

Summary: Peter, an FBI agent stationed in Jerusalem who, while investigating a

murder of a young female archaeologist, uncovers a conspiracy 2000

years in the making.



Peter Connelly, an FBI agent stationed in Jerusalem, is on a mission to track down Yussef Khalid, a Palestinian American believed to have murdered the son of a senator on American soil. As Peter closes in on the suspect, he runs into Detective Golan Cohen of the Israeli Police, who is also after Khalid, but for a local robbery. This isn't the first time these two have stepped on each other's jurisdictional toes. After a pursuit through East Jerusalem, Detective Cohen apprehends Khalid. Peter, however, comes upon a

young redheaded woman—it's like he is seeing a ghost. But she disappears before he can figure out if she's real.

Josh, who is about to turn thirteen, is living in a walled, windowless compound in a remote part of New Mexico. Tad Billingham, the pastor in charge, says that Josh is "ready," though he doesn't explain for what. Josh's caretaker, Debbie, doesn't agree but Billingham squashes her concerns. He proceeds to tell Josh that the time has come for him to fulfill his destiny.

Meanwhile, far from Jerusalem, Avram, a twenty-year old orthodox Jewish man, has been left in charge of a rare red calf in a remote part of Norway by Rabbi Lev. Rabbi Lev gives him a gun and tells Avram he will soon have to take the red calf on a dangerous journey, but he is not told where or why.

Later that evening, outside of a café in the Old City, Peter finds the striking redheaded young woman, an archaeology fellow from UPenn working on a dig in the tunnels beneath the city led

by a famous British archaeologist, Ian Margrove. She leads him through a secret door down to the site of her dig, and they decide to take swim in an underground natural pool. The midnight romance comes to an abrupt end when they hear religious chanting and the cries of a baby lamb. They sneak back out of the tunnel, and she slips a small stone into Peter's pants pocket.

The next morning, Peter finds Detective Cohen in Lynn's office. Cohen reports that they found the body of a young woman named Emma Wilson with multiple stab wounds to the torso and neck. The only lead they have is security camera footage of her walking with a man, but his face is blurry. Peter sees that it's him and the redheaded girl and confides with Lynn that he wants in on the case, but Lynn has reservations.

Back at the compound, Faye, Billingham's right hand, rushes in to report that Josh has escaped. While everyone is distracted looking for Josh, Debbie sneaks into a forbidden hallway that's identical to the one she and Josh have been living in. There she comes upon Josh, but she is shocked when she realizes he's not "her" Josh. He may look the same, but this Josh is acting very differently. Meanwhile, Faye has caught up to the real Josh along the road. He begs to be forgiven, but she says now that his feet have touched the ground he can't come back. She raises her gun and shoots.

Peter is tasked with making sure Khalid's extradition handoff goes smoothly and that Khalid is safely delivered to US soil. While taking a detour to avoid traffic, Peter's vehicle is hit by another car—clearly, a planned ambush to allow Khalid to escape. Peter gives chase but loses Khalid, though he realizes he has wound up in front of Emma's apartment building. He goes inside and discovers her apartment has been ransacked. Khalid is there with a gun and tells Peter to empty his pockets. Peter is surprised to find the precious stone Emma gave him, which Khalid grabs and take off.

When Peter is back his hotel room, he finds a drawing of the same stone in Emma's diary. Suddenly, he hears police cars pulling up outside of the hotel. He hides the diary just as there's banging on his door.

Summary: Peter searches for the murderer while also pursuing Yussef Khalid;

and forms an uneasy alliance with Det. Golan Cohen while dealing with an unexpected revelation. In other events, Avram begins his journey to Israel with the red heifer; and Billingham and his disciplines

prepare Josh for a life-changing event.



Detective Cohen has brought Peter down to the police station to find out why Agent Connelly botched the transport of Yussef Khalid. Golan presses him, but before he can get any hard answers Lynn shows up with some questions of her own. Peter admits that he's the mystery man in the security footage with Emma Wilson and that he suspects Emma and Khalid are connected. There's something bigger going on than the murder of one girl

At the compound in New Mexico, Billingham has summoned Debbie. He

knows she saw things she shouldn't, but he promises to explain in due time. In the meantime, he asks her to reafirm her commitment to their cause.

Haim, who looks like he could've once been an Israeli Mossad agent, arrives at the farm in Norway to move Avram and the red calf. Before they leave, Haim kills Olaf, the old farmer, because he didn't take the threat from the Essenes seriously and let the boy go outside with "Red." But as Haim, Avram and the calf near the airfield, they encounter an Essene, who shoots at them, landing a bullet in Haim's gut as they make their getaway.

Meanwhile, Yussef Khalid is still in Jerusalem. With the CCTV cameras throughout the city, Golan and Peter will be able to track him when he makes his next move. But Peter will need to

move quickly because Golan is close to gathering the information he needs to arrest Peter for Emma's murder.

The "new" Josh doesn't flinch when Billingham gives him the same news about not having parents as he told the original Josh. Josh also doesn't waver when he hears it's time for his Bar Mitzvah. Debbie, still emotional from the loss of "her" Josh, seizes the opportunity to steal keys to an SUV but is stopped by the boy, who asks if he can rely on her for moral support during the ceremony. Reluctantly, she aborts her escape.

