Summary: Maximus engineers a coup against the Royal Family of Attilan, and Lockjaw takes four of them to Hawaii for refuge.



On the island Oahu, a woman runs through the jungle. Armed mercenaries pursue her, and she stops to catch her breath. An Inhuman, Triton, emerges from the shadows and tells the woman that she's safe. Triton introduces himself and says that he's been looking for her, and she's one of them. He explains that they're humans and she's been exposed to Terragen, and the Inhumans have gathered in the city of Attilan.

The woman can hear the mercenaries approaching, and Triton leads her off as the mercenaries open fire. A shot hits the woman and brings her down, and Triton is forced to run off, dodging the grenades that they fire at him. The Inhuman comes to a cliff overlooking the ocean and jumps in without hesitation. The mercenaries report in that their mission is accomplished.

In Attilan, Black Bolt and Medusa are in bed kissing. Medusa uses her prehensile hair to pick up the comlink when it rings, but it continues to signal. Ignoring it, the couple make love.

Later, Black Bolt and Medusa dress and look out on the city, hidden beneath a cloaking force field on the moon.

At the Callisto Aerospace Control Center in California, Louise pilots a remote lunar rover across the moon. It bumps into the force field and stops, and the rover goes offline.

Black Bolt and Medusa walk through Attilan with their bodyguard, Auran. The king gestures to his brother in the crowd, Maximus, to join them. They enter the palace where Karnak is waiting. He shows them the live feed from the rover and another Inhuman, Gorgon, brings in the rover and adds it to their collection. Gorgon's hooved foot is briefly visible in the video, and Gorgon assures them that no one on Earth will recognize it for what it is.

On earth, Louise tells her boss George that it looks like a hoof.

Karnak is less than thrilled with his cousin Gorgon's indiscretion.

George asks if Louise is going to tell their owner that a hooved man destroyed their rover.

Black Bolt tells the others that they'll do nothing but wait. Maximus complains that's his brother's strategy for everything, and warns that sooner or later the humans will find and try to destroy them. Gorgon asks if he's one of them, and Maximus angrily says that he's an Inhuman like the rest of them. Black Bolt signs nothing, and Maximus tells them that they have to go to Earth and strike first rather than continue hiding. Medusa tells him that going to Earth would only lead to war, and Maximus asks her if she's speaking for herself or Black Bolt. When she says that she's speaking for herself, Maximus asks her what the king thinks. Black Bolt places his hand on Maximus chest, and after a moment Maximus says that he trusts him.

Louise tells the board that they've wasted \$8 0 million. George is there and tells her to figure out what it is.

The Inhumans prepare to expose the two children of two Inhumans to the touchstone and initiate Terraigenesis. Maximus and Karnak argue about whether it's random genetics or evolution of the species, and Gorgon asks Medusa where her sister Crystal is.

Crystal is out on the streets and the people bow to her as they pass. She calls to the Inhuman's giant dog, Lockjaw, which bounds over to join her. Medusa calls and tells her that she's expected there, and Lockjaw teleports them to the Grand Hall ceremony. They take out a Terragen crystal, taking care not to touch it, and place the children in the chamber. They expose them to the mists, and the girl Iridia comes out and reveals that she has grown wings and become a flyer. As for the boy Bronaja, he says that he feels the same. Maximus tells him that Terraigenesis can take a while to manifest. Bronaja collapses and convulses, and then says that he saw Maximus with snakes all over him. Maximus tells him that they'll talk soon, and Bronaja's parents lead him away.

That night in the lower caste living quarters, the children are presented to the miners. Bronaja is sent to the mines because he apparently has no powers, but Maximus says that he's yet to undergo the genetics council testing. One miner says that they didn't find anything with Maximus and he should be digging in the tunnels with them. Maximus admit that he was rendered human but his brother is king. However, he says that the kingdom forces them into a caste system. If they were on Earth then they would have an entire planet to thrive on. Maximus' comlink signals and he leaves.

The Royal Family is eating, and Karnak exchanges glances with a servant. He then describes their relationship for the two days that it would last before he grew tired of her and wanted to kill her. The servant quickly leaves, and Gorgon tells his cousin that he's his own worst enemy. Maximus arrives and tells them that Triton is dead. An Inhuman arrives and projects images of Triton's last moments before he jumped into the ocean. Maximus says that Black Bolt kept Triton's mission a secret because he knew that they wouldn't approve, and Karnak says that the king only needs consult him when he chooses. Black Bolt signs that they don't know that Triton is dead, and he was on Earth because of the recent spread of Terragen throughout Earth. Once they became who they were meant to be, they're imprisoned, and Black Bolt refuses to leave them to suffer.

Maximus wonders if it's in Attilan's best interests to expand its population, and says that they should be going to Earth. Black Bolt refuses and asks them to trust him. After a moment, Maximus walks out as Karnak and Gorgon watch him. Karnak warns Black Bolt that Maximus is dangerous because he undermines Black Bolt's decisions. He assures Black Bolt that he has his loyalty and leaves.

Gorgon tells Black Bolt that he should have sent him instead of Triton, and leaves with Crystal.

Gorgon prepares to go rescue Triton, and Black Bolt tells him that it's a rescue mission rather than revenge. Lockjaw teleports Gorgon to Hawaii. The others depart, and Medusa tells Black Bolt that they can't trust Maximus. Black Bolt says that he needs to be alone to think, and she tells him to go. As the king enters the meditation chamber, Medusa remembers the past where she entered the chamber and told a young Black Bolt that she wasn't afraid of him.

Medusa walks back to her quarters and Maximus is waiting. He says that Black Bolt should never have sent Triton, and assures Medusa that he's there for her. He tells Medusa that he would never treat Medusa the way that Black Bolt does, and she reminds him that she is his queen. Maximus asks her if she ever wishes she had avoided the room and all of the complications, and doesn't believe Medusa when she says that she has no regrets. He reminds her that they were the bad kids who snuck away and had fun, and asks Medusa if she ever considered how much

better her life would be with her. Medusa slams him against the wall with her hair and says that Maximus is disgusting, and walks away. Maximus remembers Bronaja saying that "snakes" would be all over him.

The next day, Maximus meets with Kitang, a member of the Genetic Council. Kitang brings Auran with him, and says that they are dangerous times. Maximus asks about the children's genetic testing, and Kitang says that Bronaja has some powers but so far Kitang doesn't know what. Bronaja said that he saw Kitang in a beautiful river, but there are no rivers in Attilan. Maximus asks Kitang if Black Bolt's plan to stay hidden makes sense, and suggests that they all go to Earth. Kitang supports Black Bolt, and Maximus insists that he needs the backing of the Genetic Council. He says that he's trying to save their people, and tells Kitang that his mind is made up. Kitang orders Auran to arrest Maximus, and she kills Kitang. He lies in a "river" of his own blood, and Maximus tells Auran that they have to move on. She agrees and calls him her king In Oahu, Gorgon follows Triton's trail.

Karnak is examining the rover when the Royal Guard soldiers come in and say that they're there with Maximus' authority.

The mercenaries move in and spot Gorgon. They radio Maximus and say that they've spotted the target, and Maximus tells them to take Gorgon out. They move in on Gorgon.

Karnak asks the soldiers what Maximus ordered them to do, and he says that their orders are to capture or kill.

Gorgon smells the mercenaries and stomps his feet, generating a seismic wave that knocks them out.

Karnak engages the soldiers in hand to hand.

Gorgon takes on the mercenaries.

The leader shoots Karnak... who has predicted the outcome with his own ability. he replays the scenario again in a second and takes another tactic, shooting the leader before he can open fire. Karnak then sends an alert to Black Bolt, Medusa, and Crystal. Gorgon signals and Karnak tells him that Maximus is launching a coup with the Royal Guards. He advises Gorgon to stay there.

Crystal is in her quarters with Lockjaw, listening to music via headphones. She fails to see her comlink. Karnak comes in and tells her what happened, and says to have Lockjaw take her to Oahu. Crystal refuses and orders Lockjaw to take Karnak there instead.

Lockjaw does as ordered and returns, and they go to find Medusa.

In the palace, Medusa signals Black Bolt to answer her. Maximus and his men find her and he tells them to take her. Medusa easily subdues the first few, and Maximus asks her to stop. Another of Maximus' men shocks her unconscious. When she wakes up, Maximus shaves off her hair despite her promise that she will never forgive him. They then leave to get Black Bolt.

Black Bolt is meditating in the chamber when Maximus and his men come in. Maximus tells his brother that he always took him for granted.

Crystal and Lockjaw find Medusa, who says that they have to get to Black Bolt. Lockjaw teleports Medusa to the others.

Maximus tells Black Bolt that he's done, and asks if he will speak and kill his only brother like he murdered their parents Agon and Rynda.

Black Bolt remembers the past where he spoke a single word... and vaporized his parents.

Maximus prepares to speak, but Lockjaw teleports in and then teleports away with Black Bolt. Maximus tells his men to grab Crystal, and Auran and the others capture her.

