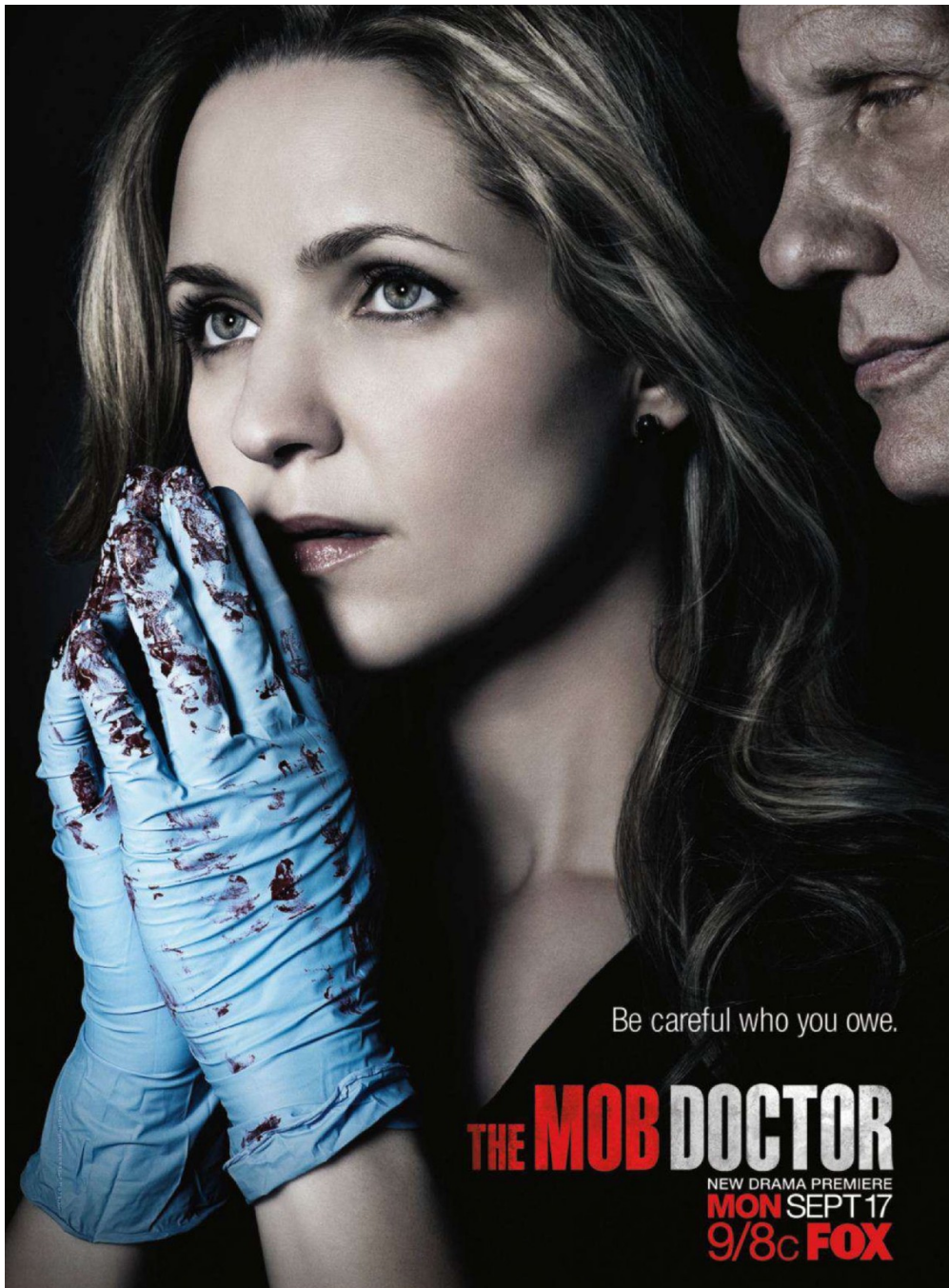

Summary: A Chicago doctor is torn between two worlds in the series premiere of this medical drama. Forced to ignore the sacred Hippocratic Oath, Dr. Grace Devlin must focus on her up and coming surgical career while also paying off her family's debt to the Southside Mob of Chicago.



The episode begins with a voiceover telling us about the first time she saw a dead body. She was a little girl then and the dead man was the neighborhood drunk, shot in the head in the South Side of Chicago. The kid wasn't afraid and wanted to touch the body and even today, twenty years later, Dr. Grace Devlin remembers every dead body. Next, we see that Grace is at a vet's and she is trying to remove a screwdriver from a thug's forehead. Just then her phone rings, which means she has to get back to work. She manages to remove the screwdriver and heads off to the hospital. She arrives at

the OR and she is late. The patient is an eight year old boy, who has a gunshot wound.

Grace successfully removes the bullet, but the body is going into shock and Grace's supervisor, Dr. Flanigan calls for drugs. But Grace doesn't agree with that and performs a surgery and little Kevin is back. Next, Nurse Rosa tells Grace that her mother Daniela is in the lobby. Just then the feds arrives with a 47 year old patient and DR. Stafford asks Grace to help him with the case. This man is all over the news. Daniela arrives and tells Grace that 14 year old Suzie; the girl Grace used to babysit, came looking for Grace and passed out right in front of her. So she got her to the hospital. Grace's boyfriend, Dr. Brett is attending to Suzie and he tells Grace that despite being a virgin, she is pregnant.

