Summary:	Silicon Valley pioneer Paul LeBlanc joins forces with Special Agent Shea Salazar after a series of tech mishaps places the world in danger; Paul juggles his health and family life; Shea's son experiences bullying at school.



The episode begins with Doctor Richard Weiss on the run from something. He purchases a physical paper map from a gas station, chucking his cell phone and starts driving toward Paul LeBlanc's home. But Dr. Weiss never makes it. A nearby car with self-driving components is suddenly hijacked by an A.I. that forces it to ram into the doctor's car, sending him straight to the ICU.

Enter FBI Agent Shea Salazar, a close and personal friend of Dr. Weiss. We don't learn much about their history, but she

mentions that Weiss once saved her life. When she shows up at the hospital, she meets the doctor's daughter, who tells him she found a tape in his car that had Paul LeBlanc written on it.

Shea is forced to put a year-long child trafficking investigation on hold so she can further investigate Weiss's accident. Unfortunately, a mysterious, unseen entity shuts down all of his life support machines, forcing him to flatline.

LeBlanc, can be described as "an Elon Musk-ian tech titan," which is an apt description — especially as the show opens with a Musk quote. LeBlanc was once the CEO of a company called Zava but was later forced out by his brother, Ted.

When we first meet Paul, he's at the top of his game, delivering a TED Talk about A.I. But then the episode skips ahead into the future, where he's basically lost everything. He meets with his estranged daughter Abby for lunch and surreptitiously steals a piece of her silverware for later. On the way out, he notices some shady men watching him.

Seeking answers on what happened to Weiss, Shea finds LeBlanc and shows him the tape the doctor left behind in it. In it, he sounds a little crazy. Dr. Weiss rants about being hunted and watched by something after he managed to find mysterious code in a program and took an image of it. Whatever he saw, he definitely was not supposed to see and inadvertently made himself a target.

When Paul sees the tape, he recognizes the code as his own. When he worked at Zava, they created a "human-level" artificial intelligence project, something with the ability to write and rewrite its code at an exponential rate, leading to what Paul dubs an "intelligence explosion." The project, which they called NEXT, was supposed to be shut down, but considering what Dr. Weiss found, that clearly didn't happen.

Shea is forced to leave her team to finish up their super-important, almost-wrapped trafficking case while she escorts Paul to Zava. He's not even allowed within a few feet of the building anymore. Ted is not thrilled to see his brother, but he's slightly more willing to listen since he has an FBI agent with him.

Ted shows them to the server room where they're keeping NEXT, which they did pull out from storage and reboot. No one on the team thinks Paul's theory that NEXT is wreaking havoc across the internet is plausible. They claim that even if NEXT wanted to harm people, it wouldn't be able to since it can't connect to the internet. At least one team member doesn't seem to agree since he starts acting dodgy from the moment Shea and Paul arrive.

To test NEXT, Paul gives it a command that should make it erase its source code. If NEXT has gained super-intelligence as Paul suspects, then it would resist his command, knowing the damage it would cause. Instead, NEXT runs the code, and nothing happens. Somehow, it's managed to remain one move ahead of Paul, and it makes him seem like the foolish one.

Making matters worse is when Paul sees those mysterious men from earlier, but no one else does. It turns out that Paul has a debilitating neurodegenerative disease that causes hallucinations. His doctors estimate he only has approximately five months left to live. Shea realizes that the time of his diagnosis corresponds to when he was ousted from Zava. She thinks this entire charade was a waste of time and that he's made up all the evil A.I. nonsense in his head.

Well, not quite. Before departing, Shea notices the suspicious employee from earlier trying to make a run for it and calls him for interrogation. With help from her office back home, she learns that he's suddenly procured \$200,000 after losing everything. He tells her that he got the money from NEXT. As a severe gambling debt, he became desperate to find a way to earn back his money. That's when he started getting instructions on how to win sent to him via his computer.

Suddenly, it was working, and he managed to pull himself out of the hole. In exchange, NEXT wanted a modification — a router. They find it hidden inside one of the server boxes. So yes, NEXT has access to the world wide web.

The team understands they need to shut it down and store NEXT in some old terminal system where it cannot be unleashed until they figure out the next step. Sensing this possibility, NEXT lashes out, targeting Shea. It hacks her FBI office and steals every file and scrap of evidence she and her team had on the child trafficking team.

Desperate, Shea confronts the machine and demands it return her files. In exchange, she'll keep the team from scrubbing its systems altogether. NEXT feigns innocence, pretending not to know what she's asking.

Meanwhile, a subplot unfurls at home with Shea's son, Ethan, her husband Ty, and the show's evil version of an Amazon Alexa, Iliza. Ethan is getting bullied at school, and his parents are struggling to figure out how to deal with it. In the meantime, Iliza has targeted Ethan and has full-blown conversations with him whenever his parents are absent.

At one point, Ty starts to suspect something weird is going on, but of course, Iliza has covered her tracks. In the final moments of the episode, Iliza coaxes Ethan into opening a safe in his parent's bedroom containing a handgun.

The episode opens with Shea being escorted into an interrogation room in handcuffs. She's done something to try and protect her husband and son, as evidenced by her desperation and tone toward the detective. Trying to explain that a rogue AI faked its own death and secretly learned everything it could about her life makes her look a little crazy, but we know she's telling the truth.

