Summary: After being betrayed and nearly killed in Tangier, private security op-

erative Sam Hunter recovers in a remote cottage. She soon returns to London to resume work for her employer, Byzantium, and determine which of her colleagues set her up. Her new assignment: posing as a

tutor to the grandson of criminal multi-millionaire, Jack Turner.



The scene opens with in Tangier. A man and woman burst in kissing one another. The next morning, the man gets his things from the safe and leaves with the woman. Later the man asks the woman if she is alright. She says that she is. They arrive for the man to do a 'little business'. They go inside and meet and the woman looks suspicious. There is a noise and they leave. As they get into the car, the woman sees a red dot from the sniper gun aimed at his head. She pushes him out of the way and is shot instead. The

man drives off. An ambulance arrives and grabs the woman. However she is alive and isn't who she pretends to be. She is actually Sam Hunter from a government agency. She goes inside telling the man that she forgot her passport. They allow her to go in. Meanwhile, the man who is distraught over the death of the Sam finds out that it is not blood that is on his lips and has the driver turn around.

She walks downstairs and takes out the guard to get inside a room. She had stolen the key from the man earlier. Dr. Arthur Hill is inside. She gets him to the safety of the ambulance with a little killing of the men trying to stop her. The man sees her and has his manservant go after her. However, he loses her. Aidan Marsh meets her and kisses her. She tells him that she has to tell him something and that he needs to meet her at a café. Later at a café, Sam sits down and waits to meet Aidan. But, instead unwanted company comes. She tells the café owner to call the police. She hides and takes down one of the men with fire. She goes and kills the other two men that were after her after fighting the third a bit. The police arrive and she realizes that they are not wearing police shoes. Before she can do anything, she is shot in the side and she falls to the ground.

The scene fast-forwards to one year later. At a home, Sam springs out of a bathtub. She was holding her breath trying to retrain herself. She makes her way through the woods to the store. She gets newspapers and highlights a symbol throughout the paper. It is a code. She returns home to add the papers to her growing pile. She gets up in her attic where she has the murder board of the man she was with a year ago and her team who she feels betrayed her. It is revealed that she was betrayed by one of her own. Later that night, Sam crouches in a corner of the room and remembers when she was little. She remembers how a car approached the car toward her mother, but that is it. The next morning she repeats her routine of holding her breath and jogging until one morning, she manages to hold her breath and run without tiring. Later, she burns the papers and gets the book that she had as a child and leaves.

She goes to a woman in another city who shows her an apartment. She gets busy getting the apartment together and walks down the street. A man sees her from the top of a building that has the same symbol as she circled in the newspapers. She walks in to meet with the Rupert Keel, the leader of the government agency she used to work for. Deacon, the man who had the sniper rifle up on the roof a year ago, comes in and finds Sam sitting there. He asks where she went and Sam says that she was sightseeing. Keel tells Sam that he is going to have to talk to the higher-ups to see if she can, in fact, be reinstated. Deacon tells Keel that they need her back. Sam gets back to the apartment and gets the call to come back to work. She gets in the next day and sees her old team. Hasan, Zoe, Deacon and a new member are there. Ian Fox introduces himself to Sam, but she is not impressed. Keel comes in to hear the meeting. Zoe tells the team that Jack Turner is the target, but they are interrupted by Aidan coming in.

Zoe resumes telling the team about Turner. He is taking everything to make sure that he wins the elections and that they need to get close to Steven Turner, Jack's son who has a son himself named Eddie. They all sync up with the information. Sam leaves and walks down to the Metro. Aidan tries to follow her. However, he is too late. She gets into her place and finds Aidan there. He tells her that he is a spy after all. He says that he knew that she would come back. It is revealed on how she escaped from the police who shot her. She says that Aidan is the only person who knew where she was. Aidan says that Sam is crazy and that he would never kill her and his child. However, she shows that the bullet she took killed their baby. He asks her why she came back and says that she still is in love with him. She watches as he leaves in a Taxi. She then crawls into a secret part of the apartment that she created. In Istanbul, the real killer of the Café owner gets a text with Sam's picture. He was the one who killed the Café Owner before Bernard got there to investigate.

