Summary: Charlie Tucker and President Payton attempt to come up with a plan to avenge the death of Payton's son, who was killed in Kabul after a diplomatic convoy was attacked.



A firefight is going on. A woman screams out for Aaron and then Maureen and Charlie. Two women and some men are in a terrible battle and shots are firing everywhere. Charlie is having a flashback. She sees the tracer rounds and then sees Aaron go down. She crawls to him, her fiancée, while shots still rage. She hides behind a wall cowering. She tells her shrink she doesn't want to talk about it anymore. The shrink says she's altering the facts of the incident based on the trauma of Aaron dying. She says she's repressing something but Charlie says she remembers it all.

She says he died and it was brutal and ugly and the memory is getting more and not less vivid. Her shrink says she's ready to face it. Aaron says face what — that he was killed in a terrorist attack. Her shrink says she's engaging in reckless personal behavior. We see Charlie drinking in a bar with a strange guy and then hooking up with him. She asks Charlie if she considers herself sexually irresponsible. Her shrink says that worries her.

Charlie wakes to see photos of her and Aaron on the wall and a stranger on her skin. She goes to shower. Her shrink says no good can come of her incessant partying. Charlie says good doesn't have to come as long as she does. Flashback to her kicking the guy out of her bed at 1:30 am. She says she has to be at work at 2 and tells him she called him a lab. She shows up to the CIA HQ in Langley six hours before the President's daily security briefing.

She looks at a news feed about Afghanistan and terrorists and thinks more about Aaron's death. Lucas dashes into the elevator as the doors close. They introduce themselves to each

other. She says he's very handsome and he thanks her. She says he's old for a briefer. They both went to school in NC — schools with a rivalry. She introduces Lucas to the others as acting director Skinner's new briefer. She points out Maureen, Kurt and Dashiell. They are briefers for the Secretary of Defense, State Department and DOJ.

She says they put together the book that is delivered to POTUS. She tells Lucas to grab a chair and keep up. They bring up Tamir Hofi, former Mossad agent in Istanbul selling a cyber warfare virus. They move him back. Sunni militants training for suicide bombing were killed in training and they all laugh. Nairobi got chatter about terrorists after the great Satan. They turn on a video from the group running on Al Jazeera. It's at a refugee camp. Charlie says the doctor looks just like Aaron.

She says he's obviously American. They see shots fired on the doctors and the sick people gunned down. The doctor is dragged out and Charlie says he has less than 12 hours to live and goes to the front of the book. They dig into the doctor — Benjamin Butler — who is a cardiologist with no wife or kids. Charlie is called to the director's office and tasks the team to keep digging.

Skinner comes in and says General Khan, Syrian intelligence chief, is in town and he wants the guy in front of POTUS. Charlie says he has ties to terrorist camps and regimes. She says the guy is a gangster. He tells her to make it happen and tells Lucas to stay after she leaves. Three hours until the briefing, they tell her Jack Dawkins team is closest and she says they need to figure out where they're holding him.

Lucas comes to tell her that the director wanted her to do what he asked on Khan. Dashiell calls the in and says MI6 is tracking them and they see the terrorists tell them the American will be punished unless 25 of their brothers are released from Gitmo. They say they will spill the blood of their evil and slit the throat of a British doctor there with Butler.

She goes to the cafeteria and asks why the Africa watchers are having burritos. She asks why they're not upstairs briefing her. Steve calls her PITA (pain in the ass) and she asks about Butler. He says he travels a lot over there helping people. He says he was in Syria recently and she asks why he was there. He says he has no clue and she tells him to get one.

They see another video of the terrorists. A guy says he thinks they found Fattah. She asks Earl for a sitrep and they wonder if they should put it in the book. They get online with Jack and his JSOC team. He tells her they can get the guy — Fattah — but she has an abduction that he needs to prioritize. She asks what the percent is they can kill Fattah today and tells him to call back when it hits 80%.

She has to pick between the terrorist that killed her BF and rescuing the doctor. She says the CIA has a lot of assets on the ground and they don't want to burn them all going after Fattah. Lucas says they should go after Fattah. She says they have to prioritize Butler. She says they never mentioned Bin Laden in the book every time they got close over the decade.

Maureen asks if she's going after Butler because he looks like Aaron. Charlie says she won't tell POTUS about Fattah unless they have more certainty. Butler reads a statement on a video asking for the release of the prisoners from Gitmo or else Americans will be executed. He's held at knife point when he reads the statement. Charlie says to print the book now.

Maureen is searching for a paper trail — the whole team is scrambling. They tear up leads as they go and toss them into burn bags. They cram the stuff on Fattah in the burn bags and send it to the incinerator. They hand Charlie the book and she head to the White House. On the way, she gets a text from someone she doesn't know who says they know about the day her fiancée died, that she's CIA and some of the materials about that day are classified. Charlie threatens to track the number but the texter says she can't.

News place about an attack on a Congressional delegation attacked including Aaron Payton, the President's son. President Payton waits in the oval and greets Charlie. She tells her about Dr Butler. She says one doctor — a Brit — was already killed. She says it's a splinter group of Al Shabaah led by Kataab, a new guy whose trying to impress the other jihadists.

The President notices the doctor looks like Aaron. Charlie says she thinks he'll be dead by noon. She tells POTUS Jack Dawkins and JSOC are nearby. She says they are the only team close enough to run a rescue. She says General Khan is in town and wants a meeting with her and says Director Skinner thinks he'll be a good asset for them.

POTUS tells her to tell the truth and Charlie says she doesn't trust the guy and says he's there to ferret out info. Payton asks if there's anything else and Charlie doesn't mention Fattah. POTUS says they'll let her know ASAP on trying to extract Butler. Charlie gets a text on the way

out from her mystery texter asking if she told the Prez about Fattah and then complimenting her coat. Someone has eyes on her.

She calls the CIA but they can't run down the line for her. She says to run it again and get her a location. JSOC calls — it's Jack. He says he's 80% on Fattah and can have him dead by day's end and his number two. He tells her he wants Fattah but she says POTUS wants the doctor. He asks if she knows about Fattah but she hung up.

General Khan is there screaming and Maureen wants to know why he's on the 7th floor. She says he snuck a cell phone into the French Embassy sewn into his coat. Skinner calls them in and he says he got off the phone with JSOC and wants to know why they didn't put this in the book for POTUS. He asks if that's Charlie's decision and Maureen says they shouldn't talk about this in front of Khan.

Khan says he can provide information on Fattah's location and Lucas says that team is on Dr Butler but Skinner says that he and Khan are taking this to POTUS personally and tells them to make it happen. Maureen calls Charlie and tells her what Skinner is doing and that Khan was on the 7th floor and she asks if Skinner knows what he did to the French.

Charlie says assume the worst and that he had a phone and is helping Fattah. Charlie sees them getting into the car. Charlie says they have to get the SIM card off of Khan's phone. David calls and chews out Charlie about not bringing the Fattah stuff to POTUS. She tells him if they lose Fattah while Butler is decapitated, then what. He tells her POTUS makes policy, not her.

Maureen says Skinner suspended her and blocked her from the building. She says she's making a run and tells them to clear out. She says to get the info on Butler and meet her. The detain order pops up and she calls Sid and says she's on the buzzer. She tells him about Khan and that he may have a cell phone on him he had at the CIA and is on the way to the White House. He says he won't make it.

She calls Steve and tells him to give Maureen the file. He says no but Maureen takes it and goes. Lucas comes to him and asks about Charlie. He says he doesn't know what the hell is going on. Charlie takes the folder from Maureen and tells her to meet at the White House. Security has an eye on Charlie but she evades them by hopping on a delivery truck.

Secret Service stops Skinner and Khan and says they have a credible threat of a danger to Khan's life. They take his vehicle and head off to "check it" for explosives. Charlie hops off the back off a truck and into a cab and tells the driver -1600 Pennsylvania Avenue. Sid has Khan in the SUV and tells him to hand over the hidden phone. He pulls a knife and says he's going to start digging.

He pulls off Khan's hat and finds the phone. He asks Khan when was the last time he was water boarded then laughs and says — we don't do that, we just drown them. Charlie comes into the Oval where Skinner is telling POTUS he suspended her. She says she didn't withhold info, she was vetting it. The Prez asks if they could have killed Fattah today and she says there was a chance.

She says if they missed, they would lose the whole network. Charlie gets a text and says that she has credible evidence that Khan secreted a phone when he came into the CIA. Maureen pipes up and says he pulled the same thing on the French. POTUS asks where Khan is and then David comes in and says that Khan has been detained by the Secret Service but they don't know where he is.

POTUS asks about Butler and tells them to get JSOC to bring him home. Jack and his team touch down and a drone flies support. They have eyes on it and follow the team. Charlie and the others watch in the ops center. The team takes out some targets and set a charge to breach a door. They blow it and head in taking down targets right and left. They find Butler in one piece and tell him he's safe. They extract him.

Charlie offers a tight smile as they watch his rescue. She thinks about lying in bed with Aaron. He says she's somewhere else thinking and asks where. She says she's stressing about the trip to Kabul. She says it's more dangerous than he and his mother realize. She says it's not important to her candidacy. Aaron says they have to go.

POTUS gives a memorial speech about her son a year to the day after his death. She speaks about his efforts as an aid worker. She says she doesn't like Taps and says her son loved Coltrane. She has a saxophonist there and he plays a smooth jazz number. Charlie is lost in her recollection of that day. Charlie tells POTUS later they will get Fattah and his whole network.

Payton asks if they will get them and Charlie says they will. Payton says she wants to hear from the woman that loved her son, will she get them. Charlie says she will find every last person that had anything to do with Aaron's death and end all their lives. Payton tells her — that's my girl. She tells Charlie that his death will make killers of both of them.

Charlie comes home to find her door ajar. She goes in carefully and finds her gun is gone. She asks Nick why he's there. He says they need to talk and she says he broke in, stole her gun and drank her Scotch. She reminds him the Scotch was an engagement gift from him. He asks if they should pour some out for Aaron. She threatens to shoot him and he says he got her gun and her back up piece.

He pours her some Scotch. She kicks off her shoes and sits on the counter. She sips her Scotch and says he's been dark for over a year. She says he was there and gone. She says she doesn't appreciate the texts and he says he doesn't send texts. She says if he didn't send them, someone knows about Fattah and what they did. She hands over her phone for him to read it.

She says she can't trace it. She yanks her phone away and says for all she knows, he could have hit the convoy. He says she's great in bed, but not bright. She says the man who may have killed the president's son was a CIA asset. Nick says he was her asset. He tells her he's sorry what he said about Aaron and says he didn't deserve to die that way.

Charlie thinks about what her shrink said about not remembering everything accurately. She remembers Aaron with a gun in his hand firing point blank. Later, Charlie sits at a bar and takes a drink from the first guy that offers. She shows him her favorite bar trick and it's on — another poor sexual decision.

Summary: A stranded Russian submarine contains stolen U.S. secrets. Charlie receives an incriminating picture. President Payton selects a new CIA director.



Tonight's episode kicks off with two divers in the Bering Sea in the United States territory. There is a storm and the ship that they are diving from loses the tether connecting them. The boat is damaged in the storm and slowly sinking.

Meanwhile, Charlie is at dinner with Constance and her husband — they're celebrating Aaron's birthday. They go around the table and make a wish for him, Constance wishes for justice and wants the people that took her son to pay for it. Marshall says that he wishes to know the truth about what really happened. Charlie promises them she will

find them the truth and justice. When Charlie leaves dinner she receives a mysterious text of a photo and the message "remember me." She calls Nick and leaves him a message — telling him that there is an emergency and someone has a photo they shouldn't have.

On the sinking ship a leader named Anatoliy stabs two of his crew members to death and then climbs in to the captain's chair and begins radioing for help. Earl and Charlie receive the calls from a "potentially distressed asset." They pull up his code name "Nightfall" and learn he has been in the Russian navy since 1980's. He tells them he has killed two officers and locked himself in the room and it will be a moment before he is discovered, he says their ship is "dead in the water."

Charlie, Earl, and their crew try to figure out what the Russian army is doing so far in American waters. They radio Anatoliy, and ask him what his mission is. He says they were tapping the fiber-optic cables at the bottom of the waters and recording everything. They have approximately six months of American intel gathered on their ship. Charlie learns that one of the lines that the

Russians recorded is full of their warfare and they can access the names and addresses of all of their assets.

