Summary: A night of passion leads to love between con-man Charlie and undercover CIA officer Emma, who are unknowingly on a collision course professionally.



Charlie Nicoletti is practicing sleight of hand tricks making a playing card appear and disappear in an instant. He's a con man and boy does that look good on him.

Charlie meets with Patrick McGuire and his team at a warehouse near the docks. They're about to make a deal on the building, but McGuire's assistant is suspicious and pulls McGuire aside. He's going to sell it to them at a discount and for crypto, not cash? Unbeknownst to them, Charlie's sister is watching the exchange and keeping her brother clued

into what he can't see. He starts to leave, but McGuire completes the deal. Charlie's sister confirms the transfer of funds, just as the FBI shows up! Was it a set up?? The feds cuff Charlie as McGuire gets away. But it turns out the FBI is actually... Charlie's parents and fiancée. He tells the group they need to clear out before the buyer learns they sold a warehouse they don't own.

Emma Hill makes her way into the offices of Pattern Logistics which is actually a cover for the CIA. Emma visits with a co-worker and boss, catching up on a recent lead. The global drug trafficking ring she's been following is making a push into the U.S. They know the what and how, but not the who. Just then she gets a notification on her phone and leaves. She goes to confront her boyfriend who's been seeing another woman. He admits it's been going on for a few months. "You're not honestly in love with me," he says.

Charlie and his fiancée are packing up at the warehouse and take a moment to discuss their evening plans. He's booked them a suite at the Langston hotel. She smiles and says, "the best part of 'happily ever after' is you don't know what comes next."

Back home at their bar, the Nicoletti family celebrates their latest successful con. Birdie says she's unsettled by this big of a job. She asks Charlie for the cold wallet from earlier, but it's gone. His girlfriend's diamond ring is there instead. He flashes back to earlier as Birdie raises her voice. "Call her!" Charlie dials the number, but it's no longer in service. She's split.

Emma is at the Langston's lobby bar and gets hit on. She immediately reads the guy and calls him out. He excuses himself, clearing a space between Emma and Charlie. They strike up a conversation revealing that both of them have just been dumped. A few drinks later they're feeling good and telling each other what they do for a living. Both are clearing lying and loving it. She says, "tell me something true." Charlie admits, "I'm a criminal." Emma says, "I'm CIA." They pause, then laugh some more at these ridiculous stories. Charlie leaves the bar and heads up to the suite. A few minutes later Emma shows up, she says she saw his room number on the bar receipt. He invites her in. They kiss, then order room service. The next morning they're about to part, but the energy between them is charged and they spend the day together getting frisky and enjoying the hotel's many amenities. As they lie in bed, Emma says, "fantasy is one thing, reality is another."

The following day, Charlie meets with a prostitute friend and he asks for leads on a quick job. She tells him about a televangelist who has a Mega Church in Arlington. She'd been at a party he hosted and noticed he was carrying a lot of cash. He thanks her for the tip.

After being AWOL for 36 hours, Charlie comes back to the bar where his family, and Birdie's deaf daughter Ollie, have been waiting for him. Birdie sends Ollie to her room and stresses that she didn't want to do a job this big. They're out \$10 million and now broke. Charlie apologizes and says he has something lined up. Birdie leaves, and Charlie and his dad talk about the breakup and how his fiancée pulled one over on them. Charlie tells his dad they've been using the same pin code on their account since Ollie was born.

Pastor Earl is the next target. As the family scopes out the church, Charlie waits for info in their van. He pulls out his phone and looks at pictures of Emma. Birdie interrupts his thoughts as she hacks into the Church's financial data. They're laundering money but from where? The Nicolettis discover that Pastor Earl gets a new burner phone each week and devise a public distraction to get their hands on the phone for a few moments. They learn Pastor Earl is going to attend a gala event in DC and the whole family has their roles to play.

It turns out Emma and her family have been invited to the same gala. Her father is a former Governor and her brother is running for Senate. The Hills don't know what their daughter's actual job is and wish she'd support them more instead of focusing so much on her logistics career. She steps away from the conversation and Charlie follows her to the bar. She's happy to see him and they dance. Meanwhile Birdie has her eyes on the Pastor who's just met with his contact.

Caught up in the moment with Emma, Charlie tells her his family owns a bar in Baltimore. He admits who he is wrapped up in his family and it's hard to see past that. Emma says she's been defining herself against her family for a long time. Birdie picks up on his distraction and reminds him why they're there. Emma asks him for a date, but Charlie turns her down. She's surprised and asks him to say he didn't think about her or feel their connection. He coldly says he didn't think about her.

After the gala, Pastor Earl gets a text reading "Cover Blown" Clean House Tonight" He empties his safe, putting all the cash into a suitcase. The next message says his contact is sending in a fixer and to be on the lookout for a Gray SUV. A disguised Charlie and Birdie arrive in the car and take the cash.

At work, Emma gets briefed that Patrick McGuire seems to be their link to the global drug ring. He's the same man who bought the warehouse.

Back home, Charlie and his family count money and Birdie mentions Emma. Charlie says it's over, he's not pursuing her. He's good at the family business. His parents say they're not ok with Charlie staying here and falling on his sword for the family. He did it once before, and he's had to stick around because of their decisions. They're not walking away and leaving him holding the bag. "We're all out or all in."

In a joint operation with the FBI, Emma watches McGuire and his team who are about to board a private jet. His assistant lingers and Emma says to wait for the whole crew to board. But they don't. The FBI moves in, the assistant runs, and Emma chases after her in a car. Emma is T-boned by another vehicle and hurts her wrist. The assistant gets away, but they're able to

ID her. The woman is Daphne Finch, and Emma realizes she's the brains behind the operation, McGuire is nothing. They won the battle but not the war.

The next day Charlie comes to her house to explain his behavior at the gala. His life is complicated. He wants to take her on that date. He hasn't stopped thinking about her.

Charlie tells his family he wants one last big score to get them out of this business for good. They agree. Then Daphne Finch comes to the bar. She knows he didn't own the building and says he owes them the \$10 million plus another \$5 million to get McGuire out of jail. She says it's going to take him time which she doesn't have. "Get to stealing, you can't lie your way out of this one."

Summary: After Daphne sets a quick turnaround for payment, the Nicolettis devise a plan to steal a valuable necklace at an auction. As Emma and Charlie are both pursuing Daphne, their worlds nearly collide.



