



Through flashbacks, we learn how Danny and Lexi met and what forced them apart. Danny enlisted Lexi and her father's assistance to set up a sting operation to track down a dangerous terrorist named Karim Farouk. He was known for using stolen art to fund deadly attacks around the world.

Unfortunately, the sting went sideways, and Lexi's father died in the crossfire. She blamed Danny for it. They discuss this briefly in the present-day, with Danny offering Lexi her father's prayer beads. She admits she found it easier to hate him than to hate herself and they seem to move past it for now.

Anna makes a great addition to the team. With her help, they figure out what Farouk's goal is. He wants to reunite the tombs of Anthony and Cleopatra. It won't be easy, no one knows where Cleopatra is located, but Anna has managed to secure a clue. She drew a picture of a medallion discovered in Anthony's tomb that indicates there is a group of guardians who watch over Cleopatra's tomb.

Anna also theorizes that the group who initially put Anthony and Cleopatra in the tomb all those years ago were also the ones who killed a group of Nazis that tried to escape with the sarcophagus 75 years before.

The final scene of the episode shows a mysterious room with potentially mystical power emanating from it. We find out the male Interpol agent is a traitor and secretly working for this group!

dleman used by terrorist Karim Farouk; Farouk obtains a clue to the location of the sarcophagus of Cleopatra; Lexi looks to Father Chuck

for help deciphering information.



The episode begins in 2019 in Rome, Italy at the Piazza Navona where Lexi Vaziri and Danny McNamara arrive at Father Chuck's; allowing them to squat at his place. Lexi begins to play with one of the swords at his place, causing Chuck to panic. They are there to look for Karin Farouk. Lexi says they can stay at her ex's place as he has plenty of room, not even sure if he is there. Chuck tells Danny that under no circumstances can him and Lexi use his bed; quickly pointing at the painting of Jesus looking at

#### Chuck.

Gwen Karlsson messages Danny about the two of them meeting with her; Lexi initially refusing to worry Interpol would be arresting her, but insists Gwen can wait until she has showered. Simon Hardwick and Gwen are introduced to each other when Lexi gives her the connection between Simon and Danny is they both wanted to capture Farouk; both losing him and now they are there. Hardwick informs them that a secure filing box was taken from a deep storage facility in Cypress; no one knows who owned the box but it was taken by Farouk's associate.

Lexi feels Aiden Shaw is the key to finding Farouk. Lexi feels they should go with her plan since all they have is a grainy photo but she had punched the guy in the face less than 72 hours earlier. Danny zooms in on the video, showing Lexi the picture he is holding is a picture of Cleopatra. Danny tells them all that this is a treasure hunt and suggests they should follow the money back to Farouk.

1944, Northern France 28th Infantry, US Army Intelligence Army Captain meets with Colonel Krug, placing a map in front of him, demanding that Krug point out where the divisions are

hiding and maybe they can all be home by Christmas. Krug shows him a photo of Cleopatra, saying she is their problem. The greatest Queen in Egypt and the greatest Archeological find in history and sits in their hands. He says he will tell the Captain where she is, but he feels that isn't her problem but he is told they will be defeated by a power the world has never seen unless he secures his release; the Captain leaves to check out his claims. While the Captain is gone, the SS Colonel is killed.

2019, Rome Italy Danny, Lexi, Gwen and Asim Masood arrive at the Carabinieri HQ, Medical Unit to visit an injured Aiden Shaw. He's pretending to be sleeping, so Danny and Lexi pretend they are about to stab him in the heart. Lexi informs him that they know he is their only link to the elusive Farouk. He says he won't reveal anything without immunity, but Lexi says she will still stab him. She lectures Danny about ruining her credit, but he doesn't think Farouk can get to him with all the cops protecting him, but Lexi reminds him that they almost let her stab him in the heart.

Outside the room, Masood says there is no paper trail leading back to Farouk. Danny suggests they use Shaw's password and attempt to take some money, triggering Farouk to make a move. Gwen says they can trace the call, after all, realize how dumb Shaw is for taking selfies. Lexi refuses to reveal Masood as Danny explains that Shaw only agreed to give her the password since he has a crush on her and now they are all off to Paris.