Next, Grace is educated about her fed patient; Ralph Sevarino, a mobster, who was ready to testify against mob boss, Paul Moretti. He suffered a heart attack and according to Stafford, the

surgery could lead to a memory loss. But Grace has another option; a new surgical procedure which has never been done at this hospital. Later, Grace receives a bunch of balloons and card that says 'KILL HIM'. Next, Grace arrives at a body shop looking for Morretti. There she sees her ex-boyfriend, Franco. Morretti reminds her that she had agreed to do anything to keep him from killing her brother, Nate. But Grace tells him that she never agreed to kill anybody.

Morretti tells her that he is about to make millions and Ralph is about to mess it up for him. Later, Grace arrives at the hospital and she has brought a soft toy for Kevin. Grace assures Kevin's mother that her son is doing great. Flanigan arrives to have a word with Grace. He tells her that he is handing over Kevin's case to Dr. Watson as she is dealing with Ralph. Brett tries to explain to Suzie that she is pregnant. That is crazy. Suzie argues that she is a virgin. Grace arrives and Suzie is glad to see her. She also notices that there is something going on between Grace and Brett. Grace asks her if she is still dating Johnny. Suzie says a yes but she says that they never had sex. Grace explains the concept of fimbriated hymen and tells her that she got impregnated through outer-course.

Suzie fears that her dad is going to kill Johnny. She also tells her that she will lose her scholarship due to her pregnancy. Grace arrives home and her mother asks her about Suzie. But Grace doesn't tell her anything. She then asks about Brett. Nate asks Grace what is wrong with her and that she needs to be a little more nice to their mother. he appreciates all that Grace is doing for him; but he also says that he had a foolproof system. But Grace is sure that Morretti would have killed him. Grace then receives a text. A former mob boss Constantine is watching the news report about his release from prison. Grace arrives and administers insulin to him. Constantine knows about Ralph and he feels that Grace likes feeling powerful. He reminds her of the saying, 'Power corrupts and absolute power corrupts absolutely'.

But Grace tells him that it is not about power. Constantine tells her that she is like family to him and that he would always be there if they needed any help. That she knows. Grace leaves and we see a man clicking pictures of Grace leaving from Constantine's. next, Brett and Grace are making out and Grace's phone rings; 2 missed calls from Morretti. She then asks Brett about Suzie. He tells her that the pregnancy is ectopic. He would perform the surgery as soon as he gets her father's consent. But Grace says that she will lose her scholarship if the word gets out. But Brett tells her that surgery without the father's consent would mean losing his license. Just then she hears a page from Kevin's room. She rushes; only to find that Kevin passed away. She talks to Olivia Watson, the doctor in charge of Kevin.

Olivia tells her that Flanigan overruled the treatment Grace suggested. Grace is pissed and asks Olivia to report this. But Olivia refuses to do so. Grace then suggests that Olivia should ask her father to keep an eye on Flanigan. But Olivia feels offended as she doesn't want to be called daddy's girl. She leaves. Grace totally loses it and she pages for Flanigan to report to the OR where Stafford is performing a surgery. She then tells Stafford what happened and she asks Stafford to pen an investigation on Flanigan; else he will need to find someone else to perform the surgery on Ralph. Stafford asks Flanigan to report the case. Next, Suzie's dad arrives and Grace tells him that Suzie has a ruptured ovarian cyst. But Brett seems totally uncomfortable with this lie.

Grace tells Brett that Rosa will do the paper work to cover up. Next, Morretti calls Grace and tells her that his man will leave a marked syringe in the OR which will contain a drug that will kill Ralph. Grace is worried. In the OR, Grace drops the marked syringe. The operation is successful. Olivia confronts Grace about Flanigan being written up. But Grace tells her that he didn't. Olivia tells her that Flanigan thinks that she ratted him out and now he is angry with her. Brett too is angry with her. Grace then receives a call from her mom; but it isn't her mom. It is an angry Morretti calling her and he has Daniela at gunpoint. He asks her to come get her mom. Grace arrives home. She then rams her car into Morretti's. He rushes out and then chases Grace. Grace drives to Constantine's house. Constantine shoots Morretti.

He asks her to go home and pretend as if she didn't see anything. At home, Nate admits that all this was his fault. Grace is called to the hospital. Brett tells Grace that the operation was a success; 'cyst removed!' Next, Grace arrives to meet Constantine. She is shocked to see Franco there. Well, he is the one who got rid of the body! Constantine was the one who got Ralph to testify against Morretti. Constantine wanted a way in. he asks Grace to leave Chicago; but she refuses. She asks him to protect her. Constantine agrees; but her debt to Morretti now becomes a debt to him.

Well, we have a deal! But Constantine tells her that she had a choice. Grace then sees Constantine's car parked nearby. Cut to the scene, where she saw her first dead body. The man wasn't just any drunk, it was her father and she was relieved to see him dead as now he wouldn't come back home and hit her mom, her brother and her. She then hears a car leave the scene; it is Constantine's car!

Summary: As Grace's ties to Chicago's Southside mob intensify, Constantine sends her to meet slain mob boss Paul Moretti's former rival, Donte Amato, who's suffering from an undiagnosed life-threatening condition. Meanwhile, romance at Roosevelt Medical Center pulses when Grace collaborates on a heart-wrenching case with Dr. Robinson involving a young bride experiencing severe mood swings.



