Summary: Years after a tragic injustice involving his father, Assane seeks to settle a score, and a debt, by stealing a diamond necklace. However, the heist takes an unexpected turn.



The episode with Assane Diop marveling at a necklace kept in the Louvre. He's clearly plotting his next move while posing as a cleaner there. This necklace, as we soon find out, belonged to Marie-Antoinette and will be put up for auction in a week's time. This happens to be the date Assane is going to make his move.

It turns out Assane is working with a trio of thugs who seem to hold influence over him. After threatening him over a balcony, Assane briefs Vincent, Kevin and Rudy over their upcoming gig.

He encourages them to head in as janitors. When the auction starts, they'll have seven minutes to escape without being caught. If they can do that, and get away in a discreet, speedy car, they'll be laughing all the way to the bank.

Just before the operation, we cut back to a very rainy Paris in 1995. A young Assane and his Father manage to bag a lift from a lady having trouble with her car. When they suave their way into getting a lift, Assane pauses over the lady calling his Father a gentleman.

Assane is close with his Father too and clearly has bad blood with the Pellegrini family. When his Father is framed and thrown in prison, Assane's Father subsequently commits suicide. This leaves Assane with quite the chip on his shoulder, muddied further by the fact he knows Juliette Pellegrini pretty well.

Back in the present, Assane arrives at the Louvre for the night under a fake alias. He's cool and collected, ready to steal the necklace as our three stooges get into position.

Anyway, the auction goes ahead and right on cue, our trio of lackeys get to work overpowering the security. In fact, this entire stunt is really cleverly constructed, jumping back in time to see

extra fragments of the past while jumping between Assane and the janitors as the heist goes ahead. The cameras are shut off and Assane immediately gets into position, winning the bid for Marie Antionette's necklace for a princely sum of 60 million euros.

Kevin and Vincent worry that Assane will betray them and decide to make that very move themselves. As alarms wail, they hurry off with the necklace as Assane is left tied up in the back. They hurry away from the Louvre, joined by Rudy in a sports car, as police chase them while hot on their heels. Eventually they manage to run the car off the road... and straight back into the Louvre again.

As the trio are taken to the station, the officer on duty discusses Arsene Lupin and how the necklace incident reminded him of that gentleman thief. It's a nice nod toward the present, as Assane is let go but with the inspector remaining suspicious of him. In fact, that nod toward Arsene Lupin is more than a nod. Assane has based his entire heist on this fictional detective.

We then jump back 2 weeks earlier as Assane hears news about the Queen's necklace being found. Based on this, he sets to work getting a job as a janitor and intentionally using Vincent and the others for his own devices as all the pieces of the puzzle come together. The pièce de résistance? Assane switched the necklace around for a fake and actually stashed the real one in a bin inside the Louvre. Dressed as a janitor, he manages to steal the necklace and takes it out with the trash without anyone suspecting him.

As the episode closes out, Assane arrives at Claire's house to pick up his son Raoul. As he does, the legacy continues as he hands over an Arsene Lupin book.

The episode begins with Assane being brought in to prison. He's introduced to his new cellmate as Assane's time appears to be up.

We then cut back 2 days earlier as Raoul looks around the jewelers. In the back, Assane learns from his friend Benjamin, who owns the place, that this necklace has never been pulled apart. This means that Pellegrini and the family lied about it going missing. But why? Before they can ponder that further however, the duo are interrupted by Raoul

showing up.

Elsewhere, Juliette greets her Mother who warns the girl to be careful. Downstairs, Juliette receives a note, telling her to meet at Luxembourg Gardens at 2pm with no police. Along with the note happens to be a single diamond.

Dressed as a delivery driver, Assane rocks up by the shoreside. He covers up Juliette's microphone and obscures his face, knowing she's being watched, and admits he stole the necklace. He wants answers.

It turns out Juliette and her Father both came up with the idea of separating the gemstones to drum up publicity. She pleads with Assane to hand over the necklace and admits that Assane's father signed a confession confirming he was guilty.

Realizing the jig is up, Assane takes off on his bike and evades the police, who are baffled by a number of other delivery drivers showing up at the same spot. It turns out Assane has switched disguises and manages to get away without being spotted.

Going back through his Father's belongings, Assane remembers Babakar telling him that spelling is very important. Within his letter to Assane are the words "Comit" and "libraries" — which don't seem like accidental mistakes.