In Oahu at the Diamond Head Crater, Medusa wonders where she is and remembers what happened. She wonders where Black Bolt left her.

Karnak is on the Haloa Ridge where Lockjaw took him.

Gorgon goes to Makapu'u Beach and calls for Triton.

In downtown Honolulu, Lockjaw arrives in the middle of the street with Black Bolt. A taxi driver swerves to avoid him and causes an accident. The driver, Keoki, gets out and Lockjaw teleports away. Someone takes a photo of Black Bolt, and he grabs their camera away and stares at it for a moment. The police arrive and Black Bolt runs off.

Summary: Black Bolt, Medusa, Gorgon, and Karnak are stranded in Hawaii after Lockjaw teleports them there and is captured before he can return. Meanwhile, Maximus tries to subvert Crystal to his cause.



In Attilan, Maximus keeps Crystal in Black Bolt's meditation chambers. He interrogates her about the Royal Family's whereabouts, and Lockjaw teleports in. A soldier renders Lockjaw unconscious before he can teleport Crystal away, and the soldiers take Crystal to her quarters. Maximus then addresses the city, claiming that the Royal Family has fled Attilan, and says that justice will be served.

Medusa contacts Black Bolt via her comlink. When he responds, Medusa says that she's on Earth and safe, and describes her surroundings. Black Bolt is unable to say anything, but Medusa

hears traffic in the background and realizes that he's also on Earth.

She spots a tour bus, tells Black Bolt that she will find him, and goes to the bus. A tourist says that it goes back to the city, and Medusa slips aboard among the other passengers.

Karnak slowly climbs down the ridge, slips, and falls.

Maximus tells Auran to put soldiers on every corner, and when the people need a calming hand, he'll step out. Soldiers bring Crystal in and Maximus claims that he didn't want to become king but the people needed strong leadership. Crystal demands to know where her family is, and Maximus tells her that he hopes that eventually she'll understand that she's been told lies. He reminds her that her parents detested the Royal Family, and tells her that things are changing and aren't going back. Maximus invites her to join forces with him, honor him as his new king, and help reassure the people of Attilan. Crystal dismisses him as a mere human, and Maximus has his soldiers take her away.

Gorgon stands at the shore calling to Triton. He walks into the ocean, struggling against the waves, and goes under. Several surfers spot him and bring him to shore, and they realize that he's an Inhuman. Gorgon explains that he was looking for his cousin Triton, and he'll have to wait there until they send someone to bring him back to the moon.

At Calisto, Louise is looking at the footage. George joins her and asks if she's still working on her theory about the rover's destruction. Louise tells him that she noticed four energy surges on the moon that led to Oahu. The surges happened where the rover died, and Louise figures that it's all tied together. George doesn't believe it, and warns her that people consider her nutty but brilliant. He relieves her of her duties on the mission, and Louise suggests that she take some time off.

Karnak wakes up from his fall and focuses on finding Black Bolt. He gets his bearings and heads off.

On the bus, Medusa notices that the passenger next to her has a knife. They enter a tunnel and Medusa stares at her shaved head in the darkened reflection of the window.

Auran brings food to Crystal in her quarters. Crystal uses her elemental powers to blast the tray out of Auran's hands. Auran draws her gun and says that she has nine guards outside. Crystal relents after a moment and Auran tells her that the sooner Crystal accepts that Maximus is her king, the happier she'll be. Once Auran leaves, Crystal picks up the comlink that she secretly blasted off of Auran's wrist and contacts Medusa.

Medusa gets Crystal's signal and confirms that she's safe. Crystal explains what has happened to her, and Medusa says that she'll find Black Bolt and then they'll rescue her. She realizes that Auran set the whole thing up and is tracking the call. Medusa crushes the comlink and leaves the bus.

When Gorgon grows tired of waiting, one of the surfers tells Gorgon to bring the fight to him. Gorgon calls Maximus and asks where his family is, and Maximus realizes that they're not with Gorgon. He says that he brought freedom to their people, and wishes that they could come to some sort of agreement. Gorgon tells him that he's leaving his comlink on if he wishes to come and find him. He then tells the surfers to leave because there's going to be serious trouble. The surfers say that it's their beach and refuse to go.

Louise packs up her things, looks at a necklace for a moment, and leaves.

Karnak comes to a creek and drinks the water. He finds the blood from his wounds and realizes that he's walked in a circle, and that his powers have failed.

Auran tells Maximus that she's located Medusa. He tells her to gather whoever she needs, transport to Earth, and kill or capture the Royal Family... and definitely kill Black Bolt and Gorgon. Auran figures that she can handle it herself, and goes to Eldrac for transport. Eldrac, a living wall, refuses to transport her. He says that it's painful, but Auran doesn't care and says that she'll kill his family if he doesn't obey. She enters the portal he creates, and finds herself on Earth.

Medusa leaves the bus at the next stop.

Auran homes in on the last coordinates of Medusa's location.

Black Bolt continues down the street, and goes into a clothing store when he realizes that his royal clothing stands out. A clerk assumes that he doesn't speak English and fits him with a suit. He walks out without paying, easily disabling the security guard when the man tries to stop him. Meanwhile, the clerk calls the police to report a shoplifter. An officer arrives and orders Black Bolt at gunpoint to get down on his knees. Black Bolt does so but when the officer tries to handcuff him, Black Bolt knocks him to the street, tosses away his gun, and handcuffs the man.

More police arrive and Black Bolt runs down the street. The officers pursue him and more of them cut him off. They start clubbing him and shoot him with a taser, and Black Bolt emits a grunt of pain that blasts a car down the street. The officers continue beating him and then shove him into a car.

Maximus meets with Bronaja and takes the boy's hand. Bronaja has a vision of the Genetic Council plotting to kill Maximus. Maximus thanks Bronaja for his help and says that he'll see him soon.

Louise arrives at Oahu and hears a TV report about Black Bolt's arrest.

Maximus and his men find the council and he tells them that it's up to them whether they serve him or not. He describes how Kitang died, makes it clear that they'll share Kitang's fate if they don't cooperate, and leaves. Maximus then goes to Crystal's apartment and suggests that she reconsider or Lockjaw might be hurt. She wonders why he wants her, and Maximus says that her parents gave their lives trying to overthrow the old system and move forward to something better. Agon had them killed, and Maximus asks if she wants to risk her life supporting something she knows is wrong. He tells her that he'll let her think about it... but not for now.

At the police station, the police book Black Bolt.

Auran finds the tourist bus and goes in. When the driver tries to stop her, she breaks his neck and finds the smashed comlink on the floor. When Auran leaves, Medusa attacks her. The two women fight, Medusa without her hair, but Auran soon knocks her out.

The police confirm that Black Bolt is the man who caused the traffic accident when he appeared out of nowhere. Black Bolt easily removes his handcuffs and the officers draw their guns.

Auran draws her gun, and Medusa stabs her with the knife she stole from the passenger.

Black Bolt puts the handcuffs down and signs, asking what they're going to do with him. When the desk sergeant explains that they'll take his photo, Black Bolt calmly goes over to the camera.

Medusa takes Auran's comlink and calls Black Bolt. When his comlink activates, Medusa tells her that soon they will be together and then kill Maximus. She vows that they are not defeated, takes Auran's gun, and leaves. Black Bolt gives his comlink to the desk sergeant.

In the mines of Attilan, Maximus arrives and finds Bronaja and his father. He tells them that the days of Black Bolt's meritocracy are coming to an end, and Bronaja will play a big part in their new society because he can see the future and they will all build it as equals.

Later, Maximus addresses the lower caste and says that they are the strongest and smartest of them all.

In her apartment, Crystal looks at a photo of her parents.

Lockjaw sleeps in the meditation chamber.

Maximus says that Black Bolt has abandoned them and asks the lower caste to accept him so that they can move forward.

Gorgon camps with the surfers.

Karnak sleeps alone.

Medusa looks up at the moon in the sky and strokes the stubble of her hair.

The guards lock Black Bolt in a cell.

Maximus promises that nothing will stop them because nothing can keep them from being free. The people cheer.

Auran comes back to life and pulls the knife out of her stomach. She uses her power to heal the wound and calls Maximus to summon backup.

Summary: While Gorgon and his new friends battle Auran and her Inhumans, Medusa gets a lead on Black Bolt's location. Meanwhile, Maximus tries to gain Crystal's support, and Black Bolt meets a nu-Inhuman in prison.



At the Declan Research Facility in Santa Barbara, Dr. Evan Declan is leaving when an assistant runs up and shows him video of Black Bolt's arrest. The assistant explains that Black Bolt is being held at a correctional facility in Oahu, and Evan heads for the airport. He then calls a prisoner, Sammy, claiming to be Sammy's lawyer. Once Sammy answers the phone, Evan says that he knows why Sammy was arrested. If Sammy does what he says, then he'll help him.

