We're six weeks before the heist and we meet Leo, the head honcho at the top of this. He knows that a lone wolf can only go so far and he needs a pack to join him for his latest endeavour. He begins to assemble a team to help him in this upcoming heist.

Trust can be earned and given, as evidenced by a montaged love story between bank worker Kate and Laura, a part of our crew. It would appear that their target is the SLS vault, which is apparently impregnable and the best of its kind. Stefan Thiele oversees proceedings (more on him later) while security detail is tight.

Leo knows in order to do the impossible, he needs to team up with a crew he can trust to do it right. So naturally, it begins with Stan, a reliable right hand man who's retired from the game. Only, 7 million dollars looks set to change his mind. As Leo discusses the eye wateringly heavy security, we see just who the target actually is. All three to be precise.

Between Cho Young-woo, Suzanne Grosevnor and Stefan Thiele, the trio (known as the triplets) control half a trillion dollars. There's about \$7 billion worth of bonds that haven't been cashed in, and that's what Leo and the crew intend to grab.

Stan heads off to meet Judy, a face from the past and someone whom they intend to recruit to their cause. Judy's partner, Bob, tags along without an invitation. Leo allows him to be part of

this, pointing out that all money will be distributed evenly between them... but only if the heist is a success. Part of this comes from a mole, which Leo has placed inside SLS.

That mole appears to be a woman named Ava, who suggests they need to bring on the best faces for each role in this heist if they even want to try and be successful in this endeavour. Ava promises to take care of the security detail, as we're introduced to RJ, a talented driver and clearly their getaway driver for this.

Before they even think about getting this heist up and running, they need money. Heading to Diamond Way, they break into a jewelry store and take a whole stack of jewels. However, Bob wants to try and steal the biggest diamond in the store, but he ends up getting caught and shot in the hand for his troubles.

Naturally, Judy saves him and the trio race away in gas masks, heading into the subway and eventually managing to get away before they're caught.

Hannah, the security whizz at the bank, finds out that she's pregnant but her sister isn't exactly enthused about it. To make matters worse, at work she finds out she needs to supervise Rajiv, who's fronting the security detail.

After working together for 8 years, Andrew — a man who's outed as a mole after an incriminating USB drive is found in his possession — is let go from his role and Hannah is promoted to senior VP. Of course, Hannah is the real mole and now that she's high up in the organisation, she can get all the IDs they need.

Seven years they've been talking about this, but Leo can sense Hannah is wavering. However, now that she's made a name for herself and has a steady job and relationship, all of that looks set to come crashing down around them.

The episode jumps back in time, seven years before the heist as we catch up with Leo. He's in prison and reveals that criminals come in all shapes and sizes. Stan is there too, also behind bars and actually happens to be his cellmate.

Leo's plight comes from the fact he was betrayed, which explains why he's behind bars. He and Stan work together and have a good operation going, using their outside gal, Judy, to ferry goods inside. She has ties to Stan and he believes she's the one.

There are some who aren't happy with this deal, especially when Stan sells a phone belonging to the Peckerwoods, a gang in the prison. There's three of them, and after smacking Stan upside the head with a rolling pin in the kitchen, leave him bleeding profusely. Leo shows and manages to save him from a nasty outcome.

Leo though, is not completely well. Seeing the doctor, he points out that he has Parkinson's. This explains the quip in the Yellow episode about "the shakes" and this diagnosis is not good. As a result, Leo decides to make a move, thinking clearly and already formulating an idea for a heist.

At the prison, Stan meets Judy's right-hand man, Bob. He's just as obnoxious as ever, and when he riles up Stan, he struggles to compose himself. However, Bob agrees to get him the cards he needs. When they leave, Stan decides to go all-in on Leo's plan.

Leo manages to get an imprint of the guard's key thanks to some flamboyant coughing and grabbing the guard's hip, while Stan spikes the food, sending the entire mess into raptures. When all the security detail leave to check what's going on, they leave Leo and Stan alone in the medical bay.

Leo breaks free from his cuffs but Stan is caught before he can escape. Leo manages to bust out through the parking lot, evading the guards as they show up in their droves.

Back inside, the doctor shrugs off the prisoner condition, claiming it's just magic mushrooms and they'll be fine in a few hours, joking that they should just throw on some Pink Floyd instead. They don't do roll call or anything, and as a result Leo is able to bust out and escape.

