More flashbacks reveal the choice Alex had to make. Cesar promised to give his Mother the best healthcare specialists in Mexico. In exchange, he just needed to take the fall for Sara's death. Well the rest, as they say, is history.

Meanwhile, trouble brews between Rodolfo and Sofia as the latter comes back with another negative pregnancy test. It's been five years and they still haven't managed to conceive. Meanwhile, Chema sifts through his old gear and finds a tape for a camcorder labeled "A.G.". As a wry smile crosses his face, he plays the tape which shows Alex in the shower. The camera lingers over his backside, seemingly hinting that Chema took a fancy to Alex in the past.

With everything set up to uncover the truth, Elisa heads over to Alex's house and decides to share some tequila with him.

Alex finds another suspect in the form of Mariana. She was at the courthouse during that time and, with her picture printed out, Alex sets out to track her down. Speaking of which, in flashbacks we see more from the day of Sara's death. Cesar propositioned her and came uncomfortably close down by the docks. Not long after, Chema confronted Sara at her house and pushed the girl up against the wall, her head snapping back nastily.

In the present, Elisa crashes out in Alex's room. While she's asleep, Alex grabs her phone and hacks in, checking different files and seeing she's due to leave very soon. A knock at the door distracts him though. It's Rodolfo, who relays that someone trapped him inside the sauna.

This reveals she's always been on his side but right now they're on different paths, prompting her to walk away and say their goodbyes.

Further flashbacks reveal Marifer confronting Sara with the evidence linked to Abel. She tried to make her see sense but Sara was convinced this is one big conspiracy and took off. Eventually she head up to the hospital alone, intent on speaking to Abel.

Sat down together, he reveals the truth about being her Dad. He asks her to bring him money so he can leave, but the conversation is ended abruptly when the nurse arrives to take him away.

Back in the present, Cesar makes a big decision and phones the police, telling them Sergio is a murderer. While chaos engulfs the casino, Alex watches from his home computer with glee. The underground den is found, housing all those women, while Sergio is stopped at the airport. Cesar meanwhile sits at his desk with a handgun, tears streaming down his face.

As more drama ensues, Moncho shows up at Chema's place and begins beating down Lorenzo after he catches Clara and Chema in bed together. Grabbing a knife, Chema stabs Moncho in the back.

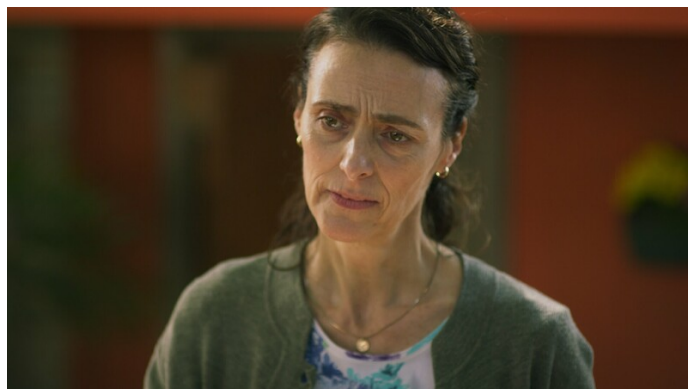

Back in the present six months have passed. We've skipped a good chunk of the timeline and now a week remains to try and find evidence before Alex is thrown behind bars. Lorenzo promises to try and delay this as best he can, while Cesar has apparently gone missing.

Sergio is behind bars though but he soon escapes, killing one of the guards and hiding in the laundry. It seems no one has even bothered to do a roll count and workers arrive to wheel the trolleys out. Anyway, this inevitably leads to Sergio breaking out and leaving, thanking the laundry workers whom he's paid off to help.

Alex continues to investigate. In fact, he messages Marifer (under the guise of Diana the Huntress) and tries to meet with her. Heading out in the middle of the night, he winds up crashing his car while realizing he's being chased.

He eventually makes it to the coroner's office though, where bodies are just wheeled all over the place, half of them aren't under bags and the room is a mess.

Anyway, Alex makes it into the office and finds the files for Abel, snapping photos and leaving. This is the man who was out in the backyard. Alex messages Diana, who simply tells him it's time they meet.

Meanwhile, Chema and Lorenzo are not on good terms, with both of them suffering from nightmares in the wake of Moncho's murder. Well, Chema eventually shows up to see Elisa, who's back from her trip in Europe. He sobs in her arms, mentioning how Lorenzo has gone and things are spiraling out of control.

