Summary: A murder on Moonhaven puts Earth's last hope in jeopardy; during what should be a routine cargo loop to the moon, pilot Bella finds herself the subject of detective Paul Sarno's investigation.



Far into the future, the earth is dying and taking humanity with it. On a last-chance mission, settlers are sent to the moon with the most powerful artificial intelligence, to try and solve the problems on the earth and save humanity.

After three decades, they've built a functioning haven for humanity, and now it's time to bring it home.

A young woman, Chill, runs through a forest away from a tall man who wants the lighted flower she's using to guide her way. He takes the flower from her, and

she begs him to let it go and not make this mistake. When he refuses, Chill takes the flower and runs off into the woods again.

In the daylight, police officers Arlo and Paul talk about their wives and children. Arlo claims that putting his bare feet in the dirt and reminding himself of how small he is, makes all his problems seem less important. Eventually, the two men find Chill Spen dead, laying in the grass.

The men easily solve Chill's death using the Chancellor device. Strego Nall is the tall man who killed her. Leaving the crime scene, Arlo and Paul run into Asus, a young girl who claims to have been drawn to Chill by the dreadfeel, which allows her to feel the last feelings of the dead.

On Earth in 2201, only two weeks remain until the first wave of Lunars return to the planet, with solutions designed by IO, the AI who is buried on the moon. Indira Mare, the envoy of IO, promises that the technology coming from the moon will solve all of Earth's problems.

Elsewhere in the early morning Pilot Bella Sway wakes and gets ready to head out on a cargo flight, with extra passengers she didn't expect, including Indira Mare. Tomm, muscle hired for her flight, is there to protect the envoy of IO and trusts Bella because of her violent past.

On what has quickly become a very different mission, Bella video chats with Jatey, and reveals she's on a secret mission to retrieve a Singer, a drug that claims to blow open the doors of your perception. It will be smuggled from the moon to Bella by a Lunar, and then to Earth by her.

Back on the moon, Arlo and Paul interview Strego Nall, who is found guilty after the Chancellor shows the footage of him murdering Chill Spen. When Paul tries to empathize with Strego, he head-butts him and takes off. The officers know he can't escape, so they leave him to run.

On the spacecraft, Bella wakes Tomm and Indira, and Indira is dedicated to her cause of ending suffering with the help of IO and the lunars. At the Glade, where the Lunars live, Tomm and Indira invite Bella off the ship, but she refuses. Indira is greeted with singing and celebration.

In the Glade, council chair Maitie greets Indira and shows her around paradise. While Maitie claims that those who serve IO serve the world, Indira is convinced that IO serves the people, not the other way around. On the ship, Bella receives her delivery in the shape of a pelican egg.

As she inspects the egg and the drug inside of it, Arlo and Paul knock on the side of her ship and ask to come inside. They tell Bella she needs to come with them, and she reluctantly agrees, surprised by the Utopia she passes on the way to the police station.

Arlo and Paul question Bella about her mother, who left her behind to become a Lunar after Bella was gone. As it turns out, Chill Spen — the woman who was murdered, was her younger sister. Bella is unimpressed by this news and mocks Arlo and Paul for trying to help her grieve.

As much as Bella tries to act as if she doesn't care about Chill Spen, finding out that her mother died ten years ago shakes her a bit. As Arlo and Paul begin a dance of grief for her, Bella is rescued by Tomm, and she doesn't tell him the real reason she was pulled in for questioning.

Bella and Tomm discuss how different the Lunars are from the people of Earth. She's sure that the two societies can't coexist, even when Tomm reminds her the work is being done for the children and the future. Bella is convinced that darkness will always find a way.

Out in the forest, Strego Nall finds a Lunar device that was hidden for him in the woods. After disrobing, he uses the device to cut out the spiral Lunar mark that rests at the bottom of his back. He's clearly in horrible pain but refuses to remove the device from his skin.

Back on the ship, Paul informs Bella that Asus, the sister that Chill grew up with, wants to meet Bella before taking the Bright, a memory eraser that will ease her pain. Bella is resistant to going until Paul tells her Asus has a message from Bella's mother.

