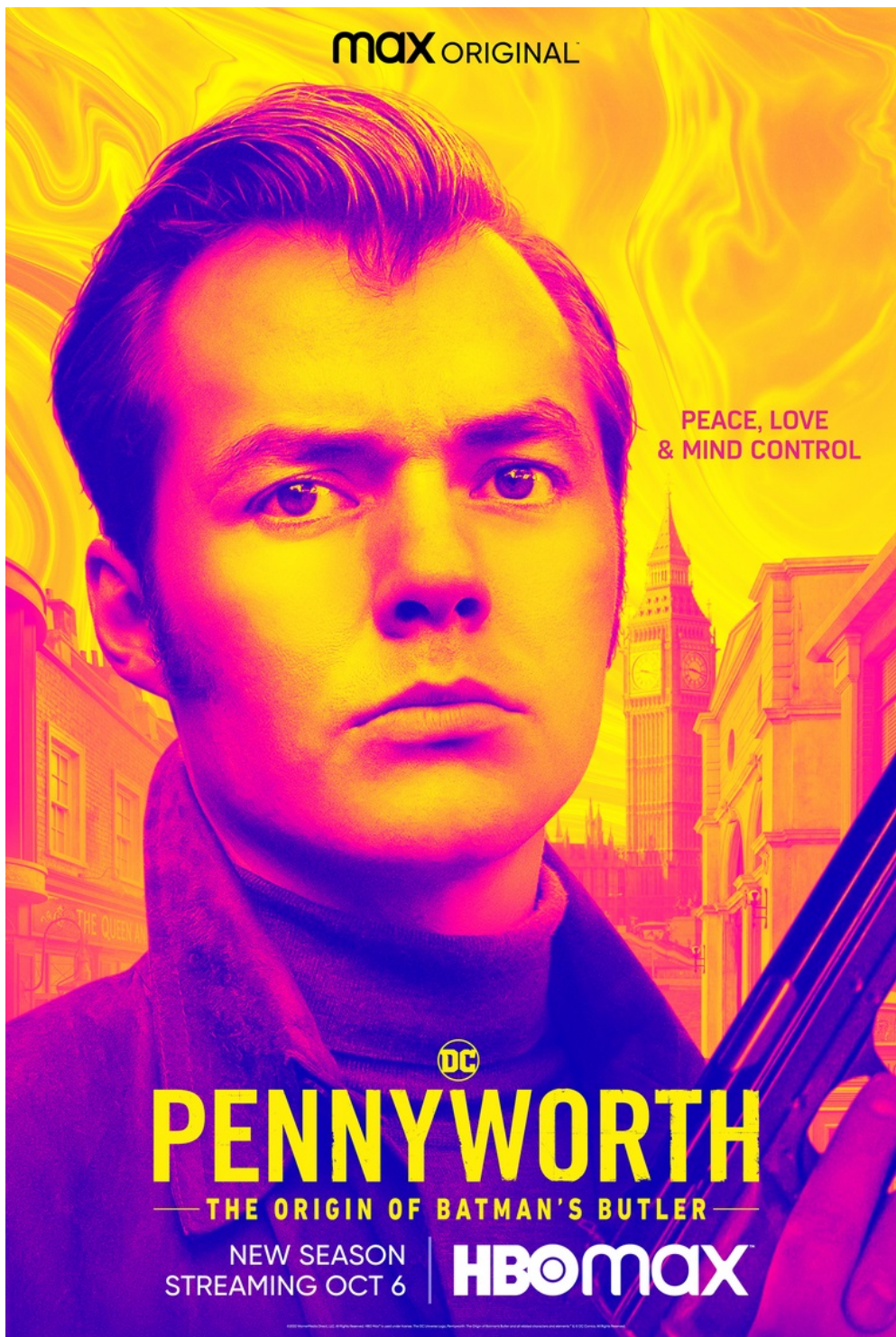

Summary: Alfred Pennyworth, a young man just out of the British Special Air Service and at loose ends, endeavors to start a security company. At the same time, Thomas Wayne offers him his first real job.



Lord Longbrass and a handful of his friends are fox hunting, when he is confronted by Bet Sykes, whom he tells to get off his land. She threatens him, revealing that she has been told by a higher power to bring him in, despite it being her day off.

Alfred Pennyworth is jolted awake with nightmares of his past as an SAS soldiers. Visibly shaken, he joins a funeral procession, wherein he and the rest of the men wear balaclavas. Dave Boy and Bazza reveal that he killed himself, and the SAS covered it up as a car crash. Pennyworth is happy that they are free of the

army, but he has started a security firm — despite being told he is too soft by Dave Boy and Bazza.

Alfred walks through London's town centre, witnessing the punishment of thieves and other criminals. At night, Alfred works as a doorman at a busy club. The manager of the club asks

Alfred to help settle a problem downstairs. The problem includes Thomas Wayne, who is trying to take his drunken sister, Patricia home, but she is being troubled by two men. One of the men pulls a pocket knife on Alfred, but he is able to subdue them by knocking the two men out. Outside of the club, Alfred and Thomas swap business cards, Patricia accidentally punches Alfred and Thomas takes full liability for the situation. Back in the club, Alfred is handed a handkerchief by one of the dancers, Esme. Alfred forwardly jokes that he will have the handkerchief cleaned and give it back to her the following Saturday, asking to meet in the park. Esme laughs, agreeing.

In the prime ministers office, the prime minister, abusing drugs, reveals the purpose of the Raven society and the no name league. He reveals that the government allow them to continue if they do not make too much noise. The disappearance of Rupert Longbrass, however, is causing a lot of noise.

In the basement of the Raven Society, Harwood interrogates Longbrass, questioning why he betrayed the society. Longbrass reveals that he became afraid of the Raven Society, but will not reveal whom he talked to about the society.

The next morning, Pennyworth is jolted yet again by flashbacks from the war. As he eats breakfast, his mother and father question him on the bloody handkerchief. Pennyworth reveals, to his father's dismay, that he wants to start his own security business. Meeting with Esme Winikus in the park, as arranged, Pennyworth reveals his history as a soldier, while Esme reveals her current affairs as a dancer and actress. The two enjoy watching a band playing, when Esme questions whether Pennyworth has ever killed anyone. Pennyworth admits that he has, but was simply working for the Queen, which, in his opinion, makes it alright. He laments his wish to live a peaceful life from now on. Pennyworth is surprised after asking Esme to play out some of her upcoming role in theatre.

Bet Sykes kidnaps Longbrass's presumed son, bringing him to the Raven Society and allowing Harwood to use him as leverage, blackmailing Longbrass to reveal the name of his accomplice. Longbrass eventually reveals this to be Thomas Wayne, and Harwood leaves Longbrass at the mercy of his torturer.

Wayne receives a call from his mother, asking about work. He reveals that he thinks that he has uncovered a fraud, and should go back to investigating right away. However, at that moment, Wayne is attacked by Bet and the rest of the society. Wayne, however, manages to escape unscathed.

Two weeks later, Esme is introduced to Pennyworth's family over dinner. She is left with difficult thoughts over their relationship after Alfred's father questions her over her father's job and her career choice. Following this, Esme breaks up with Pennyworth, fearing that they are from two different worlds. As the two go their separate ways, Esme is kidnapped by Bet Sykes, lamenting that he should call after he has Wayne in his custody and they can swap. Attempting to report the kidnapping to the police, Pennyworth receives a call from Bet, revealing that the police cannot help and the only way to get Esme back is to bring her Thomas Wayne.