Black Bolt is sitting in his cell and remembers his father King Agon telling him that being a king requires sacrifice. When Black Bolt says that it seems boring, Maximus objects, saying that Agon

is the king. Agon tells his eldest son that when he inherits the crown, he will become the leader of a great people. Black Bolt says that he'd rather just be himself, and Maximus points out that if Black Bolt dies then he becomes king. Their father assures them that no one is going to die and says that they're both destined for great things.

There's a commotion outside, and Black Bolt looks out to see Captain Pena giving a statement to the press. Louise arrives and introduces herself to Pena, and asks if Black Bolt displayed any unusual powers. Pena admits that he doesn't know Black Bolt's name, and refuses to let Louise talk to him. Pena goes inside and meets with Black Bolt. He tells the guard to put him into

general population in the hopes that Black Bolt will talk. The guard tells Black Bolt that they're going to have some fun.

Medusa walks through Waikiki Beach and realizes that people get money from ATMs. She goes to one and demands money. There's no response, even when she says please.

Gorgon walks through the jungle with the armed surfers, and he warns them that the people coming will be like no one that they've ever seen. The fighters that are coming are ones that he trained, but they figure they can take the coming Inhumans. Gorgon tells them that it's his fight for his people and his king, and the leader says that they'll fight for Gorgon's king in honor of theirs.

He asks if Gorgon can kill his own people, and Gorgon says that he'll be happy to if they're part of the coup.

In her apartment, Crystal listens to her music. Maximus comes in and asks if she's considered his offer. He says that Black Bolt is put them at risk, and if she joins him then the others will reconsider. He insists that he doesn't want to kill anyone but will if he has to. Maximus gives her a statement to give to the Genetic Council pledging his support, insisting that it's the easiest way to assure a peaceful transition. He tells Crystal that her reading the words could keep their family alive, and Crystal says that she'll do it. However, she warns Maximus that she'll kill him if he goes back on his word. Maximus thanks her for realizing that it's better if she does it freely instead of his making her.

Maximus leaves and asks Auran if she's located Black Bolt yet. She admits that Earth is bigger than the Moon, and Maximus tells her that he knows where Gorgon is. Auran figures that it's a trap, and Maximus sends her some backup and Mordis. She warns that Mordis isn't a fighter, just death, but Maximus insists that he's the most powerful Inhuman after Black Bolt.

Once Maximus signs off, he meets with Bronaja. He gestures to a door and asks the teenager how bad an idea it is to open the door that contains Mordis within. Bronaja doesn't see anything in the future, and warns that he has no control over his gift... yet. They open the door and Mordis steps out. A Mordis asks where Black Bolt is, and Maximus tells him to follow him so that he can explain.

Flora and the other Inhumans arrive to meet with Auran. They all look at Mordis, who tells Auran that he doesn't want to be there anymore than she wants him there. When Auran wonders what Maximus promised him, Mordis says that he was offered his freedom.

Karnak comes to a house in the jungle and approaches it. A man, Reno, demands to know why Karnak is there and draws a knife. Another man grabs Karnak from behind and puts a machete to his throat.

Black Bolt is put in general pop and the guard Rivera says that Black Bolt put his brother-in-law in the hospital when he flipped the car. Sammy asks to have a little time alone with Black Bolt to "play".

Auran and the others enter the jungle and Mordis suggests that Flora make a path. through the plants. She touches the ground and commands the plants to move aside for them and make a path.

Medusa arrives at the Royal Estates and one owner dries out of his walled estate. She quickly runs in before the gates close, and eats some fruit on the table. She looks around and finds clothing to wear. Medusa looks at her shaved head in the mirror for a moment, and then takes some food from the kitchen. There's a newspaper with a photo of Black Bolt's capture on the front page, and she sees a magnetic sticker for Keoki's Cab.

The ganja farmers tie Karnak up, and he tells them that he's no threat. Their leader warns that they're kidnapping and they should let Karnak go. Reno asks Karnak who the comlink puts him in touch with. Karnak insists that he has to find his family. As they discuss what to do, Karnak considers what to do to free himself. He kicks a table over but it doesn't bring down the shed as he planned. The three ganja farmers go outside to talk further.

Rivera puts Black Bolt in a cell with Sammy. Once they're along, Sammy asks Black Bolt how he got his abilities. Black Bolt indicates that he's mute, and Sammy describes Terragenesis. When Black Bolt responds, Sammy realizes that he knows what he's talking about and warns him that people like Black Bolt are disappearing from all over. He advises Black Bolt to escape and find his family before something happens to them, and Black Bolt signs, asking why Sammy is helping. Sammy says that in Hawaii they help their friends.

Auran tracks Gorgon's comlink and tells Mordis to keep Locus safe. She and the others move in and find Gorgon's comlink on the floor of a shack. The surfers open fire, and Gorgon attacks Auran. When the Inhumans attempt to summon their powers, the surfers take out one of them and a serpentine Inhuman kills another. Flora brings down the tree that the surfers are in, and they rappel down.

Gorgon finally kicks Auran down, and she calls for Mordis. He removes his mask and fires a blast of energy. Gorgon dodges it and stomps his feet, knocking them down. He tells the others to retreat, grabs the downed surfer, and runs with the rest.

The leader comes in and treats Karnak's head wound. She explains that they sunk all of their money into the farm, and Reno is worried that it will all go up. She tells Karnak that he should be less guarded about who he is, and asks about his tattoos. Karnak says that he made a decision when he was a teenager, and it's a reminder of who he used to be and who he is now. She asks who he is, and Karnak says that he doesn't make mistakes. Since he's hit his head, he can't see the consequences of his decisions. She tells him that it will be all right, but Karnak isn't convinced. He figures that he's of no use to his family in his current state, and the woman says that they're family and will always be there for him. Karnak asks if he can stay.

That night in the city, Louise is in her car outside the prison when Pena taps on the window. She warns him that he has no idea who he has imprisoned. Pena tells her that if he comes back then he'll have her car towed and her with her.

Rivera and his men take Sammy out of his cell to have a "talk". The head guard then takes Black Bolt out and Black Bolt calmly goes with him.

Maximus assembles the Genetic Council and calls the new leader, Tibor, forward. He tells Tibor to draft a new edict for him abolishing the caste system. Tibor warns that it would tear their society apart, but Maximus says that he wants to free those working in the mines. He tells Tibor that he has Crystal's support and has her brought in. She asks where Lockjaw is, and Maximus tells her that he's indisposed. Crystal warns him that Lockjaw is always at her side, but Maximus refuses to put her in the same room as her teleporting hound.

Crystal turns to the Council and says that Maximus is the king of no one. She freezes the guards' weapons with her powers and runs off.

Kitang tells a young Maximus that he is now a human, and no human can be king of the Inhumans.

Maximus tells the Council that Crystal runs away from her responsibility like all of the royal family. However, he insists that he's not like them and Agon was right that he's destined for great things.

Crystal runs into Black Bolt's containment cell and freezes the door shut, and then tries to wake Lockjaw.

Maximus says that he will never turn his back on the people of Attilan.

Crystal wakes Lockjaw and has him teleport her to where he took the others.

Reno enters the shed and says that they took a vote about what to do with Karnak. He frees the prisoner and says that he was outvoted, but he'll be keeping an eye on the two of them.

Rivera takes Black Bolt out to the yard. Sammy is there and waves to him. The other convicts congratulate Black Bolt on beating up the cops and embrace him, much to Rivera's surprise. Rivera knocks a dumbbell on the ground and tells Black Bolt to pick them up.

When Black Bolt refuses, Rivera beats him and the other convicts attack the guards. The alarms go off and more guards arrive. Black Bolt attacks the guards, and Sammy leads him out. They go into the prison to a garage, and Sammy uses his power to burn a hole in the door. He explains that he lost his family when he burned down his house by accident.

Kitang tells Agon and Rynda that Black Bolt's voice may be the most powerful and dangerous gift in Inhuman history. He tells the couple that Black Bolt can destroy Attilan, and they will never hear his voice. Rynda hugs her son, and refuses to lock him away when Kitang suggests that they do so for the safety of Attilan. Agon agrees with his wife, insisting that Black Bolt will learn to control his powers.

Sammy finishes melting the door, and he and Black Bolt run out. A helicopter picks them out with a spotlight, and Louise sees the commotion. She sees Medusa arrive in a taxi, confront the gate guard, knock him out, and go inside.

Evan is flying the helicopter, and yells that he's there to help. Sammy tells Black Bolt that he's a friend and they get in. Evan flies away just as Medusa arrives and she tries to get her husband's

attention without success. Louise runs up and asks what's going on, and Medusa draws a gun on her and says that they're going to follow the helicopter.

Lockjaw teleports Crystal onto a road. He passes out and Crystal tries to wake him up. A man in a road buggy drives up and accidentally slams into Lockjaw.

