Summary: An international manhunt ignites when the son of U.S. media mogul Katherine Newman is violently kidnapped.



The episode begins in Midtown, New York City with a kid grabbed in the middle of a hotel hallway. The thugs are all wearing masks. In view of the cameras, Leo Newman is stuffed into a suitcase. With the security footage uploaded onto a site called Go Leak, the NYPD have flagged four specific British suspects whom they believe were involved.

We then jump across to England where we see several different characters about to start a day like no other, oblivious to the storm about to be kicked up

around them. And it doesn't take long before the video goes viral.

Several different characters end up watching this video, which make up the bulk of our ensemble. In the Thompson household, deep in South East London, Natalie prepares for her wedding.

Meanwhile, a van driver called Aadesh prepares for his day, hiding his dire finances from his wife. It turns out he's been in New York for a meeting with new clients, which is particularly awkward given they don't have any money.

There's also a university student called Heather who's put on the spot by her professor, Tara, after laughing at the suitcase video. Tara is soon arrested though when police show up.

Over in New York, Leo's mother, Katherine Newman, tasks an FBI agent called Scott Anderson to find her son. All he has to go on is that he studied at Oxford, which obviously brings him across to London. And quickly, he scoops up all the suspects from their current settings.

Interestingly over at the Thompson household, Natalie messages an unknown number who messages her mum. It's from a loan shark.

On the eve of her wedding, Natalie heads out and meets the man whom she owes money to. She needs to pay the full amount plus interest and to "text when good." Eventually she agrees to meet at Selby Road, where Natalie catches up with her mum's contact and agrees to pay up. Only... they're being followed.

After losing her tail, Natalie shows up back home again and prepares for her wedding. Unfortunately, she's arrested just as she's about to walk down the aisle. As she's bundled into the back of her car and taken to Bishop's Gate Police Station, Natalie is complicit with what's happening.

Another character interspersed around all this drama is Sean, a man on a flight that touches down in Berlin. Noticing police arriving at the plane, Sean convinces the flight attendant to let him use the toilet. Eventually she succumbs to his pleasant attitude.

As he heads inside, Sean grabs a different passport, changes his look and manages to slip off the flight completely undetected. The door to the lavatory is kept locked and police soon bust in... only to find it empty.

All the suspects are rounded up (minus Sean who slips through security and steals a motorcycle) and that's where we're introduced to Vanessa Okoye, who happens to be a senior investigating officer from the Anti Kidnap and Extortion Unit.

Through a slick rotating shot, we see four main characters read their rights, including how they can have a lawyer present if they so wish. None of them want to, but as they sit in their holding cells, the camera pans across to Scott in the US, who contemplates whether they have the right guys.

The episode begins in New York with a gorgeous one-shot take of our characters at the hotel the night in question. It would appear they were all there at the same time... but were they responsible for the kidnapping?

Either way, we cut back to Bishop's Gate Station as Vanessa prepares to interview her suspects one at a time. Only, these interviews are all jumbled up together. All of our suspects are incredulous to what's happening but Natalie decides she doesn't want legal representa-

tion... even though her fiancé is a lawyer. Yeah, it doesn't make much sense either but let's run with it.

Each of our suspects are asked about the whereabouts of Sean Tilson. Although they don't know where he is, we as the audience most certainly do. He's still in Ireland, as it turns out, and has gone to visit his blind grandfather.

Sean hasn't been there for a while but stops by to help feed him. He knows Sean is in trouble, and a sympathetic pat on the shoulder to his pa confirms as much.

Next up, Sean arrives to see his lover aboard her boat. With a bottle of champagne, they head out onto the water together.

Back in Bishop's Gate, Vanessa asks questions about Natalie's movements in the hotel. Apparently there's no CCTV footage of her returning after leaving that night. So that gives her an alibi right? Couldn't they follow a trail of CCTV cameras outside the hotel and around New York?

Anyway, all Natalie can remember is drinking way too much and then waking up in her hotel room.

Under Natalie's bed though, Monique finds a whole wad of cash in a plastic bag. There are also messages too, telling Natalie that she needs to pay up. Well, the police soon show with a search warrant, intending to check the place. Only, Monique suspiciously leaves just before they do, with the money no less. As she heads out, she hides the money in a safe place.

Back at the station, we find out that Leo actually went to the same university as Tara, who apparently had a college investigation against him. The evidence though came back as no wrongdoing. Leo's notes are full of details about Tara too, but she claims it's "old news" and has more important things to worry about.