Pennyworth is able to track Wayne down to an outhouse. He calls Bet to plan the exchange, which is to happen at dawn. He questions Wayne about the Raven Society, to which he reveals that he has found a large fraud connection that leads to a secret organisation, perhaps the Raven Society. Wayne admits that there will be no exchange, as they will kill both him and Pennyworth.

Sykes teases Esme about Pennyworth, revealing that he has quite a character. At the meeting point, Wayne asks Pennyworth to tell his family he faced death honourably if he does not make the meeting. Pennyworth reveals that he will do everything he can to keep him alive. The Raven Society arrive, only to be ambushed by Dave Boy and Bazza as Pennyworth realises they have not brought Esme for the exchange. Pennyworth calls Bet, asking again for the same deal but this time Esme is there. If not, Wayne goes to the US Embassy. Under threat from Dave Boy, one of the men reveals Esme's location. In the basement, Esme is able to knock Bet out, however, when trying to escape, she interrupts a dinner between members of the society.

At the society headquarters, Alfred tells Dave Boy and Bazza to take Wayne to the embassy if they do not hear from him within the hour. He enters the house, but is knocked unconscious before he is able to reach Esme. Harwood reveals the history of the Raven Society, attempting to recruit Pennyworth. Pennyworth agrees to bring in Wayne and join the society, if they release Esme first. However, he refuses, knowing that he will lose his only bargaining chip. Dave Boy, despite Pennyworth's orders, leaves Bazza to storm the society.

Pennyworth reveals that he knows Harwood would double cross them, and that he does not

like violence for the sake of violence. Pennyworth manages to gain the upper hand on Harwood, knocking him out and stealing the keys, freeing Esme. Pennyworth and Esme are taken home after Scotland Yard arrive.

Arriving home, Pennyworth finds his parents held captive by Bet, who wants to know Esme's location. Pennyworth refuses to give up Esme's location, but she knocks at the door, looking for Alfred. Esme, Pennyworth and his parent's are able to get the upper hand on Bet, knocking her and her security out.

The prime minister receives a call from the US Embassy admitting that the UK government has taken control of the situation regarding the society. He questions Longbrass on how the situation can be kept quiet.

Thomas Wayne reveals that he has been promoted to a permanent placing, and he would like Pennyworth to work for him. Alfred refuses, but Wayne admits that he is not easily discouraged and will be back. Alfred is awarded a medal by the queen, who asks for only his silence in return. Harwood is carried off bloody, presumably after torture.

Summary: Alfred turns down an offer from billionaire businessman Thomas Wayne and instead accepts an assignment that puts him in the crosshairs of one of the East End's most dastardly figures.



A man is seen on the run from a number of assailants, he is eventually surrounded and on his knees, when he pleads to the man, whom he calls "Mr. Ripper" to spare him.

At a downtown club, Pennyworth meets with Thomas Wayne, who asks for Pennyworth Security's services. Pennyworth refuses, at first, believing Wayne's work to be illegal and dangerous — angry that Wayne put Esme in danger previously.

A man is questioned over the leader of the Raven Society, but he refuses to give up a name. Bet Sykes is seen locked in a cage, questioning how she looks. The jailor sarcastically remarks that she'll have a bag over her head at her execution.

Pennyworth is dazed again by flashbacks from his days in the SAS, questioning what time Esme's show is. Esme admits that she hasn't slept well over fears of Bet Sykes kidnapping her again. Pennyworth admits that she's locked up, perhaps in the Tower. Pennyworth admits that if business doesn't pick up then the relationship between the two will more than likely end.

Pennyworth and Dave Boy enjoy a drink at the local pub, when Jason and a group of men enter looking for Sandra. Jason remarks that he'll wait for Sandra, much to her dismay. Pennyworth and Dave Boy watch as Sandra is questioned by Jason. When Jason and the boys leave, Pennyworth questions what the situation was about, with Dave Boy offering Pennyworth Security as the solution. Pennyworth is weary, much to Dave Boy's dismay, questioning if Pennyworth remembers who he is.

After Esme's show, Pennyworth is approached by an inspector, who asks if Lord Harwood named any co-conspirators. Pennyworth reveals that he did not, questioning the inspector over Bet Sykes whereabouts. The inspector reveals that she doesn't officially exist, and will be hanging the following week. The inspector reveals that he has information pertaining someone who may — or may have already — approach him.

Bet hands the jailor letters asking him to post them for him. The jailor tells Bet that he cannot post her letters, with her simply remarking that he shouldn't be having sex with her either.

Pennyworth is stopped again by flashbacks of the war, with Mrs. Pennyworth teaching Esme how to make bread. Esme asks if Pennyworth can come see her show again, however he admits that Pennyworth Security has a job later that night. He admits that he'll try to attend the show afterwards, but isn't making any promises.

At the local pub again, Jason asks to see Sandra, who serves him without saying anything. Pennyworth enters, mocking Jason, who questions who Pennyworth is. Pennyworth throws a drink over Jason and runs from the pub with Jason's men following. Jason threatens Pennyworth with a knife, admitting that he will let Jason walk if he promises to leave Sandra alone. Jason refuses, leading to Dave Boy and Bazza beating up Jason's men.

At the morgue, Pennyworth approaches the man termed "Mr. Ripper", introducing himself to the man and handing his business card. The man mocks Pennyworth, who remarks that he is making a gesture of goodwill and respect.

Esme sits alone at the afterparty with no sign of Alfred. Simultaneously, Jason is interrogated and abused by Dave Boy and Bazza, who make fun of him, calling him weasel. Bazza questions who Uncle John is, with Jason revealing that he is John Ripper — the famous Ripper of Whitechapel. When Jason admits to telling them everything he knows, Pennyworth turns on the lights to reveal John, who is angry that John would reveal information about him. John tells Jason to leave London and never return.

Esme receives a letter from Bet, in which Bet admits that the two could be friends if she were to ever be free. Esme is horrified by the letter, throwing it away.

Pennyworth and John talk about a deal with Pennyworth Security, with John questioning what Jason did to Pennyworth. Pennyworth admits that he will be trouble to John if he doesn't engage in a deal with Pennyworth Security. John questions how Alfred knew about John's weakness, with Alfred revealing that it only took a look. John questions if Pennyworth is stupid or clever, opening a trap door in the floor into which Alfred falls.

Having received a letter from Bet Sykes, which she discards, Esme is on edge when she hears footsteps approaching and someone unlocking her door. She is relieved to find it to be Alfred returning home from work. She shows Alfred the letter, admitting she feels scared and lonely when he is not around.

Peggy Sykes receives a letter from Bet in which she writes to say goodbye, revealing that she is to be killed the following week for something she didn't do; Peggy is visibly angry at the letter and deep in thought.

Alfred and Esme enjoy watching Sandra sing at the local pub, with Alfred picking up his reward for a job well done. Pennyworth shares the reward with Dave Boy, who is weary that they have made a deal with the Ripper. Alfred puts Dave Boy's thoughts to rest, however, admitting that he can handle John.

The Prime Minister questions Lord Harwood who the leader of the Raven Society is, with him finally breaking after the torture, revealing himself to be the leader. The Prime Minister tells the torturer to send Harwood to the barbers and break him, but keep him alive.

Alfred and Esme share a moment in which Alfred asks Esme to marry him, with her agreeing and the two embracing. Esme mocks if Alfred practiced the gesture.

Bet is dressed for her execution and taken downtown with a number of other prisoners. They are executed individually, with the ordeal being broadcast on live TV. Bet, however, is saved from

the execution by Peggy, having been replaced by someone else unbeknownst to the audience and the executioner.