Evan flies in the helicopter with Black Bolt and Sammy, and introduces himself as a privately-funded geneticist. He wants to take them to a makeshift lab on the north side of the island. Sammy refuses, but Evan insists that it's safe and they're free to anytime they want. He knows about Black Bolt's power, and offers to help them understand their gifts. Evan asks to do a DNA test on them, but Black Bolt grabs his hand and taps Evan's wedding ring. He signs that he also has a wife, and Evan offers both of them sanctuary.

Medusa tells Louise to continue flying the helicopter. Louise notices that Medusa is wearing a ring like Black Bolt's, and asks if they're married. Medusa tells her to drive faster and steps on the accelerator. A police car comes after them, and Medusa orders Louise at gunpoint to keep going.

In Attilan, Tibor congratulates Maximus on handling Crystal's escape so well. Maximus asks him if the Genetic Council found it acceptable to abandon him because he became human after Terragenesis, and chokes Tibor for a moment before walking away.

Louise takes evasive action and Medusa shoots back at the police car, driving it off the road. They lose the helicopter, and Medusa prepares to shoot Louise for failing.

Crystal complains that the buggy driver, Dave, hit Lockjaw. When he goes over to her, she blasts him back with her powers. Dave introduces himself and apologizes for hitting Lockjaw, and Crystal figures that they should go to a doctor. He offers to take Lockjaw down the road.

Louise pulls over and asks Medusa to put down the gun. She does so and looks up at the moon, and Louise asks if she's from there.

She explains how she traced the energy pulses to Hawaii, and Medusa says that there's a whole city of Inhumans on the moon. Medusa says that her husband's cousin Gorgon destroyed the moon probe, and that he's there somewhere with Karnak. She tells Louise that they have to go home, but they have to go to the hotel and ditch her car.

Evan takes Black Bolt and Sammy to his lab and after running tests, he tells them that Black Bolt's DNA isn't human. The geneticist says that Black Bolt's vocal chords are super-charged, and points out that he has the power to kill everyone he loves. Black Bolt demands to know where Medusa is, and Evan promises to find her. He goes outside and calls Maximus to say that he's found Black Bolt.

Maximus insists that innocent lives are at work, and tells Evan to put Black Bolt down. Evan refuses, saying that Black Bolt's DNA could be the key to his genetic research. Maximus points out that Evan doesn't need Black Bolt alive to replicate his DNA, but Evan notes that he does because DNA will change the cellular structure.

Karnak prepares an irrigation system for the ganja fields and shows it to Wwww. He explains that Attilan's farming system is based on efficiency, and Jen shows him how to harvest ganja. Reno watches them and tells Ted that he doesn't trust Karnak. He says that he needs Ted and Jen to pull it off.

Gorgon complains to the surfers that he shouldn't have let them help, and now one of them is dead. The Inhuman explains that he never cared about a human before, and warns that it won't be a fair fighter. Holo says that doesn't mean that they can't win.

Locus leads Auran and the others through the jungle via her echolocation, and Mordis complains.

At the hotel, Louise uses her laptop to track the helicopter via satellites. Medusa goes through Louise's things and paces impatiently, and picks up Louise's rocket ship jewelry. Louise tells her to put down, and asks what Medusa's name is. Louise points out that the mythological Medusa has snakes for hair, and Medusa refuses to discuss what happened to her hair. The scientist says that she never found someone to marry.

A young Medusa leads her sister Crystal through Attilan. The people look at Crystal suspiciously, but Medusa tells her that they'll be fine because they're all that they need.

Medusa tells Louise that she's never been alone. Police cars pull up outside, and Louise admits that they traced her through her credit card.

Maximus asks the Council what would happen if he went through Terragenesis again. Tibor says that nothing would happen, but Maximus says that if he found the genetic key then he could insert it into his own genetic code and unlock it, and go through Terragenesis as if for the first time. He asks the Council's consent to go through Terragenesis again, and Tibor refuses to allow any genetic experiments on Maximus because the results could be fatal. Maximus asks if Tibor is speaking for himself or the Council, and Tibor says that he's speaking for Maximus' well-being. The new king asks if Tibor has his loyalty, and when Tibor says that he does, Maximus tells him to prove it.

Evan shows Black Bolt photos of other transformed humans, but none of them are Medusa. Black Bolt notices an assistant preparing an injection, and continues going through the photos.

Medusa and Louise slip away as the police search the rooms. Louise realizes that she left her necklace behind, and Medusa goes back to get it. The manager takes the police to Louise's room, and Medusa jumps off the second-store balcony. By the time the police arrive there, she's gone. She finds Louise, who demands the spaceship.

Dave calls the vet, his former girlfriend Audrey, to his farm. Crystal says that she's from Attilan on the moon, and Audrey says that she's a vet once she passes nine more exams. Dave takes them to the barn where Lockjaw is, and Audrey wonders what kind of dog that he is. Audrey checks his wound and says that it seems simple, and Dave assures Audrey that they can trust her. Audrey tells Crystal that Lockjaw will need some time to heal, and explains that she and Dave broke up a year ago.

Medusa and Louise get some food and Louise keeps tracking satellite surveillance. The queen explains that Attilan is surrounded by reflective shields, and that her husband is King Black Bolt. Louise finds the helicopter's location and tells Medusa to stay there while she dumps their garbage. When Louise turns around, she discovers that Medusa has gone.

Auran and her team continue through the jungle, and Auran tells Maximus that they're closing in on Gorgon. He tells her that no one else seems to consider him king, and tells Auran that

he knows where Black Bolt is. Auran notes that Black Bolt's death is essential to "their" plan, and Maximus says that they can't kill him just yet but they can keep him under surveillance.

Jen leads Karnak to the beach and he examines the sand. Jen strips down to her underwear and invites Karnak to join her. After a moment he removes his clothing as well and they go into the ocean. Karnak explains that all the water where he's from is subterranean, and Jen leads him out. She then kisses him as Reno watches from hiding. Meanwhile, Jen says that she kissed Karnak because she wanted to.

Louise finds Medusa watching with the laptop, and Medusa says that she has what she needs. She vows to find the rest of her family and then go home, and Louise tells her that her father's ashes are in the toy spaceship. He wanted to go to the moon but NASA never chose him. Medusa tells Louise that her mother and father died for their ideals, and agrees with Louise that it's stupid. She would rather have had patients than ideals.

Agon and Rynda tell Medusa and Crystal that their parents were banished after trying to lead a revolution. Medusa doesn't believe them.

Medusa tells Louise that she has spent her life trying to be the opposite of her parents. Louise suggests that her company might be able to get Medusa and her family to the moon. Medusa tells her that she can't lose Black Bolt, and Louise offers to drive her there via the car that she stole. When Louise admits that she's broken a lot of laws to help Medusa, Medusa smiles and says that she likes her, and they drive off.

Gorgon warns the surfers that they won't be able to escape Locus, and says that Karnak would know how to do but he doesn't know how to find him. The Inhuman says that Lockjaw brought him there and brought the others to the same spot, but when he gets tired he gets sloppy. He tells the surfers that he won't lose them because they feel like family, and insists that he must protect his family.

With that, Gorgon walks off.

Once Audrey leaves, Crystal thanks Dave for his help. He shows her how to high-five, and Crystal stares at her hand in shock. She admits that no human has ever touched her before and smiles.

Jen and Karnak go back to the farm and Riley tells them that Ted went back into town. She invites Karnak to stay in her tent and he accepts as Riley watches.

At the lab, Black Bolt suggests that the nu-Inhumans that Evan showed him might be captives. Sammy agrees, and Black Bolt takes out the vial that the assistant was filling. They realize that it's poison.

Maximus meets with Tibor and tells him that the Council wants to maintain the status quo. The Council arrives on Tibor's orders, and the guards drag them away. Meanwhile, Maximus tells Tibor that the Council must be banished so that their society can evolve, and Tibor agrees with him. He asks if Maximus can forgive him for betraying him when they were younger, and Maximus says that he always thought forgiveness was overrated.

The new king goes to the Terragenesis chamber with one of the crystals.

Black Bolt and Sammy sneak out of the lab, and Auran and her people arrive. Auran claims that she has Medusa and if Black Bolt does anything, she dies. When he hesitates, Mordis steps out and asks if Black Bolt wants to find out which of them are more powerful.

Black Bolt breaks open a propane tank and Sammy runs off, and Auran realizes that Mordis' energy blasts could set off the gas. She tells him to fire anyway. As Mordis reaches for his mask, Louise and Medusa pull up. Medusa slams the car door into Mordis, and his blasts goes off, setting the propane on fire and stunning the hunting team. Black Bolt picks up Locus, and then goes to his wife.

The two of them embrace, and Medusa explains that Maximus shaved her head but she's okay. They then put Locus in the car so that she can help them find their family. Mordis starts to wake up, and Louise, Medusa, and Black Bolt quickly drive away.

Outside, Reno slaps at mosquitos and loads his revolver. he then aims it at Jen's tent.

