Summary: When Bell discovers a dead body on his property, he suspects it might be linked to another unsolved murder. He enlists the help of Cammie, the local traffic cop, who begrudgingly joins him to find out.



The episode begins, and we see that Bellwether "Bell" Prescott lives with his mother, Millicent Prescott, on their estate in Boggsville, Florida.

When Millicent was trimming the flowers in the garden, William Moseley, Bell's pet alligator, who had escaped from his gator pit due to a hole in its fence, tried to attack her. However, Millicent scares Moseley away with a gunshot.

Meanwhile, Bell is in the bedroom with his late wife, Vida. Vida was killed five years ago, but Bell still hallucinates her.

As he collects his parcel from Checotah, a local delivery guy, Bell trembles from a panic attack. After collecting the package from Checotah, Bell notices something is wrong with the azalea flowers, and when he approaches them, he finds a dead body.

Bell calls 911 and tells Cammie about the dead body. Cammie Lorde, the town traffic cop, who issues tickets to speeding vehicles, tells Bell that she is not authorized to report felonies and that it is the sheriff's job.

Bell thinks the sheriff is an idiot because he couldn't solve Mel Doppler's murder case, which he investigated last month.

According to Bell, Bill Mason killed Mel Doppler. When Cammie asks for proof from him, Bell takes her to his barn, which he has converted into a private crime lab, where he has investigated and solved several crime-related cases without leaving his property in five years, ever since his wife died.

Bell then investigates the corpse and comes to the following conclusions:

1. The murder weapon was probably an oyster knife.
2. The victim had a toothache in the days before he was murdered.

Bell asks Cammie to remove the body from his property and send it to the coroner. Cammie explains to Bell that they don't have a coroner because six months ago, nearly every official in Boggsville left town when the mayor told them their paychecks were going to bounce. Cammie then informs Bell that Sheriff Grant is on his way.

We learn that Bell is agoraphobic, an anxiety disorder in which one fears places or situations that cause panic. He has degrees in criminology from excellent online institutions, and his mother claims he is a polymath.

When Cammie tells Bell and his mother that they are both suspects, Bell explains that the Prescotts may have been dredged, drunk, and some have even fathered the occasional bastard child, but they have never committed murder.

With the help of Darby, a former lap dancer who came to Prescott's estate to fix the hole in the gator fence, Bell deduces that the time of death was three days ago, meaning Monday night. Bell also finds an organic spike under the victim's shoes. In the crime lab, Cammie tells Bell that she is not from Florida but Detroit.

Inside the mansion, Millicent accidentally reveals to Bell that the body is Jamie Dykstra's, and she didn't mention it until now because she thought Bell killed Jamie. He then walks into his crime lab, where he discovers Jamie is somehow connected to his wife's case.

After dropping off her son, Tyler Lorde, at the first meeting of the Dinosaur Club, Cammie gets a call from Bell, who tells her that the dead body is Jamie Dykstra's and that they need to do something with the body before it rots.

When Cammie informs Bell that the sheriff got held up by an accident, Bell decides to take the body with him in his car. However, Bell has a panic attack and falls out of the car before leaving his property.

Afterward, Bell preserves Jamie's corpse inside the stolen ice cream truck.

Cammie informs Bell that Jamie was released last week from Grayton Correctional Facility after serving five years for robbery. Checotah tells Bell that he delivered Jamie a metal detector last week.

Bell has a hunch that Jamie was after the money his grandfather made by selling rum during Prohibition. The money is buried in coffee tins in Bell's garden.

Dr. Otis Wright arrives at the Prescott estate because Millicent thought Bell had a heart attack. While Otis is there, Bell shows him the corpse, and Otis confirms Bell's opinion as to why the dead body is blue: due to an oral pain relief gel.

Cammie goes to the Seagate pharmacy, the only place to get that oral pain relief gel. Kevin, who runs the pharmacy, tells Cammie that he sold a tooth pain gel last Thursday to Jamie Dykstra.

On the call, Bell forces Cammie to ask Kevin if Jamie bought anything strange. At first, when Kevin says that Jamie also bought benzocaine, Bell figures out that Kevin is lying by hearing the pitch of his voice. Kevin then reveals that he saw Jamie fighting a redhead wearing a mermaid t-shirt. Bell tells Cammie that the mermaid t-shirt belongs to an Okahoochee Springs employee.

Cammie refuses to help Bell with the investigation. Millicent encourages Bell to complete the investigation on his own, as Bell believes this could be his last chance to find the person who took Vida away from him.

We learn that Vida asks Bell not to leave the Prescott estate because they have a deal: if Bell leaves, he won't have Vida. But Bell decides to leave because he knows Vida is just his hallucination, and since she died five years ago, he can never have her. Before leaving the estate, Bell takes Vida's scarf with him.