Summary: Alfred accepts an assignment from photojournalist Martha Kane that turns increasingly dangerous.



The Prime Minister watches in disguise as Lord Harwood is tortured at 'the barbers'. Harwood asks that the Prime Minister be promised that the Raven Society will have its revenge for his imprisonment and torture.

Alfred is plagued with flashbacks from his time in the war while waiting to meet with Esme Winikus' father. In the meeting, Pennyworth asks for Esme's hand in marriage, however her father is weary to give such permission, asking about Alfred's past and his love for Esme. Her father denies the marriage on the basis that Alfred's past is not good ground for a sta-

ble marriage, promising to disinherit Esme if the two marry.

Esme and Pennyworth meet at the club of their first meeting. Pennyworth is angry that Esme didn't tell him of her wealth, however she admits that it doesn't matter, she does not care for her inheritance. Esme begs for Pennyworth to marry her regardless, however he refuses and the two engage in a heated argument, resulting in Esme handing Alfred back the ring he had given her previously.

Ian comes back from the shops to check on his machine and his lover Sam, who is still asleep. Sam awakens just before the machine Ian has been building is able to print the mathematical

constant Pi (3.14159) to ten-decimal places. This excites both Sam and Ian, who start to kiss before being arrested on homosexuality charges.

Pennyworth meets with Martha Kane on premise of a business deal with Pennyworth Security at Sid Onslow's bar. Martha enquires about a driver, revealing that they need to transport a man, Ian, who has a warrant out for his arrest on charges of homosexuality. After questioning whether the woman knows Thomas Wayne, she declines and the Pennyworth accepts the proposal.

Pennyworth discusses the deal with Dave Boy and Bazza, including the fact that — much to their dismay — he'd like to go alone on the mission. He is approached by Esme, who bids farewell as her show is moving and she will more than likely never see him again. Alfred wishes Esme well in the future, much to his own sadness, watching as she walks away.

The following day, Alfred collects Martha from Florin Court, driving her through the countryside to the police station in which Ian Thurso is being held. Martha and Alfred enter the police station under the guise of lawyers, remarking that they have been sent from America. The constable questions Martha's authority, with Martha revealing that Thurso has powerful friends. Ian, however, refuses to leave before speaking with Sam, much to the constable's dismay, he eventually releases both Sam and Ian into Martha's custody.

During a heated game of cards with Bazza and a number of other men, Dave Boy becomes angry as Bazza refuses to lend him money, eventually coming face to face with Phil, a man with a gun. Dave Boy pushes the man to shoot him, however does no, but accidentally shoots himself after Dave Boy hands him back the gun.

Arriving at an aircraft hanger, Alfred questions Martha's motives. Much to Alfred's dismay, she reveals that she works for the No Name League, but works with other entities on orders from the league. At the hanger, they are ambushed by the Raven Society, who take out the power making it impossible for the plane to land. Martha questions what they should do, with Pennyworth admitting that they should surrender, that way nobody dies. Martha, however, remarks that surrendering and allowing the Raven Society to get hold of Ian's work cannot happen.

Back at the card game, Bazza expresses his concern at Dave Boy's drinking, remarking that he is tired of Dave Boy's behaviour. Bazza tells Dave Boy to kill himself if he wishes to die, however Dave Boy admits that he doesn't want to die, but needs something to pass the time.

Pennyworth talks with the Raven Society, who wish to take both Ian and the machine alive, admitting that neither one is useful without the other. Pennyworth summises a plan, asking Martha for a 10,000 pounds reward. Pennyworth leaves the bunker with a gun to Thurso's head, revealing that he is under instructions to kill the man rather than let him fall into the hands of the Raven Society. The society leave, however Pennyworth realises that the society will never give up, but will be waiting to ambush them down the road. With this, they set fire to an old bus fuel to light up the runway, allowing the plane to land and Ian to leave the country.

Martha hands Pennyworth his reward, questioning whether he would consider working with her again in the future. Pennyworth admits that he doesn't think highly of the No Name Society, however he will work with Martha, only as a driver and will not carry a gun. The two arrange to meet again the following week.

Alfred reveals the new business opportunities to Bazza and Dave Boy, who both insist there must be a catch. They are surprised to learn that Martha is a 'No Name', but agree to work with her regardless.

Bet and Peggy eat breakfast, with Bet admitting that she's restless hiding out. Peggy remarks that London has brought nothing but trouble to Bet; the latter admits that she wishes to see Esme Winikus again, much to her sisters dismay.

Alfred, plagued by flashbacks to the war, goes back home to visit his parents. His father does not agree with how Alfred is spending his new found money, refusing to acknowledge the progress Pennyworth Security is making. His father instils in Alfred that he is still not good enough for Esme.

Alfred takes Esme to view a house he rents, hoping to win Esme back. Esme is confused at the idea as the two are no longer a couple. However, Alfred admits that he was scared of himself, but hands Esme back the ring, asking to be together again.

Lord Harwood is dumped in a field, having had both his feet and nose removed by 'the barber' as punishment for his involvement with the Raven Society.

Summary: Alfred and Martha Kane take a train ride into the countryside on an assignment, while tragedy strikes in London.



Pennyworth meets with Inspector Aziz, who questions Pennyworth's work with the No Name League. Initially, Pennyworth denies working for the league, but after he was threatened with hanging, promises to cease work with the league. Aziz asks why Pennyworth does not work lawfully for the Queen, to which he jokes about the salary.

Meanwhile, Thomas Wayne meets with Martha Kane for the first time, handing her the next assignment. Wayne reveals that the Raven Society protects the identity of the No Name League, and they must know the identity of the new leader;

Pennyworth and Martha must pay off an employee on the inside to reveal the information. Kane accepts the assignment, despite questioning the use of weapons, stating that the deal with Pennyworth exclusively stipulated no weaponry. To solve this, Wayne authorises Martha to offer Pennyworth more money as incentive.

Pennyworth and Martha meet at the Sid's pub to discuss their work together. Martha reveals the amount she is willing to pay Pennyworth for his help, only to decline, citing that he has a wedding to plan for. Pennyworth rebukes Martha for previously lying about knowing Thomas Wayne. Kane admits that she didn't know Wayne when he asked, but now works for him. With this, Pennyworth admits that the police have been watching, and it is now far too dangerous for the two to work together. Shocked by this, Martha offers to double the reward, admitting that their assignment is not dangerous nor will the police disapprove.

Following the meeting, Pennyworth returns home to find Esme pointing a gun at the door. Pennyworth tries to calm Esme, while she admits that she fears someone is watching them. Alfred suggests that Esme stay somewhere else for the meantime, until his work with the No Name League is finished.

Confined in a house together, tensions begin to rise between Bet and Peggy Sykes. Peggy expresses her anger at Bet's attempts to wind her up, but promises not to get mad. Eventually, the two begin to fight which leads to Peggy strangling Bet until she promises to behave.

Pennyworth meets with Martha and the two arrive at the train station to meet their man on the inside. When they arrive, however, they find the man dead. They take his wallet, finding three train tickets; which the two take, hoping that the Raven Society will be looking for them.

The two visit the 'Darkness Tea Room', hoping to find what they are looking for, given their associates last words "darkness". Over tea, Pennyworth and Martha discuss the former's relationship with Esme. Meanwhile, Mr. Pennyworth shows historic photographs, with Esme asking for help planning the wedding, to which he agrees.