As Jen and Karnak get dressed, Karnak wonders if he's hungry. They leave the tent and Reno shoots at them. Karnak analyzes the path of the bullet and deflects it with his bare hand. However, it hits Jen in the stomach, and Karnak leads her off as Reno continues firing and Karnak leads Jen off into the jungle. They hide and Reno yells that

he doesn't want to share her. Karnak tosses a stone to draw Reno off, and his cell phone rings. he takes the call and confirms that his buyer Tua is coming early, and says that he'll be waiting for him. Once Reno goes back to the farm, Karnak tells Jen that they have to move.

As Louise drives down the road, Black Bolt and Medusa sit in the back, hugging. He signs that they need to focus on finding the others, and Medusa refuses to talk about Maximus shaving her head. She finally breaks down and explains what happened, and tells her husband that she'll be all right. Locus pounds on the trunk door, and Louise pulls over. They let Locus out and she says that Karnak is nearby. She complains about how the Royal Family normally treats them, and Medusa tells her to do her job. As Black Bolt takes Locus toward Karnak, Medusa tells Louise that Locus was sent to kill them.

In the jungle, Louise says that she might be able to get her company to let them tag along to the moon. Locus' comlink goes off: it's Maximus, asking why Auran isn't answering. Medusa responds, assuring Medusa that her sister is safe. He insists that he doesn't want to harm them, and Medusa points out that he sent Inhumans to kill them. She then relays Black Bolt's message

that he plans to have a few words with Maximus, and Maximus says that he'll look forward to the family reunion. With that, Black Bolt crushes the comlink. Meanwhile, Maximus calls for Tibor.

At Dave's farm, Audrey checks Lockjaw and says that he's recovering. Crystal asks him to find their family, and explains to Dave and Audrey that Lockjaw can teleport. Audrey doesn't believe it, but Dave wants to try it. Crystal and Dave touch Lockjaw, and Crystal tells the dog to take them to where he took the others. Lockjaw teleports away as Audrey looks on, shocked.

At the research lab, Evan is autopsying the bodies of Auran and Sakas. He's intrigued by what he finds in Sakas' body: glands that exude acid. Evan tells his assistant to set up a DNA test on both of them to see what they have in common with Black Bolt.

Gorgon looks for Karnak and remembers the past.

Gorgon finds Karnak meditating and shows him the American flag that he found on the moon's surface. Karnak tells him to put it back, warning that they're putting their civilization at risk, and the humans will realize that it's gone and see Gorgon's hoof prints.

Irritated, Gorgon goes to put the flag back.

Gorgon finds Karnak's blood and realizes that he was hurt. He sets out to find him.

Reno is packing up the ganja when the gangster and his men arrive to get their product. The farmer warns that Jen met Karnak and they took off after they saw Ted's body, and asks for their help. When he shows them the grave with Ted's body, Tua shoots him and then tells his men to bring in the truck while he and another man go to find Karnak and Jen.

Jen finally collapses from her wound.

Maximus tells Tibor that Auran has failed and he wants to send more Inhumans. Tibor points out that it's forced conscription, but Maximus warns that if they don't kill the Royal Family then the people will lose their freedom. The Council leader warns that the lower castes aren't expecting to be conscripted, but Maximus insists that they have to fight on Earth rather than the Moon. Tibor quickly agrees, and Maximus tells him to address him as "My king".

Karnak gets Jen up and moving. He blocks the nerve pains in her side and then says that he's good at predicting outcomes but his ability failed. Karnak tells her to stay still and asks if she trusts him, and Jen agrees. He then pushes his finger into her back and pushes the bullet out the front through the wound. The Inhuman makes a crude suture out of a leaf, but Jen gives him the sewing kit for their tents. When Jen says that they should call the police, Karnak refuses to endanger himself and his family. He suggests that they go back to the camp to ambush Reno. They hear the gangsters coming and run.

Evan confirms that the Inhumans' DNA is similar to Black Bolt. Auran comes back to life and heals the blast damage to herself, and then grabs Evan by the throat and demands to know where Black Bolt is. Evan admits that he helped Black Bolt escape prison and find his wife, and Auran realizes that Sakas is dead. The scientist says that they both died in the explosion. Evan's assistant grabs a scalpel, and Auran disarms him and jams the scalpel into his eye, killing him.

Jen and Karnak approach the camp, and Karnak warns that he can't see an end to the plan. He wonders how he can work on a plan that he doubts, and Jen tells him that he just has to improvise. Jen tells him that doubt is their friend, helping them find solutions, and Karnak points out that's how Gorgon functions and he's only right 68% of the time. She says that she has his back and kisses him.

Gorgon tells Karnak that he put everything in back. Karnak points out that he couldn't do anything as moronically as Gorgon, and he'll always be the one cleaning things up. Gorgon points out that Karnak does nothing interesting and walks off.

Karnak agrees and they move into the camp.

When she contacts Maximus, he tells Auran not to harm Evan because he's his ally even though he doesn't know who Maximus really is.

Auran disagrees but Maximus tells her to finish her mission and he'll be sending her help soon.

Mordis and Flora take a captive Sammy with them. He uses his Inhuman power to burn through his bindings and runs. Flora animates the plants to grab Sammy, just as Auran calls Mordis. Mordis tells her that they lost Black Bolt but captured Sammy. Auran orders him to bring Sammy back to them.

Karnak confirms that Reno is gone, and finds a wooden pole to use as weapons. He spots bales nearby and realizes that they weren't there when they left. The gangsters drive up and Karnak and Jen hide inside.

The gangsters arrive and load up the ganja, and Karnak tells Jen to hide while he takes them down. Jen kisses Karnak and slips out the back, and Karnak prepares to attack.

Lockjaw, Crystal, and Dave arrive near the beach and Dave revels in the experience. He invites Crystal to sit on the hand with her, and explains about the tides. Crystal admits that it's overwhelming, and in Attilan it's just her and Lockjaw. Medusa is protective of her, and Dave advises her to hang loose. Crystal says that she never expected that being with a human was safe given all of the war and terrorism that they saw. Dave assures her that most humans are safe, and she can't live life afraid. He runs out into the ocean and invites Crystal to join him, and they'll find her family later.

As night falls, Karnak attacks the three gangsters. He takes out one and another breaks his staff in two. Using the two halves separately, Karnak takes out the second, disarms the third, and strikes him in the chest. One of the men recovers and attacks Karnak from behind, and Jen runs up and threatens to burn the bales. When the man doesn't yield, she tosses a lantern. However, when Karnak tries to run, one of the gangsters knocks him out.

Locus homes in on Karnak and Medusa explains that Terragenesis determines all. When she says that Locus only has one path because of her gift, Locus reminds her that her parents spoke against the royal family and they were banished. When Louise objects, Medusa explains that Black Bolt lost his parents shortly after she lost hers, and the loss connected them. Louise points out that they were thrown out for not changing the caste system. Tibor gives Maximus the list of lower caste gifts. He says that only one of them was happy to be drafted, and Maximus tells Tibor that they have to earn their freedom. Tibor warns that some might wonder if it's for the good of Attilan or the good of Maximus.

Maximus takes offense and says that he doesn't need friends who tear down his plans, and orders Tibor away.

Once Tibor leaves, Maximus goes to the statue of his father and says that everyone looked at him in pity. If he had received a gift then he would have been king, and now he's lost his king and his brother for the good of Attilan.

Gorgon sees the smoke from the burning bales and prepares to run in, but then considers how Karnak would do it.

Tua and his men string Karnak up and Tua demands to know who Karnak is. He explains that he's an Inhuman from the moon, and Tua doesn't believe him. His men beat him while Jen listens, tied up nearby. Gorgon approaches the camp and gestures to Karnak not to give him away, and then runs out and generates a seismic wave to knock the gangster down. The tree Karnak is fastened to topples, and Gorgon takes out the men. Karnak says that he can't free himself and tells Gorgon to free Jen. Once he does, Gorgon starts to apologize for stomping his way in and Karnak merely thanks him.

Mordis and Flora take Sammy to the lab and Auran tells them that the days of chasing Black Bolt are over. She says that they'll hold the humans hostage and force Black Bolt to come to them.

Gorgon is surprised when Karnak tells him that he's grateful to have him there. They hear gunshots and screams from behind them, after a moment Black Bolt and others join them. Medusa says that they took care of the gangsters, and Louse introduces herself. Jen says that she should call the police anonymously, and they should leave. Karnak realizes that she's sending him off, and Jen tells him that they had a good time but now they have to go their own ways. She kisses him and tells him not to be so hard on himself, and that a little doubt is good for him. Once she limps off, Karnak realizes that his powers are coming back to him.

Locus collapses and they realize that she was shot in the fight. Karnak confirms that it's a fatal wound, and Locus tells Black Bolt that he should be the king that they deserve. He nods in agreement, and dies before she can tell them where Crystal is.

Tibor walks down the hall and hooded men confront him. They demand to know what Tibor was talking to, and he insists that he wasn't defying Maximus. The leader tells Tibor that they're rebels and they need his help to take down Maximus.

