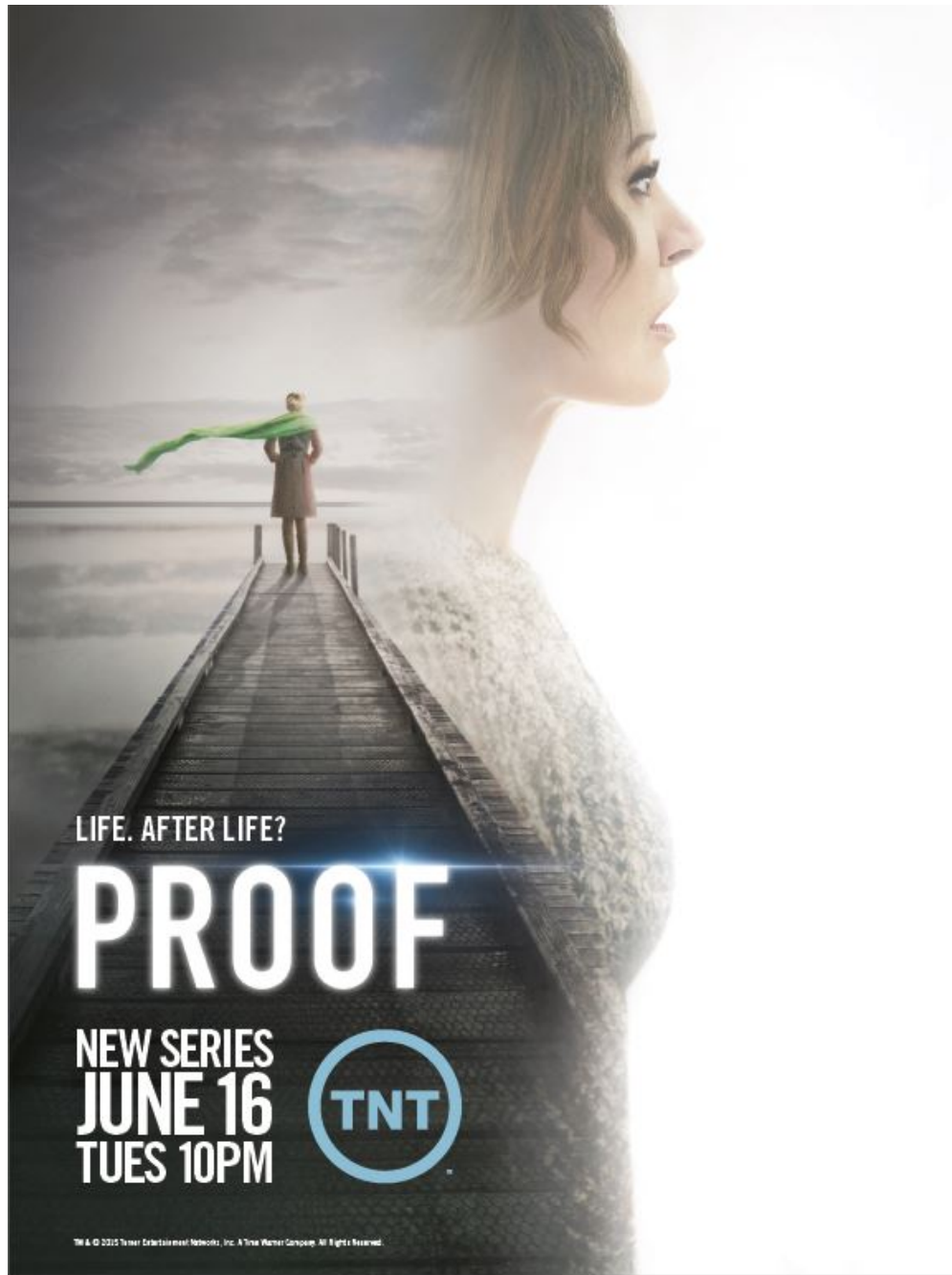

Summary: Dr. Carolyn Tyler has suffered the recent, devastating loss of her teenage son, the breakup of her marriage and a growing estrangement from her daughter. Carolyn is persuaded by Ivan Turing, a cancer-stricken tech inventor and billionaire to investigate cases of reincarnation, near-death experiences, hauntings and other phenomena, all of it in the search for evidence that death is not the end.



The episode starts off with Dr. Carolyn Tyler trying to go for a jog. She receives a page from the hospital — and has to jog straight to work. She arrives at the emergency room and her patient is an 18 year old honors student that was shot in a drive-by, while Carolyn is trying to work on the teen he begins flatlining. She tries to massage his heart, but it doesn't work, she cant bring him back. She orders one of the nurses to go get her some ice. The staff is puzzled and warns her that it is not an approved procedure, but

they bring back the ice. Carolyn keeps massaging the kid's heart while they cover his body in ice to try and slow the cardiac arrest. After a few more minutes of trying to revive the kid, Carolyn gives up and calls the time of death as 11:20.

