The episode begins with an old man, Ralf, listening to a tape recorder and trying to emulate the voice. With a nametag on and a muttering mantra, Ralf walks away, gun stashed down his pants. As the camera pans over however, it's clear this is an imposter. The real Ralf is dead on the sofa, a cord wrapped round his neck.

We're in Munich, and there's an assassination about to take place by the infamous Jackal. This master in disguise shows up at Ralf's work, posing as a cleaner, and attempts to kill Elias, who

happens to be Manfred Fest's son. As a quick history lesson, this guy is a far-right politician and Manfred Fest is the current frontrunner to be the next German Chancellor. The hit on Elias' life is botched, and he manages to get away with just a few injuries.

The Jackal does kills a good number of security guards before making his getaway, ziplining down from the roof.

Back home, this master of disguise takes off his mask and prepares for the real assassination. Elias was just the bait, and not the real target. The Jackal has a sniper all primed and ready to go, and he hits with pinpoint accuracy. The police suss out which apartment block the shooter is at, but the Jackal waits a couple of seconds longer so the security can see the glint from the scope on purpose.

When they show up, the Jackal happens to have a bomb stashed under the bed. He does hit the fire alarm on his way out, which is a nice touch to show where his morals lie, wanting to vacate "innocents" before killing the authorities. Not only that, but the car in the garage also blows too. Mission accomplished.

Over in London, at the MI6 Headquarters, we meet the arrogant and largely outspoken Bianca. She begins searching through the gun and finds it linking back to Germany. Bianca lives at home with her husband, Paul, and daughter Jasmine. They watch the news where it brings up the gunman using a sniper and the single bullet that took out the German politician.

Bianca has the bit between her teeth and heads to work, where she's incredulous over the fact this building was 2.3 miles away. She doesn't think it's possible but we obviously know that it is. Snipers are apparently "her patch" and she wants to be in on the case. She's pretty brash and outspoken, and argues back with the German intelligence agent, Werner, on the call. Bianca is adamant that this weapon must have been broken down, which we know it was.

Bianca knows there's a gunmaker that's been trying to get this done for a long time, called Norman Stoke. He's from Northern Ireland and been on the run since the Stockholm assassination in 2018. Bianca believes she can find Stoke and tries to connect the dots, being a bit sarcastic in the process. It's the only lead they have and she has an asset called Allison Sparrow in Belfast, whom she believes will help them out.

The Jackal leaves Nuremberg, heading for Paris, and he doesn't seem out the ordinary. He wears glasses, puts on another accent, and even has a box with an ivory chess set inside too, which he shows the border patrol agent. He effortlessly makes it past security and heads to an internet cafe, where he has another job lined up. There's \$10 million on the line and the Jackal wants \$1 million upfront to meet in person.

Bianca leaves for Belfast without even consulting her family. She's flaking on Parent's evening and after making her quick apologies, visits Sparrow. She throws her weight around and has Allison find the details surrounding where Norman Stoke is, partly through her partner Larry, who happens to be his brother.

Bianca just about makes the final plane back home. Jasmine is not happy and can't even look at her mum, understandably so, and Bianca knows she's messed up too.

Bianca wants to try and prod Sparrow into cooperating, and part of that comes from riling up a leftist radical group, fronted by a girl called Emma. This is Sparrow's daughter, and Bianca uses her to get to Norman Stoke. However, Emma ends up having a cardiac arrest behind bars and she's taken to the hospital. Bianca's plan backfires.

As for the Jackal, he ends up in Sweden, where he meets his contact, Leonore, and gets the lowdown on his next target. It's a brief meeting, one that eventually sees him showing up back home, which is in Spain. He has a wife called Nuria, who's delighted to see him. However, the Jackal still hasn't received the funds from the Munich hit though, and he chats with his contact again. However, he receives the message "FUCK YOU" in reply.

tion is on the line and he starts to plot his revenge.



