Summary: While working the night action desk, FBI agent Peter receives a distress call and is soon put in charge protecting cybersecurity expert Rose.



The episode starts with a woman and her young daughter getting on a train. A man stands up and offers them his seat as the train is full. As he stands, the man notices a stranger wearing a black jacket and a hoodie leave a bag behind. He moves forward to inspect the bag and finds a bomb.

He pulls the emergency door release forcing the train to an abrupt stop. He takes out his FBI badge and orders the passengers to exit the train calmly. Someone announces there is a bomb and

things get hectic. Most people manage to get off the train before the bomb explodes.

Paramedics and relevant authorities arrive and the FBI agent is informed that one person died. As our protagonist receives first aid, he notices the man responsible for the bombing among the crowd, secretly watching.

The agent chases the stranger into some dark alleys and a fight ensues. As they brawl, the agent sees the man has a rattlesnake tattoo on his side. He tries to arrest the suspect but the man runs away again. As they embark on another chase, the FBI agent is hit by a car and the suspect manages to get away.

Elsewhere, a young woman called Rose is nervously excited to give her first TED talk. She seems to be a big shot in the cybersecurity field. Another lady approaches and gives her some funding documents to sign. They are both ecstatic about being able to achieve a goal they share.

We then cut forward one year later. UI's here we learn the FBI agent is called Peter and he prepares for his shift at the White House. Upon arrival, he is called in to meet with his boss, Diana Farr. She is not happy about his response when he was ambushed by a certain Elliot Rome, who accused him of being behind the bombing a year ago.

Farr asks him to learn to say no comment to Elliot Rome's ambush interviews in the future. She reminds him of their deal and that he is to bid his time being a night agent so he can proceed to something else better. She tells him she is leaving for Maryland and asks him to mark up some files for her. He thanks her and leaves.

On his way to his office, he meets Ben Almora who informs him that the President is looking forward to their pickup game. Ben implies that the President is curious about Peter's choice to remain in the FBI instead of joining the secret service. They are joined by another man, Hawkins who asks about a crime report that Peter was supposed to do.

Hawkins is not pleased to hear Peter's excuse and says the report was "need to know." He is not happy that Peter is reporting to Farr, the President's Chief of Staff. He warns Peter to pick a side carefully. Peter heads to his office, a windowless room with only a phone and a table, and starts working on some documents.

On the other hand, Rose welcomes his aunt Emma and Uncle Henry. She tells them that the board fired her. At dinner, she tells them what happened and that she will need to stay with them as she is bankrupt. Apparently, there was a data breach in her company and due to it, she lost everything. Her aunt and uncle try their best to cheer her up and assure her everything will be fine. They have no problem helping her as she is family.

Later that night, Rose wakes after hearing her aunt and uncle talking downstairs. She overhears them talking about warning Osprey, burning documents, and the country being in trouble. Her aunt is also worried about an engineer and some files and that no one in the White House can be trusted. Rose approaches them and her aunt draws her gun. She refuses to answer Rose's question and tells her that someone is outside.

Her uncle gives her a piece of paper and asks her to go to the neighbour's house down the road and call the number on the paper. They insist that she says the words written on the paper after saying night action. Her uncle also orders her to say they need help and Rose leaves in a panic. Sadly, her uncle and aunt are attacked by two people and killed in their home. Rose happens to see one of the attackers on her way out and he starts chasing after her.

She gets to the neighbour's house and thankfully they are not home. She breaks in and calls the number on the paper. Peter is shocked to hear the phone ringing, he initially assumes it is a wrong number after Rose fails to answer his coded questions. Rose pleads with him and says her uncle and aunt are in danger and a man is pursuing her. Peter calls for help and sends a patrol to the house. He also orders Farr to be contacted.

One of the killers follows Rose into the house and Peter helps her hide. The man gets dangerously close but luckily, the patrol officers arrive in time to save her. Unfortunately, the killer escaped through a window. Peter and Rose are relieved and Rose is taken under the protection of the police.