The Nicolettis are onto their next con job, attempting to steal a Black Diamond necklace. The prized jewelry item is up for auction and the family is there in various roles. Charlie is disguised as a server and his mom, Fran is there to bid on the goods. Charlie gets a text from Emma about their plans for the evening and this puts him in a good mood. But back to business, Charlie approaches one of the tech guys saying a boss wants to see him. He gets access to the computer. Bidding starts on the necklace which ultimately

goes to the Ambassador to Russia for a whopping \$500 thousand. The Nicolettis realize that the Buyer and Seller are the same person. But why?

Daphne Finch visits her employer, McGuire, in prison. She threatens to call in his son Connor who's currently managing the business overseas.

At the CIA, Emma talks to her boss about Daphne and asks to have her hotel room bugged. He agrees.

That night, Emma is sitting alone at a restaurant, and observing other patrons, telling the server that the couple across the way is breaking up. She gets up to leave, but Charlie appears. Finally! They sit down for a few minutes and talk about how mixing family and business can be difficult. She tells him she's a data analyst and he says didn't go to college. They both want to get out of there and sneak off to his car. As they're kissing Emma looks out the rear window and sees her brother's face on a city bus promoting his campaign for Senate. Charlie gets a text telling him he's needed at home.

Daphne shows up at the Nicolettis' bar and sits down, ordering a mojito. Birdie says they don't serve mojitos. Daphne calmly uses American Sign Language (ASL) to ask about Birdie's daughter Ollie. She's instantly uncomfortable. Charlie shows up and Daphne tells him "get me my money by the end of week or I'm calling Connor."

With Charlie gone, Emma heads to her parents home which is also campaign headquarters. Her brother's campaign manager doesn't recognize her, but David steps in announcing she's his sister. She asks how it's going and they admit polling numbers could be better.

After Daphne leaves, the family discusses the schematics of the Ambassador's house and the safe where they're keeping the \$500 thousand Black Diamond. Unfortunately the safe is biometric locked. The Nicoletti's ponder how to get the ambassador to take the necklace out. Leo suggests an old classic, "Milosh" but Fran doesn't love it. It's risky but Charlie says it's good for this job.

Things have quieted down at the Hill house and Emma's parents ask her to be part of the family photos for David's campaign. She declines saying she doesn't want to be a prop. Her mom, Grace, says they're all props in politics. Emma offers her assistance by looking over her brother's numbers. She says David doesn't have a suburban problem, then points out that all of the zip codes where he's struggling are predominantly Asian American. David is shocked, "they don't think I'm Asian enough?!"

The next day at the Nicoletti's, Birdie tells Charlie she doesn't like the job, but she's not bailing. They talk about love and relationships. Ollie comes in and nabs Charlie's wallet. When Birdie catches her, she signs that Grandpa taught her the trick! Birdie gives Charlie the address to Daphne's hotel telling him, "I followed her home. No one messes with my kid."

Fran and Leo aka "Milosh" head to a trendy salon where the ambassador's wife, Mrs. Ellsworth is having her hair done. Milosh and mom loudly discuss how friends canceled on them and they need a stylish home to stage their photo shoot. Mrs. Ellsworth turns around and offers them the use of her home.

Charlie and Birdie head to Daphne's hotel and he gets to work posing as maintenance. He breaks in and tells Birdie via headset that the place is spotless, even though Daphne checked in a week ago. Out in the hall a woman in stylish boots is walking down the hall. Is it Daphne? Charlie finds a picture of a pregnant woman and snaps a photo with his phone, sending it to Birdie. They think the picture is of Daphne's mom.

The boots lady enters the room and it's Emma who's there to plant the bug. Charlie hides in the bathroom and tells Birdie, Daphne's returned. She heads upstairs. He almost knocks a bottle off the vanity, but catches it in time. As Emma is planting the bug, she hears the noise but doesn't find Charlie. Birdie tells him to get to the adjoining room door and pulls him out of Daphne's with seconds to spare.

That night, Emma's out in the town and talking with her assistant on the phone. She insists that she and Charlie are not in a relationship. Charlie walks up and she smiles then hangs up the phone. The duo heads to Charlie's car for their secret rendezvous. They talk a little bit about family and Emma says they're both emotionally unavailable people with strong physical connection. What do you do when you meet the right person at the wrong time?

The next day, the whole Nicoletti clan heads to the Ellsworth's for a photo shoot of their stylish home. Birdie will take care of Mrs. Ellsworth's makeup and hair and will swap out the real Black Diamond for a fake. But they insist no one touches the necklace.

Daphne returns to her practically untouched hotel room. She steps into the bathroom and sees that the bottles in the vanity are not how she placed them. She knows someone was in the room.

Even though Emma successfully installed the camera, she's disappointed that absolutely nothing is happening in Daphne's room. She doesn't get it. Her boss interrupts to say she has "code green" meaning her brother is in the lobby. She goes down to see David and he asks her if she'd want to join his campaign. Emma says she'll think about it.

Back at the Ellsworths the family quickly rallies and moves onto Plan B. They "notice something" on Mr. Ellsworth's hand and clean it off, getting a thumbprint for the safe. "Milosh" is loving the photo shoot, but the necklace is outshining Mrs. Ellsworth. She removes the necklace and the Ellsworths quickly put it away. Charlie makes an adjustment to the photo equipment and "accidentally" blows the power. He heads off to find the breaker box, then slips into Mr. Ellsworth's office to open the safe. But things are all smooth sailing. The family dog Dutchess starts barking! He's about to get caught. Charlie and the family make their exit with "Milosh" acting frustrated and Mrs. Ellsworth apologizing for her husband. Charlie goes around the side of the house and calls for the Dutchess, who's wearing the necklace!

Emma goes home and has David great conversation with David. She suggests that present himself as the candidate he is instead of the candidate who polls well. Emma gets quiet then tells him she works for a government agency. That's why she keeps so many things private. He's surprised at the reveal but understands.

The Nicolettis take a brief moment to celebrate a successful mission, but as they look into it they learn the diamond in the necklace is stolen. It's Hindu and is a plundered cultural artifact. They know they can't sell it. Charlie decides to approach Mr. Ellsworth. He goes back to the house offering to sell back the necklace and admits he knows its history. He won't reveal the truth, but in an effort to save face, Ellsworth will. Charlie leaves with \$500 thousand.

Emma and Charlie get together again and she apologizes about her harsh words from the last time. She says she's not good at letting people in. Then she admits that it feels like Charlie can see through her and that's scary. "You might be the only person in the world who does."

