Summary:	After a wild night in Vegas, Lucky wakes up to discover her world has been turned upside down.



The episode begins with a woman named Lucky (short for Luciana Armstrong) running through a lot filled with trucks, being chased by an FBI officer who ultimately blocks her path.

The scene shifts to Lucky and her husband, Cary, in a snazzy hotel room in Las Vegas. Lucky seems worried that they've missed something but Cary tells her this is just her father's voice in her head. Nearby, we see two suitcases full of cash.

The couple go downstairs and enjoy the casino, later heading up to the roof

to have champagne. Cary details their plan to leave on a cargo plane in the next few hours, before anyone realises the money is gone. They clink their glasses and dance.

Lucky ends up waking up much later than she's supposed to, only to find Cary gone. And the suitcases as well. He's betrayed her and he drugged her last night in order to do so.

An FBI officer named Agent Rand arrives at the hotel with a large team and orders them to search the hotel for Lucky and Cary. Lucky, still in the hotel, sees a news report about her and Cary. The reporter says they stole about 10 million dollars in cash from a mob-related biodiesel scheme two years ago.

While searching their room, Agent Rand realises that Cary must have taken the money and gone. Meanwhile, Lucky manages to sneak out of the hotel but stops when she sees a man in a leather jacket. It makes her turn around and head back inside, where Agent Rand clocks her immediately. A chase ensues.

Lucky runs through the kitchen, steals someone's key card, and navigates the maze of the hotel until she reaches a loading dock. She approaches a man loading up a truck and pretends to be running from an abusive partner. He agrees to get her out of there and they drive out right before the cops enter.

A flashback shows Lucky talking to her father, John, who is in prison. He tells her that he stole money from a woman he was working with (no names are mentioned here) and he needs Lucky to move it. Lucky realises the people he stole from will come after both of them.

At present, Lucky charges her phone in the truck and then gets off near a food stop. The driver, who knows she's lying, agrees to give her some money anyway. Lucky cuts and dyes her

hair and then evades the cops to sneak onto a bus heading to the Grand Canyon. The cops don't clock her but the man in the leather jacket follows her in a car.

Once she's on the way, she gets the call from John. Speaking in code, Lucky tells him what happened. John assures her that she'll find a way out of this.

Back at the hotel, Agent Rand sees the CCTV footage and recognises the man in the leather jacket as Dutch. She describes him as the "enforcer for Whittaker and Priscilla's right hand." She insinuates that Dutch is a lot more dangerous than them.

Lucky's bus takes a break at a rest stop, where she gets a sandwich. However, an FBI officer catches her, which brings us to the chase amongst the trucks from the first scene. When the officer finally has her, a car runs into him and knocks him down. It's Dutch. He tells Lucky that "she" wants a word and makes her get into the car.

The woman sitting next to Lucky is Priscilla, who asks her where the money is and also where her son is. Lucky tells her that Cary ran away with the money. However, Priscilla doesn't believe her. She also says that the person to whom the money really belongs will hurt her and John. She then has her people dump her in the back of another car and then take her to "the house."

On the way, Lucky uses her father's lighter to melt the plastic tying her hands together. She finds a flare with the first aid kit, sneaks out from an opening to the middle portion of the car, and uses the flare to attack Priscilla's men. The car overturns in the chaos.

Lucky tries to run but one of the men brings her down and tries to kill her. She uses a screwdriver she found in the trunk to kill him but then passes out. She wakes up some time later, takes money from the dead man's shirt and sets him and the car on fire.

The episode begins with a flashback. Lucky and Cary access one of the units of a storage facility and find boxes filled with cash. They move the cash from the boxes to their suitcases.

At present, Lucky walks through the Nevada desert, struggling with the heat. She sees a house nearby and walks towards it.

In jail, John gets a visit from Priscilla. She tells him that Lucky needs to bring her the money so that Priscilla can smooth things over with Wayne, or else

he will kill both of their kids.

Lucky approaches the house and finds two girls playing in the yard. When a snake approaches them, Lucky kills it. The girls' grandmother, Sylvia, points a rifle at Lucky and asks her who she is. Lucky says she was in a car accident but doesn't have insurance to call an ambulance. Sylvia decides to help her.

Elsewhere, Agent Rand and her people find the car crash that Lucky left behind. Rand says that Lucky was out of the mob and wonders why she got back in.