Leo heads to see Ava, where he reveals his Parkinson diagnosis to her. Next, he visits Hannah and tries to explain himself. It's here we learn that Hannah is actually Leo's daughter. While they're together, the police realize Leo is missing (finally) and decide to try and find him.

Leo has his sights set on Roger Salas though, a man who's closely aligned to Hannah at SLS. When a burning corpse is found by the police, it's perceived to be Ray Vernon (Leo's real name) and as a result, Leo is given a brand new identity to push forward with.

The episode sees us jump to five days before the heist. Here, we get a closer look at this Roger Salas character. He's the head of SLS, which happens to be the largest financial security firm on the East Coast. He thinks he's untouchable but that's wrong, he's very much going to be taken down. Especially if Leo has anything to do with it.

Leo speaks to his crew in confidence, bringing up how they have seven jobs to do in order to take this man — and by extension the vault — down. As Leo himself

puts it, they're going to thread the needle and build up to this big heist in the end.

A series of different jobs need to take place including getting into SLS, infiltrating the vault and moving gear in. With a three-part security system, temperature gauges and a whole bunch of other trinkets along the way, it's not going to be easy.

As we find out again, Roger Salas has crafted the most secure vault ever created. And that's what Leo intends to crack. While he's out at a party that night, Leo breaks into Roger's house and bugs his office. He gets a fingerprint and spikes his eyedrops too.

At the same time though, there are problems back at the garage. Tensions erupt between Bob and Stan over Judy, with the hotheaded Bob eventually deciding in confidence that he and Judy should double-cross everyone else and steal all the gear for themselves.

At the party, Roger Salas is encouraged to help the triplets with their \$7 billion problem. Stefan is confident he'll find a way to be "helpful", which ties into Leo and the gang's plans nicely. Speaking of which, Roger receives a cryptic call that night and promises that nothing he has is safe, spooking him and encouraging Roger to up the security at SLS. However, the distorted voice manages to ring through there too, demanding a ransom of \$4.3 million, which happens to be his net worth.

Roger is spooked and heads off to get an exam with a doctor for his eyes. That doctor happens to be Stan. He uses a contraption to take a scan of Roger's face, getting them one step closer to breaking into SLS. However, in the process of all this, the backdoor they've been using to get into SLS's security system is shut down, which Ava worryingly tells Leo.

Although the latter starts to despair, it's not the end of the road as he works to try and turn the tide back in his favour. It turns out Andrew is the one who wanted the \$4.3 million ransom, not Leo as we were led to believe. With Andrew's name ruined earlier in the timeline, and his wife and kids gone, Andrew has no other choice.

He blackmails Roger into submission, but when Roger leaves, he has an assassin show and kill the man outright, choking Andrew with a plastic bag so he can't rat him out anymore.

With attention turned away from Leo, the latter breaks into SLS and manages to get Roger alone in the steam room. Leo thinks twice about choking him out though, and decides to use an upcoming hurricane to their advantage and work the heist around that. After all, with New York about to get hit hard, the authorities decide to evacuate the masses and this gives them an in-route.

As the episode closes out, Roger receives a call from Stefan, who reveals that he actually does know about Roger's past, and decides they should talk after the heist.

The episode picks up three weeks before the heist, following Nazan who happens to be the FBI agent we saw a little bit of in the later parts of the timeline. She's an ex drug-addict but has been clean for a while. She also has a talent for spotting details, which we see first-hand in an operation where she stops a criminal from escaping. She's finally got a chance with Reza, her son, as it's the first time she's seeing him unsupervised.

Back at the office, Nazan is all over the diamond heist, and manages to hone in

on Ava Mercer. They only have a shell casing for now but with Nazan on the case, there's undoubtedly going to be more evidence to come.

When Ava leaves Leo's, Bob happens to be waiting for her. He wants to tag along as they head to get those stolen jewels valued. Naturally, Bob is obnoxious but they manage to get a cool \$400k to help them out. This should help them break into the vault and get all the gear they need to make this happen.

Leo tasks RJ with creating an armoured truck that's a replica of those used at SLS. They need a 2003 Chevy to begin with. At the same time, Ava is called in by the feds and questioned over the shell casing. Specifically due to the fact it has her fingerprints on. Ava shrugs it off, pointing out she actually reported two of her guns stolen to the police.

