Summary:	David Jung, a Korean-American man who faked his death nine years ago, confronts his past when his daughter Rebecca, now working as an assassin for the private intelligence agency Caddis, is sent to kill him.

The woman sneakily switches the ambassador's phone and poisons him. The ambassador, Karpov, dies, and his security team quickly moves to secure the site.

The pregnant woman is quickly ID'd while on an elevator, where a security guard tries to take her out. However, she overpowers him. The struggle in the elevator forces the woman to head back to the floor where she committed the murder.

A gunfight ensues, but she manages to hide in a room. She calls her colleague, who gives her a way out through the stairs. She quickly changes while going down the stairs, and when she reaches the ground floor, she's neither pregnant nor blonde. She successfully makes her way to the exfil location.

Back at the karaoke bar, the mysterious man breaks through the door and leaves the other guy unconscious. Thanks to this, the man manages to intercept the exfil car and take out the agents. However, the woman notices something is off and takes off running. She opens fire, getting the police's attention. The man also quickly speeds off.

Meanwhile, back in the US, we meet a man called Manny. For some reason, a woman named Juno is holding him captive. She has been torturing him and Manny is displeased that Juno is using her intelligence agency to betray the US. After Manny reveals who he is working with, Juno gives the order to kill. She sends a team to Canada to find the man Manny was working with.

Her son, Oliver, interrupts and informs her that the Seoul mission went sideways. They have been unable to get in touch with the female operative, Rebecca. Juno worries that Langley will figure out they are behind the Karpov hit and this would mean that her agency, Caddis, could lose everything.

Her top priority is to find Rebecca since she is their valuable asset. They also need to figure out who is behind the sabotage.

Meanwhile, the mysterious man ditches the exfil van after cleaning it. He switches his SIM card and heads to the train station. While there, he calls a woman called Eun-ju. Here we learn that the man's name is David, and he is trying to save his daughter from Caddis.

He and his wife had an agreement that they would give the mission only one shot. However, David is not ready to abandon his daughter. He asks Eun-ju to leave for the safe house, and he promises to meet her within a day or two.

In the US, Oliver and Juno leave for Seoul immediately. Rebecca calls Juno and promises to find the snitch and fix the mess. She is hurt that Juno doesn't trust her, while Oliver is jealous of how his mom treats Rebecca. It turns out that Juno has been secretly planning to frame Rebecca if things go south in the Karpov mission. On the flight, the team continues to try to identify David.

David goes back to the van and leaves a card with GPS coordinates. He takes a taxi and visits his old friend Choi at his restaurant. He quickly explains to Choi that he is going back to get his daughter. We discover that David faked his death nine years ago to escape Caddis.

Although he co-founded the company, he is not happy with how it has been run. Choi promises to deliver the passports David will need. However, he also worries about the tight schedule since David needs them urgently.

Rebecca and her team find the van and the GPS coordinates. As they wait for nightfall, Rebecca has sex with one of the operatives, Atwood. Later, she calls Juno and informs her that they are heading to get the saboteur. Juno is glad that Rebecca is taking the matter seriously.

In the meantime, David drives to the GPS coordinate location and prepares food. By the time Rebecca and her team get there, David is all set. He uses a few tricks to take out some of the men, and he ends up getting into a tense knife and gun battle with Atwood. Rebecca worries that they will be traced back to the house, but David assures her they are fine. Still, Rebecca is a bit shaken when Mr Kwon, the caretaker, drops by.

As they settle in, Eun-ju asks David to stop keeping secrets from her. He apologises and confesses his love for her. David shares his concerns that Rebecca is different from how he remembers her. Rebecca secretly listens to the conversation.

Later, she teaches Min-hee how to handle a gun, and Eun-ju loses it. David is forced to intervene and asks everyone to get along. Watching David's interactions with Min-hee only makes her angrier.

Back in Seoul, Juno meets with Senator Dawson, who shows her a photo of Oliver and Jae Hun-lee. Hun-lee was a CIA informer and was killed a week ago. Dawson suspects Oliver had something to do with it. He confirms that the CIA has been watching Oliver and would like to talk to him.

Rebecca longs for acceptance, and Juno tells her exactly what she needs to hear. She willingly follows Juno, and they plan to take a private plane out of the country. Juno is disappointed that Oliver thinks she tried to kill him and turned on her. Still, she doesn't want to lose Rebecca, or so she says.

David and his men intercept Juno and Rebecca on their way to the airport. David cheekily blocks the road and leads the motorcade exactly where he wants it.

An intense fight ensues between David and Gun, culminating in David slitting Gun's throat while Rebecca kills the other operatives and holds Juno at gunpoint.

Although David wants Juno dead, Rebecca convinces him to let Juno live. Once again, Rebecca sees Juno as family and can't kill her. Juno offers David and Rebecca a job in her new operation, but they turn her down. Instead, they warn her not to mess with them further.

Juno gets on her private jet and flees the country. She has hopes of starting another operation in a different country. Oliver calls her, and she apologises for being a bad mom. She also apologises for Baron, Oliver's alleged dog, which she had killed when he was young.

She clarifies that she didn't try to assassinate him while Oliver also apologises for betraying his mom. Juno assures him that it is okay, but the phone signal is weak, and Oliver doesn't hear his mom.

David and Rebecca head back to Seoul. During the ride, David tries to debrief Rebecca. However, she lies about what she and Juno spoke about. David tells her that she doesn't have to tell him what truly happened.

Later, David and his family have dinner. David and Eun-ju contemplate moving to America, and Min-hee suggests Hawaii. Before leaving the restaurant, Eun-ju asks to visit the ladies' room first. Rebecca offers to escort her while David remains behind with Min-hee.

After a while, David notices that the trip to the ladies' room is taking longer than expected. He breaks down the door and finds Eun-ju bleeding on the floor, her throat slit. Rebecca is nowhere to be seen. He asks Eun-ju if Rebecca is behind her attack, but the poor lady can't talk. The show ends with David shouting Rebecca's name in anguish.