At Asus's house, Paul prepares her for the Bright. Asus can spot the pain in darkness in Bella and offers the Bright to her as well, but she refuses. Asus tells her a story about Bella's mother and mentions that there was a third person in the Glade when Chill was killed.

Paul is sure that the Chancellor device would have found all people in the Glade since all Lunars have an IO satellite plant at the bottom of their spine. Bella is less sure and wonders if IO could be missing things. At that moment, Indira's speech from the moon begins.

Indira speaks about the future as people across Moonhaven and Earth watch. Meanwhile, when Bella and Paul head back to Chill's crime scene, Chill's dog follows Bella. In the grass, Bella finds a suspicious lunar tag, and Paul admits that something is off about the case he can feel it.

As they investigate, Bella spots a figure in the woods and takes off after them, Chill's dog and Paul in tow. Whoever left has passed under the gate at the end of Moonhaven, and Bella takes off after them. Behind the gate, Bella can barely breathe, but she watches as the escape climbs a tree before passing out.

In a meeting with council chair Maite, Indira tells her the council will swap soon, even though they should have two more years. IO has identified patterns that indicate corruption, and Maite must be replaced to prevent it. She's spent her whole life preparing for the bridge.

While Maite waxes on about what IO can and can not predict, Indira tells her she'll expect full cooperation during the swap and gets ready to leave Moonhaven. Disoriented, Bella wakes in Paul's Lunar home surrounded by his children and family and shares a meal with them.

Paul explains what happened and where Bella passed out and shares that his oldest son Wish will be on the first ship to Earth. Paul also has kept the secret of what Bella was chasing, and it's obvious that his lover is smitten with another man named Fritz.

Bella asks Paul about the girl she was chasing in the forest away from his children. She reminds him not to trust everything and everyone and prepares to head back to Earth with the envoy. Before she can go, Paul's youngest Elna does the grief dance for her.

While listening to *Me and My Shadow* in the spacecraft, an alarm goes off within the ship, and Bella finds Strego Nall hiding below deck. Strego shows her the wound where he cut out his satellite and tells Bella he no longer deserves to be a Lunar. She recognizes him as her sister's killer.



As Tomm enters the craft, Strego tells Bella that Chill called, and she answered. She instructs him to hide, but he comes to the upper deck anyway, claiming that when one world ends, another begins. Tomm, who was in on the whole thing, shoots Strego and tries to take out Bella.

In a violent fight, Bella struggles with Tomm and barely manages to shoot the drug she came to collect into his system. Scrambling away from a very high Tomm, Bella finds a worried Paul outside the ship. He claims he had a bad feeling and catches her as she passes out.

Summary: Bella wants to get back to Earth, but must wait for Paul and Arlo to untangle a knot.



On the moon, Indira meets with world leaders and discusses what they think happened. For them, it looks like Bella tried to kill Tomm, the envoy's bodyguard. The world leaders are worried that Terra, a terrorist group from Earth, is infiltrating Moonhaven and turning the Lunars against them.

Indira is sure that the Lunars are devoted to the future of humanity, and that the troubles will be resolved before the first wave is sent to Earth. She's also confident that council chair Maite will step

down, though she has so far refused. Out of the meeting, Indira looks defeated.

In a publicity video shown on Earth, a video explains why change is so important, and introduces IO, the solutions-based artificial intelligence that will solve Earth's problems. At the end of the video, a voice asks "what will the bridge mean to you?"

In the early morning, Paul wakes and finds his lover in bed with Fritz, the fireman. Taking Arlo's advice, he heads out into the forest barefoot and strips down, reveling in the smallness of his existence. When he returns, he talks to his oldest son Wish about leaving on the bridge.

When Paul heads out for work, his lover stops him and warns him of the danger Bella brings. She offers him her hands, and they "gleam," holding hands and expressing emotions of love to each other. Paul is surprised at the depth of love she still has for him, despite Fritz.

