At the same time, Kira informed Ty that she was reverting Lazarus to its original purpose. She let him go, and he pleaded with her to deliver his companions back when she rectified Lazarus.

She refused, not wanting to bring them within the premises, as it would be a danger to the project. Ty reminded her that they were only present due to the project's errors. She cautioned him to stay away.

Meanwhile, Sam was in the woods looking for herbs to assist Silas when he saw Levi unearthing explosives. Levi cautions Sam to go away but Sam declined.

Eve, Gavin, and James arrive at a hidden doorway and are greeted by James' friend, Elliott, a guard. A warning siren is ringing and Elliott states that nobody should go in at the moment.

Elliott reminds them that they must act now, as the security cameras he deactivated will be turning back on very soon.

Elliott stayed outside. Suddenly, Levi assaulted Elliott and rendered him unconscious, and made use of his key card to get in. James accessed a computer to regain control, but he needed Gavin's fingerprint to get it running, as the others stood guard.

Izzy was walking through the woods, looking for Levi, while Josh was following her, insisting that he is dangerous. Their discussion is ended when Sam starts moaning in agony.

He states that Levi physically assaulted him and is now making his way to the Tower carrying explosives. Izzy rushes away, as Josh looks after Sam.

Kira comprehends it is James' work and directs the guard to apprehend him, Kira and her team are almost done with the machine using Dr. Moore's research.

Without giving the guard a chance to move, Levi assaults him and orders the scientists to depart from the premises. Although Kira tries to take the notebook, Levi insists that she put it back and remain in the spot, since he needs her aid.

Once Scott discovered the EpiPen at the camp, Riley proposed an idea to eradicate the wasps and reach Ella — they would add soap to the water tower.

They had the necessary liquid soap and used a hose to pour it into the wasps' nests, and Veronica decided to be the one to save Ella.

Veronica proceeded cautiously towards Ella, fearful that some wasps may still be there. By stepping on something, Veronica unwittingly caused a disturbance and the wasps rose up.

Veronica seized Ella and managed to get them both inside before the wasps could sting them again. It was soon revealed that Ella was badly injured and that Veronica had dropped the EpiPen when she fell.

Scott and Riley located the EpiPen. Scott walked out and ignited a stream of liquid, spraying it on the wasps. Riley hurried to get the EpiPen, with Scott in tow to protect.

She fails to act quickly enough, though, and he finds something from behind him which he uses to briefly render her unconscious.

Levi scattered explosives all over the entrance and wanted all the power directed to the portal. Kira realized that the action would demolish the complete building. Kira refused, but Levi held her at gunpoint and coerced her to do it.

Gavin and Ty made their appearance at the same time Levi was about to detonate the explosives. Kira gets away, as Levi declared he would shoot Gavin if he tried to hinder him.

Just then, Izzy came in and informed Levi that she needed his assistance. She was heading towards the cafeteria and would stay there until Levi was prepared to converse with her.

That was enough to make Levi put a halt to the timer, but the timer has a built-in mechanism which meant it continued ticking, as the episode ended.

Lucas, who somehow got voted in as leader by the group, declares that secu-

rity is their top priority. They have no idea what other creatures fell through the auroras (besides the aforementioned T-Rex), so they need to get busy building a spiked wall and a line of fire.

Judah still resents Lucas' popularity and doesn't want to waste time with a wall. Lucas decides this impromptu security meeting is the perfect place to reveal that he and Veronica are having a baby. Hugs and handshakes all around.

Gavin turns to Scott for help on the laptop, and wouldn't you know it... Scott's got the perfect solution for charging the battery: a potato. That, plus some wiring and good luck, should do the trick.

Scott fills Gavin in on what else he's working on. He was supposed to have a job interview with Petra's mom, Maya Schmidt, before tumbling into 10,000 BC. So, how did Maya, Petra, and the rest of that group end up on a military base in 10,000 BC? To make things even more confusing, Petra doesn't know where the base is, where her mom is, or why her mom reached out to Scott in the first place.

Their chat's disrupted by a roar and all the clearing people running toward them and away from the roar. Veronica pauses long enough to say the dinosaurs are in the clearing, which, of course, leads to Gavin heading toward the clearing.

Gavin runs up as two massive dinos are fighting and hides beside Izzy and Ty. The clearing is being destroyed as the creatures fight, and the trio makes a break for it while the beasties are distracted by trying to kill each other.

The bad news: A few of the clearing people were wounded escaping from the dinosaur invasion, but no one died. The even worse news: the clearing has been taken over by dinosaurs and is unusable. Their only supplies and food are what people grabbed before fleeing.

Gavin claims he needs to go back to the clearing to get the laptop, which is weird since he had the laptop with him — away from the clearing — while speaking with Scott just minutes ago. In fact, the scene showed him running to the clearing to check on Izzy without his laptop.

Anyway, Sam says whatever they need can wait at least a few days. It's not safe to return to the clearing now. Levi joins them with news that Ty says everyone's welcome to regroup at the fort. When Levi offers to find Josh and Riley, who are off on their own gathering berries, Gavin gets all jealous and claims he can find his own son, thank you very much.

Sam, who should have been the group's leader, puts Levi in charge of marching everyone to the fort while he and Gavin look for their kids. They also recruit Izzy, Lucas, and Veronica for the mission. Sam notices Lucas has blood on his face, and Lucas remembers he fell during the dinosaur attack.