Feeling defeated she begins to take off her gloves and mask but before she leaves the room one of the other doctors shout that they have a pulse. The gun-shot victim has literally returned from the dead. Carolyn heads out into the lobby and finds the intern, Zed, that was questioning her about the ice. She orders him to never question her in the surgery room again.

Carolyn's ex husband Peter corners her in the lobby, he says they need to talk about their daughter Sophie. Apparently something is going on with her, and she won't open up to Peter about it, he thinks that she needs to have a hat with her mother. Charles pages Carolyn in to his office, he reveals that Internet tycoon Ivan Turing is considering making a huge donation to the hospital, but he has requested to meet with Carolyn — and not anyone else. Carolyn tries to argue but Charles reminds her that he can suspend her for using the ice on her gun-shot patient without permission.

Carolyn heads to Ivan's house to meet with him. He reveals that he is dying from a deadly disease and won't live to see the summer. Ivan didn't call Carolyn to save him, he called her because he wants to know what will happen to him when he died. Carolyn is confused, Ivan

explains that he needs real proof of what happens after you die. And, if Carolyn can deliver that proof he will leave his \$10 Billion estate to her when he dies. Carolyn argues that what he is asking her to do is impossible, but Ivan has done a lot of research and he hands Carolyn a stack of files.

Carolyn turns down Ivan's offer — before she leaves Ivan reveals that he knows her son Will died in a car crash last year. And, he knows that she nearly died in her own near-death experience. Carolyn is shocked, she demands to know how the hell he knows so much about her. Then, she storms out. Carolyn rushes to Peter's house and demands to know what he told Ivan, she told him that she seen their son Will when she drown in private — he was never supposed to tell anyone else. Carolyn's daughter Sophie overhears them talking. She can't believe her mom meant Ivan Turring — she wants all of the details. Carolyn's daughter can't believe that she turned down the money, she thinks that her mom should at least try. She might be able to see her brother Will again.

Carolyn heads back to the hospital and checks in on her gun-shot patient, the boy tells her that when he was "dead" he saw things, it was like he was up on the ceiling and could see his own body and the doctors working on him. Carolyn doesn't believe him, but he insists that he saw her and she was wearing running shoes. Carolyn convinces him that it was just his mind playing tricks on him, but he repeats the prayer that she was whispering under her breath when she was trying to bring him back to life.

Carolyn heads to the cafeteria and corners Zed. She asks him if he heard her say anything under her breath in Latin. Zed insists that he didn't hear her say anything. Carolyn asks him if he believes in life after death — Zed explains that his culture thinks it is a fact that there is life after death, but as a man of science he doesn't believe in it. After work Carolyn heads home and pours herself a glass of wine and begins going through the files that Ivan gave her about life after death.

The next day, Carolyn takes Zed with her to meet one of the people in Ivan's files. A girl named Lilly was in a coma for 5 days, when she woke up she told her parents about the people from her family that she met in the other world while she was asleep. Her parents explain that Lilly never could have known those people, because they died before she was born. Lilly also told her parents that she used to float up to the ceiling and watch them talk to her while she was asleep.

Carolyn heads back to the hospital and pulls Lilly's medical files. She tells Peter that she is just doing some research for a follow-up. Peter says that there was no way Lilly was dreaming because the EKG doesn't show any signs of brain activity. Peter wants to talk about their divorce, he thinks that Sophie is mad at them for splitting up and they should tell her the truth that he was having an affair. Then maybe Sophie will understand why they split up.

Carolyn goes to a nursing home to meet Ruth, Lily's granddaughter. Ruth raves that Lilly is a miracle child. Carolyn takes out some of the drawing that Lily gave her of the people that she met in the other world. One of them is a guy named "Paw Paw." Ruth insists that she doesn't know anyone named Paw Paw, but Carolyn tells her that she did some research on the internet and she knows there was another man in her life. Ruth confesses that she separated from her husband Bill for a few months and she went to a bar and met a man, she was so upset with her husband that she slept with the boy from the bar — and then he went away to Vietnam and was killed. Ruth reveals that Paw Paw is Lily's real grandfather.

Carolyn goes back to the hospital and learns that Lily was just brought in. Apparently, she has another blood clot from her meningitis. Carolyn rushes in to the room and Lily's parents tell her that they have opted not to get the surgery because there is a 70% chance that Lily won't survive. Carolyn argues that without the surgery she will definitely die. Lily's mom explains that they think God sent her back to them after the coma to let them know that she would be okay, and now it is time for her to leave for good.