Peter returns to the underground dig site where Emma took him, but Golan is already there. Peter has no choice but to explain what happened the night he met Emma. He tells Golan that he thinks Emma was meant to give Khalid the same stone she slipped into Peter's pocket. Golan then makes the connection between the stone and the ancient breastplate found in Khalid's backpack.

During Josh's strange Bar Mitzvah ceremony at the compound, a black and white calf is brought into the chapel. Billingham hands the boy a long knife and says, "The first one is the hardest. It gets easier." After Josh meets Debbie's anxious gaze, he raises the knife and slays the calf.

Haim brings Avram and the red calf to the shipping port and instructs the boy to take a boat to Croatia, where someone else will meet them. The Essene arrives soon after, but the ship has already pulled out of port. The Essene checks the truck, but Haim is already dead from his gunshot wound.

Golan gets a call that Khalid is being tracked on CCTV. Peter follows Khalid on foot, while Golan directs him by watching the security cameras. Peter is surprised to see that Khalid is headed toward the U.S. Consulate, where Ambassador Ridell is hosting a large reception. Inside, Ambassador Ridell excuses herself from her table and retreats to confines of her dark office. She is annoyed that Khalid has interrupted her during the function, but she is not alarmed by his presence. He hands her the stone that he took from Peter and she uses a Geiger counter to verify the stone's provenance. There's only one stone left to find—but it's the most difficult one.

Summary: Peter's pursuit of Khalid dead ends; and he and Cohen follow clues

found in Emma's journal. In other events, Debbie takes Josh for an unauthorized outing; and Avram continues his journey to Jerusalem.



After having tracked Yussef Khalid to the U.S. Consulate, Peter interrupts the state dinner to alert Lynn and Ambassador Ridell of the threat posed to their lives. Ridell orders the building to be evacuated and searched. Ultimately, no proof of Khalid even entering the building is found, which makes Peter look worse than he already does.

Avram is seasick and miserable on his vessel's voyage from Sweden to Croatia. He doesn't have any food for himself or Red, and the hostile crew is unwilling to

help him, even after he shakily threatens them with his gun. One crewmember easily disarms him, by punching him in the, but then later, that same crewmember comes below deck with offer Avram food. Avram appreciates the initiation rite and promptly donates the meager fare to Red.

Billingham asks Debbie and Faye to take Joshua into town for the first time to have some fun. Faye is unhappy that she must include Debbie after the trouble she caused, but Billingham says she needs to trust that he has his reasons. On the way, Debbie apologizes, but Faye is resentful that she personally had to clean up Debbie's mess and says that the original Josh's blood is on Debbie's hands, not hers.

Yussef, now transformed into a clean-cut, well-dressed businessman posing as a buyer of rare coins for a well-known collector, arrives at a seaside mansion to see Mr. Ingmar, a rare antiquities dealer. Mr. Ingmar takes him inside a locked vault to inspect the coins, where Yussef spies the elusive twelfth breastplate stone among Ingmar's antiquities. Mr. Ingmar tells him it's priceless and therefore not for sale.

Peter returns to Emma's apartment looking for more clues. When a deliveryman arrives with papers for Emma from the Science & Antiquities Group, Peter and Golan decide to make it the next stop in their investigation. When they arrive there they meet Alon, a forensic expert, who tells them that Emma wanted to test something she found at the dig site. Alon was willing to help her because she seemed scared. The DNA test revealed that the substance found in a clay pot from the excavation site came from a cow.

While Joshua plays a video game at a diner, Debbie sees a cop walk in. She excuses herself to the bathroom and jumps out of the window to call someone named Charlie. Debbie hasn't been in touch with Charlie for three years but begs him to wire her money so she can escape. He refuses, thinking that she's using drugs again. Debbie manages to climb back into the bathroom before Faye comes looking for her. As Faye notices the open the window, Debbie punches Faye and a scuffle ensues, with Faye falling against the sink, unconscious. Debbie grabs Joshua and they run outside to find the police officer.

While Peter and Golan are getting sandwiches, Peter sees a place called Café Sergei, which he recognizes from a napkin tucked into Emma's journal. He matches the map she drew on the napkin with the view. A sign on the Jewish Heritage Center across the way says #19 in Hebrew—relating to what Emma had cryptically written in her diary, "It's all about #XIX." He goes into the center's courtyard and under a glass case is the Book of Numbers opened to Chapter 19, which refers to the red heifer without defect or blemish that has never been under yoke. Thinking Peter and Golan are there for a tour, a young woman explains that the center is dedicated to the history of the temple. Rabbi Lev, who's the head of the center, passes by, eyeing them suspiciously. Peter pretends to go to the bathroom but instead sneaks into the basement. Rabbi Lev follows him and asks how Peter heard about the center. Peter shows him a photo of Emma, pretending she's his niece but Lev doesn't register any recognition of her.

After they leave, Golan is fed up with Peter dragging him around without explaining why these places are relevant. Peter brings Golan back to his hotel room to show him the journal, but the room has been ransacked. Luckily the journal is still there, but Golan is angry that Peter stole and concealed evidence. Then a security guard from the Jewish Heritage Center shows up. It turns out that he's part of Shin Bet, the Israeli secret police, and has been embedded at the JHC for eighteen months because they're considered an extremist group. He tells them Emma never set foot in the place and there's no connection to their case. He warns Peter and Golan to keep their noses out of the JHC.