Charlie briefs Constance on the submarine accident, and reveals that they have an asset aboard with the code name "Nightfall." Charlie explains that they tapped in to their intelligence — and the asset is living on borrowed time. They rerouted one of their ships, but it won't get there for at least another twelve hours.

Nick arrives at Constance's office and she shows him the picture that she received. Nick insists that he isn't behind the texts. He tells her that if it will make her feel better she can break their oath to the CIA and tell Constance about the attack. Charlie doesn't want to tell her until she knows who is sending the texts, and she wants Nick to help her figure out who it is. Nick is sure that the person sending her the messages is Fada, Charlie says that they need to find him and find out what he knows. Once he tells her why Aaron was killed she is going to put a bullet in his head herself.

After Nick leaves, Maureen hounds Charlie about what they were talking about in her office. She tells Charlie that she despises Nick and she seen him meeting with the secretary of defense yesterday. Charlie is confused and asks what Nick was doing there — Maureen has no idea, but she plans to find out.

Charlie has Earl check the ship's time ETA, they are still 10 hours away from the sub. Someone from the Russia house arrives, and verifies that "Nightfall" is their asset. But, other than that he is useless, he reveals that Anatoliy's handler was Marty and he passed away. Charlie contacts Anatoliy on the radio again, and he reveals that he knew Charlie when she was a child and she used to play with his daughter. Charlie reassures him they are going to save him, he reveals that he is running out of time. Earl notices two Russian ships moving quickly to the submarine, and at that rate they are going to get their way before the US ship does.

Charlie contacts Constance and fills her in on Anatoliy, Constance says she is working on getting another ship en route. Then she breaks the news to Charlie that she is holding a press conference and announcing the new CIA director, she has selected former Governor Ray Navaro. Charlie meets with Sid real quick and tells him to find the person sending her the texts, then she heads to Ray's coronation. Before the ceremony starts Constance takes Charlie aside and tells her that the Russians are threatening to fire on their ship if they interrupt their rescue mission. She tells Charlie she has no choice — she needs to tell Anatoliy to commit suicide and sink the ship before the Russians get to it and get all of their intel.

Sid calls Charlie and tells her that he couldn't find anything on her phone, whoever is sending her the texts has real resources. Sid can't prove it, but he is certain that Nick is the one sending her the pictures and he warns her that Nick will try to take her down and tells her to watch her back.

Charlie heads back to the office and radios Anatoliy. He is panicked and tells her that the Russians are welding through the door and they are going to find him at any moment. Charlie explains that the Russians are going to get there and get all of the US secrets before they can top them, and America's secrets need to be hidden for all time. Anatoliy asks Charlie to get a message to his daughter, she's a pre-med student in college now. Charlie records the message on her cell phone, and then Anatoliy disconnects. He rushes through the submarine shooting the Russians that get in his way until he gets to the motherboard — and he destroys it, which sinks the submarine.

Summary: Charlie has some flashbacks featuring her arrival at Midnight City when she first met Nick and see him brutally interrogate Fatah. After members of the militant Islamist movement Boko Haram kidnap 21 Nigerian girls, President Payton gives Charlie the difficult task to find and save the girls without Nigeria knowing America. was ever involved.

In Nigeria, a bus full of rowdy soccer kids drives along. Military vehicles can be seen in the distance and the coach tells them to quiet down as the jeeps pull up on them. They shoot the driver immediately and all the kids scream. The coach tries to say no but they gun him down too. One of the gunmen drags their bodies out into the desert and drives off with the bus full of young girls. One of the dead men had a camera and was filming this.

Charlie goes for a coffee and the barista tries to flirt. He tells her he tends bar at a club and offers to hook her up. Her cup says MILF on it and he says it stands for milk, light foam. She finds Nick outside and says he wants to talk about the photo. She says this all started when he got back to DC. He tells her they worked Fatah together and let him go together. She says she doesn't want to be his swim buddy.

Charlie plugs a SIM card from a phone into a tablet — she lifted Nick's phone. She downloads it and then is called to her morning meeting by Maureen. They talk about rebels in Ukraine having rocket launchers. They tell her Navarro is planning on briefing POTUS himself ahead of her next big meeting. Charlie says to focus on the book and says Boko Haram is causing problems in Nigeria.

They say the video shows the gunmen claim the girls by right of Sharia law. Charlie says they are likely headed for a bad area then will upload videos of the girls pleading to be let go. Charlie says if they can pinpoint the location, they may be able to get the girls out. Charlie is at the White House while Navarro briefs POTUS on the Chinese visit. She thanks Navarro and tells Navarro and David to leave her with Charlie.

That takes Navarro by surprise. She says — bye guys — and Navarro is forced to leave. Payton tells her that Navarro doesn't like Charlie disrespecting him and says it's just a word to the wise. She tells Payton about the Nigerian kidnapping and the two murders. She says there are videos demanding ransom from the West or else they will sell the girls into slavery. Charlie says she's sure she knows what they've already done to them.



Payton says the Nigerian government is too scared of him to act. Charlie says she thinks they can get to the girls. Payton says they only consult with the Nigerians in an advisory capacity and tells Charlie she can't put American boots on the ground. Charlie finds Navarro waiting on her. She apologizes if she was disrespectful. She says she and Payton have a shorthand that can seem casual. He accepts her apology and asks about Boko Haram.

Charlie says POTUS wants them to look for the girls. He doubts it but Charlie says she has permission to look only, not act. She tells Maureen, Lucas and Dashiell to work on finding the girls. Maureen asks Charlie what's up but she insists nothing is. Maureen says she's there if she needs her. Marshall comes in to talk to his wife and she asks about why he was asking for papers about the convoy attack in Kabul that killed their son.

He says there is nothing wrong with looking into what happened to their son. She says there is still an investigation and a report to be prepared. She says he can't jump barriers when it's a matter of national security. She says she understands his need for closure. He gets angry with her and she says she can't do this right now. She says she has kidnapped girls in Nigeria and a meeting with the

hostile Chinese premier. He asks if he should go sit in the dark and wonder who killed their son. She says — for now — and he leaves but sasses her on the way out.

Charlie watches the kidnapper's video. They force the girls to say that the Islamic religion is the only true religion but then says her name and begs them not to let them take her face. POTUS rides with David and reassures her about the Chinese meeting. She says it's the girls in Nigeria. She says the hard thing about having power is not being able to choose it. He tells her they can't right every wrong and she tells him not to catch phrase it. He apologizes.

Maureen shows Charlie something from a WHO worker. There is a pile of bodies and she asks what village. Maureen tells her it was Yola. Charlie says those are the bodies of the girls they didn't help last month. She goes to give Nick back his phone and he's annoyed. He says he's not her enemy and she says to prove it. She asks if he still has assets in Africa and he realizes she wants to go after the girls. He says it would cost \$4-5 million. He says they need authorization and that DC changed the rules.

She says it only matters if they get caught. Nick asks what's in it for him and she says he'll have a deposit in her favor bank. He says he's see what he can do. We see a flashback to five years ago — Midnight City — a black site ship cruises through dark waters. Charlie is on board. Nick is there and introduces himself. He takes her down to the detainee and says he's ready to question.

He says they are in international waters and different rules apply. She wants to go in with him and he says if she pukes she cleans it up. They go in and Omar Fatah is there tied to a chair. Nick tells him today's he's going to terrorize him. He tapes the guy's mouth shut then holds his nose so he can't breathe. He takes a photo then lets him go. The guy is panting. He shows him the photo and tells him he just took that from him and says it took just 30 seconds.

He asks if he wants to see what a day with him looks like or a month. He pours gasoline on the guy. Charlie tries to get him to stop but he won't. He opens a lighter and asks where Sheik Hakkam is. He flips the lighter open and the flame is there. He tells the guy to nod. Charlie lunges and Nick hauls her out. He tells her he's going to kick her ass and throw her off the boat if she does this again. She says what he's doing is illegal and ineffective. She says he'll never talk to him.

She tells him Fatah's loyalty is to family and says his brother recruited him then died. She

says he imagined a different life for himself as a farmer and those are the emotions he needs to access. She tells him Fatah is tougher and he's going about it wrong. Nick orders her to watch from the other room. Back now, POTUS holds a press conference. She's asked if Chu walked out of the meeting but the President says talks are ongoing.

They ask her about the kidnapping in Nigeria. She says their thoughts and prayers go out to those girls and their families. She says their counter-terrorism people are working with the Nigerians. Kurt talks to Maureen about her ex and comforts her. POTUS tells Charlie she can't take action in Nigeria and say sit could put the Chinese talks at risk. Charlie says they found a mass grave of girls near Yola. POTUS remembers them from the briefing.

Charlie says they are close to finding the village and says they could send in a private outfit. POTUS says she may not need to hear this now and says forgiveness after is sometimes better than permission before.

Charlie calls Lucas and asks about China's oil interests in Africa. She asks for specific Chinese oil interests there specifically in Nigeria for leverage. One of the kidnapped girls digs under a fence and tells another they can't stay. Her friend says if they run, they'll kill them. She says if they stay, they'll rape them, sale them and then kill them. Her friends helps her dig.

She says it's the only way for them to see their families again. One of the girls wiggles out but the other refuses to go. The escaping girl hears a noise and hides as one of the kidnappers walks nearby. She hides behind a tree then runs but another grabs her and says Hakeem is going to like her fight. He hauls her away. Charlie gets home and sets down her phone. She looks at photos of Aaron and thinks about him asking her to marry him before they go to Kabul. She says he has to talk to her mother first.

She pours herself a drink as there's a knock at the door. It's Nick. She says if he keeps following her, they're going to have problems. He says they already have them. She lets him and pours him a bourbon too. He says she has a heavy pouring hand as he takes the mostly full glass of hooch. He says he has what she wants and says it's private military out of Lagos that can be controlled and easily denied. She thanks him and asks if he wants credit for it with POTUS.

He says no but wants to know that he's in her favor bank. She agrees. At the office, Charlie calls David and says she has to talk to POTUS. She says she's on the way in to meet with Chu and Charlie says not helping these girls is just wrong. She tells her the window for taking action is closing and says she thinks she has a way to rescue them that won't come back on the US. Payton says she's listening. Chu and Payton are shooting skeet. She tells him he has a good eye.

She also says it's too bad they couldn't find a more balanced relationship. She says she read his essays on building the Chinese dream. She says she has Congress to get through to achieve her dreams and he says she should abolish it. She says she appreciates him treating her as a contemporary and equal. She shoots then and blows the target out of the sky. She tells him the US Air Force taught her to shoot but says he already knew that.

She asks him to walk with her and mentions Chinese oil interest in Nigeria. She says one area in Gumbay is particularly dangerous. He says they hired a top international security firm. She offers to loan him another force that will secure his oil fields as well as rescue the kidnapped girls. He says he's enjoying their visit and POTUS agrees. We hear screams as the men drag the girls away one by one.

Hakeem comes to tell the girl that tried to escape that tomorrow night she'll be his wife. Charlie goes to work and pulls up images of the area trying to locate the village. Maureen says the bus was taken 10 miles out from the forest. They pull up lesser known trails. They add topography. Charlie says to take away mountain roads and says they would have evaded villages with civil defense forces. Dashiell works up some suggestions.

Navarro comes to watch. He asks to talk to Charlie. He says he didn't know they had JSOC or a Seal team there. She says it's an unusual situation and he tells her to save it. She says she found a security team that took it up on themselves to search for the girls. He leaves looking annoyed. She tells Earl that it's go time and he says it should be done in 45 minutes. They wait and watch the team move in.

Syd meets with Charlie and tells her that Nick knows the security firm they're using and says he knows them too. He says they are way off the books black ops like he and Nick both are. He tells her that he checked Nick out and says he's clean regarding the texts and pic she was sent. He tells her she looks relieved and that worries him. He tells her that someone out there knows and she says someone with enough clout to get their hands on an illegally snapped photo.

They rush the girls away and then get word of one last person. It's Boko. They shoot him in the chest then go to check him. They tell them their alpha target is KIA. They say they have all the girls and are bugging out with them. There are high fives and hugs all around the ops center at the CIA.

Charlie calls POTUS and tells her it's done and safe. She asks if there's anything else she needs to know and she says no. They hang up after exchanging pleasantries. They pop champagne in the room when Charlie comes in. Kurt asks Maureen to dinner — he was hoping for a date but the others come along. Charlie declines. The kidnapped girls are delivered back to their village to their happy parents.