Carolyn convinces Lily's parents to let her do the surgery. Carolyn and Charles remove the blood clot, Lily will live — but there is no guarantee that she will not have another clot. Lily wakes up and Carolyn asks her if she got to see anyone in the other world again. Lily tells Carolyn that the people in the other world told her not to talk to Carolyn about them anymore. Carolyn pays Ivan a visit and agrees to work on his files and see if there is life after death, but she has a list of stipulations and demands — Ivan agrees to them all, he wants Carolyn to include his protégé Janelle in her work. Carolyn plans to star work ASAP, but warns Ivan that she is not quitting her job at the hospital.

Carolyn, Zed, and Janelle head to her house and get to work on organizing the research that they got from Ivan. Peter drops off Carolyn's daughter Sophie, Carolyn asks her if they can have a movie night later and spend some time together, they order Indian food and watch old home videos of Will.

Summary: When a young man claims he’s seen the ghost of his recently deceased wife, Dr. Tyler and her team are brought in to investigate an increasingly bizarre case of loss, love and jealousy.



Luke’s life began to unravel after the untimely loss of his wife. Once a successful pilot, the mourning husband was fired after telling a coworker he saw visions of his dead bride.

After she is put in danger, Cat demands that Luke undergo a complete brain scan and psychiatric evaluation or she will report him to the police.

Luke agrees and the findings clearly show a large lesion growing on his brain which would account for his visions and schizophrenic tendencies. Although life-threatening, Luke is hesitant to remove the lesions afraid that the visions of Elena will stop. With his life hanging in the balance, he agrees to the procedure, but only if Dr. Tyler is not present for fear it will upset his wife.

During the surgery at which Cat is present for anyway, all the equipment in the ER starts going berserk as all the monitors and machines furiously begin turning on and off in an ominous sign of Elena’s presence.

The surgeons are forced to postpone the surgery giving Luke enough time to decide that he wants to end his life by jumping off the hospital’s roof so he can be reunited with his love once again. Cat arrives just in the nick of time to talk the confused and brokenhearted Luke quite literally down from a ledge.

The doctor tries to tell Luke that maybe Elena was coming to him to encourage him to see a doctor and save his life. Luke seems to find solace in that idea.

The surgery is successful and Luke's brain lesion is removed stopping his constant visions of his dead wife allowing him to reclaim his life and career. Luke is dispatched from the hospital as Cat is left standing in his empty hospital room as the lights start flickering on and off. Spirits? Summary: Carolyn and her team investigate the case of an Iraq war vet who claims to have PTSD from a past life experience during the Korean War. Carolyn reconnects with a medical school colleague turned "regression therapist".



Carolyn and Zed attend a past life regression therapy seminar presented by Dr. Daniel Powell, a medical school colleague of hers whose current work in which she does not believe. He presents as a case study an Iraq war veteran named Liam, whose PTSD Powell believes is not from his time fighting in Iraq but rather from a past life as a soldier named Tommy fighting in the Korean War trying to be saved by one of his fellow soldiers who ultimately got shot in the back. Regardless of what he is facing, Liam just wants his

emotional pain to go away.

Following the seminar, another man named Ryder Newburn accuses Liam of stealing the Korea story from his soon to be published graphic novel, the story almost exactly as in the book down to the names and places. Seeing his past life more clearly in his regression visions, Liam is able to see Ryder as that other soldier in Korea, the one who tried to save him.

In speaking to Ryder, Daniel and Carolyn learn that he, a pacifist, is currently suffering from these similar visions, what he sees in his dreams. They have to convince Ryder that they at least have to try to help him emotionally by finding out if he was indeed that soldier in a past life. In the process, they have to try and figure out what accounts for some major POV differences between Liam and Ryder's stories.

Meanwhile, based on Sophie's suggestion they bring in an exchange student as a boarder, Carolyn contemplates doing the long put off task of cleaning Will's bedroom. Something she goes through with Daniel helps Carolyn decide what to do with this matter. And upon meeting up unexpectedly with a friend from Kenya, Zed begins to see a divergence in what he wants for his future and what is expected of him.

Into Carolyn's operating room come two patients from the same gunshot incident, one the criminal and the other the police officer. The officer dies, while the criminal, Randall Mason, survives, but not before he suffers cardiac arrest.

Coming out of the situation, Mason is obviously freaked by what he experienced while he was dead, not a pleasant one like most have described the afterlife to be. After initial opposition, Mason does open up to Carolyn about what he saw while he was dead. Although there were some

The Jane Doe has signs of disassociate personality disorder when subjected to a brain scan. After the scan, Jane sees someone walking past her; a woman with a boy. She recalls her out of body experience during her operation. She believes she died.

Ivan is talking with Charles about the wing he's donating and he doesn't want the wing named after him. He thinks it's self aggrandizing and rhymy. Charles wonders if there's anything he should know when Ivan struggles for the second time finding words.