The episode begins with Grace's voiceover telling us as to how her mother lied to her on her sixth birthday by telling her that her father couldn't come because of work. But we see that little Grace sees her father pass out drunk in front of their house. Cut to the present, their mother asks Nate to be back home early as Grace's boyfriend is coming home for dinner. Nate asks Grace if she has heard from Morretti and she says a no. he feels that something isn't right. Next, Constantine arrives at a house to meet a man named Dante; they are old acquaintances. Dante's wife Gemma and brother,

Titus is also there. Dante knows that Constantine wants to be back and also wants to take over the deal Morretti had with him.

But they want a higher cut than Morretti; that is 15% for the distribution of the video poker games shipment that is arriving. Just then Dante has a coughing fit. At the hospital, a 92 year old man is rushed in. He is from the rest home and has no relatives. He fell off the bed and now needs to have few tests run immediately. Grace and Brett are discussing about tonight's dinner when a bride dressed in her wedding gown arrives with bleeding eyes and nose. She collapses. Constantine calls Grace but she doesn't pick up. She then receives a message from Franco and Brett tells her to attend her phone as he will take care of the girl. Franco is waiting for Grace and she is upset with him. Franco says it is important.

He then drives Grace to the farmhouse where Dante is hiding. Constantine tells her that Dante can't be seen in public. So she collects his urine sample and takes it to get it tested. Nate is at the city college, getting himself registered. But he doesn't know what course he wants to apply for. He changes his mind and leaves. Grace learns that Dante is suffering from renal failure. Ro also tells her that the 92 year old man would live only for few minutes. Grace asks Ro to stall the death pronouncement. She then calls Franco. Next, the bride with the bleeding eyes tell her doctors that she was getting ready for the wedding when she suddenly felt as if some wave hit her and then she ran. Later she saw the blood and came to the hospital.

Grace tells her that she breathes too hard and exhales too much carbon dioxide and that changes the acid balance in the blood; a symptom associated with severe panic attack. Nate arrives at the hospital and pages for Grace. He is frustrated with Grace behaving like a mother. In the parking lot, Nate sees Grace and Franco taking Dante into the hospital on a wheel chair. Grace then tells Ro to keep her secret as she is going to run some tests under the old man's name. Franco then goes into a bar where Constantine is waiting for him. Nate is keeping a watch on Franco. At the hospital, Brett is about to run some tests on the bride; an echo-cardiogram.

Meanwhile, Grace is running some tests on Dante and she learns that Dante knew her father. She asks him if he knows who killed her father. He tells her to ask Constantine. Brett is still performing the echo-cardiogram and he sees a shadow on the posterior end of the kidney. He doesn't know what it is. But then suddenly the bride begins to scream and she pushes Brett away and runs. She has a similar attack like the one she had during her wedding and her eyes begin to bleed. Grace traps the bride and Brett takes her back. Stafford then explains to the bride's sister that the bride has a renal tumor and Brett pushing it triggered the same reaction during the wedding.

But then that was due to the pressure of the corset of her wedding dress. The tumor seems to be causing bleeding around the kidney. So it needs to be operated and Stafford tells the sister that they will need her consent. Flanigan wants to know why Grace is running so many tests for a 92 year old man. He says that he is taking over this case. Just then Franco arrives and tells Flanigan that the old man is his grandfather and he loves him a lot and if Flanigan has a problem with the tests, then he knows a good lawyer too. Dante doesn't want to stay in the hospital any longer. He tells Grace that he is leaving. She tells them to take the service elevator. Grace then goes to the OR for the bride's surgery. Stafford knows about the dinner plans. He also knows that Grace's mother is cooking duck.

Next, Grace goes to meet Constantine and asks him about her father's murder. She wants to know if he killed her father. Constantine swears that he did not kill her father. Just then Franco tells him that Titus just called; Dante passed out. They go to the farm house. Grace calls the hospital and asks Ro for the results. But Ro tells her that the results haven't arrived. Brett is already at Grace's house and Grace is running late. Ro tells Grace that Dante's test results show acidosis. Grace analyzes the symptoms and concludes that he has severe lactic acidosis. Dante stops breathing and Gemma tells Grace that Dante sniffed poppers as he felt like iron man after that. Grace makes him sniff the poppers and Dante starts breathing. Grace declares that Dante is being poisoned with cyanide which causes lactic acidosis.

Just then we see Gemma driving away. Grace heads for home and Nate stops her on her way. He wants to know what is going on. She tells him. At home, dinner is over and Brett is ready to leave. Nate and Grace arrive and Nate gives some ridiculous story. Brett sees through his lie. Grace tells Brett that Nate got into some trouble and she had to bail him out. She is sorry for arriving late. Brett leaves. Next, Constantine tells Titus that he wants 15% and Titus refuses telling him that he isn't getting more than 10% and it is okay with him if Constantine doesn't take the deal. Constantine leaves. Later, we see that Constantine's men hijack a truck carrying the gaming machines. Constantine checks the manifest and figures out that something is not right. He sees that half of the load has duplicate serial numbers.

He then meets Titus. He tells him that all his machines have twins; so half the money goes tax-free and wouldn't come under the radar. So now the price has gone up; 25% of all the machines. Titus agrees; no other option! Brett is still upset about the dinner. He wants to know what is going on; but whenever Grace is ready to tell him. Just then a patient is rushed into the hospital. But Brett declares her dead. It is Gemma. Her ring finger is cut off and Brett feels that someone must have really wanted her ring. Indeed! Grace says that the nails beds are pink, so they need to check for cyanide poisoning in the autopsy.