At the police station in New Mexico, the cop tells Debbie that she has to sign her statement about what happened to Josh and then they'll start investigating. Soon after, Billingham walks into the police station. Clearly the cop called him. Joshua says to Billingham, "I told you she would fail."

Yussef goes to a gay nightclub where he "happens" to run into Mr. Ingmar's handsome body-guard. After some flirtation, they go out to Yussef's car. Within moments, Khalid has subdued the bodyguard and has the security key to Ingmar's vault in hand. Yussef then breaks into Ingmar's mansion to steal the stone, but the Geiger counter he has in tow reveals the stone to be a fake.

Angry that they wasted precious time sending Khalid after a fake twelfth stone, Ambassador Ridell has called an emergency meeting with Professor Margrove and Rabbi Lev. Margrove claims there was no way of knowing the stone wasn't real. Rabbi Lev is certain they will find the real one but in the meantime, he's more concerned about Peter Connelly nosing around the JHC. Ridell says she'll take care of him.

Summary: Peter's obsession with Emma's murder leads him to uncover an an-

cient coded secret.



Peter learns that Rabbi Lev was involved in a plot to blow up the Temple Mount in 1991, but Shin Bet never pressed charges. What if Lev has renewed his efforts to rebuild the Temple? Not only would the Arab world erupt, but also it could set off a chain of events akin to a third World War. Golan is starting to agree with Peter that this whole thing is bigger than the murder of one girl.

When the ship carrying Avram and Red docks in Croatia, they are met by a warm man named Emil and his beautiful

daughter, Elena, who immediately makes Avram both uncomfortable and excited. The Essene, Shem, looks on as they drive off with Red hidden in a crate in the back of Emil's truck.

Meanwhile, Ambassador Ridell has summoned Lynn to her office to tell her she needs to get Peter under control. She also cautions Lynn that if she's intimately involved with Peter, she's compromising herself.

To get intel on Rabbi Lev, Peter and Golan pay a visit to Rabbi Shimon, Golan's uncle. Shimon says that even if the JHC gets all the stones and the breastplate, they'd need an unblemished red heifer and a high priest born from the lineage of the First High Priest, raised in isolation from birth without his feet ever touching the ground to fulfill the prophecy. He explains that the stones were scattered to the four corners of the earth, hidden for safekeeping. However, there may be a clue to the whereabouts of one of them in the War Tablet, written by the Essenes, an ancient religious sect that once lived by the Dead Sea.

In New Mexico, Charlie has been going from town to town trying to find Debbie. The waitress at the local diner tells him that she suspects Debbie is at Billingham's compound. Her suspicions are proved to be correct when we see Debbie chained to a pole in a locked room at the compound. Even Sandra, the woman who delivers her food, won't help her.

Emil gives Avram "regular" clothes to change into before they get to his house so Avram doesn't draw attention to himself. Avram's makeover draws the attention of Elena, but Avram's hesitation with his words proves he's more comfortable with bovine company. When they arrive at Emil's house, Shem the Essene is laying in wait on the edge of the property.

Yussef Khalid arrives at the Israel Museum dressed as a maintenance worker and enters an air vent. At the same time, the head of the museum leads Peter and Golan to the secure room that houses the War Tablet. When they open the door, the tablet is gone and the curator has been seriously wounded. They frantically search the museum, but Yussef, now dressed in street clothes, has walked out the front door undetected.

Charlie arrives at the compound, gun in hand, and Billingham attempts to diffuse the situation by explaining that Debbie left when she started using again. After a fruitless search, Charlie reluctantly takes the box of Debbie's personal belongings they hand him. When he's back in his car, a ring that he seems to recognize falls out of her stuff. During a lively dinner at Emil's house, Avram is pulled into a circle dance and exchanges shy glances with Elena before he remembers the tenets of his faith and runs off. Not too far away, the Essene peels off his clothes and throws them into a fire by the sea. He covers himself in mud and recites the Prayer of David. Later, as Avram sleeps beside Red in the barn, the Essene enters in clean white robes. He goes to Red and whispers that the full moon will bring them both to their destiny.

Peter and Golan arrive at Megiddo a few steps behind Yussef, who has driven there on a motorcycle. Yussef cracks the mosaic, swipes the stone, and takes off. Peter and Golan chase after Yussef, but they're too late.

At the compound, Debbie stands before Billingham and her peers. He's giving her the chance to repent for her sins and be forgiven. She acknowledges that they saved her life but then accuses them of using her and making her an accessory to murder. Billingham asks Joshua to divine the Lord's will, and Joshua puts the two stones Billingham has given him, one white and one black, into a leather bag. Joshua pulls out the black stone: guilty.

Summary: Peter delves into Emma's past, which leads to the discovery of a long-

hidden, ancient symbol; someone from Debbie's past attempts to res-

cue her; and Lynn's life is put in jeopardy.