Tripoli Farouk's Headquarters where Omar is praised for his good work from Farouk. He opens the filing box and digs through the photos until he finds the one of Cleopatra with the Nazis, learning she was taken to Germany; and he pins the photo to the map saying soon they will have everything they need.

Lexi and Danny arrive at a cafe while Shaw, Masood, and Gwen sit in a surveillance van. Masood is fed up and tells Shaw to simply identify the banker. He tells them he is an old guy with a beard who wears sunglasses even inside. They find Taj in the back room, who are deceived into believing they are Shaw. He begins to read his book, but just as he takes his phone to make the transfer a man walks up to Danny, remembering him as an FBI agent; giving them exit visas for his whole family, insisting he is not mistaken as he named his youngest child after him.

They are dragged into another room, where Taj issues his apologies to Agent Danny as his nephews attempt to beat the duo. After a physical fight, Danny tells them they must have gotten off on the wrong foot; but when more people arrive, Gwen comes in defeats the remaining men. Danny wonders where Lexi is. She is able to jump on Taj, but he gets away. Danny tells her things got out of hand fast when she sees the cut on his forehead. They didn't get the trace but one of his nephews might give information up. Lexi opens the van doors, finding that Shaw is gone. They are all heading back to Rome, with Gwen telling Asim she needs all his paperwork. Lexi reveals to Danny that she got Taj's ledger, suggesting they keep it between them for now; worrying Farouk has a mole inside Interpol. She points the finger at Asim, saying she only trusts Danny and herself when it comes to Farouk.

Asim feels no one is going to betray their family, as Lexi messages Danny about trying a different strategy to figure out the ledger. Danny reminds them that anything they do with torture will be inadmissible in court. Meanwhile, Father Chuck returns to his place, saying he told Danny to use good judgment which meant not giving her a key. She reminds him that Danny did use good judgment and didn't give her a key but she is offering Chuck some tea. She jokes that his snack selection is underwhelming.

She shows Chuck the ledger, saying if she cracks the code they will be one step closer to Farouk. Chuck finally says the "good outweighs the bad;" agreeing to help her. She learns from Chuck that Danny is complicated, even though he never mentioned Chuck before. The good priest informs her that she and Danny have more in common than she thinks. She wants dirt on Danny so Chuck decides to pour himself a drink before dilvuging into those waters.

Gwen interrogates Khalid who insists he isn't a terrorist; he is reminded that he should be afraid of Farouk; suggesting he could turn him over to the authorities and let them deal with him. Masood has an idea, promising to return soon.

Chuck drinks and drinks with Lexi, telling all kinds of stories of him and Danny; saying they go the stupid out of them at an early age. Lexi knows the language, revealing her mother was Christian and her dad was Muslim, but after her mother died she was never caught in the middle after that. Her mother died when Lexi was 8, Chuck feels childhood abandonment leads to what she is doing. She denies it, but Chuck knows better. He returns to look at the ledger and they

figure out the ledger is in Sumerian. He suggests if she wants penance to not break Danny's heart — again!

Danny tries to talk to Khalid as Gwen watches. He understands that they are asking him to violate his most sacred code, but it really isn't them asking this; it is Farouk. They make Khalid watch the video of bombings that Farouk did, murdering women and children; cut and butchered. How honorable is it to honor a man without honor. Khalid disagrees with Farouk, and his interpreter suggests he share the information with Danny; he agrees to help them in their search calling it an honorable transaction with an honorable man.

Danny talks it over with Gwen, revealing that Khalid doesn't have the address. Lexi texts Danny, saying she doesn't have any control issues. He calls and finds out that she is on her way to the address she found. Gwen warns him not to do anything stupid but Asim stops him, insisting that he goes with him.