Next, Grace remembers the wish she made on her sixth birthday; she wished her father never came home again. And the wish came true that afternoon when two men carry him away. Nate meets Constantine and tells him that he knows everything. He wants Constantine to hire him.

Summary: After treating a family that was involved in a fatal car accident, Dr. Grace Devlin reels when she is ordered by Constantine to tend to the driver of the deadly hit-and-run. Meanwhile, someone from Grace's neighborhood is brought into the psych ward after a bar fight, and Nate makes a critical move.



The episode begins with Grace's childhood memories of her parents fighting and her deciding to run away from home. Cut to the present, Grace rushes to attend to a family of four being rushed into the hospital. They are the Kelton family; parents and two children, a son and a daughter. Grace, Brett, Stafford, Olivia, and Flannigan attend to the family members. The father says that they were in a hit and run by a red SUV. Stafford drills the mother's skull and lets some blood flow out and she is back to normal. The son is being attended by Olivia. Grace attends to the daughter and asks for a

chest x-ray. The girl tells her that her chest feels.

She doesn't complete the sentence. Her pulse runs flat. Grace calls for help. But she is gone. Olivia suggests a surgery for educational benefit; but Grace doesn't want to rip open a small girl for educational benefits. She declares the TOD. Grace looks upset and just then her phone rings; it is Constantine. She arrives to meet him. Constantine wants her to fix a guy lying on the table. She notices a mark across his body caused by the seat belt and she asks Franco what car he was driving. Franco forbids her from going into that territory. She learns that the man was driving a Red SUV; he just killed her patient! Grace confronts Constantine. He doesn't want her asking any questions. He then tells her that the man is a cop.

Grace performs a quick fix; but actually she leaves him with an internal bleeding. On her way out, she sees Nate and learns that he is now working for Constantine. Grace reaches the hospital. She asks Brett how long it will take an abdominal bleeding to turn south; he says 24

hours. So; our wounded killer cop has 24hours after which he will require immediate medical attention. The mother still has cerebral edema. In a bar, Constantine is with his lawyer, Stavos and they are discussing his cash flow issues. Grace is still upset about the girl's death. Next, we see that Nate and Franco are about to torch the red SUV and Franco asks Nate about the doctor Grace is dating. Nate tells him that Grace was waiting for him to pop the question and he just left and was gone for a year. Grace thought it was because of her.

Franco tells him that cops were breathing down Moretti's neck and so he had to leave and he then got stuck. He was unaware of grace's thoughts. Franco then tells Nate that working for Constantine is a bad choice. But Nate tells him that he has made his. Franco then asks him to torch the car alone. He then congratulates him on turning into a felon. Next, Brett attends to Max, the son and Max tells him that his leg doesn't hurt. There seems to be a problem. Grace's mother arrives at the hospital and Grace tells her about Nate's new job. Grace wants her to tell him the truth about their father; that he was a drunk. And if Nate doesn't know the truth, he is going to go down the same path. But she tells Grace that she has no control over Nate.

Next, Constantine is with Nate and he points out to a neighborhood that used to be under his control. It is now under Marcellus Coyne. He tells Nate that Coyne did not have the guts to take it directly from him; so he set him up and ratted him out to the cops. He now wants to take it all back and asks Nate if he wants to be a part of that. Nate wants to be. At the hospital, Ro tells Grace that she cannot fix everything and so she needs to stop feeling bad about the girl's death. Brett tells Stafford that Max's angiogram is back. Brett suggests a surgery that could improve Max's leg. But Stafford disagrees and says that it is a long shot and that they need to concentrate on saving his life. Stafford suggests that they should get the father's consent for amputation.

Grace meets Franco outside the hospital. She tells him that she cannot do this anymore as she feels guilty for covering up a girls' murder. Franco tells her that Shaw is busting a drug deal in the old neighborhood and, this needs to be done. He also reminds him the good things Constantine has done for them. He asks her to let it go. Grace tells him that she did not actually fix Shaw up and that she needs to see him. Franco tells her that he might not always be there to cover up for her. Franco gets Shaw to the hospital. Flannigan questions her about the new patient. Grace deals with him and tells Ro that this is messed up and she needs to trust her. Brett meets max's father and tells him that the hospital needs his consent for amputation.

But he also tells him about the surgery where they can bypass the injury and save his leg. But there is a risk for an infection and that could risk his life. At home, Nate's mother tells him his father's truth. He realizes that Grace put her up to this. Brett is in the OR for surgery and Stafford is furious. Brett tells him that he did inform the father about the risks the surgery poses. Stafford has no option but allow it. Next, Danielle meets Constantine and it appears that they have a history together. She asks him to cut Nate loose. He refuses. Later he tells Nate to take a TV home to his mother. At the hospital, complications arise and Max's leg begins to get infected. Brett and Grace cut open the wound. Later, Stafford and Brett save Max.

Stafford is still pissed but he is glad that Brett took this chance. Max's mother is conscious and she enquires about her daughter. Grace then gets Shaw to take a look at the grieving Kelton family. She tells him that the little girl's aorta was torn out of her heart; he killed her. Max was about to lose his leg and the mother would require years of occupational therapy. Shaw single handedly destroyed the whole family. He tells her that it was an accident. But she tells him that he was drunk and so he killed her. Grace arrives home and she sees the television and wants Nate to return the television. Next, we hear news broadcast, that talks about Shaw's raid and Coyne's arrest. Constantine shares a toast with his friends in a bar.