The episode begins with a look at the political landscape in Germany. It's in tatters, to be frank. Many are calling for the upcoming elections to be suspended in light of the assassination. As for Bianca, she receives a call from Allison, who's livid over Emma being behind bars. The thing is, Emma is actually dead but Bianca doesn't tell Allison for fear of messing up her operation. She uses this as leverage to get Norman Stoke's phone number.

However, this death is on Bianca's head, which isn't great. MI6 are going to clear up the mess, but while some want to close down the case, for now Sparrow is their only lead so they're going to keep this pretence going for the time being.

Meanwhile, the Jackal (whose name here is apparently Charles but who knows what's real!) has his next target, which happens to be the tech mogul, Ulle Dag Charles (UDC). He's also intent on finding who's withholding the money from him. While he works to get his funds back, he's intrigued by this other job to tide his family over. He has a strict no-posting rule for social media too, keeping himself anonymous, which we see during a family dinner. It's not just Nuria wrapped up in this though, he also has a son too.

The Jackal gets the details surrounding the origin of the funds, and it's coming from Munich. He leaves right in the middle of his son's birthday party, which Nuria is not happy about. Still, she drives him out to the airport all the same. This seems to be a regular occurrence, given Nuria senses he's "in the zone".

For the Jackal, this is serious. He has a whole number of different passports for different nationalities, he's an expert with languages... and he drives right past Nuria in a taxi and she

notices while heading home. She's rattled that her husband is keeping secrets and worries that he may be cheating.

The origin of this hit on UDC happens to be coming from New York. The shadowy businessmen there contemplate whether he's worth investing and bringing in, with the crux of the issue being UDC's new project, River. The tech mogul is promising "global economic justice", and he intends to redistribute wealth. That comes from total financial transparency for everyone to see. While he himself has nothing to hide, he knows that others most certainly do.

Bianca is on the case and does some serious digging on this one. Using her contacts and tenacity, she tracks down the make of a bag, which the Jackal has conveniently ripped the logo off of. She deduces, from this, and the accuracy of the sniper shot, that the guy they're after is British and potentially ex-army.

Bianca has all the details, and she decides to do some digging into the army bases around the UK. Specifically, looking out for exceptional candidates with sniper rifles and those who are right-handed.

With the group in on this, Sparrow pulls through and gets Norman's number, handing it over to Bianca. She finds out that Norman Stoke is in Belarus, so off she goes. She knows full well that she's jumping head-fist into the lion's den.

Allison manages to get Norman's number while the Jackal also decides to go ahead with the UDC hit. He and Leonore bargain on the final number, eventually agreeing that the job needs to be done by the 28th, before the official release of River. The Jackal is warned not to attract any attention either. This is, of course, easier said than done, given he's out for blood. For now though, Rodin is the codeword for UDC and Jackal is going to be the codeword for, well, the Jackal.

Our killer finds out that the payment withheld to him was made from a company account, called HelleLinie from the looks of it. He follows the trail back to two names — Hans Lange and Elias Fest. The same Elias of course, whom he spared in Munich.

Speaking of trails, Bianca follows hers but realizes that Norman was waiting for them all along. There are bombs rigged on the doors and with her teammates down, Norman slips away. Bianca does, however, find the suitcase that Charles initially used outside in the woods. She stuffs it in the back of her car, along with her dead teammates, and heads back to MI6, ready for the firestorm that's coming her way.

The episode starts with Allison receiving the news about Emma. She and her partner, Larry Stoke, head off, while Bianca goes back to work. She's had the suitcase investigated, and then brings this to her superiors. They immediately reprimand her for the botch snatch and the deaths on her hands.

Bianca ignores all of this, doesn't even bat an eyelid to the deaths, and shows off how the suitcase is actually holding a sniper rifle in disguise. Isabel sees this and backtracks, deciding that the opera-

tion is still on thanks to new evidence coming to light. Outside, Bianca rings Allison and apologizes. She wants to sit down and explain herself, and for them to do it face to face.

Meanwhile, the Jackal is on the hunt and he bugs a computer with a remote surveillance device at Mahkler. He poses as an old man to do so, struggling to walk, which brings us nicely along to Elias, who's similarly desperate to walk but remains adamant about getting back on his feet again.

