

Summary: Martin Odum has the uncanny ability to transform himself into a com-

pletely different person for each job. But he begins to question his own identity when a mysterious stranger suggests that Martin isn't the man

he believes himself to be.



We see a news story about a bombing by the Citizen's Army of Virginia (CAV) planned by their Founding Father that killed 57 people. Then we see Ditman, a guy firing on the CAV range, called to see Streeter. Lincoln Ditman is brought to see Streeter — he stutters nervously as they tell him Russell said he was talking trash about the CAV. Ditman laughs nervously and says he just said he was tired of shooting paper targets with wannabes.

Streeter says the Founding Father is ready to start a fire to burn down the government and Ditman says he's been waiting for a chance to blow some shit up and

says to tell him what to do and he'll do it. Streeter cocks a gun and puts it to his head then asks if he's willing to die for the cause. Ditman tells him he worked construction 15 years then lost his job to a wetback, then his wife left and took their daughter. He says he has nothing to lose.

Streeter says life's a bitch but no one trash talks the CAV. He pulls the trigger and we hear a click. The other men in the room laugh as Streeter tells him he has big balls. Ditman laughs and asks if that means he's in. Streeter says the Founding Father wants to meet him tomorrrow. There's a noise and then helicopters. The camp is being raided by the ATF. Streeter is hustled out a back door. Ditman is left in the office with the others He grabs a gun, shoots the others then stops before shooting Russell.

Rusell asks why he didn't give him a heads up about the ATF and Ditman says it's because he didn't know. He tells Russell to put up his hands. They do, the ATF busts in and Ditman tells him he's FBI and the other guy is with him. He gives them a clearance code to call in to confirm

— he's now speaking in a British accent. He tells them if they blow his six month sting for a weapons bust, he'll have their butts.

He tells them he's there to stop a terrorist attack. One of the dying CAV guys drops a grenade and Martin yanks them out of the room. The ATF guy asks who Ditman really is and he says Martin Odum and tells the guy to call it in. In LA, Martin gets out of his car at his house — he sees a homeless guy wandering by and notes it with suspicion. He walks up and his son Aiden is there — he grabs him up in a hug. Aiden asks if he got the bad guy.

Sonya comes out, his ex, and he heads her a check and she asks their son to go inside. She says she didn't know he was back and says he can't just pop back after being gone for months and expect everything to be the same. She tells him he signed the check with the name Lincoln Ditman. He apologizes and says he'll get her a new one.

Martin argues good naturedly in Mandarin about baseball with a guy in a grocery shop when he sees the same homeless guy again. He chases him out but loses him in the crowd in Chinatown. Martin goes home to his ratty place and locks the door as his phone rings. It's Russell and he says he's calling from a pay phone. He says the CAV is back in business and Martin tells him to get out now. He says the Founding Father wants to meet Ditman tomorrow.

At the FBI Covert Ops location, Gates asks if he thinks it's a trap. Crystal comes in and asks why Martin is there. He says Ditman may still be in play and the FF wants a meet in Chicago with him. Crystal doesn't like it and says the debacle in VA is Martin's fault since he fell off their radar for six months and they didn't even know he was at the camp. She tells Martin the first she knew was when the ATF called.

Crystal says she's still cleaning up. Martin says the last time he kept her in the loop, her people almost blew his cover. Gates asks to talk to Crystal alone. She tells him she can't run Martin and says he has a personality disorder — she says 3 out of 4 shrinks says he was unfit. Gates reminds her the fourth said he was the best deep cover guy ever. He says it's more of a risk not to use him to stop the imminent terror attack.

Crystal tells Martin to quit smirking. She says he makes her look bad. He apologizes and asks if that's the only reason she's mad. She tells him it was just sex and it was a mistake. She says it happens every day and walks off. Maggie and Buchanan watch a video narrated by the Founding Father threatening terrorism. Maggie says Martin got close and Buchanan says he should have been put out to pasture but then stops short when Crystal and Martin walk up.

She introduces Martin to Maggie and she tells him she's an Air Force brat too but never got a cool accent like him. Martin shows them info on Russell, a former member of the Aryan Brotherhood, and he says he's the best asset he's ever recruited. Then he shows them Streeter, the top lieutenant, a former soldier. Buchanan says he can have the backup team two minutes away, but Martin says five.

Martin tells them Ditman's story is in his head. Crystal tells in to share it. He tells them all the details about his job, his marriage break up, the recession, his special needs child, social awkwardness, stutter and persecution complex. Maggie builds a back email record while Bobby works on his credit showing bills falling behind. Martin migrates into Ditman's persona saying he did everything right and deserved better — he even stutters.

He snaps out of it to see them all staring and Maggie says he stuttered and his accent changed. They wonder why he didn't notice. He looks tired. Crystal says to go home while they backfill the legend on Ditman. He heads out and calls Aiden but gets voice mail. He says he can't see him tomorrow but will make it up to him. He asks him to call him and says he loves him. He sees the homeless guy in the train station again and pursues him.