Later that night, Sam remembers how her mother was taken away from the car by two men when she was little. The next day, Sam walks down the road as a car follows her. Steven tries to tell his son to stay with him, but he is not really listening. A van, driven by Zoe, pulls up and drives erratically. Hasan runs out and grabs Eddie and Sam stops him and saves Eddie. Deacon watches and is glad that the plan went accordingly. Steven takes Sam, who introduces herself to Jack as Alex Kent. Jack asks for ID and confirms who she says she is. Sam leaves and reports back to Keel. He says that there is a mole in the agency. He tells her that he is there when she wants to talk. Deacon shows Sam pictures of the men who were at the Turner home. He says that they are working on the Dam. Steven calls her and she speaks in her American voice. He asks her to coffee. She agrees. Deacon tells her that the game is on. Sam goes to the café and finds Steven there. She gives him a remote control car for Eddie. Steven reveals that he looked her up and she is insulted. He apologizes and says that he wanted to offer her a job.

Sam reports to Deacon and Keel and they tell her that she can get close and that it will be better. She says that she will be restricted, but Keel likes it that she can get closer than they thought before. Keel says that there will be no wires to avoid suspicion. That night, Sam remembers how she found her mother killed and then two men grab her and put her into the trunk of a car. The next day, Sam goes to Aidan and demands a new handler, but he says that she is stuck with him. He says that there is going to be meeting with a Dr. Goebel. He tells her to plant a video feed and she tells him that Keel thinks that there is a mole in the agency. She tells Aidan that if he is the mole, he should run. Meanwhile at the plant, Dr. Goebel gets in and is met by the Blank Faced Man. He kills him. Sam starts her first day of work at the Turner's and Jack is not at all pleased at her staying. Steven tells him that this is the first woman whom Eddie has opened up to. The team sets up in another building and Ian doesn't like the provisions. Deacon asks Zoe if Sam talked to her just because she is a woman. She tells her that she hasn't. At the

house, Sam plants the cameras and almost is caught by Steven.

Hasan is sent out to pick up Goebel. Ian asks him to pick up a few things. At the Turner's, they get a disturbing call. Bingham, the servant, comes in and says that he has good news. However, the team can't hear it because of the scrambler. Sam goes in to tuck Eddie in for the night. He says that his mother died and says that he knows that Sam's family died too. He tells her that Mrs. Sidwig will get her anything. She says that she is fine. Hasan is waiting at a light when suddenly a team comes up from behind and knocks him out. He leaves behind the milk for Ian. She goes back downstairs and Steven introduces her to The Blank Faced Man who is pretending to be Dr. Goebel.

out.



The scene opens with Steven meeting the Blank-Faced Man posing as Goebel. He says hello to Sam, who come up. Jack Turner comes downstairs as the Blank-Faced Man is about to stick Sam in the neck with a needle. Steven tries to walk into Jack's office with them, but he is told to close the door. At a hotel, Keel meets with a prostitute. Zoe keeps trying to get the audio in the meeting with the Blank-Faced Man, but she has troubles. Aidan says that Hasan isn't picking up. Back in the hotel room, the prostitute gets un-

dressed for Keel. Sam tucks in Eddie and sees Bingham go out front. There is a man who is trying to get away. The team is watching and they see that the man is Husan. Sam sends a text to the team with the news.

Back at the hotel room, the prostitute gives Keel a drink. Deacon calls him and tells him about their situation. He tells him that they can't retrieve him and they are going to have to kill Husan. At the house, Sam gets word that she has to meet with Aiden and she sees that Jack is going down to the lower basement. The Blank-Faced Man asks to use the bathroom, but goes upstairs instead. Sam sees him as the elevator doors close. She tries to go to the lower basement, but she sees that it is blocked by key entry. Jack meets with Husan and asks him why he tried to kidnap his grandson Eddie. Sam goes down to the basement floor and sneaks out to meet Aiden. Jack tells Husan that either way he answers, he is dead. Zoe asks Aiden if Sam told him where she was for a year and he says that he doesn't know.