Lynn's driver, Nadav, warns her about a protest happening at the Consulate that could cause traffic problems. As they drive slowly through a crowd of angry protestors, someone notices the US diplomatic license plates, and they swarm the car. They pull Nadav and Lynn from the car and beat Nadav senseless. Lynn is knocked to ground, tear gas filling the air around her.

Unaware of the tumult across town, Peter sits at Café Sergei looking through Emma's journal. He folds down pages

with thick black lines that she drew and sees that it forms a mysterious symbol. Rami, a waiter, recognizes Emma's journal. Peter introduces himself as Emma's father and asks Rami if he can meet her other friends. Rami takes Peter to an apartment nearby where a bunch of people who knew Emma are hanging out. Peter finds out that Emma had a boyfriend, whom she broke up with after a fight the week before she died, but they never met him or knew his name. They say her friend Julie in Tel Aviv may have more details.

At the police station, Golan tries to sign out the breastplate from the evidence locker, but a senior staff member has already checked it out. Golan tries to inquire further, but the intel is apparently above his paygrade.

In Croatia, Shem, the Essene, pulls up at the gas station next to an Israeli man who's on his way to Emil's to pick up Avram and the calf. Shem hides in the back of the guy's car and pulls a knife on him.

Debbie has been returned to the locked room in the compound. Debbie asks Sandra for help one more time but she refuses, but she suddenly becomes much more accommodating when Charlie's gun is pushed into her back. Debbie and Charlie tie up Sandra and rush from the room. A few minutes later, Faye finds Sandra bound up and sounds the alarm. Debbie and Charlie decide to hide out for a bit and let everyone think they got away.

Ridell comes to the hospital to see Lynn, who is banged up but more shaken up and upset about Nadav's injuries than anything else. Ridell tells her they have to put the hunt for Yussef Khalid aside and focus on security since Secretary Reynolds in coming to meet with both sides about the peace accord.

Yussef limps into a free health clinic and quickly passes out from the wounds he sustained at the hands of Peter and Golan the day before.

Lynn is also undergoing treatment, but at a higher end establishment. Peter wants to visit her in the hospital, but he is so haunted by the night his daughter committed suicide that he can't bring himself to go in.

Peter and Golan drive to Tel Aviv to find Emma's friend Julie, who performs in drag at a gay bar. Julie says that Emma's boyfriend was an older archaeologist that Emma worked with. Peter and Golan head directly to Professor Margrove's house. He admits that he was sleeping with Emma, but he broke it off to not jeopardize his marriage. Margrove tells them they're wasting their time pursuing him because his wife can vouch that he was home the night Emma was murdered.

Before Charlie and Debbie make a run for it, they grab Joshua. When they reach Charlie's car, Billingham is there. He tries to stop them but Debbie fires the gun in the air and they drive away with Joshua in the trunk. Back inside the compound, Billingham tells Faye, Sandra and Deputy Parry (the local cop) that he wants Joshua back and whoever has laid eyes on the boy should be "eliminated."

Yussef wakes up in the clinic, his wounds having been attended to while he was unconscious. He grabs his clothes, including the stone, and hobbles out. That night, he meets Lev and some other men in the woods. Lev tests the stone—it's real. Yussef says his job is done and holds out the gun. However, Lev says there's no greater assurance of life than sacrificial death. Yussef raises the gun to his chin, says, "He's coming," and pulls the trigger. Lev buries something that looks like keys in the grass beside Yussef's body.

Shem arrives to pick up Avram, who has no idea that he is putting his life into the hands of the enemy. They drive off with the trailer containing the calf hitched to the back of the car.

Peter finally visits Lynn late that night at her apartment, but she's hurt and angry that he didn't come see her at the hospital. Also, she's upset that Nadav is dead. Peter mentions he needs a warrant to search the JHC, and Lynn asks him to leave.

As Ambassador Ridell looks on, Rabbi Lev places the last stone in the breastplate.

Peter returns to the tunnels underneath the Old City. As he swims in the pool he went into with Emma, he looks up and sees the same symbol etched in the ceiling that he saw in Emma's journal.

An aerial shot of the compound in New Mexico then reveals that it is shaped exactly like the symbol in Emma's journal and in the cave.

Meanwhile, Peter asks an office tech at the consulate, Liat, to analyze the mysterious symbol. Lynn walks in and says that now that Yussef Khalid has been found dead, Peter needs to concentrate

on the Secretary of State's visit and let the local police handle Emma's murder case—or else he's out.

But after Lynn leaves, Liat tells Peter that she has found a link between the symbol and a missing person case from three months ago of a young American named Gregory Donaldson. He was found a few days after having had a psychotic episode and is now in a psychiatric institute. Peter goes there to see him, but he's been heavily sedated. Peter sees that the symbol is rendered in raised scars on Gregory's chest and his notebook is filled with similar drawings. The doctor tells Peter that there's a young woman who visits regularly who might be able to help.

Peter goes to see Nadia, Gregory's girlfriend. She and Gregory met at Café Sergei and moved in together after only a couple of weeks. His father had died when he was three, so on his 21st birthday, his adoption file was unsealed and he received a letter and package from his father. Gregory didn't tell Nadia what the letter said but after that, he became depressed and paranoid,

saying that there were people from "The Order of Moriah" after him. He was convinced that they were a secret society that had something to do with his father's death. She gives Peter a mysterious key that Gregory would have wanted him to have.