The Jackal's target is Elias, and he finds the name of his driver, Stefan Wolf, to attack. He rings Nuria just before though, who questions him about whether he's having an affair. The Jackal shows off the room he's in, and finds his situation difficult. With Nuria begging to be with him and wanting him home, the Jackal has no answers and it all ends without anything resolved.

Nuria is desperate for answers though and she's a woman possessed. She knows there's something untoward here and goes digging through her husband's things. She finds a hidden safe in the floor, and also a hidden locked door too.

Back in London, Allison shows up, grief-stricken and angry. Bianca is nonchalant and instead brings up that Larry's number was on Norman's phone, believing that assisting an offender would

result in jailtime. She claims that she's "helping" but of course Bianca was also responsible, indirectly, for Emma's death, so Allison is not playing ball. However, Larry is angry that night when he realizes Allison has given out Norman's number and betrayed him, and he takes his anger out on her.

Back at work, Bianca is questioned over her mental state by a guy called Carver. She brings up here that Bianca's mother is an alcoholic, living in sheltered accommodation which she's currently paying for. The general thinking here is that she was paid to help fund her mother by feeding information to an assassin. Bianca is incredulous to this claim but she's definitely in the hotseat right now. There appears to be a leak inside the Embassy and the only ones who knew about the operation are Isabel, OC and Damian so it could be any of them.

While she works on this, Bianca does learn that a flurry of messages leading up to Manfred's death came from a codename of Jackal. She's also trying to figure out what this Rodin means too.

Speaking of which, in Munich the Jackal has a bomb prepped, ready to kill Elias. He poses as Stefan Wolf, killing the real driver after making him get in the trunk of a car. He takes off with Elias after picking him up. Elias admits to hiring the Jackal to kill his dad, and just like Elias did with the Jackal, he smirks and retorts "Fuck you" before killing him. With a change of clothes, the Jackal takes off after setting a bomb to blow in the car.

Allison begrudgingly decides to help Bianca after all, while Nuria enlists her family's help to break into the hidden room in their house. Inside, Nuria finds face moulds, guns, passports and stacks of cash. Unfortunately, she's being watched as the Jackal has cameras set up and he realizes that she's onto him now.

The episode starts with the media scrambling after Elias' assassination. A meeting is called at MI6, where the news about the Jackal being hired by Elias to kill Manfred is all the rage. They also know the reason for his death, and although the call itself was not recorded, Bianca thinks there could be something here.

The Jackal makes it to France, where there's definite heat all round Europe. This is something made all the trickier when the Jackal ends up crashing into a truck when he's not watching the road

properly. He has a French ID, under the name of Anthony, and when the police show, he kills the officer and the truck driver too. The Jackal is definitely getting sloppy, but he stages the scene to make it look like the two killed one another.

Back at MI6, Bianca learns that the Jackal is on the move again. OC's American contact has picked up chatter that there's another hit going to happen but they need to find a lead — and soon. This could come in the form of an ex-Army operative called George Hans, but Bianca keeps Damian at arm's length, believing that he could be their mole.

Bianca speaks to George, who brings up the distance and the time taken to make that shot. None of the names she currently has seem to be capable of making that shot, but Hans is adamant that they must be from the Army. There's one guy at Sterling who was a legend, Alexander Duggan, who fits the bill. However, he was killed by an IED though.

Over in Spain, the Jackal rings Nuria and decides to invite her over to Paris so they can talk and spend time together. He knows he's been busted and is clearly trying to save face here. Not only is he in danger of losing his family, but he may be forced into silencing her too.

The Jackal gets a room in Paris but when Nuria shows up, she slaps him across the face and demands the truth. The Jackal admits that he's a "trouble shooter" and sent in around the world to solve problems. Industrial espionage to be precise, and sometimes it can be illegal.

It's clever, because he uses parts of the truth and twists it, but he's adamant that once this job is done, he's finished with this line of work. After killing Elias, those in New York want the Jackal on a leash — and a tight one at that. They're going to stick with him for now but it's clear things are very tenuous.