Riley and Josh are declaring their love for each other and making out when a Velociraptor suddenly appears behind Josh.

Josh screams for help and comes running up with Riley in his arms. She's been attacked and is unconscious and covered with blood.

They make it to the fort, and after Sam sews up his daughter, all that's left to do is hope and pray that she survives. Sam remains by her side as Gavin assures Izzy and Josh that she's stable — for now.

Levi hands Gavin the laptop and says he went back for it just so that Gavin has one less thing to worry about.

Meanwhile, Scott and Petra string together potatoes to power the laptop. Petra confesses that she's worried the computer will signal the base and reveals that she and her mom escaped from there — they didn't just leave. Her mom told Petra they were bad people but wouldn't explain why.

Scott makes a promise he can't keep and says nothing bad will happen. They hook up the potatoes to the laptop, and it springs to life. The key players arrive before it powers up, and when it does, the screen reads, "Quantum Pairing Initiated." The connection works and some unknown person from who knows where types, "Hello?"

Gavin responds with, "Hello." When it asks who he is, Gavin types his name. The unknown person says they can help Gavin find his wife. The person claims they can see her now and provides an accurate description.

"How do I get my wife back?" types Gavin, frantic.

"Find Sierra," reads the reply. The connection terminates, and even Scott pounding on the keys can't get it to reconnect.

Riley wakes up and wants to say a few things in case she dies. She knows she's in horrible shape and has an infection. She believes she won't last long but falls back unconscious before she tells her dad what she wants to say.

Gavin's wandered off on his own, and Ty joins him, wondering if he recognizes the name Sierra. Gavin has a weird feeling the name is connected to a memory of a breakfast he had with his family. Ty gently suggests Gavin should talk to Levi about that memory since he was in it too and might remember something.

Scott rushes up with the news that he traced the signal, and its origin is within a few miles of the fort!

So, Scott, Levi, Gavin, Petra, and Ty head off to track the signal, with Scott leading the way. They don't spot a radio tower or anything metal, and Ty suggests they split up.

At the same time all this is going down, Lucas passes out while trying to reassure Veronica everything will be just fine.

Everything comes true, and Sam is understandably freaked out. He meets with Ty and demands answers, and Ty reveals a sinkhole near the La Brea Tar Pits will swallow part of LA. But that's not the fun part. No, that sinkhole will take people to 10,000 BC.

"That's insane," responds Sam, speaking the truth.

Ty spills more tea, revealing he knows Sam's getting a divorce and hasn't told anyone. Plus, he knows Sam is on medication for PTSD and that Riley quit the pre-med program but hasn't said anything yet. Ty begs for help finding out more details on a secret Army project and Maya Schmidt — help that only Sam can give him.

Sam walks away, but not before telling Ty to back off.

Back in 10,000 BC, Sam's top priority is figuring out how to get Riley (who was injured in a raptor attack) back after Josh deliberately — and against orders — stepped through the aurora. Sam's unimpressed with Gavin's begging for help in finding Maya and refuses to take part in Gavin's mostly ill-conceived plans any longer.

Everyone's been forced to take up temporary residence at the fort since the dinosaurs held a cage match at the clearing. Judah whines about being forced to work in the gardens, even after

Lucas reminds him they're lucky to have a place to bed down at this point. Veronica promises to kick Judah's butt if he doesn't stop complaining.

The banter comes to a sudden stop when an alarm signals trouble. Sam's discovered one of the fort's warriors dead, and one of the fort people's leaders, Ruth, is not so much upset about the guy's death but that a Sky Person is examining the body. Sam points to a nearby tall tree and suggests that, based on his injuries, the dead man fell.

Ruth believes he was pushed and orders her people to try and find his weapons. If the Sky People want to prove they're actually useful, they can assist in the search.

Of course, it's Scott and Veronica who locate the warrior's bow and arrows while gossiping about Ruth murdering her own husband. Scott climbs a rock to get a better look at the area and spots a symbol made of sand nearby.

Back at the fort, Scott reports that the symbol stands for eternal return or maybe a winding journey. He guesses what it means, and neither Sam nor Gavin takes him seriously. Sam's patience is wearing thin, and he heads to the fort gate to start his search for Riley. However, Ruth's given an order that no one can leave, so Sam gets into a fistfight with a guard. Gavin tries to intervene, and a brawl breaks out until Ruth orders everyone to knock it off.

Gavin and Sam are hauled away to the fort's prison.

While Ruth's giving Lucas a lesson in community-building, another warrior bites the dust, literally falling from the sky and dying just a few yards away from their feet. This time, however, the culprit is obvious. A pterodactyl dropped the woman and brought its buddies with it to snatch up more easy meals.

Ruth orders the archers to the wall, and Lucas tells everyone else to get inside.

The pterodactyls target Scott and Izzy, who are comforting a young girl inside a hut. They're saved by Ruth's daughter, Leyla, a skilled archer who scared it off but didn't kill it.

Lucas picks the wrong time to fight the wrong battle and gets all the clearing people confined to the longhouse by Ruth. If they don't like it, Ruth suggests they just pack up and leave.

Judah retrieves Scott and shows him another spiral that has appeared inside the fort. Scott decides it means the pterodactyls make them when they are getting ready to nest. He also comes up with an answer to get rid of what used to be his favorite dinosaurs.

Lucas convinces Ruth to let Gavin and Sam out of jail, and the group gets to work building a new nest and moving the egg without getting killed. Because this is La Brea, part of the solution is to send up rockets from a just-discovered Huey helicopter. And because this is La Brea, the pterodactyls are convinced to move into new digs away from the fort.