Charlie heads to the bar to hook up with the juicy barista. Navarro watches news of the Nigerian girls' rescue as he reads a file. Nick unwraps a gun from a cloth and looks at it. Is it the gun that killed Aaron?

The woman complains to the guy that they won't take the pill. A guy bursts into the clinic and starts looking through their supplies and shoving people around. He asks for drugs and the guy says just for malaria. He demands their shoes. Suddenly, there's an earthquake or something. The lights flicker, things fall over and then the lights go out. A bio-hazard storage fridge has fallen over and a vial with a disease in it has smashed.

Charlie is having a nightmare about Midnight City. She wakes and thinks back to finding Fatah and tells him she watched what Nick did to him. She quotes the King of Persia and says she knows his history and everything about him. She says she knows why he does it and she says she wants to kill people too. She says the desire to hurt, hunt and kill is very much alive in her too. Her phone buzzes and she's back in the present. Someone texts her a photo of a gun and the words bang, bang.

She gets up out of bed and heads downtown. She pulls on a jacket, pops on a hat and tucks up her hair then heads over to Nick's. She shows him the text and says it's escalating and this is a threat. He tells her he got it too and says he has a lead. He won't tell her and says he'll play it out. She asks if they're being blackmailed but says she can't see an angle. He says once they clone the op, they'll know the players because they know the targets — them.

Maureen comes out to ask the IT guy if he's done. He's listening to a French app while he works. Charlie comes in and tells him to turn it off or she'll toss it down the burn chute. The

others smile. She asks what's new today. Dashiell tells her Sheik Hakam is making new friends including Abu Sayyaf and Charlie says they need a new leader for top of the book since it's not actionable. Maureen tells her there's bad stuff in Panama after the earthquake.

She says they found a smallpox outbreak. Charlie says it's back of the book unless more crops up. She sends Lucas to check on Hakam. At a kids football game, Nick sits in his car watching. Looks like he's watching a coach. POTUS gets an unscheduled meeting request from Senator Green. David tells her to let her in and she agrees. Senator Green says they are finishing up the report on the convoy attack and there is something in there that could hurt Payton.

She asks Green what this is about and the Senator says she should assume the worst about what's coming from the report. POTUS says she won't thank her for the visit and the Senator leaves. In Panama, the aid workers are treating the people injured in the earthquake. They are running low on supplies and they won't have any more or at least 48 hours.

Charlie talks to POTUS about the book and then says a DOD sniffer plane found smallpox in central Panama. She says she thinks it's an error but Payton says it's not. Navarro comes in then and Payton greets him. Charlie says President Valera should be positive if they reach out. Navarro tells Charlie she's not cleared for this but Payton lets her stay.

Navarro says there were active smallpox vials at the hospital — it was a former American research facility — and most if not all of the vials were broken. POTUS says they were researching bio weapons. Navarro says he wants to work up some plausible deniability and POTUS asks him to keep Charlie in the loop. They leave and Navarro says he understands she has a special relationship with the President but says the agency will be their long after the President is gone.

He tells her to be clear on who her loyalty is to and she says she's very clear. Mo and the others talk about the CIA challenge coins and that Mo's ex stole her Basra coin. Lucas says exes take and that's why they're exes. They're eating a nice buffet courtesy of Charlie and they tell her it's a bribe. She pulls them in and tells them about the smallpox. She says they have to recover the vials.

Dashiell asks shouldn't the Panamians do it but they can't let them because it's US smallpox. Charlie says Jack Dawkins and his team are going on. She tells Mo to get some bio-weapons transportation transportation info. She tells Kurt to get 3D maps of the info to get to Jack en route. Marshall reminds Constance of when they used to eat on the cheap. She says they got where they are by hard work

David comes in and says he wants to talk about Senator Green. David says he can dig in and try to find out what's in the report. David asks her again to look into it and says it won't come back on her. This time she agrees. Charlie tells Jack where the vials are and asks him to leave a light or non-existent footprint. He tells her they'll be models of discretion.

Nick follows the coach and his kid home. He lurks outside watching the guy do dishes and kiss his wife. Nick is in his house with a gun out and tells him to sit down or nobody else wakes up. He asks the guy if he remembers him. He tells him it's been a while. The guy — Dale — says he was just a guard on the boat and didn't know anyone's name.

Nick asks why he's taking photos of people he doesn't know on a boat that doesn't exist. He says he knows he paid cash for that house. He asks why he took the photos and the guy says he did it for the money to buy the house. Nick puts the gun up to him and asks who he sold the photos to and he says — the Krieg Group. He says they're a lobbying group, right. Nick says no.

He holds a gun to his head. Dale sees his kid in the doorway and Nick does too. He goes over to the boy and tells Dale the kid just saved his ass. He walks out of the house. Senator Green gets a missive from the Oval Office — an invitation to a state dinner. She accepts. Charlie meets a woman who says Syd asked her to help her. She looks at the texts.

She says she added an infiltration program. She tells her to reply to the text and it will install a program that will let her listen in on the other phone. The woman walks off into the dark after Charlie thanks her. Nick finds Charlie in the CIA lobby and he says the guard on the boat took the photos and sold them to the Krieg Group. She says it's a PMC.

He says it's a massive place and that it's really bad. She says she has a line on the texter and he tells her to point him and he'll shoot. He says they need to move fast or consider exit strategies. He leaves. She thinks back to watching Nick torture Fatah. She makes notes on what torture is and isn't effective anymore. Nick is worn out from torturing the guy.

She makes a note that Nick is losing faith in the op. We see him stand back up and go back over to Fatah and wrap a jacket on him. He asks him to tell him where the Sheikh is so he can go

away and take all the fear and pain with him. Now, Charlie watches Nick walk out. Jack's group is over the water headed into Panama.

Charlie comes in to watch the ops. They are at audio only and they sit and listen. They are one minute out from the hospital. They can't land so they opt for a fast rope insertion. They put on their masks and helmets. They count down and then rappel down to the hospital and force their way inside quickly, guns drawn. They head down to the basement.

They find a lock still intact, cut it and kick the door open. That's where the broken vials are. They pop open a bio-hazard case and begin inserting the vials. They confirm via radio that they're clear. They head back out. The female aid workers walks up on them and panics thinking they're foreign soldiers. They reassure her, then see past her down the hall that there are a load of people there in the basement.

They call back to Charlie that they have exposure on the ground. The group talks about how many may have been exposed and she asks what the window is on inoculation. She tells Jack to evac the package and he says to get him the vaccines and the WHO can administer them. She tells Jack to go but he breaks protocol and asks to help. She agrees.

Jack tells the aid worker they're coming back with vaccines. Nick goes to meet Syd in the park and Syd says he's been watching him watch him for the last 15 minutes. Syd asks what he wants and Nick says he knows Charlie read him in on their problem. He tells him who took the photo and who the guy sold it to. Nick says what Charlie doesn't know yet is that Syd has worked for Krieg.

Syd says he's not connected to the texts and asks what would benefit him from prodding Charlie. Nick says it's pretty good leverage to hold over Charlie. Syd says he has no desire or need to leverage Charlie, tells him to go to hell and then says he knows Nick has also worked for Krieg. Nick asks how he's covering Charlie's ass and Syd says he can't lay down cover for her on this because Krieg is like smoke.

He says they can get to anyone anytime and tells Nick his lead is a dead end. He walks away and leaves Nick there. Charlie replies to the text and the program starts running. She hears a woman speaking French and thinks about the tech from earlier. She goes downstairs and slams him against the wall. She asks why he's texting her and reminds him she interrogates people for a living.

He tells her Dash threw his tablet down the burn chute. She goes down and finds the tablet and she searches for the phone. She finds it and pockets it. She checks the bag it was in and sees some of her docs in it. The maintenance guy confirms all the stuff in the bin was from seven. She goes back up and looks at her people. She's dressed all hot for the State dinner.

She goes to walk out as Mo says they had a win today and that doesn't happen often. Charlie murmurs — a win, yeah. At the State dinner, Charlie orders a soda and Marshall comes over to have a drink with her. Payton greets Senator Green and they smile for the camera. She thanks her for the warning but says she won't let her son's murder be used as political currency by anyone.

Charlie and Marshall watch her and he says she's not the same woman she married and has gotten good. Lucas hands Mo a challenge medal. She asks where he got it and he says her ex has been flashing it in bars to brag about his time in Basra and pick up women. Her phone rings and she gets grim fast. Navarro gets a text at the dinner and he goes to Charlie and whispers to her.

She tells Marshall she has to go. She goes to David and says she has to talk to POTUS urgently. He pulls her away and she comes to Charlie. She says the mission is complete and they got the vials out but Jack was taken into custody as a spy by the Panamanians while he was delivering vaccines to exposed civilians. POTUS says they have to disavow him. Charlie says she understands.

We see Jack lying in a filthy prison cell. POTUS says Jack pulled her out of hell in Kabul and tells Charlie to find a way to get him back. She agrees. Charlie is at a stop light when Nick hops into her car. She tells him to stop stalking her and he says to lock her doors when she's driving (what car is she driving that doesn't auto lock?) He asks if she's okay.

She tells him the mystery texter is one of her team and he says it's not surprising that it's someone close. He says it always is. He touches her hand and says she's not alone. He tells her that Aaron is gone and she can move on. She tells him not to do that and he says he's sorry. She pulls the car over. She thinks about waking up to Aaron and watching him sleep. He gets teary.

He tells her that it's still there with them and doesn't go away. She looks at Nick and he touches her hair. She closes her eyes and leans her face into his hand. He strokes her cheek. We see POTUS speaking at the State dinner. Nick leans in and kisses Charlie. David ends a call as she wraps her speech. Nick looks at Charlie and kisses her more deeply.

David tells POTUS the report leaked and there's something very disturbing in it. Syd tries to call Charlie to warn her but she doesn't take the call. He leaves her a message saying the bullet that killed Aaron came from a CIA registered weapon. Charlie's window is busted out and Nick is dragged from the car. A black bag is put over his head and he's dragged away by some guys in black.

They shoot out her tires so she can't follow. Charlie sees her phone and the voice mail and she listens. The message from Syd says that he can confirm that the bullets that killed Aaron came from Nick's gun. She's in shock.

They are zip tied and their mouths are taped over. They ride out in the desert with them and drag them back out of the van the next morning. They take them into a building and force them to kneel. A man gestures and the bag is pulled off the American's head. There's a video camera trained on him and a man approaches him with a knife. He asks if he knows who he is. The man nods. He cuts his throat.

David tells POTUS that the report about her son's death are still sealed but are being leaked. The biggest item is that her son was killed by a CIA weapon registered to Nick Vera. She says she wants to know who leaked it. She has Charlie and Navarro there among others and asks who Nick is and why his gun shot her son. Charlie thinks about Nick being dragged away as POTUS asks where he is.

Navarro has to take a call and the Prez asks if she knows Nick. She says she does but they weren't friends. POTUS asks if he was aiding Fatah and she says she doesn't think he killed Aaron. She tells Charlie to find Nick. Navarro comes back in and says Fatah kidnapped an American journalist. In the ops center, Charlie comes in. Jules says he won't kill it. David says fine.

He says they can trade. He writes something down and David says it's an IOU for a bigger story. He says the gun that killed Aaron was a CIA gun. Jules says the CIA guy's name would be redacted but David says he knows it and will tell him if he pulls the story. Jules says that's illegal but a big get and they toast to it.

Senator Green comes to see POTUS and she tosses down a folder to the woman. She says if she reroutes this pipeline it will cost thousands of jobs in her state. She asks what this is and POTUS says she knows she leaked portions of the report. Green says the report will be made public with or without the leak. Green says she gave her a heads up and says her son was killed by a CIA weapon.

She says Charlie sits next to her every day and says that's the treachery she should be concerned with. She tells her that Charlie and Nick's relationship was more than just professional. She leaves. Charlie goes back to the office as she thinks about Midnight City. She and Nick were eating with Omar and talking to him about being their asset and being an agent of change.

They promise to help him and his family if he turns over Sheikh Hakham. Nick says they're going to wash him up on shore. He asks how he'll contact them. They let him go and Nick says they don't have him but Charlie says she thinks he's there and is solidly recruited. She says he proved himself by giving them the Syrian cell. She tells Nick for sure that he's theirs.

She says only the two of them and Director Blake will know. She says Fatah's code name will be Pegasus. She asks her people what they have on the raw footage. They show her the camera guy that was with Logan. They ran facial recognition and found him in a training camp video of Sheikh Hakham's. They wonder if Logan gamed them. She says Fatah did.

