Moving on to the next set of tests, Reynie meets Sticky Washington and Kate Wetherall, and the three are brought to a mansion by the testing proctor, Number Two, to meet the reclusive Mr. Benedict.

The kids learn that Number Two and Rhonda and the shadowy bodyguard named Milligan are working for Mr. Benedict and the tests were for an ulterior motive. Benedict implores the children

that he needs their help while revealing that 'The Emergency' is being caused by subliminal messages being broadcast from an exclusive school in town, the L.I.V.E. Institute.

Benedict believes only children, including new arrival Constance Contraire, can stop the broadcasts and end 'The Emergency'. While Benedict explains the danger of the mission the power goes out in the mansion because intruders have breached the perimeter.

to the authorities with what he knows, Benedict responds that proof is useless unless it is proof of something they want.

Despite some misgivings, the kids led by Reynie, accept their missions as agents of Mr. Benedict and agree to be enrolled in the L.I.V.E. Institute, where Benedict believes the source of the messaging is coming from. Their mission is to find out who is sending the messages and hopefully shut down the transmitter.

When the kids enroll in the reclusive school, their orientation is led by Jackson and Jillson. The kids learn that there are no rules, but there are expectations that students must meet. Alone at the institute, the kids can only communicate with Benedict and his team via morse code. Waiting on the shores of the mainland, Benedict is strained with worry over what will happen.

At the institute, the kids are encouraged to watch television all the time. They begin their classes which seem beyond the realm of normal schooling. As the Mysterious Benedict Society, which the kids call their group, probes further into life at the school, they meet the enigmatic founder Mr. Curtain, who happens to be Mr. Benedict's twin brother.

Picking up right where the previous episode left off, we are back to the classroom with Reynie, Sticky, Kate, and Constance, as they meet Mr. Curtain. Initially the children think that Mr. Benedict has a split personality and is showing his other side as Curtain, but they quickly settle on the idea that Curtain is a long-lost twin brother.

The classes at the institute and the workload are bothering Kate. She wants to act by investigating the tower in hopes of finding the transmitter which is broadcasting the subliminal messages. The only way the kids will ever get inside the

highly restricted tower is to become Messengers. To do that, one must have excellent grades in class.

While the news of a twin is shocking to the children, Rhonda and Number Two are just as puzzled by the revelation. Benedict shares his family history and tells his associates of his long-lost twin brother Nathaniel. They were together in an orphanage and while Mr. Benedict was adopted, his brother was left behind. Having fled the orphanage, Mr. Benedict never saw his brother again, until now.

As the kids make peace with the idea that Mr. Benedict's motives are pure, they struggle with adapting to the class expectations. With discussions about "The cola with the quinine is a favorite of the jet set", Sticky sums up the feelings of the kids by declaring the classes are crazy. The four kids learn that the students with the lowest weekly scores who fall into the red zone get booted out of the institute and sent home on a barge with their memory wiped.

While Constance and Kate fall into the yellow warning zone, Reynie and Sticky are near the top of the group. Summoned to meet with Mr. Curtain, Reynie learns that he is close to becoming a Messenger faster than anyone else in the history of the institute.

Fearing the loss of Kate and Constance, the group seeks guidance from Mr. Benedict about what to do. Mr. Benedict advises the kids to cheat. The idea of cheating is an anathema to Sticky and Reynie. Debating the ethics of cheating The moral quandary of cheating is not a concern for Kate. She has been sitting around for too long and wants to get active, so she sets out to investigate the tower. Were it not for a timely save from Constance, Kate would have had a written report about being out late at night and straying from the path by Jackson and Jillson.

The episode ends with a flurry of activity. Milligan has returned from retrieving important documents from the mansion while carefully avoiding Curtain's goons, and Reynie is still struggling with how and if they should help the girls cheat on their tests. Mr. Curtain is rapidly advancing his program with ominous pronouncements to his underlings, and an unexpected visitor appears at Mr. Benedict's campsite. Ms. Perumal has determined that Reynie is not enrolled in the Boatwright Academy, and wants to know where he is.

While Reynie, Sticky, Kate, and Constance settle on the idea of cheating in class to help the girls stay at the institute, they hatch another plan to gain some insight into what Mr. Curtain is doing.

As Curtain sits out in the courtyard examining his journal, Reynie approaches him with a gift of bookmarks for his dogeared pages. While Reynie distracts him, Kate, Constance, and Sticky use a series of mirrors to spy on the headmaster's deepest thoughts. Thanks to Sticky's ability to remember everything

he sees he can copy exactly what is on the page to study later.