After driving a long way, Shem says Avram needs to cleanse himself and begins a prayer that Avram doesn't recognize as being from the Torah. Shem says that it's from the scrolls, which sets off an alarm in Avram's head.

While searching Eli's apartment, Golan finds a disturbing collage of photos of Emma Wilson. Golan calls Peter to say he thinks they found the killer. They drag Eli into the police station for questioning about Emma's murder. Eli is willing to sign a confession saying he killed her, but Peter still thinks that Eli is a patsy.

Feeling sorry for Joshua, Debbie undoes the chains around his ankles. But when she wakes up later, Joshua isn't in his bed. Luckily he's just outside at a gumball machine. As they're talking, the deputy's police car and SUVs from the compound race into the parking lot. Debbie pulls Joshua into the shadows. Police storm the motel room and grab Charlie. Debbie and Josh make a run for the police car, but Billingham decides to let them go—for now.

Frustrated that Golan is not asking Eli questions about their larger concern, Peter sneaks into the interrogation room, but Eli instagates a brawl. Lynn comes in to break it up but gets punched in the fray. After, Lynn tells Peter that he's been relieved of his position and his flight leaves in three hours. Peter hands Golan the key Nadia gave him and says that it could be the literal and figurative key to Golan's case, especially after Eli is found dead by an apparent suicide like Yussef Khalid.

Avram sneaks into town to call Rabbi Lev and tell him what happened. Rabbi Lev says the man he's with is an Essene who is trying to stop them. Lev tells Avram to find a big knife and stab Shem in the heart. Back at the house, Avram has the knife raised over Shem but Shem grabs his wrist and drags the boy into the woods. Shem is about the plunge the knife into Avram but instead jams it into the wood near his head and then disappears. Avram then stumbles back to the house but Red is gone.

Ridell meets up with Margrove in the tunnels beneath the Old City. They enter a room that no one has been in for 2500 years, directly under the Dome of the Rock, also known as the Well of Souls.

Security escorts Peter back to his hotel room to pack. Peter sees a shadow under his closet door. He opens it to reveal a banged up but alive Emma Wilson, crying and pleading for his help.

Golan checks on Eli in a holding cell at the police station and tells the guard to put him on suicide watch. When he gets home, Peter and Emma are waiting for him. Emma tells them her story: a few weeks ago, a man approached her at the café and said he would pay her to get Peter's attention. The guy told her what to say, how to behave, and to dye her hair red. He also instructed her to slip the stone into Peter's pocket but didn't explain why. After the night she and Peter hung out, she met the man again so she

could get paid. Instead he and some men threw her into a car and drove her to an abandoned building where they kept her chained up. When she heard them talking about killing her, she scratched the guard's face with her nails and escaped that morning.

Still on the run with Joshua, Debbie calls Billingham to arrange an exchange—Joshua for Charlie—but she has a plan that will allow her to keep Joshua. First Debbie takes Joshua to a hardware store to get the necessary supplies.

Liat shows up at Lynn's apartment and tells her that Peter never got on the plane. She also reports that she traced the key Peter gave her to a safety deposit box at the Tel Aviv Credit Union.

When Lynn shows up at Golan's apartment, Peter and Emma hide in a bedroom. Golan claims to have not seen or heard from Peter. Lynn gives him the key, tells him which bank it's associated with and to give it to Peter if Golan sees him. After she leaves, Peter and Golan drive Emma back to the place she was held captive to look for clues as to who is responsible. On the wall of the basement are photos of her supposedly dead body. She tells them they used makeup to fake her stab wounds. Golan says there was a body recovered after her alleged murder, so this must go even deeper than they thought and they should enlist some help.

Ridell tells Lev that Peter is still in Jerusalem. His response: she now must find him and kill him.

When Golan, Peter and Emma arrive at the police station, they discover that Eli has hung himself, despite Golan's precautionary measures and just as Peter predicted.

Lynn calls Peter's wife to see if she's heard from him but his wife says that since Lynn is the one sleeping with her husband, she should know where he is better than her. Ridell comes into Lynn's office and says that if Lynn doesn't find Peter in three hours, she'll declare him a fugitive.

Debbie and Joshua rendezvous with Billingham, Faye and their people in the desert. As they're exchanging Charlie for Joshua, Joshua reveals that he's wearing homemade explosives. Debbie demands they drop their guns, which allows Charlie, Joshua and her to get in the car and drive away.

From the tunnels below the Old City, Professor Margrove calls Lev to say they're about to find "the pillars." Later he calls someone who's not identified to say that Rabbi Lev will be there with the breastplate tonight and while they're looking in the opposite direction, they'll be able to "pinpoint the exact location."

Back at Golan's apartment, Peter suggests to Golan that they call Ari, the Shin Bet guy who's undercover with the Jewish Heritage Center. Golan gets in touch with his Shin Bet contact and finds out that they don't have anyone working undercover there.

During a pit stop on their way to California, Charlie gets shot. Billingham's henchmen are in hot pursuit, firing guns at the car. As Debbie tries to drive away, their car flips. Faye retrieves an unscathed Joshua from the overturned car. Charlie is dead but there's no sign of Debbie. Faye tells her men to find her but they stop when they hear that the police are on their way. Debbie comes out of her hiding place and starts walking to the next town. She goes into a pawnshop and trades her ring for a gun.