He slams the guy into the wall and asks why he's following him. They struggle and the guy says he's trying to help him. He says he doesn't know where his life begins and legend ends. Martin asks who he is and he says he doesn't know. They fight some more and he asks if he really thinks he's Martin Odum and says there is no Odum, he's a legend and it's all fake. He tells him to tell no one and rushes off.

Martin shows up at Bobby's — the kid is sweating from working out with a video game and he tells Martin his cholesterol sucks and he needs more exercise. Martin tells him he needs an off the book favor. He says he needs an ID from subway security and says it's probably nothing. Bobby downloads the security footage and looks at it. He shows him the stranger and Bobby says he'll run facial recognition on it.

Bobby tells Martin it's a good thing he's letting them watch his back and says he thinks they'll stop him. Crystal tells Martin they'll be an hour behind him on the plane. She hands over ID, photos and other info for Ditman. She says she has all of Ditman's travel plans made. She gives him a mic and he says there is too much counter surveillance but she orders him to wear it anyway.

The plane touches down at O'Hare. Martin changes clothes to get into his Ditman gear. He pops on his glasses, musses his hair and then a man knocks to tell him to hurry. Martin switches to his Ditman accent to answer. He's in a car and sees Streeter approach. He gets out of the car and greets him and says it was crazy in Virginia. They put him in their car and he gives up his keys.

Maggie comes in and says Russell missed his check in by five minutes. Buchanan buzzes Crystal and tells her and she says to check his hotel room. We see that Russell is tied up by the Founding Father and is being tortured. Russell says he's not a traitor and neither is Lincoln. FF says data can be planted and records manipulated. He says people tell the truth. He pulls out a shock kit and they torture him some more.

Maggie tells Crystal that there are signs of a struggle in Russell's hotel room. They want to warn Martin but can't because he's already in the meeting at the strip club. Crystal says she can take care of it. She comes up in lingerie and offers Martin a private dance. She sits on his lap and asks his name. She says he looks like he needs some TLC. Watching on surveillance, Bobby says that means tits, leg and then Buchanan stops him.

Streeter hands him some cash and tells him to enjoy him. She says one song will change his life. They head into a private room and he tells her to be careful and stay in camera because of the camera. She slams him onto a bench and dances around. He smiles as she straddles his lap. He tells her Crystal is a good stripper's name and then she whispers that Russell has been taken. Martin says he won't rat him out but she's not sure. He tells her that he saved his life a few years ago.

She writhes against him and asks if he would bet his life on Russell and he says he already has. Streeter gets a text saying it's time to go. She asks what about the camera and he says it's just a smoke detector. She's annoyed. Streeter interrupts and after they go she tells Buchanan to get the follow team moving — she thinks Martin has been made. He says they're five minutes out and she says to hurry. They hustle Martin out and shove him around. They tell him the FF still has some doubts about him.

They tell him Russell didn't live long enough to reassure them. They push him onto his knees and Crystal runs out saying he owes her \$50. They shove her to her knees too and out a gun to Martin's head. He laughs and says he's not afraid to die because he's already dead. He says he has stage four cancer and Maggie says he's improvising. They start to build the medical records.

Streeter calls FF who wants to know where he was diagnosed. He says in Arizona. They scramble to create the medical records. He says his doc's name was Claude Metzger. FF runs the check and says there are no records. He asks Streeter if FF is spelling his name right. He says Ditman has two N's. The tech team spelled it wrong. They fix it and the search FF runs produces results.

FF says he's good and Martin tells them to let Crystal go and says they don't need any more complications. She tells the men she's been around and knows how to keep her mouth shut. They let her go and she runs off. They tell Martin to lie low and says it's happening tonight. They call Gates who tells them there's a big economic summit at Willis Towers — he says it's a huge target.

Bobby gets an alert that his facial recognition search is done. His phone pings and he sees looks at it. Gates makes a plan for security and says it's all hands on deck. Martin is in a cheap hotel when he hears a noise. He grabs a gun and peeks out the curtains. A car is there. A knock at the door reveals Crustal. He says it was a risk coming there but she says the motel isn't being watched.

She tells him Chicago PD found Russell's body and he was tortured. She says he was right about him holding out and he says they need to do something for his family but she says that's not appropriate. She says he was a bad guy but Martin says he changed. Crystal tells him he saved the operation even though it wasn't how she would have done it. She says they have a chance of stopping it now — she says it was impressive. Martin says that wasn't easy for her to say and she tells him he has no idea.

Martin gets a call and changes to Ditman. He says he's alone and agrees to meet them somewhere. He rings off and tells Crystal he meets FF tonight. We see news about the economic conference as Martin watches a screen in a window before getting into the car with Streeter and being driven away. Maggie tracks them while Crystal follows. Martin complains about his ex-wife. They tell him to shut up.