Asim says if the exchange happened there the safe house has to be close by; a place that has a clear view of the square. Asim wants to go one way, but Danny wants him to wait until Lexi shows up. Asim confronts him about suspecting him about working with Farouk; Danny swears they are just being cautious. Outside an armed guard is waiting for orders on Danny and Asim; being told to take them out if they make a move.

Danny learns Asim is not supposed to be there, his papers missing. He also believes someone in the Egyptian government is working with Farouk. He knows what Danny is thinking, and finding the mole is a good way to blame someone else for the bombing. He knows why Danny wouldn't trust him, but every time he got close to Farouk he had to walk and there is no one he trusts more to have his back than Danny. Asim gives Danny a gun, saying its there in case they don't like the answers to their questions. The gunman is about to fire from the rooftop when Lexi attacks him from behind and his body lands on a car below. She shouts out the address, saying she will meet them inside as gunmen come chasing and shooting after her. Asim and Danny are in the middle of exchanging gunfire when Asim asks if he has seen Lexi. She drops through the skylight on top of another guard. She is able to find the photo of Cleopatra with the Nazis, completely distracted when one of Farouk's men throws a grenade. Asim drops his body on it to save Lexi, and when they turn him over he is fatally wounded, saying this is for his country before he dies.

Danny sits outside in Rome, as Father Chuck finds him on a bench. He recalls a childhood memory of finding Danny like this and suggests they batter up; talking about how they defeated the cheaters from St. Luke's who were only supposed to be 12. When they arrive at the park, Chuck is told to piss off by several of the young men standing around the yard. Chuck mocks that it hurts him on so many levels, giving Danny the baseball bat; Chuck opens his coat revealing he is a priest. They all back off as Father Chuck reminds them all that God loves them!

Chuck and Danny begin to have fun as he smashes the balls out of the park. Chuck asks Danny to stay for a while longer, even saying his girlfriend could visit. Danny misses the ball, telling him to shut up because he doesn't really know what she is. All he knows is someone needs to stop Farouk and he can't do it alone; while Lexi will attempt to do it on her own and get hurt. He frets that if anything happens to her, he doesn't know what he would do. Their chat is interrupted when Lexi sneaks up behind Danny. Danny tells Chuck that this move wasn't cool. Lexi admits she was wrong and feels terrible about Asim and what she believed. Danny feels they forced Farouk to alter his plans and that is how he will start making mistakes; he knows this because that is how he found him the first time.

Lexi pulls out the photo from the safehouse. The photo says Bavaria, 1944 now knowing the Nazis have Cleopatra. Danny informs her that Asim said something about the Egyptian culture being incorporated by the west and the same goes for Cleopatra. Farouk's stealing all of this could be his way of driving everyone into an all-out war. Lexi and Danny feel they should follow the photograph, as Lexi insists he shouldn't worry about her at this time she is ready. Danny wants to know what she meant about not having control issues; something Chuck made her think about.

Behind a tree, where Bruno Fabi is standing, speaking on the phone saying Asim Masood was not the mole in Egypt. He says they are heading to Germany, where they will find her.

Summary: A clue leads Danny and Lexi to a castle where the Germans may have

hidden Cleopatra's sarcophagus; Fabi rescues Dr. Castillo's kidnapped assistant; Hardwick reveals information to Fabi and Gwen about oth-

ers who are searching for Cleopatra.



The search for Cleopatra brought Danny and Lexi to Bavaria. It was where the sarcophagus of the Egyptian Queen was taken once the Nazis raided her grave with Antony. They failed to get their hands on the Roman general, but they did have enough opportunity to take Cleopatra and transfer her back to the fatherland. No sooner was being shown off at dinner parties that Germany was bombed and the Nazis were forced to hide what they stole. They were able to hide her location and their only mistake had

been the one picture they left behind. The Nazis took a photo with the sarcophagus in what appeared to be a castle. The castle was Castle Schadelberg and it could be found through a simple google search.

Then they got snuck with a tour guide that wanted to cover the seven-hundred-year history of the castle rather than the ten years it was occupied by the Nazis, but Lexi and Danny ditched the tour and hid out until the museum closed. And later they snuck out to go searching for the Nazi lair.

