Summary: A favor for an old drinking buddy leads Hank and Britt, small time private eyes, down a rabbit-hole of corruption in deceptively sunny Ocean Beach, California.



Viewers meet Hank and Britt on the opening episode of *Terriers*. They are private investigators and set about trying to find the daughter of the former's friend.

This case eventually grows much bigger than they realized initially, however, taking them to a wealthy real estate developer in town named Robert Lindus. The girl in question used to work for him and is bribing him with a sex tape - on that tape, there's also evidence that Lindus is lying about a project he claims to be bringing to the city.

Hank and Britt work to bring Lindus down after he kills Hank's friend, and we

close the episode with the pair wondering if Lindus will beat the rap and seek revenge. This is what else we learn about the key character:

Hank is a recovering alcoholic who seemed to have been forced off the job due to drinking. He's still sort of friends with his former partner, Mark. He also pines for his ex-wife and even buys their old home, only to learn she's getting remarried. He had been content just solving small crimes, but now seems reinvigorated.

Britt is seriously dating a beauty who wants to have a child. But he offers up a dog as a compromise. Britt is especially adept at making deals and thinking on his feet.

Hank and Britt tried to bring in a fugitive in order to earn reward money this week. They needed the cash because the police won't release the \$30,000 check Lindus cut to the pair on the season premiere, and because that rich jerk's assets have been frozen anyway.

Gustafson, meanwhile, is suspicious of the gun found in Lindus' house. He thinks it was planted, despite the denials of Hank and Britt (the latter of whom Gustafson warns about Hank always letting friends down eventually).

As for their mission, our favorite pair of investigators stumbled upon a bigger case than they initially planned, as they do track down the fugitive – and he leads them to a larger crime in which he played a role. Hank and Britt end up setting up the main culprit behind this thievery, bring him to justice and do end up collecting a reward for their work.

Hank uses that to officially purchase his old home from Gretchen, despite everyone around him (including his sponsor) thinking it's a terrible idea.

Britt and his girlfriend, meanwhile, trade in their dog. They end up taking home Winston instead, the bulldog of the dry cleaner who sometimes works with him and Hank.

Terriers took a turn for the dark this week. Here's what went down: Hank took on the case of a supposedly cheating spouse because the bank vice president said he'd approve his home loan if Hank could deliver proof that his wife was cheating. But Hank followed her around and didn't see a thing. He later confronted her and found out why:

The bank VP was a rather messed up individual, getting off on his wife sleeping with other men and then telling him about it. But she loved him and never ac-

tually went through with this. In order to save her marriage and assure himself of the loan, Hank devised a plan: he took photos of this woman and Britt pretending to have sex and then showed them to the VP. The man told Hank to come in the next day and sign the loan papers.

When the woman came over to thank Hank, which followed an awkward meal between Hank, Gretchen and her fiance (who asked Hank for help because someone was using his credit cards and had his license revoked), she and Hank ended up having sex.

The next day, the VP refused Hank's loan because he found photos of Britt online and knew he was Hank's partner. Still, Hank did give the man the proof of infidelity he was after: by describing his wife's naked body and saying he "banged the shit out of her three times." When Hank left the office, the VP leaped out the window to his death. Hank responded by forging his signature on the loan documents.

Meanwhile, Britt was approached by a man with whom he used to rob bars and houses. The man threatened to reveal damaging information to Katie unless Britt worked with him again, but Britt ended up setting his old partner up. He's likely headed back to prison.

As for that damaging information, it was this: Britt actually robbed Katie's home years ago. He saw pictures of her there and that's what prompted him to show up at the bar she worked at and actually meet her for the first time. Upon hearing this, Katie was shocked... and then turned

on. She ordered Britt to leave the residence, and then break into the bedroom five minutes later.

Summary:	Hank and Britt return to the Lindus case—courtesy of the imprisoned Lindus himself: He hires them to break into one of his offices and steal \$250,000 from the safe. Meanwhile, Hank discovers that he has a houseguest: his sister Steph.



Hank and Britt visit Lindus in jail this week and receive an odd offer: steal \$250,000 from the man and, in exchange, they can keep \$100,000 and Hank can learn the identity of the person who killed his friend, Mickey, on the season premiere.