Back at Mr. Benedict's camp, distrust is in the air amongst the group. Rhonda has been sneaking out at night. Number Two decides to follow her to see what she has been up to. In town, Rhonda has been vandalizing signs with slogans that remind people to feel instead of being afraid. When confronted by Number Two, Rhonda's reasoning is that these small acts keep her sane.

This notion carries over with Mr. Benedict as he and Milligan set out for a local mountain top that will give them a better view of a suspicious area of the island. Initially opposed by Number Two, Benedict and Milligan set out for their hike with hopes of success, and for Benedict the chance to see his brother in the flesh.

Cheating does not go well for the kids. Sticky is caught almost instantly and sent to the dreaded waiting room. Time moves rather slowly in the waiting room as Sticky imagines all sorts of illusions. When he is finally seen by Mr. Curtain, Sticky confesses his cheating but refuses to admit to who he was helping. This means more time in the waiting room.

While Reynie and Kate are worried about the fate of Sticky, Constance has started to show her true self. She didn't bother cheating on the latest test because this time she actually tried to succeed. As Mr. Benedict and Milligan make their way to the top of the mountain, Number Two

and Rhonda reconcile their differences. We even get to see Number Two in her younger days as a pool player. The younger Number Two would often do things that seemed inconsequential but made her feel alive.

Sticky returns from the waiting room and describes how horrible it was to the group, but adamantly states that he didn't betray their confidence. Amidst the joy of Sticky's return, Constance informs the group that she has decoded Curtain's journals, and the group learns that he has a plan called 'The Improvement' which is slated to begin soon.

The hike up the mountain was not in vain, as Mr. Benedict and Milligan see Curtain walk into their view and access a hidden layer within the rocks. For the first time in a long while Mr. Benedict sees his brother, but he also has valuable information to share with the kids.

The episode concludes with Kate being barged for her low grades. A chance encounter with Martina Crowe saves the day. After defeating Martina at tetherball, where Martina is the captain of the team, Kate is spared being barged, and placed on the team at Martina's request. In class, Mr. Curtain arrives with the biggest surprise of all as he happily announces the promotion of Reynie and Sticky to Messenger position.

Reynie and Sticky begin the show being fitted for their new Messenger uniforms. As they suit up for their new role, Mr. Curtain tells them that they should never underestimate the effects of a well-tailored outfit. While the boys are impressed by their accomplishment, they learn the truth about why they were promoted so quickly. Curtain tells them that Reynie's aptitude was at the highest levels and Sticky's loyalty to his friends in the previous cheating incident impressed Curtain.

While Kate and Constance tease the two about their snazzy new uniforms, Reynie and Sticky start to see life at the Institute from a new lens. Now that they are Messengers, the boys get to sit at a special table with the other Messengers and start to pick up on the gossip of those in the know. They quickly learn that Jackson and Jillson have spotted Mr. Benedict's morse code signals coming from the shore and everyone is on high alert at the Institute. The kids inform Mr. Benedict that their lines of communication are compromised, and now the children are on their own with no help.

Distressed over losing communication with the kids, Mr. Benedict, Rhonda and Number Two try to establish a new line of communication. An attempt to train a falcon goes awry when during a test at the camp the falcon destroys the straw dummy made to look like Reynie.

Ms. Perumal arrives at the camp and confronts Mr. Benedict and his group about Reynie, and soon learns about the operation that the children are involved in at the Institute. At the same time as Perumal is grilling Benedict, Reynie and Sticky are brought on official Messenger business to the tower where they meet Mr. Curtain in an isolated room with a special machine called 'The Whisperer'.

Constance's boredom at Kate's tetherball practice gives her some free time to solve the riddle of Mr. Benedict's last message. While the group was stumped about the meaning to the last morse

code message, Constance deciphers the clues given by Benedict to determine the location of the secret entrance to the tower. Kate finds her later and is upset about her leaving the practice only to be thrilled by what Constance has discovered. Together they crack the code on how to open the secret entrance.

'The Whisperer' is very reassuring and comforting to Reynie and especially for Sticky. As Sticky sits back and converses with the machine, they come to an agreement that there is something reassuring about learning. With Mr. Curtain attached to the machine opposite the boys, they begin repeating various phrases that have no real meaning except that these phrases are subliminally broadcasting 'The Emergency'.