Over in New York, Scott Anderson receives a call from his superior, Owen. He's getting restless and claims they "still have no idea who took him or why." Scott touches down in London and remains determined to make the suspects crack. He certainly does just that, making an absolutely infuriating noise with his mouth and eventually taking the reigns of the interviews himself. He's not challenged by Vanessa over it either beyond a quizzical look and a quick, scathing statement.

Meanwhile, Sean makes it to Northern England, leaving his lover tied up in the bedroom of his yacht. As he makes it to shore, he presses a button and blows the vessel sky high. Sean soon makes it to Liverpool where he kills someone else and takes their car after they've filled up at the petrol station. It's all on CCTV by the way, but the security guard is busy and doesn't actually notice.

In the morning, our four characters are free to go, and they each make their own way home. As they return to their lives, without so much as kicking up a fuss, Vanessa and Scott decide to watch their every move and wait for them to crack. And as they're let go, Sean shows up in London.

As the episode comes to a close, we see a video feed hacked in Washington as the kidnappers rasp that Katherine needs to "tell the truth", showing off Leo who's tied up but very much alive.

Katherine and the FBI doubt that the truth is connected to the businesswoman's recent appointment as the ambassador to the UK. Meanwhile, Aadesh goes to his wife's family and assures them that there isn't anything to

worry about. To calm his in-laws, he joins their carpet business.

Sean continues to text Natalie and asks her to wait for his instructions. Natalie gets home and searches for her money bag. Monique confronts her sister and demands the truth from her for the money bag in return. Natalie tells Monique that the money is supposed to be given to a client she stole money from. She also adds to her sister that she doesn't know anything about the person she is in touch with or the kidnapping that happened in New York. Tara goes to her class, only to get confronted with her superior, who asks her assurance that the institution will not be dragged to the case.

News reports regarding Tara's arrest get published online, involving the name of her college, which paves the way for her suspension. She also meets her daughter and assures her that she

hasn't done anything for her daughter to be ashamed of. Natalie goes to her former company and accesses the computer files. As she leaves the company, she gets rearrested. Monique establishes contact with Sean to return the money. However, she gets arrested right before she could hand over the money and phone to Sean.

Natalie stole the money for her sister's education in New York. When Monique got the opportunity to study in the United States, Natalie took the responsibility of paying for the education as Mon's elder sister. Since Natalie and her mother couldn't afford such an opportunity with their income, she decided to steal money from her client's accounts while doing the taxes. She stole four hundred grand from the client so that she can look after her sister while she studied in New York. As a proud sister, Natalie couldn't see her sister missing such a chance and she stole the money upon justifying her actions herself.

When Nemus, Natalie's client, found out about the missing money, they demanded double the money Natalie took from their account back. They also instructed her to do so by shifting it from other accounts she worked on. To complete the transactions, Natalie goes to her former company. The episode begins with Vanessa interrogating Eddie Walker. When Vanessa asks why he asked about Leo to the officers who arrested him, Walker replies that he assumed that the police will come to him since he was present near Leo's hotel on the day of the kidnapping. When she reaches a dead end in the interrogation due to the lack of leads and evidence, Vanessa releases Walker and starts surveillance on him. Upon leaving the NCA, Walker goes to Aadesh and talks to him.

Vanessa and Anderson use Natalie to arrest Sean Tilson. When Tilson shares the location to exchange the cash, the NCA takes enough measures to capture him. However, Tilson changes the location at the last minute. Vanessa accompanies Natalie to the new location. Tilson arrives on a bike and shoots Natalie upon receiving the fake package from her. Natalie's bulletproof vest saves her from death. The authorities chase Tilson but fail to capture him. The international criminal meets a man who pretends to help him. He stabs Tilson but Tilson manages to kill the man to escape.

Tilson's escape disappoints Katherine Newman. She decides to handle the issue on her own without waiting for the help of the authorities due to their incompetence. She asks one of her accountants, with a maternal appearance, to share a statement from her.

When the FBI fails to capture Tilson, Katherine Newman realizes that her son's safety is in her hands. She also considers the pressure building on her to tell the truth the kidnappers ask as the ransom. Katherine releases a statement that the truth concerns the sale of a property in

London, which she sold for raising funds for the President's fundraiser. The statement reveals that she did not inform the authorities when she came to know that the buyer is connected to the US Treasury's economic sanctions. However, the kidnappers hack Cooper Newman PR's screens and media platforms to release a video that demands the truth about Eric Cresswell.