Daphne comes to the bar to collect the cash. She tells them it's a good start but they have a long way to go. \$14.5 million to be exact. Birdie tells Daphne they're now serving mojitos then says, "please leave my daughter alone." Daphne tells her, "the only thing more dangerous than a man with nothing to lose is a single mom with something to prove."

Thinking they have a lead on what Daphne's up to, Emma and the team go to the docks and intercept a shipping container. But when they open it, it's empty. "She played us," someone says. Emma corrects them, "No she made us."

It turns out that the picture Charlie found in Daphne's room was of her mother and it was taken in Ireland... Daphne's not just an employee of McGuire, but she's also his daughter!

Daphne knows that Emma is after her. After the recent string of events, she calls McGuire (her father) and asks, "do you believe I have what it takes to run this organization?"

Summary: The Nicolettis persuade a wealthy woman to seek revenge on her con-man fiancé at a horse race. Emma meets Charlie's family, and the CIA and Nicolettis catch wind of Daphne expanding her business beyond the Maguire drug enterprise.



Charlie and his priest friend are playing 1 on 1 basketball and the subject of Emma comes up. As Charlie goes on about how she's smart and complicated but in the best way, a montage of their together plays. They're in bed a lot. He tells her he can see his Dad's memory slipping and that's been hard on the family. He teaches her some basic American Sign Language (ASL). They're having fun. His friend asks about the seriousness of the relationship. Charlie says, "can you be in love with someone you're lying to?" His friend asks it differently, "can you lie to someone you love?" Charlie says there's

no way she'd stick around if she knew the truth.

It's morning at Charlie's and Emma spent the night. She playfully asks if he makes everyone go out the back door. He says she can use the front but he lives next to sister and niece and she might bump into them. Emma goes out back. But she's not alone! Ollie is waiting there and signs, "are you robbing my uncle?" Emma says, "you must be Ollie" then signs "hello" and fingerspells her name. Ollie smiles and asks if Emma and Charlie have been kissing. Emma laughs and locks her lips indicating it's a secret.

Charlie goes to Birdie's and he notices she's getting a call from Ollie's dad Simon. Birdie says to decline it. She brings up Daphne and wonders why if she's Maguire's daughter, what does she need from them? Ollie comes in and asks about the woman wearing fancy clothes who keeps coming by the bar. Charlie says it's grown up stuff. Then Ollie asks about Emma. Birdie is surprised, and scolds her brother without signing. Ollie gets their attention and wants in on the

conversation. Birdie signs that Charlie's love life is a liability for the family. Leo and Fran come in and Ollie tells them about Emma, but Charlie is quick to change topics. He points out that the race track opens at 8am so they need to go. Before they leave, Ollie notices a tracking tag on her backpack and tells her mom, she's not a kid and doesn't need to be tracked. Birdie knows her daughter is responsible, but says she's still her mom and that Ollie can't hide from her.

At Baltimore Downs, Ollie and Grandpa Leo talk about horses as Charlie gets a call from Emma. She says she blew the plan to keep their relationship a secret. He knows, and now she has to meet the rest of the family. They're having a crab bake at the bar and he wants her to come. That is if she wants to and it's not moving too fast. She says it's the right speed.

Charlie meets with his pal "Frank" to discuss a potential job. This time they're going to sell a horse they don't own to a very wealthy woman. She won't even miss the money. Frank has done most of the work already and Charlie would get a 15% cut. He pushes for more and Frank says 20%. Charlie asks about the target. Her name is Martha Pope and she's a Venture Capitalist with "space money." Just then, she comes up and Frank remarks that he can't believe he gets to marry her. He goes on to say Charlie is the renowned horse trainer he'd been telling Martha about. She shakes his hand and Charlie introduces himself as Buck Callhoon.

At the CIA, Emma's at her desk and her coworker/assistant (sorry guys I can't find her name) makes small talk asking about Em's relationship status. Emma admits that she's going to fill out the E99 form claiming she's in a relationship. She finds a rubber bug/insect on a stack of papers, a joke referring to Daphne Finch playing the CIA at the docks. "Haha," Emma says, turning to the rest of the office. The CIA is in the dark on Daphne's actual role in McGuire's business, but her assistant points out Daphne is "sassy" for a mob lawyer considering the lengths she went to to make them look bad. Emma agrees. It seems like a really big move for someone who's there to clean things up and get out of town.

The Nicolettis discuss Martha as a target and while she's filthy rich, she's done a lot of good with her money too. They can't believe she's agreed to marry "Frank." The family is not feeling good about this job, and Charlie agrees. He says instead of going after Martha, their target is the con man.

The following day Frank brings Martha to the stables to check out Wicked Swift, the horse that's "for sale." Martha jokingly says that for a million dollar horse, she looks like a lot of other horses, but Charlie/Buck is quick to say she's so much more and she's a true winner. Birdie asks Leo if he's sure about selling and he says, "it's time." They tell Martha it was Leo's wife's horse, and the billionaire expresses condolences for their loss. Moving things along, Frank asks about what's "under the hood" and Fran comes in with health records. While he examines the documents, Birdie cozies up to Martha and asks about her relationship. Martha says it's been a whirlwind, they've only been together a few months and she can't remember her life before him. Frank interrupts saying the horse is better in person than on paper, just like Martha. She's flattered and agrees to the purchase. Birdie suggests they go celebrate and leave the guys to do the paperwork. Martha hesitates, but decides to go with her.

At the Hill house, the family is watching the latest attack ad about David running for Senate. The commercial says electing him will result in more of the same. More bad policies, tax hikes and a legacy of failure.

Joe says, "they go low, we go high." Grace is sarcastic, "Thanks Michelle." Emma says it's good advice, but Grace says the need to raise more money and tells David to start making phone calls. David takes a moment away from his campaign to ask about "the guy" Emma's seeing. She plays dumb and he points out that she hasn't been home all week and she's smiling a lot. For a spy she's not being very discreet. Emma smiles and says he doesn't have clearance for that info.

Emma meets a friend from another intelligence agency and asks what he knows. He says Emma needs to keep asking questions. He says he heard the streets are flooded with drugs and fentanyl is being sold at a discount. Emma thinks it's odd that the Maguires would be ok with losing money. Her friend suggests maybe they're dumping their stock now that Patrick Maguire has been arrested. Meanwhile, Daphne is making a deal with a buyer saying she'll sell to them for \$1 thousand per kilo. The buyer says he can turn around and sell it for 5x the price. She says she's looking to build partnerships with experienced professionals. "Next time we get a shipment, you don't like the price, you buy from someone else." He agrees.

