Summary:	Sergey and his new partner Anna and her son Misha, his ex-wife Ira and their son Anton are faced with an epidemic raging around Moscow. With neighbors and a relative they flee their homes as infected people and looters run rampant.



The episode begins with a brief shot of a delirious, blood-stained man stumbling through the woods. We soon cut to our main protagonist Sergey who awakens to spend time with his son Anton at the playground.

When his ex Ira arrives their introductions are frosty to say the least. Sergey promises to visit Anton next week and an

argument breaks out over his new lover Anna. However, they're both interrupted by a commotion nearby as a man doubles over coughing up blood and sporting glassy eyes.

At the Detox Clinic we meet tearaway alcoholic Polina who does everything she can to be kicked out of the clinic. After igniting her cell and flooding the toilet, her Father Lyonya arrives to take her back home. On the way though, they almost hit a woman who appears to be suffering from the same delirious state that the coughing man earlier suffered from.

On the road, Lyonya bumps into Sergey and encourages him to visit for dinner. Sergey's son Misha spies Polina in the car and immediately becomes infatuated with her; love at first sight. Anyway, the group arrive for dinner and it's clear there's no love lost between Anna and Marina.

Still, she keeps smiling through the dinner as Lyonya's boisterous demeanor dominates the conversation. Polina cheekily starts touching Misha under the table and he quickly gets up and bolts. Polina excuses herself not long after and starts seducing Misha, courtesy of stripping for his drone.

The evening draws to a close and Sergey sits with Anna, watchin the news as a virologist called Professor Pakhomov starts discussing a new viral outbreak infecting people. It begins with

3 to 4 days of coughing which is then eventually followed by death, which certainly puts everyone on high alert.

The army are called in and slowly but surely victims start falling. The army take drastic measures and quarantine an entire school. The one child infected, with red eyes and cowering in the corner, is shot with a blast of strange white liquid that causes her to start sobbing and crying as she's carried out on a stretcher.

This school quarantine eventually expands to Moscow as a whole, with the place completely off-limits to civilians. Civilians including Sergey who ends up stuck at a road blockade and unable to get back to Anton and Ira. With helicopters flying overhead, Lyonya's flight is cancelled and everyone is stuck where they are.

In the wake of all this uneasy tension, Sergey's Father Boris arrives at their house. He warns that in a week's time there will be no army. No Moscow and this epidemic is about to cause serious devastation. "They" (the city dwellers) will break through and he implores Sergey's family to leave in the morning to avoid getting caught in all that.

Unable to sleep, Sergey decides to try and get back into Moscow. He stows away in a truck in a bid to try and save Ira and Anton. As we soon see, they have problems of their own as Ira's infected mother tries to break into their house.

There's plenty of this going around though as a man breaks into Lyonya's house. After knocking Lyonya out, this soldier tries to rape a pregnant Marina. Thankfully Polina is there and she manages to stop it from happening, stabbing the culprit in the neck with a pair of scissors.

Misha, Anna and Boris all head over to Lyonya's house and form an alliance. At the same time, Sergey makes it to Moscow and to Ira's house. Snatching the pair up, they make it to the truck just in time. The driver is not so lucky though, lying in a pool of blood in the back. Gangs rule the streets and chase after the truck as the family drive up to the border.

Ignoring the soldiers, Sergey bursts through the perimeter and grits his teeth as bullets rain down on the back of the truck. As he leaves, no-nonsense soldier Yuri heads off in hot pursuit to try and find them.

They're not aware of this though, and Sergey makes it back to the house just in time. There's no love lost between Anna and Ira though, which promises to spill over in the near future.

Only, they have bigger fish to fry when the soldiers — led by Yuri — arrive at the house. Anna and Sergey run as bullets echo across the inhospitable, snowy landscape.

Back at Lyonya's house, Ira is paranoid as a man and his pregnant wife arrive looking for salvation. As Boris joins Ira and holds his gun up, they force the pair to head back on their way.

With the pair gone, the ragtag group of survivors band together and form a caravan as they start driving toward a village nearby.

On the way, the group run into trouble when Anna's car starts smoking up. Stuck on the side of the road, they're sitting ducks as Yuri closes in on them. This is only made worse by Lyonya heading back to grab a towline from the house.

It turns out that's a lie and his selfishness deceives the group. With Marina and Polina with him, he intends to drive his family up to Finland and across the border.

After finding the dead man on the ground in Lyonya's house, Yuri starts searching through the family tablet. As we soon find out, that man on the floor is actually Yuri's brother. Yuri spies pictures of Lyonya and the family, giving him a solid lead to go on along with a registration plate too.

The armed soldiers arrive up by the side of the road where they find Lyonya's car parked. Thankfully the trio manage to get away just as the soldiers show up, hiding out in the woods.