At Bella's tent on the water, she almost knocks Paul out with a chair and demands to know where she is. He claims he brought her there to keep her safe, but Bella is extremely angry about being imprisoned on the water. She lies to Paul about what happened on the ship.

Paul thinks that someone was trying to steal the Singer, the drug Tomm was injected with. Little does he know that Bella was the original smuggler, and she had nothing to do with Strego's murder. Tomm, who she assumed was dead, has been revived by IO though his mind is gone.

Frustrated, Indira finds council chair Maite detailing her flowers in another room. Indira explains that Icon wants this cleaned up and taken care of. They blame the escaping Mooner for the violence, but Maite is suspicious of Bella and claims there is no one to speak for the dead.

As Maite begins to sing again, Indira demands that she step down so that the bridge is not postponed. Maite, who holds one of the keys to IO, refuses to even consider stepping down and threatens Indira with leaking the trouble, sure that the mess belongs to Earth, not the moon.

Bella, who managed to escape her water tent, swims to a neighboring one and sails towards land in the boat left behind. On Indira's ship, Paul and Arlo investigate Strego's body and the mess left behind. Paul is learning to use logic, while Arlo is caught up in the emotion of it all.

Arlo is also sure that Earthers are dangerous and violent and wonders if this could all be connected to the death of Chill Spen. Paul wonders why Strego cut his satellite out, what he was trying to hide, and wonders if they've ever had a soul as lost as Bella.

Searching for her ship, Bella paddles around the Sea of Tranquility while Arlo and Paul investigate it in a small cove off the sea. Next, Paul and Arlo visit Asus and ask her about the relationship between Chill and Strego, who were in love before their deaths.

Asus admits that Strego often worried about the Bridge and how the Earthers and Lunars would cohabitate after the joining. She also gives the officers a carved box Chill kept for Bella. She warns them to stop thinking of the dead and start helping the living.

After landing somewhere in the forest, Bella witnesses a ceremony performed by the Lunars. When Paul and Arlo visit Indira, they find Tomm healing under IO's protection. Indira asks about Bella, and Paul reveals that he trusts her. Indira explains that true evil has never set foot on the moon.

She also admits that Icon is worried about Terra, the terrorist organization from Earth, disrupting the Bridge and slowing the futures progress. Wandering the forest, Bella is surrounded by Lunars, who say they mean her no harm, but she must stop running.

Once Bella has been brought in, Paul studies her memories and the information they have on her. He watches her history as a soldier and is shocked by the violence and danger she was constantly immersed in. Next, he searches her backpack and rewatches her initial police interview.

When Bella wakes, Paul interviews her again. He's found the footage of her talking to Jatey about smuggling the Singer to Earth. Since she lied and potentially killed someone, the council of Moonhaven will decide her fate. Before leaving, Paul gives Bella Chill's locked box.

At her trial, Bella stands before Maite and the council of Moonhaven. Sitting in a circle, Paul explains that Bella has confessed to smuggling, but there is nothing that proves that she hurt or killed anyone. Next, the council discusses Bella's fate and motives.

When the council is about to decide Bella's punishment, Paul steps up to speak for her. He admits that while Bella has a dark heart and has killed, been captured, and tortured, her mother and sister were Lunars therefore Moonhaven is responsible for her healing.

Maite is not so sure of Paul's point, especially when Bella says she has no connection to Moonhaven or its people. He convinces the council by claiming that if they cannot heal Bella Sway, how can they hope to heal Mother Earth with the Bridge?

Paul offers to bear responsibility for Bella's actions, shelter her in his home and make healing her a priority. Maite accepts Paul's charge and welcomes Bella into Moonhaven and Paul's family. Bella less than excited about the prospects, tells Paul she's joined his cult.

Paul is incensed at Bella's attitude and her lying. He calls her a coward, telling her that she owes him for lying and that she can pay him back by helping him save Moonhaven. Afterward, he takes her to a projection of her sister Chill, who has all of Chill's memories and feelings.