Maggie says he's talking about himself and Gates says the first rule of undercover is to make the lies as close to real life as possible. Maggie tells Crystal they turned off at an auto repair shop. They pull in and the garage door closes them in. There are a fax police car the guys are working on — putting stickers on. They also have 600 pounds of C4. They hand Martin a uniform. He asks who he's going with and the Founding Father is there and says he's going in with him.

Crystal and the other team surround the shop. FF shows him the police staging area and says bankers are selling out the country. He asks Ditman if he's ready to fire the first shot to start a new American Revolution. FF says he has the detonator and then when he gets close, he'll set it off. Ditman asks if he's going in with him and FF says we all have a role to play.

He says he's the FF and he will be Ditman's witness and will tell people who Lincoln Ditman really was. Ditman tears up and nods his head. They tell him it's time. Crystal counts down to the breach but one of FF's guys says he has radio communications outside the building. Crystal says they have a man inside and the CAV guys hear it. All hell breaks loose and Martin takes out some guys just as the FBI bursts in. FF holds up the detonator and tells them it's a dead man switch and if they shoot him, they all die.

He tells Crystal to get behind the wheel and says they're driving out together. FF tells Martin to back off or he'll take them all out but Martin says if he was going to do it, he would already have done. He grabs FF's hand while Streeter yells at him to do it. Martin says he wanted him to do it while he watched because he's a coward. He slams him face down into the car and deactivates the trigger.

He puts on his jacket and walks out. Crystal asks where he's going but he doesn't stop. He's thinking about what the guy said to him about not existing. Bobby works on the facial recognition but is blocked out by an access denied message. He hacks in but just then we see a hand reach around with a cloth and it goes over his mouth. He struggles.

Maggie takes down the project board as Martin comes in. She says she's sorry about his CI. He thanks her for backing him up and says he's not a great team player. Maggie says that's what Bobby told her. He asks where he is and he says he hasn't seen him. Martin gets a funny look and heads out. He calls Bobby on the way to his place. There's no answer so he comes in and finds the kid dead in a chair in front of the TV. He walks back out and gets in the elevator in a panic. He thinks about the guy again.

Back home, he gets a call from the guy and asks what's going on — he says his friend died trying to find out who he is. He tells him to meet him at Union Station platform six. He says he's being followed and to hurry. He tells Martin he was never supposed to remember. Martin pulls up while they talk and he runs to the platform. He tells him to wait. A woman brushes past him and stabs him.

He drops the phone. Martin asks where he is. He runs up but the guy collapses and says they don't want him to know the truth and don't want him to know who he is. He tells him there's a book in his pocket with answers. Martin asks who he is and the guy says he doesn't know. Martin asks who he is but the guy is dead. The crowd notices and Martin has to rush away on a train before he gets pulled in to the drama.

Summary: Martin, Crystal and Troy Buchannan go undercover when a chemistry

teacher and his family are kidnapped. The case takes on urgency when it's feared the kidnappers will use the teacher to manufacture a deadly

gas.



Bakersfield, California. A teacher and his wife are driving and talking when they are pulled over by the police. He wonders if he was speeding and his daughter sasses him. The cop approaches, knocks on the window and asks for his license. He says his license is expired and to step out of the car. They put him in the back of the police car and his wife and daughter wonder what's going on.

The cops scan his license and speak Russian. They verify his identity just as another cop car pulls up behind them. The officer gets out and asks if they need a hand. The teacher, Richard Hubbard,

pounds on the window and says they're not real cops. They shoot the cop and one drives away with him while another drives away in his car with Richard's family.

Blair, the FBI shrink, grills Martin on his behavior and sexual habits. He says he's heard he's incredible. She's not impressed with the joke and reminds him a clean psych eval is required for him to be in the field. Crystal tells Nelson that he may not be mentally fit for duty. She says if she can't control him, she can't run him and Nelson tells her to request a transfer. He says he put them together because they'd be good together and tells her Martin could be her ticket to the big time.

Blair asks him about his last assignment and wants to know if he contacted Sonya while he was gone. We see a flashback to him arguing with her and breaking something. He says he and Sonya will work it out and that Aiden is fine. Blair asks if his undercover work impacts his real life and he says he keeps them separate. She asks if it's hard to leave a legend behind when he's done.

She tells him security said he signed in with security as Lincoln. He insists it was a joke. He says the legend is nothing more than an elaborate lie and is easy to walk away from. We see him burning his Lincoln truck and items. Blair asks if he's had confusion or memory loss or confusing his legends form real life. He says he knows who he is.

Later, Nelson tells him they missed him at Bobby's funeral and he says he had a thing with his son. He did send flowers. He asks Nelson about the autopsy. He says there were no toxins and the ME insists it wasn't a homicide. Bobby had a heart defect since birth and they're convinced that's what killed him and that it could have happened at any time.