Len and Cat talk to Sophie about Charlie, perhaps discussing things with his family so they can keep in touch down the road. Cat just wants to make sure she knows he's not Will.

Cat tries to get to the bottom of what happened to Jane during surgery. She attempts to ask Dr. Nash, but finds his nurse instead, his nurse with a bear on the top of her cap, one that was likely seen by Jane when she flatlined in surgery on the day he was going too fast because he was tired.

One of Ivan's employees is wearing a recording device at the time he drops dead, downloading exabytes of data, which is about the size of the entire library of congress in mere seconds. However, He needed to have seen the images during his life to have been able to encode the data with his own version of an imprint.

When Cat watches the images, she gets a look of such sorrow on her face

that Ivan wonders if she recognizes something from her own experience, making Janel and Zed wonder exactly what he's talking about. She acknowledges to them she believes in near-death experiences, but doesn't believe that they necessarily mean there is life after death or that the two are related.

When they clean up the images when Ethan died, there is an image of his mother welcoming him with open arms. At first, as she is seen with green surrounding her, Cat thinks it might be the woman she saw. She realizes instead it's something else entirely, but equally significant.

They realize that Ethan had a DEATH experience and while Will reaching out to Cat is what sent her back to life, it's what welcomed Ethan to whatever's next. With the volume of data they have to examine, it could take years, but they could quite easily have the key to life after death.

Charles tells Ivan, meanwhile, that he has a mass on his brain. There isn't a lot of good news that goes along with it. Either stopping the treatment for his cancer to remove the tumor or treat the tumor and significantly tamper his mental faculties.

Ethan's wife is disgusted by the team scouring her life, her memories in search of an afterlife. For the first time, Cat is interested in keeping the studies going, and suggests Ethan, too was a scientist.

Julie, Ethan's wife, is suing Turing Industries. She wants them to destroy the data. Ivan believes that trying the case in the court of public opinion may be her only case.

Len can't believe Ivan Turing is walking out of Cat's house at 8:30 in the morning.

The family begins to clean out Will's room. They find it hard to agree on whether to keep or donate most things, but they smile and laugh about so many memories. Sophie finds love

notes, although nobody knew he had a girlfriend. It surprises everybody. It's reading his private memories that makes Cat think differently about Ethan's death experience.

Cat and Ivan argue over the ethical treatment of Ethan's data. What we leave behind and what we take to the grave; how private is it, and how private should it be when you're thinking about one of the biggest breakthroughs known to man?

Zed learns he's free from his engagement, but must pay back his \$250k educational costs. That stings.

Ivan continues watching Ethan's life, but he's not as comfortable as he was with the discovery at first blush and his finger hesitates over the delete key. Ivan goes to Charles. He'll have the surgery. They start having a conversation about the potential of life after death, and Ivan wonders if Charles really thinks this is all there is. Of course not, but Charles will still fight like hell to stay in this world for as long as possible.

Len cannot help himself from jumping into the elevator with Ivan. Ivan puts Len's fears to rest by assuring him with his limited time left on the planet, romantic entanglements are not on his agenda and while he doesn't know Len well enough to agree that he's the asshole he says, he'll agree that Cat is amazing, and if he wasn't dying, Len would have a hell of a fight on his hands.

When Ivan tells Cat about the data, she's shocked it's gone and at the permanence of it. Inside the maze is a specially prepared Thai meal from a chef he had flown in specially. He also asks her to accompany him somewhere around the world someday. When threatened, he upped his game. Len is at Cat's when she gets home. She tells him the truth about her research with Turing. Len thinks it's brilliant, except he doesn't take the research seriously, which sort of disappoints her.

Len tells Kyle the story of Cat the superhero. Suddenly she's the one doing the surgery on the young boy.

Ivan tells Sasha what's going on with him, both about the tumor and the cancer. He's delightfully forthright and pleasant. She's angry he didn't trust her with the knowledge, and the way he told her it's no wonder. He wasn't very soft about his reasons for choosing to tell Janel over her.

Meanwhile, Zed flatlines Cat. Her experience is very similar to what she's been going through while awake. She's at the opening scene, running through the street, seeing Will. At the beach, calling out to him. Patricia is there. She greets her and says she warned her to stop. Cat wonders if it's real. (There is a strange light Cat sees between her and Will.) Patricia says she'll take Cat to Will. It's Patricia's time to pass on, and that's why she can take her on to the other side. Up until this point, she has only helped people to reach this far. Sasha took it over.

When Cat is ready to get into the elevator, she meets a new Helping Hands volunteer. Patricia really did die. She really did pass to the other side, at the exact time Cat was doing her experiment. She goes into Ivan's room to share the news, a sly smile on her face. They're connected and the light that is always behind the heads of those in the know appears behind hers.
