, Rael updates Kleya about his successful sale with Gerraera. Kleya advises him to come home and tells him that they are involved in intricate negotiations about the sale of a valuable object. She believes his presence will aid their negotiations. Rael says that they need their piece and without it they would have to close the shop. Kleya replies that it is a crowded market, promoting Rael to warn her about the consequences of losing that piece to another collector. Kleya replies she is preparing for every outcome.

However, Rael terminates the transmission due to an approaching Imperial ship from the Segra Milo Imperial patrol. They ask Rael's Fondor Haulcraft for identification. The ship's droid transmits an Alderaanian transponder ID and identifies the pursuing ship as a Cantwell-class Arrestor Cruiser. The Imperial captain Elk orders his ship's tractor beam projector to haul Rael's haulcraft. He also orders his crew to prepare a boarding party. Rael gets the Fondor droid to prepare the ship's engines for escape.

After he breaks away, Rael gets the Fondor Droid to fire the ship's countermeasures, which consists of projectiles that damage the main disc of the Imperial cruiser. The captain is shocked while a naval crew reports that the tractor beam is failing. The captain dispatches a flight of TIE fighters and a TIE Boarding Craft after Rael's haulcraft. Rael destroys two fighters with laser cannons before destroying the two remaining ones with a laser ray. The Fondor droid completes the hyperspace calculation and jumps into hyperspace, leaving the Imperials behind.

On Ferrix, Andor contacts Xanwan and tells him to tell Maarva that she is okay. Xanwan tells Andor that his mother is dead. Andor is devastated by the news and stands in silence at the transmitter on the resort world. He speaks with Melshi but claims everything is okay. Melshi asks how many of them made it out alive and is determined to tell their story. He proposes that they split up in order to improve their chances of survival. Andor passes Melshi a blaster before shaking hands and patting him on the shoulder. Andor watches the ocean waves and the setting sun in sadness.

Summary: Cassian returns home to Ferrix, a tinderbox that is experiencing a spark of rebellion.



The episode opens with Wilmon Paak working on a machine at his late father Salman Paak's Repaak Salyard. Elsewhere, Imperial Security Bureau (ISB) Supervisor Dedra Meero lands at Ferrix's spaceport in a Lambda-class shuttle with two Death troopers. Stormtroopers guard the spaceport and Caleen Salyard. Meanwhile Bix Caleen waits anxiously inside her cell.

Meero is greeted by Captain Vanis Tigo, who says dinner is ready. Meero instead decides to walk the streets with

Corv as her escort. Wilmon continues working on a machine. Meanwhile, one of Brasso's colleagues informs him that Cassian Jeron Andor has returned to Ferrix to attend his mother Maarva Andor's funeral. Brasso tells him to keep this news secret and find steam to no one.

A disguised Meero and Corv walk through the streets of Ferrix while Wilmon assembles a machine. He looks to a hologram of his late father Salman. Elsewhere, Nurchi speaks with Xanwan about the impact of Maarva's death on Andor. The two agree not to discuss their conversation with anyone else.

Meanwhile on Coruscant, Mon Mothma confronts her husband Perrin Fertha about his gambling in their airspeeder. Mothma tells the driver Kloris to give them privacy. Mothma tells Perrin

to take his gambling offworld to Canto Bight. Perrin gets angry and denies he has a gambling problem. Perrin thinks that people are trying to get Mothma down by coming after him. Perrin hints that whoever is behind revelations of his gambling activities is aware of her covert activities. He asks where he would get the money. Mothma responds that concerns her the most. Perrin says someone is lying to her, which Mothma agrees. Kloris listens intently to their conversation.

Back on Ferrix, Vel Sartha meets with Cinta Kaz. Cinta tells Vel that they are being watched by an ISB operative and that Meero has arrived. Cinta thinks they are getting ready to trap Andor. Vel is aware of the situation and says they need to get there first. Vel tells Cinta to come away from the window. Andor roams the streets of Ferrix and touches an inscription. He reflects upon his late adoptive father Clem Andor's words "that that man who sees everything is more blessed than cursed."

Andor experiences a flashback of his father teaching him how to wash and recycle used machines as a means of saving money. Andor climbs into Bix's scrapyards and is confronted by a pair of canine creatures. He is discovered by the custodian who turns out to be his old friend Pegla. Pegla reveals that Bix was captured by the Empire.

While Bix waits in her cell, Andor and Stellan Gios separately reflects on the late Karis Nemik's manifesto about freedom being a source of strength when the struggle seems impossible. Nemik talks about countless cells engaging in acts of resistance across the galaxy without realizing that they have enlisted in the cause. He talks about diverse rebel cells being part of a galactic struggle. The Imperial need for control is unnatural since tyranny requires constant effort. Authority is brittle and oppression is the mask of fear. He talks about the small skirmishes and battles swelling into a bigger tide that will overwhelm the Galactic Empire. One single thing will break the siege.

Meanwhile, Tigo informs Meero that Imperial forces have pulled back their air traffic and uniform patrols and relaxed curfew. Tigo says that the trap is ready. When Meero asks when is the funeral, Tigo says that the Empire has delayed the funeral for two hours after lunch. After negotiations with the Daughters of Ferrix, they assigned half of Rix Road for the funeral and allowed a maximum of forty people to attend.

Another Imperial officer explains to Meero that the Daughters of Ferrix are a social club and that Maarva served as a president. Keysax dismisses them as a nonsense and says that they will have snipers and local containment units stationed nearby. Meero rules out the use of snipers since she wants Andor to be taken alive. Vel walks past an Imperial speeder manned by an Imperial Army trooper carrying two stormtrooper snipers.