The Royals circle him and say that Black Bolt knows that Maximus killed their parents. Black Bolt prepares to blast Maximus... and Maximus wakes up from his nightmare.

Audrey comes back to check on Lockjaw, and Dave explains that Lockjaw has been teleporting them around. Crystal insists that he'll be fine, but Audrey tells them that Lockjaw needs rest. She says that they should both go home, and prepares to take a picture of Crystal for the

authorities. Crystal destroys it and Audrey storms off. The Inhuman worries that they wore out Lockjaw, and Dave suggests that create a forest fire or water spout to send a signal to her family. Crystal prepares to summon a lightning bolt, and Dave drives her to a mountain.

Black Bolt and the others head through the jungle, and Louise explains that she found them because they left distinctive energy bursts when they teleported to Hawaii. They turn to Karnak for a plan, and he warns that he's not as reliable as he has been in the past. Gorgon wants to attack directly, but Medusa would rather give Karnak a little more time. Black Bolt signs that they need to take down Maximus. Medusa says that they should take Maximus alive, just as Louise arrives and says that there was another energy burst on the northern part of the island.

Locus' comlink goes off and Medusa answers it. It's Auran, who tells them that she has Evan and Sammy. She says that if Black Bolt and Medusa don't come back, she'll kill them. Black Bolt agrees, and Medusa tells Auran that Locus is dead. Auran says that they're still at the lab and signs off.

As the Inhumans head for the lab, Medusa tells Karnak that Crystal is their priority. Gorgon wants to deal with Auran immediately, and Karnak agrees. Black Bolt sends Karnak and Gorgon to go after Auran while he and Medusa find Crystal. Karnak warns that he may not be ready for a big fight, and Medusa assures him that he is Attilan's greatest fighter at even half strength. Louise gives them directions after Karnak agrees, and says that they'll come back for them after they find Crystal and Lockjaw.

In Attilan, Loyolis tells his son Bronaja that he'll come back a free man. He joins the others that Maximus has assembled, and Maximus says that they need their help to capture the Royal Family before they return and send the lower caste back to the mines. He praises Loyolis for his loyalty and has Eldrac teleport them to Hawaii. Tibor questions Maximus, who says that the people love him and will do anything for him. Bronaja listens as Maximus says that if Black Bolt kills them then the citizens will hate them all the more.

Loyolis and the others arrive at the lab and Auran greets them. She orders them to follow her.

Tibor tells the Rebel Leader that they need to catch Maximus alone and kill him.

Louise, Black Bolt, and Medusa come to a barricade across the road. Black Bolt asks why Medusa mentioned his parents earlier, and she says that Black Bolt promised her that he would be more understanding than his parents when they exiled her parents. Medusa insists that they give Maximus a fair trial and let the people decide. She says that she's trying to protect Black Bolt from himself, just as Louise finds an alternate route to Crystal's location.

Tibor approaches Maximus and asks for a word alone. Maximus orders his guards out and Tibor tells him that a rebel group are preparing an attack on his life. The new king doesn't believe him, insisting the people are happy, and Tibor says that a concerned citizen brought the rumors to his attention. He warns against the Royal Guard, noting that there is a conspiracy against Maximus, and suggests that they handle it alone. They find the rebels, force them to say who is involved, and make an example of them.

Maximus agrees, tells Tibor to find out what he can, and meet him in the control room.

Gorgon trains Maximus in fighting as Karnak looks on. Maximus doesn't see the point of learning to fight, and Gorgon easily avoids Maximus' next attack. Gorgon knocks Maximus down and says that he has to anticipate need the training. Karnak points out that they are all skilled fighters, and Gorgon calls an end to the training. Maximus grabs a staff and hits Gorgon from behind. Karnak stops Gorgon from retaliating, and points out that a sneak attack is more cunning and smarter.

At the lab, Auran tells the miners that they'll draw in the Royals and then surround them. Mordis and Flora snap at the rivals, and Evan warns Auran that she may not be able to regenerate herself forever.

Dave takes Crystal to the highest point on Oahu and she talks about Earth is nothing like Attilan. he suggests that after they find the Royals, they might take a trip together. Crystal summons lightning, Louise stops to check the map, and asks why the Inhumans hide on the far side of the moon. Medusa explains that they used to live on Earth, but when humans found them they left for the safety of Inhumans and humans alike. Lightning strikes out of the sky, and Louise points out that most humans aren't bad. The lightning strikes again in the same spot, and Black Bolt realizes that it's Crystal.

Maximus meets with Bronaja and asks him to try and "see" who started the rebellion. Bronaja "sees" Maximus and Tibor together, talking. The teenager says that Maximus didn't seem angry in the vision, and after a moment Maximus apologizes for pushing Bronaja so hard. He assures Bronaja that Loyolis will open the gates of paradise for the rest of them, and asks if there was anything in the vision that led him to suspect Tibor. Bronaja says that Maximus can trust him, and Maximus says that he wants Bronaja with him when he meets with Tibor.

Karnak and Gorgon approach the lab and Gorgon figures that they can handle the four Inhumans that they know about. Karnak can't see the flaw in the lab's security, but Gorgon does. He points out that their opponents don't know that Karnak has lost his powers.

Gorgon runs to the power shed and shorts out the lights.

Auran realizes that the Royals are there, and tells Mordis to keep an eye on Evan. Karnak steps out and Auran sees him, but refuses to shoot him. She figures that Karnak wants to shoot him and it's a trick, and has Flora notify Mordis.

Karnak approaches the lab and greets Auran. She ducks back and he walks out of sight.

Loyolis goes to find Karnak.

When Flora warns Mordis, Mordis tells her to go after him.

A tied-up Sammy calls to Karnak. He takes out Flora, and Mordis finds her a few seconds later. Karnak calls to him from the shadows, and Mordis invites him to tell him all the ways that he can defeat him. The Royal describes how Mordis came out of Terragenesis with the face of death, and the Genetic Council wanted to put him down. Karnak pleaded for Mordis' life, and

Mordis says that he was locked away while Black Bolt was allowed free. Gorgon draws Mordis' attention, and Karnak knocks Mordis out with a sleeper hold.

Gorgon unties Sammy and Karnak tells him to leave so that they don't have to worry about him. They tell him that they all have powers and assure Sammy that he's not a freak. Sammy tells them to thank Black Bolt for him, and Gorgon asks Karnak if the story he told him was true. Karnak says that he wanted to put Mordis down after Terragenesis, and Gorgon tells him that he'll handle Auran.

Karnak finds Loyolis and gets close enough to render him unconscious.

Gorgon confronts Auran and attacks her before she can shoot. He disarms her and they fight, and he pins her to the floor. He prepares to stomp her and she surrenders.

Karnak finds Evan and says that Maximus is the traitor brother of Black Bolt. Evan explains that Maximus paid for his research, grabs his briefcase with the research, and heads out with Karnak.

Crystal and Dave wait, and Dave asks if she'll be happy to get home. She admits that it's great to be on Earth, and wonders if her family saw her signal. Dave tells her that she's like a God of Thunder and kisses her. As she kisses him back, Black Bolt, Medusa, and Louise arrive. Dave introduces himself and Crystal says that he's a good person. She tells them that Lockjaw is resting at Dave's barn, and Black Bolt says that they need Lockjaw to get Gorgon and Karnak and then they can get home.

As Gorgon starts to tie up Mordis, Auran warns that when they get back to Attilan they'll see that the people love Maximus. Mordis for his face mask and Gorgon grabs him, and yells at everyone to get out. he stumps down, bring the building down on himself and Mordis before Mordis can unleash his face blast.

Audrey opens the door to reveal Louise and no one else. Louise claims that Audrey her in there because of jealousy. Dave plays along, and tells Audrey to back away. The police officers believe Louise and leave, and Louise and Dave look at the empty barn.

Lockjaw teleports the Royals to the lab and Black Bolt goes inside. He finds Mordis' cracked helmet, and Karnak kneeling by Gorgon's body. They take the body outside and mourn.

On the Moon, the rebels enter the control room. Maximus is waiting with Bronaja, Tibor, and his Royal Guard. The new king says that they have their friends and will kill them if they don't surrender. Tibor tells Maximus that he will fail, and Maximus cuts his throat. Furious, Maximus says that he's not stupid and nothing will stop him. The guards take the rebels away, and Bronaja asks Maximus what will happen to them. Maximus asks if Tibor had a knife in his hand when Bronaja saw him talking to Maximus, and says that he lied because he was scared. The new king says that fear is a great motivator, and he's trying to lead the Inhumans to something great. He smears some of Tibor's blood on Bronaja's face and tells him to trust in him. Maximus tells Bronaja to say "Long live King Maximus", and Bronaja does so.