Bell somehow manages to drive to Boggsville City Hall, where he meets Cammie, who agrees to go to Okahoochee Springs with him. They meet Arvin, who is a wildlife guide at Okahoochee Springs.

After pulling Bell out of the mermaid lagoon, where he accidentally fell, Cammie and Bell ask mermaid Kelsey some questions. Kelsey says she told Jamie she would wait for him when he was in prison, but then she met Arvin.

Kelsey was with her sister, and Arvin was in Orlando on Monday night when Jamie Dykstra died. Bell figures out that Arvin is a historian. Kelsey also tells Cammie and Bell that she suspects

Manny Galarza might have hurt Jamie because Manny took over Jamie's oyster boat when Jamie was locked up, and Manny didn't give it back to him.

On the way back, Cammie is excited because she interviewed her first suspect. Bell tells Cammie that Vida inspired him to raise money to restore the seafront. Bell then realizes that he dropped Vida's scarf when he fell into the lagoon at Okahoochee Springs.

After arriving home, Bell sees Vida, who didn't leave him, even though she said she would if Bell left the Prescott estate. However, Vida asks Bell not to break the deal again.

Cammie found out from the Florida Criminal Search Portal that Manny Galarza has a history of felony assault. But Bell refuses to work on the case, telling Cammie that he no longer has an interest in it.

Before running off the Prescott estate with his son, who was eating tomatoes in the garden for a silver dollar, Cammie reveals that she also read Vida's file, which says that Vida was a spoiled drunk with a brutal temper.

Later, Cammie goes on a date with Adam at Shucks Oyster Bar. Adam is a hedge fund manager who works for six months in New York and spends the remaining six months outside New York to avoid taxes.

Suddenly, Cammie sees Manny, who tries to run away from her, but Cammie catches him with weeds and arrests him.

When Bell learns from Checotah that Cammie has had Manny arrested, he visits the police station. Manny says that he was at Indian Bingo on Monday night. Cammie, who was on duty Monday night, checks her body cam footage. Instead of finding Manny's truck, they find the Okahoochee van in the footage, meaning Arvin was lying about being in Orlando on Monday night.

After contacting Okahoochee Springs, Cammie learns that Arvin only worked there for four months, and before that, he worked at SeaWorld for three years.

After investigating further, Cammie and Bell discover that Arvin Palanko was convicted of manslaughter and incarcerated in Grayton. Bell then shows Cammie a video, uploaded to the Florida Correctional Officers' Facebook group, in which Jamie and Arvin were in a play together.

As she drives to Arvin's house, Cammie tells Bell that when Jamie and Arvin were together in Grayton, Jamie must have bragged about Bell's buried treasure to Arvin. But Arvin gets paroled first, relocates to the Panhandle, and waits for Jamie to be released so they can both get in on the buried treasure.

Bell has a panic attack in the car, so Cammie gives him a vial of dirt, which she collected from Bell's estate, so that he can hold on to it instead of Vida's scarf.

When they arrive at Arvin's house, Bell points out an alligator breeding ground and tells Cammie that the spike he found under Jamie's shoe was a baby gator egg tooth.

After Bell finds the metal detector, Arvin attacks Bell from behind and throws him into the lake. Cammie then shoots and arrests Arvin, saving Bell's life.

Inside the police station, Arvin admits that he used Jamie's metal detector to dig in Bell's garden and damaged the fence, after which Moseley came after him. Since Arvin worked in Okahoochee, he had developed a soft spot for the gators, so Arvin decided to escape.

Sheriff Grant arrives at the police station and learns that Cammie made her first arrest, Arvin Palanko, for the murder of Jamie Dykstra.

At the police station, Arvin reveals that Jamie found out that Vida was having an affair. Jamie blackmailed Vida, and that's how he knew about the treasure.

Later that night, Bell confronts Cammie about who she is. According to Bell, Cammie is lying about being from Detroit. Bell makes the following points to prove that Cammie is not from Detroit:

1. Cammie didn't know about Niklas Lidstrom, who played for 20 years for the Detroit Red Wings, an ice hockey team.
2. Cammie has a tattoo on her wrist: "BMT," which stands for Brooklyn-Manhattan Transit of New York, meaning someone born near the Brooklyn-Manhattan subway line.
3. Bell also points out that Cammie uses a quad VPN on her cell phone to hide her location even though it slows down the internet speed.

In return, Cammie tells Bell that the vial of dirt she gave him was Tyler's cocoa.

When Cammie gets home, she calls her mom. Cammie is happy to hear her mother's voice on the phone. However, when Cammie's mother asks if the caller is Layla, Cammie ends the call without saying anything.

Bell asks Vida if she was having an affair, but she doesn't answer because Vida is just a projection of Bell's grief. Bell then tells Vida that he will find her killer.