Farr calls Peter and asks for an update. Peter informs her that Rose called and said two of their agents are in trouble. Farr tells him they can't leave their witness at the hands of local police and Peter tells her that Hawkins is already on his way. Farr says that they need to do this right so she will go to the White House and have someone take over Peter's post. In the meantime, she orders Peter to go to Rose and keep her safe. He is not to ask Rose any questions or tell her anything until Barr and Hawkins have a debrief in the morning. He is also not to tell anyone their location, not even Farr.

Peter leaves to get Rose and finds Hawkins has already given her the news of her aunt and uncle's passing. Hawkins is not pleased that Farr sent Peter to take Rose but the order came from the President and he has no choice but to stand down.

Peter drives away with Rose and informs her that he works for the FBI and they are heading to his apartment to pick up a few things. Rose is starting to realize her aunt and uncle lied to her but Peter tells her that he has orders not to tell her anything. He also tells her that he doesn't know why her family was killed.

They get to his house and he tells her about the debriefing scheduled for the next morning. He asks for her phone and asks her to pack some clothes from the next room. He opens his safe and takes a gun, takes a burner phone and grabs a to-go bag. He also puts Rose's phone in his safe and sets a surveillance camera in his apartment. Rose finds some clothes and some newspaper about a disgraced FBI agent who died in a car crash. She also feels wary of Peter as he said he works for the FBI but has a pass for the White House. She asks to go to the police and he tells her is not safe, they need to find someplace to stay low.

Outside his house, he is attacked by two men who have been listening to what Elliot has been saying. They believe he was part of the Metro bombing and is a traitor like his father. Peter takes their wallets after fighting them off and asks them to wait for the police. He leaves with Rose and calls Farr and asks her to send agents to pick up the two men. Farr asks him to take care of Rose.

Rose asks him why the two men thought he was a traitor and Peter tells her he is innocent and so was his dad. Rose talks about her aunt and asks why he was the one who answered. Peter explains that it is his job and this is the first time a call was made to ask for help. He notices that there is a car following them. He orders Rose to call the top number on his phone and asks for help through the night call.

Their assailant starts shooting and Rose is slightly injured by the grass. Peter uses his skills to lose the tail and they go to an AirBnB rented under his friend's name. Rose asks about the female clothes in his house and he explains they belong to his ex-fiancee, Zoe.

Rose feels scared that there are people after her, but Peter keeps watch while asking her to tell him everything she saw and heard at the debrief.

Peter reminds her about his orders when she questions him. She asks what night action is and Peter explains it is a counterintelligence program for agents in distress. Rose realizes that her aunt and uncle were spies but Peter admits he doesn't know anything as he is low-level.

While Rose sleeps, Peter gets a notification that someone is in his house. He calls Farr and she alerts the agents outside his house. Unfortunately, when they get there, the two intruders are gone. Peter takes a screenshot of the ring one of the intruders was wearing.

The next morning, Peter drives Rose to the debrief in a quiet neighbourhood. Farr is glad they are alive and introduces herself to Rose. Rose asks for Peter to tag along and Farr agrees. When Rose leaves to use the restroom, Farr updates Peter on the break-in at his house. The FBI doesn't have much. Hawkins kicks him out of the debrief as it is above his level, and in doing so Peter runs into Rose coming from the restroom. He urges her to tell Farr and Hawkins everything. Rose tells him she can't trust anyone as she overheard her aunt say that someone in the White House is compromised.

Away from the debrief, a woman is visited by a couple carrying a baby. The owner agrees to let them in and as they casually talk, she realizes something is off. Unfortunately, it is too late and the young couple kill her and take a bag. They leave the baby behind and drive off. The man texts someone that it is done and he gets an order to return to D.C. and finish what they started. It turns out the toddler was abducted.

Summary: After looking for a link between the Campbells and the FBI, Peter is forced to go on the run with Rose in search of a hard drive — and more answers.



The episode starts with a flashback to three months ago, the day Rose's company went bust. She was giving an interview when she got a call from their biggest client. He was angry that his company's system has been hacked. She rushed to check what the problem is and realizes someone named Adam messed with the codes on their side.