The Assistant Director, named Peter, then arrives and tells Rand off for not looping him in. Rand tells Peter that she thinks John stole from Priscilla and built a nest egg. Since Priscilla just got out of prison, John wanted to move the money and asked Lucky to do so. Rand believes it all leads back to a man named Wayne Whittaker. Peter decides to let Rand go ahead but warns her about making a vendetta out of catching Priscilla.

In the house, Sylvia helps patch up Lucky's wounds. Lucky introduces herself as Rachel and spins a lie about her husband pushing her out of the car, playing up the act of a victim of abuse. She also says her husband is a cop and may have his cop friends looking for her. Sylvia agrees to help her hide and offers a fresh change of clothes.

Meanwhile, Priscilla visits the car company Cary rented his car from and bribes an employee to check the GPS tracker on the vehicle. The man tells her the car is at a mall in Long Beach and has been there for a day. She tells this to Dutch, who is currently out looking for Lucky.

Priscilla heads to Long Beach and finds the abandoned car. Inside, she finds a tissue with an address written on it.

While having dinner with the family, Lucky gets a call from her father but isn't able to pick it up. Sylvia assumes it's the abusive husband and tells her not to take the call.

Priscilla visits the address on the tissue and meets a man named Noah. He claims not to know Cary but Priscilla shoots him in the foot and has one of her people put him in her car.

Meanwhile, Dutch sees Sylvia's house on a satellite map and heads in that direction. At the same time, Agent Rand spots the house through her binoculars as well.

Priscilla goes to Wayne Whittaker's lavish house and says she needs more time to get the money back. Wayne blames her for letting John take advantage of her but Priscilla retorts that she had asked Wayne to slow down the money laundering since it was too fast to keep track of. However, he rests the blame entirely on her, going so far as to choke her with his hands till she's out of breath. He orders her to find the money and doesn't guarantee anything about letting Cary live.

At the house, Lucky tells Sylvia that she should get going, but that's when Agent Rand shows up. Sylvia tries to lie but Rand sees through it and warns Sylvia about how dangerous Lucky is. Sylvia believes it and Lucky realises she's in trouble. She promises the little girls that she will be back and leaves the room. She then steals some cash from Sylvia's purse and escapes through the window.

Sylvia realises Lucky stole her car keys when she hugged her. Lucky drives away with a smile on her face.

A flashback shows John and Lucky in a car, on the run, with little Lucky fingering a bundle of cash. John tells her that every person has a rhythm and if you learn it, you can make them dance.

At present, Lucky's car crosses Dutch's. Since he's listening to the police radio, he realises the car is stolen and follows her. When Lucky stops for fuel, Dutch catches up to her and confronts her. He tells her about Cary being in Long Beach and advises her to get on the right side to save her own life.

She responds by using her lighter and some spilled fuel to set a fire to distract him. She hides from him until he gives up and goes back inside the store. In the meantime, she gets in the back of his truck and hides there till Dutch gets back in and drives away.

The episode begins with a flashback. Priscilla, Dutch, and Lucky watch as John makes a deal with someone to help them move large amounts of cash. He tells Priscilla that he's finalised a year-long deal for them and she responds by telling him they need to slow down on the amount of cash flow.

Lucky frowns when John brings her within Priscilla's vicinity again and as they drive away, she tells him this isn't going to end well. Agent Rand watches the whole thing through her binoculars

from some distance away.

At present, Lucky hides in Dutch's car as he drives to Priscilla's estate. Noah Miller is being tortured in the stables and Lucky watches as they determine he doesn't know anything about Cary after all. They then kill him.

Lucky gets a call from her father and panics, saying she doesn't know what to do. He calms her down and tells Lucky to find a safe place first and then call him from there. Lucky then steals Noah's ID and runs off.

Agent Rand and Agent Gates investigate the gas station where Dutch fought Lucky. Rand wants to keep following Lucky's trail but Gates wants to investigate Cary and the car he rented under Priscilla's name.

At Priscilla's place, she and Dutch discuss how it seems like Cary betrayed both his mother and his wife.

Out on the streets, Lucky sees a kid's birthday party at a lavish house and sneaks her way in, pretending to be the hired help. She goes upstairs and changes into one of the owner's fancy dresses to blend in.

