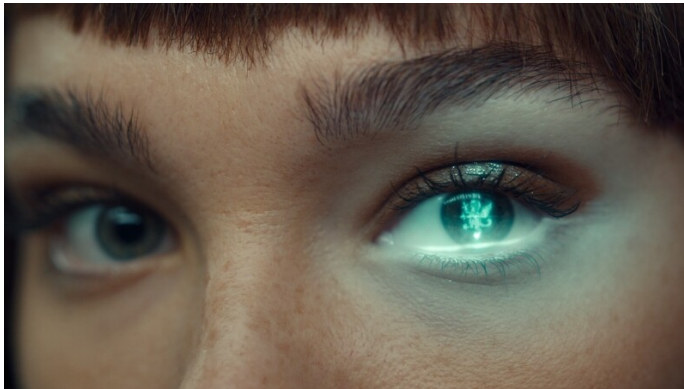

Summary: 2030: In a gray and hyper-controlled Milan, Diana and Luca are sent on a mission to Lugano to spy on the exchange of a powerful weapon. Not far away, Edo Zani, Manticore Italy's heir, has to respond to an unexpected proposal from the head of Manticore France, Cecile. In the flashbacks, Diana investigates her parents' suspicious deaths when she meets Gabriele, a mysterious Citadel agent.



The episode begins with our titular character killing someone and then turning the gun and firing on her arm. She gets back in her car and takes off. What happened? Well, we're about to find out!

We're in Milano 2030. Safe zones have been set up across the city to keep people subdued and it's immediately clear that the Manticore network is global, and alive and well in different territories. However, there are protests ongoing as a result of these safe zones and proposals about regulating firearms, something that is ap-

parent based on "the American Model". This is being met with mixed reactions, to say the least.

Diana and Luca are given their next targets, who happen to be other Manticore agents, and it involves spying on a sister agency. The meeting is scheduled for 4pm and they're also going dark too — so no more communications for the time being. However, they are given strict instructions not to fire or get involved in any scraps.

This meeting is directly linked with a weapon manufacturing firm, Zani, which is fronted by Ettore and Edo Zani. They're creating firearms that are inexplicably able to transform into different items that would trick security details. They show up to a secret meeting with the Germans and France, fronted by Cecile and Wolfgang respectively. It doesn't go well, as the Zani's (and by extension Manticore Italia) are shocked that they're being kept at arm's length and held down for another 3 years and won't be able to vote.

Outside, Cecile propositions Edo, trying to perform a coup so they'd turn their two territories and agencies into one. But this would also mean fracturing what he already has in Italy. All they'd need to do is marry to secure that bond, and then they could mould their Manticore into something else entirely. Naturally, he needs to think it over.

Luca and Diana drive to Switzerland, tracking that secret meeting which is taking place in Lugano. They find their targets and listen in, as the French and German agent mention cryptic terms involving an Apple, which is code for a deadly weapon. As the pair exchange items, Diana takes her gun out and fires on them, killing the French agent in cold blood. The German agent skips away.

Diana is reckless, leaving her cover to shoot in the open. She's not killed, miraculously, and she grabs one half of this "apple" from the table where the deal has gone awry, steals a car and takes off with Luca just along for the ride.

Now, Diana's motivations will become clear in the episodes ahead I'm sure, but for now, we catch up to the beginning of the episode, as Luca and Diana scrap. The latter kills her partner in cold blood and heads back to HQ.

Diana is brought in for questioning, where she passes the lie detector and also gets herself patched up after putting all the blame on Luca and claiming he shot first and Diana was just defending herself. She also brings up that Luca was seeing someone else too.

Diana is a woman possessed, determined to find out what caused her parents' plane crash in the Alps years before. While tracking the escaped agent, Rainer, she gets dizzy and ends up collapsing, brought to the hospital to treatment.

Whilst there, the doctor reveals that she has Ménière's disease. This is an incurable inner ear disorder that can cause vertigo.

When he wakes up, her sister Sara is there to check on her. The pair have a strained relationship, brought on from their past issues and confrontations surrounding their family. Sara is leaving for Iceland soon, one of the last refuges away from safe zones and crippling surveillance everywhere, and she wants Diana to follow. However, she refuses, given she's lusting for revenge and wants to finish up what she's doing on this mission.

Speaking of familial issues, there are tensions with the Zani family too, especially as Edo is torn between brokering this deal with Cecile and staying true to his family.