With the car gone and the license plate matching that from the house, Yuri orders the guards to comb through the woods and find the family.

As they get searching, mutiny grips the family as the soldiers turn on Yuri and shoot him dead. Lyonya, Marina and Polina manage to narrowly avoid being killed and breathe a sigh of relief when they leave. Thankfully the group have their radio but not much else.

Anna heads out to greet Boris who ends up tied to the car to avoid doing damage to anyone. Thankfully the alcohol has worn off and even better, Sergey awakens from his delirious state to find Anton watching over him.

Igor returns while the group are at the bathhouse and strikes Misha from behind. When Lyonya returns to the house alone, he finds their resources stolen from the boot and Misha lying face-down on the floor.

Unfortunately Igor isn't alone and he's brought guests. They're all infected too and as he heads in with Sergey, they watch in horror as this family of infected stalk toward them. A woman is shot dead by Lyonya as he arrives.

The survivors from the house all stand together as Pavel lends his expertise to Sergey's injuries. Ira immediately takes a fancy to him though and helps fix his broken glasses. With a contact lens in hand, she pins the man down and helps him out.

After calling her beautiful, he asks for a photo to remember her by before these two groups go their separate ways.

After the death last episode, Lyonya remains distant with the others. He also refuses to tell Polina exactly what happened in the house.

Unfortunately the group run into yet more trouble as they find the bridge before them has completely collapsed. Even worse, their car winds up stuck in the snow. No amount of pushing is getting them out but that's not for the want of trying.

It's no good and the survivors are forced to stick it out by the side of the road for now.

fractured, Anna and Ira come to blows over what to do next.

She screams to the heavens but it seems like her son is gone. He's not among the dead and Pavel does his best to stop her sobbing.

Just then, a helicopter flies overhead and drops a whole load of leaflets out the sky. Promising hot meals, medical attention and accommodation, these flyers confirm this zone needs to be evacuated.

As they continue on, the group find a crowd of people being bundled onto buses as part of this evacuation scheme. Among them is a boy who looks a lot like Anton.

Ira hurries down and pushes past the soldiers, scrambling on the bus to find her son. Only, it turns out the boy isn't actually him.

To hide their footprints, she has him lying on a blanket and drags him along. It's actually quite a smart move and one in the clear, they get talking about their current predicaments.

Anton explains the complicated family set-up they've got going on but Olya too has a dysfunctional band of survivors back home.

Anton is taken to a nearby village and introduced to the fighters inside this cottage. Midway through talking, the group hear a radio broadcast crackle in on the walkie talkie.

The soldiers had to kill a bunch of people in front of the bus and they're preparing for the next stage of their plan. Dressed in gas masks, soldiers arrive at the village and go door to door, rounding people up to evacuate them.

When they arrive at Olya's house they don't do that. Instead, they put a pillow over a sleeping man's face and kill him in cold blood.

Under no illusion about what these soldiers have planned, Olya rallies the group together when the armed guards leave. She encourages them to take up arms and they begin training, courtesy of a retired officer in the village.

Back at the complex though, the kids force Anton outside. Thankfully he's safe and sound though, prompting Ira to throw her arms around him gratefully.

As a way of saying thank you, the group hand over a couple of tins to Olya and they say their goodbyes. With 100 miles to go to their destination, Anna suddenly starts coughing and sputtering blood.

This then cuts us back to the road as Anna continues to cough up blood. She decides to drive alone but as she sits in the car by herself, the rest of the group talk. Lyonya wants to take preventative measures and issue a quarantine which Pavel agrees is a good idea.

As they get driving, the group stop on the road as they find an inviting house with the lights on. Only... this house happens to be the same one we saw at the start of the episode. Marina finds the dead bodies inside and screams, prompting Pavel to shut the door tight.

With Anna on a stretcher, they carry her precariously into the house and quarantine her inside one of the rooms.

It turns out Pavel seems to have some sort of immunity to this disease. When he worked in the hospital, every doctor there died apart from him within 3 days. He's never been sick. Is he the answer to this infection?

We then cut back a year and a half to see more of Anna's past. While she smokes a cigarette outside, she listens to Sergey berate Ira on the phone and talk about couple therapy. It turns out Anna was actually his therapist in the past.

This therapy soon turned physical and saw the duo sleep together. Only, while Sergey is getting dressed she plants an empty condom wrapper inside his bag.

Back in the present, Sergey looks on glumly as he sees his Father start to drink again. As we see from the past, this is something that consumed him while Sergey was a child. He even went so far as to accidentally shoot his son in the leg.

The group have bigger problems now though as Lyonya teams up with Ira and decides to split the house in two halves. One for those who have been in contact with Anna and the other half for those who haven't.