Martha and Birdie enjoy champagne and Martha gushes about "Frank" and how they were engaged 3 weeks after meeting. Birdie tells her the truth, that they are supposed to be conning

her, and Frank is not who she thinks. His name is Jones Malone and he's been running a version of this scam since high school. Birdie guesses at how everything unfolded and Martha is shocked into silence. She asks what she's supposed to do and Birdie fills her in. Start with the truth to sell him a lie. He won't see it coming, because he doesn't think he'd fall for a con.

The women meet up with the others and Martha states she's not signing anything, this feels like a con. She doesn't know horses, but does know unfounded hype for IPO. She wants public validation, so they're going to race the horse. If the betting odds stay the same, she'll buy Wicked Swift for \$1 million. If the odds increase, she'll buy for up to \$2 million, but anything over 6:1 and she's out. Frank is surprised, but loves the thought of doubling his money.

In Belfast, Ireland, Connor is boxing at a gym when he gets a call from Daphne. He asks about the money. She tells him everything is under control. He tells her to make the money right or he'll have to come over.

David is busy making phone calls and telling potential donors he's not a carbon copy of his father. A vote for him is a vote for the future. Emma comes by on her way out and he tells her not to sweat it with her boyfriend's parents. He gets back to the phones and answers a call. A woman with an unknown number who calls herself Claire Fox says a committee is meeting about pulling support. She says she has a solution and invites him to meet for lunch then says, "I'm not who you think I am."

Charlie cleans the bar and tells Fran he's nervous about them meeting Emma. Daphne comes by asking about the money. He says he'll have it by Monday as promised. She's confrontational and says if he doesn't approve of her methods, maybe he'll approve of Connor's. He tells her to call Connor, and she's a bit panicked. There's no need, if Charlie keeps delivering, she'll keep Connor at bay. He tells Birdie what happened and that he doesn't like how Daphne walks in like she owns the place. Emma shows up and hits it off with everyone but Birdie who's avoiding her as much as possible. Leo has difficulty remembering where the lagers are stored, but Emma swoops in with a classy assist. Charlie's Priest friend tells him you said she was great, but you didn't say she was great.

Emma takes a call from her assistant who says a tall American woman has been having meetings with Maguire's rivals. They wonder to what end and think maybe she's trying to get out of the business after all. Courtney asks about the party and Emma tells her Birdie is not a fan.

Emma confronts Birdie and agrees to a game of darts. She says you can ask me anything you couldn't find online. You're protective of your brother, I am too. But she thinks Charlie is great. Charlie says she passed the family test with flying colors.

Frank/Jones comes to the bar and asks how much they could bump up the price on Wicked Swift? Charlie says \$1.7-1.8 million. Thinking about what he's about to do, Jones points out that love is the biggest con of all... and Charlie should know that. Next day at the track the team hustles and gets buzz going on Wicked Swift. They wind up with 7:1 odds. A comfy \$1.7 million.

Martha talks to Birdie and is hesitant, this is her life, it's not just money. She likes Frank. Martha asks him if instead of getting the horse they take the money and travel, take time off and be together. He says he really wants the horse, this is a once in a lifetime opportunity. She agrees, of course he's right. That's all she needs, she'll follow through with the double cross.

Emma is at the house and it's empty, David sent nearly all his team home. It's just the family and James wants to watch the derby. David's campaign manager interrupts and tells him quietly, they're below support, the campaign is dead. David wants to keep this info between them. He picks up his phone and agrees to have lunch with Claire Fox.

Back at the track, Leo chats up a friend at the bar and shows three large stacks of cash. He's sure he's walking out today with 6x what he has. His buddy puts \$100 thousand on Wicked Swift and the odds close at 4:1 or \$2,500,000. It's above Martha's cap. Charlie convinces Jones to put in half a million of his own money, "think of it as a 10 minute loan." They make the purchase and "Frank" slips away, telling Martha he wants to get a closer look at the horse they bought. But instead, he takes a taxi to the airport. Charlie asks Leo if they want to see how the race goes, he says he knows a 6th place horse when he sees one.

At home that night, Birdie comes into the living room looking at her phone. She's frantic. "Where's Ollie?" she asks Fran. Ollie appears, and Birdie asks why the tracker says she's across town. She signs that she's not a kid anymore. She put the tracker in Daphne's purse and signs, "You want to know what she's up to."

Birdie and Charlie check the tag locations and it turns out, Daphne's visiting rival cartels. Maybe making moves without Connor knowing? They call Connor and distort Charlie's voice, telling him Daphne's meeting with rivals. Charlie says, looks like your sister is going for your crown. Connor says he doesn't have a sister. "You sure about that?"

At the CIA Emma and her assistant discover Daphne has been making new deposits, but if she's selling to rivals, she must be working on something else. They wonder where her new revenue stream is coming from and decide to follow the money.

Frank/Jones learns there was a problem with the account and he's out half a million, now he's stiffing the Nicolettis. Charlie pretends he's mad and hangs up. He calls Emma and leaves a message wanting to talk to her about something. As he gets on his motorcycle two people in black clothes grab him as a van drives up. Two more jump out and haul him inside, covering his head with a sack.

The officer in the room with Charlie asks if he knows Emma Hill is a CIA officer. He's surprised but maintains his cool, "I do now." She asks if he's been to Central America. He

admits to being in Nicaragua and overstayed because he was in prison. He says he punched a military official and it was not his best moment. He didn't tell Emma because he didn't want her to think less of him.

Emma and Charlie are sitting in her car and her voice is fuzzy as she apologizes about the situation. The agency needed to interrogate him because she declared they were in a relationship. Her voice clears, "are we good?" "Yeah."

Charlie returns to the bar. His family was worried because he's been silent for 12 hours. He defensively says he was with Emma. Birdie tells him they found the keys in his bike and it scared them, plus the Maguires are getting antsy about their money.

Emma returns home and David asks if he can put her down for plus one at his campaign fundraiser dinner. She agrees. Joe comes in and says the new polling numbers are strong. He's proud of his son. As he looks over the sheet again, he sees Claire Fox's name. He says that her support, "is not the kind you want. It always comes at a cost."

