Summary: Sidelined by PTSD, Special Forces veteran John Creasy gets a second chance when an old friend hires him to investigate a terrorist plot in Brazil.



The episode begins with a CIA mission being led by John Creasy, a decorated war veteran turned private contractor. However, his team is ambushed and killed in Mexico City. John escapes but he suffers from severe PTSD, turning to alcohol and pills.

4 years later, we see that he sleeps with a bag on his head, like the ones his team were put in before they were killed. He attempts suicide but survives. An old colleague, Rayburn convinces him to join his private security firm and flies him

down to Rio de Janeiro, where he lives with his wife, two sons and teen daughter, Poe who is going through her rebellious phase and "hates" her dad.

Rayburn's latest assignment is to prevent a potential terrorist attack before the local election. President Carmo has been building luxury condos instead of helping the poor, and the terrorists may target these sites. Prado Soares, head of security doesn't trust the withdrawn Creasy and tests him by asking him to strip a Glock and by jumping him. Creasy fails but Rayburn insists on hiring him, believing in him.

Poe mistakes Creasy's hesitation as annoyance at Rayburn and relates to it. However, Creasy reminds her that Rayburn loves her and would sing her lullabies via the phone no matter where he was in the world.

That night, a cop notices some truckers loading something under an overpass. A biker with a tinted helmet simply kills him.

Rayburn tries to bid Poe goodnight and rightly figures that she is upset by his uprooting their life in the USA and leaving her friends behind. He gives her a lucky penny he found at Carmo's construction site and insists all he wants is his family by his side.

John is busy drinking at a beach party and the fireworks give him PTSD. Melo, Rayburn's taxi service, picks him up and ends up lending an ear when he worries about letting down Rayburn.

He runs off on spotting a church in an abandoned alley and two men try to rob him. He only takes it seriously when Melo tries to stop them and they take her hostage. Creasy almost kills them and Melo stops him.

Once everyone is asleep, Poe heads off to a house party. But she is not in the mood and falls asleep. She wakes up and realises she has 15 minutes before Rayburn notices she is gone. She takes her friend, Liam's bike and races home.

Near the intersection, the truck and the biker from earlier cause her to fall. Annoyed, she finally arrives at the complex and her dad spots her from the lobby. He is teasing her when the building explodes, killing him, his wife and two sons. Both Poe and John are in shock.

Soares debriefs Creasy that FRP, an extremist organisation, has taken responsibility. Poe is the only witness but she won't speak to them. John commends her for using her statement as leverage. He negotiates on her behalf, demanding security and plane tickets to take her to her grandmother. John will be staying back to ensure Rayburn gets justice. President Carmo agrees but Soares is skeptical.

Osmar, the trucker from earlier, is given files on Poe and John, ordering him to fix things soon. They don't think John is a threat.

As they are taken to a safehouse, Poe tries to hold John's hand but he doesn't react. That night, masked, John easily puts the Glock together.

Summary: As they face relentless attacks from all sides, Creasy tries to help Poe reclaim her memories — and discovers no one can really be trusted.



The episode begins with Poe being nervous about the interview. Creasy advises her to put her emotions aside so they can approach the puzzle that is her family's murder with a clear head. However, at the same time, he doesn't want her to go through any more pain.

While Soares' men transport Creasy and Poe to the US embassy, Osmar's men attack. Creasy orders a detour to the closest military base and hangar, and Osmar's men fall back.

Creasy believes there's a leak in the chain of command and refuses to let Soares or anyone else interview Poe. Soares is hesitant but agrees.

Creasy's methods are unconventional but he makes Poe relive the memories. She not only identifies the two white vans heading towards the complex, but she also remembers seeing the biker's face. She breaks down and while Creasy is surprised, he gives her her space.

Soares is impressed and agrees to work with Creasy. However, he fears that by having a purpose now, it may bring out the worst in Creasy.

While Soares heads out to debrief the president, a private jet is readied to take Poe to USA. She wants to stay with Creasy but he convinces her to get on the plane.

Right then, Osmar's men arrive and a gunfight ensues. Creasy takes one of the shooters, Tiago, hostage and drives off with Poe in a local's car.

Elsewhere, Gabi worries for Melo's daughter who has shut down after the murder of Melo's husband. Gabi believes it is not safe for them and wants Melo and the girl to move to USA. Creasy calls, asking for help and Melo agrees in exchange for legal relocation.

Next, he calls Tappen, his old CIA boss, who had greenlighted the mission that killed his team. Tappen agrees to provide cash, protection and a plane for Poe.

