The episode begins at home with the McAllisters gathered around the TV watching Frasier. Amanda/Mandy McAllister soon enters to triumphantly announce she's got the baby down. This statement segues into a heated debate between Mandy and Audrey McAllister's opposing views about independence.

Later that evening, Mandy is still sore about Audrey's earlier remarks and vents to Georgie Cooper in private. At least she thinks it's in private until Jim McAllister knocks on the door to point out they've

left the baby monitor on the living room table.

Audrey clearly overheard Mandy's harsh remarks and subtly addresses them over breakfast the next morning. Luckily the two don't get much time to air their grievances thanks to Connor McAllister's awkwardly brief interruption.

Things immediately get awkward for Gorige at the McAllister Garage when Jim gives him a work order to deliver to Ruben. Although in a respectful manner, Ruben makes it painfully clear that he is far more qualified than Georgie and should have the Assistant Manager's position. Elsewhere, Audrey and Mandy's relationship crumbles even further when Audrey questions Georgie's intelligence.

Georgie only learns about the insult because he confronts Audrey after returning from work to find Mandy in tears. This ultimately leads to them moving out hastily and renting a small trailer in a not-so-desirable location from the pushy Bev. Despite everything, the dispute actually seems to strengthen Jim and Georgie's relationship. Jim will even ask him to move back in while Georgie admits to looking up to Jim like a father figure.

That evening, Mandy and Georgie have Meemaw and Mary Cooper over for dinner while Jim tells Audrey that he isn't firing Georgie. She isn't happy to hear about this and even goes as far as blaming Georgie for ruining Mandy's life. Jim defends Georgie by claiming that it could just as easily be seen the other way around. There is a bit more back-and-forth but Audrey will ultimately admit to missing her family and Jim encourages her to apologize.

Georgie maintains his positive attitude as he and Mandy end the day by reflecting on their predicament. Mandy briefly hints at going back to work. Although Georgie appears a bit taken aback by the announcement, he claims he will support her in anything she wants to do. Things never get that far thanks to Audrey swallowing her pride and apologizing the next day.

Despite it being only one day, things appear to be going well at the McAllister's house until Jim and Mandy overhear Georgie confronting Audrey over the baby monitor. Jim immediately opts to turn the device off but Mandy insists on turning it up. Luckily, what could have ended in disaster is sidelined when CeeCee utters her first words, Dada.

The episode begins with Georgie Cooper's brief visit to his late father's gravesite where he very briefly catches him up on the life's events. Although Georgie tells him that everything is going swimmingly, he certainly doesn't say it with confidence. This is proven to be a gross overstatement when Georgie arrives early at the McAllister Garage to learn from Jim McAllister that he left the lights on and the keys hanging in the door when he closed the previous night. Despite the major blunder, Jim is exceptionally nice

about the whole thing.

Things don't appear to be going well in Georgie's personal life either when Audrey McAllister confronts Mandy McAllister about overhearing them arguing. Audrey immediately deflects and blames their conflict on the stresses of being unable to find a job. Connor McAllister soon takes the spotlight off her when he interrupts with requests to borrow the car.

Looking to be helpful, Georgie offers Ruben a hand with changing the shocks on one of the vehicles in the shop. This doesn't go so well, as Ruben tasks him with holding a transmission recirculateor in place and tells him not to drop it. 30 minutes later, Georgie is still supporting the recirculator and Ruben is nowhere to be found. It isn't until Jim arrives with an urgent phone call from Missy that Georgie learns he's been duped. Things only get worse when Georgie learns Missy has been suspended from school and needs a ride home.

Although he takes an entire bottle of Tums with him, he drops everything and goes to get her. This causes him to be slightly late for dinner where briefly before his arrival, it was revealed that Mandy still hasn't had any luck with her job search. Once Mandy mentions expanding her job search, Georgie automatically jumps the gun and declares that he will not be moving. This blowup ends with him storming off and ending up at the Medford Emergency Room.