The partners accept, and Britt is in charge of the theft. It goes smoothly, they deliver the money to Lindus' wife and keep their half, with Hank now focused on who killed his friend. Mrs. Lindus gave him the name, but the individual just turns out to be a heroine dealer, who says he doesn't know the guy who paid him to

sell extra H to Mickey.

From there, Hank and Britt track down Lindus, who has been freed on bond. He's setting his wife and son up in a plane when Hank and Britt basically kidnap him. But he makes a run for it and gets hit by a car. He doesn't wanna go to a hospital because then the cops will know he tried to skip out on bail.

Therefore, Hank and Britt bring him back to the former's house. Also present there? Hank sister's, Stephanie, who has been living in Hank's attic, unbeknownst to him until now. She's off her drugs and left her mental hospital.

Lindus mumbles to the guys that there's some construction company Mickey worked for. He found out things he should not have and that company had him killed. Lindus now has documents that also implicate that company, and is connected to the operation/murder in some way. But the guy actually dies before he can say more.

This is a special problem when Mark shows up. Mrs. Linus when down to the police department and said Hank and Britt kidnapped her husband. Mark looks around and doesn't find the

body, but orders Hank and Britt down to the station. They go with him, leaving Stephanie at home.

The episode ends with her finding Lindus' corpse.

With Lundus dead, Hank and Britt had to scramble this week to cover their tracks, especially after Mark made it clear that he may get booted from the case if he can't find Lindus and won't be able to help Hank and Britt in the future.

It didn't help matters to have Lindus' wife accusing Hank and Britt, correctly of course, of kidnapping her husband.

The partner decide to run Lindus and his car off the road and make his death look like an accident. With this done, the two appear to be in the clear...

... but then Steph mentions something to Hank: the papers that Lindus had in

his possession (which Gretchen and Jason both confirmed proved that the construction company was covering up pH levels in the ground, and which got leaked when Lindus' body was found with them on his person) were actually forged. It's physically impossible for the chemicals on there to be mixed together in such a way.

Hank and Britt search for an antique ring on this episode. They are tasked to find it by a couple, the female half of which is dying. But the case soon grows very complicated.

Our favorite PI duo does successfully find the heirloom, but they also learn secrets about their clients. For example: he fathered a wife with his mistress, and the ring is actually worth \$300,000, but only she knows that. Once the woman discovers that her husband has been cheating, she aims to change her will and give the ring to their 16-year old son.

But she has to be healthy enough to do so, and Britt and Hank will hold on to the antique until then. Maggie, meanwhile, is the couple's lawyer.

Elsewhere...

Jason realizes that Hank was the one using his credit cards (because he recognized Britt as the guy who stole his wallet during his and Gretchen's engagement party) and gives Hank a nice speech about how he really is gonna marry Gretchen. But he also covers for Hank and says someone else had stolen the information.

Soon after Britt tells Hank he plans to propose, Katie goes out with her classmates without him. She gets really drunk and sleeps with her professor! She wakes up, full of regret and sorrow and calls Hank to tell her what happened. She's an absolute mess, but Hank insists she can't tell Britt because it will kill him. She has to pretend like it never happened.

Britt is taken aback by how distant Katie is acting on this week's episode. We know why, and Hank knows why, but poor Britt is in the dark.

The main storyline, however, centers around an amnesiac college student that Hank tries to help. Why? Mostly because this kid reminds him of Stephanie. We see Hank work tirelessly to prove to the kid, and to Mark and to himself that the confused teen is really a good person... even when we learn he kidnapped a fellow student.

Turns out, the kid had been taking anti-Malaria medication and it made him

act goofy, while also leading to a forgotten identity. Hank's assistance helps the kid realize that he can get better.

As for Stephanie, she's seen better days. She hallucinates a play date with a young neighbor and realizes she needs the kind of professional help Hank simply can't provide. Therefore, she recommends herself for a facility outside of town. Hank pays for it with the \$100,00 in bonds he and Britt got for the Lindus case and emotionally bids his sister farewell, handling their separation and situation far worse than she does.