She says Fatah worked Logan as a mark. POTUS asks David if they should really go to Qatar now and he says it's best not to look weak when the report is coming out. POTUS tells David that Green told her that Charlie and Nick are romantically involved. He asks if she believes it. Payton says she believes in Charlie. David tells her to fire Charlie immediately. He says his job is to shield her.

He says Charlie is the most direct line to her. Logan gets a call about his impending book deal. He says he's a player gain. He drives and smokes gleeful about his newfound fortune. He

starts coughing hard and then runs off the road and into oncoming traffic. He drives head on into a semi truck. Interesting. That's a loose end but who took care of him? David? Charlie?

Jules meets David at a bar and tells him that Logan is dead. He says he had a heart attack and drove into a semi. Jules says 36 is young for heart trouble. David asks what he's saying and Jules says the deal is off and he's running the interview. David says it could be seen as an act of treason. Jules tells him to keep the other story he offered and he'll keep the one he already has.

Mo tells Charlie the Fatah interview is going to air. Dash comes in and says Aleek Al Moosari is their camera man. He was actually born in the US and radicalized. He died in 2012. He fakes his down death. She says he's a shadow in Fatah's service and says they have to get him. It's time for the interview. They dedicate the interview to the memory of Tom Logan.

Fatah says death comes for us all and he wants to prevent this. He says he wants to know he wishes them no harm but their leaders have come after them. He says they want their people released and Americans off their soil. He says to cease killing their people with drones. He says meet these demands or die. He says we are your brothers, sisters and fathers, your children. He says we are the friend you invite over, your coworker, your doctor. He says we are everywhere. Our disciples are everywhere.

We see people all over the US watching this video. Charlie fills POTUS in on Al Moosari on Air Force One. She says he may be part of a US cell. She asks about Nick and Charlie says Nick didn't kill Aaron. She says she had a gun that Nick gave her and something happened and it was used on Aaron. She says when they got out of the firefight, she realized she didn't have it on her.

POTUS asks why Nick gave her a gun and Charlie says he wanted her safe. POTUS asks if she loved Aaron and she says she still does very much. Payton says they have a job to finish starting with Al Moosari. Payton asks if there is anything else she's keeping from her and Charlie says they're not. She walks out and David comes in. He asks her if everything is all right. She says she wants eyes on Charlie — every move and every word. She says she wants to know everything.

Charlie finally takes desperate and dangerous measures to remember the events of the convoy attack.



On Air Force One, Charlie drinks coffee and wanders. Mo asks if it's pronounced Cutter or Kut-are. She says Cutter and asks Charlie what's up. She says Fatah set up this terror network and they're stuck on the plane. Mo says they nicknamed Al Moosari — the Moose. She tells Charlie she's still digging and trying to find Nick. In Qatar, we see a guy go into his garage and load up a backpack with some items, put on a helmet and leave on his motorcycle.

Payton talks to David in the limo and he says they need to tread lightly. She says they just need continued use of the military bases. David says yes but to launch clandestine missions from. She says she won't let Fatah's network to build a head of steam like Al Qaeda. She's got a strategy ready. The motorcycle guy speeds through traffic toward the convoy. Mo talks to Charlie about Fatah but she's lost thinking about Kabul. She says it feels like an attack is coming.

Mo asks if she's okay and she asks if Charlie has remembered all. She says she has lost details and needs to remember. She says she thinks POTUS thinks she's lying and MO says a faulty memory is a lie. Charlie says she sees Aaron pointing a gun at her and says she remembers her shooting back at him. Payton tells David that Charlie is hiding something and buying time. He asks why she trusts Charlie so much and Payton says she was almost family.

David says Fatah is one of the most dangerous men in the world and he built this network under Charlie's nose and she's the expert on him. He says she's not throwing strikes. The motorcycle guy stops and sees the convoy a block away. He speeds toward it. The Embassy opens the gate when POTUS is one minute out. They roll into the Embassy gates and the cyclist is hot on their tail. The guards notice and everyone runs to shield Payton.

They rush to shut the gate and shoot him off his bike. His bike goes down and he's on fire. They put it out and he screams out repeatedly that he works for the CIA. Later, Mo says he was shot twice and has burns. She says the station chief wants them to interview him. His name is Rayst Kamal and he's not on the CIA books but Charlie says it happens. The PM of Qatar shows up to see Payton. She stands to greet him. She sits and he says he was considering canceling the meeting.

He says they're supposed to be allies and says they're spying on them. He says he wants Kamal released back to them. She says he attacked the Embassy and that's all she knows. He gives her a deadline and says to give Kamal back by tomorrow or face closure of their bases. He wishes her luck making war on their enemies without them. Lucas and the others talk about Moose. They say he was supposedly killed by Mossad in 2012.

They plan to release photos of him and see what floats up but Lucas says they should sit on it. Lucas says "Ray" put him in charge and they are shocked by the first name use and says Navarro put him in charge to have a scape goat. Nick comes to tethered to a rack with loud punk rock music blaring. There are lights on him. He sees a guy standing there. The guy sits and pulls off his hat. He has a mask on that makes him look like Nick and Nick calls him handsome. The guy speaks through a voice modulator.

Nick says to spare him the tactics and says they know the same playbook. The guy tells Nick it's unlikely he'll leave this box alive. Nick says he'd better never. He's battered and bloody. The guy asks Nick if he killed Aaron Payton. Nick tells him to take off his face and says he'll tell him. He asks who was with him when he interrogated Fatah and lights a blowtorch to show he means business. He comes for Nick with it.

Kamal sits cuffed and bandaged when Charlie and Mo come in. He says he's supposed to only speak with Ben. They ask how he met Ben. Charlie says they have to see if what he says matches the file. He says he met Ben at a bar. He works for the Qatari Armed Forces in procurement. He says he told Ben about the things that his boss was doing that was illegal. He says he has evidence with his brother who will only release it to him.

Lucas asks if they've called the Egyptians for info. Kurt gets a call and says he needs an hour. He says there's a walk in at a safe house in Baltimore who asked for Charlie. He says he's going. Dash tells Kurt about the convoy crash in Qatar. He asks to talk to Mo if she calls. Payton asks Charlie about Kamal. She says he thinks he's their asset but isn't. She says he's just a pawn of someone who pretended to be CIA. Payton wants to give him back to the Qataris.

Charlie says he has good intel they may want. She says the intel could be legitimate and shows that the Qataris are selling US weapons to Fatah's terror network. Kurt shows up to the safe house and says the woman is in the back. He tells the guard to take a walk around the block. He goes to talk to Ms Anchez. She says she asked for Charleston. She says they have mutual friends and he asks what she has. She says she may have accidentally hacked a secure comm satellite for corporate espionage.

Kurt says he doesn't care who she contracts for and asks to see it. She says the program has data on a bunch of nefarious groups the CIA has failed to track. She says she wants an obscene amount of money after they verify the data is good. He says he's got it and takes the flash drive and goes. He says he'll be in touch and leaves. She calls him a dork. He goes to the car and pops in the drive. He calls Dash and sends the program. He tells him to use a disposable cluster and to keep it away from everything.

Payton tells David about the Qatari's possible treachery. She says they need the base more than ever. She says it's even more important with Fatah's network now on line. She asks Charlie why they're playing catch up on the network. Charlie says they need to retrieve Kamal's intel. She says she's inclined to trust him based on her training and instincts. Payton says once again she has to take her word. Charlie says nothing.

Kurt gets back and Dash says to pay the woman. He says it's encrypted data from the Midwest and Middle East. He says it's like a big 10 conference. Charlie tells David that Kamal says he has satellite images of arms deals. She says his brother is in the Tangiers. She has to smuggle out

the most wanted man in Qatar and take him to the most popular shopping center in Qatar. Mo goes to requisition a vehicle and notices someone is shredding documents.

The Marine tries to stop Mo at the gate and says the Embassy is on lock down but she pulls out. The Marines give chase with lights blaring. With that distraction, Charlie walks Kamal out the back door. They stop her and she flashes her CIA badge. She opens her trunk and they see bags of shredded paper. Charlie takes off in another car with Kamal.

At the mall, Kamal points out his brother's store but she tells him to walk past. She asks if Ben ever taught him trade craft. He asks what will happen to him after that. He says he wants a normal life but she says the chance for that ended when he came to them. He says he didn't do this for America. He says he doesn't like his country helping evil men like Fatah. They walk past the store, go downstairs and go around.

Nick is asked about the photo of Fatah, Nick and Charlie and ask whose idea it was to turn him. Kurt takes a photo of Moosari to Lucas. He says he thinks he was in Cairo for surgery on his eye but Lucas is stubborn. Kurt brings him a bottle and says to have a drink. He says him having the DTs is slowing them down. He says to dry out on his own time and for now, knock back a few drinks, get his head on and help out. Lucas glares but grabs the bottle.

Charlie and Kamal pose as a couple and go into his brother's shop. He hands him the file from the storeroom. She says they need to get Kamal back now for a full debrief. She asks for another way out and his brother points to a service hallway. She says they have to move and goes out the back. They hear an elevator ding and a guy comes out. Kamal calls him Ben and she shoots him. She asks how he knew they were here and he says he's CIA. She says he's not and that he was set up.

She checks Ben over and says she has no idea who he is. She snaps a photo and says he's a CIA asset now. She tells him to grab Ben's bag and let's move. They hear sirens and she says they heard the shots and they have to go now. They walk out of the mall and she coaches him on how to move through the mall. Mo calls Kurt and tells him that Charlie shot someone. She asks for help vetting the intel to help Charlie. Their call gets cut off.

He goes out and talks to Dash who tells him that the mystery girl gave them a line into the terror network communication. Kurt wonders if the timing is odd since the info came in right when they needed it. Dash tells him not to be like that but Kurt is concerned. Lucas comes over and says he was right about Moosari getting eye surgery in Cairo. He says post-surgery treatment requires steroids and they wonder if they can trace his meds shipped from the hospital.

Lucas says he's been sober eight years but then a week ago... Kurt stops him and says he has no interest in this but says just not to screw them up at work. He says his secret is safe and says Mo got a huge problem out of her life and doesn't need another. He tells Lucas to stay away from her and Lucas agrees. Charlie explains to them that she had to shoot the guy.

Dash sees that the intel has been altered. She gets a text saying the intel is bogus as David is screaming at her. She tells POTUS and David about the backdoor info they got that let them vet them properly. She says Kamal was set up to try and trash the Qatar/US delegations. Payton says they can solve them by turning over Kamal. Charlie doesn't like this. David tells Charlie to get her priorities straight and she rants at him that the country is her top priority.

Payton shuts down the argument and asks for a moment alone with Charlie. He leaves. Payton says another Pres went to war over WMDs in CIA info. She says she's still paying for that bad info. She tells Charlie that on her watch this new terror network has risen up and her beautiful son was killed. Payton says the presidency is only as good as those that serve it. She tells Charlie to tell her what happened in Kabul. Charlie says she can't remember.

She says she's told her everything she can remember and would never do anything to harm her intentionally. Payton says she's dismissed as her briefer effective immediately. Charlie thanks her for her time and leaves. Mo tells Charlie not take it personally but Charlie says it is personal for both of them and wonders what if she really did shoot Aaron on instinct. Mo says there may be a way to get the info that's painful and illegal.

The hacker chick follows Kurt and he asks why she's creeping on him. He tells her she solved a problem they didn't even have until today. She says he thinks the CIA is the end all and be all but they're not. She says the company she works for is. He gets hostile with her and tells her not to touch him. She hands him some money and says it's a finders fee. She tells him to donate it or use it take Maureen out.

The guy questions Nick some more and he won't answer and tells him to blow him. He tells Nick to enjoy his trip and says it's coming to an end. Charlie talks to Kamal and hands him a passport. She says they made the base renewal contingent on his freedom and says she wishes him luck in Canada. She says he and his family have been offered asylum. Mo has some drugs to shoot Charlie up with to stimulate her memories.

She hands an IV and says she has HJ7 — she says if it gets too hairy she'll stop it. Charlie says to not stop no matter what she says or does. She steps fully clothes into a bathtub of cold water and ice cubes. Mo starts the IV and zip ties her down. She tells her it's an ad hoc chemical interrogation that has risks including heart stoppage and seizure. Charlie tells her to do it. Mo starts the injection and Charlie says she may hear her say some really ugly things. Mo says okay.