Bella approaches her sister for the first time and speaks to the projection. Chill recognizes Bella, although they've never met, and Bella tells her they have the same mother. Chill can't understand that Bella is her blood sister, and Bella apologizes for not getting to her in time.

At Pauls, Bella is an outcast and a dangerous one. Fritz, Lone, and the children keep well away from her, and she tells Paul she's brought trouble into his home. Paul explains that Fritz is knitting into his family because he yearns for Lone, Paul's lover, so he already has problems at home.

When Bella distractedly looks up at the sky, Paul can tell she yearns for Earth. Bella tells Paul the entire story of what happened on the ship, including Tomm and Strego's connection. He admits that there is an agent from Earth on Moonhaven, and he can't be sure it's not her.

Bella gets Paul to promise to let her return to her ship if she offers her help, and he agrees. Messing around with the locked box, Bella finds a compartment that perfectly fits her dog tags and gets the box open. Inside are Bella's mother's belongings, including a video transmission.

On the transmission, Paul and Bella find a recording of Chill before she died. In the video, Chill claims that the Bridge is a trap, and Moonhaven was never about saving the Earth. She promises her sister Asus that everything she did was for her before the video cuts out.

Summary: Indira tries to get The Bridge back on track while Bella helps Paul uncover a conspiracy.



A young Indira Mare begins to learn from IO, who tells her she's good at what she does from the start. She meets another girl, and they bond over surviving their Earth circumstances. Later, their class goes to one of the poison pools of water that populate the current Earth.

Using the technology IO developed, the girls watch as the poison pool turns into crystal clear water safe enough to drink immediately. Indira is excited by the technology, but her friend is bitter about those living in Moonhaven and tells

Indira that the strong will take what they want.

On an otherwise regular day, the school is attacked by Earther's after its technology, and students die needlessly. Indira's friend leads her to an exit safe from the attackers, and Indira realizes her schoolmate has been an inside man for the killers the whole time.

Paul arrives at Arlo's and wakes him to tell him about Chill's last words. Arlo doesn't believe Chill, and Paul leaves in much better spirits until he finds an apprentice waiting for him outside. At his home, Bella inspects the box her mother left her and watches the children spar.

Inside the box are matches, several coins, small drawings of flowers, and an oval black egg that displays Bella's mother's words and voice. The message reassures Chill that her mother loves her even in her absence. Bella is interrupted by Elna, one of Paul's children, and notices someone is watching her.

Paul wants to know who's been following her, and she worries that she's bringing danger to his doorstep. To be safe, Bella heads to see the Envoy. Indira asks Bella if she has any answers, and Bella tells her that Tomm is a double agent. Indira doesn't believe her, but Bella is insistent.

After, Paul's child Elna leads Bella to her ship, the secret she found. Inside, Bella has flashbacks to what happened and later delivers the Singer's pod to Paul while his apprentice watches. The man who made the pelican runs from his workspace after seeing Paul and Bella.

When Bella goes tearing after the pelican man, she's confronted with visions of herself and her mother, and the sound of a baby crying. When she finds the child, she can see it's herself after being left by her mother. Eventually, Paul finds her kneeling in the forest.

As they leave, Paul explains the forest is called Mirrorwell, and it's designed to stretch you in ways you don't want to be stretched. Nearby, they find Sirl the pelican man crying into a mirror. He refuses to speak to either of them, and Bella tricks him into seeking out his companions.

Paul sends his apprentice to follow Sirl, and Paul and Bella seek out the people who make the Singer. They meet council head, Maite, and her second Sonda, who are sure that no mooner would steal the Singer, while Paul notices that it must have been Maite who had them followed.

Convinced that Paul and the others are delusional, Bella tries to persuade Paul that not all Mooners are as real and passionate as he is, but Paul is loyal to Truelune and the promise of the future. He angrily leaves her behind, while she claims that Moonhaven will burn.

Back at the council, Maite and Indira meet with IO, and Maite denies the first wave of shuttles permission to land. When Indira meets with Icon, she's warned that the ships must be allowed to land, but Indira is reluctant to try and force Maite.

When Bella arrives back at the house, Paul apologizes and gives her the ship parts she needs.