Diana tracks Rainer, the German who escaped from the deal that went sideways in Lugano. Diana wants 20 million in exchange for this Apple, and he agrees to meet her the following morning. As she heads back home, these scenes directly contrast that of flashbacks from 9 years ago. Diana receives a mysterious call, eventually leading to her meeting an informant on the rooftop.

This man is called Gabriele and he knows that the hit against Diana's parents was organized and chalked off as "collateral damage". He tells her that Zani Manufacturing are behind this and after giving her some affirmations, tells her to work on apprehending those who killed her parents. He's also from Citadel.

In the present timeline, Diana shows up at the door of none other than Edu Zani. She brings up how she has the French half of the weapon and knows about the plan to resurrect Manticore Italy. And she wants to talk.

Summary: Diana and Edo form a secret agreement and make their first move, but they underestimate Cecile's fierce reaction. While Manticore Italy is under attack, Ettore Zani has to step in to stop a war from breaking out. In the flashbacks, Diana completes her training with Gabriele and becomes a Citadel agent.



The episode begins with Diana dropping off the French half of the weapon to Edo. She feeds back about how Luca is dead and wants to try and turn the Germans against the French, being the orchestrator in all of this, while also resurrecting Manticore Italy in the background. As for Diana, she wants to leave the agency and get out while she can. She never signed on to sell weapons to the Mafia, and would much rather take out some bad guys. She's had enough.

Thankfully, we get a good exposition dump here as Edo, fresh off his meeting with Diana, heads to the exposition computer, which informs us that she's been working for the company since 2022 and her parents were killed in special operation 011 back in 2017.

Diana eventually heads back home, where she and Sara end up in a big fight. After parting ways, Diana is followed by a bunch of agents that tail her in a taxi.

Flashbacks flesh out more of her real motivations here though, as Diana meets with Gabriele and wants to help shed more light on the past. Apparently another agent was onboard the plane, which backs up the special operation we know about. And unfortunately, these flashbacks are now playing catch up to info we literally were just given. The crucial point though is why? Why was that agent killed?

For now, flashbacks show her training in a dingy little gym underneath the swimming pool. This includes both physical and mental training, working on her stress levels and mental prowess. Gabriele also brings up how Citadel was created to make the world a better place. After this impromptu training, she's being brought in to work with them the following day.

From here on out, it's goodbye and they're only to communicate via a handheld tablet he hands over to her.

Back in the present, Edo decrypts the data on this contraption (which Diana has left for him) and he finds some sort of anomaly. Ettore shows, and Edo quickly changes the huge projector screen in front of him to something else. Not suspicious at all. Well, Edo loses his patience and tells his dad about Cecile's plan to work behind his back. Ettore actually thinks the marriage would be good as they'd be in a more powerful position to negotiate but of course, he doesn't know the full story here.

Diana meets with Edo in secret that night, where he feeds back that the French half of this weapon happens to be an interception system, which can be reduced right down so it's microscopic. It would manage to evade all security systems, which I'm sure will come in handy later on in the show! However, the flaw Edo found would bring the entire system down and its been placed strategically. What does this mean? Well, the meeting was a set-up. The French were going to double-cross the Germans and take their half of the weapon.

Edo hands back the half to Diana, and agrees that they should work on stirring the pot and getting what they both want here. Part of this includes Diana showing up 300km from Milan, at an abandoned amusement park to start her deal. Instead, they immediately begin firing on each other.

Over at Manticore France, Cecile rings Edo who has made his mind up. He's not taking the bait and marrying, and he's not budging despite Cecile trying to play the sexism card.

Right off the back of this, Zani Manufacturing goes haywire as it seems someone has hacked the system. It's Cecile. She's taken off with everyone and seems to know about the drama in Lugano too. Ettore is not happy when he finds out and decides to try and grovel with her to lift the lockdown. Edo though, encourages him to bluff his way out of this.

Ettore speaks to Cecile and admits they were spying on her. He reveals that the agents — Luca and Diana — were acting against the orders given to them and that, of course, means Diana is public enemy number 1.

Diana shows up back home, unaware of all this. An armed agent immediately starts shooting and she gets dizzy and blacks out. The agent disappears when she regains composure, and it would seem like Edo may be responsible for this.

Anyway, Diana receives a call from Sara, who is at a nearby bar. She's with Edo, who got her out in time so she knows nothing about the shootout.

As the episode closes out, Ettore pores over the video footage of Diana lying during her interrogation, and he susses out that she's not telling the truth.

Summary: Ettore sends Edo and Diana on a sensitive mission that threatens their alliance. However, the two discover that they want much the same thing. Eight years earlier, Diana carries out her first mission for Manticore.