The team sees that the Blank-Faced Man doesn't have the briefcase he went into the house with. Aiden tells Sam that she is going to have to kill Husan. Aiden gets back and gives Ian some milk. Ian finds out that the team has authorized Sam to kill Husan. He doesn't like this and gets up. However, Zoe tells him that he signed up for this. Deacon says that they can't afford to be compromised. At the house, Bingham is whipping Husan with a chain trying to get information. However, he isn't talking. Sam goes downstairs to Jack's office and sees Steve. Jack comes downstairs and tells Jack to come talk to him. He tells Steven that he needs to earn his respect. They leave and Sam was hidden behind the door. She gets into Jack's drawer and takes the elevator key card.

She goes down to the lower basement and goes up to Hasan. She puts a sticker on his hand that Aiden gave her. This is going to kill him. However, Husan tells her to take it off and says that someone on the team set him up. He tells her he knows why she was hiding and tells her to take it off and he will tell her. He obliges and says that a man with grey hair and a scar came to him. She hides as Bingham and an associate fingerprint Husan. She goes back upstairs and returns the keycard. Meanwhile, a man walks up to a woman named Emma Freeman. He introduces himself as Lt. Cornel Cooley. He is the man with the scar that Husan was talking about. He asks Emma about Sam and she tells him that she doesn't know where she is. He says that she can help her and shoots her in the head. Emma's 8-year-old daughter sees the man.

Sam goes in to check on Eddie and sees a photo album by his pillow. There are pictures of his mother. She goes in her corner in her room and remembers more from her mother getting killed by men and how she was taken, put into a trunk of a car and taken somewhere. Over at the house across the way, Sam sees a figure in the window. The next day, she goes to Jack's office and sees that the keycard is not there. She goes to see the family at the breakfast table and Steven brings up the cereal Reeses Puffs that you can only get in America. Jack comes in and ignores Sam. Eddie asks if Sam can take him to school and she agrees. On the way out, Sam tells Steven that it is clear that Jack doesn't want her there. Steven tells her that he needs her to stay. Jack goes down to the lower basement and asks Husan again who he works for. Husan spits in his face and Jack kicks him repeatedly.

Ian has looked up information on Keel and the organization. He says that he is curious. Deacon says that Keel will decide what they do and says that making assumptions can get him killed. Sam goes out and the team watches. Aiden says that Sam hasn't killed Husan yet. She drops Eddie off at school and hears on the radio of the death of Emma Freeman happened. Sam asks to be dropped off and gets out of the car. Aiden goes in to see Keel and tells him that there is a mole. Aiden says that it is not him. Keel tells Aiden to watch Sam and report back to him with any suspicions. Sam goes to the home of Emma and sees a picture on the fridge of her and Emma in Afghanistan. When she leaves, Cooley follows her. She stops him with a drop kick and asks who sent him. However, he is not talking. They fight and he eventually gets away after the fight.

Sam gets to her apartment and Aiden asks her what happened. She tells him that she 'fell'. He asks about Husan and Sam tells him that Jack keeps the key with him. Aiden gives her a device to hack that elevator. Aiden cleans her up a little and tells her that there will be consequences if she doesn't kill Husan. She says that she is done and get up. Aiden goes up to a door and a woman answers. Sam crawls in her hideaway and prints out the Cooley's picture. She is trying to figure out who is trying to kill her. Back at the house, Bingham tries to be civil to Husan and offers him a drink. Dave Rider, a known associate of Jack's, arrives at the house. Jack tells Steven to give them a moment. The team tries to listen in on them, but the scramblers are too much. Jack and Dave talk and Jack tells him that they caught the guy who tried to kidnap Eddie.

Sam gets in and Steven says that he was getting worried. She shows him that she got him some Reese's Puffs. The team watch as Dave drives off with the briefcase. Ian and Zoe follow him and Ian pretends to be hit by his car. Zoe tags the briefcase. They talk and Dave drives off. Sam makes her way down to the lower basement again and the maid, Mrs. Sidwa, is going to the ground floor. Sam asks her about the horses in Eddie's album and says that his mom used to take him. She tells Mrs. Sidwa that she will look for his riding things in the basement. Steven talks to Jack and tells him that he wants to be able to show that he can take over the business. They go down to the lower basement and he gives Steven the crowbar. However, he drops it. Jack walks off. Steven tries to act tough, but realizes that he can't. Sam comes in and knocks out the guard. Husan tells Cooley didn't give him a name and says that Cooley said that he would pay a

lot for her head. She is shocked.