She bonds with Elna while fixing the ship, and takes her for a ride while Paul naps on the dock. When he wakes, they're shooting through the skies and Elma is having the time of her life.

In space, they look down at Moonhaven carved out on the moon, before heading back to Paul.

On the way home, Paul and Bella find Blu beaten up in the bushes, hurt badly by Sirl. Around the corner is Sirl's body, and down the path, Elna has found a hideout.

Inside is a device for removing the Mooner's mark and hundreds or thousands of removed Mooner marks. Paul is noticeably shaken, and they rush to protect Arlo and Tomm from the army of deserted Mooners who will come after them.

When they arrive at Tomm's bedside, Indira refuses to leave for her own safety. She claims that IO warned them about all of this and Bella reasons she could have done the same just as easily. Indira reads her well and begins to tell her the story of her childhood.

Suddenly, Tomm groans and begins to wake, shouting he's coming, he's coming. Outside, a mooner is taken down by a man in a mask, and other masked figures appear in the yard.

Summary: On the brink of The Bridge, Paul prepares for some difficult goodbyes.



As Tomm begins to wake, the renegade mooners attack, and Arlo, Bella, Paul, and Blu fight to protect Tomm and the Envoy. A fire starts in the house, and the Envoy runs away during the scuffle while a masked mooner manages to grab Tomm and inject him with something.

Bella goes after Indira while Paul and Arlo haul an injured Blu out of the burning house, leaving Tomm behind. She finds Indira fighting off a rabbit-masked attacker who's trying to inject her with the same substance. Bella is ready to

fight him, but he disappears in a cloud of yellow dust.

Bella, Paul, Indira, and Arlo watch the Moonhaven fire crew put out the fire with IO technology. Once they get inside, Tomm is gone. Paul and Bella speculate about doubt ruining the first wave celebration that's happening tomorrow.

At the celebration, the first wavers hear a speech about the dangers and importance of their mission on Earth. As they're assigned their bridge placements, a first waver starts shouting about the bridge being a trap and claims that the earthers will kill them all when they land.

At the Envoy's quarters, Indira is shocked that many mooners want a separatist moon and IO for themselves. She opens up to Bella about Council Maite refusing to let the first wave of ships land. Then she pulls out Tomm's gun and calmly asks Bella to shoot her.

She tells Bella she has to believe in something and pulls the trigger using Bella's hands while the gun points at her stomach. Bella is horrified until the bullet is stopped by IO, proving Indira's point about how crucial the bridge is. Bella pledges to help her in her cause.

At home, Paul, Lone, and the children discuss Wish's landing place in the Sahara desert. Fritz claims that Paul is naive and that they know earthers better than they know themselves. Paul is upset that Fritz has infected Wish with his renegade ideas and is angry at Lone.

Fritz aggressively preaches that it's earthers who have attacked the moon and bring nothing but trouble, and Wish storms out as Paul tells his family that mooners are removing their marks and causing chaos. He goes after Wish, who tells him he's a fool before taking off.

Bella heads to Council Maite's and asks her about the ships. Maite claims that Bella came when she came when called. As she opens her office door, there's a painting of a flower identical to the one Chill was holding when she died hanging above her desk.

When Maite says she wants to know what trouble IO saw before the ships land, Bella tells her she is the trouble. Talking to Sonda, Maite promises that Bella is the sign she's been waiting on. She seems excited by the mooner's doubt and claims that something bigger is coming.

At Paul's, Lone tells Bella that Paul is at his birth-mother's last rites since she's dying. When Lone asks about the fire, Bella tells her the truth. They squabble over the differences between their cultures, and Lone asks Bella what more she wants her to give than her child.

At the Palmi for his mother, Paul speaks to her for the first time and tells her his name. She asks him about his life, and he admits his confusion over Wish's journey in the first wave. His mother reassures him that all children leave and that this isn't the first time Truelune has had a test.