Grace then confronts Franco. She now knows that the whole raid thing wasn't about cleaning up the neighborhood but it was about revenge. It wasn't about drugs; it was about Coyne. She warns him never to lie to her again. Cut to the flashback, we see that little Grace who had decided to run away, changes her decision as she feels that she has a home and a purpose. She returns home. Cut to the present, Grace confronts Constantine. She tells him that she will have Shaw arrested for the little girl's murder. She tells him that her mother doesn't need the gift but he says that she liked it. He then walks to his car; it explodes. Grace rushes to check on Constantine's driver. He asks her to walk away. We then see Franco getting a deep dish for Moretti.

He is alive! And Franco has been hiding this from Constantine. Moretti is upset that the bomb missed and the people who he helped are now rattling around Constantine. Franco assures him that they will come around. Moretti decides that he will kill Constantine.

She then tells him that there is a cardiac transplant case and so Dr. Baylor would be coming to the hospital. Just then Jimmy walks in with a couple of guys; her high school friends. One of the guys, Tony, stands on a table and greets Grace. He is drunk and he falls of

the table; managing to crack his skull open.

Brett and Grace tend the wound and offer to take him to the hospital; but Tony ignores their advice and he walks out with his friend. Grace receives a text from Franco and leaves. She lies to Brett saying that it is her mother. Franco's text was about a pregnant woman, so Grace picks some things from the hospital. Franco tells her to put her family in the car and get out of Chicago. Grace meets the pregnant girl, Tracy. Tracy tells her that the baby hasn't moved for two days and she is due in three weeks. Franco leaves saying that he has something to take care of. Grace does an ultrasound and tells Traci that her baby is a breach and so she needs to set him right. Tracy agrees. Tracy tells her that she is not a bad person. After the check up, Grace asks Constantine about what is going on.

He tells her that Tracy got knocked up by a politician and he cut in a deal to keep her quiet. Next, Morretti is shooting bottles and Franco arrives. Franco tells Morretti that he found Ralph Severino. Franco tells Morretti that Ralph is under FBI protection. They are keeping Ralph alive so that he can testify against Morretti. He tells Franco that there is a way to get to Ralph and he hands over the picture of a girl named Peggy to Franco and asks him to find her. Morretti says that Peggy is his ticket back to Chicago. In the bar, Stavos and Constantine watch the news which talks about the upcoming trial on Morretti which will put him on the most wanted list. David arrives; he is the politician who knocked up Tracy.

He tells Constantine that he isn't going to pass the gaming ordinance for him as he did not do it for Morretti. Constantine tries to blackmail him about Tracy. David says that prison didn't seem to knock the edge off Constantine. He dismisses Constantine's threat and walks away. At the hospital, Tony arrives to meet Grace as his head wouldn't stop bleeding. He needs to rush and asks Grace to help him. She takes him to a vacant room. She then staples his head with a surgical stapler. He is ready to leave when Rosa notices his jacket. There is a halo sign from the blood. But this means that he is leaking spinal fluid.

She tells him to take a day off from work and rushes him for a CT scan. Grace is in radiology when Brett arrives and tells her that Baylor is giving the doctor a pre-op brief. During the brief, Grace makes a point and Baylor declares that Grace just saved her patient's life. She then tells Grace that she is giving the assist on this one to Olivia and this does not mean that she doubts Grace's abilities. Later, Brett and Grace arrive to meet Tony and Tony asks Grace about Franco. It appears as if Brett doesn't know about Franco. Tony then asks them about his head. Grace tells him that the spinal fluid isn't his. She then asks Tony if he got into a fight and he tells her that he was out with the other guys last night.

Brett and Grace rush to the waiting room and they find spinal fluid running down Jimmy's nose. They rush Jimmy to the OR. Elaine, Jimmy's wife, arrives and Grace introduces her to Stafford. They try to tell her that there is a hematoma around his brain. But Elaine doesn't understand and so Stafford tells her that he is going to remove the blood collected outside his brain and if all goes well, Jimmy would be fine. Constantine calls Grace and tells her that Tracy's water broke and she is going to check on Tracy. Meanwhile, Constantine gifts Stavos a gold watch worth \$20,000, for his 15 years of loyalty. Franco manages to track down Peggy who works at a restaurant.

Grace asks Rosa to get her some equipment which is used for delivering babies. She takes Rosa along with her to deliver Tracy's baby. The baby is out and Tracy asks them to take the baby away. She asks Grace to tell Constantine that she wants her money. Grace calls Constantine and wants to know that truth. He tells her to stay out and that the baby is going to a nice Canadian couple. Rosa arrives and tells her that Tracy is bleeding. Tracy is unconscious and Grace says that they need to operate now. At the hospital, Olivia thanks Baylor for taking her as the assist. It is time to close the heart and Olivia says that she can do it.

But Baylor notices that the angle is off and Olivia makes a mistake. Baylor asks her to step away and takes over. Meanwhile, Grace waits for Tracy to wake up. She tells Tracy that she had to perform a hysterectomy and that she wouldn't be able to conceive anymore. Tracy now wants her kid back. She asks Grace to help her. Grace goes to Constantine and tells him about the situation. He tells her that Tracy is a call girl who got knocked up by a politician and she is getting her money. He says that she is playing her like she played the politician. Stavos appears worried.