Upstairs, Bingham says that the prints that they took are no match to anyone. They go downstairs. Sam asks about the man and he tells her that he needs to get set free. She does and he starts fighting. Sam wins this by stabbing Husan. Jack and Bingham find him there dead. Sam runs off upstairs. The team gets word that Sam accomplished the judge. Ian says that he is not happy at all. Sam meets with Aiden and tells her that the more she stays, the more she is in danger. She tells him that she is not scared. Keel meets with someone at the Pall Mall. It is Bernard Faroux! Sam sees that the figure in the window across the way is not there anymore. However, she is being watched by the Blank-Faced Man.

of Byzantium.



The scene opens with Lars Holm and his wife coming up to a road blockade when a man comes up asking him to open the car door. There is a man trying to kill him. Lars gives in and they drive off. However, the man tells Lars to pull over. Lars realizes that Jack Turner sent him. He refuses to and the man kills Lars' wife. They struggle and the car flips over. The man who was walking with the knife pulls up in the car and pulls the man from the car. He tells him that the car wasn't supposed to crash. At the Turner residence, Sam

wakes up Eddie, who was in the middle of a nightmare. He tells her that he keeps seeing the man's face who tried to grab him. She tells him not to worry because he will never bother him again. She tucks him in and leaves.

At the MI6 office, Aiden walks in and Zoe is there waiting for him. She talks about the mole that they may or may not have in the division. They go through the team and Zoe suspects Sam. Meanwhile, Sam goes downstairs and Stephen asks her where she is going. She tells him that she is going for a jog. Sam arrives at MI6 and Keel tells them that they've got business. Zoe says that Patrik Lindberg is the head of K-PEC along with Lars Holm as co-chairmen are the targets. There is a bid on the company and Sam says that she can swap out information about the deal that Jack is working on with a dam that is being built. Zoe tells the team that 4 investors are interested, but no more so interested than Chinese Industries Group. Keel asks Sam if there is any other news and she says that there is none.

She walks over to her apartment and looks at her board. She pulls off the picture of her old military friend who was killed. She remembers the meeting she had with the man in the alley.

She picks up the copy of The Snow Maiden, the book her mother read to her. Later, Sam is going to Brightling Chase Hotel for the weekend with Eddie and one of the guards accuses her of stealing from the Turners. Back in their hideout, Ian is not pleased that Sam gets to go to a hotel. Zoe tells the team that the tracking signal is gone on the briefcase. Ian accuses Zoe of planting it wrong. Sam arrives at the Brightling Chase Hotel and Sam sees that guards are going to the vault. Bingham leaves the briefcase in there. Eddie is driving his remote control car down the hall when it bumps into Bernard Faroux. She walks away and texts Aiden the news.

Meanwhile, Aiden is 'getting busy' with Natalie Thorpe when his phone goes off. He tells her that he has to go. She asks him if Keel has found out about them two. He says that he doesn't know. Aiden tells her that they have to end things. She asks if that is the reason and he says that it is. Stephen goes up to Jack and Jack tells him that Lindberg will be along. Sam is anxious and tells Eddie that she will be back. She goes to the room where Bernard is and takes out two of his guards with a fire extinguisher. However, he is waiting for her inside his room. He pins her against the wall and demands the Turner bid. She tells him that she doesn't have it. To show that he means business, he puts the gun in her private area and says that she will get it to him. Lindberg gets to the hotel and Jack tells him that he is going to sign the document without Lars there.

At their hideout, Deacon tries to listen in on the office in Jack's home. However, he is not making any progress. He tells Zoe that someone called Jack moments before Hasan was grabbed. Zoe says that it wasn't Aiden, but Deacon is not too sure. Ian points out that two men are taking a body away. They suspect that it is Husan and Deacon tells them to see where they take it. Meanwhile, Natalie arrives in the security room at her office and the tech guy says that Aiden goes away from the street cameras for a long time. She sees that Sam is there, someone she thought was dead. Later that evening at the hotel, Sam goes to get Eddie a hot chocolate and gives Aiden the USB drive. She tells him that he ran into Bernard and he is clearly uneasy about it. She tells him that she will get some information out of him. The guard who accused Sam of stealing from the Turners comes up to Eddie and asks where Sam is. He sees her with Aiden and walks away. Aiden walks up to the man and knocks him out.