When the boys return from their duties, they meet with Constance and Kate and describe their experience. Sticky doesn't see the harm they have done, while Reynie sees his work as helping to create 'The Emergency' for today. A plan starts to form amongst the kids, despite Sticky's hesitance, to disable 'The Whisperer'.

Dinner with Mr. Benedict does nothing to sway Ms. Perumal of their plan to stop 'The Emergency'. Perumal states that when she returns home she will call for help. Mr. Benedict states that she can do this, but the influence of Curtain and 'The Emergency' will prevent her from speaking with the authorities.

Plagued with doubt about the mission and fearing for the safety of the kids, Mr. Benedict announces to Rhonda, Number Two, and Milligan that they must gain access to the island and remove the children from the mission.

Meanwhile, Curtain is ecstatic about the progress being made with 'The Whisperer' and plans to move ahead with his diabolical deeds. Ms. Perumal makes good on her threat to phone the authorities but when she does rather than connecting with the police, Perumal is directed to an automated message that offers no help at all.

The episode begins with a flashback to the orphanage that Nicholas Benedict and his brother Nathaniel lived at as boys. The two brothers are studies in opposite as Nicholas is shy and reclusive while Nathaniel is demanding and bossy.

In the present, Mr. Benedict hatches a plan to rescue the kids from the institute. Rhonda and Number Two watch as Benedict explains how they will all travel via a dilapidated submarine piloted by Milligan to the island. The plan is to land on the island and free Reynie, Sticky, Kate, and

Constance. Rhonda and Number Two point out that not everyone can fit in the submarine, so the plan is quickly modified for Milligan to go alone.

At the institute, Sticky is projecting a more hopeful attitude. Unlike the rest of the group, Sticky feels like 'The Improvement' might be helpful and not dangerous. Feeling isolated from his friends for portraying Mr. Curtain in a positive light, Sticky seeks reassurance and comfort from the institute founder.

Curtain's manipulation of Sticky deepens as he informs the confused boy about his potential on the 'Whisperer'. Their private session on the machine has some unintended consequences for Constance. While Sticky is just repeating simple phrases into the machine, the 'Whisperer' is

subliminally broadcasting instructions to the citizens of Stonetown. Constance is subject to the 'Whisperer' as well and leaves the island.

With Sticky lost in the wonder of the 'Whisperer', Reynie looks to a new source of information about Curtain's plan 'The Improvement'. Striking up a friendship with Curtain's son S.Q., Reynie implores S.Q. to bring him to a forbidden part of the island. Kate has longed to attack the tower and do as much damage as possible, but she quickly learns from her friendship with Martina that a special access key is needed to gain entry in the tower.

Milligan's journey is perilous. The submarine which Rhonda and Number Two deemed to be dangerous is a disaster waiting to happen. From one calamity to another Milligan strives to keep the sub from imploding beneath the surface. Thanks to the 'Whisperer' Stonetown is humming with people's uncontrollable desire to purchase blue berets. Even Constance is unable to resist. Her foray into the city is short and explicitly to purchase a blue beret.

Kate uses her friendship with Martina to the group's advantage. While Martina is distracted Kate makes use of her bucket and duplicates Martina's access key. Despite his father's warning, S.Q. brings Reynie to a secret part of the island to practice their drawing skills. The forest before them doesn't look like a normal part of nature. Reynie sees the surrounding trees are topped with antennas which S.Q. explains is part of his father's experiment.

In another flashback we witness adoption day for the Benedict brothers. Nathaniel has done everything he could to make his shy brother Nicholas seem appealing. Unfortunately for Nathaniel, his overbearing attitude is too much for the prospective parents, and they choose to adopt Nicholas and not both brothers. Nicholas leaves promising to come back for his brother, but never does. After explaining what happened in the orphanage, Mr. Benedict blames himself for everything, but Rhonda and Number Two reassure him that he was only a child and that he had no control over events.

Still alive in his tiny sub, Milligan is making progress towards the island. After a destructive crash against the island's underwater turbines, the sub breaks apart, leaving the whereabouts of Milligan unknown.

While Captain Noland and Cannonball are trying to figure out what to do with the stowaways, the stateroom is broken into by the water polo team, who have been following the kids.