Assane figures out that the former refers to a man in prison with the same surname — Etienne Comit — and library is a straight translation. Both of these could potentially lead to his Father's innocence being proven.

In order to do this though, Assane infiltrates the prison, switching places with a man named Djibril, to get closer to Etienne.

Juliette meanwhile, comes under fire from the Inspectors who question whether she actually knew Assane or not. She deflects the line of enquiry though and asks the Captain to find the necklace.

In flashbacks to 1995, we see Assane approached by Dumont, who tells him to pack his things and leave. As he does, he bundles the Arsene Lupin book in his bag and tries to evade Dumont. Try being the operative word though, as he's eventually captured.

That capture sees him brought into juvenile prison where he's handed a bible and forced to settle in. Assane refuses to play with the other kids as he receives a letter from his Father; a letter sent while the police cleaned out his cell.

The inspector gently mentions Andresy School, the best private school in France, and a donor who has paid for him to receive the best education there.

Back in prison, Assane meets Comit after getting himself stabbed in the stomach by a dope-hungry gang demanding he deliver. He explains to Comit that he's Babakar's son, allowing Etienne to speak openly. It turns out Babakar was alone in his cell and under surveillance. Etienne wasn't there but tells Assane to look through his belongings where a book lies that holds the clues he seeks.

Back at the police station, Youseff Guedira continues to research into Arsene Lupin and decodes the names to realize they're all anagrams for Lupin. There's a clear connection between the thief and the fictional detective but for now, he doesn't have much else to go on.

Back in prison, Assane looks through Etienne's belongings and finds a Lupin book. Using this, he decodes a message reading: "An innocent trapped by Anne Pellegrini." Assane heads back to Etienne and thanks him for his help, promising to do his best to clear his Father's name.

Back in prison, Assane is found in the showers after hanging himself. The nurses rush in to take him to hospital as we learn Assane concocted all of this on purpose to find a way out of prison.

Assane realizes his time is up and leaves Dumont tied to his chair. He hurries outside before the police eventually find Dumont. With Assane back in hiding, Dumont returns home and immediately starts taking down all the hidden cameras around his house. Assane watches disapprovingly on his monitor.

As we jump back in time to 1995, Dumont believes Babakar is innocent and mentions to Pellegrini how the man's alibi doesn't match up. Dumont promises to see this investigation through to its conclusion... until Hubert threatens his family. This is why he was forced to put Babakar away and make him sign a confession. As we soon find out, Hubert also hid this from his wife too.

Using the "coward trick", Assane dons a new disguise as Fabienne rings from outside, allowing Assane to head up and retrieve a VHS tape from the archives. Hurrying away, Assane brings this crucial piece of evidence back to Fabienne.

As we cut back in time to 2006, we see Claire in therapy talking about Assane and his job. Or, well, her lack of understanding surround exactly what he does.

In an old, abandoned house, Leonard loads up his shotgun and prepares for Assane's arrival. Raoul meanwhile, sits tied up to a chair with nowhere to go. Assane finally rings, with Leonard picking up. He threatens the hitman, warning him against hurting Raoul as everything looks set for a big showdown.

During flashbacks we cut back to Claire and Assane's childhood, where a racist shop owner refuses to allow Assane to buy a violin. He's desperate to impress Claire though and eventually breaks in after school and takes one, being discrete and managing to evade capture.

Back in the present, Assane levels with Guedira and admits that he knows he's a cop. In doing so, he manages to tie Guedira to his car and even take his ID too. With the police en-route, Assane has an hour at most to grab Raoul and get out.

Tension mounts though as Assane sneaks into the house and engages in a game of cat and mouse with Leonard. The two wrestle, with gunshots cracking the air sporadically. Eventually though Lupin bests the hitman and throws him out the window. Raoul however, is gone. He's actually in Leonard's trunk and with the hitman still alive, he pours gasoline over the car and ignites it.

A haunting but well-shot set of scenes then interweave together. The violin owner arrives in the past and notices Claire playing the instrument at her recital. She immediately drops the strings as she notices police arrive. Now she understands that Assane lied and the violin is indeed stolen.

The other scene is far more harrowing and shocking. The car explodes as Assane receives an antagonizing message from Leonard. "Next time, check the car." As the vehicle explodes and envelopes in flames, Belkacem arrives and forces Assane down to the ground as he screams in grief-stricken pain.