She tells Mo to start recording and she does. Charlie sits back in the water. Mo says they are rewinding the convoy. She talks about the explosion and the attack. She asks Charlie to tell her what she sees. We see gunshots and the explosion. We see Charlie saying who in the convoy is dead. She sees Fatah dragging her out of the wreckage.

She says Aaron saw them and raised his gun but Fatah raised her gun and shot him. We see Fatah saying to her — when one can act, one can act as a liberator. Then the fire fight continues around her. She sees Fatah who tells her that Pegasus still flies then he runs off into the night. Mo sits by the bed. Charlie wakes up and tells her she remembers everything. She says Fatah is still her asset.

There's a video of a tour group looking at DC monuments, then the St Louis arch and the Liberty Bell, Hoover Dam and other landmarks. Someone scales the wall at the White House and runs across the lawn. They make it to a side door and open it, setting off an alarm. They tag a painting of Lincoln with the terror group symbol. Secret service busts in and takes the masked guy down. He says they are all going to die. It's a white guy who was speaking Arabic of some sort.

Charlie is on Air Force One in Qatar. She tells Payton what she remembered about that night. She says Fatah pulled her out of the wreckage and shot Aaron. She tells her that Fatah is a CIA asset that was turned three years ago in Kabul. She tells Payton she's not supposed to read her in on these things unless she specifically asked. Charlie says she would trade her life for Aaron's but POTUS says she created the man that killed Aaron. She's outraged and tells Charlie she betrayed her.

Charlie says she doesn't know why he was there or saved her but says he's still their asset and is high up in the terror organization. Charlie says she has to meet with him. POTUS tells her she broke her heart and to not break her promise about finding and killing the people responsible

for her son's death. She tells Charlie to get off her plane. Navarro tells the group about James Wilcox breaking into the Oval Office and tagging a photo there. Navarro says locations all across American were tagged and they think it's an active AR cell.

Navarro asks about Moosari — they're still tracking him. They tell him they need Charlie but Navarro won't say where she is. Nick is still being held captive and chained up. He manages to get loose of his shackles and finds his clothes. He looks around the area where he was held and finds the mystery mask. He also finds a key and curses. He comes out of the storage container where he was held and sees that he's in Yemen in a ship yard. Lucas goes to see about Wilcox.

Agent Dale Scott (guest star Cress Williams from *Hart of Dixie*!!) tells Lucas that he's got issues including a history of mental problems and civil disobedience with Anonymous and joined the jihad about six weeks ago. He says a professor — Ahmad Ahmadi — "opened" the guy's mind and may be recruiting for AR. They head out to see the doctor. He's lecturing on Asian crime cartels. They interrupt his lecture and take him out.

He tells the class that he's being detained against his will and that his rights are being violated. Charlie is also in Yemen. A guy from the local hands her a gun and ID. He tells her to enjoy her stay. She has her cover ID and goes to check into a hotel. She stands on her balcony and hears her door open. It's Nick. He laughs and smiles at her. She can't believe he's there and alive. He tells her he doesn't know who was holding him in the shipping container but says he'll make them pay.

She asks why he's there. He says the box opened up and he had a hotel key. He says he's wanted in Yemen and whoever left him there knew it. He says the whole interrogation was about her, Fatah and Pegasus. She tells him she read POTUS in on all of it today. He asks if they wait for bullets to start flying. She says Fatah is at Sana'a but that's old data. She says she's going to try and meet him there. He asks her if she feels it — being there with no protection or cover.

He says it's deep and dark and she says they have to find Fatah and shut the Pegasus Op down. He says they could end up on YouTube with a knife in their throat. Senator Green talks about the White House being on a witch hunt for locking up Wilcox's professor. POTUS tells David to turn it off and says Green is a loose cannon. Maureen is with them says they're working on the AR cell and Moosari. Payton says that guy's head on a platter can be their rebuttal.

Dash is working on the tagging of the monuments. Mo shows up and Kurt says they think an attack is imminent. He also says hey have another angle. They have people talking to every Rx delivery service looking for Moosari's medication he needed after his surgery. They're robo-dialing most of Egypt and Mo says to crank up the efforts. Charlie tells Nick that the CIA is tracking Moosari because he's running assets in the US.

He says they need Sheik Akham otherwise it's terrorist whack a mole. She says the Sheikh is like Santa Claus — no one has seen him. They pull up and see a road block. She has papers and they hope they'll fly. Nick asks for her gun since he has no papers. He says they have to play it like old times. She hands it over. The guard asks for papers and Nick hands over hers. The guard looks hers over then asks for Nick's. He says they're in the trunk.

The guy tells him to get out. He gets out and goes to the back. He opens it while another guard stares at Charlie. Nick unzips a bag and Charlie gets out of the car. The guard finds liquor and Nick says he forgot about the booze. He begs them to leave Charlie alone. Nick asks if they can overlook it and offers the guy a big bribe. The guy snatches the cash and tells the other guards to chill out. They let them go and they drive off.

The guards are happy to have the booze and Nick says he hid the good stuff in the wheel well. She asks what his problem is with Yemens and he asks if she knows a certain warlord. She says he went insane when his brother died in a car crash. Nick says he shot the guy's brother — that caused the crash. Wilcox paces his cell and tries to get a shelf loose off the wall. He fails and then tears apart his bed and tries to pull metal off of it.

They have the professor in interrogation and ask him if the tagged sites are targets for terror attacks. Agent Scott says he seems to have a lot of interest in AR then asks about James. In his cell, James takes off his clothes, folds them neatly. Lucas gets tapped then he brings Scott out. They rush to holding and find that James has cut his throat with part of his bed and has bled out.

Lucas thinks about the terror symbol tattooed onto Wilcox's arm. Dale says it took a lot of fortitude to take out his carotid and jugular to make sure it was done. Lucas says it's the first time he's seen someone do that to himself. Nick and Charlie roll up to a local market and head

inside a little cafe. They are seated in the back and brought water. Charlie says if Fatah has eyes on the place, he'll know they're there.

Nick asks if she's willing to kill Fatah and the Sheikh. She says secret police are there and he says those are not his favorite people. They stand and walk out as the secret police come to find them. They make a run for it. Charlie begs for help from some women and they hook her up in a burqa. She thanks them. Nick makes it to the car and wonders where Charlie is. She hops in and he says the outfit is cute. Lucas asks the professor about the \$2.1 million he's moved.

He says he feeds and clothes refugees and Lucas says refugee camps are recruiting grounds for terror groups. He slaps the professor and demands to know when the attack is coming. He tells him to think hard about his answers. Scott says he can't go at him like it's Gitmo and Lucas says he has permission to do what he wants to the guy. Scott says they traced the money and it's clean. He says they have to let him go. Lucas is furious.

He heads back to Langley and into the war room. Mo asks what happened. He says they came up snake eyes and Mo asks if he's okay. He says he's fine and asks them if they have anything. Dash says they now have an internet meme of the AR logo so they are up to 221,412 photos with the logo that may or may not be legit. A kid is handed a package and he puts it in his bike basket and rides off. Kurt says he has something on Moosari and Mo calls it in.

The kid rides to a door and knocks. A slat opens and he hands off the package. An asset snaps photos and Mo tells POTUS she's talking to that they have confirmation on Moosari's location. Navarro tells POTUS the SEALs are after Moosari now. She tells Mo it's a good job. They bring up the images from the ops room so Payton, Mo and Navarro can watch. They have been told to capture Moosari and not kill him. The SEALs touch down nearby.

Nick tells Charlie they're moving on Moosari now and says it's good. She placed a blind ad for Fatah and Nick tells her that her long shot worked. We see the SEALs running up close to where Moosari is located. The SEALs are nearly on top of the place. Charlie calls in and Mo takes the call. She puts her on speaker and Charlie says she has to call it off. She says she has a meet with Fatah in two days and Moosari is their middle man.

David tells Payton to grab him now and use him to get Fatah. Charlie says they'll lose Fatah if they do this. She says Moosari gets them to Fatah and then to the Sheikh. The SEALs call in for approval to go hot. Payton thinks and says to pull back. They abort. Charlie thanks her and the SEALs disappear back into the night. Charlie gets the coordinates for the meet. It's in Egypt. Charlie looks at the rest of the message. The code says "send vera" that means to send Nick.

Charlie asks if he's going and says it could be an ambush. She reminds him he tortured Fatah for months and he says it was an interrogation. She says he can't go but he says they have no choice. They hug each other warmly. He looks resigned and scared. She looks stressed.

He kisses her and tells her he'll be okay. She tells him he's a liar. He tells her she'll be okay and that's all that matters. She kisses him and wraps her arms around him. She pulls off his shirt and he pulls her robe off of her. He picks her up and lays her down on the bed. Navarro is back at Langley. He reads the others in on Charlie running Fatah as an asset. He says four weeks ago he made contact and offered to lead them to the Sheikh.

He tells them their main responsibility is to support Charlie in her search for Fatah and the Sheikh. He says no one else can be read in outside of that room. He says the mission is Bellerophon. Charlie calls Navarro and puts him on the line with Nick. After the call, Nick tells her that Navarro went for it and Charlie says Navarro is likely the one who sent Nick there. Nick says she needs to catch the flight. She kisses him again then leaves.

Green says she realizes what Payton is becoming and won't stop until she makes sure everyone knows it and anyone is in that chair but her. She walks out.

Payton makes a statement while Charlie listens. POTUS says they are united against terror and for justice here and abroad. She ends the statement as Charlie checks her laptop. Nick is escorted into Moosari's place at gun point. Moosari greets him in English and says soon they'll have no home to go back to. Moosari punches Nick in the face and then they put a bag on his head.

beaten. He hears gunfire later and then there's an explosion and part of the jail is blown up. He takes shelter in the corner of his cell. His jailers are gunned down and then there are cries to find the American because he's worth a lot of money. A man is shot down right outside his cell. Jack is taken from his cell by the armed and masked men.

Charlie lies in bed watching the clock. It goes off at 1:15 and she shuts it off. Maureen tells herself to take a breath and get it together. Charlie lies in bed. Charlie is asked about discharging her weapon in Doha. She says the man she shot at was armed and she believed her life and her asset's life was in danger. Her interviewer asks about her being fired as the President's briefer. She says she was transferred. He asks about her memory loss in Kabul and she says she's recovered it.

The man releases her back to active duty. Mo tells the others Charlie will be back after her debrief. She says she'll be back on the Fatah thing. They get a report that some Colombians took

Jack from prison and want \$10 million and the release of someone jailed by the US. Mo says they have to redo the book and put this on top. She says it headlines since POTUS has a relationship with Jack. She tells Kurt to find out where Seal Team four is.

Charlie shows up as Mo and Dash are rushing out. They tell her to get with Kurt to get filled in and she tells Mo to knock em dead. Police cars race by while Mo sits in traffic and they see a red backpack left at a public site. Mo tells POTUS about Jack and Payton says she wants him back. The book is missing page seven and she says the intel about Jack came in late and was left out of the book. Mo says they won't kill Jack as long as they think he has value. POTUS says to look like they're playing ball and extract him.

David tells her about a backpack with the AR symbol left at the Washington monument. She asks Mo what her gut says about this and Mo says the analytics aren't in yet. POTUS is disappointed at her lack of insight and tells her she can go. She asks David what he thinks and wonders how many backpacks can there be out there. He says she wants Charlie's input on this. Charlie comes into the ops room and Lucas says he's actually glad to see her. She dittos that.

They tell her about the bomb scare and they tell her Agent Scott is coming to coordinate. She asks to talk to the guys and they step into a quiet room. She says she wants to tell them about Fatah and says she ran him for three years with Nick and couldn't tell them before because it was off book. Kurt says she doesn't have to justify it to them but she says she does. She says she's coordinating the operation and says when Nick says he has the Sheik in his sight, they'll take him out.

They tell her that Jack is at the top of the book and that FARC took him from the prison and has him in the Darien camp and want \$10 million for him. Jack speaks to his captors as they walk through the jungle. He asks if they're lost and says that narcos aren't good at navigating the jungle. One punches him. They are looking for a bridge and can't find it. Jack mocks them for being scared of the river and tells them how to avoid piranhas.

One of the guys offers to feed him to the piranhas instead and he says to do it. They look for a jungle pig to distract the deadly fish so they can get across. Jack makes a move and takes out one of his captors. He steals a radio and then a gun. He says there are no piranhas in Darien gap. Jack is loose. Agent Scott shows up to the CIA and Charlie says she's showing him eyes only stuff — it's photos of the AR logo all over the place.