Back in the present, Rose gives her statement to Hawkins and Farr. Hawkins is pushing her as he believes she is hiding something. Rose insists that she is telling

them everything but Hawkins is adamant that after 30 years in the FBI, he knows when someone is lying.

Rose leaves the room angry and Hawkins tells Farr that Peter shouldn't be protecting Rose, he is not qualified. Farr points out that she has been watching Peter for the past year and he is ready.

Rose comes back and asks what the next step is. Farr informs her that she will remain in Secret Service protection and will be taken to a hotel. She is to remain there until it is safe. Peter offers to escort her to the hotel but Rose insists on walking.

Peter asks why she withheld information and she reminds him the White House has been compromised. They get to the hotel and Rose complains about living there with no gadgets or books. Peter assures her that she is safe under the Secret Service's watch and she thanks him. Peter leaves and even sends books to her room.

Meanwhile, the killers, Dale and Hellen drive back to D.C and get a ticket for speeding. Hellen is curious about what is in the bag and but Dale warns her that it could be dangerous to open it.

Peter reports for his shift at the White House and Farr asks if he got more from Rose. He says no. A meeting starts, led by Farr, and Hawkins briefs the people present that the Campbell's

(Rose's aunt and uncle) worked for the FBI in counterintelligence and had retired. He believes they called night action because they were working something off books. Ben asks him to consider that someone might have changed the rules in Spyland.

So far, the FBI has no suspects or motives. Hawkins asks Peter to stay out of it as he is not even supposed to be in the room. Farr interjects and points out Rose is alive thanks to Peter, and she also wants to know what Hawkins is hiding in his investigation. She is worried about the truth of the Campbells getting out and wants the case to be solved before that happens.

After the meeting, Farr asks Peter to double-check Hawkins' work and get him the files on the Campbells when they worked for the FBI. Even though it is above his clearance, she wants Peter to find out what Hawkins might be hiding. She wants to know if Peter is ready and willing to do what it takes to get to the truth and protect Rose. He wants him to step up.

Peter leaves to find check on an update regarding the ring the intruder was wearing. His colleague tells him the ring is similar to a sigil from the Royal House of Yugoslavia. They deduce the original owner may be from a royal family.

Peter heads into his office and after checking the files, finds out that Hawkins used to be the Campbells' handler while they worked for the FBI. This is also news to Farr and he wonders what else Hawkins might be hiding. She asks him to separate the cases Hawkins oversaw and have the report on her desk the next morning. She also wants him to keep this new information to themselves.

Later, Peter receives a call from the night action number. It turns out to be Rose who remembered the number. She is feeling lonely and also wants to know if they are making progress on the case. Peter assures her that they are working on some new leads. They talk and Rose shares she is worried about what happens next.

They talk some more and reveal more about their lives. Rose tells him she was betrayed by a friend and Peter tells her about his old dream of being a professional basketballer. Rose shares she misses her aunt and uncle and invites him to have breakfast with her the next morning. Peter agrees and says they can do a late breakfast.

On the other side of town, Dale and Ellen are at a motel. Ellen is still obsessing about what is in the bag. She decides to look and finds a nanny cam, Ellen wonders if they can download the files but Dale tells her to leave it alone. He gets a call from two men who tells him that they have new information on the target. They send the new information to Dale.

The client and the second man talk about Dale and Ellen, retorting that Dale has been working for him for the past eight years and recently brought in Ellen. They make a good team and have excellent results.

The next morning, Peter delivers the files to Farr and tells her about his breakfast plans with Rose. Farr thinks it is good that he is forming a connection with Rose and hopes she will open up to Peter. Peter arrives at the hotel though and finds the Secret Service agents gone. He rushes to Rose's room and finds the door unlocked. Her attackers killed the power and the lock on her door is not working. They rush to escape but Dale sees them on the stairs and opens fire.

Peter and Rose jump through the glass window and flee into the streets. As Rose was only in a robe, they head to a clothing store to buy new clothes. Ellen visits the store but is unable to spot them. This makes her frustrated as she doesn't like losing. She steals a phone and Peter uses it to call Farr. He wants to know who pulled out the Secret Service agents. Farr kicks everyone out of the room except Ben and Nathan Briggs from Secret Service.

