The episode starts with Simone and her team in the middle of an intense arrest and she is wearing a wedding dress. Brendon can barely focus as he keeps thinking about going back to his acting career. He has been offered a tempting role and he is considering it. However, I don't think it is a good excuse to be distracted during a shootout.

Tracy asks Carter to sell out Garza and give her proof that Garza is breaking protocol so she can dismantle his new unit. She gives him two options, a promotion or a demotion to a remote town in the middle of nowhere.

Simone and Brendon are still on probation and are being trained by Carter and Laura. Today, they are learning all the mandatory tasks a rookie must complete during their probation. Devon and Simone want to start with the most challenging task which is getting CIs.

Simone is overly confident after making an arrest on her way to work. She and Carter take a bet on whether she can easily charm the drug peddler she arrested into becoming a CI. Simone puts on the heavy charm and works Anton like a tambourine and he sings like a canary.

Carter reports to Gaza that Simone's CI may have given them a lead and they will be putting a wire on him. Garza thinks that is great work but asks Carter to ignore protocol unless they get an arrest.

The fake Quincannon gives them a lead but they find another body double. I gotta say, maybe Quincannon is onto something here!

Brendon decides to go to the reading of the role he was offered after Laura tells him what she has profiled on him. She thinks he lives for praise and he should decide if he can hack being an FBI agent.

Carter is currently going through a divorce and Simone tries to motivate him up to get back in the game. Isn't it too soon?

On the other hand, she advises Laura, to be honest about how she feels about her old partner Mark. Laura takes her advice and makes a point to apologize to Mark for leaving the way she did. Apparently she just up and left without as much as a goodbye . They end up sleeping together but Laura is still healing from the betrayal of her fiancé and doesn't want a serious relationship. Summary: When Simone and Carter go undercover to find an international assassin known as The Reaper, a prisoner seeking bail recognizes Carter and nearly blows his cover. Laura and Brendon trace a lead on The Reaper's assault rifle while Brendon works to heal his relationship with his father. Meanwhile, Simone's demanding work schedule puts a strain on her relationship with Dina.



The episode starts with Simone going to Ventura county jail as an inmate. She is there to try and get close to the girlfriend of an assassin named the Reaper. The FBI got a lead that the Reaper is in L.A and is about to do a hit. Unfortunately, they were only able to arrest his girlfriend who is refusing to cooperate. Garza is sending Simone undercover as an inmate to get close to the girlfriend and Carter as a sheriff's deputy to protect Simone's cover.

In the meantime, Brendon and Laura work on a lead based on the gun the

reaper left behind. Brendon uses his connections as a former actor to identify a possible gun expert who might be commissioned by the reaper to craft a new high-tech sniper gun.

Once in prison, Simone doesn't waste time getting close to the reaper's girlfriend, Zora. She steps in to defend Zora from prison bullies and gains her trust. She and Zora start getting close but the mission is threatened when another inmate, Jasmine, remembers Carter as the FBI agent who once arrested her. She threatens to blow up his cover if he doesn't help her get out of prison.

Meanwhile, Brendon and Laura head over to talk to the gun expert and Brendon receives a call from Chen informing him they arrested his dad while he was attempting to break into his storage holding.

The gun expert is not as cooperative as they were hoping he would be but he signals to them that the client they might be after is leaving with the gun he commissioned. They chase the guy but he manages to fight them and escape after carjacking a car.

While working the case, there's an alert that an agent named Jason has sounded an alarm that his cover has been blown. Later, Garcia asks to speak to Brendon and warns him about the troubles that can come with dating a colleague. Garcia has been there before so he knows what he is talking about. Brendon tells him that there should be nothing to worry about Antoinette turned him down.