When everyone is busy with the cake cutting, she steals the guests' wallets, one of their purses, and gift envelopes with cash in them. She finds car keys inside the purse and uses the

car to make her getaway. At the same time, we see glimpses of John teaching a younger version of Lucky how to steal money at a kid's birthday party.

Meanwhile, Agent Rand finds security footage of Lucky entering Dutch's car. She follows the car's trail and arrives at Priscilla's house, where the two have a tense tete-a-tete. While leaving, Rand calls Gates and tells him that she has a hunch Cary got a new car. He agrees to check it out.

Lucky arrives at Noah Miller's house and doesn't find anything. However, next door is a woman who makes fake IDs, likely the same person Cary met. Lucky pretends to want a fake ID for herself, to get out of a bad marriage. When the woman shows her some previous IDs she's made, Lucky spots Cary's new ID, under the name of Colson Smith and with an address in La Jolla.

On the road again, Lucky gets a call from her father (on a burner phone, so he can talk freely). When he learns she's found Cary, he tells her not to be emotional and to simply get the money and leave.

She agrees but getting into Cary's new place isn't easy. Lucky goes to a bar and flirts with a man named Eric, who is the real estate agent for the place Cary is staying. They go back to his office with Lucky pretending to be drunk... until she takes his phone and threatens to call his wife.

Under threat of blackmail, she makes him give up the key and access codes to the property Cary is staying in.

Elsewhere, Agent Rand finds the car that Cary has rented. As a result, he also has Cary's new ID, with his new name and address. Simultaneously, Whittaker calls Priscilla and says that he's got a location on Cary.

Lucky enters Cary's house and sees that he's going to the beach for a swim. While he's swimming, she searches the house for the cash but can't find it. She finds a bag with a gun and laptop, but the latter is password protected.

The episode ends with Cary coming home and finding himself face to face with Lucky.

The episode begins with a flashback in which Agent Rand approaches Lucky and warns her that her father is in danger. Agent Rand describes how Priscilla buys gas wholesaler without paying taxes and resells it at full price.

However, she doesn't have any actual evidence against Priscilla. She presumes that Priscilla is going to let John take the fall, since there is plenty of evidence against him and Cary. But Rand only wants Priscilla and asks Lucky to help her. Lucky gets convinced and asks for

full immunity for John and Cary.

At present, Lucky and Cary face each other in the beachside house he's rented. He asks to explain and she hits him, hurting her hand in the process. He wants to explain himself but Lucky rants about how she thought he was dead because at least that would mean he didn't betray her.

While they're fighting, Agent Rand calls for backup as they move towards the beach house in La Jolla. At the same time, Priscilla and Dutch drive towards the same destination.

In the beach house, Cary and Lucky continue to argue as he tries to explain himself. He finally bursts out that Priscilla was going to kill Lucky.

A flashback shows Priscilla meeting her son after getting out of prison. She tells him that John has been stealing from her and Lucky knows where the money is. She's surprised to learn that Cary and Lucky are married since she didn't let Cary visit her while she was in prison.

She wants Cary to bring the money back to Whittaker and work in the business with her and Whittaker. Cary says he doesn't want anything to do with it since he's in love with Lucky and wants to live an ordinary life with her. That's when Priscilla drops a bomb — Lucky helped put Priscilla in jail and lied to Cary about it. Her final card is to threaten Lucky's life, since she is the one who knows where the money is.

At present, Cary accuses Lucky of lying to him for years. She says the FBI already had Priscilla and she wanted to protect them — her and Cary — from her. Cary, in turn, accuses John of being at fault, for stealing the money in the first place.

Cary then admits that he couldn't actually bring himself to give the money to his mother. He was about to meet her at a diner to deliver the money when he saw her laughing with Dutch.

Seeing her laugh while he just blew up his life broke something in him and he decided to leave. He went back to Las Vegas but by then, Lucky was already on the run. So he deposited

the cash through various ATMs, changed cars, and came to La Jolla. He thought Priscilla would come after him and didn't realise she would go after Lucky.

At present, Lucky brushes his explanations away and asks for the seed phrase to access the money. He refuses. She then grabs the gun and points it at him, ready to cause pain and force the answer out.