She asks Peter to repeat what he said. Ben says it is impossible and orders Nathan to check. He finds out that a command was issued 30 minutes ago, pulling out the agents. The only people who have such access are the President, Farr, Ben, Briggs and Hawkins. Peter asks for Hawkins' location but he is unreachable and Rose finds that suspicious. Farr asks them for their location so she can send someone to get them. He won't be coming in and will do whatever it takes to keep her safe.

Rose argues they need to get proactive and figure out what her aunt and uncle were investigating and what got them killed. She has a clue about where to start and they head back to the Campbell's house. Rose learns that they shot her aunt six times and is motivated to get her revenge.

Rose tells Peter about what she overheard that night about Osprey, the engineer, and some files. She overheard them saying the country is in trouble and something will be going down in

seven days. She also remembers her uncle mentioning a driver in the woods and she figures out what he meant. They grab some clothes in the house and take her aunt's car to a cabin.

Concurrently, Hawkins meets with the mastermind behind the killings. Meanwhile, Ellen and Dale go back to the motel, where Dale tries to calm her down. Their moment is interrupted by the client who calls to give them a new mission.

On the drive, Peter tries to convince Rose that she doesn't have to do an investigation and she can trust the FBI. He promises to take care of her and prevent another scenario like the one that happened at the hotel.

They arrive at the cabin and start searching the house. Peter finds a hard drive hidden inside the wall, and Rose tries to open it. In doing so, she finds out that it has been heavily encrypted and she can't access the files. Peter realizes the files are named 2781, the number of the train he was on when the bomb went off. He wonders what Rose's aunt and uncle were doing investigating the Metro bombing.

Mulling this over, he calls Farr and asks her if they found out who pulled the agents. She reveals that the order came from Hawkins but he is unavailable to answer their question since he is dead. Someone killed him and left his body to be discovered on a farm. He was shot six times as well.

Peter tells her about the encrypted hard drive and she orders them to come in. She wants to keep them safe and urges them to bring the hard-drive too.

Summary: Peter teams up with Rose for a risky mission at the White House. Elsewhere, a notable agent joins the security detail for the Vice President's daughter.



The episode starts with a flashback to one year ago when Farr first met with Peter at a zoo. She asks if he has ever been there and he recalls visiting while young and wanting to be a bear. He shares that he was being bullied at the time so he chose a bear.

Farr asks him if he has heard about night action and explains what the job entails. Peter was under the impression that she was hiring him to be a night agent. She clarifies that she wants him to answer the phones for the night agents

and Peter says that she is asking him to be a glorified 9-1-1 operator. Farr tells him that the phone never rings unless a night agent is in trouble.

She also states that this would be great for his career and will open doors for him. Given his dad's legacy, it will be hard for him to get a better offer. Farr tells him that his answer before was wrong, in a zoo, you should always want to be the decision-maker. The one with all the keys hence the zookeeper.

Back in the present, Farr asks Peter if he heard her and he responds that they will be at the White House in one hour. After hanging up, Peter ponders over why Hawkins would throw away his 30 years of service and become a traitor. On the other hand, Rose doesn't care what drove Hawkins to his early grave. She is more concerned that Peter is intent on following his orders and wants to go to the White House in one hour.

Peter tells her that they could de-encrypt the hard drive there as they have the necessary resources. Rose argues that they could be potentially handing over evidence to the culprit at the

White House. She thinks that someone willing to kill the Deputy Director of the FBI is not only dangerous but powerful. She says whatever the case, whether Hawkins was clean or dirty, it is risky going to the White House. Peter asks her if she thinks everyone in the White House is dirty and she responds that she is still not going.

Peter says he is too low-level to go against an order and the situation is above his level. He believes that they can trust Farr to protect them. She was the only person who gave him a chance even after knowing who his father is. He is betting their lives on the fact that she will come through for them.

He calls Farr and tells her that Rose is hesitant to come in and they will need time. She agrees to give them until 10 am the next morning. He asks about Hawkins and she tells him that they are investigating who he was meeting and the President is being briefed in an hour.