Medusa advises Loyolis to surrender, and the miner quickly does. Karnak says that Evan is a collaborator, and he says that Maximus if during his research on Terrigenesis and how it can be replicated. They figure that Maximus wants to go through Terrigenesis again, and Black Bolt suggests that Maximus has already murdered the Genetic Council.

The next morning, the Royal Family prepares Gorgon for burial. Medusa asks

what kind of message they should send to Maximus, and Karnak breaks Auran's neck. He says that she'll come back and they'll send her body to Maximus to get his attention. Medusa insists that it has to stop, and asks Black Bolt would kind of king he would be if he kills his brother. Karnak says that actions have consequences and Maximus is about to learn that lesson.

Maximus tells the Royal Guard to search for more rebels. Crystal and Lockjaw teleport in with Maximus' team, takes out the guard, and says that Black Bolt has asked for parlay under tradition. They are returning Maximus' team as a show of good faith. Crystal tells him that Gorgon is dead, and Maximus figures that the Royals has had enough. He says that he grants their request, and tells the Royal Guard Sergeant that he'll have the advantage once the Royals come to him.

In Hawaii, Karnak says that they should attack Medusa. Medusa figures that they're tired and their loss is tearing them apart. She wants to do more than survive, and Black Bolt warns that he has to deal with reality. Medusa wonders where it ends, and she says that Medusa has to pay for his actions. However, she begs Black Bolt not to kill him. He refuses and Medusa says that there's one more place to go.

Black Bolt has Lockjaw teleport to the beach and Medusa sees someone swimming toward shore. It's Triton, and his relatives run to greet him. Triton explains that he was wounded but he

and Black Bolt set a meeting place and the king felt it was best that Maximus believed his plan was working. Medusa tells Triton that Gorgon is dead and it's not part of a secret plan. Black Bolt has Lockjaw take them to the Royal Bunker, and Medusa complains that she's never seen it before. They tell Evan that they're on the moon, and Medusa wonders if Gorgon's death and the loss of her hair was part of Black Bolt's plan. Black Bolt talks to her privately and she says that it's insulting when she sidelines him. During her time on earth, she's perceived how people see them. She refuses to be just Black Bolt's interpreter, and asks what the plan is.

Black Bolt and Triton prepare for war, and Triton goes to undermine Maximus.

Auran comes back to life and Maximus tells her that the Royal Family is looking to bargain. She says that they have suffered losses, and Maximus plans to take the high road by honoring the death of a traitor. Auran realizes that Maximus wanted to become an Inhuman, and that she followed him she admired him as a human. Furious, Maximus says that everywhere he goes he'll always be a human to be pitied. He tells Auran that once he's been through Terrigenesis, he will need Attilan to a new level. Then they will go to earth and have a life larger than they can imagine.

Evan shows Karnak his research on Terrigenesis, and explains that Maximus wants to splice his DNA with the samples. Karnak figures that if Black Bolt brought Evan then he has some value. When Evans wonders if he'll be safe in the bunker, Karnak looks at Gorgon's body and tells him that none of them are safe.

Maximus meets with the people and says that they're there to honor Gorgon. He talks about growing up with Gorgon but there was always a distance. Maximus wishes that Gorgon had put forward the effort to see him for who he truly is, and the Royal Family can't see any of them for who they are. He claims that he wants both sides to set aside their differences and avoid any more losses.

On the field of parley, Auran reminds Maximus of the rules of parley. The Royals teleport in with Evan, and Black Bolt and Medusa step onto the field. Maximus joins them and Medusa translates Black Bolt saying that they're there to extend grace. They will turn over Evan so that he can proceed, and in return they reclaim their throne and set aside any punishment. Medusa says that they want Maximus to become one of them, Maximus accepts, and has his Royal Guard take Evan.

Medusa asks Black Bolt if it's right, and Maximus notes the dissension in the family. He points out that they have nothing and it's all his, and Black Bolt hates it. When Black Bolt starts to warn him, Maximus says that he has always been one of them and will remain king. He rescued a friend of his, and declines their offer. Maximus warns Black Bolt that the people would be appalled if Black attacked him. Black Bolt says that he will kill Maximus the next time he sees him. With that, he returns to Lockjaw and the Royal Family teleports away.

Later, Maximus meets with Evan and asks to see his work. Evan shows him his DNA samples and Maximus says that he will choose what powers he gets. The scientist warns that he doesn't know if it's safe. Maximus explains that Terrigenesis is what binds them together, and to be ignored by it is an insult. He says that Evan will be part of a second controlled Terrigenesis that will benefit both of their people, and Evan's name will be linked to that moment. Auran calls Maximus out and says that they're having some mechanical issues. The maintenance crews have been conscripted, and Auran suspects loyalists or the Royal Family itself is responsible. Maximus figures that the Royals have returned to earth, and tells Auran to investigate the guards who were on the maintenance crews. He then goes with Evan.

In the bunker, Medusa tells Black Bolt that the parley was a worth a try. She reminds him of how she came to the Quiet Room to gloat after Black Bolt accidentally killed his parents. Medusa thought that he was irredeemable, but then she saw in his face that they were the same person with different circumstances. What she saw today was two people in the same pain, and insists that nothing is irredeemable. Karnak overhears her and comes in, and Medusa says she hopes they choose rightly when the time comes. He says that he saw the flaw in Evan's research, and they should let Maximus figure it out on his own. However, he wants to use it to bring Gorgon back through a second Terrigenesis. Medusa is surprised that Karnak is embracing a plan he isn't certain will work, and Karnak refuses to wait on certainty. Black Bolt reminds him that a second Terrigenesis is forbidden, but Karnak points out that no one knows for sure. The king still forbids it, and Karnak nods in agreement and walks off.

Auran goes to the control room, and Karnak takes out her guards after analyzing the flaws

in his plan. Once they're down, Karnak tells Auran that he's there to help her. He says that he sees the flaw in Auran and wants to help her. Karnak says that she's backed the wrong man and knows it, and she feels regret for Gorgon's death. He reminds her that Gorgon trained her to do the right thing at the right time, and says that neither of them are at that point. After a moment, Auran lowers her gun and Karnak asks for a bit of her DNA.

In the bunker, Medusa asks Crystal how she's doing. Crystal says that she left Dave without hardly saying goodbye, and admits that she cares about him. Medusa agrees that not all humans are bad, and Crystal describes how she saw normal people on earth living normal lives. She thinks that's what she wants, and at least wants to have the choice to spend her life with Dave.

Karnak and Auran bring Gorgon's body to the Terrigenesis cell, and Karnak concedes that his ability to see flaws might be how the Royals are sabotaging Attilan. He takes her DNA sample and says that her regeneration powers will adhere to Gorgon through the nanogene technology. Karnak injects the DNA into Gorgon and they activate Terrigenesis. Auran tells Karnak that her powers may not be so strong any more, and Karnak admits that he's had some difficulties of his own which have forced him to rethink... they both hope for the better. Auran wonders if it will work, and Karnak says that he needs it to. He opens the Terrigenesis chamber but Gorgon is still dead. Auran suggests that maybe they're supposed to come to terms with death instead of avoiding it.

Guards arrive, and Auran says that she's fleeing but not with Karnak. She runs off, and Karnak closes the chamber and turns off the lights before leaving.

Maximus takes Evan to the Terrigenesis room and Maximus says that it's the key to who they are. Evan tells Maximus that they're onto the final path, and Maximus nervously takes out a Terrigen crystal. He tells Evan that it isn't how he imagined it, and the first time he was surrounded by people who loved him. Maximus says that he wanted it to be a victory, and Evan reminds him that he said that he'd be the first of a new generation. Bracing himself, Maximus goes to one of the chambers and sees Gorgon in the other chamber. The room shakes and the guards report that surveillance is down and they're blind. Maximus leaves with his men, telling Evan to stay there.

Triton tells Medusa that Maximus is out in the open with six men. He then kills three of the guards one at a time, and they're unable to find the hooded Triton in the crowd. They duck into a tunnel and Triton kills the remaining guards and goes after Maximus.

In the Terrigenesis room, Evan is studying the samples when the power goes out. Someone crashes through the shadows, and Evan calls to the figure. The man steps out of the shadows... and Evan realizes that it's Gorgon.

He insists that Black Bolt abandoned the people, and once he goes through Terrigenesis he will lead the Inhumans to earth as a conquering enemy. Black Bolt tells him that he doesn't know what enemy they're facing, and Triton suggests that they take Maximus to the control room via the tunnels.

Meanwhile, Black Bolt tells Crystal and Medusa to set up an evacuation as a last resort. Medusa says that she'll take care of it and tells Crystal that she'll need his help and Lockjaw's.

Karnak confronts two guards and says that he can kill them. A third guard gets the drop on him and they lock Karnak in the Quiet Room.

Lockjaw teleports Medusa to Louise, who hugs her friend in relief. Medusa has a case and Louise realizes that she's there to ask for a favor. She wants to go to Attilan, and Medusa warns that it's not safe and they might all be leaving. She's there to figure out where they're going.