The episode begins with more flashbacks. 8 years back, Diana was held at gunpoint by a strange man who threatened her in her car. It's Matteo. He brings up how the secret service were the ones who killed her parents and he propositions her. He doesn't want her to stop her mission but knows they're just pawns. Together though, he believes they can topple the system — and he wants her to be one of their top agents.

Diana shows up for training, where she marvels at their massive facility.

Here, she learns the Zanis want to subvert the whole system, which she feeds back to Gabriele. Further flashbacks sprinkled in the episode see her head off on her training missions alongside other agents. One of them happens to be Luca, although the pair don't have much time together.

In the present, Diana puts her sister to sleep and has the team work to fix up the flat so there's no evidence of a break-in. As for Edo he's called into a briefing with Ettore. Apparently Ettore's meeting with Cecile has been fruitful as she knew Klein had double-crossed her and made demands. With all the agencies turning against each other, Ettore has decided to stick closer to Cecile, wanting to work with Manticore France to track down both halves of the weapon and form a loose alliance. Edo though, is wanting to turn all of this into a big war between the agencies, as there's opportunity within the chaos.

Edo is bound by his father's plans and part of that comes from tracking down Weber. He seems to be stationed somewhere within the Trapani region but in order to get to him, they need to go through the Tringalis, who aren't on good terms with them. A rival gang could be the solution here, the Magnanos, who may reveal Weber's location if a family member goes. And of course, Edo is sent along.

Naturally, Edo chooses a "top agent" to accompany him and he chooses Diana. Diana wants to capture him alive but Edo has other ideas. Either way, they head over to Sicily, ready to start their mission. The head of the clan, Enzo, meets with Edo and they talk business. However, Edo riskily decides to take data from Enzo's phone, putting the two in close proximity and taking what he needs without suspicion.

Weber's location is an abandoned warehouse, but of course when Diana shows up, he's nowhere to be seen. Save for a zipline that leads off to a labyrinth across the ways of course. Diana gives chase and manages to track the guy down, eventually leading to Diana getting the upper-hand and killing the guy outright.

Diana scans Weber's face after killing him and lets Edo know the news. However, no weapon means they move to Plan B instead, which includes doctoring footage of Weber moving through the hotel and trying to kill Edo. Diana even gives a little warning shot against the wall to make it look authentic.

Diana shows up at the hotel room, where Edo is working on the manufactured footage. All of this is, of course, their double-cross for Ettore who falls for the bait for the time being when he sees the footage. He convinces himself that the Magnanos may have revealed his location for the hit.

Diana is ready to get the hell out of dodge but Edo has other plans. He wants them to make a good night of it in Sicily and have dinner together. Some of the flashbacks actually help to show Diana's disdain toward Manticore in the middle of this. After a training exercise gone wrong, and a bombing on the Piazza Duomo, she wants out. However, Gabriele encourages her to hold on a bit longer, given she's their inside guy and without her, they have no way of overthrowing the system.

That night, Edo brings up how he's felt alone within Manticore and Diana is the first person he's managed to actually be real with and feel like himself. Just then, Diana has another of her dizzy spells and she races back to her hotel room.

Diana visits a doctor after her next attack, where she learns that this may well be triggered not just by heightened stress — but also by romantic feelings. At least, that's the insinuation here. As she grapples with this, Ettore rings and brings Edo in. He doesn't trust Diana, and he admits they've managed to bring Cecile back onboard. That doctored footage of Weber at the hotel? Ettore is well aware it's a fake. In fact, he has the German half of the weapon already and he knew Edo had plans to betray him.

After this double-cross, Diana is approached in the street and knocked out, kidnapped by the Zanis.

Summary:	Diana is captured and struggles desperately to survive while Ettore has to make a hard decision in order to restore Manticore Italy's power, as memories resurface of the day when his relationship with Edo was shattered forever.



The episode begins with Ettore pointing out that this whole endeavour with Sicily was just a ploy to see how deep Edo's connection with Diana went. And choosing her wasn't even part of the deal — Edo did that all by himself. Ettore got everything from Weber — including the weapon — by threatening his family. Edo though, hits back and points out that the French half of the weapon doesn't work, and reveals he double-cross that he and Diana discovered from the French side of things.

Off the back of this, Ettore wipes his hands of his son and kicks Edo out of Manticore. Edo is livid and finds out from Julia that even she knew that Sicily was a trap. He also brings up how Diana has earned her position and he feels passionately about that (and getting in her pants).