After being tipped off by Charlie that Daphne is his half-sister, Connor comes to the U.S. He tells her from now on they're doing things his way. She tells him the Feds are watching. He doesn't care and reveals that he knows the truth. "If you think being the boss' bastard is gonna get you a seat at the table sister, it won't." He reiterates that he's here to clean up her mess.

Birdie and Charlie share a moment at the bar and she admits that she didn't hate Emma. In fact she liked her. Leo pipes up that everybody loved her. Their conversation is interrupted by Daphne, who wants to know when she'll see the next payment. She needs more money now. Charlie suggests that instead of paying her back in half million increments, he gets her \$10 million by the end of the week and their deal is done. There's a high stakes underground poker game on a yacht where he'll get the money. Daphne agrees that if Charlie can pull it off, "we're square."

The family is a bit taken about by Charlie's solution. Birdie reminds him it's very dangerous, that's why we've not done it before. They couldn't figure out a way to get out with the money and would likely be killed in international waters.

Charlie gets a voicemail from Emma saying she's sorry followed by an invitation to David's fundraiser. Leo finds his son and asks why he wants to do such a risky job? "You expect us to just fall in line?" Charlie says he saw an opportunity and that he's going to do what needs to be done to care for his family. He tells Leo that he can't lie to Emma for much longer, the truth is going to find them. He says he never wanted to go straight until her. Leo agrees that they can't move on with Daphne in their lives. He tells Charlie that when it's the one, you go all in; then shares his ideas for their yacht con.

At the CIA, Cas and Emma get a hit on one of Connor's aliases, Matthew Damone. They wonder why he's back stateside.

Daphne tells Connor that they can expand the operation, but they have to work together. She clarifies that she didn't hunt down Patrick Maguire, he showed up at her mom's funeral. She wants to do for their business what Bezos did for books. Daphne's idea is to unite street level ops for distribution. She says if they sell at a loss and undercut the competition, their rivals will become weak and dependent on them instead of the Mexican cartels. We don't build our own network, she says, we steal theirs. She tells Connor she's not the enemy and there is room for both of them. "We could make a lot of money together." Connor agrees that he likes money, but he wants to know how she makes up for their losses.

Leo and Charlie reveal that they know how to get out of the yacht heist alive. A wealthy man, Robert Renway frequently hosts high stakes poker games on his yacht. Fran, Birdie and Leo will get on the boat as waiters and a dealer while Charlie posing as "Ernesto Ricci" gets invited to play. But first, Ricci needs to get on Renway's radar and Charlie is going to show he's legit with a million dollar buy-in in a different game. They'll have to use their Pastor Earl money, and that's all they have.

"Ernesto" wins his game and as expected, Renway introduces himself. Ernesto says the game was good but he's looking for high stakes. Birdie radios in not to push it. Fortunately, Renway gives Ernesto his card. The con is on.

At the fundraiser, Emma gives Charlie the rundown on her family, stressing that her mom, Grace will be a challenge. They ask about his occupation and Charlie says he owns a bar with his family. Grace grabs his arm and takes him for a private conversation. Joe tells Emma not to be hard on her mom. She tells him Charlie is different. Emma looks around the room and asks about a woman she doesn't recognize. It's Claire Fox and Joe calls her, "a shark in the water."

Oh damn! Robert Renway is at the fundraiser dinner and sees "Ernesto." The men exchange greetings as Emma comes up. Fortunately, no one uses their names. Grace and Joe see the exchange from inside the house and she tells Joe she likes Charlie. He's not too sure. Charlie is too smooth.

Claire introduces David to her colleague Jennifer West and says she'd make a great addition to the campaign. David is surprised but doesn't decline.

Joe and Charlie have a chat and Joe doesn't hold back, he says he's wary of anyone who has all of the right answers. "What's your angle Charlie?" Emma and Grace intercept and Charlies assure Emma it's fine. She walks him out and he thanks her for having his back. She goes back inside and Charlie waves to Renway as he leaves.

Ernesto shows up to the yacht game and Renway greets him warmly. He says what's mine is yours, and Ernesto says he'll remember that. As the events unfold, we hear Charlie discussing

the plans for the heist with his family. The cash is being held in a guarded room and they'll need to cause a distraction.

Leo is the dealer at Ernesto's table. He wins the first game, but then his luck turns. Fran comes by with drinks and Leo slips, calling her by her name, but she makes a savvy cover. Ernesto loses and can't handle it. Renway tells him to take a walk. Birdie hacks into the guard's phone and sends an urgent text. With the room unguarded, Fran, Birdie and Charlie take the money. They're running out of time and Fran creates a further distraction. When the guard returns, the money is gone!

Ernesto returns for another game, right as Renway and his team learn they've been robbed. A dummy boat sails away from the yacht and as the Renway's men chase it down. Fran and Birdie get away with two trash cans full of money.

Connor meets up with one of Daphne's men and inquires where she's getting the extra money.

Fran tells Leo they have to talk, he broke cover during their heist, they can't will away his health problems. He tries to shake it off telling her they walked away with \$10 million, "I can't be slipping that much."

Emma has been keeping tabs on Connor and meets up with an FBI contact. He says Connor is heading to the airport. She asks about the quick turnaround, why he's leaving so soon. They decide to follow him.

They make eye contact. He knows it's her, but did she figure out it's him??

Connor calls Daphne and asks why she's working with the man who ripped them off? He says she's not part of this family and if she wants what's his, she can come and get it.

Charlie tells his family he might have gotten made. They ask if someone saw his face. He said he had the mask down, but he's got a feeling... The family says let's not panic until we have a reason to panic.

There's a knock on Charlie's apartment door, it's Emma. He asks if everything is good and she tells him she thinks she caught a lead on her case. They kiss, and she asks if he's ok. She says she knows this week was a lot but thinks it's worth it. "I think so too," Charlie says.

Charlie calls his friend at the scrap yard and insists he crush the car. "I need it to disappear." Birdie overhears and asks what's got him worried. Charlie says he's being extra careful and to have mom keep Ollie at Uncle Gio's for a few more days while dust settles on the last job. Birdie

tells him Daphne is there. Daphne wants the Nicoletti's to con Baylor to get access to his book of secrets. Leo says they're all paid up, but Daphne disagrees, says they called Connor in to undermine her. She gives them just a phone number for Baylor then tells them he's a cold war relic. "Good luck, you're going to need it."

