Summary: Alice investigates a suspicious overdose as Catherine plots her next move.



The episode starts on the night of Halloween, where a man struggles to escape from a house as he crawls outside. A woman fills a bowl with candy for the children trick-or-treating outside when she notices him trying to escape. She returns inside, finds him crawling down the stairs and mocks him. She injects him with drugs and leaves him to die.

The episode moves to FBI agent Alice Black, who is on phone duty after leaving her job at the NYPD. Her superior, Mason Adkins, calls her into his office and tells

her that her former colleague, Detective Danny Kelly, is seeking her help with a case.

He asks her to visit the crime scene, write a report, and then return to her duties. Mason also brings up Alice's former relationship with another detective, which rattles her. Alice arrives at the crime scene and catches up with Danny, who reveals that he is about to get divorced.

The officers working the case welcome back their former colleague. Inside the house, Danny reveals that the victim, Caleb Easton, the son of billionaire Jay Easton, has died of a drug overdose. It turns out that Caleb is the same man who was held captive and overdosed by the woman.

Alice takes one look at Caleb's body and concludes that it is a homicide staged as an overdose. Danny explains that Caleb was at the house with his girlfriend. Alice searches the house, and Danny leads her to a bathroom that reeks of bleach after being scrubbed clean. She finds laceration marks on the door along with a single iridescent sequin, likely from a woman's clothing.

The episode then follows the woman who killed Caleb as she mugs a homeless girl named Jinny. She calls a domestic violence shelter and pretends to be an abuse victim in distress. After receiving the shelter's address, she arrives there, acts terrified, and introduces herself as Jinny.

The receptionist sympathises with her and assures her that there will be no record of her stay. Once alone in her room, the woman removes her wig and hides the sequin bag under her bed.

Meanwhile, Alice meets her sister Amy and her friends at a bar and reveals that she has a date. Back at her apartment, she invites a man over to have sex but instead challenges him to a sparring match before refusing to sleep with him.

After he leaves, Alice masturbates and suddenly remembers something. She calls Danny to remind him about Adrian Murado, another drug dealer who was supposedly murdered by his girlfriend through a drug overdose.

At the station, Alice and Danny review CCTV images to identify the woman who was with Caleb. Since she is wearing a dust mask, they cannot determine her identity. Alice also tries to find a connection between Adrian and Caleb but comes up empty.

Later that night, Alice researches the Easton family's philanthropy before searching through old police files. She discovers that a closed case links Caleb to Adrian.

The next day, she meets State's Attorney Nora Washington to discuss the case and asks about Adrian. Nora claims that Adrian was a sex trafficker who was likely murdered by one of his victims. Although she is initially sceptical of Alice's theory, she eventually hears her out.

Nora asks Alice to accompany her during an investigation, and the two continue discussing Adrian. Alice asks about the victims involved in the case, but Nora says she cannot remember any of them. She explains that many victims are heavily addicted to drugs and emotionally attached to their traffickers, making it difficult to get information from them.

Nora later meets Tina, a minor involved in an ongoing trafficking investigation, and Alice gives the girl her jacket to encourage her to attend the hearing.

At the shelter, the woman joins a group session where several women share their experiences of abuse. She calms another resident during an emotional moment, impressing the receptionist. She later asks about obtaining a new ID so she can find work.

The receptionist explains that she must stay at the shelter for 60 days but offers to prepare a fake reference letter to help her. Back in her room, the woman looks at her new ID under the name "Jinny Allen" before visiting the website of a lawyer named Oliver Charles.

At the police station, Alice and Danny question Caleb's neighbour, a teenage boy who was seen on CCTV interacting with the masked woman. He claims that she flashed him while he was sitting on his porch. He also remembers a poppy flower tattoo on her waist but cannot recall anything else about her.

The next day, Alice returns to work at the FBI office, where Mason tells her to stop helping the NYPD with the investigation.

At the shelter, the receptionist finds drugs inside the woman's sequin bag and confiscates them. She questions her about Oliver Charles, but the woman distracts her by flirting. Even after the receptionist reveals that she has a girlfriend, the woman kisses her.