Emma tells Peter that while she was on the dig and with Margrove, there was talk about DNA samples being sent to a lab in New Mexico. Peter tells her that it turns out the DNA was from a cow. She was suspicious that Margrove had something to do with the people trying to reclaim the Temple Mount and that if they had that DNA and mixed it with that of a red heifer, they could create what they needed. Peter arranges to meet Lynn while Golan goes to the bank to see what's in the safety deposit box. But the only thing in it is a VHS tape.

That night, Lynn is late meeting Peter at the park. Suddenly a bunch of cars appear and start chasing Peter. Someone pulls up next to Peter and yells at him to get in. It's Shem the Essene. Peter asks who he is and Shem says, "I'm the guy saving your ass!" After they've lost the other vehicles, he drops off Peter and says, "When it's time to meet again, I'll find you."

Back at Golan's, Peter, Emma and Golan put the tape in the VCR: It's of a man named John Donaldson giving his official documentation of the biggest archaeological discovery of his time, perhaps ever, from February 15, 1989. In the tunnel, Lev and Margrove stand over the symbol of Moriah, which is etched in the floor of the Well of Souls. They move the four pillars into slots on the floor. Once assembled, Margrove says that the weight of the breastplate will activate the device. When they place the breastplate on top, an ancient stone pipe begins to release oil. A fire ignites, which is supposed to illuminate the location of ancient treasures. They watch as Hebrew letters appear on the cave ceiling. Peter shows up at Lynn's apartment to confront her about their failed meeting in the park the night before. As they work through it, they realize that someone is playing them both—and that person must be on the inside. Since they both suspect it's Ambassador Ridell, they devise a plan for Lynn to bait her with false information about someone from the Jerusalem Heritage Center helping Peter escape whoever was chasing him. Lynn is also going to look for a connection between the Ambassador and Yussef Khalid

the night of the reception.

Margrove and his assistant Assaf have narrowed down the three places in Jerusalem that mention the word "Dinah" and then pinpoint the Sisters of Dinah convent. To gain access to the convent, Margrove and Assaf claim to have been sent from the British Museum to authenticate the "Revenge of Dinah" relief that's located in their basement.

Avram is now at the Jerusalem Heritage Center, but the red heifer is not. Rabbi Lev is furious that Avram failed his mission but he has a plan to fix the boy's mistake.

Peter, Golan and Emma pay a visit to Professor Zohar, who teaches at Tel Aviv University. He says his former colleague John Donaldson was a romantic who believed there was a mythic vault of riches under the Temple Mount and that Margrove was nothing more than a dimwitted, greedy treasure hunter. He explains that Margrove encouraged Donaldson to publish his paper in 1988, which fed the intifada, in which sixty Israelis and over a hundred Palestinians were killed. After that, Donaldson was totally ruined. One night, he came home drunk, slit his wife's throat and

then his own in front of their kids. All Zohar knows is that the evidence Donaldson referred to in the video was locked in a secret room but not where. Peter, Emma and Golan wonder if that's the same room seen in Donaldson's video, which looks like it could be located in a building in Mishkanot Shananim.

Now armed with a rifle, Debbie approaches the compound and then sneaks in through the loading dock. When she ducks into a room that turns out to be a lab, she goes through some files and is horrified to discover sonogram photos from women in the compound, including Faye and Sandra.

Lynn goes to see her friend Phil, the head of security at the consulate, to ask him if the security cameras were turned off the night of the reception. He says the logs don't indicate any outages but he'll have the backup records sent from the states. She thanks him and asks for his discretion.

Peter and Emma's search for the building Donaldson made his taped confessional in leads them to the Sisters of Dinah convent. His room has been left undisturbed because the rent is still being paid regularly. The room is dusty and covered with notes, photographs and the scrawled ravings of a mad man. They discover a trap door beneath a rug, which reveals a ladder leading into the tunnels beneath the convent.

Meanwhile, Margrove takes a hammer to the Dinah relief, a rare relic itself, to reveal the symbol of Moriah behind it and then drills into the center of it. His assistant sends a camera through the hole, just as Peter and Emma are exploring the other side of the tunnel. The camera reveals skeletons of the Essenes who were sealed in the vault to protect the treasures in the afterlife around the time of the first Crusade. Soon they spy their precious bounty: the suddenly-no-longer-mythical Temple Treasures.

As Debbie makes her way through the halls of the compound, she encounters Officer Parry and shoots him point blank. After being hit in the head at Qumran, Golan awakens inside the trunk of his car—in a parking garage in Haifa. After extricating himself, his office tells him they found the detective who worked the Donaldson case fifteen years ago, so Golan heads to a kibbutz in the Negev to speak to him.

When Ambassador Ridell goes into her office bathroom, Lynn has the opportunity to look at Ridell's desk phone for the last numbers dialed and then sneak out. Figuring she can trust Liat, she arranges

to meet her at a coffee shop to ask her to discreetly find out about a pastor arriving today with a "special delivery" as part of Ridell's delegation.