The family discusses their situation and Leo says spying on a spy is nearly impossible. Looks like they'll have to hire him. Charlie says he's got a "tip" his "friend" Ray Tipton Jr. (RTJ) is checking out of a posh hotel after a wild night with details he'll want buried. Leo jokes that RTJ is a worse human than his father was a VP. Birdie says they'll slip Baylor a phone filled with delicious blackmail—and malware—that will give them access to his computer and files.

The next day at the hotel the Nicoletti's get to work making the room a mess for Baylor's arrival. Charlie poses as RTJ and Birdie as his girlfriend. Baylor tells them to start cleaning the place up.

David has a meeting with his campaign team which now includes Claire Fox's friend, Jen. Jen points out the need to reach the Gen Z crowd with better social content. Joe pulls David aside and says "don't tell me this was Claire Fox." David points out that she supported the campaign, but Joe tells him, don't assume this is for you. She always has another agenda.

Back at the hotel, Baylor tells Birdie that the woman pays the price. Always. She should take the money he's giving her and forget everything that ever happened. Just then "RTJ" gets a call from the junkyard. The feds are there and the car is still on the lot. He says he can give them the grand tour so Charlie can come by and take care of the car. Charlie leaves the hotel. Baylor uses a spy camera to take pictures of Birdie's phone, then puts it in the microwave.

Damn! Trying to improvise, Birdie says Baylor needs to give her a ride since he killed her phone. He agrees.

Charlie gets to the lot and swaps license plates on the car, right as Emma and Mason make their way over. For added distraction, he calls Emma and they agree to meet later that night. She approaches the car, moments after Charlie sneaks away.

Birdie has a mini breakdown in Baylor's car expressing how heartbroken she is over RTJ. Baylor says let the past stay the past. She comments about how he must see a lot of people with regrets in this line of work. He pulls over for her to get out and tells her the sob story needs work. "I have more on you than you do on me." Back home, Birdie asks why Charlie is not at the hotel. He tells her the night ended early. Her phone rings and it's her ex, Simon. She doesn't answer, but it shows she has 3 missed calls.

Charlie asks if they had any luck with Baylor's black book. There are still 200 lockers to check out in 34 buildings. She then changes the subject and tells Charlie she knows he's been lying. What's going on? He doesn't think it's going to work out with Emma. She doesn't know about their secret lives. He's got to let it go and let the past stay the past. At the bar, Ollie tries to pick the lock to the basement. Birdie catches her and says it's only kegs and mousetraps down there. Fran comes by and says it's only a matter of time before she gets down there. Then they'll have to have "the talk."

Emma finds a manilla envelope addressed to her at the house. She opens it and finds a series of pictures.

The Nicolettis go over their plan to acquire the painting. Simon and Birdie have tickets to a high-end Salon at Mr. Abramov's penthouse. Charlie will be on van duty, while Birdie will lift the painting. The event is very classy and Birdie reports little security. She scans the layout to Charlie and notes there aren't even lasers protecting the art on display.

Emma has a serious conversation with Joe and shows him the pictures. They are old photos of him with Claire Fox. He admits to an affair and says he came clean to her mom. What he didn't know was that Claire had hired a spy to trail them. The affair was a black mark on his Senate career. The envelope also contains a card that reads "Roylson 8 pm." Joe asks why someone would send the pictures to Emma. Then it clicks. "You don't work in logistics do you?"

At the Salon, Simon tells Birdie he's been sober for 2+ years then the duo mingles at the event while an opera singer entertains the guests. Charlie tells Birdie Simon is playing her, but she says she knows what she's doing and takes out the earpiece. He tells her she's always seen things as black and white, while for a politician, everything is grey. There's an answer, but she hasn't found it yet.

Charlie tells Birdie what he discovered at the storage unit and if the feds find out, the Nicoletti's are definitely going down. Just then, Emma comes in and asks Charlie to work for her and take Daphne down. He says if he does this, she's definitely not going to like him. She says she doesn't like him now, so there's nothing to lose.

Charlie goes to Daphne and gives her an envelope with the location of \$2 million worth of unregistered firearms along with the contact information for Brad Willford. Daphne is impressed and he tells her he can do so much more for her. He knows she wants the "Maguire Throne" and he can help her get it. She smiles.

Charlie has agreed to work as an asset for Emma and help her bring Daphne down. Daphne has taken Charlie up on his offer to show her what he can really do and she wants to return the Blennir painting to Brad Willford. Why? She wants to attend an elite event at Pine Grove. Emma says it's a National Defense gathering where the 1% of the 1% set the national security agenda behind closed doors. Willford, who works for American Armory, will be a featured speaker and Daphne wants him to sell her weapons.

Charlie will go undercover as Brook Stern Jr. Emma tells Cas and Mason about her asset and their plan, but doesn't say who he is. Charlie rehearses the character with Emma. She wants him to figure out Daphne's plan and where she's moving weapons. Emma warns him about the high security and says to wear the coms at all times. As they finalize details he asks her, "So that's it? Last week you said you loved me." "Last week you were a bartender."

Leo and Fran are uncertain about being CIA informants. They wish Charlie would have asked them first, but Birdie feels a bit more positive. She says Charlie's love life may solve their problems.

Birdie heads up to her house and Leo follows. She asks what happened when Simon left. Leo tells her he was in town and Birdie was bartending late. Simon was passed out, high, and baby Ollie was in the bathtub. The water was freezing and she was turning blue. When Simon woke

up, Leo said he'd had enough chances. He can ruin his own life, but not Ollie and Birdie's. He threatened him with a loaded gun saying, "get clean or I'll kill you." Leo didn't tell Birdie because she would have gone back. "I did what you couldn't." Ollie comes home from school, breaking the tension and ending the conversation.

Daphne and Charlie get the invite to Pine Grove and head to the West Virginian retreat together. She asks why she doesn't have a cover, and Charlie says she doesn't need one. The duo is posing as business partners and Emma warns him to stick to Daphne like a shadow.

The first thing on their agenda is for Daphne to meet with Willford. Charlie tries to tag along, but Daphne stops him. "Business partners' is only a cover." Willford arrives and asks about Grigroy Abramov. She says he's on his way back to Russia because illegal arms dealing is a violation of his A-1 Visa. Willford asks if this is a shake down, but she's interested in the M2010 Sniper Rifle that his company makes. With her capital and shipping routes, they can move 10x what Grigroy was able to handle. Willford crushes her spirits. He says for every 100 M2010s that American Armory makes, only 3 can disappear otherwise higher ups start asking questions. He agrees he likes money, but wants to stay out of prison.