Now, it is 2021 and we're in Marseille. Lupin is living a secluded life and a year has passed since the Pelligrini incident. Assane Diop aka Lupin's wife is questioned about his whereabouts.

Claire receives a text to follow a mysterious man with an orange umbrella. The person is Assane. Claire and Assane have a tiff, and she mentions that Raoul wakes screaming in his sleep.

Claire asks Assane to turn himself in and calls him a coward. Assane talks to his best friend Ben about a heist to steal the Black Pearl. The scene cuts to 2017 when Assane got arrested after stealing said Black Pearl.

The news is still rife with Assane Diop and his actions. Two journalists are fighting whether Assane Diop's story is still worth running on the front page. Just as they do, a man dressed in black enters the establishment to make a delivery.

The manager goes ahead to deliver the letter and we also see the Black Pearl securely kept for viewing in one of the rooms. The letter is for Mr Imbert, the main manager. He is shocked to read the letter.

Fleet of detectives arrive at the scene and get in to secure the perimeter from a probable grenade bombing. The letter is from Assane Diop mentioning that he will steal the Black Pearl on Friday, December 3rd at 10pm.

Raoul is bullied at school and alienated as well. Assane sees this and is reminded of his school days when he faced a similar predicament.

At the station, Guedira is excited that Assane is back. He also finds that Assane's letter is a smoke signal. Guidera explains that the name Michel Beaumont is from another Lupin story.

At the news station, Fleur (one of the two quarrelling journalists), gets the scoop about Assane and is on the front page again. Claire hears about Assane's heist challenge on the news. As they do, the police and staff start preparing for action. Mr Imbert takes a police personnel on the rounds of the place and explains the security detail.

The scene cuts to 1998 during Assane's school years, as he goes to collect the letters from his old tenement. In the present, everyone is set to action and catch Diop. A crowd gathers outside in support of him.

Sophia talks to Guidera asking for help for a clue. He says Diop might try to divert attention or he might have already stolen it. Sophia cross checks with Mr Imbert about the Black Pearl.

Back in 1998, Diop collects the letters and finds a postcard from Senegal. It is from his mom to his dad. Bruno pins Assane against the wall and demands cash. Assane and Bruno are friends and Bruno invites Assane over to his house to watch a football match on TV. Assane asks if he can crash at Bruno's place for a few days and the latter accepts.

Back in the present, everyone is waiting for Diop to steal the Black Pearl, but nothing happens for a few seconds. As they all sigh in relief, the alarm goes off and wouldn't you know it, the Black Pearl is stolen!

Even Assane's arrest was an orchestrated act ;the people taking him away are actually his friends. Assane says that he sent over the money to Bruno and gets off at a spot.

Police cars are already surrounding the city in search of Assane. A couple of strikers on the roof spot Assane making the escape but he falls down and is unconscious.

Ben is still in prison as the episode begins. He receives a phone from Assane, and Ben informs Assane that Claire knows that he's alive. Assane tells Ben about his own mother's kidnapper.

Assane reassures Ben that he will take care of the situation, but in a burst of anger, Assane takes his research map off the board, leaving only Keller's photo behind.

Manon is also in prison and being interrogated by Sofia. When Sofia shows her Assane's photo, Manon says that police

might be desperate to investigate after a dead guy. Sofia then shows Guidera's photo, which makes the other detective change her stance. Manon notices this change.

The man with the money bag in the last episode reports to Keller about the latest development. It is also revealed that the money was fake. Keller asks where Claire works and orders to kill her.

The scene cuts to 1998. Bruno and Assane are watching a match when someone knocks on the door. It is Claire. She says Bruno called her with news that Assane wants to see her, but Bruno had lied. Claire prepares to leave unless Assane apologises. He does and asks her to come in.

The scene changes to the present where Claire feels that someone is following her. Someone actually is, as it turns out, and that person is Keller's henchman. She orders a taxi and calls Alex to bring Raoul home.

Raoul says maybe Assane sent the person. Claire asks Alex to check the house and then makes some pasta for dinner. After dinner Raoul reminds Claire about the sneakers.

Alex and Claire have a dialogue about Assane and how he and Alex are different. Claire is also worried that they might be followed to Raoul's game. Alex reassures her. She almost kisses him but he rejects Claire advances.

Alex reminds Claire to lock the doors and windows and set up the alarm. Claire says she doesn't know how it works and Alex offers to set it up for her. The code is 1864.