Even though the kidnappers do not reveal who Eric Cresswell really is, Katherine's rattled reaction to the kidnappers' demand and Cresswell's image does indicate that she knows the white-bearded man. Cresswell can be a person from Katherine's past. As the head of a reputed PR agency, Katherine may have been involved in a dispute or activity that also involved Cresswell. Her or her company's PR strategies may have done wrong to Cresswell or his family for the kidnappers to take vengeance on her through Leo. As someone who has enough economic, social, and political influence, Katherine may have harmed Cresswell for personal or career gain in her past.

The truth about Cresswell is expected to reveal Katherine's connection with the man. If Katherine or her company had harmed the man, due to personal reasons or with a PR assignment of Cooper Newman PR, the truth may expose her and her company.

After getting released, Walker finds Aadesh and shares his suspicion that someone is setting them up. They decide to contact Tara and Natalie so that the four of them can go to the press and share their suspicions and innocence. However, all four of them and Natalie's sister Monique get abducted by anonymous people. The abductors hold them at gunpoint and demand information about Leo to not kill them. Even though the four of them and Monique say that they do not know anything about the kidnapping, the abductors do not believe them.

As the abductors get ready to kill Aadesh, Tara, Walker, and Natalie, Sean Tilson arrives and kills the abductors. In the ensuing shootout, Monique gets killed but the others escape in Tilson's car.

Summary: Hiding in a country cottage, the five suspects attempt to uncover who framed them — or who among them is guilty.



The episode begins with Sean's attempts to hide from the anonymous people trying to kill him and Aadesh, Tara, Walker, and Natalie. He leads the others to the house of the man who tried to kill him. Sean instructs the others to tell the truth about their involvement in the case to unravel the mystery behind Leo's kidnapping. He makes it clear that the only way for everyone to walk out of the mess is to prove their innocence by telling the truth.

Tara reveals that she has tried to unfold the discrepancies around Leo's admission even after the formal investigation. Walker says that he may have talked to Leo or been at the same pub with him for the authorities to arrest him. As they discuss their involvement, Natalie shares her suspicions concerning Sean's involvement. Aadesh, on the other hand, insists on contacting the police. Walker struggles with his wound and Sean helps him by attending to it. As they discuss, a neighbor named David comes to check on the house. Tara and Sean pretend to be the acquaintances of the house owner to avoid suspicions.

Meanwhile, Natalie attempts to kill herself with Sean's gun for Monique's death. However, she fails to do it. Aadesh opens the laptop of the man who tried to kill Sean and finds an email to Martin Copeland, the COO of Cooper Newman PR. As they consider the possibilities of Martin's involvement in the case, David realizes that Sean and Tara aren't who they pretend to be. He calls the police and goes to check on them.

When Aadesh reveals that he had hacked Cooper Newman PR to impress them to get a job, Sean and others ask him whether he did come across anything vital about Leo Newman. He reveals that he did read some e-mails of Martin Copeland regarding Leo's succession to run the company. Sean expresses his suspicion that Martin is involved in Leo's kidnapping upon listening to Aadesh. He informs the others that he is going to New York to confront Martin for trying to kill him and putting an end to his livelihood. Natalie joins him upon swearing vengeance on Martin for possibly paving the way for her sister's death.

Meanwhile, Tara enquires about joining Sean and Natalie from Aadesh and Walker. She realizes that she or the others can never be safe in the UK when they don't even know who is after them. As Sean says, New York will be the last place their enemies or the authorities will doubt they are in, which opens a gateway for them to investigate the kidnapping themselves to prove their innocence without the fear of harm. Tara convinces Sean to leave for New York as a group since the predicament isn't just about Sean or Natalie.

Thus, the five of them decide to go to New York for safety and to find the truth behind Martin Copeland's involvement. As Sean suspects, Martin Copeland can be involved in Leo's kidnapping. Since discussions regarding Leo's succession to become the head of Cooper Newman PR were happening, Martin may have orchestrated the kidnapping to prevent the boy from becoming the next CEO of the company. Exposing a controversial chapter from the Newmans' lives — specifically regarding Eric Cresswell — gives Martin a chance to become the next commander of CNPR.

Martin, who may have lived all his career under the shadow of Katherine Newman, maybe seeking a way to come out of such a position to establish his own authority in his company and influence in the society. Since the kidnappers want the doom of the Newmans instead of money, it is guaranteed that Leo's kidnapping isn't financially motivated. If the kidnappers succeed to ensure the downfall of Katherine and possibly Leo, Martin may benefit in several ways, which can be deduced as a possible motive behind the kidnapping.

After leaving the house to go to New York, Eddie Walker uses a secret device to text that Sean, Natalie, Tara, and Aadesh are on the move.