Later that night, everyone at the fort lets down their guard and parties. The fort people remain suspicious of the Sky People, but Ruth believes it will just take some time before they're all kumbayaing around the campfire.

Ruth presents Lucas with a small rocket that was her grandfather's. Apparently, he fell into 10,000 BC back in the '60s and was one of the first "outsiders" to join the fort people.

Gavin informs Sam, who still hasn't made it out of the fort's gate, that he wrote down the helicopter's tail number. It's from Ladera Air Force Base in LA, and somehow Gavin believes this is all a clue as to how to bring Riley back. Also, Sam still needs to go with him to find the base and Maya Schmidt since she may have all the answers.

Sam is all in.

Season three episode two ends in 2021 with Sam returning to meet with Ty after verifying with Riley that she dropped out of the pre-med program. And over the course of just a few hours, Sam has learned that Maya Schmidt is part of a top-secret program on quantum physics run out of Ladera Air Force Base.

Sam thinks they need to find someone who knows more about that program, and Ty knows just the person.

Gavin's walked out of the LAPD by a cop and led straight to Sam and Ty waiting outside. They bailed him out and Ty promises to tell him why over coffee.

The episode opens in 2021 with Sam and Ty having just laid out their strange and twisty tale of sinkholes, dinosaurs, and 10,000 BC. Gavin isn't really shocked about Ty's bizarre time-traveling story, but he is surprised they think he can contribute to helping stop what's going to go down in just a few weeks.

Ty believes that Gavin's prior work with quantum physics at Ladera Air Base is connected to the sinkholes. Unfortunately, Gavin can't get them into the base and knows zilch about a secret project because of huge gaps in his memory. Ty pleads with him to help anyway. Lives are

at stake!

Gavin doesn't want to play along and takes off from the restaurant without saying goodbye.

10,000 BC Gavin is much more helpful. He draws a map to the base and points out a peak that pilots use to navigate. Gavin's certain they'll find Maya there and get answers about all their missing friends/family members.

Scott's anxious to rescue Levi and Petra, but Gavin and Sam shut him down. This is simply a recon mission at this point, which means only Sam and Gavin are going.

They head out and Gavin's certain he's forgetting a key detail about the base. His gut instincts tell him to turn around and Sam agrees they should pause until they figure out what's got him on edge. Of course, as soon as they stop walking a woolly rhinoceros appears behind them. They're making a run for the trees when the rhino blows up behind them. Literally blows up — with pieces flying through the air and everything.

They hit the ground, and Sam notices a mine just inches from his face. Maybe what Gavin forgot is that the base is surrounded by a minefield. As they're contemplating their next move, a helicopter buzzing overhead forces their hand.

They follow piles of rocks that couldn't be more obvious if they had "Step Here to Live" signs on them out of the minefield to safety. But their celebration is short-lived as a soldier holds them at gunpoint. He ties them to a tree to be picked up, and suddenly out of nowhere, Maya Schmidt appears, knocks out the soldier, and rescues them.

They take cover at the beach, and Maya's shocked to learn they've met her daughter Petra. Gavin doesn't remember anything about his time with Maya, and Maya spills the beans, confirming the government was conducting time-travel experiments at Ladera. Gavin was a test pilot for the program, which was to be weaponized to send soldiers back in time to get the jump on their enemies.

Maya confesses she's the one who took away Gavin's memory using a biological cocktail. She also reveals that before she could become a whistleblower, she was caught and brought to 10,000 BC with Petra.

Oh, and Maya now believes she might be able to recover Gavin's memories.

She collects poisonous mushrooms that should open his mind without, hopefully, killing him. Since she's a psyops officer whose job is to manipulate behavior, she knows a little bit about making people trip out.

Maya whips up the concoction in 10 seconds (or less) and Gavin swallows it, willing to do anything to get Eve back.

Meanwhile, Izzy and Leyla walk, talk, and flirt. A wild boar attacks, and Leyla falls right into a tar pit. Izzy refuses to leave her to get help and instead has her grab a branch, even though Leyla doesn't think Izzy's strong enough to pull her out.

Leyla is quickly proven correct.

Still, Izzy won't leave and instead sits down to make a fire. Why? To give them more time to talk and flirt, I guess, because otherwise there's no logical reason. The pit starts bubbling, and Leyla sinks to her armpits.

Izzy declares, "We don't have time for fire!" Really? You think?

She breaks the world record for making a thick rope out of tree bark. What?! When?! How?! We're just shown the very tail end of her working on it, but the camera does pan down to let us see stripped branches on the ground.

An angry boar grunts from the forest as Izzy tosses the rope, which is long enough to be tied around a nearby tree, to Leyla. With Leyla busy pulling herself out of the pit, it's up to Izzy to shoot the boar with her bow and arrows. Izzy hits it, but it doesn't go down.

Leyla emerges from the pit just in time to launch the fatal shot.

Back at the fort, Lucas whines about wanting a seat on the council, and Veronica takes it upon herself to promote Lucas' good traits to Ruth. However, Veronica's promotional campaign backfires and Ruth offers Veronica the seat.

When Veronica delivers the news to Lucas, he does a horrible job of hiding his disappointment.

Back to Gavin and the poisonous mushroom we go, and Gavin's high as a kite. Maya guides him through his memories, and suddenly, he starts convulsing and loses consciousness.

