Summary: In his prime, Berlin gathers a team in Paris to execute an incredibly

challenging heist, aiming to steal jewels valued at 44 million euros

from 34 cities in a single night.



The episode starts with Berlin saying goodbye to his third wife. They are getting divorced, and Berlin is saddened about the end of his marriage. In his narration, he says only two things can turn a bad day into a great one: love or a big heist.

A car pulls up next to him, and he gets in. In the car, he introduces four other people as his crew. We have Keila, an expert in electronic engineering; however, she is pathologically shy. Secondly, we have Roi, a common thief with a knack for picking doors and Berlin's protege.

Thirdly, we have Damián, a professor by day and a criminal mastermind by night. Then finally there is Bruce, the jack of all trades.

The gang interrupts a dinner party at a fancy house by pretending to be police officers. Berlin takes the host aside and shows him a fake search warrant. Berlin says the man is being charged with illegal trafficking of antiquities. The man leads Berlin to his vault and picks a particular chalice. After selecting the chalice, Berlin reveals he is not a police officer but will confiscate the item.

A guest tries to play a hero, and Berlin puts him in his place. Berlin advises him to stop the ruckus, trying to prove himself to his mistress. He tells the man that dying over love is not worth it. After seeing the gun, the man changes his tune and apologises, pleading for his life. It is evident that Berlin is taking his divorce hard.

Next, the gang travels to Paris and book rooms in a hotel. Berlin introduces a new team member, Cameron. We learn that Cameron has been through a lot and just got out of a mental hospital. As soon as Roi sets his eyes on Cameron, we can tell he fancies her. Even Berlin notices and warns the young man to maintain a platonic relationship with Cameron. He also tasks Roi with watching over the beautiful lady.

The team gets to work and starts discussing their next heist. The reason they stole the fourth-century chalice worth about 40,000 euros. They intend to use the chalice to trick a priest into

allowing them into his church, where they will dig a hole and steal 63 jewels worth 44 million euros.

The jewels are set to be transported to the biggest, most prestigious auction house in Paris, opposite the church, and that is how they will break in. The church's crypt is only 5 meters from the auction house, and they must follow the old tunnels hidden below.

The next day, they visit the priest and pretend to be an excavation team from the Polytechnic University of Salamanca. Keila has planted 650 references about the team online, and the priest thinks they are legitimate. He hopes the team will find evidence that his church might be the oldest in Paris.

The team says they have evidence to believe that there is treasure below the church, and the priest is eager to invite them to the crypt and let them dig. They work on sneaking into a man's house and installing surveillance cameras.

The man, François, is the only one who knows when the jewels will arrive. The plan is to find out the date of the last shipment to make their move. In the meantime, their hotel is right opposite François's house and using secret surveillance, they hope to learn more details about the shipment.

After breaking into the house and installing the hidden surveillance camera, the teams wait at the hotel. Roi tries to get close to Cameron but fails as she sees him as Berlin's lapdog. Meanwhile, Bruce and Keila bury the chalice in the church to make it look like they uncovered an antique under the church.

Based on their conversation, Bruce is a player, and Keila doesn't appreciate his easy-going nature when it comes to sex.

Concurrently, Berlin shares his frustration and disappointment over his divorce with Damián. Damián is married and believes Berlin has yet to find the right person. The two stay up to watch François, and this is when Berlin starts getting infatuated with the man's wife. He follows her to a bar and listens to her singing.

Later, he confides in Damián that he met someone, and the latter warns him not to complicate matters by starting an affair with their target's wife.

The following morning, they trick the priest into believing they found the chalice under the crypt, and he gives them his blessings to dig further. Berlin recruits Roi's help to rope in Camille, his new infatuation. However, she plays coy, making Berlin second guess himself.

On the other hand, the priest asks for the chalice to take back to Spain and show the university dean about his team's great work. Damián is flustered by this request and tries to dissuade the priest. However, the ex-convict, supported by the priest, takes his side. Damián is forced to give up the chalice and calls Berlin to alert him of the situation. In return, Berlin orders Roi to do everything he can to get it back.