Elsewhere, ISB officers Blevin and Kloris discuss an audio recording of Mothma and Perrin's conversation about the latter's gambling problems. Blevin thinks that they can exploit Perrin's gambling problems as a leverage against Mothma while Kloris thinks that Perrin has gambled before. Blevin also discusses Mothma's recent financial transactions. Lagret informs his comrades that they are missing news of the successful operation against Anto Kreegyr. Blevin leaves to join the briefing but Kloris stays behind.

Major Partagaz proudly announces to the assembled ISB officers that Kreegyr's entire team was killed and that they can close the case. The sole dissenter is Meero who speaks via comlink since she is offworld. Partagaz justifies the decision to take no prisoners by saying that the elimination of Kreegyr's cell was intended to please the Emperor following the Aldhani heist.

Elsewhere, Luthen exits his Fondor Haulcraft and rides a speeder bike on the rocky surface of Ferrix. Meanwhile, Corv realizes that the man whom he has been following is not Andor. Pegla arranges for Andor to meet with Brasso in an underground tunnel. Andor regrets leaving Bix. Brasso passes a message from Bix. Bix says that Andor is not at fault and describes him as the first spark in the fire. Bix also describes Andor as an unstoppable force for good. Brasso also tells Andor that Bix loves him despite his faults.

Elsewhere, Pegla keeps watch for Andor. He tells Andor that the street is clear while Brasso tells Andor that Bix is being held in the hotel. He thinks the Empire is keeping her alive for a reason. Andor is determined to rescue her. Brasso says that he will take care of the funeral while Andor rescues Bix. Meanwhile, a disguised Cyril Karn and Linus Mosk travel on hoverbus towards the Ferrix business center.

Andor climbs out of his hiding place while stormtroopers march through the streets. Vel also meets with Luthen and discusses Meero. Luthen briefs Vel about their plans to assassinate Andor and tells her to get in touch with Cinta, who is watching the Andor household. The "Time

Grappler" bangs a block to signify the beginning of Maarva's funeral. Musicians begin playing their instruments as the Daughters of Ferrix prepare for the funeral. Meero asks what is going on.

While Luthen roams through the streets, Karn and Mosk also travel in disguised through the town. Musicians lead the funeral procession through the streets of Ferrix's settlement. Wilmon also joins the procession while carrying an object in his pouch. Vel, Cinta, and Corv also slip through the crowd while an Imperial officer orders his men including Imperial Army troopers and stormtroopers to get the people off the street. Andor spots Rael while hiding in an attic. Meanwhile, Bix watches the procession from her cell.

Nurchi meets with Corv and negotiates his reward in exchange for spying. Corv agrees to smuggle him out and stages a fight to maintain Nurchi's cover. At the Ferrix hotel, Meero warns Captain Tigo that she wants Andor alive. As a large crowd of citizens gathers in Rix Road, Imperial troops arrive to confront the funeral procession. B2EMO leads the procession. With Carv and Death troopers in pursuit, Andor flees into a sewer which leads to a kitchen in the Imperial hotel.

Imperial forces watch as the funeral attendees begin chanting "stone and sky." Meanwhile, Andor holds a cook at gunpoint and asks where is Bix. The cook gives directions before expressing his condolences for Maarva. At the funeral procession, B2EMO plays a holorecording of Maarva, who talks about touching a funeral stone for the first time while she was six years old. She talks about walking to the Funeral Square with her sister and being inspired by the dead. She tells the assembled crowd that she wants Ferrix to go on. She says that the people have been sleeping. Maarva says that they have been turning from the truth; that there is a darkness spreading through the galaxy. She describes the Empire as a disease that thrives in darkness and when they sleep. She urges them to fight.

Captain Tigo overturns B2EO, angering the crowd who begin attacking the Imperial Army troopers who are equipped with riot gear. Andor navigates his way through the hotel and knocks out a soldier. As the crowd fights the Imperial Army soldiers, an officer orders his men to shoot the "Time Grappler." Meanwhile, Andor finds Bix in her cell and tells her that he has come to free her. Bix is reluctant to leave but Andor encourages her.

Meero is accosted by protesters. Wilmon hurls his improvised bomb at a vehicle carrying explosives, scattering the crowd and the Imperial soldiers. Keysax issues orders to open fire on the crowd as the protest descends into a skirmish. Stormtroopers and Imperial Army soldiers open fire on civilians and protesters, killing several. Corv finds Cinta in the streets but she stabs him. Pegla evacuates B2EMO from the streets while stormtroopers use laser turrets to open fire on the crowd.

Andor escorts Bix out of the hotel, which has been damaged by the explosion. They pass an unconscious Nurchi, who was knocked out by debris. A stormtrooper attempts to stop the Time Grappler but he throws him down the towel. Meero is attacked by a mob but is saved from being lynched by Syril Karn, who hides her inside a storeroom. Meero is initially angry but reluctantly thanks Karn. Rael watches the uprising from a distance. Elsewhere, Cinta reunites with Vel. Vel is concerned about the blood but Cinta realizes that it is not her blood.

Pegla helps Brasso prepare a ship for lift-off. They are soon joined by Andor and Bix. Andor convinces to evacuate Bix and advises them on escaping Ferrix. Bix bids B2EMO, Bix, Pegla, and Wilmon farewell and promises to find them. While the ship flies away, Andor heads back to the Ferrix town center. A despondent Mosk sits by a street corner. Meanwhile, Mothma and Fertha introduce their daughter Leida Mothma to Stekan Sculdun and his mother Runai Sculdun.

Rael boards his Fondor Haulcraft and tells his droid to prepare for departure. He is soon confronted in the cockpit by Andor, who asks if he came to kill him. When Andor hands him a blaster, Rael asks what game is this. Andor says this is no game and dares Rael to kill him or take him. Rael smiles and decides to recruit Andor.