Ian and Zoe watch as the men take the body out. Ian gets out of the car and sees the two men chop the body up and throw the pieces in a fire. Aiden drags the guard to the woods when another guard comes up behind him and they fight. After a struggle, Aiden manages to kill the other guy as well. Ian gets back from watching the men and tells Zoe that they were cremating Hasan. He says that he managed to get his boot, but Zoe says that Hasan didn't wear boots. Lindberg is signing over the company to the auction to be bid and is clearly uneasy. Stephen sees this and asks Jack about it. He says that he is fine and that they will win the bid because he has seen the other bids. Back at MI6, Deacon is talking to his daughter when Zoe and Ian come in. Ian tells him that he snagged Hasan's boot. Deacon says that Hasan didn't where boots. Deacon gets a call from Aiden and Aiden tells him that Bernard is one of the other bidders. He says that they have to get her out of there, but Deacon says that he has to talk to Keel.

Sam sits down with Bernard and tells him that she is there to offer him a chance to save his life. However, he is not worried. He tells him that he met with Keel about information on Tungjia. He tells her to bring the bid and then he will tell her. She tells him that she will kill him. He tells her that she has until 8:00. Deacon meets with Keel and he tells Deacon that he met with Bernard about what happened to Sam. Keel tells Deacon to let Sam stay in the hotel. Jack asks Bingham about the two men missing and he asks where Lindberg is. Zoe tells Deacon that she has more information on the two men who chopped up the body. They link a location where the briefcase could be to a Gentlemen's Club. It is owned by David Ryder. Ian and Zoe go off to check it out. Later, Sam gets ready for dinner and Stephen is surprised on the way she looks. Bingham tells Stephen that Jack is not going to be with them for dinner.

Ian and Zoe get to the club and Ian goes inside to find David Ryder at the pool table. He demands him to pay him 2,000 for hitting him. He tries to have one of his men beat up Ian, but he is ready and hits the guy with a cue ball. David offers him a drink. Later that evening, Bingham tells Lindberg to come with him. Sam gives Eddie her copy of The Snow Maiden and tells him to read it. She sees Lindberg and Bingham walking in the woods and she follows. They meet with Jack and Lindberg tells him that he never agreed to kill board members. Sam listens in. Turner reminds Lindberg that he signed the deal and that there is no turning back. Sam reads up on how Lars and his wife were found murdered. Zoe is looking at pictures of her and

her loved one when Ian tells her that he is getting drunk with David. At the hotel, Lindberg is met by Sam and she tells him that she wants to take down Jack, but needs his help. He agrees.

Aiden goes up to Natalie and tells her that he told her that it was over. She tells him that screwing her doesn't give him a pass. She shows him the picture of Sam and Aiden accuses Natalie of trying to kill Sam. She tells him that she didn't. At the Club, David gets his men and says that they are leaving. The men who chopped up the body are there. Ian gets up and smiles at the naked girl dancing on stage. He sees them organizing another hit. Lindberg tells Jack at the hotel that Bernard has his bid. Bernard gets a note from Sam that says 'Au Revoir'. He tells his guard to kill Sam when the bidding starts. Bingham and Jack scope out the hard drive and Aiden clones the hard drive. Bingham and Jack see that it hasn't been cloned, but Jack says that it could be done as they speak now. The bidding begins on K-PEC. Jack arrives to the bidding and meanwhile, Lindberg is killed by the two men who chopped up the last body. The bidding continues and Sam goes outside. She is followed by Bernard's men. She manages to kill the two men and goes back inside.

Bernard leaves his table after he realizes that he has been outbid. Jack's bid is 1 Billion and Stephen says that is 30 Million more than they have. Jack tells him that he needs to make his move on Sam. He tells him that she is with Lewis. Jack gets suspicious. Aiden and Sam get to the office and find out that the spikes in revenue are because the natural disasters are being caused by Turner and Conroy. They are interrupted by security and Sam and Aiden run from them narrowly escaping. At Jack's office, Bingham says that Sam being with Lewis doesn't prove anything.

