Tom says they checked the dental records, the dead bodies are confirmed as the missing elderly people and there is a new missing person, Caspian Cole, 80 years old.

We see the same two young teenagers that were in the car, they are meeting up with another boy who gives the boy a weapon that looks like a machine gun, but is a piece of debris — he tells her they are on track, they just need to find more.

She tells him that he did papers on children's nightmares, he was obsessed with neurological computers. He says everything he heard, he doesn't sound like someone that would just jet off to Greece. She says, and Cyprus, he was there too.

She asks him why he is asking her about her father. He tells her that he is alive. She says she knows and she knows that he and Maddox knew. She asks what he knows about it. She tells him they have to stop, he says he can't live without her and this was a gift given to them. She tells him that they have already had their gift, a life with each other. He is afraid if she goes back, she will die the next day and forget to wait for him.

Kurt left the debris, he and Clara walk away. They have chosen to walk away and die together, now. A hazmat team picks up the piece of debris. Bryan is in the woods looking for them and finds the backpack that Kurt was holding.

Maddox is with Irina, she has a briefcase with another piece of debris. She wants to know why he wants this communication frequency, he says because it works.

Bryan and Finola are back in the car together, she tells him that he can trust her, she knows it wasn't easy for him to tell her about his orders.

She says she can't trust Ferris and he can't trust Maddox, there is something going on that neither of them understands. He tells her that they are going through her apartment. They traced the calls that came from Anson Ash's phone, they are from Maine.

He was offered fifty thousand dollars, he left that morning to do the trade. Liam's daughter, Caroline walks in and Luke tells her to give them a moment. Luke goes on to say that his brother has been acting weird, intense and he has only seen that with guys in Afghanistan.

Bryan asks if they could look at his laptop and the marsh where his brother found the pieces. Finola thinks the debris maybe took control of them all. Kathleen is in the kitchen, she can see her brother and Bryan in another reality, they can see them too.

Finola is looking at Bryan, he writes a note, but when he turns it around, they vanish. Kathleen says the other people can't see them but they can, that must mean something. Finola says she can't deny what she just witnessed but her father thinks the universe is in a state where it can't take her visiting the debris again. Kathleen says it is her fault, she insisted her brother do the jumps in the first place and needs to fix this. Kathleen runs out of the house and down the hill, and again, she jumps.

Finola is with Grace in the SUV, they are at the location where Kathleen jumped. Then, the two head to the house again, outside there is a reality cloud, on the upper level of the house. Finola says she will have to clear the house, Kathleen says she knows, this is not the first time she has been here. Kathleen tells her about her brother and Bryan, she spoke to them and they want to speak to Finola.

They head in the kitchen, Bryan turns around his note pad and it says another version of you was on the verge of the answer, something about a bilateral deviation and he has no clue what that means. Bryan tells her no more time. Bryan is gone. Kathleen and Finola head outside, Grace is there and they see a helicopter coming, Finola tells them they have no more time. Kathleen urges her to jump with her, they can take the information and start over again with the knowledge they have now.

Finola is back, she calls her father and tells him that he is going to have to get them to stand down, she needs more time. Finola is back in the house with Kathleen, she tells her that they all need to jump together, to put things back to where they began. They synchronize their watches, they all head outside and run. Finola asks Kathleen if they will remember everything once they are back in their realities, Kathleen doesn't know.

They all jump and are inside the tunnel. Then we see Bryan and Finola together, they stop by the ocean, then back to the house. Shelby and Kathleen say hi, Shelby tells Bryan to come in, he will tell him what he knows. Meanwhile, Craig is in his office, he gets a message about a lunch appointment missed, but he didn't have one. He then calls Julia, gets the answering machine, and hands them up. Craig arrives home and finds an envelope on the kitchen table. He sits down and opens it up, it is divorce papers.

Anson is giving back his dinner tray and grabs the guard's hand who tells him that he is writing him up on a report for that. The guard then enters the code to the security gate and Anson can read it in his mind, he smiles.

rive at another debris site.

Inevitably, this brings our pair to the site, who rock up in hazmat suits themselves. Bryan approaches as the girl whispers details surrounding his time in Afghanistan.

