

Summary: Charlie's new gig gets off to a rocky start when he and Gabrielle tag

The episode begins with Charlie on Skype to his parents, pretending to be in an executive office shouting at interns for a coffee. His parents are old-fashioned, insisting that Alicia, the woman he isn't even with anymore, should have kids first. He promises to buy them a new car and an oven with money he doesn't have, and Auntie Lydia is fuming that he continues lying about his life.

Charlie attempts to be the nanny, accompanying Gabby at this club event for her Sara. It's safe to say his efforts to be Gabby's friend/nanny fails, as she does everything in her power to make it diffi-

cult for him. At one point she sits with one of Sara's executives drinking alcohol (we soon find out it was a mocktail) and then swiftly helps a rapper roll a joint. The executive explains that he must treat her like an adult rather than a child. Unfortunately, Charlie's struggles — she is insufferably spoilt.

Her behavior doesn't improve, forcing Charlie to take her back to his apartment with Auntie Lydia and Del. Gabby proceeds to offend everyone at the dinner table, and then resorts to telling Gabby that her father thinks he won't ever make it, he's a one-hit wonder and only spends his money on drugs and women. Charlie is hurt, forcing him to quit. When Gabby returns home, she explains what she said and why he has resigned, and the episode ends with David trying to call Charlie.

heads to her first day of school and quickly starts racking up enemies.



The episode is the aftermath to Charlie and David falling out. For the majority of the chapter, neither character is in touch. Instead, the series focuses on Gabby, who is about to embark on her first day at school. As daunting as it is, she is desperate for her parents to be there for her. She wakes up for breakfast and sees her dad has made her a wonderful meal to start the day, but unfortunately, her mother Sara is not there, too busy at the recording studio producing music for one of her artists.

At school, Gabby struggles to socialise and bed in. She experiences bullying for

the first time by a group of older girls who start gossiping about her parents. But Gabby creates her downfall — at PE, she mocks the teacher, explaining that it's much more important to learn the periodic table than play lacrosse. Accidentally, she fires the lacrosse ball at the PE teacher's breast, which results in getting sent to the headteacher's office.

Gabby suffers her first ever panic attack, and because neither parent is available, Charlie gets called to pick her up. They ride on the bus home together, and Gabby leans on Charlie sobbing about her experiences. Finally, her mum shows up to comfort her.

The episode ends with David and Charlie making friends. The family invited Charlie to ten-pin bowling and there, they beg him to become her nanny again, and in exchange, they will give him studio time. Charlie makes it clear he will accept the offer only if he doesn't have to put up with her shit, and that will be their responsibility.