She sees that Hill has the original fax of the meeting and that he was the one who sent the fax. She tries to leave, but is stopped by the guards. She is caught. Stephen looks at the report of the gas leak at the business. She realizes that Jack was involved. Zoe tells Deacon and Aiden that Zahir is on the move. They meet her in the elevator and take down her guards. They tell her that someone is trying to kill her today. She tells them that she is going to go through with the speech. She says that she is not afraid.

Tyrone and Ian go to the mall and see a man in a Rafi the Rabbit costume. They demand his wallet and keys and tell him to get in the trunk. Ian asks Tyrone what he is doing and Tyrone shoots the man. Keel meets with his doctor and is told that his tumor has shrunk a little, but not to give his hopes up. Stephen talks to Jack and tells him that he wants the truth about the building being blown up. He says that he doesn't want to be part of this and that he and Eddie should have left years ago. Jack tells Stephen that he is free to go, but is not allowed to take his grandson with him. The meeting comes and Zahir says that she is coming. Sam is being held and Keel gets a message. He calls someone. Ian goes to the man's apartment that Tyrone killed and waits for Tyrone to get back. Soomro meets with Umiar and he tells her that Zahir knows

that someone is going to try to kill her. He says that Umiar's family is set to make a lot of money with the selling of the dam. Zoe gets to Polyhedrus and gets Sam out.

At the meeting, Deacon and Aiden look around for Tyrone, but he isn't there. Nothing happens. Sam tells Zoe that Hill is the whistleblower. Sam breaks into the archive room of Hector Stokes' estate where she finds one file with her name and another with information about her mother's murder. Just then, the security guards come around, and Sam fights them off. After sustaining a light wound, she escapes, and hands her file to Aidan.

After losing his men, Stokes calls in a woman named Orla to take care of Sam. He wants her eliminated, but the presence of the Blank-faced Man is complicating matters. Orla shows up at Zoe's

flat unexpectedly and tries to convince her that she's looking out for Sam, and she needs the Byzantium agent's help.

Jack meets with Soomro, the Pakistani minister who ran the bidding for the Khyber dam. Soomro tells Jack that while Turner did take out the whistleblower, he didn't live up to his promise of taking out Zahir as well. Soomro plans to award the bid for the dam to the Chinese. Jack recognizes that the Chinese are a front for Polyhedrus and tells the minister that he has the proof that Dr. Hill never did. If they won't award him the contract, he'll reveal the evidence and cost Polyhedrus billions.

Stephen Turner confronts Sam with the file he was handed by Inspector Everett. Sam quickly covers and denies any wrongdoing, and Stephen, increasingly suspicious of the role his father played in Lewis' death, tells her he wants to take her and Eddie and leave his father's house for

good. Stephen gets Everett to admit on tape the orders that resulted in Lewis' death, then takes the evidence to the police. When Stephen goes in to meet with the local commander, he finds his father instead and is chastised for going against the family. His father informs him that Sam has been playing him the whole time.

Fowkes goes to Dave Ryder, claiming to hide from the cops after Tyrone set him up. When Dave brings him into his home, Fowkes goes about looking for the briefcase, which he believes contains the evidence that Polyhedrus fears.

Natalie Thorpe, Aidan's MI6 handler, meets with Edward Gillespie, the Under Secretary for the Ministry of Defence. She informs him that that file on Sam Hunter she'd given to her superior somehow ended up in the hands of Hector Stokes, and that she fears something called Hourglass is behind it. Thorpe realizes that Gillespie is part of the conspiracy and likely the person who passed on the material to Stokes, though he feigns total ignorance about Hourglass.

Sam traces a check Turner's company made out for Horst Goebel back to a young Pakistani girl named Noura, whom Goebel had sponsored. Sam meets with her and learns the true story of the Khyber dam: The people in Noura's village didn't want to leave their homes to make way for the dam, so Polyhedrus faked a natural disaster that killed 600 villagers. Doctors Hill and Goebel had collected evidence in the form of soil samples from the lake proving the so-called disaster was really a gas attack carried out by Polyhedrus. The evidence from the lake is in the briefcase that was delivered to Jack Turner.

Rummaging through Ryder's house, Fowkes finds the case. Ryder catches him in the act, but just as he forgives him, Tyrone shoots the older man in the head. Fowkes and Tyrone fight in Ryder's building, with Fowkes coming out on top. He grabs the briefcase and brings it to Byzantium, where it's revealed to be full of nothing but rocks. Zoe pores over old footage and realizes that the real briefcase never left the Turner house. The one given to Ryder was a decoy.