As the tea shop empties, Pennyworth is held at gunpoint by the owner, which leads to her accidental death. Leaving the tea room, they are chased by the Raven Society. They manage to escape the initial chase, however are attacked by two more members, which they manage to scare off as Martha holds them at gunpoint. Martha expresses concern that their mission will be deemed a failure by the No Name League, with Pennyworth sending her to find a doctor. Kane is treated by Dr. Frances Gaunt, eventually passing out from the pain.

Pennyworth hands himself in to the Society, asking to see the leader. Pennyworth is questioned by the Society, however refuses to answer to anyone but the leader.

Frances reveals that she is aware of Martha and Pennyworth's mission to find the leader, admitting that she is the new leader. Francis admits that she cannot let Martha go, but must make an example to show she is not weak. Francis questions Martha for her name, admitting that she is willing to tell her family what happened to her. At this moment, Pennyworth is brought in, with Martha revealing that the Society knows everything about them. Martha and Pennyworth are able to escape, admitting that they don't wish to kill Francis, only to find her name.

Martha and Pennyworth drink, having achieved results without dying. Martha jokes that everything is humorous to Pennyworth, with Pennyworth admitting that Martha will more than likely be rewarded for the mission. The two begin to kiss, with Pennyworth stopping the act, leaving to return home to Esme.

Having left Pennyworth's parents to return to their new home, Esme is strangled to death, presumably by members of the Raven Society. She is found in a pool of her own blood by Alfred himself.

On their way home, Bet notices Lord Harwood on the sidewalk, visibly disgusted by what has been done to him, she attacks the boy keeping him hostage and rescues him.

Back at the Pennyworth house, Alfred's parents hold a wake for Esme. Meanwhile, Alfred lies upstairs, believing himself to be responsible for Esme's death. Alfred explains to an imaginary version of his former friend, Spanish, that his involvement with Martha Kane meant he was away from Esme when she was murdered.

On the streets of London, a fight ensues between members of the Raven Society and the No Name League. Thomas Wayne is stopped by a member of the league, Joshua, who reveals that the leader of the League wishes to meet with him. Thomas is blindfolded and taken to a secret meeting point where he meets the family of Undine and Julian Thwaite, the leaders of the No Name League. Julian reveals that the No Name League are losing the battle on the streets to the

Raven Society. Julian reveals that he is to meet with Frances Gaunt on terms of a truce, and then kill her.

Wayne meets with a member of the CIA, revealing that he believes that the No Name League are aware that he is CIA. He reveals that the league has asked for him to arrange the murder of Frances, to which the operative tells him to do, revealing that the CIA engineered the whole ordeal to take down the Raven Society.

Martha Kane visits Pennyworth, revealing that the League wishes Alfred to go back to work. Pennyworth however tells Martha that he won't engage in violence anymore, refusing to work with the No Name League any further. Alfred's visions of Spanish worsen, and Alfred begins to have visions of Ms. Darkness, the owner of the tea room killed in Lady Penelope.

Wayne meets with Bazza and Dave Boy, offering the two a job with the No Name League, with excellent pay. The two however decline the job offer, admitting that Wayne has changed and the two are not murderers. Despite this, Dave Boy enquires about the job after Wayne reveals the salary to be 1,000 pounds.

Following their daily runs, Mr. Ripper brings Pennyworth to the cemetery, revealing that the ground has settled and it is now time for him to pick out a headstone. Mr. Ripper admits that while Esme's murder looked like a robbery, it was not and was done to hurt Alfred directly. Pennyworth pushes for the Ripper to reveal the killer, but the Ripper admits that he himself doesn't know the killer. Alfred does, admitting that the killer and Alfred know each other well. Alfred agrees to do something for Mr. Ripper in return for his help.

At Sid's public house, Alfred enquires whether Dave Boy has visited recently. Sid admits that he hasn't been seen, with Alfred asking to borrow his shotgun. Alfred enquires whether Sid or Sandra have heard anything from Jason Ripper, however the two admit that they haven't.

Alfred enquires to Bazza about Dave Boy's whereabouts, who admits that he is working for Thomas Wayne as a shooter. This interests Pennyworth, who enquires about who the target is; Bazza is unable to give him an answer, however.

At a local restaurant, Frances Gaunt meets with Undine and Julian, the leaders of the No Name League. They discuss the love for their country while waiting for Dave Boy, who is undercover as a waiter. Frances is aware that the No Name League is suffering, given the size of the Raven Society, with Frances asking for the League's terms. At that moment, Dave Boy enters, killing the Raven Society's security, before being shot himself by Frances. Pennyworth enters, shooting Julian in the head, killing him instantly, much to Undine's surprise.

Inspector Aziz meets with the Queen and the Prime Minister, revealing that Julian is dead — more than likely at the hands of Frances Gaunt — and the No Name League is more than likely going to sink. The Queen admits that the Raven Society has done the country a great favour.

As they are watching, Lord Harwood begins remembering his past as the leader of the Raven Society; he announces that the Prime Minister must die.

Meanwhile, Sid Onslow watches the news along with Dave Boy and Alfred Pennyworth as Thomas Wayne approaches, wishing to speak with Pennyworth. Wayne asks what happened to Dave Boy, who sarcastically remarks that

he messed up. Wayne reveals his anger towards Alfred, who killed Julian, questioning who he was working for. Wayne reveals that he is aware that John Ripper and Julian have become close, as Pennyworth demands to be left alone. As Wayne leaves, Pennyworth reveals to Dave Boy that Wayne is a CIA member posing as a member of the No Name League.

Pennyworth visits John Ripper, demanding to know the name of Esme Winikus' killer, but John sends Pennyworth to see the Baroness at the Bethlehem Royal Hospital to seek the answers he is looking for. At the hospital, Pennyworth is able to gain an audience with the Baroness by revealing that John Ripper sent him. Pennyworth is shocked to see the woman in a cell,

questioning what the woman did to end up in the cell. The woman reveals that she is a witch, much to Pennyworth's dismay. The Baroness questions Pennyworth on who the other woman involved in Esme's murder is, proving to be somewhat mysterious. The woman refuses to help Pennyworth initially on the basis of his rudeness; she admits that she will help if he brings her the left hand of a murderer.

Thomas Wayne meets with his superior, where he expresses anger over Julian Thwaite's death, believing the US government to be working with someone close to Undine to put her in power. His superior does not confirm nor deny, only admits that there will be more peace talks between the Raven Society and the No Name League. Wayne is given the ultimatum to ensure that Frances Gaunt takes the truce, or to kill her himself.

Wayne is angry when his sister, Patricia Wayne, appears at his door asking for money. Thomas refuses to give her money, remarking that she will just buy drugs. Wayne takes Patricia to Martha Kane's apartment, asking for help looking after her while he is on assignment. Wayne questions if Martha would be okay to tell his sister that Martha is a former girlfriend of his.

Patricia takes Martha to a party much to her dismay. Martha worries about Patricia, asking that the two only stay a short while, but Patricia remarks that Martha should live a little.

Wayne and Undine meet with Frances Gaunt on the basis of a peace deal, with Frances apologising for the death of Julian, revealing that the Raven Society was not responsible for his death. The two talk of peace, with both parties agreeing to order their men off the street and draft a statement for the news.

Meanwhile, Martha encounters Patricia again and, realising that she has been crying and is heavily intoxicated, orders that the two return home immediately. As the two attempt to leave, however, they become lost, leading to Martha trying to find the exit alone. She is led into a room full of Satan worshippers, however, leading to her witnessing a man with an animal head and multiple eyes.