That's when Agent Rand and her team arrive, knocking on the door for Cary. They burst into the house and find it empty. A few seconds later, Lucky and Cary drive out of the garage and speed away.

Unfortunately, Rand has a helicopter and a dozen cars following them. Lucky stops under an overpass to lose the helicopter and they head out on foot instead.

While walking, Cary asks Lucky why she took John's money when their life was set. She says that life was over anyway, Whittaker and Priscilla would have come after them. He retorts that she just can't say no to her father.

At that moment, Priscilla and Dutch find them. Lucky immediately makes a run for it. Priscilla tells her son she can forgive him but he follows Lucky instead. They run to a nearby parking lot where Lucky steals car keys from the first guy she sees.

They drive off in the new car but unfortunately, Priscilla and Dutch find them and give chase. The police join in as well and things start looking dire. Cary uses his gun to try and buy them some time. A shootout ensues. In the end, a bullet hits their car and it overturns.

A flashback shows the FBI taking John and Priscilla away and getting Lucky out of the cuffs. Lucky's surprised when John is taken away as well. Agent Rand says he was deeper in than she realised and she couldn't keep him out of it. Lucky rails at her and calls her a liar.

At present, Lucky wakes up in the crash and sees that Cary's been shot. He's bleeding out and slowly loses consciousness while Lucky begs him to wake up.

An injured Rand approaches the car to find only Cary there. She soon passes out as well. The EMTs arrive and confirm that Cary's dead, placing a sheet over him. Priscilla watches from afar and Dutch stops her from going towards his body.

The episode begins with the aftermath of the car chase in the previous episode. Lucky, on foot now, finds the cars that got into a collision due to the chase and gets inside one of them. She pretends to be a victim, the granddaughter of the old woman who was driving. She gets to the hospital with the ambulance and sees Agent Rand being admitted as well. A few minutes later, she passes out.

She wakes up in a bed sometime later and grabs her things. In the bathroom, she comes across Agent Rand's daughter

Dana, who is upset because the last thing she told her mother was that she hated her. Lucky comforts her and then leaves, heading to a nearby hotel to book a room for the night.

Peter Kershaw arrives at the hospital to visit Agent Rand and tells her that Cary's dead but Lucky's in the wind. Rand tells him Lucky will still be in the area, but Kershaw tells her to rest.

Elsewhere, Priscilla gives Dutch the orders for Cary's cremation and memorial. She also tells him to inform Whittaker.

In her hotel room, Lucky hints about her father. A flashback shows little Lucky asking her father if they are bad people. He compares what they do to a lion killing an antelope — a survival tactic.

At present, Lucky grieves Cary. She gets a drink at the bar, where a man who missed his flight starts a conversation with her. For once, she's honest and tells him her husband died in a car wreck. She laments their fight and the man buys her another drink.

Meanwhile, Dutch is woken up by the sound of Priscilla shooting trophies in her yard. She asks Dutch if Cary's death is her fault and Dutch tries to offer some comfort.

In the morning, Agent Rand leaves the hospital against the doctor's advice and Lucky steals a car from the hotel and heads out.

At Cary's memorial, Priscilla finds that she can't be around so many people. She takes the urn and goes to the beach, spreading his ashes in the water. Lucky turns up there and tells Priscilla

that the money is gone, since Cary never told her where he kept it. She tells Priscilla she doesn't want to keep running but Priscilla doesn't give her a choice. She has to find the money.

In her car, Lucky vents her frustration out on the teddy bear that Cary left her with. A recorded voice inside starts reading out the 12 passwords required to get into Cary's laptop.

Agent Rand goes home and starts working on her laptop. Dana sees a picture of Lucky and tells her she saw her in the hospital. Rand calls Gates and tells him to keep this between them.

As for Priscilla, she takes the urn and goes to see Whittaker, who we now learn is Cary's father. Whittaker doesn't seem to care though. He pulls a gun on Priscilla and tells her to get his money back.

In prison, John suddenly learns that he's getting out despite having 8 years left on his sentence. He leaves the prison to find a cab waiting for him and a black car driving away.

He calls Lucky and tells her what happened. Lucky thinks it was Rand who did it, in order to smoke Lucky out. The two meet and Lucky tells him she has the money. He asks her what her plan is and she says he's not going to like it. The episode ends with John and Lucky giving themselves up to Agent Rand.