At the brief, the President is informed that the officers have no suspects or witnesses and very little evidence. They are only sure he was killed somewhere else and his body dumped on the farm. The President asks to be updated and informed when she can share her condolences. In a shocking twist, we see the second man who was in talks with the hired assassins among those in the brief.

Farr remains behind and updates the President on the Rose situation. She asks the President to read her in on Campbell's mission. The President agrees and asks her to sit down.

Meanwhile in the woods, Peter and Rose watch the cabin from afar. They are trying to test if Farr can be trusted as she is the only one who knows their location. If the hired assassins arrive, they will know that she is on the take. Soon, the assassins arrive and search the cabin.

They also search the woods nearby but Rose and Peter are able to escape. Peter also manages to take their number plate number. He calls his cop friend, Sisco and asks him to run a BOLO on the car. Rose takes this as a sign that Farr can't be trusted but Peter is hesitant to believe this.

Back at the White House, Ben confronts Farr on the whereabouts of Peter and Rose and she says she doesn't trust him. She questions how he didn't know that the Secret Service agents were pulled from the hotel. Ben claims his innocence and Farr tells him that she will let him know when she knows more. HE leaves to take a call from one of the Secret Service agents, Arrington tasked to take care of the Vice President's daughter, Maddie.

Maddie is studying Art & Activism at Georgetown University. Ben informs Arrington that he is pulling out an agent and sending a replacement as it is all hands on deck after Hawkins' murder. Arrington is not pleased to hear Ben is sending Erik Monks as the replacement. She, however, says it is okay.

Once Erik gets there, Arrington introduces Maddie to the new agent. Maddie is in a rush and trusts Arrington knows what she is doing. She rushes to her, next class and Arrington gets Erik up to date. Peter follows through with the plan and lies that Rose ditched him. Farr puts out a BOLO on Rose. The plan goes well until some police officers unknowingly visit the diner she was at. She freaks out and hurriedly leaves and Farr finds out their plan.

She asks him why he did it and he says he doesn't trust her since she was the only one who knew their location. Farr realizes her phone might have been hacked and sends it to the lab. She assures Peter that she can be trusted. She tells Peter that the Campbells were commissioned by the President to look into the Metro bombing.

The President was doubtful about the report and a leaked statement from a terror group, People's independence Front (PIF) . PIF later denied issuing a statement taking credit for the attack. There were also many questions instead of answers. The President initiated night action and the Campbells were close to finding the person from the White House who was involved. Farr thinks it might have been Hawkins but she doesn't want to make assumptions. She wants to find the evidence first.

Meanwhile, Ellen gets sick of staying in a motel and convinces Dale to stay at an open house she visited earlier. She dreams of living a fancy normal life but Dale doesn't feel the same. Nonetheless, Dale agrees to stay with her for a while at the open house.

At the University, Maddie's teacher starts subtly flirting with her. Maddie starts feeling better and happier after her professor shows interest. She later has an incident at a bar with some random man. Whilst there, Erik slips up due to his shoulder injury. Arrington gets frustrated with him and says she has to report it. Erik shares his suspicions of Maddie's suspicion of Maddie and the professor. They head to the professor's house but find no sign of Maddie.

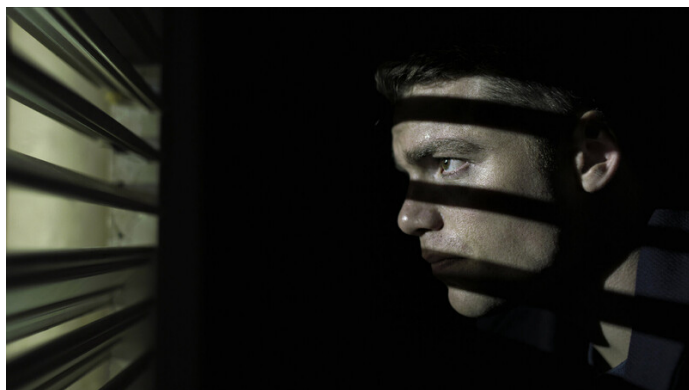