Later, the woman, posing as Jinny, works as a waitress at a party where she serves Oliver Charles. At the same time, Alice receives a call from the hospital informing her that Tina has been injured in a car accident. Nora arrives and reveals that Tina was also recruiting other girls into trafficking for money.

She hands Alice a flash drive containing Adrian's case files before discussing female serial killers and wondering what drove this woman to target wealthy, influential men. Nora brings up Alice's past abuse at the hands of her ex-boyfriend that put her in the same hospital. She compares victims of assault to Medusa, a victim who was turned into a monster.

That night, Oliver takes "Jinny" home and has her sign an NDA before they have sex. Jinny tells Oliver to do whatever he wants with her. At the same time, Nora tells Alice that victims of violence are often the most violent people. Nora reflects on how women who fight back against their abusers are often judged for their anger instead of their suffering.

That night, Alice returns home and goes through the files on the flash drive. She discovers CCTV footage showing Adrian attacking a girl with a poppy flower tattoo on her waist at a convenience store. The episode ends with Jinny singing Oliver a lullaby as he sleeps, revealing the same poppy flower tattoo on her waist.

Summary:	Alice fixates on the case, leading to old habits. Catherine lays her trap.



The episode starts with Alice trying to get into the shower before work but backing out after being triggered. At the same time, Oliver prepares to leave for work and thanks Jinny for the night before, asking her to leave a copy of the NDA behind.

Jinny reads through the document and suggests that she become someone he owns, asking if she can stay at his apartment while he is away. Although Oliver is unsure at first, Jinny convinces him to lock her inside the apartment be-

fore teasing him. He gives in and orders her to clean the apartment naked so he can watch her through the security cameras while at work.

Meanwhile, Alice discusses the connection between Adrian and Caleb's murders with Danny. She brings up the woman with the poppy tattoo, but Danny insists they need stronger evidence before linking the two cases, especially given Caleb's wealthy background. He then tries to change the subject by asking about Amy's engagement party, but Alice refuses to discuss it.

At the FBI office, Mason asks Alice to prepare a report on Caleb's murder investigation and reprimands her for going behind his back to involve herself in the case.

Elsewhere, Oliver receives a notification about movement inside his apartment and eagerly watches Jinny cleaning the place naked through the security cameras. Later that night, he returns home and attempts to sleep with her. However, when he notices the poppy tattoo on her body, Jinny panics and hides in the bathroom.

Nora reviews Alice's report and points out that the only evidence connecting the two murders is a blurry CCTV image of a poppy tattoo from 14 years ago. She questions why Alice has not interrogated Tim Baker, the police officer who handled Adrian's case.

Alice and Nora meet Tim, who recalls Adrian claiming that the teenage girl involved was his daughter. He adds that the girl confirmed the story at the time. Nora accuses Tim and the other officers of frequenting Adrian's massage parlours, which operated under the guise of lounges.

Alice asks whether Tim ever verified Adrian's claim, but he says he cannot remember. After he leaves, Alice confronts Nora about withholding information regarding the massage parlour. Nora admits she has difficulty trusting Alice because of her background as a former police officer before walking away. Danny later asks Alice to meet him after work.

Meanwhile, Oliver notices Jinny has left the apartment and begins texting her. Jinny shows the messages to Becky, the receptionist at the shelter where she is staying, implying that Oliver is her abusive partner who is trying to control her. Becky advises her to cut off contact with him, but Jinny instead demands the drugs Becky confiscated earlier.

When Becky refuses, Jinny threatens to expose an intimate photo of them together to Becky's girlfriend. She then hands Becky a list of supplies she needs before returning to Oliver's house that night. There, Oliver questions whether Jinny is even her real name and accuses her of lying to him. Jinny suddenly injects him with drugs, causing him to lose consciousness.

As he begins passing out, she reveals that they met years ago at a party when she was only 15 years old and that Oliver paid to have sex with her. Horrified, Oliver realises exactly who she is before blacking out.

Later that night, Alice once again fails to gather the courage to shower. She heads to the club where Danny asked to meet her but unexpectedly runs into her ex-boyfriend, Marshall. Disturbed, she leaves and returns to the FBI office, where she reviews the CCTV footage alone.