Guidera comes to his office and finds Sofia there. Sofia tells him that she knows Guidera worked with Assane. Guidera summarises his plan and is also dejected that Assane escaped again.

Sofia is clearly agitated. She tells Guidera that he actually admires Assane as Lupin. Guidera says she can arrest him if she wants to, and the discord between them is clearly visible. She warns him to inform the next time Assane makes any contact and leaves.

Keller asks his henchman if Claire saw him and she confirms. The henchman says that she will be on her guard. Assane's mother tries to break free from the cable tie and succeeds. She overhears Keller telling his henchman to kill her the next day. As a result, Assane's mother attempts to escape from the window.

Raoul is preparing for his match and looking for his bottle. He asks Claire who proceeds to check the fridge. She finds the ketchup bottle inverted and kept, just like Assane does. She connects the dots.

Raoul asks if Assane will be at the game tonight, and Claire says she is not sure. Keller sees the window open and thinks that Assane's mother has escaped but she was in fact hiding under the bed.

After Keller leave, she goes down the stairs and walks out. She fakes an emergency and steals a man's wallet. There is small flashback from the previous episode when teenage Assane had seen his mother's postcard from Senegal.

Assane's mother reaches Assane's old residence but the new tenant slams the door in her face. Claire goes out and receives a phone call from Alex. She tells him that she is allowed to move on regardless if Assane is alive or dead.

Assane (Alex) is watching Claire from afar and sees a man follow her. She informs him that she is at the mall to buy Raoul new shoes and he guides her to a quick exit from that floor. The two continue their small talk, while Assane still has his eyes on Keller's henchman following Claire.

He asks Claire to exit the mall and go to another store. He stays on the line while she does and helps her navigate. While at the mall, Assane sneaks in a piece of clothing to the henchman's pockets. When the henchman begins to leave, the security are alerted of a theft.

The scene cuts to 1998 at Bruno's house. The trio are celebrating the win when Mrs Fouchard knocks on the door for a surprise inspection. Keller arrive in time and she leaves without any problem. Keller lashes out at Bruno and leaves in anger.

Back to the present, the henchman goes to Keller with another news of a failure. Keller pushes him out the window of Mariama's (Assane's mother) room, thus severely injuring the henchman. Mariama find Fleur's article and reaches The Objector office to talk to her in private.

Cut to 1998, Keller takes Assane and Bruno to plan on a robbery at a jewellery store. They did it once in the past and Keller is taking full benefit of the duo's dependency on him.

In the present, the police investigate the henchman's accident. He inform the detective about Keller and the fact that Keller stole the Black Pearl as well.

Fleur calls Guidera and informs him that Assane is alive. She also tells him that his mother is in Paris and has asked her to set up a meeting with her son 'at the place where the gentleman listens to his favourite song'. She gives this tip to Guidera to follow up on.

Assane sees the message in the newspaper. Guidera figures the place while Assane prepares for his meeting with his mother. Raoul and his team are allowed to play with their coach absent, but the boys are dejected that Alex did not show up. They decide to forfeit but Raoul brings up their enthusiasm.

The game is underway. Guidera calls Sofia about the message for Assane and asks for her help, but she does not trust him and cuts the call.

Guidera heads to the location, and so does Assane. However, Assane is in a disguise as an old man. He is walking up the steps when he hears a woman singing in opera notes. He is reminded

of the time he heard opera on the radio with his father. He makes the connections that his mother was referring to the opera singer in the subway.

Guidera follows Assane but he is caught by the ticket checkers. Assane spots the opera singer and his mother, but Guidera sees Assane on the other side of the platform, getting into the metro that has just arrived.

Claire sets up her house alarm and is retiring for the night as the episode comes to a close. However, Keller breaks the lock and enters the house.

Mariama is at Assane's place and wonders what her son is up to. Assane has finally reunited with his mother in the middle of all this, and has a lot of questions

to ask her. Specifically, he asks why she did not join them.

She takes him back in time and narrates what problems she faced. She mentions that she was close to securing enough money for the ticket to France but her boss suddenly decided to cut the pay in half. She then stole the money but was arrested. She was ashamed of her deed and to face her son. She also said that she became a real thief after she got out of prison. She missed them every day.