Maya and Sam bring him back to the fort to recover. Izzy visits him and then takes a seat by Leyla for a fireside chat. They hold hands and are about to kiss when fort people walk by.

Gavin comes to after a few hours and says he saw a safe that he opened. Inside was a microchip, and he thinks he was stealing it. Nothing about Eve or anyone else... just the chip. Sam puts two and two together and, surprisingly, comes up with four. In other words, he figures out the message they received on the laptop was a ruse. Whoever sent it just wanted inside Gavin's head to find the microchip.

Once more to 2021 we go and, given that Gavin's an alcoholic, Ty and Sam split up to check nearby bars. However, Ty makes a pit stop to see his ex-wife Sophie and apologize for how he pushed her away. She feels like a failure, and Ty insists she's a good writer and that her book is good. Everything is good... but she needs to not do what she's about to do tonight.

Ty and Sam eventually find Gavin drowning his sorrows in a bar, and Ty tries to make a connection by explaining his ex-wife also turned to alcohol and pills when things got bad. Tonight, she'll be disappointed at an AA meeting, drink and drive, and get into an accident with a young family. The dad was still in a coma when Ty fell into the sinkhole.

Ty blames himself for ruining his wife's life.

Ty calls Gavin a coward who'll never get back to his own family if he doesn't face his fears.

Later that evening, Gavin shows up at Sophie's AA meeting and delivers a speech that changes Sophie's future. Ty and Sam are also in attendance to witness Gavin's emotional speech. Sophie has tears in her eyes when Gavin says, "Everyone in this room needs someone who gives a damn because none of us can do it on their own."

When the meeting wraps up, Ty asks if they can talk and Sophie agrees. Ty apologizes again and assures her he's the man he is because of her. She deserves love and happiness, and Ty makes her promise she'll keep writing. Sophie's grateful for the kind words. They hug before she drives away.

Gavin's ready to step up and help out. He'll figure out a way to get them onto the base. They don't seem to notice that as they drive out of the parking lot, they're being followed by a woman with a gun.

The episode kicks off in LA in 2021. Ty and Sam are growing antsy waiting outside a diner for Gavin's contact to show up. Inside, Gavin is approached by a woman he doesn't recognize but who seems to know him.

It turns out the woman has canceled Gavin's real meeting and needs him to go with her if he wants to continue breathing. She almost runs over Ty and Sam, driving out of the parking lot like a bat out of hell.

And now we're dropped back into 10,000 BC, and Gavin hasn't totally recovered from being drugged by Maya. As

Sam examines him, the laptop springs to life, asking if he's found Sierra. Gavin replies that he's found Maya Schmidt. A photo of Eve pops up, confirming this mysterious messenger has Gavin's wife.

Whoever is typing orders Gavin to find the microchip. Eve's life depends on it.

Maya explains that the microchip Gavin stole is the key to time travel. The chip contains the code that will allow the government to program a fleet of planes to travel through time. But now it's gone, and Gavin is the only one who knows its location.

Sam comes up with an insane idea which you just know is the solution. The only real question is why it wasn't Gavin's idea. After all, he's the one who always comes up with crazy plans. Anyway, it's to use the tar pits to send a message to 2021 Scott.

Izzy arrives with news that a massive fire is approaching the fort. The fort evacuates and heads to the highest peak, while Izzy, Gavin, Maya, and Scott head to the tar pits with the message.

They're in the middle of an emergency, but Lucas takes the time to apologize to Veronica for not supporting her promotion to the council.

Maya reveals she was told to recruit Scott to the project back in 2021.

As the group heads to the peak, Lucas spots a wolf puppy. Sam doesn't want him to, but Lucas brings the adorable pup along anyway. Veronica approves.

Stick with me here as this episode jumps around between the two time periods a lot. In 2021, Gavin's phone — which was left behind when he went with the unknown blonde woman — rings, and it's Scott. Ty recognizes his name immediately when it pops up on the screen.

Ty and Sam visit Scott, and Scott has a difficult time wrapping his head around Ty's 10,000 BC story. Scott called Gavin's phone because he received the tar pit message, and obviously, neither Ty nor Sam is Gavin. So, Scott isn't on board with their story quite yet.

Scott, quite rightly, points out that in movies, the bad guys always claim to be friends with the person who's trying to be contacted. Plus, Ty does have a British accent. Point, proven.

Ty decides the best way to Scott's heart is through his stomach.

The group's taken a rest in 10,000 BC as the smoke makes it difficult to breathe. Sam wanders off, and Lucas finds him noticeably upset. Something's up, and Sam finally confesses that when Riley was 10, a fire destroyed their house. He got his wife and kids out, but this fire's bringing up painful memories.

Ruth's scouts say the fire is now headed right at the fort. However, there's a dam near the fort and if they break it, it will wet the area near the fort and save it from the flames. Veronica, who is pregnant, volunteers, as do Sam, Lucas, and the wolf puppy.

Gavin experiences another flash of memories involving the chip, and in the vision, he sees an arm with a scar made of three parallel-ish lines. And a paper titled "Universal Flora" written by Scott.

In 2021, Gavin's handcuffed inside a car and his kidnapper introduces herself as Helena. She tells him he willingly signed up to do horrible things to stop something worse from happening. She also talks about fighter jets becoming time machines. Helena was a civilian consultant, and she's the one who got Gavin on the list as a test pilot. Okay, the story's finally getting a bit interesting...