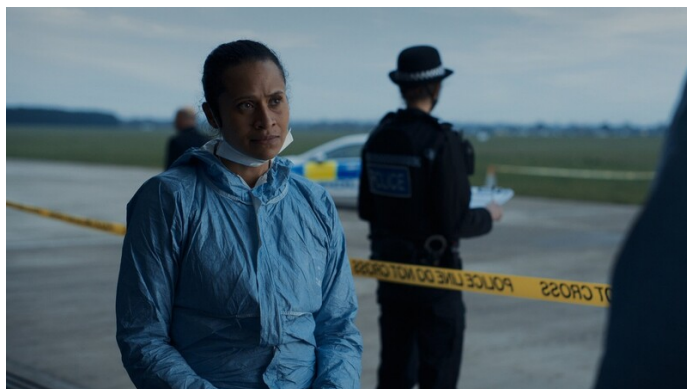

Aadesh uses his tech proficiency to transfer the money Natalie transferred from her former company for Sean to buy the fake passports.

Tara does a makeover and goes to meet her daughter Daisy. She ensures her that she will come back soon after an important journey. After completing the transfer, Aadesh goes to meet his wife Sonia, only for the latter to dismiss him. Natalie contacts Joe to meet her mother but Joe tells about Natalie's call to Vanessa and Anderson. They try to stage a meeting with Lydia but Natalie realizes that the authorities have come to know about her call.

After the visits, the five of them meet at a park and go separate ways to board different flights to New York City. In New York City, Katherine meets Amy, who runs a company named IOP Energy. The first client of Katherine, Amy warns Katherine about the repercussions of the truth behind Eric Cresswell. Katherine tries to convince Amy that everything is under control.

Through surveillance cameras, Vanessa and Anderson find out that Aadesh and the others are trying to leave the UK. As they arrive at a position to choose an action, Vanessa reveals to

Anderson that Eddie Walker is an undercover agent named Liam McKenna who works for her. When initial questioning of Aadesh, Natalie, and Tara arrive at a dead-end, without producing any leads or evidence to find Leo Newman or his kidnappers, Vanessa directs Liam to infiltrate the gang of suspects to find out the whereabouts of Leo. She fakes Eddie/Liam's arrest and interrogation and releases him to find a pathway to get into the gang.

The abduction of Aadesh, Tara, Natalie, and himself give Liam a chance to team up the suspects together. Sean's successful attempt to save them completes the group Eddie needs to follow. Using a hidden device, Liam continues to update the developments of the gang to Vanessa. When the three suspects resist every question and lead Vanessa put forward to them, the officer realizes that the only way to extract the truth from them is to have someone among them, leading her to use Liam.

Since Liam is already in the group to direct them, Vanessa expresses her confidence that together she and Anderson can find Leo by letting them flee to New York.

After arriving in New York City, Sean directs Aadesh and Natalie to stay differently. He accompanies Tara and Eddie/Liam to a hotel, waits for them to sleep, and leaves the hotel to meet Martin Copeland.

They return to Washington Square Park and join Sean with the rest of the group. Meanwhile, Vanessa and Anderson direct the NYPD to follow them. The van stops in front of FBI headquarters and a man reveals to FBI officers that he was hired to park the vehicle in the locality. Upon tricking the officials, Sean, Aadesh, Natalie, Tara, and Walker get into the Park Madison Hotel to see Martin. At the same time, Katherine fixes an interview with Nancy Harper, a famed television personality, to talk about her son's kidnapping to regain public sympathy as a mother.

Upon understanding that silence isn't the way to move forward, Katherine decides to open up about Eric Cresswell in her interview with Nancy Harper. In 1995, Cooper Newman PR's first-ever client International Oil and Petroleum Energy (IOP Energy) commissioned Eric Cresswell, a professor of mathematics and climate modeling, to study about environmental impacts of fossil fuels.

Cresswell's report shed light on the gravity of climate change happening on the planet Earth, especially proving that the upward temperature trend of the planet is alarming. Cresswell also predicted temperature changes in the Philippines, severe heat waves in Europe, and water shortage, crop failure, and livestock fatalities in Syria, which turned out to be true over the years.

Cresswell's 1995 report was a huge setback for IOP and the oil industry in general. Since IOP was a client of Cooper Newman PR, Katherine made sure that the report never gets published. She directed IOP to commission several other studies and reports that gave alternative predictions — most probably fabricated to serve IOP's interests — to discard Cresswell's findings. She also made sure that Cresswell and his report will forever remain in oblivion, only for the kidnapers to resurface the whole affair in the most adverse way as far as Katherine is concerned.