Claire frantically calls Alex and asks him to come over immediately. She says that she knows Alex is Assane. Raoul is happy to see his father alive. Assane takes Raoul and Claire to his place, and whilst there they meet Mariama as well.

The scenes shifts to 1998 when Keller takes Bruno and Assane on the heist on the day of the football World Cup finals. Assane tries to get out of the situation but Keller threatens him again.

In the present day, Assane tricks a pier checking official and successfully steals a jet from under his nose. Assane is researching on a Minister of the Interior who can get Ben out of jail.

Claire and his mom announce that they will get Ben through proper means by hiring a lawyer. Assane's mother objects to Assane robbing or cheating the Minister. Until then the family will be safe tucked away in a safe house. He promises to wrap up a few things and to leave in two days.

Assane's mother asks him to promise to not do any more robberies or heists as he has a family to support now. The scene cuts to Assane in an old military man's disguise. He pretends to be Little Ali who served in the war with the Colonel (the person whom Assane is visiting in a disguise). The two indulge in some nostalgia.

Assane keeps up with his military personnel disguise and enters a gathering where he meets the Minister of the Interior. He speaks highly of his services and looks like a true patriot.

As the medal ceremony is underway, Assane finds his way to the private chambers of the house. As he is sneaking his way in, security personnel catches him. There is a scuffle in the adjacent hallway and the guard goes to check. Assane successfully sneaks into the Minister's office but the guard finds out and issues an alert.

The scene then runs parallel to the present and 1998 as Assane tries to break into a safe, after earlier preparing to rob the jewellery store. Assane and Diop sneak into the store and talk about the match on their way. There is one security official at the desk but he is also watching the match.

Assane succeeds in the present day, and exits without anyone detecting. However, back to 1998 the alarm goes off in the jewellery store as Assane and Bruno run away with the loot. They get into the car and Keller drives them off.

In the present, Assane and his mother are wading through the tunnels but are also being followed. The jet that Assane had stolen earlier was just for this. They escape from the underground waterway.

After they successfully exit, Assane calls the Minister and threatens to leak information about his contacts with the illegal traders. Assane refuses the money offer and asks the Minister to get a friend out of jail.

Manon is let out of jail and Assane ambushes her as she is walking away. He asks her to rat out Keller but she refuses. She brings up the past when Assane gave information about Keller and Manon.

Assane then reveals what really happened in 1998. Assane and Bruno did not take the emeralds as Keller had expected. He loses his cool and drives off rashly than he already was. A policeman follows them on a bike. Keller asks Bruno to take the gun and shoot. Assane dissuades him but after pressure from Keller, Bruno shoots. They end up in a car accident, and Bruno is visibly shocked.

Back to the present, Assane justifies his actions to Manon. He asks her to call Keller and arrange for a meeting, which she does.

Assane and his family share a warm dinner and indulge in some good time with each other. After his family is in bed, he takes one long look at them before leaving for his meeting with Keller.

Guidera receives a message from Assane. It contains a picture and the word Grimaudan. Guidera looks to decode the message and succeeds. He calls Sofia and informs her Assane contacted him and that he knows the location of the Black Pearl.

Sofia does not believe Guidera. She in turn informs Guidera that she got a tip about the Black Pearl and that a person named Keller has it. He somehow convinces Sofia to follow his lead.

Assane asks Keller to hand over the Black Pearl and he eventually does so. As Keller leaves, he is surrounded by the police. Keller says that Assane has the pearl now, but Guidera runs over to find Assane and sees him standing and surrendering.

Guidera asks Assane about the pearl. In a short flashback, it is revealed that Assane lied to two women that he got stood up and hands over a rose to them. Bruno intercepts the women and asks for the rose. He says he was the date but he missed him. As it turns out, the Black Pearl is in the rose!

In 1998, Assane calls Claire from a local pub. He apologises to her and asks her to come away with him. She waits for him. The scene changes to the present. Claire, Mariama, Raoul and J'Accuse are waiting for Assane.

Assane tells Claire through a letter that he has turned himself to the police. He hopes that she and Raoul would lead a good life without him. He expresses his regrets in the letter.

Assane turns himself in, and agrees to a confession but puts forth three conditions. One is to release Ben, second is to give him a letter and the third is something to read while in prison.

A warden hands an envelope to Assane, which happens to be from a prisoner few cells away. The envelope contains a few lines from one of Lupin's stories. The man is one of the main victims of Assane's past robberies.