Richard is dragged into a warehouse, left and the door shut with a padlock. They show Crystal and Nelson the kidnapping files on Richard's kidnapping. He's a Russian who was involved in the chemical weapons program. He tried to blow the whistle on the Russian mob when they weaponized it and America gave him asylum. They think Chechens picked him up.

They ask if there is a legend active in the Chechen mob and Nelson says they may have, but won't give a definite answer. Agent Kitson leaves. Crystal thinks they nabbed Richard to force him to make a chemical weapon. They tell Maggie that Troy has a CI in the Russian mob that runs an underground club. Troy says he shows up as Spencer Holt, a disgraced attorney just out of white collar prison that launders money.

Nelson tells him to sweat the CI for info on Richard. The kidnappers bring Richard's family to him. His wife asks what they want with them and he says he doesn't know. They call him Novelsky and tell him the colonel will be there tomorrow and is eager to see him again. His wife asks who it is and Richard speaks in Russian and says he never wanted to see them again. Susan, his wife, is shocked and asks "who are you" as they are all locked back into the storage room. She didn't even know he could speak Russian!

At the FBI in LA, Martin shows up looking for Rice. He introduces himself and asks if he covers the subway and he says planes, trains and automobiles. He asks him about a murder in the subway of a homeless man. He pulls a file and says the guy was stabbed and died on scene. Rice says no one saw anything and the surveillance camera aimed at the scene was disabled.

Martin asks for an ID and Rice says he has to see the boss on that. Martin asks for the ID on the down low and he says Robert McCombs, former Marine, with mental health issues. He tells Martin the guy was crazy and Rice asks why he wants to know. He says he can't know and walks out. Aiden calls his dad and Martin says he's sorry about the other night.

Aiden tells him he should by his mom some new dishes and Martin asks him to go shopping and to dinner on Friday and he says he should check with his mom. Susan and Jane sit in their captive room while Richard is taken downstairs to where a lab has been set up. They tell him to make VX. He says he won't do it. The colonel, Yuri, comes in and tells him he will make it.

Yuri tells him he shouldn't waste his true talent. He shows him a video feed of Jane and Susan with knives at their throats and makes it clear he will hurt them if he doesn't make the VX. They hand him a safety hood and tell him the components are on the way.

Martin, Crystal and Tony head to the underground club. Tony tells them the guy can be jumpy and to let him handle it. Tony is greeted warmly by his CI and Crystal introduces herself as a Cayman Island banker and Martin is introduced as simply "with her." They ask to talk in his office. In private, he yells at Tony about bringing in cops and they ask him about the kidnapping.

Nic tells them to get out and says the Chechens are scarier than they are. Martin pulls his revolver and dumps out all but one bullet. He points the gun at his crotch and pulls the trigger — he says that way he can play more than once. He dry fires twice and Nic says Dimitri and that the guy had cash and mentioned Bakersfield.

They are out front of Dimitri's and Crystal tells him no more cowboy shit but Martin says the gun wasn't loaded. She says she'll go to Nelson and he tells her that rules don't apply with guys like that. They have cameras up at Dimitri's and Maggie pulls the feeds up. They spot one of the kidnappers and Maggie pulls the dashcam footage. He says Dimitri is the suspect but they're not really to pull him in.

Martin suggests provoking Dimitri to get him to contact the kidnappers. Martin says they should let Dimitri know Spencer and his banker are available. Nelson agrees and then asks to meet with Martin. He tells him they found some off books files on Bobby's computer. He shows him the pic of the homeless guy and asks who he is.

Nelson asks him to trust him and Martin says his name is Robert McCombs and says he's homeless, mentally ill and had been following him. He tells Nelson that Robert told him that

Martin Odum was just a legend. Martin says he seemed convincing. Nelson tells him not to ever tell anyone else what the guy said to him. Nelson leans in and tells him that many undercover agents struggle coming out.

He tells Martin when this case is over he wants him to take some personal time and get his head together. Martin's at a food truck when Rice approaches him and offers him a taco. He asks what Rice wants and he says he has more info on McCombs. He says there were witnesses on the platform and one had some video. He plays the video for him and Martin sees himself.

book was. He says he can't talk about an active investigation. Rice probes further and Martin says he didn't kill him but doesn't know who did. Rice tells him he won't let this go or drop the ball and that he should know that about him.

Richard is dumped off to his family in a lot of pain — he's been badly beaten. She asks what they want and he tells his wife he used to be a chemist for the Russian military and he made terrible weapons. He tells her he tried to leave his life behind when he fled. He tells her that she saved his life. She cleans his wounds and he promises to get them out of there.

Crystal checks in with Maggie who tells her Troy will meet them there. Martin warns her if they're made, they'll all be killed. She says he's the liability, not her. Crystal tells him she doesn't like tequila and says she'll have bourbon — he told her to have a shot to ease her nerves. Nelson reminds them there are innocents in the bar and that backup is 30 seconds out.