Bianca wants to talk to Allison, but after a few back and forth retorts, it becomes clear that Allison is actually dead and Larry has her phone. He attacks her with a knife and Bianca calls MI6, needing assistance. However, when he sees the police approaching, he scrambles away.

Back home, Bianca heads back with her arm patched up. She refuses to talk to Paul about what happened and sends him off on his business trip with a nonchalant kiss and a hug. Bianca, finally after 4 episodes, shows some vulnerability. She looks in the mirror and handles her gun, worried.

Things at work aren't any easier for her. There's only so much Isabel can do to protect her, and they need to make progress on the case. Bianca wants Vince reassigned, a guy whom she has a lot of history with and someone who helped her out with Larry. Isabel agrees but wants constant updates on the case.

Larry phones Norman and obtains Bianca's home address. While he gets to work, Bianca speaks to Vince and brings up what she's learned so far. They need to figure out who this Rodin code-word is relating to — and fast. Vince turns the attention to Bianca's marriage, which she claims is "good" in her most unconvincing voice properly. Of course we know that it's not going well.

In Croatia, UDC happens to be off on a small, beautiful island swimming. He learns about the contract against his life but shrugs it off. His security intel don't want him to leave the island but UDC is determined to forge ahead with his plan to announce River regardless of consequence.

The Jackal leaves Paris and heads to Estonia for a concert. The idea here is to scout the place, something which links directly into the announcement about River as this is where it's going to take place. However, the sound canopy is opened, and the Jackal is caught unawares, dropping his phone on the concert floor. One of the workers, Rasmus, helps him out and he manages to get it back.

When Bianca heads home, she finds Larry holding Jasmine up at knifepoint. She doesn't hesitate, hitting Larry in the leg and demanding he reveal everything or she'll kill him. Jasmine though, happens to be watching all of this. She stops Bianca from going further, and lies to her that she wasn't responsible for Emma's death. The police though, show up to arrest him.

The Jackal heads back to his hotel room and finds his contact from New York there, waiting for him.

If he has doubts, then he just needs to speak to Norman Stoke about this. Well, the Jackal is not particularly enthused about having a babysitter, but this one's nonnegotiable.

The Jackal speaks to Norman and questions him over what's been happening with him. He confirms there's something "unusual", which are a bunch of visitors who showed up while he was on

a business trip, He "took care of them" before slipping away.

Jackal decides to work alongside Norman to make the deadline. He needs something to get through the metal detectors and contemplates whether he could use a cast to smuggle things through. For now, he meets up with Norman and the pair head off together.

Bianca shows at the hospital to see Larry. She immediately starts torturing him, suffocating the guy with a pillow, and offering up a favourable prison sentence and Norman staying alive, but Larry doesn't play ball. At least not to begin with. Eventually he spills that Norman is in Budapest, and gives a visual description of the place to help them narrow down where he is. There's about 11 locations meeting their criteria so they need to narrow it down.

Bianca does suss out that UDC is the next target, but she's keeping this from Isabel. As advised, she's keeping her circle close.

While work is a bit hit or miss, Bianca's personal life is a mess. She shows up to see Jasmine and Paul, who brings up that they're pretty freaked out by what's happened. Paul is actually staying with his ex-wife at the moment, which isn't doing their marriage any favours I'm sure, but bringing danger into their home has crossed the line.

Bianca opens up and explains the severity of her job but unfortunately, her marriage's foundation has been uprooted. Paul tells her he doesn't recognize her and walks away, leaving Bianca teary-eyed and struggling.

Nuria heads back home but she's still not convinced her husband is who he says he is. The Jackal though is busy wrapped up with his drama involving Norman. He tries to find out where Norman went for his business trip. He brings up he was in Belarus and shot at by MI6 and Bianca. He got a tip-off from an anonymous number, telling him to clear out. The Jackal warns that this better not backfire

Vince rings in the morning with details that they've managed to find a location where Norman is hiding out. However, his construction of the cast is complete, and the whole thing cleverly turns into a weapon. As a cast, you'd never have guessed.