Black Bolt and Maximus continue on, and Maximus says that Black Bolt has never been down there before. He says that Black Bolt is the one who betrayed him. He promised that Maximus would be king and then changed his mind after he killed their parents.

In the Quiet Room, Kitang tells Black Bolt that his power is the only thing that can protect them from their greatest enemy. Maximus storms in and Kitang tells him that Black Bolt is the new king.

Maximus tells Black Bolt that it's insulting that a murderer is a king and he isn't. Black Bolt signs that he didn't want to be king but he had to be king. Maximus doesn't believe him and Black Bolt leads him on. The city shakes and the cloaking device in the dome fades out for a moment. Maximus says that the pressure is trying to stabilize and soon it will give out entirely.

Karnak blames himself for what happened to Gorgon, who realizes that his cousin did it. He throws Karnak into the wall, and Karnak begs him to calm down. Karnak says that he was broken and is getting better, and they may be able to help him. He tells Gorgon to give him a minute to think, and Gorgon starts stomping on the wall. Karnak warns that he designed the room to contain Black Bolt's sonic waves... but Gorgon's weapon is brute force. Gorgon smashes through the wall.

Crystal goes to Eldrac and says that they need him to evacuate Attilan and it's too much for Lockjaw. Eldrac is glad to help.

Black Bolt takes Maximus out to the street, and Loyolis and the other hunters see him. They attack and Maximus runs off while Black Bolt knocks out the guards and locks them into a nearby building.

Triton finds Karnak and Gorgon, and Karnak tells Gorgon that triton wasn't really dead. he tells Triton what he did and admits that it's a mistake, and triton tells them that they have another problem.

Maximus and his guards go to the Terrigenesis chamber, and Auran tells him that Gorgon destroyed the chamber and killed Evan. The usurper discovers that the Terrigenesis crystals are gone, and tells his men to bring Bronaja to the grand hall. Once they're there, Maximus tells Bronaja to tell him where the crystals are. Bronaja warns that his power doesn't work that way, and Maximus touches him to start a future vision. Once he recovers, Bronaja says that he saw Maximus as the undisputed king of Attilan, and Black Bolt was gone. The city shakes and the statue of Maximus' father falls. Maximus and his people go to the control room.

In the control room, Maximus uses his handprint to stabilize the shield. He then broadcasts a speech saying that Black Bolt and the Royals stole the Terrigenesis crystals and they must be captured. Maximus says that every citizen is Attilan's greatest champion, and insists that they will never surrender.

Medusa and Crystal go to George, and Medusa explains that the Inhumans will need to come to earth. They need George to talk to their boss. When George doesn't believe them, they have Crystal and Lockjaw teleport in to convince him. George agrees to talk to the boss and asks who else knows about it. he says that the boss will want exclusive access to the Inhumans. Once they're alone, Crystal tells medusa and Louise what are happening. The case has the Terrigenesis crystals, and Medusa gives them to Louise to take care of them. Louise promises that she'll keep them safe, and gives Medusa her father's ashes to take to the moon. Medusa agrees to do it, and tells her to let go of the tiny metal rocket. Lockjaw then teleports the sisters back to Attilan.

Karnak and his relatives get to the control room, and Maximus confirms that only Maximus can stop the dome from collapsing. The flaw in his plan is that he's no technical genius, and he doesn't know what he did. Maximus thinks that he can stop the damage but he may not, and they'll know when the dome collapses and they all die. Black Bolt arrives and Karnak tells him what he did to Gorgon. He admits that he disobeyed a good order from his king, and only did so to get his cousin back. Black Bolt puts a hand on Gorgon's soldier, calming him down, and Karnak tells Black Bolt that he can't stop the dome's destruction.

The Royals find Medusa in the bunker, and Karnak warns her that Gorgon isn't the same. Medusa says that they will talk of Karnak disobeying orders once the current crisis is over, and informs them that Crystal is coordinating the evacuation. If necessary. Black Bolt says that they need to tell the Inhumans to prepare to leave, and medusa wants to make one less effort to talk Maximus down.

Even if she fails, it will stall him and she can bargain with the one Terrigenesis crystal she has. Karnak warns that the guards are everywhere, and Medusa suggests that they find someone

who wants to protect Maximus and Attilan.

Once the Royals contact Auran, she guarantees Medusa's safety and Maximus' and takes her to Maximus. Medusa asks Maximus if he's willing to die, and Maximus claims that he can terminate the destruction at any time. He says that he will only do so when he has rounded up the Royals. Medusa asks him if makes him feel good to see her without her hair, and Maximus tells her that she's almost human like him. she says that now she knows what it feels like for people to dismiss her like she did him. Medusa admits that she ignored him and maybe if she had been a better friend, they wouldn't be there. Maximus tells her that she was his only friend, and Medusa says that if he cared for Attilan then he would never destroy it. As they talk, the dome wavers again.

Black Bolt and the others get to the control room and Karnak warns that the dome is dangerously close to collapse. They access the camera systems .

Medusa warns Maximus that they are running out of time. He agrees to spare her life and tells her to go back to earth while she can.

Medusa offers him the crystal if he steps down from the throne and stops the dome's collapse. Maximus orders her to hand it over, and Medusa smashes it. Maximus promises that Medusa will die for what she has done, and orders Auran to come in to kill Medusa.

Auran refuses and tells Medusa to go, and Medusa tells her that Maximus is all Auran's before walking out.

Black Bolt and the other return to the bunker, and Medusa tells him that Maximus won't back down. she asks if they should begin the evacuation of Attilan, and after a moment Black Bolt agrees. They broadcast to the Inhumans, saying that they have made mistakes.

However, they have always put the needs of Attilan before themselves. Medusa says that her parents had a vision of tearing down the walls of class, one that Maximus seems to share. She warns the Inhumans that Maximus is endangering them all with his selfish needs, and the Royals want to continue the change in a more positive direction... on earth. Medusa explains that Maximus has compromised the protective dome, and they must return to their homeland with her and Black Bolt leading the way.

Maximus and Auran watch, and Maximus insists that they're lying. He swears that Attilan is his, not theirs, and Auran stares at him in shock as Maximus says that he will let the dome collapse and kill all of them. Meanwhile, Black Bolt tells everyone to go to Eldrac. Attilan begins collapsing and the people panic.

Auran tells Maximus that he has to put his palm print on the scanner. He says that he will... once people accept him as their leader. Maximus reminds Auran of Bronaja's vision, and insists that no one goes to earth until he says so. When he orders Auran to stand guard, she takes her leave of him and Maximus thanks her for her loyalty.

Crystal leads the Inhumans through Eldrac's portal.

Medusa buries the ashes of Louise's father.

Karnak goes after Gorgon and says that they have to leave. He admits that it's the most selfish thing he's done and warns Gorgon that if stays then he will die... but he'll leave that up to Gorgon. Karnak begs Gorgon to live, and promises that he will help him if Gorgon choose to live. They go to the grand hall where Black Bolt, Triton, Medusa, and Crystal are waiting. Black Bolt says that they are Attilan and Attilan will never die, Medusa warns Black Bolt that Maximus will never see his side, but Black Bolt tells them that Maximus is too dangerous to leave unchecked and he has to deal with his brother. He kisses Medusa and she teleports to earth with the others. Black Bolt then goes to find his brother.

Black Bolt enters the control room where Maximus is waiting. Maximus tells him that he let it go too long and there's no stopping the dome's collapse. He admits that it's his fault, and Black Bolt says that he doesn't want to hurt him. Maximus points out that they will both soon die, and admits that they are brothers. He then tells Black Bolt the truth about their family.

Maximus forges royal documents to convince Black Bolt that their parents had ordered brain surgery on him. When a young Black Bolt objected, he killed his parents.

Maximus thought that Black Bolt would flee, but instead he killed their parents for no reason at all. He invites Black Bolt to kill him, and Black Bolt punches him unconscious. When Maximus wakes up, he realizes that he and Black Bolt are back in the bunker.

Maximus figures that the bunker will hold even if Attilan falls, and wonders who it was built to withstand an attack from. He hopes that he will never find out, and Black Bolt refuses to

say. Maximus asks why they're there, and Black Bolt shoves him away and leaves, locking Maximus inside. Black Bolt walks out and destroys the building above the bunker with two words: "Goodbye, brother." Alone in the darkness, Maximus says that he is the king of Attilan.

Black Bolt runs to Eldrac as Attilan collapses around him. Eldrac tells him to hurry, warning that the city's destruction is his own. Black Bolt leaves via a portal and the city collapses... and Eldrac along with it.

On the moon, the ruins of Attilan stand. In what's left of the ruins, the walls glow with blue runes.

On earth, the Royals go to talk to their people. Medusa tells Black Bolt that he saved the Inhumans, but he says that they traded one danger for another. They go to the Inhumans and Black Bolt tells Medusa to speak as the queen. She speaks in her own words, welcoming the Inhumans home. Medusa says that they face a future as friends, not a conquering army.