Meanwhile Charlie attends a session about End Use Monitoring that explains the goal of keeping weapons out of the hands of enemies. Emma asks for an update and Charlie says Daphne ditched him. Emma says get her to open up. He's good at that. Charlie finds Daphne at the bar and orders some mojitos, but Daphne says she doesn't like them, she was just messing with Birdie. He asks for negronis instead and Daphne's impressed, she loves them. He says he knows. Emma's jealous. As she's listening, her FBI pal Vik Singh comes over and says hi. He's at the retreat running countersurveillance. He knows Daphne is here and the feds are to give her plenty of space. He asks if that was her doing. Emma says she can't confirm or deny.

Back in Baltimore, Bridie and Simon meet to discuss the past. She confronts him, saying he could have killed their daughter. Simon admits his fault and says leaving was the only way he knew he couldn't hurt them. If it wasn't for Leo he never would have left. "You were the best parts of my life." Birdie says she spent 10 years wondering what went wrong. Simon apologizes, but he had to be sure he was sober before reaching out. He asks if he can be some small part of Ollie's life.

Daphne says they can't do the arms deal because Willford can only siphon off a handful of weapons. Charlie says they can try to control the supply, have American Armory discontinue the M2010s and then Willford will have enough to sell to them. She wants to know how he plans to have them stop manufacturing a profitable weapon? Charlie says everyone wants one of three things: money, power or respect. They need to learn what the CEO of American Armory desires.

The next day, Daphne talks with Henry Scoals of American Armory. Turns out he grew up in a rural community and while he was always interested in science, he followed the biggest paycheck. She asks about improving weapons. He's interested but needs someone else to foot the bill.

Congressman Eisenberg is the defense subcommittee chair and Daphne and Charlie believe they can get him to support positioning money behind new weapons. Unfortunately, they can't get close to him, but maybe they can charm his husband? Charlie and Daphne hit the dance floor and casually chat up the couple. Eisenberg and his husband agree to a game of pickleball the following day.

Eisenberg wants respect. He brings a balanced perspective to defense and doesn't like war. Charlie asks his thoughts on End Use Monitoring, or remotely controlling weapons? The congressman doesn't have the budget support, but his husband points out there's no oversight on earmarks. Eisenberg could be the new face of modern warfare.

Fran asks Birdie about her fight with Leo. Birdie wishes her dad would have told her what happened. Fran said they talked a lot about what to do and she was happy Simon left. She says they wanted to spare Birdie the fear of that night. Fran gently says, "you wouldn't know anything about keeping your kid in the dark..."

Emma and Vik talk about how they got into the line of work and Emma says she always thought the job found her. She likes the idea of right and wrong, but wonders if, "bad guys are bad because we chase them?"

Charlie and Daphne talk about their plan. Scoals will make a new weapon, congress shows up with cash, now they need the Department of Defense (DOD) to award American Armory a contract. Daphne says the DOD undersecretary was one of her professors at Columbia. She's

confident they'll be able to get an invitation to dinner and can convince him End Use Monitoring is the future.

They toast to getting Daphne what she wants. She asks how Charlie got into this line of work? He said two generations of his family were tailors and then Leo was a steelworker. After he lost his job he discovered that grifting kinda worked. So long as the guy above him was cheating him it seemed okay to do it back. Daphne points out that this is the most committed relationship she's had. Charlie says he was seeing someone but she broke his heart. He asks Daphne if she's after money, power, or respect? "Nice try Charlie, but I'm not the mark".

In Baltimore, Birdie tells Ollie that Simon wants to meet her. Ollie asks why he's taken so long to reach out. Birdie signs that he was trying to get sober. Ollie is surprised, it took 10 years? She asks what she should do and Birdie says that's her decision.

Dalton Bridges is the DOD undersecretary and his talk is about supply chain securities. He notes that cobalt is held up in places like Congo and one resolution is to arm and empower the individual regions. Daphne approaches after his speech, but he doesn't seem to recognize her. However, he does spot Charlie's Yale secret society lapel pin and that's enough to get them an invitation. Daphne is upset. She tells Charlie that back in the day, Bridges called her term paper a game changer, but he doesn't remember her? Charlie agrees it's not fair, but should that stop her?

They have another heart to heart and she talks about how her mom had to take a second job as janitor. When she couldn't get a sitter, Daphne would lie on a blanket and watch her mom clean office bathrooms. Charlie says it's humbling to see your parents struggle. He tells her Leo has dementia. Daphne was finishing her undergrad when her mom got cancer. She deferred a year and thought she could help, but she only watched her mom waste away. Patrick Magurie showed up at the funeral and said he was her father. He offered to pay for her MBA and she took the opportunity. Just then someone brings "Mr. Stern" the official paper invitation to a special dinner with Bridges. Daphne tells Charlie that when it comes to money, power, and respect, she wants it all. "Let's go get it."

Before dinner, Emma meets up with Charlie and lets him know Bridges is ex CIA, he'll be able to spot any holes in Charlie's cover. She then asks if the story about his family was true or a way to get Daphne to talk? He says it's both, and there was a lot he wanted to tell Emma. They have a moment, then she says to be careful.

Vik and the FBI detect an interference signal. Someone is running surveillance and they need to pinpoint the source. He comes to Emma's cabin and tells her about the unauthorized bug. They have to check her room. She complies and then carefully knocks her earpiece out and crushes it with her shoe.

Charlie heads to the special dinner and is greeted by a hooded man. He shows the invitation and is allowed in. Bridges approaches and asks Charlie what brings him to the retreat. Daphne goes to visit Patrick Maguire in prison, filling him in on the business. He mentions Connor and how he's gone

to Mexico. Daphne says he took the \$10 million she was going to reinvest, but Maguire says he's not playing favorites with his kids, however, he'd appreciate someone getting him out of prison. Daphne visits with a Judge and offers details to an offshore account for letting "her client" out. She's paying more than he's accepted for similar bribes, but he says he doesn't work with criminals and leaves.

Daphne invites Charlie over to her new place, and asks him to apply pressure on the D.C. Circuit Judge to release Maguire. Meanwhile Emma and Birdie are listening in to the conversation and have their own discussion about Charlie. Birdie wonders if this is hard for Emma, but she insists she's doing her job, he needs to win Daphne's trust. Birdie tells Emma she's trying to protect her brother and doesn't like the way Daphne or Emma have been treating him.