While the Jackal heads out to give the gun a test ride, he's unaware that Bianca, Vince and the others are closing in on Norman's safehouse. The Jackal happens to be watching from the coffee shop though, and he hurriedly rings Norman. As MI6 close in, the Jackal tells him to clean up.

After deleting files from the computer, Norman tries to buy some time but he's soon apprehended. He doesn't do a particularly good job of cleaning up after himself, and Bianca immediately questions him over the Jackal. Unfortunately, there's a bag of Jackal's things on the sofa so she decides to try and bait him into showing up.

Jackal though, cleans up and shoots Norman before leaving... on a horse. They don't shoot the horse though, and aren't particularly good shots to be honest, as the Jackal heads into the woods in the dead of night and after a tense cat and mouse chase, manages to slip away, avoiding the barrage of bullets Bianca unleashes into the water.

The Jackal survives, but it's undoubtedly a close call. In fact, when he falls asleep in a barn, he awakens to find a gun in his face. He's tied up and looks set to meet a nasty end.

The authorities are all over Norman's workshop though, and after snatching up Jackals' jacket and putting it inside her coat, Bianca and Vince are called out to the farmhouse following the deaths. The Jackal is long gone though, and he rings Nuria, telling her he's not sure if he'll even make it back to Spain. He apologizes for getting her mixed up in everything and reveals that he's in Budapest. Nuria though, agrees to help.

Nuria knows about the secret room of course, and the Jackal gives her specific instructions for sorting this out.

Bianca and Vince head to the scene where they've found multiple prints. One of these is going to match the car, so it would appear that they're on the right path. However, it's all awkward timing because OC rings with news that Isabel is moving forward with Operation Anubis. However, OC has been deleting messages and one mentions him talking about UDC.

Speaking of which, UDC is still in Croatia and he's going to announce River in the next four days. That gives us a window of time for when the Jackal will strike. For now though, he needs to get out of Hungary. That's going to be difficult, and even more so because he's also haunted by his past, which includes a lot of bloodshed and death from various kills while working in the army.

The Jackal decides not to kill the driver, sparing his life and making him promise not to say anything to the police. Laszlo agrees and with that, the Jackal slips away. He heads to the internet cafe and speaks to his contact. They're getting angsty and losing faith that he's the right man for the job.

Juggling this and his relationship, the Jackal confides in Nuria and points out that he needs these disguises in order to get out of Hungary. "Is this worth it?" She asks, and the Jackal pauses. "It was," He replies.

Nuria shows up and it's immediately clear that what she's brought transforms Jackal's looks completely. In fact, he ends up the spitting image of a frail old man in a wheelchair. Funnily enough, Bianca happens to be in the same airport.

Back at MI6, Carver continues his rounds, this time turning toward Damian. He brings up Alexander Duggan, along with a potential mole in a beautiful woman whom he slept with while on holiday. He may have fed information to her about the Belarus operation but Damian isn't sure whether he did or not. Either way, Isabel makes a big call and decides to divert Bianca from the flight back to London across to Tallinn, Estonia instead.

When Bianca and Vince board the flight, they happen to be situated in the chairs right in front of the Jackal. They do mention OC's name here, which certainly tingles Jackal's spidey-senses. They touch down without incident but that night, the Estonian police show up asking questions. Apparently there's a burglary in the area and despite evading police, the Jackal is definitely a bit suspect.

The Jackal decides to ring Rasmus, the kid who helped him find the phone on the concert floor several episodes back. They go out for a drink together, and eventually end up having sex.

The episode starts with us back in Tallinn. Jackal meets Leonora at the library, where he brings up that Intelligence agents are in the vicinity and wants her people to help get them off his scent. She's impressed and with "guns" incoming on Friday, the Jackal is under pressure to deliver. He doesn't want to get too close here, but Leonora does call in some favours to slow down MI6.