Just to add more drama to the fold, Lorenzo arrives to greet the pair with big news. It turns out the developers are constructing a new complex precisely where they've buried Moncho, leading the pair into a whole world of trouble.

When Elisa heads outside, Sergio kidnaps her with a couple of his goons. He takes off with her while Alex too is knocked out. When he awakens, he finds Cesar sitting waiting for him. With Sergio acting alone, Cesar needs Alex's help in finding his daughter. He also has a videotape of Elisa, which in turn incriminates Sergio.

Cesar asks for Alex's help and begins begging, dropping to his knees and hanging his head in shame. Unfortunately police show up and this causes Cesar to act hastily to try and save Elisa's life. He heads out with a gun drawn, telling Alex to find his daughter before shooting himself in the head.

Meanwhile, Officer Morales arrives to talk to Lorenzo about Moncho's death. He tries to keep it together, inviting her into his office. It's clear he's struggling though.

As the episode closes out, we cut to the coroner's office where Cesar opens his eyes. It turns out the gunshot from the previous episode was actually orchestrated by an officer nearby, who shot the ground while Cesar collapsed at the same time, making it seem like he's shot himself in the head.

He admitted the truth about his sexuality and how he loved Alex. He never got a chance to leave because a man robbed him after making love. Unfortunately Alex's voicemail is full. It's a cruel end to a trying confession.

Chema eventually leaves though when his Mother approaches, trying to talk to him. Just then, the camera pans up to show Cesar standing on the balcony overseeing proceedings.

This cuts us back in time as we see Cesar working with the General to fake his own death and bring all the other officers into this plan too. The coroner is involved as this operation extends, handing over Cesar's faked death certificate.

Meanwhile, Chema, Clara and Alex all work together to try and find Elisa. Only, there's a problem.

Chema receives a worried call from Lorenzo about the officer and it immediately sends him into a whirlwind of emotion, unsure what to do. As he drives off, Alex tries to get to the bottom of who Diana is — and where Sergio may be holding Elisa. The clue may well be in the video of Elisa, as Alex steadies his emotions and checks the background of the video for clues.

Back at Chema's place, Officer Morales meets the trio as they try to concoct a story on the fly over what happened to Moncho. She's clearly suspicious of them, especially as Lorenzo speaks over any contradictions.

He dodges questions about Clara being the surrogate and eventually Chema puts his foot in it, mentioning the body being found in a vacant lot. This information however, is classified so it piques her interest over how he found out.

It turns out Marifer hacked Chema's computer and essentially planted Clara to be their surrogate in a bid to try and find her Mother. Her Father meanwhile, is a different matter and something left unresolved for now.

Further flashbacks reveal Nicandro confronting Sara about the money she took from him. He demanded it back but she's certainly not playing ball. After being hit by a car while out on his motorbike (a direct result of Sara cutting his brake lines), Nicandro recovered at the hospital. There, Elroy shows up.

He hands over incriminating photos of Sara and Cesar together on the dock. He tells Nicandro that someone needs to stop her — and he even has pictures of her cutting his brakes too. Sara meanwhile, learns that Abel has broken out the hospital and hurries outside the hospital.

With a gun in hand, Alex makes it to Sergio's estate thanks to several different clues. However, he finds Cesar there instead. While he watches from afar, Alex breaks into the basement and grabs Sergio, choking him out.

Drama ensues back home too. A man arrives and grabs Lorenzo, stabbing him in the neck as Chema is forced to hold his lover, crying to the heavens as Lorenzo bleeds out and fades away.

With the police utterly useless at their job, Chema honours the promise he made Alex and heads into the station himself. He tells the officer there that he has a debt to pay. He admits to killing Moncho and also claims to be the one who killed Abel as well.

After taking down the photos and evidence from his wall, Alex spies the security footage and sees Elisa heading into the casino with gasoline. She lights the place up and lets everything burn, with her still inside as the flames lick hungrily up the walls.

Both Alex and Rodolfo race up to the casino. Alex heads inside and grabs the girl, trying to save her from the flames. Marifer also shows up and admits that she murdered Sara. Alex is beside himself with anger and threatens Marifer, who in turn suddenly goes full on villain and tries to convince Alex to ditch Elisa and save her. Anyway, rubble eventually falls on her as flames continue to rage.