Alfred encounters trouble in the local club when a man refuses to pay his bill. This leads to a fight in the street, with Alfred cutting off the man's hand, much like the Baroness predicted. Lord Harwood and Peggy prepare to leave for a meeting with Frances Gaunt, leaving Bet behind much to her dismay, whom they believe may be recognised. When they arrive at Gaunt's house, she is ecstatic to see Harwood, whom she and the rest of the Raven Society believed to be dead.

Wishing to understand her missing three days and find Patricia, Thomas and Martha retrace her steps, finding themselves at the house where the party occurred. They demand to see Patricia, with Martha questioning what drug he gave her that caused her to lose three days. He admits

that he did not give her anything, but they are free to see Patricia. Patricia seems in good health, but does not wish to leave with Thomas as she believes to have found her place in life.

Gaunt admits that the Society is lost without Harwoods leadership, but they should perhaps get him out of the country to a safe haven, more than likely Germany is the best option. Harwood dismisses the notion, admitting that Gaunt having Julian Thwaite killed was a bold move, but Undine will want revenge and break the truce. Gaunt proclaims that she did not have Julian killed, but is at Harwoods disposal. Despite this, Harwood wishes to stay hidden from the world until the Society can consolidate power, much to Gaunts shock.

Thomas begs Patricia to come home with him to a family that loves him, however Patricia rebukes him, citing that he only wishes to protect the share price of the Wayne name and Crowley has opened her eyes to life. Thomas is angry at this, however Patricia believes him to be callous, cold hearted and small minded and does not care about her at all. Despite this, Thomas admits that he cannot believe she is truly happy with her current situation despite her protests.

Crowley observes that he feels Martha is tense and on edge. Martha admits that he doesn't understand what he is dealing with, revealing that the Wayne family are billionaires and have crushed far bigger people than himself. With this, Thomas enters the room announcing that Patricia is an adult and free to stay with Crowley. Thomas does warn that if something is to happen to Patricia then he will hear again from Thomas. Martha is shocked by the decision, questioning how Thomas could leave his sister with such a man, while Thomas tells Martha that she should take a look at herself before judging.

Alfred visits a gentlemen's club for retired soldiers, but is refused entry as he is not believed to be a soldier. He sneaks around the back, asking the soldiers if they know of Curzon's location, however nobody is willing to speak. To entice them, Alfred reveals that Curzon killed Esme due to a bad joke he made while serving in the army, but still nobody is willing to give up Curzon's location. Alfred is escorted out and a confrontation begins between Alfred and one of the soldiers, however the confrontation is quickly ended when the soldiers superior commands he stand down. The man tells Alfred that he believes him and will check out the accusation, sending a man to reveal Curzon's location if found to be true.

Martha visits Thomas again, revealing that she has began remembering the missing days and Thomas needs to rescue Patricia. Alfred reveals that it is his fault that Esme is dead, which upsets Bet who reveals that she loved Emse and they need to track down Curzon. Bet asks if the two can work together; Bet however admits Curzon was not alone as she saw Curzon leaving Alfred's apartment on the night of Esme's murder. The two visit the real estate office — the owner of the building — questioning why the two were let into the building. The man admits that the two looked like respectable buyers as there are many apartments in the building, however he did not notify the police, which angers Pennyworth, as the police did nothing to stop the murder.

The Prime Minister and the Queen discuss the recent Raven Society posters that have been circulating the streets of London. While the Queen does not seem interested, the Prime Minister is furious at the situation and the Society's disrespect of the government. The Prime Minister worries that the Society will destroy half of the country to get what they want, suggesting that

they use more forceful methods — he suggests water cannons and rubber bullets, but the Queen dismisses him, fearing looking oppressive.



Undine discusses the recent poster with her advisor, John Ripper. She believes that the No Name League and Raven Society had a deal, and this rally is in violation of the terms. She wishes to take action, however John advises her to sit back and let the police deal with it, truly believing Gaunt's rally to be a mistake. Nevertheless, Undine wishes to retaliate to Gaunt despite John's advice.

At the Severed Arms, Pennyworth tells Dave Boy and Bazza to track the woman down who accompanies Curzon the night of Esme's murder. They question what Alfred will be doing, and he reveals that the

police jeopardized Esme's murder case and he wants to find out why.

Gaunt tries to write her speech for the rally, but struggles as she is nervous, wanting reassurance of his plans post-rally, with him sarcastically remarking that he will castrate the Prime Minister. While she wishes for Harwood to show mercy, she questions what will happen to the queen if she does not agree with their leadership. Harwood reveals that her uncle is willing to step back into the government and take the Queen's position — this shocks Gaunt who is horrified that Harwood would consider putting an abdicator in power.

Realising that the police covered up Esme's murder, Alfred confronts Inspector Aziz, who is at first reluctant to admit knowing anything about the case. Alfred pushes, however and Aziz reveals that Curzon is the son of a very influential Lord who called in a favour, but does not reveal the Lord's name in fear of being killed. Despite this, he promises to look into Curzon's whereabouts for Alfred and is given twenty-four hours.

The Prime Minister enjoys dinner and a discussion about the war between Gaunt and Undine. The men believe that the Raven Society is superior as they respect rank, while the No Name League is messy and unorganised. During the discussion, the Prime Minister is excused when he is notified of a phone call by Arthur Pennyworth. The call is from Aziz, who meets with the Prime Minister and Curzon's father, Smytth. Aziz admits that Pennyworth is digging and is a highly trained SAS soldier and therefore will be difficult to deal with, but it can be done for a price. The Prime Minister states the price of the dealing to be that he has Smytth's promised vote for protecting his son, under any circumstances.

Martha visits Thomas and it becomes clear that Thomas has not been the same since his encounter with Crowley; he has been taking drugs and heavily dependent on alcohol. Martha questions what he and the CIA plan to do about the Raven Society rally, however Thomas still denies being CIA, despite this, Martha admits that she is alright working with Thomas as a CIA agent. Thomas, however admits that she isn't reliable given her three-day blackout and misplacing of his sister. Furthermore, he denies that he met the devil at Crowley's house, citing that Crowley is a scary man and got inside his head.

Receiving a call from Aziz, Alfred loads his gun ready to head out, but runs into his mother and father in the living room. She hugs him, but looks worried as she feels the gun through his jacket. Nonetheless, she tells him she loves him and Alfred leaves. Alfred arrives at the location to find Curzon and Pike — his accomplice in the murder — blindfolded. Realising that the meeting is a set up, Alfred calls out to Aziz, admitting that he knows a trap when he sees one. Aziz pleads with Alfred not to kill Curzon admitting that he will let Alfred leave the country, but Alfred does not agree. Aziz questions whether Curzon is worth Alfred's life and prepares to give the order and have Alfred killed. Just at that moment, Bet appears, holding a knife to Aziz's throat and ordering his men to stand down. Pennyworth handcuffs Aziz while Bet begins to torture Curzon. She begs for ten minutes to torture Curzon, and Alfred initially agrees, but shoots Curzon in the head, killing him and walking away.

At the Raven Society rally, Gaunt introduces herself and speaks of the Society's goals, to reduce unemployment and bring back morals. She admits that she is no leader, only a doctor,

while revealing what the government did to Harwood, the Raven Society's previous leader, including the torture and disfigurement. She then formally announces her resignation as leader of the Society, proclaiming Harwood to be assuming the position of Leader once again; something that excites the audience. The prime minister is among those watching and orders that soldiers arrest Harwood. The rally turns to chaos as the police arrive, but Harwood commands that they stand down, with all of the officers obeying his command to much surprise.