Later, Blu brings Sonda to the Envoy's chamber. Sonda apologizes and admits that she begged Maite to let the ships land. Indira infers that if Maite won't act right, Sonda should. On her walk home, Tomm approaches Sonda, and they make love in the forest. Tomm now has one blue eye.

At the mooner police station, Bella shows Arlo the synthetic flower petal she found at Chill's murder scene. Arlo had someone make him a giant magnifying glass, and they see that the flower petal would once have had a base. Tomm and Sonda scheme over removing Maite.

Sonda is eager to know what Tomm's experience under the Singer was like, and he explains about the monsters he saw and the monsters who saw him. Sonda tells him he'll recover, but he claims the Singer was a gift, and their destiny is to rule together on the New Moon.

At the police station, Arlo rewatches the footage of Chill's murder and spots the flower, which he didn't see before. When Paul arrives, they watch Chill use the flower like a compass and wonder where it could lead. Arlo also shows Paul the missing flower petal.

Together, they deduce that Strego Nall hid the flower somewhere on Bella's ship. Arlo figures out that Strego let Tomm kill him, and he was trying to tell Bella where he had hidden the flower. He heads for the ship, while Paul heads to Wish's honoring ceremony.

Alone, Bella heads back to Council Maite's chambers and is startled to find her there waiting. She asks Maite why she wanted her to see the flower painting, and accuses her of working with the rebels. Maite reveals that the painting was made by Bella and Chill's mother Loa.

Maite also reveals that she and Loa were lovers and partners before she died. Until Chill died, Bella wasn't tagged as blood by IO and Maite couldn't find her. Maite has no idea how Loa knew Chill was her daughter, but she was a seeker and sought the places others feared to go.

At the first wave celebrations, Elna narrates a play put on by the children about Moonhaven's history and the rebellion caused by blood ties, and Wish admits to Paul that he's scared. Bella pleads with Maite to let the ships land, but Maite tells her others have found another way to go.

Bella sarcastically asks if there are aliens on the moon using IO, and Maite confirms it. Loa, Bella's mom was the first to contact them, and she hasn't returned since. As a giant symbol made of fire is burned in the space in front of the Earth, Bella goes to the window.

When Bella turns back around, Maite has disappeared. Arlo, who's been exploring Bella's ship, finds the flower hidden away and prepares to take it back to Moonhaven. Tomm, who's been hiding on the ship and waiting for someone to find it, thanks him.

In the Envoy's office on Moonhaven, Indira speaks with a member of Icon who is worried about the lunar resistance. He's sure that Tomm will go after both keys to IO, and Indira angrily assures

him she will find missing council chair Maite, who disappeared.

Maite finds a pile of dandelions that seem to lead her on her path in the forest. Maite and Loa found the first dandelions on Moonhaven together, and Maite imagined them as volunteers for the gardening cause. Loa worried about being a weed on Moonhaven rather than a volunteer.

While exploring Moondhaven, Maite noticed Loa's passion for finding new things and told her to enjoy exploring the forest alone. Loa passed through a tall triangular gate into Primo and went missing. Now Maite approaches that same gate alone and heads into the wilderness.

Bella goes to see the Envoy, and while she's on her way, Indira meets with Sonda, hoping for news. Maite was spotted going into Primo, and Indira doesn't want others to know. When Bella arrives, she explains Maite's thoughts on an alien race coming to the moon in search of IO.

When Sonda has left, Bella tells the Envoy about Maite and Loa, her mother. She explains that Maite believes the alien race can talk to IO, and Loa has crossed over to be with them. Indira implores Bella to remember what's real and what's not and asks her to find Maite and kill her.

If Maite dies, Indira and Sonda can give permission for the ships to land without her. Bella heads to Paul's house, where he insists they dance before work. He shows her a map of Primo, explains the changing environment, and agrees to go with her to find out the truth.

Before they can leave, Arlo arrives with his arm in one hand and the flower in the other. After repairing his arm, they discuss the flower working as a compass. He means to take the flower to the Envoy for safety while Paul and Bella track Maite. Arlo is excited by the discovery.