Next, Franco calls Morretti and tells him that he found out that Peggy is Ralph's daughter and now he wants to know the truth. He wants to know the end game. At the hospital, Grace learns that there is an AVM (arteriovenous malformation) in Jimmy's brain; it is sort of a time bomb inside his head which has a 10% chance of rupturing. Elaine is rude with Grace but she says that they don't want to operate as the surgery could cause a stroke, loss of speech or blindness. So they decide to go with the remaining 90%. Baylor tells Grace that thanks to Olivia, her patient would never speak again. Grace then goes to check on Tracy. She also hands her a plane ticket and asks her to leave with her baby and never come back.

Next, Constantine meets David and hands over an envelope with the baby's hair in it. He asks David to change his mind; else he will call a press conference and invite David's wife. Grace puts Tracy in a car and the car leaves. Franco arrives and sees that he is a little late. Next, Morretti enters Peggy's apartment and holds a gun at her. He asks her to call Ralph through her laptop.

Ralph is shocked to see Morretti and Morretti tells him about the gun he placed in his drawer. He tells Ralph to take the gun and shoot himself; else he would kill his daughter in front of him. Ralph shoots himself.

Morretti leaves. Constantine arrives to meet Grace. He gives her the money she spent for the plane ticket. After all, he is not that bad a person! Next, the news says that David has changed his stance on the ordinance. But Stavos and Constantine don't believe the report that says Ralph killed himself. All charges against Morretti have been dropped. Morretti tells Franco that it is time to reclaim what is his.

Brett is looking at a scan of his patient Will Jamison and he sees that there is an intestinal blockage; the problem is he doesn't know what is causing it. Olivia seems to know his patient's history. She says that she

had some downtime and so she took a look at the reports that were there in surgery.

Brett tells her that she is trying to impress Stafford with her diagnostic skills after a botched surgery. Grace is about to perform the transplant when Sara is stricken with fever. Stafford says that they cannot perform the transplant till the time they rule out infection. Grace tells them that this is Sara's last chance but the seniors don't give a go ahead for the operation. The heart then is rerouted to someone else. Brett is attending to Will and he suggests that they need to operate on Will. His parents are troubled on hearing about another operation. Will's younger brother, Ethan tries to plug a cord and he gets a shock. Brett puts him under Olivia's care. Sara wakes up and Grace tells her that they will find her another heart.

Grace then sees that she has three missed calls from Constantine. She calls him and he tells her to visit a friend in prison who has a unique medical situation. She goes to meet Eddie Nolan

and he says that he knows everything about her as he was Constantine's cell mate. He says that he faked a chest pain. He tells her that Sara Anderson is his daughter. He wants Grace to kill him so that Sara can get his heart. No way is she doing this. She fights with Constantine. Olivia notices that there is something not right about Ethan's leg and she wants to take his parent's permission to run some tests. Grace tells Sara that ALVAD is the next best option till the time they get a new heart.

Grace then asks her if there is someone she could call, but Sara tells her that her parents are dead. Olivia readies Ethan for a CT scan. But he refuses to let her touch his foot as it has been paining terribly since the time he got zapped. She removes his shoe and they are shocked to see that Ethan's foot is completely twisted. Next, Constantine asks Nate to step up and ask to convince the bar owners in the neighborhood to buy the video poker machines he is selling. Next we see that Eddie gets himself admitted in the hospital by faking chest pains. He has been assigned to Grace. Grace goes to examine him. He once again tells her to kill him by slipping a particular drug so that he can kill himself.

He tells her that Sara was an excellent student and he wants to do something for her. Next, Grace is operating on Sara and getting the ALVAD to activate. But the aorta tears and there is bleeding. Sara is crashing and they need to go on by-pass. But Grace suggests a pericardial graft. Nate manages to convince two bar owners to take the poker machines by reminding them of their debts they owe Constantine. Sara is out of surgery but the left ventricle is over powering the right causing fluids to accumulate around the heart. There is nothing much Grace can do. She goes to meet Eddie and tells him that his daughter is dying and she can't stop it. But she can let him meet her. She also tells him that she is not going to play God.

Sara knows that she is going to die and Grace tells her that she knows the truth about her father. Sara doesn't want to see him. Meanwhile, Olivia notices that Will's intestine and Ethan's body are twisting in a similar manner and she feels that it could be related and caused due to some genetic defect. Brett leaves to get a chromosome mapping done. Nate goes to the third bar owner but he ends up calling policeman, Sergeant Tavares, who badly beats up Nate. They tell them that they need to implant a device in Ethan's brains which will control his movements.

They wouldn't have suggested it if it weren't the best option. The parents agree. Sara wakes up and learns that her father's heart is beating inside her. She tells Grace that she will turn her in for this and Grace says that she will accept the consequences. She wants to know why Grace didn't listen to her. Grace says that after all that Eddie did, he came through for his daughter. At home, Grace tends to Nate's wounds. Grace has an idea how this could have happened. She knows that all this might be freaking out their mother. Next, we are taken to the flashback where Grace's voiceover tells us that when her mother returned from her weekend away, he father started drinking again.

Grace knew that her father chose not to be a good father. As much as Grace hated the man, she never stopped wishing that he would reach down to her, pick her up and make her fly. Cut to the present, Grace arrives to meet Constantine and says that he missed their meeting today. He says that he felt better. She knows that Constantine set up Eddie's shooting. But he points out that all ended well for everyone.