The Nazis were firm believers in Aryan mysticism. They wanted to believe they were the superior race and so they followed a man constantly high on various drugs. Its was the drugs that made Hitler so paranoid and that paranoia was lent to his loyal foot soldiers. It took an old painting for Danny to realize the lair was connected to the basement and while he knew his Nazi history it had been Lexi thinking as a thief that opened the lair. They found a reconstruction of Cleopatra's tomb that the Nazis must have set up to display the many treasures they stole from the pyramids and what the treasure hunters didn't find right away was Cleopatra. They were busy looking for the dead queen while Farouk's men were closing in.

The picture they were using had a bunch of a Nazis in it and one child. The child was the granddaughter of an important Nazi official and she was still alive. Meaning Farouk was willing to kill anyone that got in the way of what he wanted and what he wanted was revenge. The episode begins in Paris, France 5th Arrondissement where Danny McNamara and Lexi Vaziri sneak into some secret tunnels under the city. They find an "X" and Danny pulls the wood off; Lexi tells Danny to stay behind because he is just an outsider but if she isn't back in half an hour he is coming to get her.

ROME the police arrive at Father Chuck's apartment, demanding to know where Danny McNamara is. He is hand-cuffed, taken in for questioning regarding the murder of Captain Bruno Fabi.

Lexi comes with a peace offering for Alessandro and Alina, but learns from them that her mother never wanted her to be part of this. Alina says she also cared about Fabi as he taught her everything, just as Lexi's mother taught him. Lexi wants to know if her mother is there and is shown the nameplate for Jamila Vaziri; realizing she has been visiting an empty grave for the past 20 years. She is offered an apology but her mother was a warrior in a much longer struggle. Alina explains the story of why they took people from all lands and cultures to protect these relics. Lexi learns the Brotherhood was nearly destroyed because of the war and this is what her mother gave her life for.

1999 in Alexandria Vaziri Antique Shop Courtyard Jamila tells Lexi that she will be back before she knows it. Jamila promises that someday she will understand why she had to leave, as her mother reminds her that her father is protective but they are truly the protectors; that was the last time Lexi saw her mother alive.

Back to 2019, Lexi introduces Danny to Alina, revealing that she is a full-blown secret society. Alina is given consent to reveal whatever she needs to tell Lexi. Alina informs them that Chuck has been taken into custody; Danny feels they need to go back to Rome but Lexi believes Chuck can handle himself. Alina tells Danny about the CIA contractors gathering intelligence, hiding

in a bunker as his entire family was wiped out; after that, he became radicalized. He is now known as Karim Farouk. She says they have been monitoring his real name but nothing has connected the dots; Lexi says they can help connect the dots as Danny says he has a contact in Iraqi Intelligence he can ask for help.

Danny reveals that his contact learned two people survived the bombing, a Nadia Bishara, who was 5 years old at the time. She disappeared during the firefight. Lexi and Danny believe this could be Farouk's last living relative. Alina gets onto the computer, saying they can hack into the medical records and if they find Nadia they can draw in Farouk; both Danny and Lexi are excited at the prospect of finally catching him.

Chuck continues to be questioned as he says that Lexi has a good heart, just like Danny so he wants to know what this is really about. He believes this is tough since she seems like the type that has everything in military-grade in her life; so the revelation of a secret society might make her question everything she believes about the world. She says she is 4th generation police and was taught to follow the rules. Chuck says it is not Danny and Lexi who are keeping her up at night; she admits that the Italian police are shutting her out. He says there are the laws of God that are about what is just and the laws of man which are about what is legal. The first one can never be broken, not so much about the second.

Danny and Lexi are off to find Farouk as Alina says she has to stay there, and this is now Lexi's choice as to whether she wants to join the secret society and when the time is right Lexi will know what to do.