Still at Qumran, Peter goes in and out of consciousness as Shem and his fellow Essenes tend to his gunshot wound. When he wakes up, Shem tells Peter that the Order of Moriah is able to carry out their mission now because of advances in technology and cloning. Soon they'll slaughter the unblemished red heifer and burn her. They'll mix her ashes with the ashes of the original red heifer, at which point they'll be able to rebuild the Temple. According to Shem, Peter has a part to play to bring healing to himself and the world, but Peter brushes off the notion that he was destined to be involved. Shem then shows Peter and Emma the caves where the Essenes have been hiding out, some of which reach all the way to Jerusalem and the Temple Mount.

As she's going through the manifest, Lynn notices a page is missing so she makes a call posing as Liat and has the document emailed. Reverend Tad Billingham is on the list, which makes Lynn wonder if Liat was trying to obscure that fact. Lynn heads directly to see Golan to tell him what she knows so he can share it with Peter.

After being taken at Qumran, Red is now back at the JHC but Avram is not allowed to come in contact with her. With the help of a friend, Aaron, Avram sneaks in to see Red at the retreat center where she has been moved. He spray paints two white lines down her back in order to protect her. But when Rabbi Lev arrives, he tells Aaron to wash the calf. He will not let this stop him.

Golan arrives at his brother's apartment to pick up Peter. Golan notices Emma in bed asleep and chides Peter for crossing the line with her. They go to the airport to await the arrival of Ridell's "delegation." They watch as Ridell greets Billingham and Faye with a handshake but then goes up to Joshua and bows her head to kiss his hand.

Later, Liat comes in to Lynn's office to give her the missing page from the manifest but says something that confirms Lynn's suspicions about her. Lynn attempts to leave the building but Ridell's henchmen try to stop her. She gamely fights back but Liat knocks her out and deletes her text to Peter warning him of it all being a trap.

Peter and Golan have followed Ridell, Billingham, Faye and Joshua to an airplane hanger. Billingham pulls one of his books out of a crate and tells Ridell that they are "undetectable." Faye gets a call that the FBI knows they're there and Billingham says it doesn't matter because in two days, the FBI and the world won't exist. He says, "First Jehoshaphat, and then Armageddon." Golan wants to grab them before they board their helicopter but Peter says they should wait to see who else is involved. Peter remembers that Gregory Donaldson was obsessed with "Jehoshaphat," so they drive to the psychiatric institution and sneak into his room. He's drugged out of his mind so Golan gives him something to counteract the anti psychotic meds.

Avram sneaks into Lev's house with a hammer, intent on murdering him. Shem grabs him from behind and drags him outside. Avram asks why Shem stopped him. Shem says killing Lev won't save Red or the world. The only relevant target is the only person who can kill a red heifer because he's pure and has been training for it his whole life: the high priest.

Margrove calls Peter because he has had second thoughts about what he has enabled and needs to meet with Peter immediately, so Peter goes. Golan stays with Gregory Donaldson. After Gregory becomes more coherent and is able to give Golan the pertinent information he needs, Golan heads outside. As he's leaving a message for Peter, a car comes out of nowhere and purposely hits him. Then the mysterious driver steps out to deliver the final blow—a knife to the throat. As Golan fades, he realizes that the driver is none other than Emma Wilson.



As Margrove requested, Peter meets him in the tunnels. He tells Peter the Order of Moriah hired him to get them to the Well of Souls but now he wants to stop them from destroying the foundation stone beneath the Dome of the Rock, which is sure to bring about Armageddon. He was only ever interested in the Temple Treasures, which Margrove tells him are behind a two-foot wall in a passageway called Warren's Shaft. Afterwards, Peter rushes to the scene of Golan's accident, but he's too late: Golan is already dead.

However, next to his body, the name "Rebecca" is scrawled in blood on the ground. Peter runs inside the psychiatric institute and barges into Gregory Donaldson's room demanding to know who Rebecca is but Gregory is out of it again and the orderlies drag Peter away.

Lynn is blindfolded in the back seat of an SUV that's driving through the desert. Next to her is Liat, who is texting with Ridell, giving her updates as they go. Eventually Lynn manages to knock out Liat, shoot the driver, grab Liat's cell phone and free herself.

Peter returns to Itay's apartment to see Emma. She notices that Peter has sandstone on his shirt, which she explains doesn't make sense: there wouldn't be sandstone in the tunnels because it doesn't work with water, which makes something click in Peter's head. Both Margrove

and Donaldson said you have to follow the water, so Peter goes to see Udi, Golan's significant other, who is a geologist specializing in the underground waterways. Udi explains that if a dam at Beit-Zait above the city were destroyed, half the city would be flooded through the aquifers. The only way to prevent that is to enact the "Armageddon Protocol," which engages a set of automated steel doors that seals off escape routes.

Shem secretly meets with Avram and hands him a knife. If Avram wants to stop Rabbi Lev and his men, he needs to kill Joshua.

As Emma is walking, a car pulls up alongside her. It's Margrove. She gets in and he asks if Peter bought her story about Warren's Shaft and the sandstone. She says he should be finding out about the Armageddon Protocol right now. Then she says, "Let's go get our treasure."