Stafford is trying to remove the cyst and he sees that it is leaking fluid; it must have ruptured. He successfully manages to get the cyst out. At home, Grace bandages her wound and Brett calls.

Constantine arrives at her house and she tells Brett that she will talk to him later. He is pissed and hangs up on her. He tells her that Franco and Morretti are dead men and he wants her to

stay put till that is done. He tells her that he had promised that he will protect her and he will keep his promise. He has kept one of his men to watch the house.

Flannigan arrives and pulls Grace out for a surgical consult. But it turns out that he asks her to attend to Miss Evans, who keeps coming back to the hospital for drugs. Grace attends to her and we learn that she has come to the hospital 81 times and Grace recommends her to a de-addiction center. Nate calls Grace as he has an emergency. Grace arrives to meet Nate and she learns that Nate and his friend Victor are holding a pure bred race horse for his sperm, which could fetch them a hundred grand. So they fed the horse with couple of Viagra and now the erection wouldn't come down. To top it all, the horse has to race the next day and the horse actually belongs to Tommy; a man one wouldn't mess with. Ro gets some meds from the hospital and Grace feeds them to the horse.

Next, Titus arrives to meet Constantine and tells him that there are some manufacturing delays and that he would get the remaining gaming machines to him by the end of the week. Somehow, Constantine is not too convinced. Brett tells Grace that he hadn't seen his brother since his mother's funeral and that he and his father don't see eye to eye. Grace heads for Jack's surgery. After the surgery, Stafford is unsure about Jack's progress and so he wants Brett and Grace to talk to Caral, Jack's boss, who witnessed the accident and learn what exactly happened. Flannigan assigns Miss Evans to Wilcox and Wilcox prescribes the drug Evans asks for. Later, Grace and Brett meet Caral Goodman, the woman who saw the accident, Mark, Brett's father and Annabelle, Jack's wife.

Goodman tells them that she did not actually witness it; she heard the noise and came running out. Brett tells them that since the accident took place outside the courthouse, they could take a look at the security footage. Celeste tells Constantine that the bomb used to attack Constantine was used to blow up a diner couple of years back. Stavos knows about the case as he consulted on the same. He tells Constantine that their old friend, Jimmy Niggles made that bomb. Next, Grace, Brett and Stafford watch the security footage and Grace points out that Jack lost consciousness before he met with the accident and not the other way around. They ask the family if Jack had been travelling and Caral Goodman tells Brett about one recent trip that Jack made.

Nate calls Grace and tells her that the horse has gone violent after the meds and he cannot be controlled. Grace hurries to meet Nate. Brett tells Annabelle that Jack's condition is deteriorating and that if they don't find out the actual cause, he could die. Grace goes to check on the horse. She is about to inject the horse with some meds but Nate and Victor stop her as the horse is going to be tested for drugs and they don't want any trouble. She asks for ice; a non-invasive way to bring down the erection. Wilcox performs the abdominal CT on Evan and finds out that this time she really is having acute thrombosis and might need surgery. Grace missed it and she caught it; that's all that matters. Constantine has Jimmy tied to a table.

Jimmy is badly beaten up and he tells Constantine that the Amato brothers are the ones who hired him. Nate and Victor get into a tiff and Victor draws his gun at him. Grace intervenes and Victor backs off and leaves. Grace reprimands Nate for his foolishness and tells him that instead of attending to Jack, she is here dealing with his mess; once again! At the hospital, Grace notices something weird on Jack's chest and Brett sees that it is a tattoo; and it says 'Caral'. Brett confronts Caral and asks if she was having an affair with his brother. She admits to it and Brett finds it weird as she has been seeing Jack since the time he was a kid. It is a UV tattoo and she tells him that Jack got the tattoo done in Barbados.

The tattoo is infected. Caral wants Brett to save Jack and tells him that Jack never wanted to marry Annabelle. Also, after Brett left, everything that Mark wanted for Brett is now on Jack and so Jack pulls the strings on Jack's decisions. Next, Constantine pays the Amato brothers a visit. Titus tells him that he did not do anything as he needs Constantine for his business. It turns out that his brother Dante, hired Jimmy to build the bomb. Constantine shoots Dante and Titus assures him that he did not know about this. Constantine tells him that he is going to absorb Dante's shares and also that they would continue doing business together. Titus agrees. At the hospital, Brett suggests that Jack could be suffering from botulism and his diagnosis turn out to be right.

And later, Stafford tells Brett that Jack is responding to the antidotes. Brett tells Grace that his mother had a lump in her breast and it was cancerous. But his father told her to delay her chemo for five weeks for his work purposes, so that the media wouldn't accuse him of being distracted. This killed his mother as the cancer spread to the lymph nodes. Brett continues to tell her that his father cried at the funeral and then made it to the cover page of Times, which is

now framed in his office. Grace now knows the reason for Brett's resentment towards his father. Later, Brett meets Jack and tells him that he knows the truth. He asks his brother what he wants him to do. Brett then tells the family that Jack's condition was due to some kind of corn infection.

Caral is relieved and so is Annabelle. Mark thanks his son for doing this for him. He knows about Jack's affair. Brett tells him that he did not lie 'for' him but he lied 'because' of him. Next, Celeste arrives to meet Constantine with a bottle of wine. Gio arrives and tells him that there is someone here to meet him. A guy enters and Constantine does not recognize him. He is sure as he tells the guy that he never forgets a face. The guy asks him to look closer; he tells Constantine that he is his son.