She says she has some favorites. One has the photographer's face reflected in the car window and she says to run facial recognition. Earl says they have 17,000 photos of the Washington Monument alone. Mo chews out Lucas for leaving two pages out of the book. He asks if she double checked them and Kurt says you have to double check. She accuses Lucas of sandbagging him and she's mad. Charlie goes to talk to him. She's very upset and says she let Payton down.

Charlie tells her she can do it but Mo says she doesn't want to and wants things the way they were. Charlie says she's running Nick's operation full time and says Mo has to get a line on Jack for POTUS. She says Jack is good and wonders if their old amp station can pick up a signal. She says they need something that can pick up something smaller and she says a surveillance station can pick up something smaller. Charlie says they need to be listening.

Nick is taken by Moosari to a location and he says it seems public for Fatah. Moosari asks about money movement and Nick says Switzerland is not as neutral as it was. They tell Nick to strip and he does. He's down to his underwear and says if he knew it was going to get weird, he would have worn something special. They crush his cell phone. Scott says the FBI thinks the next backpack won't be empty. Mo says he has to go and he asks them not to start a war. They laugh. Earl starts monitoring signals from Columbia. Mo says Charlie pointed out they had been looking and not listening. They notice a walkie on a low Hertz output. They have it near a certain area and then they clean up the photo. Charlie shows them a V that Jack made in the woods. It means SOS. They also have a heat signature about five miles away.

Payton is with her hubby when she gets word that the Seals are on the way to extract Jack. She says she wants to know the moment he's back on American soil. David says this could be a PR victory for her. He says they could remind Americans what a true patriot is. Mr Payton asks to speak to his wife alone and David asks if it's necessary. He insists it is, POTUS says okay and David leaves. Her hubby says David is everything he hates about politics. He says he's

grandstanding for gain.

His wife says that's what the game is. He reminds her that Jack saved her life and doesn't need to be paraded around like a show pony just because Kyle Green is slinging mud. Payton tells him he's an academic and doesn't get it. He asks if she thinks he's being a thorn in her side for the sake of it and she asks him to tell her. He reminds her he's still her husband and says he doesn't take kindly to being dismissed.

Nick is in a truck driven out into the desert. They tell him to get out and Moosari says the problem is money launderers who appear out of thin air. He says he met Fatah three years ago and he moves money and that's why Fatah brought him here. Moosari sprinkles out a sack of gems and tells Nick to evaluate each one. The Seals are cruising the river looking for Jack. Earl says they're a few clicks away. They touch down and Charlie hopes Jack gets with the program.

They head into the jungle on foot looking for Jack and find fresh blood. They uncover a body and tell her it looks like a ground skirmish between two factions. They ask for a confirmation on Jack. They tell him those guys are FARC and he's unaccounted for. He says whoever killed them was a pro and says there is no brass on the ground. goes to brief Payton. She says Nick's intel isn't helping. She says no one has given them the lab or bomb locations. She says Nick is with Fatah and will let them know when they are close to the Sheikh.

ExtremeTruth.net has a message board and all seven were on there but the site has since been shut down but the private messages weren't on the cache. Ahmadi owned the site and that's the problem since he hates them. Fatah tries to figure out who saved them. Nick says it's not the CIA and says they wouldn't shoot Filipinos. Fatah says they have to move on to meet the Sheikh. The other man says the people following them must be dead before they can go on.

He tells Fatah to send Nick to make sure all the men are dead. Charlie goes to see Ahmadi. She asks about the website and says she's an analyst with the CIA. He reminds her they accused him of being a terrorist. She says anything that inspires terrorism is just as bad as terrorism. She tells him the American members of AR were recruited through his website. He says he came to America to feel safe and enjoy democracy and the rule of law. He says the CIA showed him what he came for was a lie.

She says she wants access to the servers. She says she's trying to save lives. Charlie comes back to the CIA and she got the access. Dash says she's been summoned to the conference room. Senator Burke is there. He says there's a congressional committee being formed to address the abuses of the agency. She tells him to take it up with the director. He tells her he's in a hospital bed and that's not appropriate. She says this isn't either.

He says she's only there for her poll numbers but his daughter says she invited her and he says no photos for exploitation. Dash says they found two of the seven talking about picking up term papers at a certain address where they're no school. Nick looks at foot prints in the mud. Some guys in extreme camo sneak through the swamp. Nick shoots one.

The other runs into the woods. When he checks on the one, the guy tries to choke him. He breaks his neck and then the other guy speaks to him in American English saying — you were told to stay away. He checks the dead one and sees an Airborne Ranger tattoo. The other one that ran away pulls off his head gear and curses — it's Syd! Payton looks through a photo album when Marshall comes in. He says he thought she was already in bed. She says she has a lot on her mind.

She asks how his speech was. He says he pulled in a crowd of eight. He asks how the bomb factory search is going and she says Charlie thinks they're close. He says okay and asks what else is on her mind. She asks why he didn't tell her he went to Kyle's viewing. He says it was last minute and she says she was passing him passing classified photos and was sleeping with him. He says he thought they were done keeping score but he was crying at her wake. He says 10 years was long enough.

She says she's forgiving but not forgetting. She says she gave him information about their son as a friend that she refused him as a wife. Nick comes back to Fatah and says it's done. He says he killed one and the other ran off. Fatah demands the gun and Nick hands it over. They head off to the camp. Kurt speeds along in his fancy new car playing loud music. He pulls off the road and gets out. He looks at the car and opens the back door. He searches all over the exterior and then finally finds a tracker. He curses.

Charlie and the gang are searching the building at that address with a bomb robot. They find a line of backpacks. Seven of them. The robot tries to unzip one but can't. They send a guy in wearing a Hurt Locker suit. He unzips it and confirms it's a bomb. He says he can defuse. He cuts it and moves on to the next. He starts to open the next bag and the whole building blows. Charlie goes to brief Payton on the incident. She says they found the site where they were storing the bombs for the attack.

She says a bomb technician was caught in the blast but says thousands of lives could have been lost otherwise. She says Ahmadi helped them by giving access to his servers. Payton says he's a true patriot and it's a rare thing nowadays. Charlie asks if she's okay and she says she's tired and never wanted this thing to start and now wants it to be over. She says the AR Seven need to be moved to a transparent site and allowed access to lawyers and medical professionals.

She says she heard Banks stepped in hard on her interview with Burke. Charlie says it was pretty great. Payton says Burke will make a lot of noise while the two of them take out Hakam and Fatah. She says Burke will target the CIA while they erase the greatest threat in recent history. They clink their glasses in a toast. Over at Burke's office, box after box of CIA files are delivered to him. He opens a folder and sees that nearly every word has been redacted.

Kurt looks at his desk and tosses his briefcase down. Victor crushes a pill and takes it with whiskey as Kurt comes in and thanks him. He hands back the black credit card and the GPS tracker. Kurt says the money, car and job is recruitment not recon and says he's surprised he hasn't found a hooker in his bed. He asks what Victor really wants and he says he wants him to tell him everything about Fatah and Bellerephon.

Charlie watches the news coverage of the explosion of the bomb site. Mo comes in and says the bombs are off the streets. She reminds her that she taught her to never second guess the trade offs. Mo says there's some actions in the Philippines and says it's an American body. Charlie says if Nick killed an American during an unsanctioned op, he'll burn either way. Ahmadi gets a letter. It's a thank you card from Payton for his service to the United States of America.

He puts it in his desk then goes to a secret door in his closet and opens it up. We see hanging racks of bomb components.

The FBI escorts out the captured AR terrorists. They load them on a bus that's got guards on it and is escorted by more FBI. The people start to chant the AR mantra. They each break one of their thumbs and slip their cuffs. The bus doesn't answer then they follow car radios. They get static then they hear noise. The bus is all over the road and drives off the road and goes nose down in a horrific wreck.

Charlie updates Payton on the op in the Philippines. She says Nick is with Fatah on the way to meet the Sheik. She says from their, Jack Dawkins will eliminate the Sheik. and Fatah. She also shows POTUS a photo of a Krieg group contractor that was found dead in that part of Panama. She asks Charlie if she's heard from Nick and if he had something to do with this. Charlie says if he did, it was in defense of the mission.

Payton says she does not have faith in Nick and says they'll go with another plan if they don't hear from him in 24 hours. Charlie says it's not a good idea and POTUS tells her to put her feelings for Nick aside. Charlie says whatever force she deems necessary to protect the country makes sense. Payton says that's what she'll do.

Back at the CIA, Charlie gets back from her briefing and asks if Nick has checked in. She says they need to hear from him. Banks comes in and tells Charlie she has a problem with the AR7. He says they only recovered six of the terrorist's bodies. He tells her she and Lucas need to go on site and meet with the FBI. Dash says he's the FBI briefer. Banks says he doesn't care and doesn't trust the FBI to contain the risk.

Banks says when he comes down there, he feels 100. Dash says he looks great. Banks glares and leaves and they ask Dash if he was flirting with him. David comes to see Jules who says he knows he has some shit going down in the Philippines. David asks if he's looking for another Blackwater story and says there are private military contractors down there and something is going on.

He says he can trade for something else if David doesn't want him to run the story. He says he wants an interview with POTUS tonight about everything but the Philippines. David says the notice is too short and Jules says to take it to her. He says the dead man's name is Jacobs and he has a camera friendly wife and kids. He says it will feed the whispers of impeachment. A boat trolls down the river.

Nick and Fatah are on board. Another group of armed men greets them. They take them into a camp on the shores of the river. Fatah calls out a Muslim prayer. The others gather around. David takes the deal to POTUS she says the choice is easy and she should do the interview. He doesn't like it but she's ready to do it to cover up the news of the man hunt. David wants to stall.

Payton says if he runs the story, it can damage the op but David says the interview will make her look scared and like she's covering something up. David says her next time on TV should be a victory lap to announce the deaths of Fatah and the Sheik. Charlie sees they all broke their thumbs to get loose of their cuffs. Kenneth Travers was the one who got away and they wonder if he has more to do.

We see the young man running through the woods. He looks battered but is alive. Earl shows Mo what the chatter looks like. He says the online chatter is non-existent. He shows it the day before the bombing and then today. Dash says something massive is coming and only Kenneth the escapee knows what it is. Lucas says Kenneth was in and out of foster homes. They go talk to Agent Hernandez.

One foster family seemed to connect because he was on the honor roll when he was with them. Hernandez doesn't want to follow the lead but says they can go if they want. He asks them to let him know if they get a hit. They agree and roll out. David finds Jules at the White House. He says he has an appointment with POTUS and thanks him for presenting his proposal well. He says he owes him one.

Lucas says they have no legal authority and asks what to do. Charlie says they need to blind them with their CIA credentials. They talk about Banks and how much they like his absence of tact and call him a door kicker. They also discuss that they miss Ray. She asks how many days Lucas has sober and he says eight. She says that does not sound fun and he says it is what it is.

He tells her that he screwed up with Mo. She says to make it right now he's sober. Kurt is on the phone negotiating a security contract for a Mr Karos. Kurt says it's 250k pounds per operator. He says he's headed to Aleppo where bullets are cheap. He closes the deal and ends the call. Emily comes in and says she was in Bangkok. She says it's a hell of a story but lurid.

She says she'll tell him over lunch but she insists and says he's not a civil servant anymore. She says he can even get drunk and get into shenanigans over lunch. He agrees. Victor watches them go then goes back to Syd who waits in his office. He asks what happened and he says Nick was onto them and he barely got away.

Syd says he's done on this but Victor says no. Syd says he's done what he asked and was paid for. He says his loyalties and Victor's agenda are headed different ways. Victor says he needs to remain operational if he wants to keep Charlie safe.

Charlie and Lucas talk to Kenneth's former foster parents. The wife shows an album of all the kids they fostered. She says they never could have kids of their own. She says it must be hard to understand how Kenneth stopped be that kid in the photos The husband says it's harder that people think they had something to do with what he's turned into or that they're harboring a terrorist.

Lucas says Kenneth is injured and may come to them. Charlie says Kenneth just got swept up and was susceptible to the message and got in over his head. The dad says to just let him die after what he did. Lucas says no wonder he's willing to strap a bomb to his chest. Charlie says

the mom still loves Kenneth. She comes out to talk to them and says Kenneth called her but she didn't want to tell her husband.