Britt gets picked up by a Mexican drug cartel early in this episode and taken to south of the border. Turns out, the police never arrested his former partner, Ray, because he fled to this country and got himself in trouble by having Mexican cops swipe cocaine he was carrying for a dealer.

Now, he's ratted out Britt and both men are being held at gunpoint and asked to retrieve the drugs. Britt agrees to do so when the mean drug dealer says his man will kill Katie if he disobeys.

Meanwhile, Hank and Mark have traveled down to Mexico to rescue Britt. He

and Ray are able to successfully break into the Mexican police evidence locker and extract the cocaine, which Britt is then able to deliver to the proper people - but there's a problem. The man assigned to track Katie never got the call to leave her alone because the man tasked to phone her when the drugs were safe got killed.

As a result, Britt, Hank and Mark must hurry back to the States. The latter calls some uniform officers to sit on Katie's house, but they arrive too late. A Mexican baddie is already inside and he has both Katie and her professor hostage. The latter is there because Katie forgot her cell phone in class and he brought it to her.

In the end, Hank takes a bullet making a heroic save of Katie, which obviously prompts a great deal of gratitude from her and Britt. Britt asks Mark why he ever warned him about Hank being a bad friend, considering what just went down. Mark laughs and says Hank will have to tell him that himself.

He learns from Maggie that Jason Adler changed his name because his family was accused years ago of molesting children in the foster home they ran. They were not convicted, and various victims gave different accounts of Jason's involvement. Hank offers Jason the chance to come clean to Gretchen prior to their wedding, which is scheduled to take place in five days. But Jason tells Hank to do what's right.

For Hank, that means taking the intel directly to Gretchen... who can't believe Hank has gone to this extreme, says Jason already told her all about it and disinvites Hank to their wedding. Ouch.

For Britt: he helps a tranny hooker solve the case of her murdered friend. They can't catch the killer because the guy killed himself months ago, but they can go to the friend's family and tell them what a great person their runaway son was. The investigation gets to Britt, who thinks he's gonna be a father because he found a pregnancy case in the trash. He goes home and proposes to Katie, who says yes...

...but viewers know there is a problem: she earlier told Hank that, yes, she is pregnant. But she can't be sure the baby is Britt's until a test comes back in three weeks.

Hank saw him in the hotel and recruited Britt's techie friends to come over and bug Zeitlin's room. They ended up getting audio and video of the attorney threatening a lawyer who was on to the land deal. Hank saved her life and then confronted Zeitlin with his evidence.

Elsewhere, Katie admitted to Britt that she was pregnant AND had the affair. Ouch. Naturally, this made him pretty angry and sad by episode's end. He told Katie he was gonna move out.

Summary:	Hank is determined to redeem himself when he finally get an opportunity to revisit the rape case that prompted the police department to fire him, but the case evidence leads him on a winding investigation that deals with multiple decades.



We flashback to three years ago on this episode of *Terriers*, learning a lot more about why Hank and Gretchen got divorced and how Hank and Britt first met.

As to the former issue: Hank, a full-fledged alcoholic, got caught up in the case of a serial rapist while still working as a detective with Mark. She made it clear that something went down between the pair, but she didn't want to discuss it.

This caused Hank to believe the guy was the rapist, a fact he went crazy trying to prove. He badgered the suspect. He got drunk. He was questioned by Mark for possibly running this guy off the road and planting evidence in his car, a charge Hank denied, but in an angry way.

The rich dude ended up getting Hank kicked off the force, and it's easy to see how this led to more drinking and more problems with Gretchen.

Hank also met Britt during this case, as he was caught breaking into a car near where one of the rapes took place. Hank got a good vibe from him and gave the criminal his card.

How did all this relate to the present day? We watched as Britt took Winston and left Katie. The episode concluded with Britt giving Winston to Katie and saying he didn't care about her affair anymore, or even who the father of her baby was. He just wanted to be with her after his year in prison, due to those assault charges.

Britt then got into Hank's car in order to be driven to jail. But Hank stopped at a red light and asked Britt if he wanted him to continue driving straight, toward prison - or to turn, get on the freeway and head to Mexico.