Danny and Lexi arrive at the hospital, showing her that Karim Farouk is a wanted criminal and now she has the chance to stop him; with one phone call, saying Nadia has taken a bad turn and he is needed immediately to come. They assure her that even though Nadia is to be bait, she will not be harmed. Farouk receives the call, willing to risk it all even though they are so close to their goal. He says if anything happens to him, his orders are clear and they are to finish the job!

Lexi reassures Danny they can handle this as the doctor brings out Nadia, which is Farouk's niece. She leaves her on the grounds, before giving Lexi a very odd nod. Lexi spots a man approaching Nadia but he spots Lexi's gun as he hugs Nadi and runs back into the hospital; both Danny and Lexi giving chase. Danny shouts to Farouk that it is over, he raises his hands but gunfire erupts from an approaching car. Farouk is upset that he didn't follow orders but is told he can thank him later.

Danny and Lexi learn from the doctor that Nadia is okay but upset; as far as she knows her uncle is a good man and the only family she has. Lexi is furious with herself for not taking the shot; feeling she is soft and weak because of Danny as she only thought about the little girl who would see her only family member die right in front of her. Danny believes they may have a way to find Farouk as he dropped his bag. The bag reveals it is from a region in Cyprus that has been a haven for illegal activity. Danny says that Farouk rushed here from Cypress and he would need to get immediately back there to finish his plans. Lexi feels they are lucky to have a shady antiquities dealer on their side.

Paris, Lexi greets Simon Hardwick at their private jet. He is disappointed this is not a long distance booty call as Danny reveals they believe Farouk is in Cyprus but they need his help into nailing down where Farouk is. Lexi stops their bickering, saying this is their best chance. Simon wants legitimacy in exchange for helping them. Lexi doesn't care where he stands when they reveal Cleopatra to the world. He explains that he dealt with pirates, saying the name of the ship always chances but if Farouk is in Cyprus he is using the pirates for sure. Danny doesn't want to bring Simon along but Lexi agrees with him. She doesn't trust Simon but she trusts his hatred for Farouk; they joke about Arabian Sea Pirates before boarding the plane.

Danny calls Gwen Karlsson, but she tells him that she cannot talk right now, after sneaking into a police protected place. She cuts the tape and enters the room, fiding several papers and files hidden in a violin case. Some policemen approach the apartment, causing Gwen to hide as they demand to know who is there; but they find no one nor anything as she is hiding on the ledge outside, several stories high.

In Cyprus — Port of Famagusta, Danny, Lexi and Simon lurk in the shadows, finding a lot of fire power. Simon reminds them it is an illegal port, Danny asks for backup but Simon tells Lexi she shouldn't trust the Brotherhood, also telling Lexi that if she gets the chance she needs to kill Farouk. Simon tells them they are holding a lot more information than they know and he will tell them another time. Simon walks out into the open, going to talk to the guards, saying he knows

them from the football game, He says he can get them really good tickets, but Lexi and Danny are able to subdue them; feeling they make a really good team.

They race through the shipyard with their guns drawn, spotting Farouk's wheelman; knowing Farouk isn't far behind. They all agree they will not allow Farouk onto the ship; Danny reminds them they are trying to take Farouk alive if possible. They use the cover of crates and shipping bins to get closer to Farouk; but Simon knocks over a metal bar causing gunfire to erupt. Farouk jumps into a forklift while Lexi and Danny continue to exchange fire with Farouk's men and the pirates.

Lexi climbs one of the shipping crates while Danny walks on the ground. Farouk orders his men to get into the ship when he spots Lexi. A shot rings out and both Lexi and Danny realize Simon killed Farouk. Danny assures Simon that Farouk cannot hurt him nor anyone before, helicopters arrive and Simon wants to leave. Lexi tells him to stay put since he wanted to be a hero and should be acknowledged as the man who killed the most wanted terrorist. Simon quietly tells Lexi that there is more to the Brotherhood than she knows and it has to do with her father.