Berlin can't be bothered to go after the priest himself since he is preparing to go out with Camille after overhearing that her husband forgot their date. Camille decides to go to the Opera by herself after being disappointed by her husband, and Berlin sees this as an opportunity to be seized. He dons his tuxedo and acts like he coincidentally met her while walking out of his hotel.

The episode starts with Berlin inviting himself to join Camille as she goes to the opera. He makes it sound like it is a coincidence that he is staying in the hotel opposite her apartment. He asks for some time to explain himself.

Camille is in a hurry, so she agrees to allow him into her cab. While she changes, Berlin goes on and on about how he is newly divorced and looking for peace of mind.

Camille finds all these intriguing but a bit misogynistic. Nonetheless, she is

happy to have Berlin's company. However, it turns out she is not heading to the opera per-se but to a rock club called the Opera to see her friends perform.

Even though Berlin is overdressed in a tux, he finds a way to fit in and has a mighty time flirting up a storm with Camille. No one has ever accused this man of having no rizz, you know! Berlin writes his number on her arm by the night's end and sends her home.

On the other hand, Cameron brings the bike over to the hotel to lend it to Roi. She insists on knowing what Roi is planning and coming along. The two manage to grab the briefcase from the priest and give him the scare of his life. However, they didn't plan for the two ex convicts escorting the priest to intervene. What follows is a wild chase that interrupts a wedding and a funeral, finally ending in a parking lot.

As they try to escape, the two steal and wreck two cars while setting off 26 alarms. Ultimately, the goons win and take back the chalice.

Meanwhile, Keila shows Bruce her simulation. She is creating it to help her deal with her shyness, and Bruce is friendly but a bit over-sexual in his praise. This makes her uncomfortable,

and she asks him to leave. However, we can tell she is uncomfortable because she likes him and doesn't want to admit it.

The following day, Damián confronts Roi and Cameron for the mess they created. Thankfully, the stunt scared the priest, and he returns the chalice to Damián. He has changed his mind about travelling to Spain and is taking a one-week recovery leave. The one-week leave gives the gang seven days to drill the hole and pull out their heist.

Another urgent matter is that Berlin has been MIA since last night, and Damián sends Roi to wake him up. Roi finds the man awake and in great spirits after receiving a call from Camille. Camille feels a special connection with Berlin and tells him about her marriage but says she wants to explore. Berlin lies he is leaving the next day.

After the call, Berlin was hoping Camille would call him back in a few hours and chase after him. He is surprised when she shows up at his hotel room, asking to be let in. However, with all the surveillance apparitions in his room, Berlin refuses and turns her down, saying he is not looking for an ordinary, trivial affair.

Camille is disappointed because she doesn't think of herself as ordinary but understands where Berlin is coming from. He then changes his mind and goes after her in the elevator. With one kiss, they start an affair.

Elsewhere, the rest of the team works on drilling the hole while Berlin has the time of his life, having an affair with Camille. He is not the only one who is having a crush. Keila admits to Cameron that she has got it bad for Bruce. We can't blame her, though. Bruce is fine, and you know what they say about opposites attracting.

Cameron warns her to be cautious not to fall in love since love is like a disease with different phases. Maybe she went to the mental hospital after losing her beloved? To distract Keila, Cameron starts a dancing party, and they end up inviting Bruce and Roi.

The following day, the team meets up to discuss their process and strategy after getting to the wall that will lead them to the vault. The plan is to break through the wall and get inside the auction house.

No one expects them to get into the vault through the backdoor. They move their equipment and get to work cutting through the concrete wall that secures the antechamber that leads to the vault. They cut the iron joints that connect to the blocks but decide only to move them once they need to.

The antechamber has CCTV cameras linked directly to the security guard's monitors. There are two guards the gang needs to be cautious of, and they need to get them away from their desks for three minutes. During this time, Keila will hack the CCTV footage.

To distract the guards, Bruce pretends to be a food delivery guy who messes up the delivery and shows up 90 minutes late. This is to get the guards riled up and entice them into a fight.

While Bruce buys time for the gang by pretending to pass out after being hit by the guards, the team don their hazmat suits and gloves. This is to make sure they don't leave DNA evidence behind.

With the guards distracted, the rest of the team breaks into the empty vault. Remember, this is only a practice run to ensure everything runs smoothly on D-day. This is also to give Keila a chance to get control of the auction house system. It also allows them to come in and out of the vault as often as they please.