Tomm, Sonda, and the rebels camp out in the desert, and Sonda is worried to hear that Arlo has the flower. She's dedicated to destroying the bridge, while Tomm isn't so sure. In the Singer, he saw Maite dead and Sonda using the key to IO to let the ships land.

Out in the wilderness, Bella talks to Paul about Maite's thoughts on her mother and the alien race on IO, clearly skeptical of all of it and Maite's mental health. She's convinced that Maite is in denial, and while Paul wants to help her, Bella knows Indira would prefer Maite dead.

At the Envoy's rooms, Arlo shows Indira the flower, and she immediately demands they find out where it leads. Blu encourages them to destroy the flower, but Indira forces them to let her see where the flower goes, claiming IO will protect her. Arlo and the others join her, just in case.

Paul and Bella find tombstones in the Primo, left over from the rebellion. Bella wonders how Paul can still believe in Moonhaven after everything has begun to fall apart. He's unwavering in his faith, and regardless of his doubts he knows he's contributing to something bigger.

Paul is wiser than he looks, and tells Bella he won't let her kill Maite. As they wander, they find a commune of gazers living a simpler life outside the glade. The gazers claim IO has been restless and disturbed, violently spasming and changing things in the environment at a whim.

Paul and Bella open up about their search for Maite, and the gazers tell them shadowy forms have been seen at the edge of the woods. Zek, a gazer, saw a wild young child in the trees, someone different, the same child that Bella saw when she ran past the wall of the glade.

Bella and Paul discuss the child Zek saw, and while Paul doesn't believe it, Bella knows what she saw. She tries to convince him the child is real, but Paul has no faith in the impossible. When he asks Bella if she thinks her mother is still alive, she angrily walks off without him.

Meanwhile, Arlo, Indira, and the other mooners follow the flower past the gate of Moonhaven into the desert. While they're struggling to breathe, Indira approaches the tree Bella saw the child in with the flower and it lights up with a brilliant orange glow, growing leaves instantly.

After touching the tree, Arlo realizes it's made of the same composite as the flower. When a leaf falls and spells out their names as they touch it, Arlo discovers all the bloodlines of Moonhaven are kept in or on the tree, which could devastate Moonhaven's society as they know it.

Arlo tells the lunars to stay back, but at that moment Tomm arrives with a gang of the unmarked, who all have weapons. Since they're out of the glade, guns can work, and Tomm shoots one of the mooners and kills him. IO is angry at the violence and begins shifting the environment.

As the mooners and the Envoy run, everyone but Indira is cut down, including Arlo whose last glimpse is the Earth from the surface of the moon. In the forest, Bella and Paul wake, and Paul is full of dread. Maite is watching them as they wake, and beckons them forward.

In a flashback, Maite asks Loa (Bella's mother) what haunts her heart as she paints. Loa thinks leaving Earth was a mistake, and she admits that she left her daughter behind. Every night she dreams of Bella and she wants to go back to the Earth, which obviously upsets Maite.

When Paul and Bella follow present-day Maite through the trees, they come upon a massive cliff. They try to talk to Maite but she tells them the bridge means nothing. Instead, she claims that Loa has found a new way forward, that she is the bridge between past and future.

Bella tries to assert that her mother is dead, and Maite admits that she regrets doing what she did to keep her on the moon when she wanted to leave. Bella is flabbergasted that Loa wanted to return to her, and furious when she realizes Maite told Loa she was dead to prevent it.

Bella goes at Maite with a knife, but Maite claims this is the beginning, not the end. Before Bella can do anything, Maite lets herself fall backward off the cliff and into the mist. As Bella is looking down to where she fell, the child from the wilderness jumps onto Bella's back, tossing her over.

With Paul's help, Bella manages to hold on and drop the child before climbing back up the cliff. As they're fighting, Paul sees that the child has glowing eyes, and can somehow float and control her moment in space without assistance before she floats down over the cliff herself.

As they walk back to the glade, they run into Blu who hysterically informs them that everyone is dead. As they watch the skies the first ships land on the moon on Tomm and Sonda's orders. At Paul's house, Elna looks up at the sky and is excited that everything will be ok.