Danny and Lexi admire the Sarcophagus as Danny feels that Farouk's plans didn't end with his death. Lexi thought she would feel good now that he was dead but all she feels is numb. Danny apologizes to Gwen for the way they left things as she admits she broke into Fabi's apartment and stole the secret files from his work. She says Father Chuck told him she could do it as he was investigating a different angle on Farouk and wants to know if Danny will work with her to find out what he was planning. They both feel this is weird, promising to work together. Lexi doesn't know what Fabi was investigating but she knows who does and has a lot of questions for him.

Lexi returns to the secret society, bringing in a blindfolded Danny, who promises he can be discreet, but is in awe of what he sees. Lexi questions Alessandro who admits that Fabi was looking into the Farouk file she stole but wasn't ready to believe the story she said and wanted to know more about the mystery surrounding her father's death. Fabi's conclusions died with him as Danny is upset that they didn't work together earlier to capture Farouk. Danny and Lexi are in Russia where they find a dead scientist, feeling they would have known they were coming there eventually after the raid. Danny orders to get everyone out of there immediately as he touches a strange substance on the table.

They have to believe that Farouk's crew is carrying on with his plan and now they have a biological weapon.

He demanded that Reece tell him everything and the man only told him about his part in the Fensgate Heist. He went on to tell Danny that he's been like a son to him and so Danny couldn't find it in himself to push. He left Reece alone and later Reece received another guest.

Ana went to Reece because she told him that Farouk's men would use the opportunity to attack. She also learned that Zara Farouk was actually their Farouk's mother and that Reece was Farouk's father.

Reece had set up a trust fund for his son, but Farouk used the money to fund terrorism and

so Reece did everything possible to bury the secret of their connection. Reece even killed Ana so that the truth would never get out.

The episode begins with crime scene checking out the poisoning that happened at Jay Reece's place. Danny Mc-Namara suggests that Jay put the unveiling of Anthony and Cleopatra on hold until Faroiuk is caught. Danny questions Lexi Vaziri about the poison being in the wine as Farouk poisoned two other people, but it was a contact poison; something doesn't add up for him.

Father Chuck walks into the apartment, learning that Dr. Ana Castillo is dead. Danny says supposedly she was

poisoned by wine from Farouk's crew, but he has his doubts. Chuck tells him about what he learned from Egypt, that Farouk's father is Jay Reece, and it was Castillo that signed for the package with the information. She went directly to him with the secret, but their conversation is interrupted when Gwen Karlsson who tells them about some email exchanges saying, "In current game, my King is going to be captured. How should I proceed?"

They learn that Gazal was Reece's mole, not Farouk's. Gwen confirms there has been money exchanged. It was a capture mission, couldn't risk Farouk talking. He was willing to keep a terrorist on the loose rather than exposing his secret. Danny is devastated to learn that he was being used since day one and murdered Castillo to keep his secret. Lexi wants to go talk to Danny, but Gwen stops her, saying she has more for her that concerns her as well as Danny.

Lexi joins Danny on the roof, where she offers him ice for his hand. She makes shim promise to not kill himself when she reveals that the box of paperwork showed them that Reece is Farouk's father. It was her father that promised he would handle it and that was in the office safe; in the file, she stole. He realizes that Reece had her father killed making it look like Farouk did it. He admits they have come a long way, him breaking his hand on a wall and her coming up to him, trying to figure out what to do. He apologizes, vowing to get justice for her father. He feels maybe the brotherhood has what they need to take him down.

Lexi makes the call and finds out the military is there to stop the transport that is carrying a biotoxin that is set to arrive for the unveiling of Anthony and Cleopatra. Lexi's call is cut short when the trucks arrive and stop. They surround the men and begin shooting them all, but when she opens the back of the truck it is a bomb that detonates immediately, killing all the militant around them. Back at the apartment, Lexi, Danny, and Chuck watch the news as Gwen reveals they found several bodies with the medallions on them, but there are no survivors. Gwen feels the attack is over as Lexis says they gave their lives to stop this. Danny wants Gwen to confirm the toxin, she promises they will be in touch. Chuck answers the door where they all receive personal invitations to the unveiling; they feel this is the best chance to catch them off balance, but Lexi can't promise to rip his throat out with her bare hands.