While Jackal fools around with Rasmus, Nuria is lost in her own thoughts back home. Her family are worried about

her, but she continues to try and trust her husband, despite his obvious unfaithfulness. Nuria's brother pushes for 40 grand in order to get the bar he was speaking about earlier in the series up and running. Nuria is conflicted but eventually agrees to let him into Jackal's secret room, although she's not particularly happy. Jackal isn't either, as he watches the footage himself and sees Alvaro stash the gun and money in his pockets.

There's been nothing back on the dust prints (nothing on the hair, DNA or Jackal's bag then?), and given Bianca only caught sight of the Jackal at night, the sketch doesn't really look much like him. But, miraculously, a police officer — the same one who questioned Jackal that night — recognizes the face and calls it in.

However, on their way out the building, there's a hit against Bianca and Vince's lives. They manage to avoid being killed, with the attackers stopped outside, but it's certainly a close call.

Despite being slightly delayed, the pair show up at the apartment but find it empty, given Jackal is luckily over at Rasmus' place.

They speak to the Hungarian officer, who brings up that Jackal had a British passport under the name of Peter. Well, it's going to be difficult to find Jackal, as he hunkers down in the restricted section of the concert hall, high up and away from unsuspecting security intel, using Rasmus' card to break in. This is somewhere that Rasmus showed him earlier in the episode and contextualizes why he got romantically involved.

Buying excessive food from the vendor for the concert the night before is explained here by him needing to wait for the big talk with UDC the following day, but Jackal is haunted by the ghosts of the past.

The recurring flashbacks we've been seeing stems from an operation in the Middle East that's gone wrong. We don't see much around this though, but we do see how conflicted Jackal is over everything. Nuria is the wildcard here, and when they first met, she was full of life and working as a waitress. Believing this may be the end of the road for him, a single tear falls from Jackal's cheek.

The big day arrives and security is super tight. Bianca looks around and almost spots where Jackal is. The big speech goes ahead though, and Jackal leaves his hiding spot and methodically works his way to the sniping spot.

UDC takes to the stage, and behind bulletproof glass, Jackal preps for the shot. It's an incredibly tense affair, but someone else races on stage and messes everything up. UDC is taken out, the operation is a botch, while it's absolute pandemonium in the arena. The Jackal does manage to get away though, but Rasmus sees him leave and unfortunately, he's forced to choke him out and kill the guy.

The episode starts with us whisked off to Helmand in Afghanistan, 2013. The Jackal is there as a sniper, working to take out a man believed to be their target. Jackal is convinced it's not him and is prepared to wait as long as is needed. This, of course, explains why he was able to lie in the theatre for 2 days with his weapon.

The Jackal, as it turns out, is the name on the jeep he's driving with his teammates. Alexander Duggan? Yep, that's definitely the Jackal's real name as

well. In Cyprus, there's drama involving a Middle Eastern man, as Jackal's spotter, Gary, is drunk and points out the woes of working in the army.

The man comes with a proposition though. Given the money paid within the army is poor (less than being a binman in the UK apparently), he has a solution. In exchange for 10k each, they can "take care of a problem".

The pair agree, and begin working around to take out various targets. It's easy money for them, given their talents and all expenses paid, they could be set for life.

For now, the Jackal decides not to go ahead with this, so Gary and Doug head back to the army and continue with business as usual. However, the operation ends up botched. Despite them needing to take the Deputy Governor in alive, an unsuspecting sniper from high up in the

hills catches the Jackal unawares. He fires before his comrades can get hit, and birds flutter up into the air. This contextualizes all those shots of birds we've been seeing before.

Gunfire rains down and the Americans blow the place to bits, unaware that it's actually a wedding taking place inside. Gary and Duggan race to the scene, where the place is bathed in blood. The other team members decide to cover up the whole affair, deciding that an RPG had them pinned down and they had to call in an airstrike to cover the whole thing up.

Back in the present, Leonore phones those in New York and brings up that the shooter came from the security detail within UDC. There's pure chaos and pandemonium with this group, and they now have a week until River releases publicly, so this is enough for Jackal to go back after them.

The shooter though is a fanatic, and working within UDC's own security counsel. While they scramble to work out how they allowed someone like that in their own ranks, Bianca and the others work on the connections to Duggan, and the cameras from the night at the concert.