The call was like a goodbye call and came from a cell phone reported stolen. The call came from somewhere near a cell tower. Charlie says to look up hunting blinds and cabins since the foster dad took him hunting. Payton rehearses for her interview. David comes in and flips through the questions. Payton asks him to sit. David asks how close they are to eliminating the Sheik.

He then says bin Laden was on that same watch list for a decade. She says she has no exact time line. David says it sounds like a dodge or she's ignorant. Payton asks Violet to get them coffee and the woman leaves. Payton tells David to say what he wants. He says, for the record, Jules and his network need numbers and won't be soft on her. She says he just doesn't like that he made a decision without her.

He asks her more tough questions about Kenneth Travers. Then he asks her about Charlie and why she kept her on and accuses her of nepotism. She says Charlie's job is to advise her. Then he asks her about her husband having an affair with Green and that he was leaving her for the Senator who had already left her husband. She screams at him to get out and David says to get her answers straight or she can enjoy the rest of her first term because there won't be a second. He slams out.

Lucas and Charlie walk through the woods and Lucas says he doesn't like not being armed. She says she is and says Kenneth can be misunderstood or Charles Manson. She pots a blind and calls out for Kenneth. She sees a drop of blood. She has her gun at the ready. She says she knows he's hurt. He asks if she's CIA. He runs out and she shoots him but not fatally. Lucas says he'll call an ambulance but she says to put his phone away.

Charlie tells Kenneth that he has 3-5 minutes before he's unconscious and in 10 he'll be dead. She crouches down and asks if he wants to die. She says now that you feel it, you know how awful a thing dying really is. She asks if he wants to die or wants her to call an ambulance. He says no. She says there will be another attack and he says yes. She asks when and he says he doesn't know. She steps on his arm and he says it's bomb vests everywhere. He says Professor Ahmadi has the vests.

Nick goes into a tent and sees stacks of crates. He opens one and checks it out. He goes to a larger one and finds his phone. He ducks just as a guy comes out him with a machete and he takes the guy out. Fatah comes in and he asks why. Nick says he interrupted him. He asks Fatah to buy him time to call Charlie with the coordinates. Fatah takes the machete and slices his own chest.

Men rush in and Fatah says the dead man betrayed them. The FBI comes for Ahmadi. He blows out the back of his head right as they come in. Lucas calls Charlie and says Ahmadi killed himself and there's bomb residue everywhere but the vests are all gone. He says Kenneth told the truth. Charlie wonders what Ahmad's end game was and why he led them to the backpacks. Charlie goes to see Kenneth.

He's in the hospital. He tells her that he told her all he knows. He says no single man knows anything so no single man can bring AR down. She asks about the Sheik and he says he's no ordinary man. She asks how he knows and he says the website. He says he's an example. He says years ago, the Kush was a pasture and the Sheik worked the land but then the invasion came and forged him into a soldier.

He says the soldiers beat and shot his father. He says he cooked for them and polished their boots and prayed. Kenneth says one night he cut all their throats and burned down the house then joined the Muhajadeen. She asks if the Sheik gave the detonate order. She asks Kenneth why he would do this and blow himself up for him. He says no one believes anymore and the faithful don't exist her.

He repeats the standard Muslim prayer. In the camp, Fatah gives an inspirational speech to the men. He talks to them about the reasons to fight in their righteous cause. They all then chant Allah Akbar (God is great). He seems a total fanatic. Nick watches and wonders at the gleam in his eyes. Lucas gets back to the office and finds Charlie still there. She splits her coffee with him and he says he just wants a drink.

He says that would shut all this down in his mind but he won't do it. She says she understands. He says people are killing, dying and doing horrible things for reasons he doesn't understand. He asks if she would have let Kenneth bleed out in the woods. She says five years

ago, no. Now, she doesn't know. He says the bombs are out there. She says if they can kill the Sheik they stop the attack. He says that's on Nick.

Lucas asks why Charlie is such a true believer in Nick and she says it's all she can believe in now. Lucas puts on his jacket and says he's going to hit a meeting. She tells him to take a chance and call Maureen. He says not tonight and that he'll see her in eight hours. Kurt is having sex in the back of his car. Charlie lies awake. Her phone buzzes and she grabs it. It's Nick. He gives her the coordinates.

He says the Sheik is en route and will be there in an hour. He says this is their shot. He says it will get tricky but asks for a little warning. He asks for the plan for Fatah and she says they have to kill them both and then get Nick home. She tells him to call back when he has eyes on the Sheik. Payton is working on her interview notes when Charlie calls.

She says she's about to do the interview and Charlie says Bellerephon is a go right now. She tells her to get back to her with a full report ASAP. A boat trolls up to the camp. Fatah greets the Sheik who then looks at Nick but walks past. Jules sets up for the interview. He has his talking head there ready to go. Payton walks down the White House halls. She's not in the room and the show is going live. Phillip Franklin says they have to postpone and go live to the seven o'clock news. Payton greets her staff and says let's go. They turn on the screen to watch what happens with the op.

In Afghanistan, in the past, we see Nick and Charlie in a jeep then hiking in a grassy area. He won't tell her where they're going and asks how long she's been in country. She says eight months and he says that's enough time to learn to hate it. They top a hill and she gasps. There's a field of red poppies but Nick says you can't see the war or addicts from here. She says it's beautiful. He tells her they talked about burning the fields to cut off Sheikh Hakam's money supply.

Nick says the game changes as you play and you need to find something you can count on. She asks if he brings all the

girls there and he pulls her to him and says he never brought anyone here. He kisses her. Back in the present, Charlie washes her face and thinks about that kiss. At the CIA, Charlie heads to the ops room and codes herself in. She asks what she's looking at and Dash points out the compound. He says there are 20-25 people.

Mo asks what they do and Charlie says they wait on the guest of honor. Banks come in and says Fatah and Hakam together and it's a good day. He asks if POTUS knows and Charlie says yes. Banks says she needs this to stay president. His concern is Nick on the ground who is not a priority for the President. He tells Charlie to do what she can to get him home. Dash takes a call from Nick and patches it to Charlie. He tells her that Hakam is there. She asks what the window is and he says less than six hours.

Dash tells her that Jack Dawkins can be there in 20 minutes. She tells him to keep his head down so he can get a seat on the plane back home. They lose the call. Earl says Jack is on a

carrier nearby and can be there in 20 minutes. There is also a typhoon brewing that can interfere with the helo. Earl suggests dropping a bomb on it all but Charlie says they need proof of death on both and not a crater.

She tells Lucas to work on a cover story to tell the Filipinos. Charlie walks out and Mo reminds her it's okay to be upset that Nick is one of those red dots. She tells Mo to come up with another plan so that POTUS won't call in an air strike. She says she needs to get Nick out while still getting Fatah and Hakam. Over at the Krieg Group, Kurt asks how they can get eyes on this. Emily is in the satellite when Victor comes in. He asks her to update him hourly.

Victor calls Kurt out and says he needs him on something else. Kurt wants to stay on it but Victor says he needs him outside in the world using his special access. He says they need human intel and says the satellite can only tell them so much. Kurt says he gets it and Victor says a man is only as loyal as his options. Kurt goes back into the Krieg ops room and gets his stuff together. He says he has to go see some old friends then Kurt asks what's on the screen. She says it's bad weather blowing in.

Senator Burke rants that all he got was boxes of redacted files and says investigating the CIA is a fraud since they are Payton's Republican Guard. He has the photo of Charlie, Nick and Fatah and tells the person he's talking to that he has something newsworthy. David tells Payton that the Filipinos don't quite buy the navy exercise story but are letting it go. Payton calls Jack and tells him to keep pushing and find a way. Charlie then calls POTUS and says she's worried about the weather.

Jack says the weather is no problem but Charlie says if the helo goes down, they lose Fatah and Hakam plus a stack of SEALs. Charlie says the op is too dangerous at present. Payton tells Jack to stand down and says it's a scrub. She's not happy but can see the typhoon gathering momentum on her screen too. Charlie asks how long the typhoon will hold Hakam there and Dash says three hours. That means all they have is an air strike with no proof of death.

They also tell her the Ahmadi vests are still out there and if they found out they're targeting their high priest, they may set them off. Mo takes a call saying that Payton called in an air strike. David tells Payton she has less than an hour before the Correspondent's Dinner. She says they can't compromise the mission or let anyone know what's going on in that room. She says she's waited a damn long time for this moment.

David gets a note and says he has to go put out a fire. He finds Banks in his office. He tells David the op in Filipinos is reckless, stupid and is going to get Americans killed. Banks says he knows the presidency is in trouble and says to shoot straight with him and they can be allies. He asks if they're going to strike down his guy on the ground and David says it may happen. Banks says if this goes wrong, David is out of a job and he's dodging subpoenas.

Banks tells him he's young and will still be at Langley long after Payton is good. He tells him he's not that young and tosses him from his office. Earl says the F18s are rolling out and it looks like it's happening. Kurt texts Mo asking to see her urgently. She ignores it and keeps watching. Charlie shows up to the White House and David lets Charlie into the ops room. She asks Payton to speak privately. Payton says whatever she has to say she can say it in front of everyone.

Charlie says she can't send in the F18s and says it's not the right course. She says there is an operative on the ground. Payton says she's protecting Nick Vera. Charlie says it's her job to bring him back. Payton says one man is not worth scrubbing this mission. Charlie reminds her that Aaron was one man. Payton says it's never about one man. She says she will not miss this chance to get Fatah. She tells Charlie she won't stand down and asks if she'll stand with her. Charlie says she will.

Back in Afghanistan, Charlie stands outside looking at the poppy field. Nick comes out and tells her they're out of wine. She smiles at him. They watch a truck pull up the road with poppies in the back and an armed guard. They watch it go by. Nick jokes with some locals in Pashtun. She says they know him and he says they know he could take their livelihood and says it's safer there than Kabul. She says they can't stay there but he says she can run Fatah and they can stay there.

They head into Kabul to a market. Charlie sees a bombing that Hakam caused and asks Nick how they can let this go on. She says Hakam is trying to spread this all over the world. Nick tells her if she wants to blow up some bad guys, there are some down the road. She says Hakam is the mission but Nick says next week Hakam will be their ally. He asks her to just be present with him there for a day. She nods and kisses him then pulls him in for a hug but she watches the

town burn on TV.

Now, Charlie sits at Payton's side and looks at a photo of Hakam on the big screen. She steps out to call Dash and asks to be patched to Jack. She says POTUS is going through with the air strike and asks him to get Nick out. Jack says that window closed and he can't get to him. She asks him to warn him. Jack says if he alerts Nick, she could blow the whole mission. Jack says they can only hope Nick is smart enough to get out of the way.

He says it's Nick or the mission and tells her he's sorry but it's what they do. She agrees it's what they do and ends the call. Kurt creeps into someone's house and then picks the lock on their safe. He grabs out a folder and leaves. We see it's Navarro's house. Lambert meets Senator Burke at the Correspondent's Dinner. Burke reminds Lambert he just got stood up by the President and asks what his plan is. Lambert says he put together a package that will hit between the salad and soup course.

Lambert asks where Burke came across this magic bullet that shows they had their hands on Fatah. Burke says it was in the personal effects of an old colleague. Lambert asks if it was Senator Green and he nods. Banks finds Burke in the bathroom and says he didn't know he and Lambert were such good buddies. Burke storms out. David tells POTUS they have to leave for the dinner and the planes are just three minutes out from the target. She tells Charlie to see this through.

Charlie asks to see the infrared then sees there are people fleeing. She says they're going to the tunnels. She says there is nothing to target and says they will look like they bombed an ally. She says they're gone. Burke approaches Payton at the dinner and she asks if he's enjoying himself. He says there's been a disturbing revelation about the CIA. She says this is not the time or the place but he says it can't wait. He asks if she knows about Charlie's relationship with Omar Fatah. She asks what he means.

She asks if it was in the files and he says it's in the press. Mo calls Charlie and tells her to check a news site. She sees the photo of she, Nick and Fatah. Mo asks what they do and she says they have to kill Hakam. They are in the tunnels and Hakam asks Fatah about his injury. He says he's okay. Hakam says everything they started is coming to an end. Nick creeps along behind them. Fatah leaves the sat phone for Nick and follows Hakam. Nick grabs it up.

Kurt looks at the Top Secret file he stole and then sees he's being followed by an SUV. He floors it and tries to evade the vehicle. He cuts off the SUV then takes a turn down a back street but the SUV is there and blocks him in. It's Syd and he tells Kurt — sorry pal — and pulls a gun on him. Lucas says they are going to lose the biggest target in CIA history. Mo checks but there's no chatter. Charlie calls in and Mo says they're looking for radio chatter.

