While the party gets underway, at a CIA Black Site they notice something afoul with the nuke that was disarmed earlier. However, they can't get through to Hagerty, who's currently doing drugs and high on shrooms. Unfortunately, he encourages Paul to eat some of the dip, which he's laced with drugs. Paul has no idea and eats a fair amount.

In the midst of this, Paul and Ava end up fighting but the latter uses her resources to better Paul. There's also a rather risqué moment involving Paul and another guy in the shower, but there's more important things going on right now.

Remember the CIA Black Site? Well, it turns out the "lab rats" have learned that the bomb they seized only has hints of the Uranium needed to level the city. So where is the rest of it? Well, it turns out this operation is far from over. But unfortunately every Special Forces member are not exactly in a fit state to work right now.

McKnight isn't a complete chad (wordplay absolutely intentional here) as Ava overhears him in one of the bedrooms talking to his mum. It certainly has Ava think differently of him and the pair end up having sex. Unfortunately it all goes wrong wrong; Chad says the L word and the pair can't "rise" to the occasion.

When Ava starts getting dressed, Lerner rocks up in whipped cream and she's crushed when she sees Ava and him together. An earlier chat explains this because Lerner has the hots for McKnight and confided in Ava about her feelings. As a result, she bolts out the room.

Ava can't follow though as she receives a mysterious call from someone who reveals that they still have the bomb and they'll detonate it unless the group release Koslov. If they don't, the city is going to be obliterated. They have 5 minutes to clear the place out, so Ava does just that and then they take the Zoom call in the bedroom.

It's rather hilarious, especially when the camel shows up on screen. They also lie and claim that they've celebrated responsibility. Their leader tells the group they have 7 hours to find that nuke, and under the influence like this — not to mention Hagerty completely out of it and Lerner AWOL — that's not going to be easy.

Ava realizes that there's a "main course" out there with a real buyer and the appetizer Koslov mentioned before is just a crypto buyer (the meeting interrupted earlier on) that was going to be scammed.

Lerner happens to be off with an eccentric singleton called Sharonda who has her in the back of her car. The trouble is, she's undercover and working with Koslov. Hagerty shows up in the hotel room while this is going on, completely out of it and buck naked before collapsing on the ground.

Everyone is scooped up and thrown in the back of a helicopter and they take off for parts unknown.

Summary: The team races to Area 52 to grill Koslov and his buyer, and Maya heads to the strip club with a new friend who threatens to sabotage their mission.



The episode begins at Cannon Air Force Base in New Mexico. We're six months earlier than the current timeline and the team are about to be briefed on their big mission. They're all acquainted before they're told about a special ops force. They're essentially the best of the best combining forces to get rid of the portable nuclear device on US soil.

Agent Ava Winters is apparently the absolute best leader they have and she's leading the team forward. We're given some background about Koslov, includ-

ing how he's holding a grudge over the government after his family were killed in a fire in the past. The team essentially need to find and neutralize the device and the only way to do that is by working together.

Back to the present and onboard the helicopter, nobody is working together. They're all bickering and fighting, even when they touch down at the airbase. They scoop up Haggerty and take him inside, while Ava makes a pretty bad first impression by falling over in front of the Colonel. They're taken into Area 52, which is their top secret base that they're keeping Koslov.

Ava decides to speak to Lana, the woman who was tied to the bed in Koslov's bedroom last chapter. Ava hopes to get through to her and they begin talking. Lana apparently met Ivan at a party a few nights ago and he promised to show her his private jet. Lana remembers them

speaking Russian, which is a start, but Ava is convinced that she knows more than she's letting on so decides to keep her around.

Ava speaks to Koslov next. He antagonizes her but Ava takes it on the chin and decides she may be able to get some info out of Chen, the other guy they've arrested. Koslov is confident that Ava won't get anything about she leaves the room all the same. When she does, McKnight jumps in and decides to talk about how amazing America is. However, Koslov has the verbal upper-hand and he certainly knows his stuff. He antagonizes McKnight, getting under his skin and telling him how awful the US actually is.

As for Ava, she plays the recording she secretly made with Koslov for Chen. Within this, he berates Chen and points out how awful he is at his job. Chen opens up after this and points out that they need to find Koslov's courier. He doesn't know who he is but knows where he is. If he has his phone then he'll get the location immediately... but there are terms that need to be agreed on. Specifically, full immunity in writing from the Secretary of State.

While Ava gets to work feigning the letter, the others learn that Hagerty is out in a coma for 9-12 hours unless they can get some meth, which might wake him up. Unfortunately, everything comes to a head when McKnight decides to let loose on Koslov, smacking him around and almost jeopardizing the mission.

In the midst of this beating, Koslov does mention something important. Whoever Ivan was working with "slipped through their fingers". And that happens to be the white-suited goon from the start of episode 1.