However, Manticore are currently interrogating Diana, who's kept in a holding cell. Edo manages to break in and see her. He hurriedly tells her that Ettore knows everything so they need to move and get out. With the guards incoming, Diana brings up that the prisoner next door to her is actually a Citadel agent as well. He's the one who killed Edo's brother.

Edo confronts Matteo and Ettore with this information, especially the implication of going beyond protocols and torturing inmates when he was initially told that he was dead. Ettore defends his methods, calling Edo a hypocrite given he's a weapons manufacturer so he should know what he's doing.

Now, Edo has always been an emotionally charged man and flashbacks show that. As fate would have it, Cecile and Edo have ties that go way back. The pair are given grandiose plans from their families to take over the Manticore legacies, but Cecile is a bit of a mess. With her mother currently sick and the Manticore plans overwhelming, she decides to call off their relationship given their differing life paths. Despite being in love, she breaks his heart. This also gives more context over episode 1's proposal from Cecile to join their families.

Much like Diana's abhorrence toward Manticore, Edo has a similar reaction when he finds out the Piazza Duomo has been destroyed. Apparently this was done as a diversion to let them take out Citadel once and for all. With war waged, this is, apparently, their way of securing war by overthrowing the current authority.

Meanwhile, Diana decides to negotiate her position. She wants to be transferred across to Manticore France. She'll be executed either way but decides Paris may be her best play. She knows Ettore needs to get into France's HQ and steal the real half of the weapon. Well, transferring Diana is the best way of him doing that. Just like the agents who mentioned the Trojan war at the hand-off, she's going to be a trojan horse.

Ettore sparks the embers of war not long after, speaking to Wolfgang and pointing out that Cecile is playing him like a fiddle. After, he brings Edo back onboard and they patch up their ties. At the hangar, before flying out to Paris, Edo shows up and promises to try and do his best to keep her safe, while taking out Manticore France.

The episode begins with Edo giving a rousing speech before they head out, ready to storm Manticore France. This is actually directly contrasting a similar plan that took place 8 years before, with Diana joining other Manticore agents as they look set to storm Citadel Italy. She's struggling though and needs to pop pills to focus and stop her condition debilitating her. Their target is Citadel Italy and she's brought in along with the other agents on her mission. Leading the charge happens to be Edo's

brother, who's obviously killed by the end of this.

Diana heads into the heart of the Citadel, where one of the agents, Andrea, is busy destroying Citadel equipment so Manticore can't get their grubby paws on it. He wasn't aware a double agent was working undercover and together, they do their best to burn everything. He does end up knocked out though, and obviously brought into Manticore France for questioning, but Diana doesn't break her cover.

In the present, the agents all have their weapons stripped before being taken to Manticore. Diana is handed over to Cecile, and eventually thrown in a holding cell in the basement.

Down in the lobby, Edo speaks to Cecile, who promises that they're going to get back on better footing now. Italy are being reinstated to the European council and the sanctions will be cut too. Edo suggests they split the weapon and share it around between agencies. Cecile smiles weakly and agrees, but in private she speaks to her associate, who points out that once she has the German half of the weapon, they intend to increase not decrease sanctions against Italy. She'll also lower Klein to their level too and double-cross them all.

However, they obviously get pulled right into a big trap. Diana calls for Cecile, pointing out the Zani's intend to trap her. Cecile brings up the defective French half of the weapon and how war is coming. Diana believes her best shot at living is through Cecile but this is, of course, her way of stalling for time. It's part of her masterplan.

Unfortunately, Edo is arrested at the airfield before they all have their guns returned to them. He doesn't resist though as Edo shows up to see Cecile in her office, which starts the plan to take over Manticore. Matteo leads the charge, using the special microscopic weapons made at the Manufacturing plant to arm everyone and, of course, avoid detection at the scanners.

This works a treat, as the attack goes ahead and Cecile realizes she has walked right into this big trap. Back-up can't reach them either as comms and power goes down in the building, trapping Cecile in her office. Edo kills the guards he's with, courtesy of another weapon he has stashed, and using the tech, heads down to regroup with Diana.

Well, when they show up in the main server room, Edo manages to obtain the real French half of the weapon. Diana though, can't keep her promise she made to Citadel, and lets her emotions get in the way of her. Top secret agent, by the way.

Edo believes this is a new start for Manticore Italy, and as they take off with the French half of the weapon, Cecile's lockdown is lifted but all of her data has been taken. As for Diana and the others, they show back up on home soil.