Grace suggests a treatment but Wilcox overwrites it and gives Stuart an electric shock to reset his heart rhythm. But that leads to a flat line. They lose him and Wilcox admits that this was her fault. Meanwhile, Constantine meets Trapani. He asks Trapani for a favor by helping Luke. Trapani agrees. Constantine learns that Trapani's girl is down with some flu and he offers to help by bringing in Grace.

Trapani agrees. The doctors break the news to Bethany. She is upset and tells them that she wants to meet Stuart. They tell her that Stuart had an extremely unstable heart rhythm

The episode begins with a man walking into a parking lot and gets inside his car. He then pulls out a gun and attaches a silencer to it. He then takes a look at the picture of his target; Constantine's son. Next, Constantine talks to his son and learns that he is into real estate and that he had borrowed money from the Nordalas Cartel, who is now calling in their private loan. Luke tells Constantine that someone broke into his house. Constantine asks Luke to stay at his place till all this settles down. But Luke tells him that he is not looking for a father; he is just looking for help. Luke leaves and

and they could not do anything. Just then Stuart wakes up asking where he is. Wow, back from the dead! Stafford arrives and Grace educates him about the case where there are no signs of infarction; the only thing is the cold that he has been constantly having. Stafford explains this as the Lazarus syndrome. Grace gets a text from Constantine and she arrives to meet him. Constantine takes Grace to Trapani's place. She goes in to check on Chloe. Trapani tells Tino that he did talk to the cartel; but they have already ordered a hit on Luke and they have given this assignment to Diego, a man who never messes with his work.

Trapani assures him that he would do whatever he can. Grace checks Chloe and finds out that Chloe had breast implants and one is smaller than the other. Grace points out that they are missing something as Chloe's condition is not improving. Just then the nurse tells the doctors that she is bleeding. Her urinary tract is hemorrhaging. They take her to the ICU. Next, Luke is taken to a safe place. But Trapani tells him that there is nothing that can be done as there is no cancelling of this job. These guys don't play nice. Luke is worried and he says that he wants to get out. Constantine stops him and tells him that he would save his life. Luke is not convinced. At the hospital, Wilcox tells Grace that she tried every test and everything looks normal. Just then the cardio machine starts beeping and they do an ultrasound. They find that there is blood accumulated around the heart due to excessive CPR.

They remove the blood. Next, Gio is at Eddie's magazine store as Luke wanted some skin magazines. Constantine calls Gio and asks him to go back and not leave Luke alone. Gio leaves and Eddie picks up the phone to make a call. At the hospital, Brett tells Grace that Chloe has a tumor in her prostate. What? But he doesn't want to stay with him in his house; he is going to check into a hotel. Constantine is glad that Luke is at least planning to stick around. Constantine leaves to take care of some business; he says he is going to the Devlin's. Stavos hears for the cartel's lawyer and looks like it is not good news. Constantine walks into a bar and leaves his phone in the car. Stavos tries to call him but is unable to reach Constantine. He leaves a voice message in which he tells Constantine that

Trapani did not talk to the cartel and there was no truce that was supposed to take place.

The cartel is now pissed that Constantine took down their man without even trying to negotiate. And now things are going to get ugly. The guys from the cartel arrive at the bakery and open fire. Gio and two others are killed. They catch hold of Stavos and ask him about Constantine's whereabouts. They shoot his leg and press down on the wound real bad. Constantine reaches Grace's house and he talks to her mother.

He tells her that they should tell Grace everything before she finds out on her own. Just then a van passes by and opens fire on both of them and drives by. Grace rushes to the door and finds Constantine and her mother lying on the doorstep; both shot and both of them are not moving. She cries for help.

Grace's world is reeling and she confronts her mother who has just regained consciousness.

Her mother admits to the fact that Constantine is her father. Nate is shocked. Stafford talks to Constantine about Grace. He asks Constantine to leave her alone; else he would end up ruining her career. Franco calls Grace and she tells him about Ro's slip of tongue. Franco tells her that all she needs to tell York is "I don't know". Just then Franco receives a message from York asking him to meet immediately. Nate forgives his mother and he knows that Grace will too once she stops freaking out. Just then she has some sort of an attack. Later, when Grace arrives Ro tells her about her mother and she rushes to her mother's bed. Brett tries to keep her away. He tells her that she suffered from lipid embolism and there was no rhythm; they could not do anything. She is gone.

Grace is shattered. She goes to Constantine and blames him for her mother's death. She tells him that she is going to tell the FBI whatever she knows. Grace is pissed.

She tells him that she does not want any of this. He tells her that she has no choice. He knows that it is his blood running through her veins and all this comes naturally to her. No one could have pulled off the meeting as well as she did. And there is no way out. Constantine dozes off under the effects of the sedative. Grace then picks up the insulin and injects a heavy dose into the IV. We then see that the monitors show a flat line. The King falls. Grace walks and finds Nate waiting to meet Constantine.

She tells him that he is resting and also that she is done. Nate finds it weird. She then walks towards the exit. She passes Ro, Stafford, Brett and York. Outside, Franco is waiting for Grace. She gets into the car and he asks her if she is ready to do this. She says that she is ready as now they are going to deal with this together. They kiss. Franco starts the car and drives away; to Mexico!