While Joshua is getting fitted for high priest robes, he tells Billingham that he has served his purpose and orders him to go. While relaying this shocking exchange to Faye, Billingham decides that Satan has taken hold of the boy so they must continue on their path without him. Faye reminds Billingham that she carried and raised those boys and won't destroy this Joshua, too. Billingham gets so worked up that he starts choking on the nuts he has been eating but Faye does nothing to help him. Within moments he takes his last breath while she looks on, the job of stopping Billingham neatly done for her.

Lynn flags down a guy riding a motorbike and gets a ride back to the consulate. Ambassador Ridell arrives at the same time with Israeli Defense Minister Krugman, so Lynn ducks out of sight.

Peter drives to the dam just outside the city where he sees Shem. He follows Shem down into the bowels of the dam, where he finds Billingham's books, which were clearly just shells to hide something within them, strewn all over the place. Then he sees that the base of the dam is rigged with explosives the size of the holes in the books. They have less than twenty minutes before the explosives detonate but Peter is unable to defuse it because it's failsafe. When Lynn calls Peter, he tells her she needs to get someone to enact the Armageddon Protocol. She tells him Defense Minister Krugman is in Ambassador Ridell's office but she needs to find out what side he's on. Peter tells Shem that even if the protocol is engaged, it won't save the Dome of the Rock because the Well of Souls is covered in sandstone, which isn't strong enough to hold up the foundation stone above it. Their only hope may be to get to Warren's Shaft and see if they can divert the water down there.

Meanwhile, devoted followers circle around an altar at the Temple of Absalom where Joshua, dressed in his robes, is getting ready to sacrifice the red calf. Rabbi Lev leads the ceremony while Avram watches and waits for his moment.

And deep in the tunnels beneath the apartment that John Donaldson once occupied in the Sisters of Dinah convent, Margrove shows Emma the Temple Treasures.

Lynn sneaks into Ridell's office. When the Defense Minister comes in, Lynn comes up behind him and puts a letter opener to his neck. She tells the Defense Minister that a bomb is about to blow up the dam and he either already knows that or will engage the Armageddon Protocol. Downstairs, Phil tips off Ridell that he's seen Lynn on the security cameras so Ridell and her armed men burst into her office. Ridell tells the Defense Minister that Lynn has been suffering from delusions but Lynn convinces Krugman that he has nothing to lose by enacting the Armageddon Protocol. Despite Ridell's protests, he makes the call.

In the Well of Souls, Peter and Shem take sledgehammers to the wall separating them from Warren's Shaft. They reach the shaft but it has a false floor. As Peter frantically tries to break through it, they hear the sound of far off explosions.

When the steel doors move into place, Margrove says to Emma, "The end of their world, the beginning of ours" and she replies, "Thank you, Peter Connelly." Emma then says that her father was right about everything. It suddenly dawns on Margrove that Emma is the daughter of his old colleague John Donaldson.

When the dam explodes, it sends everyone at the Temple of Absalom scattering to get a better look at the devastation across the valley they know is coming. Red is left behind so Avram quickly sneaks off with her. When they see that the Temple Mount is not crumbling, Rabbi Lev, Faye and Joshua return to the altar to continue with the sacrifice but the calf is gone.

Shem and Peter cling to a ladder in the shaft as the water rushes in. As they hoped, the water is diverted down into the newly opened shaft.

Lynn and the Defense Minister look out over the Old City, which stands unchanged, while Ridell is escorted out of the building in handcuffs. Later, Peter has made his way back to the consulate. Lynn has a lot of work to do figuring out how many others were involved but she'll be doing that without Peter. When he goes back to his office to clear out his belongings, he notices Gregory Donaldson's file on his desk. Inside he sees the name Rebecca Donaldson and suddenly realizes who she is. He drives to the Sisters of Dinah convent and goes down tunnel from John Donaldson's old room. There he finds Margrove's lifeless body and Emma-aka Rebecca Donaldson—standing nearby. She says she's been waiting for him. Peter asks her if this was all about revenge but she says it was about bringing the man who took everything from her to justice. At age fifteen, when she learned the story of what happened to her family, she became Emma Wilson, enrolled in University of Pennsylvania and took all of Margrove's classes. She seduced him and he told her about the people who were paying him to dig where no one should be digging. She knew all about the Order of Moriah from her father's crazy rants. Enacting the Armageddon Protocol was the only way to stop them. Margrove was able to target Peter as someone who could accomplish that for them. So with Emma's help, they were able to draw in Peter by exploiting the death of his daughter. But she never counted on falling in love with Peter. Now that it's all over, she says, they can be together. But he informs her that soon the place will be swarming with police because ultimately she did a lot of bad things including killing Golan. He just came to say goodbye. As the authorities storm the tunnel led by Lynn, Peter walks back into the light.

That night, Lynn goes to see Peter in his hotel room. She says Emma didn't go down easily but they have her in custody along with Rabbi Lev, Joshua and Faye. She asks him where he's going to go now. He says he was thinking of asking his boss for a transfer far, far away and thanks her for being his friend.

Two weeks later, Avram has given up his orthodox garb and his faith. He has brought Red to a remote cattle ranch. He gives the rancher instructions for her care: no milk, no meat, let her die a natural death and if anyone asks, tell them she's blemished. Then Avram leaves her, satisfied that she is safe, and walks toward an unknown future.