Melo takes Creasy and Poe to a favela, a low-income neighbourhood, where her cousin is part of the local police. Poe sees a chess set in the safehouse and reminisces how Rayburn tried to teach her, since navigating life is like playing chess. Creasy smiles for the first time as it is he who taught Rayburn chess.

Poe has questions about Tiago and how the interrogation will go and Creasy doesn't hide what he is about to do. Melo sees her daughter in Poe and hangs out with her. They end up bonding over Brazilian chicken nuggets and being lonely.

During the interrogation, Tiago easily breaks. Turns out, he and his men are just part of a local gang. Osmar, who is part of FRP, hired them for a hit after the bombing. Osmar also knew Creasy and Poe would go to the military hangar for the detour.

Meanwhile, the CIA contact the Brazilian government to aid Creasy. However, President Carmo doesn't trust Creasy, calling him a loose cannon. He is hesitant to help as it won't be good for the optics.

At the end of the episode, Creasy comes up with a plan to get Tiago to lead him to Osmar. But he needs Poe's help.

Melo needs to go back to her daughter and ropes in her cousin, Beto to look after Poe. However, Beto is involved in some kind of gang war and decides to bring in his inexperienced baby brother, Livro, to guard Poe. A fellow gang member, Vico warns him that it is a bad idea.

But Beto wants Livro to earn his keep and join a gang. Livro hates violence and Beto warns him to man up. Livro ends up bonding with Poe as he is also an orphan. Beto used to look out for him but now hates him for being different.

A CIA contact brings Creasy the money for his mission. He also reveals that FRP has been trying to swing the election and their leader, Ferraz is in jail.

With the fake pictures, Tiago contacts Osmar from a warehouse intercom, and the latter orders him to buy a burner phone and wait. But the impatient Creasy forces him to enter the warehouse. Tiago attacks and Creasy kills him. It alerts the thugs in the warehouse to Creasy's presence but he escapes.

Meanwhile, Poe wants to go out and Livro agrees to a short excursion. They talk about books and chess before running into Vico. The thug messes with them and even holds Poe at knifepoint. He claims he is just testing Livro and that he is the only one who cares for the boy.

Once they are left alone, Poe calls Creasy and begs him to come back, as she is scared. In a rush, he drops Melo's card at the mobile store. However, he hangs up on Poe when Osmar calls the burner phone.

The burner has a tracker and Creasy lures Osmar to a parking lot. At the same time, the mobile store owner tells Osmar about Melo's card.

Elsewhere, Melo tells Gabi about Creasy and how he can help her daughter, Marina move to the USA. She also relates to him and wants to help but Gabi is worried for her.

At the parking lot, Osmar and his men fail to find Creasy. Annoyed, Ferraz pulls Osmar out of the mission. While defeated, Osmar tells his men to check out Melo. When they leave, we see that Creasy has sneaked into Osmar's car.

Poe is scared and keeps trying to call Creasy who doesn't pick up. She plays with the lucky coin her dad had given her. Livro gifts her a book on chess as a farewell and reveals that he has been replaced by one of Beto's bodyguards. She asks him to wait anyway till Creasy returns.

As it gets to midnight, she panics as Creasy hasn't shown up. Livro promises that no one would leave her behind.

Meanwhile, Osmar's men jump Melo and demand answers on Creasy. With a gun to her head, she is forced to drive them to Poe.

At home, Osmar gets a call from his men about Melo taking them to Poe. He tucks his son in and once he leaves, Creasy approaches the little boy.

The episode begins with the extraction team waiting for Poe and Creasy, but they never show up.

Creasy tricks the kid, Mateus and traps him, his mother and Osmar in the panic room. Once he ties down the family, he makes his offer. Osmar aka Gabriel is a dead man but Creasy will let his family live if he tells him everything about the FRP and the bombing.

Back at the favela, Melo warns her gang with car blinkers of Osmar's thugs holding her at gunpoint. Everyone's im-

mediately alerted and starts arming up. A confused Poe thinks the favela is after her and runs off with Livro trying to stop her. Vico takes control of the situation and rants how he is the one handling Beto's assignment.

The favela starts shooting, killing one of the thugs. The other, Gray Beard makes a run for it. The chase comes to a stop when Gray Beard runs into Poe and grabs her and Livro.

Osmar is more than cooperative and Creasy uploads all blueprints to his old CIA portal. Tappen decides to analyse it first before sharing it with President Carmo.

Back to the interrogation, Osmar doesn't know the identity of the mysterious biker, claiming he was sent to monitor the attack. Creasy pretends to hurt Mateus and instead, Osmar reveals that someone was going to track Poe in USA should he fail to capture her in Rio.