Alice concludes that the girl with the poppy tattoo had blonde hair. While going through old case files, she discovers that three confidential informants received plea deals following the raid on the lounge. She asks Nora to identify them, wondering whether Caleb was one of the informants.

Nora admits she has been unable to uncover their identities. Desperate to earn Nora's trust, Alice reveals that she was fired after reporting Marshall to her lieutenant for assaulting her. She explains that she empathises with the victims because so many men who abused minors were never held accountable. Convinced by Alice's honesty, Nora agrees to help her gain access to more information about the massage parlour investigation.

At the same time, Becky calls Jinny while she prepares lunch inside Oliver's house. Becky tells her she could not find the wig she wanted, frustrating Jinny. When Oliver regains consciousness and crawls toward the kitchen to attack her, Jinny forces him back into bed and drugs him again. Moments later, Oliver's daughter, Mira, unexpectedly arrives at the house.

The next day, Danny takes Alice to the Easton residence to speak with Caleb's sister. He apologises for inviting her to the bar where Marshall was present and points out that she smells of sweat because she has been avoiding showers, giving her a bottle of cologne.

During the interview, Caleb's sister reveals that Caleb had been dating a woman who had recently escaped an abusive relationship. Alice then asks why Caleb, a former lawyer, left the bench in 2012, but the conversation is interrupted when Jay Easton arrives in a wheelchair.

As the family tries to end the interview, Alice reveals that Caleb was starved and drugged to death by a woman before mentioning the Candlelight Lounge.

Jay immediately orders them to leave. Outside, Danny criticises Alice for taking over the interview and accuses her of implying that officers like him and Tim Baker accepted sexual favours from teenage girls. Despite her objections, he later brings her to Amy's engagement party, where Amy attempts to reconnect with her sister.

Meanwhile, Jinny tells Mira that Oliver is unwell. During their conversation, Mira mentions wanting to cut her hair, but says her father refused to let her do so because "guys like long hair." The comment visibly triggers Jinny. She pours them both wine, secretly destroys Mira's phone by placing it in the oven, and helps curl her hair.

Jinny then asks whether Mira has ever had sex before revealing that she herself had "a lot of sex" at Mira's age. She deliberately burns her own fingers with the curling wand and tells Mira she suffered a similar injury as a teenager.

At the engagement party, Danny privately asks Alice why she never pursued legal action against Marshall. Upset, Alice walks onto the dance floor. Amy later tells Danny that Marshall used to drag Alice out of the shower and beat her. She recalls finding Alice unconscious in the running shower before taking her home.

Feeling guilty, Danny apologises that night and offers to sit outside the bathroom while Alice showers so she feels safe. With his support, Alice finally manages to step into the shower.

That same night, Jinny confronts Oliver after he wakes up. She recounts the night he abused her, reminding him that another underage girl was present. She recalls him complimenting her hair and handing her a glass of water before assaulting her. Oliver insists he never knew she was underage and begs her to spare Mira. Jinny ignores his pleas and drugs him once again.

The following morning, Alice wakes to find Danny in her living room just as Nora arrives with the identities of the three confidential informants. Caleb's name is not among them. Danny also reveals that investigators found only legal pornography on Caleb's computer, with nothing linking him to child abuse.

Alice suddenly remembers a report about Caleb's stolen black Mercedes-Benz. After reviewing the CCTV footage again, she spots Adrian getting out of the vehicle. Nora checks the file and discovers that Caleb's lawyer, Oliver Charles, reported the theft.

The next morning, Mira wakes to discover that Jinny has destroyed every security camera in the house by baking them in the oven. Terrified, she searches for her father. Jinny tells her that Oliver is dead, prompting Mira to run into his bedroom.

There, Jinny continues their conversation from the previous night, explaining how Emily Dickinson's wishes were ignored when her poetry was published after her death without her consent. She then reveals that Oliver assaulted her when she was the same age as Mira.

Shocked, Mira asks Jinny to tell her exactly what Oliver did. The episode ends with a police officer arriving at the house for a welfare check, only to discover Oliver's dead body while Mira sits beside the bed with her hair chopped off.