Koslov manages to kill Chen before he says anything and decrypts his phone, and the only solution is for Lerner to get involved. She's the only one who can decrypt the phone.

Of course, Lerner is still AWOL and off drinking copious amount of alcohol. She's also spilling lots of details about the nuke and how the team are screwed without her around. Naturally, she's taken to a strip club to keep her busy while Sharonda prepares to take her out. The plant tries to drug her but it doesn't work. Thankfully, Maya Lerner starts talking to one of the dancers who takes a fancy to her, and he offers to give her a private dance in the back.

The rest of the team decide to take the Vulture over to Big Willys. While they do, Ava ends up urinating into a can during an ongoing joke about her needing to pee which continues throughout this episode. When Ava slips, Hagerty falls over the edge, McKnight jumps down to hold him and while hanging precariously, Trunks is the one who manages to save them both. Unfortunately, urine goes everywhere.

When the Vulture touches down, everyone heads inside the club save for Paul and Lana, who's along for the ride as Ava wants to keep an eye on her. Anyway, Hagerty is brought in and dumped at the exact table Lerner was at — complete with the drugged drink Sharonda has left. Thankfully he doesn't drink it, but they do manage to get him some meth, which should help revive him.

In the back, Ava manages to find Sharonda and holds her up at gunpoint before she can hit the killing blow on Lerner. Of course this ends up as one big misunderstanding, and Lerner is stuck in the middle of this.

Sharonda ends up slipping away out the back, while the rest of them hijack a party bus to chase after Sharonda. Sharonda gets the jump on them and has the pair in her sights, and almost hits the trigger on her sniper. However, Paul shows up and blows the truck sky-high before it's too late. Unfortunately, those drugs kick in and he begins hallucinating. Uh oh.

Down on the ground, Lerner decrypts the phone and learns that their target — the white-suited Russian — is called Vladislav Litvin. He's Ivan's courier. If they follow him then they should find the bomb. They know that the Americans are honing in on them but Litvin is confident that they're proceed with their plan as normal.

that looks familiar. Lana admits that she doesn't really have the hots for any of them and they all tend to blur together. Thanks Lana, that's a big help!

While Angela speaks to McKnight about his "hate-f*ck" situation, Lerner wants nothing to do with Ava after her betrayal and refuses to talk. High above, Paul is shocked when he sees his daughter hugging a random guy in her prom pics. And it turns out, she's actually off in Las Vegas too!

When Litvin ends up inside one of the casinos, the whole team gives chase to track him down. He's heading for the food court, much to Trunk's pleasure, but he's told to stay put and at a distance. Unfortunately, that means no food. As for McKnight, he starts winning at the Craps table thanks to Lerner's teachings. In the wake of this, she also throws shade at Ava for her black dress and calls her sl*t.

Litvin eats his noodles and eventually bins them when McKnight starts his USA chant. He ends up in the elevator, heading up to the 19th floor. McKnight can't wait and decides to run up

The group break into the lake house and Lerner immediately heads over to the computer. Unfortunately, it's only Windows 2000 and has dial-up internet which is going to slow things down. Ava phones Director Langdon and updates her, but also asks for help in IDing the

buyers. She has a print on a bloody zip tie but it's only a partial and it may not do much.

Paul is desperate to get involved but the others aren't so sure that's a good idea. Stealth is the name of the game here and they can't just go in hot and destroy the mission. Angela hands over her sniper rifle to Paul, being sure to avoid giving him any bullets — just in case.

In the midst of the mission brief, Lerner gets a hit with the prints. Apparently they belong to a guy called Wade Maddox. He has his own military company and he used to work with the agency. He's a Shadow Operator and after going off the grid for over a decade, he certainly knows his stuff.

While this is going on, Paul guards Hagerty but unfortunately he takes his eye off the ball and the inflatable raft drifts away while he's looking at pictures of Jen. That's a problem because at the Compound, a race for the bomb briefcase ensues. Lerner tries to stop Maddox herself but she ends up shot for her troubles. The entire team tries to help her, while we cut across to Hagerty on the water. He wakes up and finds himself on a little party boat, and immediately starts drinking.

Yeah, she was messaging Ivan Koslov instead. Lerner wakes up and decides to leave the hospital in her gown, stumbling out the front door.

While she scrambles back to find the others, Anastasia makes a deal with Ferguson. She'll give the nuke in exchange for her brother, and they need to meet at the corner of Flamingo and South Las Vegas Boulevard at 8am. Once the deal is made, they go their separate ways... but of course she has another plan. She's going to double-cross them.

As for Trunk, he's in the kitchen and finally, after 7 long episodes, he finds a massive feast and takes out the guards at the same time as eating the buffet food.