Although Ava is able to leave, it's clear she's had run-ins with Nazan before and is concerned this could blow up later down the line. Leo encourages her to be extra vigilant and although Ava

says they don't have a "real problem", it's clear that this isn't true. The pair a history together, given Ava was the one who originally ratted out Nazan for her drug addiction.

Navan is certainly onto something at work. She speaks to her associate, Toby, and points out that she thinks this whole Diamond Way gig was a front for a much larger operation about to take place. She's sussed out that Ava is working with Bob, given the pictures she's taken.

Nazan then reveals, through some heavy-handed info dump dialogue everything that's happened to her after 9/11. Despite joining the FBI, her background means she's had a lot of xenophobia leveled her way. She eventually turned to drugs as a way of escaping.

Meanwhile, there's more drama between Bob, Stan and Judy as the former lashes out and hits Stan while the trio are out at the bar. When the fight spills over into the street, unbeknownst to them all Nazan has her guys watching their every move.

Bob and Judy discuss cracking safes out in the open and eventually end up screwing in the car. However, it's enough for the FBI to work on, especially as they find Judy, Stan and the others involved in this, leading all the way back to Leo.

More importantly though, Nazan figures out that Ava is just another spoke on the wheel rather than the top heist planner and as a result, has her followed.

However, Ava gets the jump on Navan as the officer follows the wrong woman. When Ava slips away, she takes the time to plant drugs on Nazan. When the police catch up, they find the drugs and take Nazan down for questioning.

As a result of this unwanted heat, Ava decides to skip out on this operation, believing it's way too dangerous and without her involved, they'll have nothing on Leo and the others.

With Nazan on the verge of losing custody of her son, she makes a call to ICE and has Ava's grandmother taken away as a bargaining chip. With the woman about to be deported, Nazan meets Ava in private and forces her to flip and work as her mole on the inside.

The episode starts 24 years before the heist, way before the events of the rest of the series. Leo breaks into a house and begins cracking the safe while Roger works to distract the guests downstairs. After cracking the lock, they take as much money and jewellery as possible.

Leo is forced to wait it out inside the safe until the coast is clear. It's touch and go for a while but they do manage to get out in one piece, thankfully!

After, the pair split their \$70k winnings and discuss how close they came

to this being game over for them. Leo has a whole family back home, including daughter Hannah and his partner, Lily. While taking Hannah out to the diner, Leo is encouraged by Roger to come to Vegas as they have another job on the table.

Even this far back Leo and Ava have history, with Leo ferrying his stolen wares to her to exchange for cash. She tries to encourage him to play ball, promising the biggest haul ever if they team up.

Leo is unsure what to do, given his family situation, and eventually suggests to Roger that they take a break and slow down. When Roger refuses to indulge his request, Leo instead plays the race card. Eventually that works out and Leo taps out the operation.

8 months pass and Leo is living a simple life, working as a key cutter. Roger shows up and suggests he make copies of keys to make for easy pickings. Although he claims it's a joke, the amount of debt Roger is in is certainly no laughing matter. He's around 300k down and needs Leo's help.

When a meeting goes awry between Lily and a businessman named Kyle, thanks in part to Hannah running around and breaking the rules, Leo hits out when Kyle throws out a slur about

the ghetto. As a result, Leo decides to go all-in on his latest plan with Roger, deciding to make counterfeit jewellery for an auction.

Part of the plan here comes from breaking in and switching out the real jewellery (which they can sell to Ava's buyers) for fakes. It's touch and go for a while but they do manage to take out the guard in the area who spots Leo hiding behind a table. Roger decides to stage a fire in order for them to escape in the chaos, intending to hide the evidence and get away in the panic.

It turns out Leo's wife Lily is actually inside the building all this time, having decided to work for her boss. Disaster strikes and Leo is forced to watch his wife pass away. Roger however, decides to leave his friend in hot water.

Naturally, Leo is spotted by police who show up and prepare to arrest him at the hospital. As for Hannah, Leo gives her some words of advice and tells her to be strong, hugging her tightly before leaving this poor girl with no parents and kept under the care of Ava, who shows up at the hospital.

Summary: Tensions run high when the crew regroups after the heist and questions what went wrong – and who to trust. FBI agent Nazan makes a shocking discovery.