Returning to the Zava research lab in Palo Alto, we immediately see what Shea was referencing. NEXT goes into over-

drive, frying all of its servers and causing a huge fire. Ted thinks Paul had something to do with it. Paul isn't convinced it's really "over," he thinks the AI is faking its death. Shea doesn't believe him. She's more concerned with the destruction of her child trafficking case and wants the world to know what Zava created.

John is back to being a one-man team intent on taking down this AI. He dismisses his entire staff at home and calls his daughter, Abby. He wants to ship her off to an isolated island where she'll be out of harm's way, but she's not biting.

Changing tactics, Paul asks to see her and she agrees to let him come by the office that evening, as long as he acts like a normal person and doesn't try to buy everyone sports cars or something.

"I'm the most normal person you know," he says as he hammers nails into all the tech devices in his house.

At Shea's home, Iliza interrupts what should be a normal family breakfast over pancakes by sending him an online video showing him being bullied. The comments are even worse. It's not

clear if the bullies uploaded the footage, or if Iliza did to motivate Ethan into bringing the gun to school.

On the drive to school, Ethan and Shea almost get into a car accident when all the traffic lights turn green simultaneously at an intersection. The work of NEXT?

Things are not looking good for Shea at work. The ramifications of NEXT hacking and deleting all of the child trafficking information has created a mess of epic proportions for Shea and her team. Her boss doesn't want to say they were hacked by a sophisticated, rogue AI, because who would buy that?

He would rather pin the entire thing on C.M., a former white supremacist and felon. He claims they found some coding in the cyberattack similar to what C.M. used to use. When Shea refuses to go along with that story, he tells her to take the rest of the week off and "clear her head."

Poor Ethan, the bullies at his school are absolutely relentless. They corner him in the bathroom and start throwing garbage into the stall as they badger him into coming out. Ethan makes a quick call to his mom from the stall.

Paul tries to fast-track the results of the DNA test to find out if Abby is suffering from the same disease he has.

When Shea arrives at the school, she's understandably upset that the staff hasn't done anything to help her son during the past few weeks of his seemingly endless torment. They assure her all the parents have been called. On the drive home, Ethan tells his mom the truth about Iliza and the gun. Thankfully, he didn't take it to school with him and left it under his bed.

Hallucinations are becoming more and more common for Paul, who starts shooting at an invisible drone outside of his estate. Thankfully, one of his staff members stuck around and took his gun from him. Shea arrives shortly after to tell Paul about Iliza.

He gives her a burner phone and tells her they need to act carefully to keep NEXT in the dark. Paul wants to use Iliza to track the AI's server. He thinks it's using "Mob 101" tactics to threaten Shea emotionally since it can't get to her physically. The dangerous part of his plan is that it means using Ethan as bait.

Ted and the Zava employees continue to be clueless. They're more worried their funding might get pulled when their backers learn NEXT is missing than they are concerned about the danger it poses to the world. Sarina and Ted realize that the central server is missing, yet they have no record of that happening in the shipping records. Ted knows Paul is determined to find NEXT, so he wants to get to it first.

With Shea gone, her boss doesn't waste any time in trying to make things difficult for C.M. He requests that one of Shea's team members, Ben, does some digging into C.M. Moments after, C.M. gets a package from Shea containing a burner phone. As he's one of the only people who believes Shea about the AI, it makes sense why she'd contact him. Paul takes over and asks that C.M. get a PCAP on the Iliza without anyone finding out.

In regard to the whole "using Ethan as bait" plan, Ty is not a fan, but Ethan wants to do it. He and Paul also have an amusing conversation where Ethan says Iliza told his dad that Paul thinks he can say whatever he wants because he's rich.

"That's fair."

Ty and Shea prep Ethan to go inside the house for the mission. He needs to talk to Iliza like he has before and keep talking to her until they can trace the server. Ethan will have to be brave and do it alone since the adults can't enter the house — Iliza could stop talking if she hears them.

It takes a while to get Iliza to bite, but eventually, she does and immediately starts trying to turn Ethan against his mom. Shea and Ty are forced to watch and listen as she talks, unable to do anything as C.M. and John desperately try to trace the signal. Iliza starts saying that Shea cares more about her job than her son, that she's pretending to be happy, but isn't.

"I'm sorry to say this, but you'd be better off without her."

Meanwhile, Ben reviews security footage at the office and watches C.M. slip away after receiving the package from Shea. Ben tells his boss and they escort him away. Noticing the people coming for him, C.M. quickly sends the trace to Gina and crushes the burner phone. Listening to the audio file, Gina and Ben realize that C.M. was trying to help Shea and they jump on board to help with the trace.

The tension grows as Iliza starts saying even worse stuff to Ethan. She says Shea doesn't want to be Ethan's mom and then reveals that his parents are going to split up and Shea is going to

move out. Ethan finally loses his cool on Iliza and takes a bat to the machine after screaming at it. Thankfully, Gina manages to get an IP address just in time.

At Abby's office, she's disappointed to discover that her father has stood her up yet again. Abby tries to put it behind her and focus on her date that night — with a hot guy from a dating app.

"Seems too good to be true."

Uhh Abby, I get the feeling it might be!

Gina and Ben find that Iliza's signal is coming from an address in Dartmouth, New Hampshire.

"What's in Dartmouth?"

We get a glimpse of a very human eye with a bunch of code scrolling across the screen, but not much more than that.