Summary: Alice's work on the case forces her to face her past. Catherine heads home.



The episode starts with Alice trying to calm Mira down and convince her to put down the knife Jinny forced her to use to chop off her hair. Mira mentions a bag Jinny stole and asks for it before her mother takes her away.

At the crime scene, Alice runs into Marshall and is visibly shaken by his presence. Nora assigns FBI Agent Frank Choi to assist with the investigation and introduces him to Marshall as the lead cop on the case. In private, Alice rushes to the women's restroom after suffering a

panic attack.

Later that day, Frank tells Nora about Alice's long-term relationship with Marshall and argues that Nora is not ready to lead an FBI investigation. Nora checks on Alice in the restroom, but Alice insists that she can handle the situation and refuses to let Frank take over the case.

Meanwhile, Marshall awkwardly discusses the joint investigation with Danny. Back at FBI headquarters, Alice briefs the team and reveals that the murders of Adrian Murado, Caleb Easton, and Oliver Charles are all connected to a serial killer.

Alice explains that Caleb and Oliver were friends and colleagues, while Adrian was seen kidnapping a young girl at a convenience store in Caleb's stolen Mercedes. She identifies the girl as their murder suspect, noting that she has a distinctive poppy flower tattoo on her waist.

Alice believes the woman was trafficked as a child and is now seeking revenge. Nora adds that trafficking victims are trained to blend into society, which explains why there is no clear image of the suspect's face.

Frank challenges Alice and Nora by suggesting that the murders could have been motivated by financial gain rather than revenge. Alice disagrees, arguing that there is no evidence to support that theory. She believes the woman is on a suicide mission, determined to avenge what happened to her.

The team also discusses why the killer left Mira alive. Marshall explains that Mira is still in shock and unwilling to speak. Frank grows frustrated when Alice cannot provide more information, while Marshall reveals that Oliver first met the woman at a party, earning Frank's favour.

Meanwhile, Becky meets Jinny in public and tells her to do whatever she wants with the compromising photos. She also hands over the items Jinny requested. Jinny continues manipulating Becky by asking her to get high together.

Later that day, Jinny, whose real name is revealed to be Catherine, arrives at the home where she works as a nurse. She greets Alden, a man in a wheelchair because of muscular dystrophy. Alden thanks Catherine for continuing to care for him three years after his mother's death.

Back at FBI headquarters, Alice tells Danny that Marshall and Frank are searching for Jinny Allen, the woman who checked into the domestic violence shelter. Alice and Danny agree that the suspect probably used a fake name. Alice also asks Danny to convince Mira's mother to let them interview her.

At Alden's house, Catherine gives him his medication and helps him into bed. She then retreats to her room, blasts music, and dances while going through the items she has collected from her victims. She tries on Mira's retainers and plays with the curling wand she stole.

Later, Catherine streams on an adult content website under the name "Miss Mask." She eventually ends the stream, watches a trauma affirmation video, and messages someone on a dating app.

Shortly afterwards, Catherine receives a message from her friend Isabelle's sister, revealing that Elena has reunited with her abusive ex-boyfriend and plans to stream adult content for money. Concerned, Catherine decides to check on her.

Alice continues working late when Marshall and Frank return after searching for Jinny Allen. They discover the real Jinny, while Alice confirms that the woman staying at the shelter was using her identity. The team visits the shelter to interview the residents. Alice speaks with a woman who has a black eye, triggering Marshall. He abruptly leaves the room, and Alice follows him outside.

Alice tells Marshall that Becky has been having an affair with Jinny. Marshall then asks whether he ever hit Alice. Shocked by the question, Alice wonders how he cannot remember abusing her. Marshall apologises and admits that he only remembers parts of their relationship. He asks Alice to visit his mother in the hospital because she thinks of Alice as family. Marshall also confesses that he still loves her, but Alice refuses to discuss their past.

While the police search for Becky, Catherine visits Elena at a brothel operating under the guise of a motel. Elena introduces Catherine to the other women working there. Catherine urges Elena to leave with her, but Elena refuses. She says Catherine became difficult to live with after everything she went through. Elena asks about her sister, Isabelle, and Catherine reveals that she is still trying to find her.