On the other hand, Bruce worries why Roi has not returned the bike he borrowed. Bruce rented the bike and needs to return it before the police are involved. Roi advises him to forget about the bike he rented with his fake passport.

Keila adds that the rental company took Bruce's picture, and they can use facial recognition to track him down. Roi responds they are in trouble because the priest's ex-cons took the bike.

After spending most of their time in bed, Berlin and Camille finally decide to get a break. As they talk about the place they should visit in Paris, François calls to confront Camille about the affair. He found the emails on her open laptop.

Berlin goes for a walk to give the couple time to talk. Berlin feels happy that the secret is finally out and he can get Camille to herself.

At the same time, Cameron overhears François moving up the plan since the jewels have arrived. François plans to take the jewels to be appraised the next day before a press conference and the auction. This changes everything, and the gang must also move up their plans. She informs Damián, who insists they must steal the jewels that night. Damián has Roi call Berlin and informs him of the changes.

Summary: The robbery is on and tensions are high as the crew starts to doubt

Berlin's leadership. Keila and Bruce must make sure to cover their

tracks.



The episode starts with Berlin arriving at the church just in time for the heist. Meanwhile, François is just wrapping up placing the jewels in the vault. As expected, Damián is a bit antsy since he knows Berlin is late because of his affair with Camille.

Nonetheless, the hustle must go on, and they have 15 hours before the vault is opened again to steal the jewels and clean up after themselves. With everything in place, the gang enters the vault and starts packing the goods. However,

Damián is taking his divorce frustrations out on Berlin.

Berlin asks him to stop acting like a jealous girlfriend. Berlin wants to finish the work, head to François's apartment, and remove the cameras they hid. Damián didn't have the time to do it as their heist was moved up by two days.

With Keila on the computers, the gang suits up and enters the vault while François finishes signing some papers. The tension between Damián and Berlin heightens and almost turns physical.

Damián believes the affair is worthless and accuses Berlin of ruining François's marriage. He says Berlin is lying to Camille and is selfish. Words are exchanged, and a scuffle ensues as Damián pushes Berlin against the wall, creating a sound that François hears. Everyone in the vault freezes.

The guard ignores the sound, saying it is probably metal expanding. The guard explains they can't open the vault for another fifteen minutes, but François insists on opening the antechamber to see if everything is okay. Keila quickly informs Bruce and Cameron to shut down their operations.

The two immediately take action, locking up everything, and the guard finds nothing suspicious. He reports to François that all is well and asks if he would like to override the vault lock.

However, a call distracts François, and he says it won't be necessary. He leaves the building, confident that his jewels are safe.

The gang quickly picks up where they left off, but Damián informs Berlin that they will never work together again. With the jewels secured, Roi and Berlin return to the hotel while the rest dismantle the set-up. They have 4 hours to leave everything as they found it.

Roi puts all the jewels in Damián's room at the hotel before heading out with Berlin to François's apartment. The plan is to set it up and make François look suspicious.

At the condo, Berlin drugs François with chloroform before removing the cameras and any trace they might have left behind. Roi confronts Berlin about drugging François as it was not part of the plan. Berlin quickly puts him in his place and tells him never to question or judge him again.

After taking out the cameras, Berlin takes François's car to one of their houses in Chantilly and sets him up by leaving some damning evidence behind. On his way back, he sees the guards trying to reach François.

In the meantime, the rest of the team clean and remove any trace of their presence by making it look like they never entered the vault. They cover up the hole and return everything the way it was. Lastly, they work on their plan to cause a power outage to buy time to remove the security cam relays.

They take out one of the high-voltage power lines under the auction house for this part of the plan. They create a slight diversion ahead of the power outage by pretending to be from the headquarters and asking for help. The guards leave their post to check on the issue, and the gang finish up on their heist.

The power outage disables the surveillance system at the auction house and the system that opens the vault doors. This forces the guards to call for the technicians. The gang is counting on the technicians from Geneva arriving and the vault being opened within six to seven hours. By then, they will be done removing their traces.

The team leaves after sealing every entrance they used in the successful heist. They return to their hotels in separate groups.