Summary: Cammie and Bell do a deep dive into what Vida could have been up to in her final days. Meanwhile, Cammie receives a surprise visit from someone from her past.



The episode begins, and we see that Bell Prescott is having a nightmare in which he sees that his late wife, Vida Prescott, has been found dead, and Sheriff Grant tells him that he did it. Bell wakes up from his nightmare, and Vida asks him to believe that she didn't have an affair. Bell proves to Vida that she is a projection of his mind, so he cannot trust anything Vida says.

Meanwhile, Cammie Lorde is doing her duty when Sheriff Grant visits her and tells her two things:

1. Cammie is just the town traffic cop who writes speeding tickets, so solving one murder case (arresting Arvin Palanko for the murder of Jamie Dykstra in the previous episode) doesn't make her a true detective.
2. Grant warns Cammie to stay away from Bell, who Grant says is leading her down a dangerous path.

Millicent Prescott advises Bell to see a therapist after losing a chess game to Skramstad, an online player. According to Millicent, solving Jamie's murder case was a terrible idea for Bell because the case revealed that Vida was cheating on him.

Bell asks Cammie to help him solve his wife's murder case because he feels he has been working on the "wrong hypothesis" all along.

According to Vida's murder case files, after Vida Prescott got into a fight with her husband, she went to a bayou, where someone killed her for her expensive jewelry. Cammie believes that whoever killed Vida is long gone from Boggsville.

However, Bell believes there is an alternative possibility for why Vida was killed. Bell thinks the police officers wrapped up the investigation because no one wanted to discover the truth behind the murder.

Cammie agrees to help Bell solve Vida's murder case, but on one condition: she needs Bell to provide her with all the evidence from all the cases he solved, but he didn't do anything about it.

Cammie was sick of being the town's traffic cop, and now she wants to become an investigator. Bell agrees to Cammie's condition. Cammie returns Vida's scarf, which Bell lost in Okahoochee Springs.

Cammie finds JoJo McDunnough's lottery ticket among the evidence she collected from Bell and sets off to search for him. Cammie then visits one of her friends' salons, where she learns that after JoJo won the lottery, he moved into an apartment on the Northside.

Cammie puts handcuffs on JoJo when she goes to his apartment. With Bell's help, she finds out that JoJo killed his aunt Emilia McDunnough, who bought the lottery ticket.

Cammie also finds crack (weed) in JoJo's apartment, so she apprehends him and takes him to the Boggsville police station, where she meets Marcus, the father of her son. Marcus wants to meet with his son, Tyler, after abandoning him for a year.

At the barn, Vida tells Bell about her problems with his family. Later, Darby tells Bell that Vida was worried about him because he had changed after the death of his father, Indigo Prescott. Darby reveals to Bell that Vida came to her for help because she was lost and lonely, but she doesn't know if Vida was having an affair.

Bell has another nightmare in which he sees Vida cheating on him with another man. After Vida was killed, Bell reconstructed her last day, but believes he is missing something.

Cammie agrees to help Bell find out how Vida's last day happened. Bell leaves the property with Cammie, and they visit all the places Vida had been to on her last day.

Cammie and Bell go to a parking meter, where they visit Boggsville Family Clinic, which is run by Dr. Otis Wright. While Cammie distracts Otis by talking to him about the favorite characters of *Law and Order* Season 3, Bell steals the patient files. Unfortunately, Bell didn't find any files that prove that Vida visited the clinic that day.

Cammie remembers that there used to be a lawyer's office near the parking meter. Suddenly, Bell faints at the thought of the possibility that Vida was not only having an affair but that she also wanted to divorce him.

Later, at the Prescott mansion, Bell asks his online chess competitor, Skramstad, who is also a hacker, to give him the details of all the WiFi connections Vida was connected to on her last day. Skramstad gives Bell the details of 15 saved networks.

Cammie has to take Tyler to his karate class, but Bell wants her to stay and help him with the case, causing an argument between them.

Afterward, Checotah hooks Bell up with 5-MeO-DMT, which takes Bell into 15 minutes of psychotherapy, where he learns that the 15th saved network on Vida's phone is Sam Lund's WiFi connection.

Bell assumes that Vida was sleeping with Sam, but it turns out that Sam is gay and has a partner, Paul, and two kids. Sam then informs Bell that Vida was looking to rent a seafront apartment because she wanted to move out.

Sam calls Vida's father and tells him that Bell had come to him to ask about Vida. Meanwhile, Marcus visits Cammie's house and threatens to let him visit his son, or he will have to legally ask permission, which could expose Cammie's real name.

At the end of this episode, Bell is shocked to see Vida's father waiting in his room, who is there to tell him the truth about what happened to her daughter.
