After being there for four years and not delivering a semblance of her project and doing that kind of stuff, they take away her grant and expel her.

She tries to say they're trying to make her small, and that it's not her fault that

is happening. But that's a lie, and not only the university, but she knows that. Still, that doesn't make her give up. When she gets the chance to collect her stuff before leaving, Riri assembles the iron suit she made with her grant and escapes to Chicago.

Meanwhile, a gang attempts to steal a house. Everything is set to work out, except one of them keeps messing up at disarming the alarm. Ultimately, because of him, the robbery goes wrong, and they have to escape.

Now, John, one of the members, and his boss, the Hood, must find someone new who is familiar with hardware. Magically, they look up and find their answer in Riri flying to her home.

However, the girl quickly makes a spectacle of herself, crashing down and having to walk around carrying her suit.

When she arrives home, she overhears her mother discussing the girl's grief with her friends. A few years ago, Riri's stepdad, Gary, and her best friend, Natalie, died. She tries to nonchalantly enter and go to her room, but her mother already knows she was expelled and gets angry.

Thankfully, Xavier, Natalie's brother, comes and saves her from the scolding. He can't understand why Riri could be living a normal life, but she refuses. To Riri's surprise, her black market dealer is a coward who can't stand up for himself. So she quickly gets him to take her to where he has the parts she needs.

Before leaving for a team meeting, Riri celebrates with N.A.T.A.L.I.E. However, when a guard spots them, the AI freezes and glitches. Because of that, the girl can't take control of the iron suit and almost gets shot.

Hood saves her in time by shooting the guard's shoulder, giving them time to run away. Later, she asks Clown about their leader, and she says the only weird thing about him is that he has some sort of mark on his back. Riri doesn't get to ask anything about that, as John tells her it's good to stay away from people's matters.

He reminds her that she's spending time with a bunch of criminals, but she still can't admit she's doing something wrong. The girl also asks what his hood is, but he only says it's magical and refuses to further explain.

When she gets home, Xavier is waiting for her, and he has suspicions about her job. That leads to them talking about Natalie, which fills him with joy, as he cherishes every memory he has with her. He handles his grief in a totally different way from Riri, who avoids thinking about it for long.

Suddenly, Joe, the arms dealer, knocks at her door and demands that she work with him. She inspired him, so now he wants her to help him create things that will help people. Conveniently, one of Joe's projects is a prototype for a biomesh skin material, which can solve her problem. Thus, she goes to his house to get it.

While she's there, she has to help him fix his arm after he hurt it with one of his projects. She ends up finding a bag full of his father's ashes and learns his dad is Obadiah Stane, the Iron Monger. Joe is actually called Ezekiel Stane, the son of Iron Man's first villain.

Because he knew his dad was a villain, he lived his life to be someone different. Getting closer to him allows Riri to open up, and she tells him she built the suit because her stepdad was an Iron Man fan.

At night, the Hood and the rest of the group go after Hunter Mason. To serve as her cover, Riri lets N.A.T.A.L.I.E. pilot her suit, and she tries to find Parker to cut his cloak. However, even with the biomesh, she activates an alarm, and the whole place goes into alert, closing everyone off. As Mason refuses to sign the deal, Hood kills him.

Riri runs off with a part of the hood on her hand but ends up meeting John on her way out. He understands what she did, and then a fight starts. However, because of the alert, the door closes, and they lose oxygen little by little.

Even though her suit makes it in time to save her, she leaves John there by himself in a rush. Later, the whole group meets up, Parker tells her to look for his cousin, and after flying away, she says she found him dead.

Then, the girl arrives at her house, having another panic attack. She can't forgive herself for not helping John and letting him die. However, it only gets worse when she realizes she dropped the biomesh there at the scene of the crime. She promised Ezekiel she wouldn't do anything to incriminate him, but that's what she just did.

At the same time, the Hood screams into the nothing, asking if that was all part of the plan. He's demanding answers, and suddenly they come to him. When he turns around, he sees his cousin suffocating alone. But then, Riri's iron suit walks and stands behind John's corpse.

Meanwhile, Hood talks with the strange man who gave him the cloak. He's angry, but says that he'll give Parker more power if he can keep the cloak.

Riri convinces Ezekiel to stop fighting her, but he's still in Parker's control, so he can only warn her of his following attacks. Thanks to that, she can hit him in the groin, which is the only way to reset him. He says he still has business with her, but doesn't feel like a dangerous enemy anymore.

Now, it's Parker's turn to take a beating. Riri surprises him with her magic suit, which doesn't let him use the cloak to hide. However, the demon's powers possess him, and he begins to transform. His skin changes, his eyes turn black, and his nails become claws. He viciously jumps towards Riri and starts tearing into her armour while she activates an emergency protocol. But the suit explodes before that.