Berlin orders the team to remain in their rooms and thoroughly clean them so as to not leave any evidence behind. He informs them they will check out separately between 9 and 10 in the morning to avoid any suspicion. Damián is tasked with cleaning all the jewels.

Unfortunately, Bruce has a loose end and recruits Keila's help to handle it. They pretend they need privacy to sleep together, but Bruce asks Keila to help him delete his passport entry in the bike rental place. He is anxious that if the police look into the bike, they will find his picture, and he will get nabbed. They sneak into the car rental shop and delete Bruce's passport.

However, the plan goes awry when they sneak in and some guards are present. Keila pretends she is replacing the sick accountant while Bruce hides under her desk. She is about to make it out, but the computer refuses to delete the passport, and the guard offers to help. Only when he bends over to show her the 'trick' he finds himself staring right into Bruce's eyes.

Back at the hotel, Cameron calls her ex but decides not to leave a message. She is interrupted by Roi, who is pissed after Bruce kicked him out of their room to 'sleep with Keila' and Damián lashed out at him.

Roi insists on sleeping in Cameron's room, and they bond over his tattoo. Cameron is fascinated by the octopus tattoo on Roi's back. She teases Roi, and he decides he is done following Berlin's orders.

He is ordered to come out, and Keila tries de-escalating the situation. She says that Bruce is her boyfriend, and their plan to be naughty in the office is ruined. Of course, the guards don't believe this and ask for IDs. Instead. Bruce uses the

weight light to hit the gun off his hands. Keila jumps to action and picks the gun first.

She suddenly turns into a hard-core criminal, ordering the guards to get on their knees, and they steal money from the safe. She makes it look like a planned robbery and confuses the investigation once it starts. Bruce is impressed with her as they drive away and comments on her panties. This annoys Keila, and she calls him out for not grasping the weight of the situation.

Elsewhere, Roi and Cameron go out, and Cameron reveals she took one of the jewels to wear for the night. She promises to return it the following day. It is at this point that she tells him about her ex, who is a musician. Their relationship started off well until she got obsessed with him. It got too much and started affecting her mental health. Their idyllic relationship finally ended, but Cameron had a hard time forgetting him. The song he wrote for her kept reminding her of him, and she kept seeing his posters everywhere.

She lost it and accidentally burned down her place while trying to get rid of their memorabilia. She was diagnosed with a psychotic break, acute paranoia and emotional dissociation disorder. That is why she ended up in the mental hospital.

To make her feel better, Roi steals one of the planes in the hangar they were hiding at and tries to fly it. Thankfully, he stops because he is not a licensed pilot! However, his trick worked; the adrenaline rush made Cameron feel better. However, that is short-lived when they realise they left the jewel necklace in the car.

Meanwhile, Berlin returns to the hotel he got with Camille and acts like he spent the whole night there. Camille visits his room first thing in the morning. He asks her to choose between him and François. She says it is difficult as she is in love with both men, and he asks her to call him once she has decided.

On the other hand, we meet Marie Lavelle, the detective in charge of the heist investigation. As expected, she arrests François as he is the main suspect, and there is no evidence of a break-in. Damián calls Berlin, shares the good news, and asks him to ensure the police are gone before contacting the transporter.

This is all part of their evacuation plan. Bruce and Keila are the first to leave, disguised as backpackers. They are supposed to head to Spain on a bus carrying three tins with the jewels. Berlin argues no one would be looking for high-end jewels in a bus! Secondly, Roi and Cameron leave and pick an RV. They are later joined by Damián, who will play the role of their dad. He tries to subtly make Camille turn against her husband by mentioning some suspicious behaviour. Camille shows him the blown safe and how she feels like she has been living with a stranger.

He comes clean about the missing jewel but never mentions Cameron's role in the incident. Roi says he did it because he was angry at Berlin. Berlin is understanding and commends him for coming forward. He apologises to Roi, and they talk about his relationship with Camille.

Berlin is frustrated that Camille only sees the good in François. He says that by framing François, they put him on a pedestal in her eyes. To change this, Berlin offers her money to hire the best lawyer in Paris and free her husband. Of course, Camille is moved beyond words over how kind and considerate Berlin is. She says he is a one-of-a-kind lover, and Berlin basks in all her praises, talking about never kicking a man when he is down. She invites him to visit François in jail.