Alex uses his parkour skills to escape the inferno too, heading outside where he notices the building burning to a cinder. Rodolfo sees it too and chuckles in glee as his Father's business goes up in smoke.

Elisa hears word back from Chema who wants to try and prove what he did was self-defence, (good luck with that) but for now he's stuck behind bars. 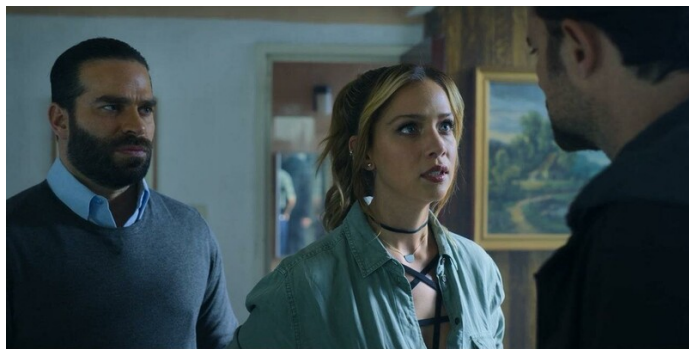

It's clear at this point that Reinaldo is the ringleader in all this. He set his sights on Sara very early on, leading the Medusa Center goons to keep her safe and isolated from her brother.

In the meantime, Reinaldo helped to concoct the story that Marifer was the one who killed Sara from the parachuting accident, something she carries with her to her death. However, Sara actually survived that accident and didn't die at the hospital after all.

At the end of the previous chapter, it was revealed that Cesar has actually kidnapped Tonya, Reinaldo's right-hand woman. He serves her up to Alex on a plate, given she should know where Sara is being kept. Tonya taunts Alex about Sara's true desires and what she wanted, before finally spilling some answers.

However, all of this is a front as we see an additional shot of Sara in her room, brandishing a massive knife from her sleeve. It's also worth noting at this point that Marifer loses consciousness and dies in the Medusa Center, failing to recover from her wounds.

We then jump back to Alex in the present, who's told everything from Tonya. She reveals what Reinaldo has been up to, including Sara's location, which he charges off to investigate, leaving Tonya tied up.

Elisa is not exactly happy, having earlier been involved in her own argument with Rodolfo about Cesar kidnapping Tonya and its moral implications. Anyway, Alex learns everything and leaves, crashing into the Medusa Center all guns blazing, killing several security guards in his way.

Inside the building, Reinaldo begins his "treatment" on Chema. The poor guy is dropped in an ice-bath and shown pornographic material. Chema pleads with Reinaldo to stop, claiming that he doesn't have those feelings anymore. Reinaldo is a man possessed though, believing he's doing the right thing. He brings in a woman after too, telling him he needs to have sex with her to show he's a true man. Without getting too crude, hopping from an ice-bath and then having sex does not sound very pleasant!

Anyway, Elisa and Rodolfo arrive at the Medusa Center to make sure Alex doesn't kill any more people, eventually helping him cable-tie the employees. Reinaldo sets off the alarm before coming face to face with Alex, who heads down to the basement.

With a tape in hand, they make a trade-off — as Reinaldo throws over the tape confirming everything he's done, in exchange for Alex dropping his gun. However, Alex is smart and he manages to shoot Reinaldo in the leg with a handgun he has hidden away, leaving the doctor incapacitated.

Chema leaves, wanting to find Lucia, but Alex urges him to take Elisa out. While they're all arguing, Daniele breaks free from her cell and leaves with them. Reinaldo manages to get up and scamper off, prompting a big family reunion in the main atrium, especially with Lucia is found, safe and sound. However, one of the security guards happens to have a knife and he begins breaking his cable ties to get out.

The security guard grabs his gun and fires. Rodolfo charges at him and gets shot in the process. Cesar appears and shoots the guard in the head. In doing so, the guard passes away as Rodolfo starts bleeding out.

Meanwhile, Alex stalks Reinaldo through the hallways, eventually leading to a big stand-off. It's at this point where we see exactly what Tonya told Alex — and it appears to be true as well. This is where Reinaldo buried all of his victims from the heinous crimes his team committed. Alex decides to call this in to the police, who show up and begin digging the bodies up one by one.

With Lucia by their side now too, Sara's memory can go on through them, the surviving members of the family. As they walk away from the gravesite, where so many victims have been killed at the hands of Reinaldo, we pan across the beautiful countryside and end this series.