Bringing her back to the lab, Bryan tries in vain to learn more from her. Only, she repeats important conversations from his life; fragments of important moments linking back to Afghanistan. And then he's whisked off to the dry, choked deserts, complete with a really awful fake beard. As he relives moments in Surobi, Finola is forced to try and save her partner.

In Afghanistan, Bryan continues on his mission but finds a young woman called Asalah. Bryan promises that her grandfather will be safe and that he'll find the man.

As the soldiers all begin talking among themselves, Muriel broadcasts the exact details of their conversation as it happens in the dream sequence to those outside. Finola believes this could

well be linked back to when Bryan was cloned in Pennsylvania. In essence, we could be looking at a hive mind situation, with Bryan's memories "backed up" in a network of debris.

Back in Afghanistan, Asalah and Bryan grow closer together. On the eve of an important mission, Bryan tells Asalah to leave and take her grandfather to safety as well. As the fighting gets underway, Bryan suddenly stands up in the middle of everything and looks down at the dead body of Asalah — she's been shot. She was killed in the ensuing skirmish, leaving Bryan in a bit of a mess.

After laying her down, Bryan turns around and finds Muriel sitting on her chair in his vision. He's confused and unsure why he was forced to relive this memory again. As he steps up to her, he's suddenly whisked out of this vision. He snaps out of his unconscious state and bolts upright. In doing so, he learns that Muriel has died.

Bryan reflects back on his time with Finola in the aftermath of all this. With a picture of Asalah, Bryan admits that he carries this with him as a reminder of what it's like to invest in something he could lose.

Stuffing the picture in his pocket, Finola and Bryan reflect on the true nature of the debris. They're both in agreement — the debris and humanity are both studying and learning from one another. For what reason the debris is doing this however, remains to be seen. It does seem to be taking a big interest in Bryan though.

As the episode closes out, we cut to Arizona where an Indian man lays out on a mat and stares at the sunset.

However, that theory is thrown out when Bryan, Finola and the others head inside and see what's happening with their own eyes. In the darkness of the warehouse, they find a worker called Zimmer alongside several others who are all being controlled in some way. The debris boxes continue to move, seemingly being thrown through a pocket in time/space and spat out the other side.

He's got coordinates for the map-maker piece of debris but the signal is weak. After spying a strange swirling humanoid creature out in the woods, he's clearly erratic and struggling.

Anyway, they make it to ground zero where we saw all those people from before, standing and crying. They're all facing

East and each seem to be entranced, seemingly affected before arriving at this location.

With George joining them for this investigation, the trio set out to find the debris piece to examine exactly what it's doing. When everyone bursts out laughing, George deduces that this is a sign of emotional convergence; a way of bringing together emotionally charged individuals going through heightened moments in their life.

George finds the debris piece, which is glittering in the sunlight as he approaches. Together, they begin to study it. George deduces that they need to sever the link between the people and the debris piece in order to move it. However, that also comes at a consequence — the people will have their memories erased completely.

There's no time to come up with an alternate plan, and that stems from the fact INFLUX operatives are en-route. It turns out George Jones actually phoned them and he's the one responsible.

George wasn't killed after all and in fact actually took his own life to allow himself to be reborn. It turns out this debris piece is just a small part of a much larger whole. George intends to enable it to help transform the human mind. He wants to help take humanity to a higher plane of existence.

Speak of the devils, Anson meets Otto (notably played by John Noble who was Walter Bishop in *Fringe*!) He sports a drop of blood on his face too; a direct result of murdering and contorting different individuals inside a gas station. They hit the road and prepare to head up to the debris site.

They eventually manage to blindside Finola and hold her up at gunpoint. Otto walks with him, where George mentions how a "telesphere was born yesterday. It came from a pocket dimension inside Orbital and its birth may have triggered the debris".

Using electronic equipment, the group begin severing the connection between the debris and the people facing East. They do it slowly, with each of the Influx members (and Finola) given a pill to make sure their memories stay intact. Bryan is sadly going to be a sacrifice in all this, along with the 50 other, brainwashed individuals.

The blast sends everyone to the group, with their memories wiped and the debris piece able to be moved into George's car. Bryan staggers up and finds himself struggling. However, he somehow still holds his memories intact.

Otto checks him and realizes that he's the "Third man" in all this. His identity has been hidden all this time and he's key to what's happening.

Heading inside a cave the camera pans across to show another Finola, this one locked in stasis. What does it all mean?