At the same time, the police find the car and arrest the guy who won it in a race. The man gives the police a perfect description of Roi and his tattoos. He tells Lavelle that the man and the lady are Spanish. To this effect, Lavelle calls Europol to ask for help.

Roi and Cameron get closer while camping. Meanwhile, their new 'dad', Damián, meets a new woman who is moved by his widow story. She offers him a homemade drink, and he gets wasted by himself. He can't stop thinking about his wife and calls her. Unfortunately, the new lady overhears the conversation and realises his wife is not dead, as he said. Damián asks for a second chance and loses his cool when his wife refuses to take him back. He accuses her of cheating, and she hangs up on him.

On the other hand, Bruce and Keila experience heavy rainfall that forces them to share one tent. However, Keila becomes more attracted to Bruce as he lies shirtless beside her. After the rain subsides, she heads out to pee and is bitten by an asp viper. Bruce hurriedly gives her first aid and tries to get her help. He carries her on his back and tries to get to the hospital as she is having an allergic reaction to the snake venom.

The episode ends with the return of the formidable Alicia Sierra, Deputy Inspector Europol Spain. She is working on the case with Lavelle.

To our surprise, Raquel Murilo picks up the phone and is glad to join the girls in Paris for a criminal gang-hunting spree. We gotta admit, these two have great chemistry!

Whilst Berlin and Camille babysit their neighbour, Susi's son, things continue to get dire with the other gang members. Camille tells Susi all about her affair, and the latter is surprised. However, Camille says there is nothing weird about Berlin helping François. Susi questions how all these happened so quickly, but Camille has no idea. Susi leaves for her audition. Camille and Berlin meet the lawyer who says François's case is hopeless.

Thankfully, Berlin returns the kid safely, and while hugging Camille goodbye, she steals his room key.

Berlin returns to the hotel and finds Damián waiting for him. They talk about finding the perfect love and bond over their failed relationships. They decide to crush a wedding to forget their pain and sing to their heartbroken hearts' content.

Back at the camp, Cameron tries to let Roi down easily, but he insists he loves her. He really wanted to kiss her at the lake, but she pulled back. He confesses his love and says that he can see she is scared. He argues he wouldn't have hurt her like her ex. As they talk, a team of police officers, led by Lavelle and Sierra, station themselves outside. One officer's radio goes off unexpectedly, alerting the two that the police have arrived, but they have a plan.

While Berlin and Damián sing at the party, Bruce holds two police hostages, and Camille sneaks into Berlin's hotel room. She is shocked beyond belief to learn he is the heist's mastermind after finding all the evidence lying around.

The episode ends with the police cornering Roi and Cameron in one part of the country while Bruce drives inside the hospital to pick up Keila after her treatment.

Damián and Berlin race against time as Lavelle, Murillo, and Sierra arrive at the hotel and ask questions about their group. One of the staff reveals that two of the gang members are in their room and leads the way.

The police get to the room to find Berlin, and Damián cleaned up their trace and burned their surveillance equipment using acid in the bathtub. After finding out the truth, Camille decides to call the police, but Susi talks her out of it. She hangs up the call and convinces Camille to blackmail Berlin. After finding out that François has been hiding a secret family, Camille decides she has had enough of being taken advantage of and lied to. She takes Susi's advice and starts tracking Berlin down.

For months, they try to find Berlin, and Camille uses the information he told her during pillow talk to find him. Berlin knows Camille didn't sell him out to the police and has been trying to forget her. However, Camille and Berlin cannot restrain themselves, and she throws away the recorder, leaving Susi in the dark, waiting outside.

The following day, Camille with Susi to threaten Berlin, and he gives in even though he cleaned out their evidence. Sometimes, you really can't outdo the doer. Berlin tries to argue his love for Camille is genuine and rare. Even after giving up his share and promising to send them more money, he leaves a love note on one of the notes.

After a few months, the three unite to update each other on the case, but it looks bleak. Sierra is sure the gang will pull another job and wants to be ready when that happens.

After happily letting Susi and Camille blackmail him and take his share, Berlin contacts Damián and sets up a meeting. He tells him he lost his shares and says they need another heist. Damián couldn't agree more as he was already starting to feel bored.