Nick calls on the radio and they patch Charlie in. He says he's in the tunnels and says he's following them. He says they can lock onto his signal. He tells Charlie to track his signal and let him paint the targets. He tells her to use him as the target. Payton comes back and David says Nick followed Hakam and is sending a signal. Nick tells Charlie it's okay. POTUS is asked for authorization. Payton says it's granted. They signal the F18s. They free the weapons.

Charlie thinks about Nick touching her hair before he was kidnapped from her car. She's near tears. The F18s say they are commencing the attack. Back in Afghanistan, Nick wakes to see Charlie is gone and that she left a note for him. She writes that he can't be surprised since he knows who she is and what she's capable of and not. She wrote that she wanted to let the mission go and makes this work. She says she just can't because she can't give up. She told him she's sorry, she loved him and always will.

Nick steps out of the tunnels holding the radio high so they can see where he stands near Fatah, Hakam and all the other terrorists. Nick looks up and sees the missiles coming at them. In the ops room, everyone claps as the targets are hit. Charlie tells POTUS she was right when she said this would make killers out of both of them. After the storm clears, Jack and his crew go to check the bomb site. Banks tells Payton that this was a colossal screw up and asks how the news got the photo.

He says he saw Lambert with Burke and need to get this under control. Payton says they can tell the truth — that Fatah was their asset and he helped the CIA find and destroy Sheikh Hakam. She says it's the greatest op in CIA history and that Nick and Charlie are heroes. She asks Charlie what she thinks. Charlie leaves the room without speaking to POTUS. Charlie goes to see Syd who has Kurt at gun point. Kurt is shocked to see Charlie.

She asks to speak to Kurt alone and hands her the gun. Syd tells her to call if she needs

him to dump him somewhere. Kurt asks why she had him kidnapped. She says she knows Krieg was shadowing Bellerophon thanks to him. She says Krieg warned Hakam they were coming and asks how they pulled it off. Kurt says it wasn't him. She says it's because of him that Nick is dead. She calls him a traitor but then Kurt says he's undercover at the Krieg Group for the CIA.

He says Navarro sent him there and she says the only man that can verify it is in a coma. He says he went to Navarro's house to get the proof. He tells Charlie he's been trying to call her all day to warn her but no one would give him access. He says he got the proof to try and get her to listen to him. He says he thought TKG was shadowing Bellerophon to kill Hakam and Fatah and take the win from the CIA to discredit them. He says TKG was protecting Fatah.

He says TKG has been tracking Hakam for a decade. He says all they know about Hakam came from Fatah. Kurt says what if Hakam doesn't exist. Charlie says Hakam isn't the real threat, he's a legend that Fatah made up and Fatah is the real prophet. She sighs and says Fatah is the real leader of AR. She says he's been playing them this whole time. That means he must have gotten away or else he never would have given Nick the radio.

She also says Jack Dawkins is on the ground looking for bodies. Navarre says she has to tell POTUS all these things. Charlie says she's resigning so she can do what she needs to do next and that she doesn't want it coming back on the CIA.

Navarre tells her to track Fatah down and do what she has to do. Charlie comes to the White House to talk to Payton but she's already making a press conference saying Hakam and Fatah are dead. After, Charlie tells her that Fatah created Sheikh Hakam to be the leader of AR so he could run, hide and strike at them again. Payton says she just lied to the whole world and asks what they should do now. Charlie says she'll keep her promise. She says she resigned from the CIA and is going to finish this thing with Fatah herself.

Charlie says she can find and kill Fatah quietly so he doesn't see it coming. Payton takes a page from her notepad and gives her the number to her direct hotline. She says only three people in the world have that number and tells Charlie to call when it's done. They hug and Payton says — let's end this. A guy is talking to a girl in a cafe drinking wine. She buys him another glass of wine and he recognizes an AR tattoo on her wrist but she says it's a Pegasus and calls it her spirit animal. He buys it.

Charlie talks to Syd and he tells her she's playing hunches and is going to die without agency backup. She tells him to stop being so grim. He hands her some equipment and says the weapons are unregistered. He kisses her on the head and tells her to watch her six. Payton tells David she wants Burke in jail for leaking a top secret photo and she wants the unredacted report seized. David says she can't do this and she says it's aggressive but they have to empty the ranks of those coming for him.

David says she's going to get impeached. Payton says they can't back away from this battle just because they won this fight. Lucas, Mo and Dash wonder why Charlie resigned. Mo says they need to focus on finding the vests and shutting down AR. Kurt goes to chat with Navarre at the hospital to tell him TKG was shadowing Bellerophon the whole way. He talks about a tech there and says she's trouble because she came in and gave them some info that left a back door.

Kurt says TKG is protected Fatah because it makes money for them in protection services. Navarre tells him to stay at TKG, mine it and feed it to Navarre in real time. Kurt asks if this is operational intelligence and Navarre says Charlie is out in deep water alone and they have to help her. Victor gets a meeting with Payton and congratulates her. He shows her a video showing Fatah is alive. She asks when it was recorded and tells him to turn it over to the CIA for analysis.

Victor says it's private property and he won't turn it over. She says what he's doing is treason. He says it's free enterprise and asks to have a very pointed conversation with her. Charlie touches down far away in a hot sandy place. She hops into a Jeep and takes off. Victor tells Payton she just lied to the whole world. He says Hakam was a straw man and Fatah is likely very much alive. Payton says he better not try to extort a sitting president.

Victor offers to act as a third party and take care of things outside of CIA channels that are under scrutiny. Payton asks if he's asking for a contract and she says he's asking for a hunting license. At a mall, the guy who was drinking wine is woken by a security guard. He's wearing a bomb vest and is confused. He begs the man to take it off him and then it explodes killing him and the guard instantly and sending out a huge blast.

Earl tells the group about Jared Blum, the bomb wearer and says he was divorced and worked at Goldman Sachs. The woman is Christiane Lender and they head to her last address. She has hung herself. Mo says Stacey Dover seems to be an outright recruit and they talk about James Wilcox and Ahmadi and the professor's suicide. They theorize that Blum was drugged, fitted with the vest and moved from the mall wine bar to the bench.

Charlie calls in and Mo tells her about the AR vest incident at the mall. Charlie says Sheikh Hakam was made up and Fatah is the real bad guy and in charge of AR. She tells her to back channel the CIA chatter to Afghanistan. She says she thinks he'll try to take credit for the bombing to build the AR legend. She tells Dash to pull her files on Fatah and go through them to build a hit sheet. Last, Charlie says they need to focus on James to try and find the other vests.

Lucas and Mo go see James in the hospital and he says he was going to meet a guy named Mark in San Antonio. He says he was going to take two vests there and was going to a couple in Houston named Al and Enid. Lucas says he's lying but James says those were the names he was given. Payton chats with Marshall who says he's going back to their other home. He says he's done with her presidency and her keeping secrets from him.

She calls him an arm chair critic and says he doesn't understand what this office asks of her. He says he didn't know what he was signing on for and doesn't have the stomach for this now. Payton says if he can't stand by her side now, he should go. She pretty much calls him a coward. He says she has his heart but he doesn't like the warrior she's become since she took office. In Afghanistan, Charlie talks to people on the street and then goes to take a call from Mo.

Mo says the vests are likely in Houston and San Antonio. Charlie says it's personal and to look for personal ties. Earl says DC is 1000 miles from Minneapolis and San Antonio is another 1,000 miles and then Houston 200 miles away. They wonder why two cities so close together in Texas. Charlie says it's not people. She looks up at the stars and says it's the AR symbol and says they're making a Pegasus. She says it's the constellation. They overlay it on the map as she says that will tell them where the bombs are.

In San Antonio, at a busy park, a man sits in a bulky jacket. Lucas tells Charlie they contacted law enforcement in the target cities. Dash says he finished the Fatah research. Charlie says she has to power down and move because there are too many eyes on her. The guy in San Antonio sits on the steps of a gazebo with the trigger in his hand. David comes and tells Payton that by saying she got Sheikh Hakam she may as well have said she killed Hannibal Lecter or the Joker.

Payton asks how he knows and he says he's the Chief of Staff and knows things.

He asks why she met with Victor Gantry and she says he's trying to leverage her based on that knowledge. She says TKG wants license to hunt down established terrorists like Fatah. David says her critics have accused her of using the CIA as her private army and now she's thinking of hiring an actual army. Charlie wonders where Fatah is and thinks about Nick telling her about the Hindu Kush and saying Fatah only gives them table scraps.

Nick told her he felt like Fatah was using them to take down his enemies, not American's. She thinks about kissing him and him telling her that he's looking out for her because he loves her and then he calls her Chuck. She laughs. He says at her darkest hours, he's got her. Now, there's a 911 call in San Antonio from the bomber. He says he's an AR believer but can't blow up kids. He says he left the bomb in a trash can.

Burke talks to David about the leak and he defends himself. He says Kyle Green was compromised by TKG and says no one is above betrayal. David asks if he's blaming Kyle for the leak and Burke asks why he came to warn him about Payton's intentions. David says Payton doesn't need any more enemies and Burke could just keep his mouth shut. Charlie calls Nick's phone to hear his voice on his voice mail greeting. She dials it again and again. She thinks about kissing him.

Kurt asks for Victor at TKG and is brushed off. He heads upstairs and Mo says they found some triangulation in Afghanistan. Mo says she thinks he's in the Hindu Kush and Charlie asks for sat images of that area. Kurt goes into the server room using Victor's protocol and starts downloading files. Mo gives Dash something to upload to Charlie. Kurt gets the files and heads into the stairwell. He's in the parking lot and Victor asks if he's leaving early.

Victor asks what he took and says the mainframe has a tamper detector. He asks if Kurt thought he didn't know he was still CIA. Victor says they made him a mark because he was easy. He says to be sure to plug that data rip right into the CIA database. Victor threatens him and Kurt says he doesn't have the reach. Victor seems nonplussed and walks off coolly. Charlie lies on a hill looking down over a valley. She calls Payton and says they're nearly there.

Payton asks how she can help and she says nothing. She tells POTUS it's odd and says she feels Aaron close to her now, as strong as ever. Payton says that means he's there and will help her finish this. Dash comes in and says task forces are closing in on all the targeted locations to try and secure the vests. They find one in Texas, one in Portland. In Spokane, a guy in a vest is tackled. Lucas says they got them all and they high five but Mo says they're not done yet because Charlie is still out there.

David comes to see Payton and hands her an envelope. She asks what it is and he says it's his letter of resignation. He says when they started this crusade, they wanted to put a soldier into office who knew honor and sacrifice. He says it's been his pleasure serving her but says she needs someone more like minded to serve as Chief of Staff.

Kurt comes into the ops room and everyone is floored. Dash shakes his hand and welcomes him back. They tease him about his fancy TKG suit. Kurt tells them TKG was shadowing Bellerophon. They tell him Charlie is out there solo after Fatah. He says he's glad to be back and tells them he took a data dump from TKG. We see Charlie sneak down into the valley and pry open the gas tank on an SUV. She stuff in a rag and lights it then creeps away.

She heads for a tent and then engages in a fire fight with some AR soldiers. She hides behind a truck and continues her fight. Suddenly, someone is helping her and she shouts out that American military is coming. The SUV she rigged blows up then and the people flee in terror. The mystery sniper takes out another guy then Fatah comes out and she tells him to get on the ground. He tells her he won't lay down. He says he gave her Sheikh Hakam and she says that was a shadow.

She says he used them to get rid of his enemies. She lowers her gun and asks who the man was he ID'd as Hakam. He told her that Payton said Hakam was dead so it doesn't matter. She says he's not dead, he's you. She says she knows there was never a Dr Jekyll, just Mr Hyde. Payton meets with Victor and says she knows TKG protected Fatah. She says he has the blood of Americans on his head. He says her hands are just as unclean since she lied to the American people.

He says he's offering to help her take out terrorists but she says he fueled AR by his activities. He says Fatah is still free and she says she has options. He says if she's talking about Charlie, he knows about that. He says he can provide Fatah's location this second and says two F22

raptors could be there in moments. Charlie says he hit the convoy in Kabul. She says he saved her because she was his link to the CIA. He says without her Pegasus would crumble.

She asks if he means Pegasus, their operation or AR's Pegasus plot to bomb America. She says she believed he wanted the best for Islam.