They show up and spot Dimitri. Nic and Dimitri meet up with Troy and Crystal. Martin watches from the bar and says Dimitri has muscle with him — three armed men. Maggie taps into the security cameras at the club. Nic tells Dimitri that Spencer is like Gandalf with money. Crystal offers to show him around the Caymans sometimes. He says he can't hear them and says they should go to Nic's office.

Martin alerts them that they're on the move and he can't follow. Maggie says they have no cameras back there. Dimitri calls in to his higher ups and says they should come meet him. The translation program tells Nelson and the others that these people may be able to help with the Bakersfield situation. Maggie traces the signal and says it's in the city but they didn't get him.

Nelson tells Crystal the colonel is on the way to the club and he's Dimitri's boss. He tells her to watch herself. Dimitri pulls her into his lap and she says it's bank policy to only sleep with people who are for real. She flirts with him and then snakes his cell phone before excusing herself to go to the bathroom. She locks herself in the room and pulls out his phone. She downloads the data.

Martin tells Maggie that they have visitors. She says she has lost Crystal's signal and Martin says these guys aren't Dimitri's boss. The two newcomers open up a hail of fire into the club killing everyone. They say in Russian that there's another one and go looking for her. Martin shoots them down then calls for Crystal. She runs out and over to Troy but it looks like he's dead. Martin calls her and she grabs Troy's gun. She shoots Dimitri.

At the Port of Long Beach, Russians chain the door to a warehouse and yank it open. They steal barrels of chemicals and speed away. At the club, body bags are wheeled out. Maggie tells Nelson seven dead including Troy and she can't find Martin and Crystal. He tells her to lock the place down and make sure no one leaves. Nelson says it's a GD mess.

Nelson gets a call from Martin who says they're at his place. Nelson says Troy is dead and he tells him he knows and is sorry. He says Crytal is okay. He says they sent pros and it's above the Chechen mob. Martin says they are organized and financed. Nelson says they'll get these guys. Crystal stares sadly out the window. She tells him she's going to find out who killed Troy and put a bullet in their head.

Rice's boss rants and says he can't put surveillance on an FBI agent. She tells him not to mess with DCO operations. She tells him to stick the video in a box and sends it to OPR. She says the request is denied and says to close the file and turn it over. She marches off and Rice makes a call. He lies and says the boss signed off on it and says to start surveillance now 24/7.

At the office, Crystal sits stunned and sad. Maggie comes in and tells her they got the data from Dimitri's phone. She says the gunmen were Russian mob. She tells her she didn't know Troy well but she's sorry. She leaves. Nelson comes in and tells them they have to stay focused and can grieve when it's over.

Maggie rushes in and shows them the San Pedro robbery footage and says the chemicals stolen are what's needed to make VX gas. We see Richard in the lab working. He thinks about his daughter and wife being held and is tormented as he works.

Nelson talks to Martin about the VX issue and Martin says he needs to go back under now. Nelson asks which legend and he says Dante Auerbach, Lord of War. He tells Martin they can do it. Martin and Aiden comes back to the house with new dishes for Sonya. Aiden asks if she can come next time but Martin says he may be out of town next week.

Aiden goes in and Sonya asks if he's going under again. She says it will kill him. Rice sits with some guys in a surveillance van watching him and Rice says he'll follow him tonight. He pulls out after him. Martin makes the tail and pulls out across several lanes of traffic. They tell Rice that he pulled a u-turn but they have him. Rice pulls up outside a storage place and wonders where he went.

Nelson tells the crew they have no leads and most of the city is in the kill zone. They pull up Dante's legend — he's a British arms dealer. We see Martin prepping for the role. Nelson says Dante is a talker and a gambler and tells them to sit back and watch because it's Martin's show now. We see Martin check into a hotel. He picks up his car from valet and heads out.

In the latest episode of "Legends," we basically picked up where we left off with the Hubbard family still under captivity and the clock running on the father to produce the VX chemical weapon or die-right after he watched his wife and daughter killed in front of him, in "Lords of War." Though papa Hubbard tried to make a valiant escape, starting a fire in the lab and knocking out a guard in the process, then setting his family free and making a run for the gate- they were caught before any of them could make it over the fence, and the only result was a sped-up clock in terms of how long he

had to produce results.

Enter Dante, aka Odum's black market weapons dealer alter ego. Reconnecting with facilitator Khalid, who Dante had dealt with before, he managed to finagle a meet with Ana Paulanos, a lovely lady that even Khalid wanted to keep his distance from- and advised Dante to do the same. Naturally, he did no such thing, wasting no time in coming on strong, especially since the clock was ticking, with the team predicting three days tops before the VX was good to go and the location of it was gone.

Problem is, she's already got a buyer, and one she trusts, not some flashy new guy she knows nothing about. So, of course, Dante tracks the buyer down, and semi-tortures him with a flat iron, albeit not much before he spills everything, understandably. Dante advises him to stay away from Ana and has him sink the deal with her, before leaving after telling him they'd be watching, so he better make wise decisions in how he handled himself. Then, he waits for the inevitable call from Ana.