Moments later, Elena's pimp, Big Man, arrives. Elena hides Catherine under the bed before Big Man violently assaults her. The attack triggers Catherine, who flees the motel.

The following morning, the police discover Becky's body in the woods. Alice is unsettled by the discovery and questions why the killer spared Mira but murdered Becky. Meanwhile, Alden wanders into Catherine's room and looks through her belongings, including photographs of her victims. Catherine catches him there, and Alden assumes she has been scamming wealthy men for money. He also compliments her new black hair.

Later that day, Alice and Nora discuss Mira's condition. Nora explains that trauma can cause memory distortion, leaving victims with only fragments of their memories. Alice questions Mira, who claims that she cannot remember the woman or anything about her father's final moments. Desperate for answers, Alice continues pushing her to think.

Mira eventually recalls that the woman could not feel pain in her fingers. She also remembers the woman saying that Oliver abused her when she was younger. Mira refuses to help create a sketch of the suspect but hands Alice a photograph that the woman instructed her to give the police.

The investigators examine the photo, which shows Oliver Charles, Caleb Easton, and Jay Easton posing with two teenage girls, one of whom is facing the camera. Alice identifies the girl as Isabelle Luna, who entered foster care after being abandoned as a toddler. She believes the second girl is their suspect and asks the team to question Jay Easton.

Nora notices Alice becoming emotionally overwhelmed and calls for a break. Marshall praises Alice, causing her to sympathise with him.

Elsewhere, Catherine bathes Alden and asks whether she can move into his late mother's room. She also asks to borrow his mother's car, and Alden agrees. Later, Catherine practices a new accent in her room but becomes triggered. As a trauma affirmation video plays in the background, she messages Elena to tell her that Isabelle has been killed.

That night, Alice visits Marshall's house to speak with his mother. She reminds Alice of her difficult childhood and the years she cared for her after her own mother abandoned her. Marshall's mother suddenly becomes aggressive and pressures Alice to help Marshall secure a promotion. Disturbed, Alice decides to leave.

Marshall tries to calm both women and follows Alice outside. Alice points out that she never even reported him for abusing her, but Marshall asks her to forgive him. He then reveals his real motive by asking Alice to tell his lieutenant that the allegation of abuse is untrue. Realising he only wants to protect his career, Alice leaves in disgust.

Marshall chases after her, accuses her of sleeping with Danny, and slams her car door shut. Alice immediately draws her gun and orders Marshall to go back inside as the episode comes to an end.

The episode starts with Alice trying to get in touch with Danny after having an anxiety attack because of Marshall and his mother. Danny ignores her call while spending time with his son, Liam, who is in a care home amid Danny's divorce due to his disability.

At the same time, Catherine goes on a date with a man named Blanchard and introduces herself as Marta, a former sex worker who now advocates for the rights of sex workers. She asks about his family before suggesting they go back to his

house. Blanchard, who still lives with his parents, takes Catherine home, where they have sex.

Blanchard calls Catherine a slut, which immediately upsets her and causes her to stop. He apologises and cuddles her instead. Before going to bed, he asks Catherine to leave early so his parents do not see her.

Meanwhile, Alice brings her date, Cole, home and starts making out with him. She lies that her husband is away for the night and tries to hook up with him. However, she pushes Cole away and tries to get him to hit her.

In the middle of the night, Alice calls Nora and asks her to help look for Isabel. During the drive, Nora pours herself another drink as they discuss Catherine's reason for leaving the photograph with Mira. Meanwhile, Catherine goes to Alden's house, where he asks her to be his girlfriend, claiming that he loves her. She accepts Alden's proposal as the episode comes to an end.

Summary:	Alice and Catherine converge.



The episode starts with Emma taking her father to bed and giving him morphine to put him to sleep. Jay asks if Emma paid Catherine and wonders why she is coming after him despite that.

Emma tells Ed that she has gotten rid of the hard drives but realises that Catherine has already entered the house. Catherine confronts Emma, but the latter threatens to shoot her. Emma asks Catherine to take the gun and kill Jay, but Catherine demands to know what happened to Isabel that night.