While Doctor Hill explains to Georgie that he's had a panic attack, Jim and Audrey discuss the dispute at dinner. Once again, Jim goes to bat for Georgie as Audrey is practically counting the days until he and Mandy split. At this point, Mandy has become distraught by Georgie's absence and calls Missy to see if he's over there. This discussion almost leads to Missy sharing her problems at school but Georgie returns, leading to Mandy rushing off the phone. Despite him not wanting to worry her, she pulls the hospital visit out of him. She also helps him realize that he has a lot going on in life. First thing the next morning at breakfast, Georgie apologizes for snapping during dinner. Audrey's obtuse pleasantry leads to him suspecting that Mandy has already shared news of his hospital visit. Jim attempts to reassure him by claiming a lot of men have emotional problems, including him. Despite that, he obviously lies to Georgie when he tells him the best way to combat the turmoil is with healthy eating and exercise.

Later that day, Georgie briefly returns to his father's gravesite where he tells him the truth. These meetings appear to be his release and sometime later, he brings Missy along and encourages her to share her problems. She does after making him leave. The episode ends with her in tears and admitting that she feels alone with him, Sheldon, and Georgie out of the house.

The episode begins in the McAllister kitchen where Mandy McAllister briefly reads and discusses an article about breastfeeding before an excited Georgie Cooper joins them. Georgie's excitement is soon explained when announces that his mail has not only been officially switched to the McAllister's address but he's got his very first credit card. Audrey McAllister certainly doesn't share the excitement but advises him to spend with caution, apparently, a lesson that Mandy had to learn the hard way.

Once Georgie is busy bathing CeeCee McAllister, Mandy quickly addresses Audrey's comments about the credit card. She apparently hasn't told Georgie anything about her experience. Both Audrey and Jim McAllister advocate for her telling Georgie, but Connor McAllister interrupts before any more can be revealed. The talk to secrecy eventually leads to Connor claiming that he's secretly corresponding with Jay Leno about their shared birthday.

Georgie later treats Mandy to an evening at a fancy restaurant but promises to return to Taco Bell's dollar menu the following day. Mandy clearly becomes uncomfortable the more they talk about debt and the card but manages to keep her secret for the time being. Georgie assumes that the later intimate encounter is her returning the favor but quickly realizes she was simply buttering him to break the news about her \$12,000 credit card debt.

Mandy's betrayal continues to eat away at him and eventually leads to a bit of a confrontation with Jim. Ruben also unwittingly gets pulled into the matter and surprisingly sides with Georgie. It isn't until later that evening when Mandy shares her statements with him that he realizes the situation is far worse than he imagined. The \$12,000 was merely for a single card of many. Georgie gets another shock when one of the statements reveals that Mandy paid for an exboyfriend's medical charges. He later leverages his relationship with Jim to track down the exboyfriend, Nick.

Much to Georgie's surprise, getting Nick to repay the debt is no more difficult than showing up and asking for it. Despite that, he doesn't appear all that shocked when the Bank Teller tells him that the check didn't clear. Although Georgie luckily runs into Nick on his way out of the bank, he ends up fleeing the scene after learning Nick is here to rob the place. During dinner that evening, Mandy shares her plans to return to the diner while Georgie pitches getting a tow truck to Jim. Much to everyone's surprise, Audrey backs the idea. Georgie and Mandy end the night in bed, promising to be more honest with each other. Before the episode ends, two brief scenes reveal that Georgie's tow truck idea is a hit and Mandy has returned to the diner. Other than becoming emotional while taking the order of a young c =couple with a newborn, she appears to be doing so as well.

The episode ends with Jay Leno leaving a voice message on the McAllister's machine, thanking Connor for the birthday package.

Much to Audrey McAllister's displeasure, Georgie Cooper appears to be doing especially well for a so-called beginner. Mandy McAllister clearly has no interest in the game and even attempts to quit at one point. It isn't much longer before she gets her wish, but retiring to the bedroom only adds to her realization that her and Georgie's social life has become non-existent.

Mandy sets out to immediately change

things the following day when a colleague at the Bluebell Diner, Beth, asks her out for a drink after work. Despite having a good time, Georgie later inadvertently ruins it when he jokes about her getting hit on.