Bianca figures out that Duggan is the only person capable of making that shot and the intel they have seems to indicate he went to Afghanistan... and then never came back. He has been declared dead but without a body, it's definitely suspect. We know he's their man and Bianca is closing in.

In Spain, news spreads of the attempt on UDC's life. Nuria is rattled as she sees the composite sketch and starts to believe he's their man. Her brother does too, and when the Jackal finds out, he's adamant that he needs to keep his mouth shut no matter what.

Jasmine shows up that night to see her mum. She struggles to get the words out but at least agrees to hear her out.

Meanwhile, in Wakefield Prison in England, Bianca shows up to see Larry. He chuckles and resigns himself to his fate behind bars. He calls her rotten and that she's just as bad as him, but Bianca is here to say sorry. He doesn't listen and grabs a shiv he has stashed up his trouser leg, and slashes his own neck.

Bianca is shocked by what she's seen and is rattled. Vince tries to calm her down as she heads back home to wipe blood off her hands. She does compose herself long enough for the brief on Duggan, where she learns that, after the operation we saw earlier in the episode, a massive explosion wiped them all out.

While OC is called into the hotseat by Carver, we cut back and see that the explosion was actually orchestrated by Duggan. He rigged the jeeps with a bomb, wiping out his own teammates while saving himself and Gary in the process.

The episode starts with us over in Croatia. All boats in and out of the island are monitored closely, and the Jackal is watching. Leonore shows up and immediately breaks his train of thought. She brings up that with River launching in 48 hours, they have a very slim window of time to get this done. But the Jackal is not done yet and is adamant about finishing the job.

Over in Split, Jackal works to try and figure out a way to get to UDC. With the pressure mounting, he needs to try and

find the right outfit and disguise to go in. For now, it's time to head back home but Nuria is outside, watching his every move on the baby monitor.

Nuria eventually confronts her husband and questions what's real between them. Given everything going on with the Jackal, she calls him a liar and demands the absolute truth. He admits to being a professional killer and with this out in the open, she believes they can have a proper conversation.

As they sit together, the Jackal brings up that he has one more job to do — that being UDC — and then it's over. For good. The wildcard here though comes from Nuria's brother, Alvero. He's been talking to a guy called Jimmy TeJero, a shady Cuban gangster whom he's convinced Charles will be his business partner.

When Nuria feeds this back to the Jackal, he remains calm, composed and promises to make things right. He speaks to Alvero and agrees to go to this business meeting with him. Well, the Jackal manages to resolve this little issue, shooting Jimmy dead from a drone, while out on a boat.

Bianca decides to go and find Captain Mike Baldwin, the man who led his team into death. He's suffering from lung cancer, thanks to his time in Afghanistan. She doesn't waste any time, getting right down to brass tacks. Bianca wants details on Douggan — and she wants them now. He doesn't give much but does reveal his associate, Gary Cobb, who could be a crucial clue here.

Bianca brings this to Isabel, but the latter has decided to close the case. The bigger picture here is that they're wasting their time and need to reallocate their resources. Bianca though is a woman possessed and remains dead-set on finding him. Even if that means going outside the perimeters of her work to do so.

Bianca speaks to OC, who's clearly rattled and wants nothing to do with this case. It's definitely a changed tune from what we've seen him singing over the past few episodes. Could Carver have got to him?

With nowhere else to turn to, Bianca shows up to see Paul. She admits to missing him, allowing herself to be vulnerable, and trying to fix their marriage. Paul though believes she's only here because of a problem with her work. Even so, she does stay the night and notices news coming in for the kill shot against Tejero. She immediately perks up with the links to being a sniper and making a deadly shot from range.

However, Jackal is already on the move and he heads back to Split, out at sea, where he sets up a snipered drone. It's very tense, as UDC's life hangs in the balance. They have a Code Red alerted, as UDC's security intel is killed. We know he's a proficient swimmer, and UDC stays underwater as he makes it back. Unfortunately, he's killed in the process, prompting the Jackal to get away — but he's not alone as there are others after him.