We discover Ana knows Colonel Yuri all too well, as he "rescued" her back in the day from Chechnya and that if she can't fix it, he would need to "wipe the slate clean" and start fresh,

which didn't sound good- for her, at least. So, she calls Dante, has him thoroughly checked out while she seduces him and gets the go-ahead from her peeps after he passes the inspection. The meet is on with Yuri and all the team has to do is follow him discreetly, although he had to go in hooded, sans gun and phone, so it ended up being mostly guesswork as to where they were headed on their part.

Eventually the team figured out a likely hide-out that lent itself well to a lab in the general vicinity of where Odum/Dante was headed and descended upon it- only to discover that Yuri and the chemical weapons were long gone. On the plus side, the Hubbard family was still there, so they were able to rescue them from the armed guards keeping watch over them. But where was Dante?

Turns out he was meeting the big man himself, Yuri, who was taking no chances with Dante. After Dante pulled a bit of flashy moves and threatened to kill him- and his men did the same with Dante, Mexican stand-off style- the two came to terms on one condition: Dante had to show he was serious about buying the weapon at hand by using it on someone there that Yuri had decided was disposable. It was undeniably a rock-and-a-hard-place sort of situation, and maybe the guy in question was a bad guy, but still, killing another human being held against their will with a nasty chemical weapon is pretty freaking hardcore. And yet, Dante did just that, and that was where we left him.

Summary: Martin gets the Colonel and Ana Paulanos captured after purchasing

VX gas from them. One of the Colonel's followers discharges VX gas on a crowded bus and guarantees to strike again if the Colonel and Ana

aren't freed.



After being forced to kill a captive with the weapon's grade VX nerve, agent Odum, as Dante, has to negotiate with the colonel on the price for the claimed five litres of concentrated chemical. At the FBI office, Hubbard confirms that he did make five litres of the deadly agent. Once Dante agrees to a price for the nerve agent, he tells Medved to give him a flash drive with the terrorist's bank details on it and that they will have no electronic communication until the exchange the next day.

When the "arms dealer" returns to his apartment, Ana shows up to "keep an eye on Dante" and to tell him where the meet

will take place. The two end up in bed and the FBI agent learns that the woman was rescued from an orphanage by Medved when she was ten. She also reveals that the orphan officials put the children in cages. It is apparent that Ana has become attached to Dante, even after he suggests that the colonel murdered her parents and adopted her out of guilt, she goes on to obviously have sex with him again.

At the park, the three meet and Medved brings a container full of the agent and Dante transfers the \$32 million to the bank account as agreed. Once the money "clears," the FBI show up to arrest all three. Suddenly a sniper begins shooting agents and Ana, Medved and Dante begin to run. Only the FBI agent and Ana make it away.

The woman then learns that Dante is not an arms dealer but an FBI agent. Odum then tells Ana that she is under arrest. In Legends: Betrayal Tony Rice is still trying to pin the homeless man's murder on Odum, despite Nelson Gates' clear warning to leave the agent alone. He tracks down another homeless man who witnessed the murder and Rice learns that a woman killed the man and not Martin.

The stuff in the container that Medved sold to "Dante" was filled with hairspray and Martin assures the team that the VX does exist as he saw it work. Odum says that he will go back and get the colonel to give up the agent. Crystal questions Medved and reveals that they know the man raped and killed Ana's mother.

Before McGuire leaves the interrogation room, Medved demands safe passage from the U.S. for him and Ana or there will be VX nerve agent attacks hourly until he is released. Shortly after his threat a cannister goes off in a city bus killing 16 people. Crystal wants to see Medved sent to a "black" location where he can be treated without rules until he tells them where the nerve agent is located.

The director of the FBI authorises Odum to stay undercover and "break out" the colonel and Ana in order to recover the VX agent. Martin and McGuire convince the woman to "turn" against her adoptive father. Odum by telling her what Medved did and Crystal by showing the woman the CCTV footage where the colonel admits the crime.

The FBI and Odum stage an escape using explosives, a helicopter and a "shootout." Dante then takes the two away in the chopper to a house. Once there the "arms dealer" pistol whips Medved until he calls off the nerve agent attacks. When the colonel does so he facetiously asks Dante if they are friends again and the "dealer" stabs the man through the hand.

Leaving Medved and Ana alone, the two talk and the colonel admits he did rape and murder her mother. She demands that he give the nerve agent to Dante and take her to safety. Crystal attempts to show Odum how much she appreciates what he has done and he gets angry. Martin accuses her of trying to "manage him" and he says that too many people died because he "misread the target."