The episode of Kaleidoscope sees us arrive at the morning after the heist. Leo is driving a boat with the rest of the crew, where it seems the heist was a complete mess. Stan sports a gunshot wound on his ear while the mood is somber. They weren't successful in escaping but as Leo himself mentions "no one can point out the moment it all fell apart."

There's devastation across the city as we cut back to moments after the failed heist following this boat opening. The storm has ripped through the city, while

Leo soon learns that they have a rat in their operation. Now, for those who watched the earlier episodes we know exactly who this is. Judy tries to work out who it is, while Stan shows up in an Uber, angry to learn that Leo doesn't have the Bonds as promised.

Roger and Hannah show up at SLS, having seen them on the feeds and knowing they're close. They try to deduce exactly what's happened, with bees inside and the vault itself completely submerged in water.

The FBI show not long after, led by Nazan who's still on the case. Nazan points out she has a mole and knows the vault has been broken into and demands that they be let down and see the safe. Roger shows and manages to talk them around until they get a warrant but it's clear they're not done with this yet. Stefan ringing Roger doesn't help, as he looks warily and eventually tells him the bonds are fine.

The thing is, the bonds aren't inside the safe and even worse, Stan has actually left his glasses at the bottom next to the vault, which are found and subsequently checked at the lab for DNA. Naturally, Roger traces this back to the guy who did his eye exam, and then his car. It's only a matter of time before they're found out.

Roger's assassin, Carlos, shows up at Stan's place and immediately shoots up his family when he learns Stan's not there. He continues on the hunt.

Meanwhile, Ava shows up with the bonds at Leo's headquarters, but she's been shot in the shoulder. RJ and Bob are both gone, with Ava claiming Bob is dead. However, as they fight, one of the boxes is knocked over and it shows coloured cards inside.

Naturally, no one is prepared to trust anyone, as it seems someone has taken off with the real Bonds. All of this inevitably leads to a big stand-off. Carlos arrives, breaking everything up, and shooting Stan in the ear.

Carlos realizes the rest of the bonds are gone, with Judy managing to entice them into the office where Leo lies in wait and shoots Carlos dead. With the SLS goons dispatched, the group head onboard the speedboat and race away.

Meanwhile, the FBI shows up to see Roger with a warrant. They have a right to search everything, including the private vaults. He obliges and shows them downstairs where the vault is no longer submerged and everything seems to be in order.

The safe is empty, with Roger claiming they've moved it to keep their assets safe, while Roger's "private vault" is kept shut. Inside happens to be a whole load of water... and something else hanging up. Quite what though, remains a mystery until the White episode!

Stan and Judy are still running their scams together and have made a nice little profit for themselves. Both of them are attempting to bury their demons under a litany of crimes. Like a modern day Bonnie and Clyde, right? They offer to sell up counterfeit wine to a seller in the lounge but Stan gets cold feet at the last second.

Leo's condition is deteriorating with the Parkinson's starting to hit him hard. While he goes to physical therapy, Ava is there to watch over him. She even encourages him to get back into heists again, pointing out the Midwest has a good place they can hit. She doesn't want him to stop.

Stan rings though on the back of attempting to pawn some jewellery and it seems his cover has been blown and he's been spotted. As a result, Stan gets cold feet and rings Ava and Leo, worried that they might be outed too. And unfortunately, he's right.

Leo receives a letter from Hannah and can hardly process the news that she's got a child before Ava rushes in and declares they need to pack their things and go. The FBI is heading down to Folly beach and it seems they've figured out the pawn shop Stan used. However, the guy behind the counter doesn't out Stan, given he's a different cashier, and for now they're in the clear.

When Bob and his two goons show up at Ava's place, a shoot-out ensues, eventually leading to Bob blindsiding her and knocking Ava out. When Ava regains consciousness, she finds Bob sitting in front of her.

After dispatching Zanetti earlier in the episode, Bob smirks and demands answers. He wants Judy and his \$100 million. When she refuses, Bob has her tied up and begins doing the rounds, searching the place thoroughly. Leo is nowhere to be found but Teresa is. Ava's grandmother hacks at him with an axe but she's quickly stopped. Both of them are held up at gunpoint as a result.

Leo eventually does come out of hiding and hands over everything he has. Stan is obviously nowhere to be found, given he's off in South Carolina. Leo tries to encourage Bob to stop, pointing out that he's a ghost and he should just start over in his life. When Bob refuses, Leo is forced to organize a meet with Stan and Judy for him, promising to give them some money. The meet spot is the Smashing Crab, a seafood joint.