Helena and Gavin were trying to dismantle the program from the inside — just the two of them. "We're the good guys, Gavin," says Helena, adding that she has proof that will convince him.

Helena uses her thumbprint and asks Gavin for his, too, to open a safe deposit box he knows nothing about. Inside is the microchip he stole.

Once more to 10,000 BC we go, and Scott confirms he wrote "Universal Flora." That's enough to confirm Gavin's memory is real. But Gavin doesn't know who had the three scars on their arm, and that doesn't ring a bell with Scott.

Gavin's choking on the smoke now, so Scott hustles off to fetch Maya down by the river.

Sam's group arrives at the dam, but the pulley to open the gate is damaged. Veronica suggests they need to use gunpowder to make an explosive to loosen the support beams. It's a great idea, but Sam and Lucas leave it to Veronica and Ruth's people because the wolf puppy has chosen just this instant to run off toward the fire.

In LA, Ty's prepared a lunch that 10,000 BC Scott told him his mom used to make when he needed comforting. Ty also points out Scott has a vase of flowers that, when they saw them in 10,000 BC, caused Scott to become depressed.

Ty knows it's about a girl, and Scott confirms he lost the best thing in his life and has given up on everyone. Sam delivers one of his patented pep talks and Scott can't help but give in. He shows them the message he got from the tar pits. It instructs him to call Gavin Harris (with a phone number) and tell him he hid a microchip. Finding it is the only way to save his wife. The note also says Gavin must find a way to get that chip to 10,000 BC.

The note's signed by Gavin.

Speaking of Gavin, he and Helena arrive by a lake, and she reveals that she's his half-sister. All of this is linked to their family's legacy. Their father didn't care about either of them; he only cared about time travel.

Helena walks Gavin to an aurora and explains the red half goes to 1965, the year the program originated. The blue side goes to 10,000 BC. Ty and Sam race up just as Gavin's about to go through the aurora. Ty asks about the chip, Gavin confirms he has it, and Ty says the microchip must go to 10,000 BC because Eve's life depends on it.

Helena's sorry about that, but they have to go to '65 to stop the project.

The aurora becomes erratic, and Helena pulls a gun on Ty and Sam. Ty insists he's family, too, and begs for the chip. He'll take it back to 10,000 BC since he's the only one of this foursome who's been there.

Suddenly, Sam attacks Helena and gets the gun. Gavin gives the chip to Ty, and Ty steps through the aurora.

Back in the past, Sam and Lucas search for the wolf puppy and find him in a small shelter surrounded by flames. Sam has one more confession to make. He forgot to save Riley's dog and he died in the fire.

Unfortunately, there's no time to run, and instead, they must hunker down and wait for the fire to move on or go out.

Veronica hits the makeshift explosive on her third shot, and it works as planned. The dam breaks and the water floods the area around the fort, putting out the flames.

And now we're back in 10,000 BC for the final minutes of episode four. Scott realizes Maya is the person with the scar and that she's been lying. She knows why the program was interested in him because she had his paper.

Maya reacts by doing something we don't see to Scott. She then catches up with Gavin and Izzy and claims the soldiers took Scott.

Veronica finds Lucas and Sam hiding out from the fire with the wolf puppy. They're covered with a shirt, and initially, she thinks they're dead. They aren't. Veronica's happy to report the fort was saved.

That night, the celebration of survival is underway when Ty walks up to Sam. They hug and Ty reveals the aurora sent him to 2021. Gavin joins them and can't believe Ty was able to get the microchip. Ty says all three of them actually did it. Plus, he learned the other side of the aurora goes to 1965. That's where Josh and Riley are right now.

The episode begins with Gavin pondering what to do with the microchip while visiting what will be, in 10,000 years, Eve's favorite spot. Ty reminds him they need to trade it for Eve, but they admit to being worried about whoever is sending them the messages on the laptop.

Ty's also worried that something happened to Paara since she's overdue on returning from her trip. Both men pledge not to stop trying until they get their families back.

Izzy confesses to Veronica that she's

worried about her relationship with Leyla after turning down an offer to go stargazing. Fortunately, that conversation is cut short when her dad has her join him and Ty to look at a new message that just popped up. Gavin's instructed to bring the chip to Cahuenga Peak in exchange for Eve. The connection ends before he can get assurance Eve's alive.

Maya pops in and thinks it's good news. Gavin calls a time-out and wants a very specific 10-minute window to think about it.

Sam finds Lucas out in the woods and warns him not to storm the base alone to retrieve Scott. It turns out Lucas was actually just visiting his mom's grave. Way to jump to conclusions, Sam! Before Sam leaves him to commune with his mom, Lucas wonders if he thinks it's all a little too coincidental that Scott, Petra, and Levi just happened to have been found by these people and taken.

Lucas suggests there's a mole feeding the soldiers information. Sam doesn't think that's a crazy theory and says he'll help him figure things out when he gets back to the fort.

Gavin's 10-minute break is interrupted by the unexpected appearance of Maya. She wants to help him make the trade, but Gavin announces he's going to destroy the microchip. It's too powerful and too dangerous.

Maya pulls a gun on him as he walks off. She reveals the chip is hers and she's taking it back. Sam and Ty walk up at just that moment — Sam with his gun out and Ty surprising Maya

from the opposite side and disarming her. They demand she hand over her backpack and Gavin confirms he knew it was her when she showed up seconds after the chat ended. He orders her to say where Eve's being held.