Medved, Ana and Dante all go to the bank where the colonel has his VX stored in a deposit box. At the last minute Martin decides to unlock the safe deposit box and when he pulls it open the drawer explodes with a flash bang stunning the agent. Medved takes the same keys and opens another box that contains a gun and the nerve agent.

As he leaves the bank vault, the colonel shoots anyone with a gun as he approaches the exit door, Odum and Ana catch up to him. Medved realises that Dante is really with the FBI and the two men face each other, guns in hand as Ana then picks up another gun from one of the fallen agents.

In a tense moment, where Martin has a gun aimed at Ana and Medved, she shoots her adoptive father in the throat killing him. When the rest of the FBI storm the bank, Ana tells Odum that she will never go back into a cage. She then aims her gun at Martin forcing McGuire to shoot her. By the end of the episode, Martin has successfully recovered the VX nerve agent and it is clear that while this mission has ended, the man is still undergoing a personal meltdown. His legends are causing his reality to unravel even further.

FBI DCO asset Martin Odum comes out from his latest legend and while being scrutinized by the DCO psychiatrist he becomes defensive and then angry at her questions. Finally he storms out of the session and McGuire, who is in charge while Gates is gone, asks the therapist about what went on. The doctor reveals that his problems have nothing to do with his latest mission, but something else.

The result of the eval is that Martin is declared unfit for work and is on "leave" until they can figure out how to proceed. McGuire seems oddly disturbed by the news. In the meantime Odum has been

removed from active duty.

Crystal is approached at a bar by Tony Rice and when she makes the first real move, he says he's married and she replies, "Take the night off." When Rice explains who he is, she gets angry and calls him an "A**hole." Tony persists and shows McGuire the cell phone footage of Odum and the murdered man in the subway. He reveals that Gates, Crystal's boss, is protecting Martin.

It appears that Odum is beginning to have real problems dealing with who he really is versus the legends he must take on. When his estranged wife Sonya comes by to visit, he tells her that he is having trouble sleeping and that there are a great many blind spots. She reminds him that he had a car wreck in February 2004 and that the scars on his body are from that. Martin then looks up the information on the internet and despite having flashes of memories about the accident he also remembers the murdered man telling him that Martin Odum is another legend.

While having the flashback of McCombs dying, he remembers getting a book from the man who told him that "the answers are in there." Looking at the novel, he notices certain pages are dog-eared and he gives the page numbers to Maggie Harris to find out what they mean. In Legends:Rogue Odum is taking control of his problems and proactively searching for answers, regardless of where they may lead him.

Crystal and Rice meet and she sees the file that Tony has on Martin. The two decide to investigate McCombs, the man murdered in the subway, and his connection to Martin. Maggie meets Odum in a cafe and she reveals that the numbers are a phone number. She also gives him the name of the man the phone belongs to, Denis Evans. Martin tells Maggie that she needs to "cover her tracks" as what she is doing for him could get her killed.

Martin goes to see Evans and after identifying himself as an FBI agent, the other man panics and tries to attack Odum with an hatchet. When he is disarmed be begins to cry and begs the agent not to kill him. Evan's asks Martin his name and after being told, says to Odum that he wants his "real name."

The two men go inside and Evan's reveals that he knows Martin and they were in Iraq together. The man has a photograph to prove it. He also tells the agent that Odum, McCombs and Evans are the only three men still alive from the group in the photo. Martin tells Denis that there are only two now and Evan's says that he is leaving but before he goes, he gives a name to Odum, Kyle Dobson "the guy in charge, over there."

Tony and Crystal go to the Department of Veteran Affairs to get information about McCombs from a doctor who is reluctant to share it. The physician reveals that the man "lost" himself for awhile. The two agents watch as McCombs stares out at them from a video screen and says he "watched the whole world burn."

Odum decides to go after Dobson and makes up his own legend to help him. Maggie puts all the information into the computer to back up his new character and looks both bemused and concerned when Martin goes into his legend's skin right before her eyes. She tells Odum that she found something in Dobson's file called Operation Raining Fire which causes the agent to have a flashback.

Odum's self created legend is called Len Barlow who is a cowboy and born "a century and half too late." Rice and McGuire trace Evans down and find the man's house. They discover that someone beat them to the address and when they enter, the two find that Denis has been tortured and killed.

Martin searches out a contact in Houston where Dobson is supposed to be. The man steers the FBI agent to Kyle's girlfriend. As Len Barlow, Martin talks the girl into taking him to Dobson. Once they arrive, the man recognises Odum and in a matter of seconds, Martin gets into a gun battle where the odds are greatly stacked against him.

Amazingly, the agent manages to take Dobson away and while driving off, a truck crashes into the car. By the end of the episode it looks like Martin's last lead on who he really is may not be able to tell him anything.