Catherine recalls being sent to the Easton house with Isabel right after the latter delivered a baby. Catherine also recalls being welcomed with flowers and remembers that Emma was kind to her.

She blames Emma for enabling her abusive father, brother and their friends to harm little kids, but Emma argues that they weren't kids but teenagers. Catherine is filled with rage and charges at Emma, who shoots her.

Danny asks Alice to be safe and wait outside until the police force shows up. Nora advises Alice on what she can do if she enters the scene beforehand, asking her to possibly collect evidence before arresting Catherine.

Alice hears the gunshot and enters the Easton house. She finds Emma in the greenhouse and goes looking for Catherine. Alice realises that Catherine has been shot and tries to stop her. Catherine breaks down and tells Alice that she is tired of letting other people decide what happens in her life.

Catherine talks to Alice about what it is like to kill someone and feeling a sense of peace and power.

Meanwhile, Emma uses the opportunity to destroy the flash drives. She calls Ed to inform him about the scuffle with Catherine and rushes back inside the house. Catherine confronts Emma in the room where Isabel died and asks her to reveal the whole truth about that night.

She recalls being taken to a different room with Oliver while Isabel stayed behind with Caleb and Jay. Emma reveals that Isabel started bleeding profusely, possibly from being sexually assaulted right after giving birth.

Catherine starts remembering the events of the night and recalls being brought into the room as Isabel was crying from the bleeding. She remembers holding Isabel's hands and finally remembers drugging Isabel to end her suffering.

Emma claims that she called Hal to save herself but insinuates that Catherine is the one to blame for Isabel's death. Catherine is shattered when she realises this, but Alice tries to console her. Catherine imagines holding Isabel's hand and passes out as Alice handcuffs her.

Outside the Easton house, Danny and Nora are stopped by the local cops, who prevent them from entering. The FBI arrives, but Ed tries to stall the officers from entering the premises as well. Nora accuses Ed of trying to help a criminal like Jay and wonders if he is the informant that Ed is trying to protect.

Emma runs outside the house and asks the FBI to arrest Catherine, who is trying to kill her. Danny and the other cops, along with the FBI officers, barge inside and arrest Catherine.

Alice sneaks into Jay's room, but he recognises her from the video. Jay calls Alice a movie star and claims that he enjoyed watching her in the video, but starts choking. Alice calls the paramedics, who declare Jay deceased as they take his body out of the house.

After the incident, the NYPD officers, including Danny and Marshall, are awarded for solving the case. Marshall is awarded for getting in line and getting shot by a serial killer. Nora attends the ceremony for Danny and asks if he has heard from Alice, who is suspended from duty.

Danny refuses to tell Nora anything about the flash drive and claims that he destroyed it. Meanwhile, Alice meets Catherine in prison and tells her that the FBI managed to find where Isabel was buried. Catherine is relieved to know that Isabel's daughter, Elena, was finally able to lay Isabel to rest.

Alice and Danny meet at his beach house to spend some time together. She talks to him about the video, but Danny tries to calm her down. Danny tells Alice that if they end up sleeping with each other, he will not be rough with her.

The two end up in bed together, and that night, Danny waits outside the shower while Alice bathes. Later that night, Danny asks Alice to do as she wishes with the flash drive. Alice returns to desk duty at the FBI office and takes the flash drive to Nora.

She tells Nora about her video on the flash drive, but the latter asks if she has watched the video. Nora asks Alice to face her fears if she wants to do a good job as an FBI agent.

Alice returns to work, and Nora sends her to the sensitive materials room and asks her to watch the video. Alice musters up the courage and watches the video, breaking into tears. She learns the video has been shared 50k times and looks at the names of the people who shared it.

Meanwhile, Nora meets Ed and tells him that she has the flash drive, threatening to expose him as Jay's accomplice.

In the sensitive materials room, Alice recalls speaking to Catherine, who wonders if Alice is hiding something. Catherine clocks Alice and wonders if she liked the way killing Jay felt. A flashback from the night of Catherine's arrest shows Alice stepping on Jay's nasal cannula pipe when Jay started speaking about her video. Alice pretends to call the paramedics but intentionally smothers him until he dies.