Danny and Lexi are welcomed right in, but Father Chuck is stopped and checked over by security, only finding his medallion. They walk into the Ana Castillo Wing, learning that Reece isn't there yet. Chuck gives them their weapons as they review their plan. Simon Hardwick finds them, saying he will get out of there as soon as they can as the valet line is ridiculously long, encouraging them to do the same.

The museum guard spots one of the doors is taped open, but before he can react, a green light is on his chest. Meanwhile, Danny and Lexi watch as Jay Reece unveils Anthony and Cleopatra; everyone is given their medal for being heroes of the ark. Lexi plants a bug on Jay when she hugs him. She leaves him to chat with Danny, who takes him aside. Danny warns him that the real Karim Farouk could still be out there unless he took care of all the loose ends. Danny reminds him that he knows people like him who have needed to cross lines to protect themselves; Reece excuses himself, thanking him for the heads up. Reece realizes that Danny must know and wouldn't be surprised if he is wired. Lexi follows the men away from the exhibit, but when she tries to open the door it doesn't budge. Father Chuck is called away by security.

Danny wants to know why Simon and his partner are refusing to take pictures, but he is told that they got close to a confession from Reece but the bug went dead. Danny thinks the recording will be enough, but Gwen calls him to inform him they have a problem, as there were no toxins in the trucks. Danny and lexi realize that one of Farouk's men were dressed up a security guard and if he is there, the truck explosion was a misdirection. Danny becomes very suspicious of Simon, saying he was there from the very beginning; he has been there at every step of the hunt. Lexi and Danny look at each other, as he realizes Simon is the real Karim Farouk and the attack is about to take place there.

We are brought back to a time when Simon was held captive, where he talks about the terrorist are the price of doing business. He shares on the map that all the holdings belong to one man — Jacob Reece; whose family has been bleeding the lands for generations. He reminds them to slay the beast you must kill from the heart. Simon speaks to Karim, saying the Americans must be looking for him, although they are looking for Karim's face, not his. He feels he can manipulate the Americans from the inside, saying he could feed them information, saying Hassin shall now be Karim Farouk, a name that haunts them for the rest of their lives. Back to the present day, Danny calls Gwen, who will alert the Egyptian authorities, asking her to get the police to prepare an antidote for at least 300 people; Lexi and Danny are left alone, wondering where Chuck is. Lexi says they need to clear out the place immediately but are stopped when they are tasered unconscious. The two wake up tied to chairs; Danny tells their captures that they need to stop Farouk, but Zara Farouk doesn't buy their story, demanding to know who else knows about Castillo. She threatens Chuck, saying he will die if they don't start talking.

Simon walks up to Reece, saying they almost met years ago. He tells Reece that he knew his mother, someone who had a rare disease from a rare toxin that was slowly killing her. Simon came to see him for the urgent care she needed, but he was turned away when Reece denied he was his son. Simon stops Reece from walking away, saying his mother was shamed for being a single mother and that his mother took the money he gave her to send Simon off to a private school. Reece wants Simon to leave immediately, but Simon tells him that no one is leaving.

Several men come in shooting, saying that he gave a vessel his rage, but he gave that vessel his real name so Reece would know that his son was out there and would be coming for him. He tells him that Reece's day of reckoning has arrived and presses the button on his phone. Gases pour into the room, he injects himself with the antidot4e, saying he is going to watch his father die with all the other people; just like he watched his mother die, only Reece would go quicker.

Danny continues to talk to Zara, as he and Lexi continue to loosen their hands; their security

detail arrives and distracts them long enough for Lexi and Danny to break free. Shaw gets shot trying to protect Danny and Chuck and is thoroughly disappointed that he can't even die heroically when his medal takes the bullet for him. He tells Shaw to get Chuck somewhere safe when they go after Simon.