Gray Beard calls Osmar's home and on learning of the situation, demands a hostage swap — Poe and Livro for Osmar and his family. Via the call, Poe begs Creasy to help and it triggers the time he saw and heard his team getting killed. He passes out and Osmar coaches his son into moving his swivel chair to the panic room exit.

Meanwhile, Vico is furious with Beto for putting Livro at risk just for some money. While Beto and Melo try to get in touch with Creasy for the hostage negotiations, Vico takes matters into his

own hands to save Livro. Gray Beard is holding Poe in front of him and Vico plans to kill Poe, allowing his right-hand man to kill Gray Beard who would be left wide open.

However, Gray Beard keeps moving and Vico accidentally shoots Livro in the arm. At the same time, Creasy wakes up and stops Mateus from escaping. Gray Beard calls the panic room again and threatens to kill the two teens unless Vico stops shooting at him.

We see that Creasy has also uploaded a recording of Osmar listing everyone involved in the bombing. Tappen and the CIA director are impressed and finally decide to share it all with Soares.

Melo is able to get in touch with Creasy who agrees to a hostage exchange. Duda, Vico's superior, is upset that he jeopardised the whole assignment and put Livro at risk.

The hostage swap takes place in the mountains. Osmar's men, all trained, keep their distance as Creasy keeps his hands on the family. The favela, some nervous and inexperienced, train their guns on Gray Beard, who has his gun pointed at the two teens. It's a close call but the swap is successful.

Beto berates Livro for messing things up. Poe cries and blames Creasy for abandoning her and he apologises to her. But it is still not over as Poe knows the biker's identity. Creasy, Poe and Melo pick up Melo's daughter, Mariana and they head to another safehouse.

The news reports that the Brazilian authorities have identified and neutralized all individuals involved in the bombing. Osmar has allegedly killed himself and his family has apparently been arrested while trying to flee the city.

Creasy is still radio silent and Tappen announces that he will personally go to Rio and help him. But alone, he tells someone that he will kill Creasy and Poe.

Melo too tries to convince Creasy not to abandon Poe. When he doesn't listen, she offers to take in Poe till the Ferraz situation is resolved.

Creasy pays Duda's men for their troubles. We see that crew politics is involved as Vico isn't part of Duda's crew. Duda blames Beto for taking on a complicated assignment and gives Vico his cut from Beto's share.

Annoyed, Beto takes out his anger on Livro, beating him up. Melo, who has come for her share, is shocked and tries to stop him. Vico throws the money at Beto, wanting no part of it.

Melo demands answers from Vico and is shocked to learn that, like Beto, many bully Livro for being different.

Meanwhile, Tappen leaves Creasy a message at one of the hotels and the latter calls him from a burner. Tappen stalls, trying to emotionally manipulate him. Creasy refuses his help and hangs up but it is too late; Tappen gets his location.

Melo brings Vico and Livro to the safehouse and Creasy is annoyed. Melo explains her strategy — she and Vico want him to help relocate Livro as well, since the favela will kill him. To earn his keep, Vico promises to get Creasy in and out of the prison.

Ferraz reveals that Creasy has just doomed himself. The news suddenly reports that Creasy has kidnapped Poe and is responsible for the bombing.

Even Ivan doubts Creasy and puts the relocation on pause. A tipline is set up and for the reward, Beto decides to snitch on Creasy. He gets a hold of Vico's right-hand man, Bacca and learns all about Ivan. He doesn't even care about the reward and just wants to get back at Vico and Melo.

Back in the tunnel, Ferraz reveals that he actually wants Creasy's help. The FRP was never violent towards civilians. President Carmo has kidnapped Ferraz's family and is forcing him to attack the city. Under the pretence of stopping the FRP, Carmo not only steals the election, but he can also declare emergency.

Ferraz asks Creasy to help rescue his family. In turn, he will hand in recorded phone calls with Carmo and Soares, forcing him to conduct the bombing.

His final ace is intel on Tappen's involvement. Tappen has gone rogue and is working with Carmo. FRP was supposed to target a different building. But when Rayburn hired Creasy to crack down on the leak, Tappen convinced Carmo to target them so their plan is not exposed. Tappen also personally supervised the bombing. At this, Creasy is heartbroken.

Creasy calls Poe and gives her a line-up. From it, she recognises Tappen as the biker, confirming Ferraz's story.

With Beto's intel, the news reports that Marina, Melo and Livro are in cahoots with Creasy. In prison, Felipe snitches and tells Soares about the entrance to the underground tunnels. The prison guards get close to Creasy but he triggers a bomb attached to a faraway pipe and lures them away.