As Georgie's work conversation with Jim McAllister reveals the following morning, Mandy has clearly gotten inside his head. A nearby Ruben overhears the conversation and tells Georgie and his Friday half-court pickup basketball games and pizza but fails to invite him along.

Despite having another card game scheduled with the parents, Mandy breaks those plans to spend the evening with Beth. She also drags Georige along, which leaves Jim and Audrey alone with Connor McAllister and an odd number of players. Thanks to Connor's suggestion, this leads to a spirited game of, 'Can You Guess What I Am In 20 Questions Or Less?'

Mandy and Georgie's night is no less awkward and only gets even more so when Beth's teenage son Todd recognizes Georgie from Medford High School. Despite this, the two of them hit it off and end up in the garage working on Todd's dirt bike. While Mandy and Beth debate the perks of sleeping with much younger men, Georgie and Todd debate the upsides of divorce and marriage.

While Mandy and Georgie return home, Jim and Audrey are down to 12 questions but more determined than ever to solve Connor's riddle. Mandy's frustration eventually spills over into a heated argument when he tells her that she is acting like his mother because she doesn't want him riding dirt bikes with Todd.

Although Georgie has a great time riding dirt bikes, things immediately turn awkward when Todd, Richie, and Jason break out the beer and he takes on the parental role. At the McAllister

house, Audrey clearly has too good of a time taking advantage of Mandy and Georgie's argument. While Georgie plays designated driver to Todd and his friends, Mandy and Beth return to the Roadhouses. This time, however, Mandy clearly isn't having a good time and ends up calling Georgie to pick her up when Beth leaves her to make out with Doctor Piccardo.

By the time Georgie picks up Mandy at the Roadhouse and they realize they'd be having a much better time watching CeeCee sleep, Jim and Audrey are down to one question. Unfortunately for them, they do not solve the riddle and Connor refuses to share the answer. This is where the episode ends.

The episode opens with Georgie Cooper (Montana Jordan) suggesting that he, Mandy McAllister (Emily Osment), and CeeCee spend the holiday with his family, being that it will be the first since his father's passing. Mandy is more than accommodating but leaves the task of telling Audrey McAllister (Rachel Bay Jones) to him. Much to his surprise, Audrey is just as receptive to the suggestion as Mandy. She, however, does not appreciate him thinking otherwise and is getting ready to give him a piece of her mind

when Jim McAllister (Will Sasso) whisks him away to the garage.

Georgie's even more surprised when he learns that Mary Cooper (Zoe Perry) isn't doing the annual dinner. To make matters worse, she has no interest in joining the McAllisters. Even though Missy Cooper (Ragan Revord) has already made plans to spend the holiday with a friend, both Georige and Mandy try to convince her to spend the day with him.

After failing to cheer Georgie up with a surprise visit to the garage, Mandy asks Meemaw (Annie Potts) and Dale (Craig T. Nelson). Despite already having a camping trip planned that Dale is really looking forward to, Meemaw doesn't seem to have a problem changing their plans. With Meemaw and Dale's assured attendance, Mandy returns her focus back to securing Missy's attendance. It takes a bit of convincing and a trip to the tattoo parlor, but Mandy gets her to agree as well. Mary still isn't convinced and nearly becomes hostile when Mandy pushes the invitation.

It isn't until much later that Mandy shares the news about their guests but she doesn't have a problem with it. Georgie comes in during the discussion and is happily surprised by the good news until he learns that his mother won't be attending. In addition, he's suspiciously curious as to what changed Missy's mind. Although Mandy claims she is a good negotiator, he clearly doesn't believe her because he later approaches Missy with the same question, which she remains tight-lipped about as well.

When the day of the dinner arrives, Audrey becomes frustrated with Jim's excessive drinking and Connor McAllister (Dougie Baldwin) makes the mood awkward with a Thanksgiving Accordion tune. However, this is nowhere as near as awkward as things get when Audrey reaches her breaking point with Jim's drinking. Before that happens though, Mary also makes a surprise visit. The argument eventually reaches a point that leads Mary, Missy, and Georgie to George Senior gravesite. This is practically where the episode ends.

he feels Jim sees him as a failure for never having had a job, and that everything he does seems to make Jim angry, while Georgie says that he's just worried for him.