At the Pennyworth house, Mary is treating Arthur for "bumping into a door" when Alfie enters. Mary notices that Alfred isn't looking too good and hugs him, which eventually leads to the entire family embracing. Mary treating Arthur gives the impression that she is perhaps aware of Arthur's membership with the Raven Society.

The Queen chastises the Prime Minister for his meagre efforts to control the rally, given she was under the impression that Harwood was dead. The Prime Minister sarcastically remarks that perhaps if she had allowed him to use water cannons and rubber bullets, the situation would be different. The Queen tells the Prime Minister to quash Harwood.

Ecstatic at their win at the rally, Harwood and Gaunt dance until they are interrupted by guests. Gaunt asks who the guests are and Harwood admits that they need to have a back up plan incase the Queen is not cooperative. With this, he welcomes back the Duke and Duchess.

Alfred visits Esme's grave, apologising for his actions but citing that it needed to be done. He tells Esme the story of their first date and the moment he realised that she liked him. He admits that things are looking up, but is surrounded by armed police as Aziz watches. Alfred does not resist, simply putting up his hands and surrendering.

Summary: Alfred, Thomas and Martha become entangled in an assassination plot against Lord Harwood.



Following his arrest for the murder of John Curzon, Pennyworth is questioned by Aziz and two other officers over his accomplice, Bet Sykes. The officers are unaware that the woman was bet and ask Alfred to give up her name, however he declines, citing that she saved his life and he cannot give her up. With this, Aziz tells the men to allow him to say goodbye to his family and then take him for sentencing. Alfred says goodbye to his family and is sentenced to seven years in prison.

On the news, the Prime Minister tells the country that he has lost the support of the government and no longer has a majority, thus a general election will be called. He admits that the Queen has allowed him to act as interim Prime Minister while the election is called. He further admits that all previously banned political parties are allowed to stand in the election — a bid to show that the country does not wish to have the No Name League or the Raven Society in charge.

Thomas is shocked at the news while Martha believes that it could be a good way to get the No Name League into power. Despite this, Thomas believes that this is a way for the No Name League and Raven Society to destroy themselves; he believes that the No Name League should not be in power. He announces that he must return to work, with Martha hoping to return too, however he declines, inciting her to think about the work she is doing for the League.

Harwood returns home to his wife, accompanied by Bet and Peggy. His wife seems nervous at his return which Harwood instantly notices. He admits that he likes what she has done with his house, while she admits that she is happy he is home but it feels like a dream and is all too sudden; it is hinted by the expression on Bet and Peggy's face that there is something going on between Harwood's wife and the butler.

Sandra visits Alfred in confinement, where it seems he has taken leadership among the prisoners. She reveals that she has been sent by Dave Boy and Bazza with word of an escape plan, something that shocks Alfred, who sends Dave Boy and Bazza a message back: to forget an escape and allow him to think of something himself. Afterwards, Alfred tells Sandra to forget about the likes of him and move on with her life and he will do the same, much to her dismay.

As Undine Thwaite gives an announcement regarding her run for Prime Minister, Harwood, Peggy and Bet watch from Harwood's home. Harwood scoffs at Undine, believing her to be a weak opponent, however Bet and Peggy seem to like her. Harwood orders that the TV be turned off and at this moment the Duke and Duchess arrive, angry that they are confined in secret. Harwood tries to convince them that the two need to lie low, nobody can know they are in the country. Gaunt and Harwood discuss the recent broadcast and Harwood admits that Undine may be a more formidable opponent than he thought. He asks Gaunt to set up a meeting with Undine to arrange a truce and perhaps a deal.

When Aziz finds out about the proposed coalition and announces this information to the Prime Minister. This infuriates the Prime Minister, who admits that he personally would send in the army, but they're more than likely loyal to Harwood. He sends Aziz to meet with Alfred about dealing with the situation.

Aziz proposes to Alfred that he could be free of his charges if he will do the government a favour and murder Harwood. Alfred questions why Harwood, with Aziz admitting that it would look like the No Name League did the killing, but Alfred is not convinced and fears that it could give the Raven Society an edge at the polls. Aziz further reveals that Harwood has the Duke and Duchess and is using them to blackmail the Queen and needs to be stopped — Alfred agrees on the premise that once the killing is done all of the charges against him are dropped.

Bazza and Dave Boy question Alfred's return, believing there to be a catch. Alfred admits that he must kill Harwood in return for his freedom, however Bazza does not believe that Aziz will simply let him go after the killing, but will want him to keep doing their dirty work. Dave Boy and Bazza agree that they are in, while Mary questions what the trio are talking about, admitting that she doesn't want to lose Alfred again.

Meanwhile, Undine and Jack hand Thomas a list of seats that are up for negotiation at the meeting with the Raven Society. She tells Thomas that the list is ranked with most important seats first. Undine admits that she cannot go herself as she cannot be seen to associate with a fascist. Martha arrives and Undine sees this as a perfect opportunity for the two to work together again, despite Thomas' reluctance, he eventually agrees on Undine's orders.

Alfred receives a call from Aziz while at home with his parents announcing that the killing is scheduled for the following day. Mary questions the call, admitting that she knows there is more trouble. Alfred denies this, citing that the work is government sanctioned and safe, but Mary does not believe this and announces that Arthur has cancer in a bid to keep him out of trouble. Breakfast the following day is awkward and Alfred rarely speaks except when he is leaving.

At the meeting between the No Name League and Raven Society, Alfred is in position with a clear sight on the proceedings. Aziz gives the order that Harwood is to be killed first and then the two No Name agents, shortly after, he gives the go ahead to fire. Alfred readies to fire before realising that the No Name agents are Thomas Wayne and Martha Kane, close allies of his. He reveals this to Dave Boy and Bazza, who both advise him to fire anyway, but he is reluctant. Alfred questions Aziz over the radio on why he was never told Martha and Thomas were involved, however Aziz admits that they did not know who the No Name agents were. With Alfred reluctant to fire, Aziz launches "plan b" and sends the police force in to take care of the situation personally. Fearing the police's actions, Alfred fires warning shots, encouraging both the No Name League and Raven Society to flee with his help.

Fearing that he will be arrested by the police for not following the plan, Alfred bids farewell to his parents, announcing that he will be leaving for Wales until the heat dies down. His father is at first confused while his mother is heartbroken, but both bid him farewell nevertheless.

Fearing that he will lose the election, and realising that the Prime Minister would never let

him win, Harwood enlists the help of the army to remove the Prime Minister from power. The army are at first reluctant despite Harwood's offer of more funding, citing that they answer to the Queen, but are finally convinced when Harwood tells them the Queen authorised it, despite not having done so.

Following with the plan to blackmail the Queen, Bet and Peggy ambush her and her men while she is out deer hunting. They kill two of her men and threaten her at gunpoint, ordering her to drop her weapon.

Alfred calls his parents announcing that he has found a way out of the country but cannot talk too much as the line is most likely bugged. Alfred tells his mother that if she does not hear from him soon not to worry as he is safe. His father tells Alfred not to worry as things will soon change and he will be free to return back to the country.

Following on with Aziz's plan, the police arrive at Harwood's manor to arrest him alive. However Harwood is not present, instead Lady Harwood and the butler are found hanging in the living room as a result of their suspected affair.

The two are dead when the police arrive.