Edo and Diana give in to their romantic desires, and afterwards, Edo decides that he wants to share power with Ettore and he has dinner planned to get that sorted.

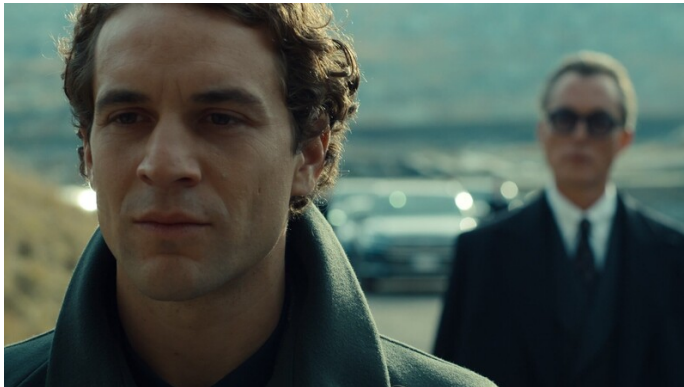

The episode begins with a flashback after the attack on the Citadel. Diana leaves a voice message about how she's a Citadel agent operating inside Manticore. She's trying to find other operatives and after 19 days, it seems like a bleak endeavour. Manticore Italy is under heavy sanctions as a result from its sister agencies... but we know all of this, why are you wasting our time Citadel: Diana? Get on with it!

We also get a recap of everything that's happened up until this point during the past timeline, and the extent of Diana's

issues. Specifically, how alone she feels. Just then, she receives a visit from Edo. He asks about his brother, and Diana is quick to point out how they had a few interactions together but he was a good leader.

Back in the present timeline, we're a month after the events of episode 5. Diana shows up to see Sara, who's on the verge of selling her house and making her way to Iceland. She promises there will always be a place for her if she needs it, but for now the pair hug and say their goodbyes.

With a lot that's happened between them, just like in episode 1 our terrible foursome (Cecile, Wolfgang, Edo and Ettore) all try to discuss their next steps. They talk about their weapon called Jupiter, which the Zanis believe is the future of Manticore Europe. They're going to disperse it via the world's water supply.

This weapon is parasitic in nature and embeds itself directly into the human body on a microscopic level. This would mean Manticore Italy would be able to track any person at any

time. They'd be the ones in control of all the power and "promise peace and prosperity", but at what cost? The worst part, is that Manticore would have power of life or death over anyone via a specific protocol brought on, thanks to Ettore's interjection.

The European council are going to share their access to Jupiter as a result of Italia having the weapon. However, Manticore first analysis of the agency's data from both France and Germany. They're almost on equal footing, but of course Italy have the upper-hand in this new world order. Edo has real power now, and his father is quick to point out that he needs to figure out what he's going to do with it.

The wildcard here though is Diana. She replays Gabriele's message in her mind before meeting Edo. He's angry that she's back, but Diana has decided that she wants more from her life. Specifically, being with him. After sleeping together, she brings up how she contemplated destroying the weapon but eventually decided not to, given it would just get her in more trouble. As for Edo, he reveals that Manticore killed her parents, which we knew anyway. And furthermore, Edo wasn't involved in that decision apparently.

Edo pitches to Diana what he's invented, and then speaks to Ettore about Diana's change of heart. He's suspicious over her, especially the way Diana's opinions have changed. It's hard to know if it's actually because she's playing both sides or just bad writing. He's onboard with her though... at least on the surface anyway.

After a heart to heart with his father, Edo decides to give him the code to Jupiter. However, Edo wants Diana to manage the running of Manticore Italy. Ettore agrees, and they're going to make it official that night. However, as soon as he gets the code, he immediately decides to block Diana's communications and take her out after the operation is complete, via Matteo. Julia is shocked, but Ettore believes he's doing this for Edo's sake.

Diana's life is hanging in the balance, and when Edo finds out what his father intends to do, he tries to communicate with Matteo. However, he's off with Diana at the local water plant, where they disperse the first batch of Jupiter. At the same time, the government manage to pass the law to deregulate firearm purchases.

After the test is complete, Diana and Matteo immediately begin fighting. Diana defeats Matteo while Edo reveals the shocking twist that he actually has some of Jupiter inside his father. Ettore is horrified, as Edo reveals a controller in his hand, knowing it will affect his nervous system.

As for Diana, she's shocked when she finds the other agents dead and out of the shadows comes Gabriele. She's not alone in taking down Manticore after all but what will she choose to do? Will she choose to be with Gabriele? Or her lover, Edo?