Maya refuses and reveals she has the upper hand. Her watch is a tracking device... and just as they realize what that means, a voice screams, "Nobody move!" Sam, Ty, and Gavin are surrounded by soldiers and Maya simply takes the microchip from Gavin's pocket.

Shots ring out and the soldiers begin falling. However, Maya and two soldiers get away and drive off in a Jeep. Gavin's savior? His sister Helena. Wait, how does he recognize her? He didn't know her in 2016 before he fell through the sinkhole. Ty's met her but 10,000 BC Gavin wouldn't recognize her face and it's unlikely he gave Gavin a full description of her.

Helena followed Ty through the aurora, and she's super pissed they let Maya have the chip. It turns out Maya leads a private security company and was contracted by the military to build time-traveling fighter planes. No one knows her real plan — except, apparently, Helena — is to sell the planes to the highest bidder. They need to stop her now!

Also, Helena is really angry with Gavin because he always disappoints her.

Back at the fort, a rock falls off a tray Veronica's carrying in the council hut, and the sound it makes when it hits the floor draws her attention. She discovers a trap door and pulls out the case it's covering. Inside is a radio for contacting the Ladera Air Base. She immediately tells Lucas what she found, and they both realize Maya isn't their only problem. Only members of the council use the hut.

Veronica will try and figure out the spy during the council meeting, which is just getting underway.

The council takes a vote on whether to let the refugees continue to stay at the fort. Veronica understands their concern and shows them the case containing the Ladera Air Base radio. Ruth suggests they take a break and return to the table with clear heads.

Veronica goes looking for Ruth and Lucas reveals she left the fort for an "emergency diplomatic meeting" with another tribe. Veronica and Lucas decide to track her down since if it walks like a duck, it is a duck.

Leyla and Izzy go on a walk and wind up finding the dead soldiers. Leyla says she's an excellent tracker and assures Izzy she'll help her find her dad who she just assumes was walking this direction.

Meanwhile, Scott and Levi are locked up in cells at the Ladera Air Base. Levi reveals they keep asking him about Gavin and a microchip. And Scott fills Levi in on Maya being a dirty, rotten traitor. Levi suggests that Scott give them what they want — more details on a plant he wrote about in a research paper — but Scott has nothing left to say about it.

Maya and the soldiers arrive at the base and she hands off the microchip to have it taken to the lab. She then meets with Scott's interrogator — Levi. Yes, you read that correctly. Levi is working with Maya and the soldiers.

When Levi enters Scott's cell, Scott immediately assumes he's a spy since he's in their uniform and has one of their tattoos on his arm. But Levi insists that he found out about Maya and the bases all throughout time, and that he joined up so he could get back to 10,000 BC and find James. Maya still believes he's on their side, but Levi tries to convince Scott he's pulling the whole secret double agent switcheroo thing and is still the old Levi and not a bad guy.

Levi reveals the fossilized plants Scott studied are the key to making Maya's time travel work. Scott insists he didn't show the paper to anyone else. Levi slips into bad guy mode when Maya joins them and says he's certain Scott told someone about the paper, even if he keeps claiming he didn't.

Maya wants to be queen of all time travel, so she needs to be the only person with the knowledge Scott possesses. Rather than get punched in the face by Levi, he now claims he told some people. Scott won't say the names and Maya orders Levi to punch him in the stomach.

Since Scott won't talk, Levi suggests they move him to a long-term detention facility. Maya says she'll arrange it. When she walks away, Levi tells Scott that he acted perfectly.

Elsewhere, Gavin, Helena, Ty, and Sam float down a river on a raft since it's quicker than walking to the base. Helena uses the time to fill Gavin in on their shared history, explaining they made a pact to leave the country and head to Mexico. However, he backed out of their plans and let her take the heat for stealing the microchip.

Gavin had his family; Helena had no one.

And now the Scooby Squad has a new problem — a prehistoric alligator twice the size of their raft. It knocks Helena into the water and then pulls her under, so Gavin puts a knife between his teeth and jumps in to save her. They both swim back to the boat with the alligator on their tails. Sam lets loose with a hail of bullets from one of the dead soldier's rifles and the alligator screams in pain. It finally stops its charge and sinks.

They make it back to safe ground and keep walking to the base. Gavin promises when it's over, he'll finally introduce Helena to his family. They spot tire marks but don't spot a surveillance camera in a nearby tree.

Back near the fort, Lucas and Veronica catch up with Ruth, and she insists she has her reasons for working with the base. Veronica realizes she's covering for someone.

Leyla stops following footsteps and heads to her initial destination. Once she gets there, she's upset the aurora to Izzy's time isn't there like she was promised. Izzy's totally confused and insists running away isn't the answer.

Ruth, Veronica, and Lucas show up just as Izzy asks Leyla who told her about the aurora's location. Ruth says Maya did and that she's lied about everything. Oh, so it's Leyla who's been using the radio and spilling the beans to Maya — not her mom, Ruth.

Lucas wants to use the radio to spy on the base, and Leyla confirms she knows the code to turn it on. Once it's on, they learn a team has been sent to take out Ty, Sam, Helena, and Gavin.

Levi and two other soldiers escort Scott to the other detention center. Levi's seen Eve there and wants to make everything right. Izzy runs into a clearing nearby, sees Levi, and one of the soldiers reacts by pulling his gun and getting ready to shoot her. Levi jumps him while Scott fights the other soldier. Scott's about to get stabbed in the face when Lucas clobbers the soldier with a branch to the head.