Having kidnapped her earlier, Bet and Peggy force the Queen to send a message to the government. The message is that she is safe and among friends, but orders for the immediate resignation of the government and Prime Minister with force authorised if necessary. To replace

the Prime Minister, she announces Lord Harwood, much to cabinet's surprise. Not long later, the Prime Minister receives a call from Harwood insisting him to resign as they have the Queen and the Duke and Duchess Windermere. Harwood threatens that they will face the consequences if they do not cooperate, however the Prime Minister persists that they will not be bullied. This infuriates Harwood, who is advised by the military counsel that there is no need to shed English blood and to give him 24 hours to decide. Having witnessed the phone call, Gaunt expresses her concern over the recent events, admitting that she didn't sign up to abduct the Queen.

Pennyworth is at the docks ready to leave for New Orleans, Bazza reveals that he will arrive in the US in two weeks. When they attempt to leave, however they are approached by the police who ask what their business is at the docks and that all passage to and from the country is no longer allowed. Bazza scoffs at the idea, telling the men that they will miss their boat, but the police ask for their union cards and a fight ensues. Alfred, Bazza and Dave Boy are able to escape in a police vehicle with armed officers chasing them.

Thomas is in a rush when he arrives at Martha's apartment insisting that she pack a bag as they have to leave. He reveals that Harwood is staging a coup and has kidnapped the Queen. Martha does not see why they have to leave until Thomas reveals that there is more than likely a kill list with their names on it. He tells Martha that the CIA have arranged transportation out of the country, but Martha is unwilling to leave the No Name League behind, wishing to head back to the headquarters and see if she can help. She is shocked when Thomas reveals that Undine had her husband killed with the help of the CIA — who thought she would be easier to control — and the gunman was none other than Alfred. A knock on the door is heard and is revealed to be Alfred, Dave Boy and Bazza looking for a way out of the country. He admits that he was the sniper and missed purposely but now Thomas owes him one. His favour is safe passage out of the country, but he begins to have second thoughts when Thomas reveals that the Queen has been kidnapped. Alfred thinks that if he saves the Queen then he will be free to stay in the country with his parents and will not have to flee to the US, an idea that sounds ridiculous to Bazza and Dave Boy.

Hearing of the Raven's success, Arthur goes to meet with fellow members of his team. Walking through the streets of London, he sees Undine Thwaite hanging, having been captured by the Society. Meeting with his comrades, he announces that their job — members of the Old Guard — is to defend the victory until their last breath. They all hail the Raven Society, celebrating their success.

On the drive, Martha questions if Alfred killed Justin Thwaite, to which he announces that he did. She further questions if Undine was aware, but he admits that he didn't ask. Thomas reveals that he didn't lie to her and wants to be her friend as he likes her. Martha questions if he means sexually, to which he blushes. They arrive at Peggy's house to find Bet with a knife to the Queen's throat. Thomas pulls a gun on Bet, while Alfred enters through the back doing the same. Alfred tells Bet to put the knife down but she is reluctant, refusing to be thwarted until Peggy convinces her to listen. With the Queen safe, Dave Boy makes a joke about the situation being too easy, when someone jumps from a nearby cupboard and stabs Dave Boy in the chest before being shot by Bazza.

General Malcolm receives a call from the Queen ordering the arrest of Harwood and Gaunt and the shutdown of operations. The Raven society guards are shot and Malcolm orders that Harwood and Gaunt are arrested by the military, which is now back under control of the government. The remaining Society soldiers are also rounded up and arrested with their weapons confiscated. The Queen makes a public announcement assuring the country that she is safe and among friends. She admits that she has sometimes been blind to the suffering of her people, but this will soon change as they move forward unified. Alfred congratulates the Queen, questioning what he should call her, to which she whispers something in his ear that shocks him. It is revealed not long after that Alfred slept with the Queen, who warns him not to tell anyone of the events.

Mary and Arthur are surprised when Alfie returns home, announcing that he has been granted a royal pardon by the Crown. Arthur questions if Alfie had anything to do with Harwood's defeat, praising Alfie, who reveals that he has been offered a job working for Scotland Yard and now feels as though he is doing something useful. Alfred remarks that he would've thought Arthur would like the look of the Raven Society and its principles, with Arthur sarcastically laughing. Alfred reveals that he is aware of his father's cancer, prompting a moment between the two in which Arthur admits that he didn't want any fuss but hasn't got long left.

Arthur asks if Alfred will always think good of him when he is gone despite what people may say.

In prison, Harwood apologises for the situation he has gotten Bet, Peggy and Gaunt into, who admit that they don't blame him. He admits that not all is lost as the Old Guard do not surrender, but would rather die. With this, we see Arthur bid goodbye to his family and leave with a briefcase.

Martha visits Thomas' apartment admitting that she has been thinking about what he had said earlier. Martha asks if she was wrong to infer that he liked her sexually, and Thomas admits that she wasn't wrong. Martha admits that she too likes Thomas and the two kiss. When the two are kissing, Thomas stands and is shot multiple times by an unknown assailant.

Arthur appears as a butler at a cabinet dinner. He tucks the Queen under the table before leaving into the kitchen. In the kitchen, he activates some kind of explosive hidden in the cake. Alfred soon realises what his father is up to when his mother lets slip that Arthur is a member of the Raven Society. Realising that the Queen could be in danger, Alfie heads to the government dinner. Alfred confronts his father, who pleads with him to leave, but Alfie is reluctant and Arthur raises the explosives detonator. Arthur pleads with Alfred to go home and look after his mother, raising his hand to detonate the explosive, but Alfred shoots him in the chest and the explosive detonates anyway. Alfred is able to carry the Queen — now unconscious — out of the burning building.

Behind Raven Union lines, Martha Kane finds herself interrogating a Raven Society member at gunpoint who is trying to plead for his life. He tries to say that she has heart, but Martha says she does not. She manages to get the location out of the guy she was interrogating, but is forced to make a daring escape when the Union cops arrive and start shooting at her.

Through the use of a wartime propaganda film, it's mentioned that one year later, the Raven society is now known as the Raven Union, which under the stewardship of Lord Harwood has supposedly "liberated" England.

In Langley, Virginia at the CIA Headquarters, Thomas Wayne briefs the CIA on the situation, and on the Raven's opposition, the English League, a hodgepodge of anti-fascist groups ostensibly fronted by The Queen but in reality, it is really organized rather badly at that by the Prime Minister. Moreover, the Raven Union now controls 90% of the country, with the exception of London and some other key cities, but it is all but inevitable at this point that they will win. According to Thomas, who has been witness to the chaos that is quickly unfolding, when the Raven Union gains control of London, "It'll make Arkham Asylum look like a country club.". Due to the fact that the Raven Union winning is all but inevitable, the U.S. is choosing to not intervene. Instead, they will play nice with the Raven Union. As a result, Thomas is eventually

told they want him to go back to England as a Station Chief. He is reminded that if he can't get with the program as it is now, that this is the part where he can step down gracefully.

Meanwhile Alfred Pennyworth, along with his brothers in arms Bazza and Dave Boy are running a no-questions-asked lounge bar in Soho's neutral zone, where the rules are strict — no politics and no guns. In addition, the money is decent, though it is being supplemented by odd extracurricular jobs, which are supplied by various people, among them Detective Inspector Aziz, now on the English League's High Council.

Martha disapproves, thinking that Alfred is abandoning his principles, but he is doing all of this because he wants to accumulate enough cash to relocate him and his mother to America before the Raven Union's eventual capture of London. As it turns out, by abducting one Colonel Salt for a hefty fee, this seems like a good way to expedite that plan and his subsequent departure from British soil.

Whereas Salt, has George Orwell captive and eventually shoves a chisel in his ear and incinerates the man in question. Later, Salt recognizes Alfred from the papers and claims his dad was a hero to him. Alfred seems glad to hand him over to Aziz, but he's snatched right back not long after and quickly resumes work for the Raven Union as though nothing even happened.