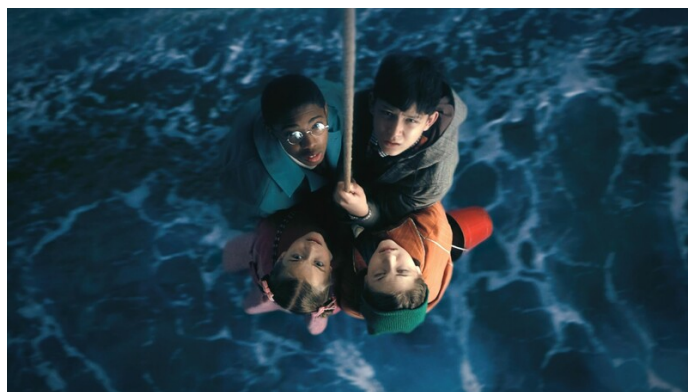

the ability to find true happiness, Benedict knows that what Curtain is doing is nothing more than simple trickery. To Benedict, it is outrageous that people will become dependent on an artificial state of mind.

Number Two is only partially listening to what Benedict has to say. She is spending her time thinking of ways to escape from Curtain's compound. At one point, Number Two talks about using the lemons that are grown on site to create a mold infestation, but Benedict interrupts her thinking. Benedict wants to help his brother, and he knows that Curtain has an undesirable need for Benedict's approval.

On the ship, Cannonball has been actively searching for the kids, while also confirming that the ship is running slower than it's supposed to be. Informing Captain Noland, the third officer is ordered to find the kids, or else the blame for the lack of sugar, the stowaway kids, and being late will fall on his shoulders.

In the engine room, the kids are wondering what they will do. Being chased by the water polo team, and without adult help, the Mysterious Benedict Society is running out of money and

direction. Close by they can hear the crew members in the engine room gambling. Constance tells the group that they need to take advantage of this opportunity and make some money, so they do. Sticky, Kate, and Constance are very successful, but Reynie is lost at the art of gambling.

Trying to cross the ocean faster than the kids, Rhonda, Milligan, and Ms. Perumal seem to be slowing down. The dirigible blimp has encountered bad weather, slowing their travels, but allowing Milligan to gain some time to talk about the struggles of being a father again to Kate. Ms. Perumal tells him that he can worry all he wants, but that worry will not armor him when something bad happens.

Back in the engine room, the kids have made it back to their hiding spot to count their winnings. While Sticky employed card counting methods, and Kate shaved down the dice for the craps table to ensure perfect rolls, Sticky talks about his failure. Learning that his friends had cheated to win, he shames them all in giving back the money. When they return their ill-gotten gains, the worker is impressed by their honesty, and decides to reward them with a small financial endowment. (As Constance says, this reward in no way equals what they just gave away.)

Though Reynie is pleased, the group is entrapped by the water polo team who is there to ensure they don't find Mr. Benedict. Just when things are looking tough, Cannonball saves the day and prevents the water polo team from causing any problems for the Mysterious Benedict Society. The problem is that the kids are stowaways, and they must be taken to the captain.

Mr. Benedict has been sitting in the audience for one of Curtain's happiness program recordings. While everyone around him seems to be taken by the edict of Curtain, Benedict is skeptical of what is promised. Curtain just wants to help others open their eyes to happiness.

Rhonda, Milligan, and Ms. Perumal may be landing in the Northern Iberian plains, the kids are about to face judgment before Captain Noland. Stowaways and the cause of the sugar shortage, Captain Noland is very annoyed at the predicament he has been put into. When Kate promises to fix the engine which will ensure that the ship arrives on time in Europe, Noland agrees he will let the kids go, but only if Kate can deliver on her promise.

834 escudos short of his fare, he threatens to summon the cops. However, all parties involved (before the cop shows up) reach a decision to engage in a barter deal. The driver turns down whatever Kate offers from her bucket, instead demanding the entire bucket itself. Weatherall refuses to part ways with the bucket, but Constance saves the day as she hands the driver her pendant. She explains her actions later, by saying she didn't want to pick up the pieces of Kate as that would be her state without her bucket. Within the railway station, the youngest member of the group senses that Mr. Benedict is in trouble and they need to hasten to his rescue.

The four children open the locker at the train station and receive a clue. It is here that Constance realizes that the eye containing the clue is on the pendant she handed to the can driver. Kate comes to the rescue and takes Reynie along with her to get it back. They find the driver and he tries to call the cops on them. It was a play on greed where, instead of letting it go and keeping the "worthless" necklace, he opted for another item for his fare. Milligan siphons out a boot full of gas from a car and the trio reaches the station. It remains unclear if they entered or not.