Izzy asks about her dad, but Levi was unaware that Gavin is nearby. He makes Izzy stay behind and heads off to save Gavin. Levi spots the soldiers ready to ambush Gavin's foursome and manages to shoot a few. Sam and Helena join the firefight and all but one soldier is killed.

Unfortunately, the one still alive shoots Levi in the chest just as Izzy shoots the soldier with her bow and arrow. Sam and the group rush to help Levi, and Sam announces it's a gut shot. The wound won't stop bleeding, and Levi's on the verge of death when Gavin asks for a minute alone with him. Levi and Izzy exchange goodbyes as Levi says Eve's in the long-term detention center. Levi knows he's dying and says he made peace with everything but Gavin. Gavin calls him his brother and Levi says, "Brothers till the end," and then passes away.

They all take a minute to acknowledge Levi's death, and then Sam suggests they need to get to Eve quickly before reinforcements arrive.

As they get closer to the detention facility, a double aurora appears in front of them. They realize the directions on the map says "red" where the detention center should be. They figure out the detention center is in 1965 and so are Josh and Riley. Helena says it makes sense since Maya has an operation in 1965 with a detention area.

Helena tells her brother to destroy Maya's infrastructure in '65 and then volunteers to come with him.

The episode ends with Izzy, Sam, Helena, and Gavin stepping through the aurora. Only Scott remains behind.

Summary: Gavin leads the survivors in trying to find Eve, Josh and Riley. Will he be able to finally reunite his family and still find a way back to the lives they once knew?



The episode begins with a flashback of Gavin learning Eve was pregnant with their first child. The action then switches to 1965, with Gavin, Izzy, Sam, and Helena hoping that they're getting closer to finding Eve.

Helena believes they should head to Reisander's base in Pasadena. There's a detention center there and that might be where they're keeping Eve. Helena thinks they can kill two birds with one stone — rescue Eve and destroy their research on the microchip. She's going to use an electromagnetic pulse explosive to wipe out their research.

Sam believes he found Riley at Cedar's Hospital, so they decide to divide up, with Sam going off on his own to check on his daughter.

Meanwhile, back in 10,000 BC, Ty suggests that Lucas, Veronica, and Scott should step through the blue aurora to 2021 right now. Veronica doesn't want to leave without everyone, and Ruth volunteers to retrieve the clearing people from the fort.

Scott also wants to find Petra before they leave, so they wind up searching the soldiers' Jeep. Ty discovers his wife's wedding ring and some of her belongings and demands to know where it came from. One of the soldiers reveals it was with a group of villagers who were killed in a dinosaur attack. He describes the location as five miles away.

Gavin, Izzy, and Helena break into the Pasadena research facility, but Eve's not in the detention center. Helena finds a manifest that says Eve was transferred to the Ladera base in 10,000 BC. They just left, so the group splits up again, with Gavin and Izzy chasing after the transport and Helena remaining behind to destroy the servers.

Sam was right about Riley's whereabouts and finally reunites with his injured daughter. He apologizes for taking so long to find her and confirms he hasn't found Josh yet. Riley still has a fever because antibiotics weren't commonly used in the '60s. Riley demands to know his diagnosis, and Sam believes she has a torn diaphragm from the raptor attack.

Sam thinks the only way to save her is to go through the blue aurora to 2021.

Before he can move her, Riley says, "Dad, I'm having trouble breathing!" Sam springs into action and performs an exploratory laparotomy, which isn't common practice yet. He's locked the door and swears he's the only one who can help her. He also swears he'll be a different father and husband if this works.

Back in 10,000 BC, Ty's group takes the Jeep to the location five miles away and splits up to search for the dead villagers. Ty claims he'll be lost without Paara, and Scott can relate. They discuss Scott's breakup with Emily and how he let her drift away by not being brave.

They spot the dead villagers, and Lucas assures Ty that Paara isn't among them. Smoke's seen from the abandoned village nearby, and Scott and Ty rush off to find its source.

Lucas pours his heart out to Veronica while waiting for Ty and Scott to return. He confirms he wants to go home to 2021 and knows she's made him a better man. As they're talking, Veronica experiences cramps. She admits she should have gone through the aurora, and Lucas comforts her, assuring her their baby is going to be fine. He also promises to get her through the aurora ASAP.

Ty hears Paara scream and finds her trapped under a fallen shelter. Ty and Scott try to lift it off as Paara explains they were attacked by a pack of dinosaurs. She knew he'd come, and Ty reveals he was pulled back to 2021 but this is his home — here, with her forever.

Scott and Ty use leverage to free Paara, and thankfully, she's not gravely injured. Unfortunately, the noise drew a T-Rex and Scott tells them all to stand still since they have horrible vision — per Jurassic Park. However, they discover Steven Spielberg was wrong and have to run from the approaching dinosaur. Lucas and Veronica race up in the Jeep and the group barely escapes being the T-Rex's lunch.

In 2021, Gavin and Izzy crash into the transport vehicle to stop it, and it's Josh in the back of the vehicle — not Eve. They're happy to be reunited, and Josh explains that after they took Riley to a hospital, men grabbed him and put him in a cell with his mom. They wanted to know everything about Gavin.

Today, they fought with the guards, but Josh was grabbed and sedated. Josh has no idea what happened to his mom. That means she's still at the research facility with Helena, a name Josh doesn't recognize.