Charlie returns to the bar where Leo and Fran are hosting a group of Leo's steelworker buddies who recently lost one of their own. Fran asks Charlie to make sure Leo gets to his neurologist appointment on time the following day and he agrees. Emma and Birdie return and Emma asks to debrief Charlie. He's about to take her to the basement, but Leo asks them to go outside since they're having a private party. Fran tells Emma, Leo's not a fan of "G-men."

Emma and Charlie step out and he tries to explain why his dad is so uncomfortable. She comments that Charlie's past must be why he's so comfortable around crime. She asks what his

plan is with the Judge, and he hopes to catch him slipping up so that Daphne can turn him. He points out that both women want the same thing, to get Maguire out of prison. Except Emma's end goal is to take them down.

At the Hill house, Joe tells Emma he's not seen any pictures of him and Claire Fox on the front page... does this mean she found another way to solve her dilemma? She smiles and nods but doesn't elaborate. David, Grace and Jen arrive back from campaigning and Emma asks how it went. He doesn't want to give the stump speech again, but Jen says he did great and this is the momentum they need for November. There's something between them and Joe and Emma pick up on it. They ask Grace how long it's been going on and she's not quite sure, but thinks David and Jen are good for each other. Joe tells her Jen was hired because of Claire Fox and Grace sighs. "I thought that woman was done trying to ruin our family."

The next morning, Birdie is readying the bar and asks Charlie about Leo getting to his appointment. Leo said it was rescheduled, but something doesn't seem right. Birdie checks the tracking on her phone to discover their dad is in Virginia. He's alone and Charlie sets out to find him.

Leo is in Falls Church, VA where he's golfing. He tells Charlie something came up and points to another golfer. The man is Davey Solum and he's responsible for losing Leo's pension. Charlie calls him out for doing a job alone, but Leo references his son's current position with the CIA. He says Davey owes him \$208 thousand or the would be value of his retirement fund. Charlie can help or not, but Leo's getting what he's owed.

Leo approaches Solum on the course and Charlie poses as one of the Club's caddies. They apologize for getting in his way and ask to play the back 9 holes together. Davey agrees. Leo tells Charlie that the watch Davey's wearing is about as much as his lost pension. The men tee up and talk careers with Davey dissing the steelworkers unions. Leo asks if Davey wants to make things interesting and play for \$5 thousand a hole. Davey suggests \$10 thousand.

At the Hills, Joe and Grace confront David about Jen and he's offended. He says he's smart enough to know if his girlfriend is duping him. He's not like other politicians who can't keep it in their pants. Grace says there's a reason they don't trust Claire Fox, and David is shocked to learn the truth. Joe says they didn't tell him because they didn't think their son would make a deal with her. David says he got into politics for his father's legacy, but for once he's grateful he's not Joe.

Leo is having an unlucky streak losing to Solum on the last four holes. He says double or nothing on this next one which would result in \$100 thousand. Solum agrees and while Leo winds up in a sand trap, he's able to recover and wins the hole. Solum is interrupted by a call from his kids, and Charlie tells his dad they need to walk away. But Leo's not having it. He bets Solum \$200 thousand he can make the same winning putt again. Leo and Charlie leave the golf course with a check that basically covers his pension. Emma comes to the house to see Birdie and finds Charlie on the porch. She says they missed him today and asks if everything is ok with Leo. He gives her a brief rundown and she's surprised. She can't protect him if they are running other cons. Birdie comes out and invites Emma in for a drink. Emma says she thinks it's time they move on from surveillance to logistics and hands Birdie a flash drive with financial records for the Judge. Birdie is excited and Emma says "at least one Nicoletti trusts me." Birdie tells her that's not true. Charlie never tells anyone the truth, but he did tell Emma. He basically sacrificed himself for her. Emma doesn't know what to do with this information.

Leo apologizes to Charlie for not giving him a choice in their con life, but Charlie's ok with it. Fran comes in with their friend Shelby whose father recently passed. Leo sidebars with Fran and Charlie about going back to Solum to recover money for all the pensions. Maybe they can get everyone together and convince Solum to spend money to save money. Another friend walks in and Leo tells him he's got a job for the old crew. Fran tells Shelby she'll want in too.

Emma and Birdie discover interesting findings in the Judge's tax returns. It looks like he

accepts bribes from "respectable" criminals. He's got an upcoming ruling on a business run by a Korean family and Birdie thinks Emma is the perfect candidate to bribe him. She poses as a wealthy heiress and confronts him outside the courthouse. He quickly caves.

Fran, Charlie and the crew meet up at an active construction site they'll be staging as a wing they're building as part of a hospital. Meanwhile, Leo heads to the golf course and meets up with Solum. He tears up the check and saying he doesn't need the money any more than Solum does, then goes on to tell him about the hospital. Solum asks for the tour now, and they head over to the site. Fran poses as the foreman and Leo makes a little slip up referencing steelwork, but seems to recover. Solum needs to talk to his business partners, but he might be willing to fork over \$10 million to his name on the building. On his way out, one of the workers calls him "Davey" even though they weren't introduced.

David and Jen are on a date at the tennis courts and he brings up Claire Fox and asks how her family knows her. Jen says she's not sure her parents are part of so many campaigns. She asks what he's really getting at and he tells her Claire has history with his father. Jen says it won't be an issue if she's not on David's campaign. She can work anywhere, but there's only one David and she really likes him.

Daphne confronts the Judge in a parking garage as he's leaving for the night. She tells him she offered him the same account the heiress did. Does he want to be bribed or blackmailed? She says he's going to rule in favor of Patrick Maguire then leaves.

Leo calls Fran as he heads back to the bar. He says to tell the guys they still have Solum on the hook and... the day wasn't a total bust. He got Solum's watch! As he puts it back in his pocket, the cops show up and take him to the station for questioning.

Birdie calls Simon to thank him for not fighting her on Ollie's part in the job. He knows she wouldn't put their daughter in danger and wouldn't ask if Ollie wasn't ready.

Emma tells Grace she read the memoir and thought it was good, honest. She was expecting a fluff piece and was pleasantly surprised. Grace said they've tried to be perfect for too long, it's time to be real. Emma asks how she trusted Joe again, and Grace says she still loved him. Trust is a choice. Emma says she's stuck on the forward because it's not about legacy, but rather a love story.

Leo shakes Frankie's hand and tells him to sell their bar.