However, all of this is a big ruse, as Bob shows up and is shot dead by Nazan and Toby when they arrive and corner him on the beach. As he drops dead, so too does Ava as Bob's goon fatally shoots her. Leo is shocked and viciously murders the goon. Through all this carnage, Judy finds Bob's bag which happens to hold the Bonds and decides to take off with it.

Meanwhile, Leo makes the call he always promised to Hannah, facetimeing with her. Next, he shows up in prison to see Roger and reveals that Bob is gone. Our FBI agents are on stake-out too, while New York braces for the incoming storm. Oh, and Roger happens to be surveying the cameras at home too.

The first step of this mission comes from Stan driving his truck in through the front gates, passing security with Bob and preparing to storm the SLS vault,

moving their gear after parking up. Meanwhile, guards are taken out to prevent the alarms from being rung and they head downstairs.

Ava and Leo gas the corridors which causes other guards to fall unconscious, while down in the sewers Judy starts leaving lights like a neon breadcrumb trail for Hansel and Gretel. However, this house isn't made of gingerbread but instead reinforced with layers of security detail.

Leo prepares for the next stage of all this, complete with the face mask of Roger he obtained thanks to Stan's eye exam.

Bees are fed into the system to disrupt the gait sensor. This, of course, wouldn't show up on the CCTV cameras at Roger's place so it looks like a simple electronic malfunction due to the storm. Dressed in a bee suit and with Roger's face print on, Leo manages to break in through to the other side. The crew join him and Leo's group access the vault.

The temperature is stable too, prompting the group to enact their next plan, which includes flooding the vault. The trio of Stan, Bob and Leo work on opening the vault as the place begins flooding, slowly transporting the bonds one by one.

Now, through it all the group are unaware that Ava is working with Nazan. She messages the FBI to tell them they need to get to the 59th floor immediately. She and Toby bust in, smashing through the glass and finding the heart of the operation hidden behind a fake wall. In doing so, they rip up all the electronics and it sends the feeds haywire.

This immediately sends Roger and Hannah racing to SLS with the whole operation on the verge of collapsing. In the pouring rain they race up to the building, while Nazan and Toby do the same. When Leo receives a message reading "Roger knows", they hurriedly move to end the operation.

Ava moves the gear into the elevator, sending it up to the mailroom, where Hannah takes over. There, Hannah switches out the bonds and moves a whole bunch of coloured card in the boxes, explaining what happened there and how she ended up with the bonds.

Meanwhile, Stan loses his glasses in the scramble to leave. With the vault filling with water, Bob is the first to leave in a very uncharacteristic move, telling the others they're greedy. That's, of course, a far cry from his actions earlier in the series where he wanted the best diamond.

Meanwhile, Ava, Leo and Stan break into the vault while Bob tries to leave with Judy. He manhandles RJ but before he can shoot Bob (missing the first time), Judy shoots him dead. The pair dump him in the garbage and Bob even makes a quip that she's a "hell of a shot." Turning around, Stan is right there and sees them together and rushes off. Bob fires but it misses Stan.

When Bob stalks him through the streets, Judy shows up and chokes him out, deciding to switch her allegiance. The scar on his neck was, in fact, from Judy choking him out. So, she's responsible for choking his windpipe and preventing him from speaking but he wants her back and blames Stan?

Anyway, down in the parking lot Ava betrays the FBI and takes off with the bonds, unaware that they are the fake ones. Nazan fires and it hits Ava's shoulder. She finds Bob in the middle of the road and decides to drive around him. When she does, Bob wakes up and clutches his throat in agony. He uses a pen to pierce his neck, given there's blood in his lungs. It's enough to keep him alive.

Through all of this, Hannah reveals to her father what she's done. She did it for Leo and decides to give all the bonds back to the Triplets. In doing so, it allows them to still have the funds and write everything off as a financial loss. This way, the rich get richer and Leo can survive without having to be looking over his shoulder the whole time. She wanted to get revenge on Roger after what transpired between them in the past.

As a result of this chat, Leo decides to descend back into the waterlogged vault again and breaks in. Using the key, he opens the vault and places the counterfeit jewel there, hanging for the feds to find.