Izzy leaves to check on the aurora just as Sam arrives with Riley in the backseat of his car. Her wound's infected, and they need to get to 2021 right away. Gavin knows Sam needs to do what's best for his daughter and says this is where they part ways. They shake hands and thank each other before Sam sprints back to his car with Josh.

Josh doesn't leave; he just says goodbye to Riley.

Helena drives up with news that she saw Eve, they fought some guards, and she got pinned down. Eve took the EMP and is going to finish destroying the microchip research. Helena just left her there on her own because she swore she'd do the job and then step through the aurora to 2021.

Gavin decides they'll head back to 10,000 BC and get the microchip. That's what Eve wants them to do.

The next scene shows them in 10,000 BC, watching as the clearing people exit the world of prehistoric creatures and return to LA in 2021. Veronica's turn comes, but Lucas isn't going with her. He's decided to stay and help Gavin and the group find and destroy the microchip. He'll catch up with her when they're finished, swearing on everything he loves that he'll make it.

So, with 20 or so minutes left in the series let's recap. The mostly nameless clearing folk have gone back to 2021, Sam and Riley are also back in 2021, and Eve is the only person remaining in 1965. Gavin, Izzy, Josh, Helena, Ty, Lucas, and Scott are with Paara, Ruth, and the fort people in 10,000 BC.

Gavin believes they can use the T-Rex to help them get into the base. They lead the T-Rex to the base's gates by racing ahead of it in the Jeep. The soldiers follow Maya's order and open fire on the dinosaur and the T-Rex uses its little arms to rip down the gate.

The bullets have no effect, and the T-Rex takes out a few soldiers as Gavin's group runs onto the base to retrieve the microchip. Scott hears Petra yelling while being manhandled by a soldier, and he and Lucas chase after her.

Seconds later, Gavin finds the microchip just as Scott and Lucas return after helping Petra escape. Now, if only they can escape the base and get to the aurora before it closes. Unfortunately, Maya and her soldiers have other plans.

Gavin's group is surrounded by dozens of well-armed soldiers. Maya demands that Gavin turn over the chip and is taken by surprise when the fort people and Ty launch an attack. Soldiers fall as Gavin's group joins the fight. Izzy's almost stabbed when Leyla saves her.

The group escapes, but a huge flash erupts, and Gavin believes it's the aurora closing. Josh wonders how they'll get back to his mom, and Izzy is certain it can't end like this. Gavin pledges that it won't; he has an idea.

They head over to where one of the planes is stored and Gavin believes he can fly them home. Ty says his goodbyes; he's going to remain in 10,000 BC with his wife, Paara. But, of course, they can't just fly off. After three seasons, we've learned that La Brea doesn't just deliver happy endings without throwing in a last-minute roadblock or two.

Maya wasn't killed by the T-Rex or in the fight that followed, and she holds Josh at gunpoint. She demands the chip and Gavin tosses it to her. Maya watches it in flight and Helena uses the distraction to shoot her in the chest.

Maya's dead, Josh is safe, and now everyone gets on board the plane. He's starting the engine when the T-Rex charges down the runway at the plane. Helena wants to abort. Gavin disagrees and goes for it. The T-Rex opens its mouth, but the plane escapes.

Helena places the chip in the plane's computer, and they head through the aurora to 2021. The aurora closes behind them.

They apparently landed in a field in the middle of nowhere, but at least they're in LA and it's 2021. Helena says a brief goodbye and Gavin wonders what her next move is. He invites her over for a family dinner, and she's more than happy to accept the invitation.

Gavin, Josh, and Izzy think Eve might be home, but Josh wants to stop and see Riley on the way. She's in the hospital but looking much better, and Josh smiles at her like the teenager in love that he is. He confesses that the day of the sinkhole when they saw each other in traffic, he knew right away he was going to love her. Riley confesses it wasn't love at first sight for her.

Veronica and Lucas look at their baby's sonogram, and it has a healthy heartbeat. Scott's with them and reminds them he'll see them on the weekend — and every weekend after that.

"What happens in 10,000 BC, doesn't stay in 10,000 BC," jokes Scott.

Scott puts on his big boy pants and speaks to the love of his life, his ex, Emily. She thought he died in the sinkhole, and he explains that it changed his life. He gave up weed, saved his friends' lives (repeatedly), and is the man she deserves. He hopes she'll give him a second chance.

They kiss... so we'll take that as a yes.

Sam's back with his family, Riley's recovering, and he's all smiles. Sam and Gavin finally reunite and hug it out, declaring each other friends for life. The only hitch is that they haven't found Eve yet.

Gavin realizes there's one special place where she might be waiting for him. They head to the tree on the hillside that they used to visit for special occasions, but she's not there. Gavin is sure she will show up there because they always agreed this is where they'd meet if there were ever an emergency.

Back in 10,000 BC, Ty places the wedding ring back on Paara's finger and says he feels like he has his life back.

Gavin and the kids wait for hours, and Eve still hasn't shown up. He swears she'll be there and they won't leave without her. Just then, Eve runs up the hill, and Josh races down to hug her. Izzy follows, and then Gavin. The family's finally back together in 2021!

He asks where she was and she jokes that she got stuck in traffic on La Brea. She wasn't sure she'd see them again so she wrote them letters in 1965 and buried under the tree. Eve gives them to them now and Gavin says it's time to go home.

They walk down the hill arm-in-arm as the upside-down La Brea logo switches to right-side up.