Keel confronts Sam about breaking into Stokes's house. He knows she came back to Byzantium to find out who wants her dead, but Sam still doesn't trust him. Natalie catches up with Sam and hands her the key to a safety deposit box, the contents of which will reveal Aidan's true identity.

Bingham confronts Everett after realizing that he's been working with Stephen. He has Tyrone kill the inspector.

Keel meets with Stokes, who asks him to move up their timetable and kill Jack Turner within 48 hours. The hasty action arouses Keel's suspicion that Polyhedrus is readying to kill Sam as soon as the mission is carried out.

At the Turner house, Jack asks to speak with Sam. He apologizes for the way he's treated her, and offers Sam a cup of tea-in which he's slipped in something extra.

Aidan informs Sam that the mission is coming to end-the client, Polyhedrus, has ordered Byzantium to kill Jack Turner. Realizing that the mission is the only thing keeping her alive, Sam desperately searches her hazy memory as to why Polyhedrus wants her dead, but remembers nothing. Aidan asks her to retrieve the case from Jack's study with the evidence being used as blackmail.

Outside Eddie's birthday party, Byzantium plants an explosive device on Jack's car. Just as Jack is about to step inside,

he asks his grandson to join him. Sam fakes an ankle injury to pull the boy away from the car. Eddie runs over and the bomb goes off. Jack is only slightly injured, but Sam's cover is effectively blown.

Back at the house, Bingham poisons the water he's been giving to Sam. A troubled teenage girl who lives in the house across the street witnesses it from her window and sends a message to Stephen. She tells him that Tyrone and his father killed his wife, and now they're doing the same to Sam.

Sam summons her strength to look for the case, but before she can take it, Bingham walks into the study. He takes her phone and forces her to drink the poisoned water.

Following up on the girl's lead, Stephen confronts Tyrone at Dave Ryder's old bar. Tyrone isn't rattled by the encounter and doesn't deny killing Stephen's wife. Instead, he tells Stephen that he's been a better son to Jack than Stephen ever has. Stephen returns home and sends Eddie to

a friend's house so he can confront his father. When pressed, Jack tells his son his bidding and blackmailing for the Khyber dam was about revenge: Polyhedrus is responsible for the death of Stephen's other brother, and Jack won't be satisfied until he kills the corporation.

Jack meets with the Pakistani minister Soomro to share the evidence he has of the mass murder Polyhedrus carried out to secure the Khyber dam. He provides Soomro with a soil sample from the briefcase the Blank-faced Man delivered in the guise of Horst Goebel. The Byzantium team analyzes the sample and finds it contains no evidence. With Jack holding zero leverage, Soomro walks out of his office, prepared to sign the dam contract over to Polyhedrus.

Jack is incensed and orders everyone out of the house except for Sam. He puts the house on lock-down so no one can get in or out and climbs the stairs to Sam's room. He holds a weakened, poisoned Sam under the water in the bathtub. Sam fades in and out of consciousness and flashes back to her childhood and the memory of a man, missing part of his finger, holding her down in the Oast houses on Hector Stokes' estate.

The Blank-faced Man, who has watched Sam's poisoning through his own security cameras, provides Aidan with a needle he says will help Sam. Aidan fights with Bingham outside the Turner house and kills him.

After Jack leaves Sam for dead in the tub, she finally lets out a breath and pulls herself out. She spots Jack leaning by the railing and knocks him over. Turner falls to his death while Sam collapses to the floor. Aidan rushes in and injects her with the needle, reviving her. "You're late," she chides him.

The Blank-faced Man meets with Keel. He has the briefcase with the real evidence against Polyhedrus, and he offers in exchange for Sam. Later, Crane gives Keel his letter of resignation, but Keel enlists him for one final mission.

Orla uses Zoe to lure Sam out onto a nearby bridge. Gun in hand, Orla approaches Sam, who seems as if she's just been betrayed. But before Orla can shoot her, Sam is taken out by a faraway shot and falls over the bridge. The sniper is Crane and he's shot her with a squib, just like in Tangier.

A healthy Sam returns to Scotland, where she picks up and plays with the child she'd never actually lost.