Paul is devastated, convinced Arlo must be dead, but the arm begins to move and points them towards the fence. Bella finds a hole under the wall, and beyond is an injured but alive Arlo. At Paul's, Arlo heals and tells Paul that IO saved him, and the bloodline tree needs to be hidden.

He and Paul agree that blood leads to blood, and it could weaken the foundation Moonhaven stands on. At Indira's lodging, Bella informs her that the tree will destabilize Moonhaven. Indira tells her the tree doesn't matter, and her only focus is the bridge.

Instead of agreeing to help, Indira suggests that Bella killed Maite, although she explained that Maite jumped into the crater. Indira also refuses to admit that she sent Bella into Primo after Maite and claims it's no longer safe for Bella to remain on Moonhaven.

There she finds Tomm, who's unworried about the Envoy's plans. He claims all the mooners will turn against the Earth, and he's sure that his people will soon control IO, protecting them from Icon. Tomm offers Bella a place in his army as the first wave of ships leaves the moon.

At Paul's house, he's finally honest with Fritz about disliking him, and he and Arlo tell him they think the tree is a test from IO to determine whether people are worth saving. At the tree, Fritz and the fire brigade section it off so that Mooners can think about what they're about to do.

In the forest, Sonda finds Tomm and confronts him about the first wave of ships. Tomm tells her the first ships need to return to Earth and that everything will be over soon. In Maite's office, Bella tells Sonda that she knows she betrayed Lune. She asks Sonda to stand against Tomm.

Sonda finally admits that Tomm shared the landing sites of the first wave of ships with Terra, the Earth insurgency group who will kill the first wavers when they land. Paul is beside himself with the news and blames himself for encouraging Wish to go on the first wave of ships.

Bella takes Paul to Maite's chambers, where they talk to Chill again. Chill admits that she once met Loa, who brought her the flower that leads to the tree. Chill hid the flower until she showed it to Strego. During the conversation, Bella has an idea about contacting the first wave ships.

To do it, they'll have to get onto CAT, which Indira has made into a prison for markless Mooners. Paul and Arlo allow Elna to come against Bella's judgment, and they find the markless cuffed and sleeping on the ship. Upstairs, they dodge Indira's guards, and Bella contacts Jate.

Jate is not happy to see Bella, who never smuggled the Singer. She asks him for help contacting the ships, and he promises to try. Elna refuses to leave the ship and stays hidden to listen for news of the first wave. Before leaving CAT, Bella spots Tomm, and he spots her.

Bella warns Arlo and Paul, but the markless Mooners begin to wake and arm themselves, preparing for war on the moon. Bella, Paul, and Arlo barely escape, and they meet with Lone, Fritz, and Sonda. Blu informs them that Indira was captured, and they fear the worst.

While waiting for the fight, Blu asks Arlo how IO could allow this to happen. He reminds her that IO is not their parent but their child. On the ship, Elna receives communication from the first wave they've diverted their ships from the original landing sites to a safer location.

While Elna is leaving, Indira is brought to Tomm and reveals she was in on the plan all along. She's been creating chaos to show the mooners real suffering, and she plans to take control of IO and take over the moon. Indira flashes back to being shot when gunmen invaded her school.

Elna hears all of it, and she escapes and makes her way to Paul, Arlo, and Bella to tell them about the ships and Indira's plan. On the way home, Bella decides to go after Maite into the crater and says she'll be back with help. Paul calls her a seeker like her mother, and they part.

On CAT, Indira worries that IO is against their plan. She tells Tomm about Maite's theories on beings on the moon who talk to IO, but Tomm promises her their safe on the ship where IO can't see them. At Paul's, he and Lone discuss their relationship, and Lone tells him to let her go.

Lone reminds Paul that he isn't his past self anymore, and it's time for him to lead. On Earth, Wish and his crewmates land on an unknown beach. In Primo, Bella lights a flare, and heads in alone under the cover of darkness, searching for her mother, Maite, and the moon's mysteries.