Aziz is quickly on Alfred's doorstep complaining about this since it implies a leak that potentially came from Alfred himself, though he vehemently denies it. Salt, it turns out, was a bigger fish than first implied, and Aziz is curious if he mentioned anything about a Project Stormcloud. Later, Alfred ponders these details with Gulliver Troy, who swiped Salt away from Aziz at Alfred's request in exchange for another hefty chunk of change.

Meanwhile, Bet Sykes, is now a captain working at a Raven Union detention centre, and repeatedly fails to get information out of a supposed subversive. Bet's superior reckons he can get her to open up by raping her, citing party protocol as justification for doing so, and telling Bet to put the kettle on while he goes about it. She doesn't exactly take kindly to that and brutally beats him to death with the metal teapot, before making off with the girl.

In the end, "Stormcloud" is hinted to be something that causes a great deal of blistering agony for the test subject. It is further revealed in this trial run of the weapon, that the casualties of Stormcloud must look as though they died peacefully.

In the end, Alfred is left with no money since it went up in flames, and the guilt of his actions leading to the death of another one of his friends.

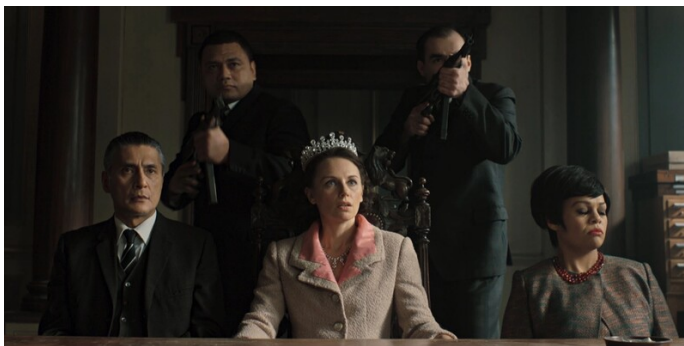

Troy's presence is menacing and ominous, and Alfred suspects that his old SAS Captain finally knows that he is sleeping with his wife, Melanie. While Troy doesn't confront Alfred directly, he does end up cornering his wife, forcing her to tell him the truth. In answer, Gulliver violently beats

Alfred and his crew secure the "Stormcloud" weapon, and then move to get out. However, Salt eventually realizes that something is wrong, and the four men are captured before they can escape the compound. Alfie starts searching for Jessica, and it leads him to a nightclub. The owner reveals he last saw Jessica with Sister Susie and starts laughing. The owner adds that Susie gives kids drugs so that they don't even know their own names. As for anything else, it's above his pay grade.

After Martha has lunch with Thomas's father and his new wife, she deems them "weird, even for people like them". Whilst his father claims he has visited them as he wants to see Samantha, both Martha and Thomas wonder if something more suspect is behind his return. As Bet falls asleep, the two hostages try to free themselves. But Bet wakes up just in the nick of time, and

she asks if they are willing to talk. When Bet puts the baby to sleep, the couple attacks her, revealing themselves as the Nazis that Bet was after. So, Bet shoots them both dead and finds the book she was after.

When Thomas is alone with Patrick, he learns that someone has gone missing with top-secret information. And that's the reason for his return. As he knows that Martha is an agent, he wants Martha to help him. But as Thomas still believes that Martha has given up that life, he is certain that Martha can't help Patrick. Alfie tracks down Susie. But she doesn't react to Alfie's threats as she's a well-respected charity and believes she's untouchable.

Even so, she allows Alfie access to Jessica. But Jessica doesn't want to go home. As you'd predict, Alfie and Dave get their way, and they leave with Jessica. Alfie, however, overpowers the guard and gets them to take him to Zahra's father, Zeya. But her father is skeptical about escaping as he is more than aware of the fence's power. Instead, he would much rather stay than take a chance on Alfie's seemingly hopeless mission of escape.

Martha learns that Jon Salt is dead (But is Bet also dead?) When Mary enters the scene, the conversation turns to the murder of Thomas's father. But is Martha beginning to wonder whether Thomas could be responsible? Lucius warns Dave that he needs to leave the area, but it's obviously way too late for Alfie. Alfie learns that Sandra is pregnant, a fact that she had previously tried to tell Dave. Although, he was too high on drugs at the time to realize. It causes increased tension between the two friends, and that tension continues well into the mission. Gully is also on the mission, but something isn't right with him either. Martha goes to Lucius, and she knows that he is the leak. And it turns out that she wants to stop all of this. However, Lucius tells her that she is on her own. During the mission, when the "bast**d" takes control, he nearly kills Gully. However, Alfie and Dave are able to interrupt before anything overly dramatic can happen.

Gully isn't scared off, however. While the man may not be worth dying over, Gully is still eager to go ahead. As a result, he knocks Alfie out and decides to "go kill" the man. In his attempts to

Next, Patricia is gathered by a group of people with white masks and taken to a table. At the table, Sally sits sobbing and warns Patricia not to drink the tea.

Alfie visits Sandra. And whilst she won't allow him inside her friend, she gives her condolences over Gully's death. But why is Alfie there? Because he thinks they should get married.

does Sandra do? She slams the door in Alfie's face.

After the opening credits, Thomas returns! Martha doesn't know how to react to his return, and she remains silent. A prisoner tries to escape from what appears to be an underground facility but ends up being shot to death. From the vault, Lucius crawls into the building mere seconds later.

Dave learns from Sally, who is no longer being held captive at the dinner table, that Francis drugged everyone at the party, and it resulted in a killing. Back to Martha and Thomas, and he confirms Martha's suspicions that he killed his father. He defends his actions by saying he did it because his father tried to kill Martha. But Martha is livid not because he killed his father but rather because he put his family at risk. Thomas finds that hypercritical considering the risk Martha brings by being an undercover agent.

Afterward, after believing that Sam left with Mary, Mary and Thomas realize that Sam is missing. But it's more complicated than that. Sam is with a woman who looks identical to Mary, and she demands 100,000 pounds from Thomas. Sally shows Dave the scene of the crime, but the body is missing — raising a few doubts from Dave. But as Patricia is hiding in the closet, it proves what Sally claims to be true. Lucius watches as an experiment is performed on a prisoner, which results in them being burnt to death.

Fake Mary holds Alfie at gunpoint. As he speaks to her, he guesses that whatever her reason is, it's personal. And he is correct, as the woman wants to really hurt the Wayne family. To ensure Sam's safety, Thomas publically confesses to killing his father. Afterward, Fake Mary instructs Thomas and Martha to get inside her car. Inside the car, Fake Mary sends them to sleep.

Guess who returns, Bet! She has been drugged to her nut while being held captive as a prisoner. But Bet is now trying to escape. Maybe Lucius will be able to help? Fake Mary takes off her mask. It's Regina! She clearly wants revenge. Regina tells Thomas that to keep Sam safe, he must kill Martha. Elsewhere, Alfie, Mary, and Sam are tied up in the basement. Thomas appears to decide to kill Martha so he can keep Sam safe. But there's no chance of that happening. Instead, he attacks Regina. The noise allows Alfie to take an opportunity to attack her henchman whilst Regina knocks Thomas to the ground.

Just as Regina is about to stab Thomas to death, Alfie threatens to shoot her. As Regina claims that Alfie should get in touch with the Prime Minister, Martha shoots Regina in the head. With the scene safe now that Regina is dead, Alfie tells Mary that Sandra is pregnant. At the end of the episode, a group of milkmen claims it's the dawn of a new day.