Crystal and Rice continue to work together and go through the late Dave Evans' personal files trying to figure out what is really going on with Odum. Maggie tries to find out about Iraq and can only find a minimum amount of information. Gates returns and apart from being upset to see Rice there, lets Crystal know that he is not happy,

Dobson finds out that he was shot and Martin boards a bus with his captive so they can get to a hospital. Rice explains to Gates that he no longer believes that Odum killed McCombs but that the legends agent is in serious trouble. Before

the bus can arrive at a local hospital, the police intercept the vehicle and arrest both Odum and Kyle. Martin tells the police that he is FBI and he gives the men his boss' name and the code Foxtrot Echo Zulu. Once Dobson learns that Odum "is a cop" he mumbles that "no wonder they couldn't find you."

Legends: Gauntlet shows that Gates has always known that Odum is not real but another legend. However, Martin's boss continues to let the man believe otherwise. Gates sends Crystal and Rice to Houston in order to pick up Odum and his prisoner. The local police are hostile and while the two FBI agents head out to help Martin, Rice wonders if the undercover agent is losing his mind.

While hospital personnel work on Dobson, Martin waits impatiently and talks to Gates. He reveals that the "chop shop" had illegal weapons, military missiles, etc. The agent brings up that Dobson says Martin was in Iraq in 2004, which Gates says was impossible due to "the" car accident which left Martin in a coma. A member of the hospital's staff gives Odum a coffee that has been drugged and he passes out.

When he wakes up, Dobson is being taken out of the hospital by what appears to be federal agents. An SAC agent approaches Martin and attempts to keep him away from Kyle and he tries to use a taser on him. The FBI agent intercepts Dobson and he steals a car to take this mystery man to a safe place for interrogation.

Gates tells Odum to take Dobson to Austin, Texas to a friend of his. The car's radiator gives out and the two men hole up in a deserted house. Kyle tells Martin that his people are coming and that the FBI undercover agent does not have long to live. Odum continues to question his prisoner and reminds him that if it takes too long for Dobson's people to take Martin out, that the man's own people will kill him.

Martin gets his position to Crystal and Rice and prepares for a last stand scenario. After taking out the team sent to kill him and rescue Dobson, his back up arrives. Before the FBI arrive, however, Dobson agrees to help Odum and prior to being taken away by the cavalry, the man is shot by a long range sniper.

By the end of Legends: Gauntlet Martin Odum has lost his last lead. Gates tells Martin's wife she needs to get back together with him and the undercover specialist still has no idea what his name really is.

While Odum dealt with the fallout of his rogue mission last week, he no doubt felt as if he had landed himself in some "Quicksand," and then some. While Gates managed to contain the situation with some serious damage control- not in the least after Odum short-circuited a bit at the debriefing- it was a clear a big win was needed to get him back into the good graces of the DCO.

Enter Prince Abbaud, a visiting Middle Easterner and Oil Master, in town for the Arcadia Policy Council, a meeting of all the biggest heads of energy, aka some of the most powerful people in the world. With so many powerful people in attendance, coupled with the presence of the

controversial Abbaud, chances were that something big was destined to go down, and a leak about the top secret meeting seemed to trace back to Human Rights activist and Junior Analyst Aaron Rawley. So, an undercover Crystal leaked the info to Rawley to see if he would bite and try something- a move I'm guessing the team would go on to regret later.

As part of his penance, Odum was teamed with the newly-recruited Rice, who staked out Rawley, who led them to another suspect Hani Jabril, a Women's Rights Activist with an axe to grind against Abbaud. A search of her room proved inconclusive, so it was legends time, this time Sebastian Egan, a hard-drinking gonzo journalist in the Hunter S. Thompson mold, who was well-known in journalistic circles, but rarely seen in the flesh. Connecting with Jabril at a conference, Odum managed to get himself and Rice access to cover Jabril's planned protest at the Council meeting.

The episode carries on where last week's episode ended, with the death of Prince Abboud who is dispatched via a drone with explosives attached and when it detonates kills the prince and his bodyguards as well as taking out most of his car. Hani Jibril narrowly misses being killed by the remote controlled flying bomb only being saved by "Sebastian Egan," by the skin of her teeth.

The state department employee who set Hani up, Aaron Rawley contacts his "handler" who praises him on a job well done and tells Rawley that his money has been wired to his account. While talking

to the man, Aaron's accomplice comes up, Hassan, and places him in a choke hold. While he is unconscious, the accomplice injects Rawley with a drug killing him.

Because of the political implications with the assassin being a government employee the state department decide to blame Hani and let her become the focus of Arabian rage. The plan is to avoid an international incident and the agents from the agency tell the FBI that the case is out of their hands and has been declared classified due to national security.

Jibril learns that Sebastian Egan was a lie and when she meets Martin she is understandably upset. As she leaves, Odum tells her he will see that whoever killed the prince and set her up burn, Hani replies that she does not believe him. In Legends: Iconoclast, Martin goes back into the jouno legend to try and flush out the real assassin who set up Jibril and killed Abboud. The DCO have opted to ignore the state department's mandate to leave the case alone and Odum sets himself up to be kidnapped.