Creasy updates Ivan who decides to use his original plan to rescue Creasy and Ferraz. However, he doesn't have enough men and needs 3 more hands. Along with Melo, Livro volunteers. He convinces Vico who is upset that Livro is risking himself. Livro wants to prove himself and believes it is the right thing to do.

While Ivan's prison break begins, Tappen orders another mission. He knows of Ivan and decides to lead a raid at his villa in hopes of catching Poe. Fortunately, she spots him early on and escapes with Marina on a bike.

At the prison, Livro, Vico and Melo pretend to be the bomb squad. Ivan distracts the guards by shooting at the prison from a helicopter. Vico gets them in and Melo is able to call for a fake evacuation near the tunnel. Outside, Livro waits as the getaway driver and takes inspiration from Vico's brash persona to evade any questions.

Right before the gang escapes, Ferraz backs out. There are no recordings! He simply wanted to save his family. And he truly hopes that Creasy will find a way to take down Carmo. The only thing he can do is stall by giving fake intel to Soares when he is questioned about the prison break.

Creasy is furious but has no choice as he leaves Ferraz behind.

Everyone escapes smoothly and they are all reunited at the docks. Poe hugs Creasy and he lies that they have everything. Alone, he tells Melo that they can still use him as a trade.

Summary: Cornered and exposed, Creasy sets a trap to lure his enemies into the flames — even if it means he burns alongside them.



The episode begins with Creasy telling the gang that he knows how Tappen works. Flashbacks show that Tappen wants to use his connections with Carmo to elevate his position. But Tappen has a dead man's switch insurance policy in place. He has recorded all conversations with Carmo and Soares, and collected evidence against them. If something happens to him, all evidence will be automatically released to the press and law enforcement. This will lead to Carmo and Soares' arrest.

If Creasy kills Tappen, the dead man's switch is triggered anyway.

Creasy also helps rescue Ferraz's family which angers Soares. He kills Ferraz and puts Tappen on house arrest so Creasy cannot go after the CIA agent.

Creasy's initial plan is to turn himself in, get in a room with Tappen and kill him. Melo warns him against this suicide mission. He feels guilty and blames himself for Rayburn being targeted and his team being killed. Melo insists it is not his fault and explains that Poe cannot lose him too. She needs him to survive what comes after.

We see this when Poe is finally able to log into her dad's laptop. She sees family photos and starts crying as her memories of them are tainted. Creasy comforts her and promises her that she is not alone. She bitterly points out that she is and he reveals that he will stay by her side.

At the end of the episode, we see that he is with her at the Rayburns' funeral.

Creasy makes a fake tape. Ivan's man, Osip laces it with a mild nonfatal toxin. And Melo puts it in a safe deposit box.

Ivan's father has a condo under a shell company and the gang pretends to rob it.

Unfortunately, a neighbour recognises Creasy and calls the cops. There is a lot of confusion when the gang escapes. On his own, Vico decides to get arrested so they can complete the trap.

Tappen questions Vico who lies that he was hired to steal a key to a safe deposit box which has a tape recording of Carmo forcing Ferraz to conduct the bombing.

Soares and Tappen retrieve the tape and play it in a locked room. They hear Creasy lying that the tape is laced with a fatal toxin. The two men experience some symptoms and panic. They call for an evacuation and in the chaos, Vico escapes.

Soares and Tappen are brought to the nearest hospital to be checked. Poe reveals herself to them and runs off with Ivan. Shocked, Tappen sends most of the officers after her.

With minimal security around Tappen and Soares, Creasy heads towards them. But Tappen soon realises that this is a trap and orders a lockdown.

Reinforcement arrives and starts shooting at the gang. Vico, Livro and Melo arrive to help Ivan and Poe who are surrounded.

Creasy goes after Tappen and corners him in a room. Poe screams for Creasy through the in-ear and it triggers one of his episodes. Tappen strangles him but Creasy comes to his senses and kills Tappen.

The officers are about to gun down the gang when Creasy shows up with a Molotov cocktail. He sets the officers on fire and kills them.

They almost escape but Soares takes Poe hostage. He points out that he has nothing to lose with the dead man's switch being triggered. Poe uses her self-defence to get away and the two men struggle over the gun. Creasy kills Soares but he is shot in the chest. Fortunately, Creasy survives.

The whole truth is revealed with Creasy's name being cleared. Carmo is arrested. Melo decides to stay in Rio, hoping that they can work together to fix the country. Vico and Livro join Ivan's company. Poe has been living with her grandmother and they finally hold a funeral for the Rayburns.

The CIA director contacts Creasy for a mission. The target is the same people who ambushed his team in Mexico City. Creasy agrees to take a look.