Simon is tormenting Reece about what the toxins are doing to him. Reece insists he never knew but Simon feels he never cared. Danny spots all the armed men, as Simon continues to confront Reece; saying they are finally there with the whole story for the world to know. How he abandoned a child, murdered to keep a secret and now the secret ended up murdering him. Lexi pulls her gun on Zara, who wonders if it is worth dying to find out if Zara is the one who killed her father. Lexi withdraws her gun, suggesting they end this like ladies. Both remove their shoes and begin to physically fight. Meanwhile, Danny faces another obstacle when he shoots at the bulletproof glass. Lexi beats her, throwing her through the glass and points the gun at Zara, saying she won't kill her as he wouldn't do it. Danny finds a spool of cable and swings into the museum, saying he would totally do it.

Gwen and the police arrive as Chuck tells Danny he as medical training and can give Reece the antidote. Danny tells him to let him die, as he killed Lexi's father and ruined his father's life, murdered Castillo and no one knows how many other people. Danny won't let him get away with it but Lexi says his worst nightmare will come true as his family legacy is ruined; something he will watch from behind bars. Lexi continues to try to stop him, taking the antidote and injecting him, saying she will not allow Reece to destroy Danny's life too; they suddenly realize Simon is gone.

Gwen, Danny, and Lexi review the case with the Egyptian police; saying they can get the information from Carlo; the General agrees to make a deal. Danny gets Gwen to deputize him before they went after Simon.

In Seychelles, Simon is relaxing on the beach, when Lexi walks up asking where he comes up with the names. Danny explains how he is not getting them tracking bad guys through their treasure things. Danny tells Karim Farouk aka Simon Hardwick that he is under arrest. Simon says this was nothing personal to them, it was revenge for his mother and hoped they could at least understand that. Simon reminds them he did give them the warning to get out of the gala, and he really likes them, saying they are practically on the same side. Danny tells him if he looks at the gun one more time under the newspaper, Danny will shoot him. Simon feels they only thing he is responsible for is killing Hassin, and he really isn't the bad guy.

Lexi tells him it is nothing personal as Danny says he really is the bad guy and handcuffs him before handing him off to Gwen. He says he will be seeing the two of them soon since the world is such a small place these days.

Back in Cairo, opening night of Antony and Cleopatra Exhibit takes place. The team, Danny, Lexi, Shaw, and Chuck observe in silence as Danny's hands back his badge to Gwen, causing her and Chuck to smile at each other before she leaves. Shaw shows Lexi his check and waves goodbye. Chuck and Danny hug each other before Chuck leaves the two of them alone. Danny takes Lexi by the hand as she thanks him for not listening to her when she said she never wanted to see him again. Danny grabs her, brushes her hair away and kisses her as others wander through the exhibit.

to take over the weapons check at the club, while Danny and Lexi look around for a man with a branded hand. The episode opened with Danny, Lexi and a very reluctant Shaw putting on a performance for the listening device they had discovered, so as to bait Kate and her CIA pals into following Lexi to a made-up meet-up. When the time for said assignation rolled around, and as Kate & Co. tailed Lexi, Shaw and pint-sized Han created a streetside distraction, allowing Danny to isolate and confront his ex-fiancee — though not long before Lexi showed up to taser the duplicitous blonde.

Tied up back at Shaw's place, Kate was wholly uncooperative, saying not a peep. While Chuck watched over Kate, Danny and Lexi went downstairs to see what Vince had gleaned from a cell phone pinched from Zhang last week. The only noteworthy lead was a series of calls to a "Graham Townsend" — aka Simon Hardwick. 



Oh, and she has an underground nuke ready to detonate/kill millions! The Superintendent chose to play it safe and not let this quartet of "Westerners" get in harm's way, so he locked them up in the basement.

Luckily, Danny uncovered a boarded-

up set of stairs, and the four made a run for it just as Violet and her goons infiltrated the PD and started shooting/fwip!ping cops dead, after plunging the city into a blackout. But by the time Violet got to the vault holding the banner, it was gone — pinched by a gloating Simon.

Simon eventually turned the banner back over to Violet, as he scampered off to co-opt her getaway plan. Danny and Lexi went after Violet, while Shaw and Chuck headed to deal with the nuke.