The episode wastes little time as Inspector Ana rings Nuria about the assassination. This is all a backdrop to the real drama here, as the Jackal is on the run from the authorities, who are still after him. He manages to slip away though, but it's still touch and go.

UDC is dead though and with that, the Daghaus board postpone the River launch. Indefinitely. With the Jackal having been successful, the board are told they need to "clean up loose ends".

Back at MI6, Bianca is still on the case

and more determined than ever to find the Jackal. She knows that the hit from the boat is not dissimilar to that of Tejero's killing, both of which done from a big distance. Isabel is having none of this, given she believes MI6 are a team and right now, Bianca isn't playing this the right way. In fact, when she refuses to entertain Bianca's plan, Bianca quits.

With her job gone, she arrives at school and apologizes to Paul for what's happened. She just wants her husband back and knows that they're a team. It's a sweet moment, especially as she owns up to not always being there for them.

It doesn't take long for Isabel to show up, as she tries to talk her way back into work. Not only that, but she's also backtracking on wrapping the case up. Bianca needs to do this under the radar; an unsanctioned operation... which she refuses.

That night though, Paul believes Bianca should go and do it. She can't let it go and the parallels to Jackal's current predicament is really well done here.

The Foreign Secretary shows up to see Isabel, where it becomes clear that the two are in collusion together. It turns out she was dirty after all, and Isabel is convinced that Bianca will hand her notice in. That's a problem though, as the Foreign Secretary worries that she could be a liability. To prevent that occurring, the Secretary wants Bianca to go after Jackal and take him out. Then they'll take her out, covering all their tracks.

The Jackal ends up in a car crash and tips upside down after swerving away from a kid with a football in the street. He's on borrowed time though and manages to slip away, getting a lift from an elderly couple to the border of Montenegro to get out the country. On the way though, he finds his own moral compass challenged, with the pair scared. When the woman stabs Jackal in the shoulder, he's forced to kill them both.

Bianca enlists Vince's help and they head out to Spain together to chase up the Tejero link. They speak to Inspector Ana, who has decided to release Nuria's brother. Bianca gets nowhere but Vince's soft touch works wonders to bring up Alvaro's file. This links back to Nuria and, subsequently, Charles.

Just like the Jackal, the pair decide to wait and figure it out. She knows there's a bigger plot at work here and wants to know what it is. As for Nuria, she's had enough and packs up all the money, contemplating running away.

The Jackal makes it to Spain, while Leonore is told her fee will be paid when she makes contact with someone called Simon. Leonore senses a ruse, and that she's going to be killed, and manages to get away before that happens.

Back in Spain, Nuria leaves in a taxi with her son, away from this life. Bianca realizes she's going in a taxi so she's running away not toward danger. As for the Jacal, he heads back home, prompting Bianca and Vince to close in. As they do, Leonore rings and warns that the authorities are coming for him and he needs to move.

It turns out Nuria has actually left a sizable amount of money in the drawers, allowing the Jackal to pack his stuff. As he does, Alvaro stumbles around the mansion drunk. He immediately fires his gun, and the pair kill him. The Jackal meanwhile, decides to lock himself in the safe room.

When Bianca hits the fire alarm, the Jackal kills him, quick as a flash, from the hallway. Bianca wants answers and even calls him Duggan. She points out she does this because she likes to win, and the Jackal says the same thing. She offers to help him get Nuria back and eventually shoots her. As blood oozes from Bianca's mouth, he takes off.

However, despite winning at his job, he's lost his family and remains deadest on finding them. Unfortunately, he's hit by a car on the road in a shocking accident.

Back in London, Isabel is promoted up to Chief, while OC has a message from Bianca, confirming that Isabel is the corrupt agent here. He deletes the message, covering it up.

As for the Jackal, he's still alive following the accident. He meets up with Leonore, who points out that there's another "unpaid debt" that needs to be followed up on. That being, of course, the powers that be in New York. Before he agrees to it, he wants to find Nuria and his son.
