Summary: After returning to her former position as Virginia's Chief Medical Examiner, renowned forensic pathologist Dr. Kay Scarpetta investigates a sinister and mysterious murder that eerily resembles her first big case from 28 years prior.



The episode begins with a coin sitting on a train track. An oncoming train's headlights illuminate a woman's dead body on the ground.

Elsewhere, a forensic pathologist named Kay Scarpetta gets a call about the murder. She arrives at the location and we learn that she's been away for a while since the cops welcome her back. Scarpetta examines the body, whose hands have been cut off at the wrists. Pete Marino, an ex-detective, shows up to remind Scarpetta about Lucy's birthday.

They seem very familiar with each other and she tells him the case is a bad one. She then finds the coin on the tracks and looks at it curiously.

A flashback takes us to 28 years ago. In 1998, a young Scarpetta is similarly woken up in the middle of the night by a phone call from Detective Pete Marino. He says there's been a murder. Scarpetta calls a woman she addresses as Yaya to look after the young girl sleeping in the next room — Scarpetta's niece, Lucy.

She then goes to the site of the murder, a house where a man named Matt Peterson found his wife, Lori, murdered in their bedroom. Upstairs, we see a very similar body to the one in the present timeline. The wife's body is naked and tied up and also the fourth such murder victim.

At present, Scarpetta is officially sworn in as chief medical examiner once again. She gets a visit from Dr Reddy and Maggie, both figures from her past. Dr Reddy is now a health commissioner and he asks Scarpetta to let Maggie work for her, which Scarpetta doesn't seem too happy about. We then see both versions of Scarpetta conducting an autopsy.

Maggie tells Scarpetta that an Officer Ryan has asked for her. It's unclear what this is about since the next scene shifts to an older Lucy, sitting by the grave of a woman named Janet, her wife. In the background is Scarpetta and Dorothy, her older sister and Lucy's mom. They bicker loudly, which annoys Lucy.

In the past, Marino plays an audio recording of his questioning with Matt. He suspects Matt but Scarpetta doesn't believe he's the killer. An FBI agent named Benton Wesley joins in on the investigation. He and Scarpetta think on similar lines about the killer being a sadist.

They soon learn that Matt's partial fingerprints were found on the body. Scarpetta comes home to find that Lucy's been on the computer all day. She's seen the news about the dead doctor (Lori) and tells Scarpetta not to die as her father did. Scarpetta assures her that she won't.

At present, Scarpetta comes home to find Dorothy dressed to the nines. Scarpetta's worried about Lucy since it's her birthday and she's still grieving Janet. Lucy seems to be coping by talking to an AI version of Janet in the cabin by Scarpetta's house, where she lives. Scarpetta enters the room and gifts Lucy a bracelet made of dinosaur bone.

They go back to the house where they are joined by "the husbands" — Agent Benton Wesley and Marino! Benton is married to Scarpetta while Marino is married to Dorothy. Dorothy begins telling Lucy she should work again and maybe move out, which frustrates Lucy. Scarpetta pulls Dorothy into the kitchen to tell her to stop but the argument spirals and they accuse each other of being bad for Lucy.

Benton breaks it up and tells Scarpetta she's getting a call. It's a missing person who might be the Jane Does they found earlier. Scarpetta and Marino head out. Scarpetta tells him she would have never come back if she knew Reddy was going to be her boss. She then tells Marino that she wants him by her side through the investigation since she needs someone she trusts. She makes him her official forensic operations specialist so he can access crime scenes.

They head to the house of the Jane Doe, who is a biomedical engineer named Gwen Hainey. Officer Ryan says they have found a weapon that matches her head injury, a kettlebell. He conveys that the fingerprints on the kettlebell were found to be Matt Peterson's. Scarpetta is shocked and tells Marino that they might have got the wrong guy 20 years ago.

The episode ends with a sinister clip of Matt, from both past and present.

Summary: In present day, Scarpetta and Marino enlist Lucy to track down their former prime suspect from 28 years ago, Matt Petersen, due to a possible link between the cases; while in the past, the two investigate Petersen's potential involvement in his wife's murder.



The episode begins with a flashback to Miami, 1978. A young Kay helps her father out in his grocery store. Suddenly, thieves enter and steal the store, killing her father in the process.

At present, Scarpetta notices a skin graft on Gwen's leg and sends a sample for DNA testing. At the same time, we learn that Dorothy and Marino have been staying at Benton and Scarpetta's place for a while, waiting for the work at their own house to be done soon. Which is apparently going to take another month.

Meanwhile, Lucy keeps talking to AI Janet.

After a night of working, Scarpetta comes home to hear Dorothy complaining about the fact that Marino is working with her again. She also fights with Scarpetta about Lucy's over-reliance on the AI. Scarpetta and Matt head out to work and Scarpetta once again reiterates that she shouldn't have come back.

In the past, young Scarpetta is introduced to her new colleague Wingo. He says fibres from Lori's dress were found on Matt's hunting knife. Marino and Benton put Matt through a polygraph test but the results are normal. Around this time, Scarpetta also meets Dr Reddy and quickly deduces that he wanted her job but didn't get it. Dr Reddy then comes across Maggie, who is Scarpetta's new secretary.

Marino and Scarpetta then visit the other victims' houses (Brenda, Patty, and Cecile) and try to get into the mind of the killer. They also try to find a pattern in the victims, since Cecile is the only black woman, while the others are white. Scarpetta points out that Lori was the only one who wasn't single and the killer used phone cords on her instead of a lamp cord.

At present, Scarpetta and Marino talk about the skin graft on Gwen's leg. Since they haven't been able to find Matt Peterson, they call Lucy and ask her to help find him. Elsewhere, Benton gets sworn in at the FBI, where his former boss welcomes him. He is introduced to his new colleague, Sierra, whose team has also been investigating Gwen from before she died. Sierra tells him about the case and warns him to keep all of this from his wife. Including the fact that they are currently in possession of Gwen's phone.

This is followed by intercut scenes of Sierra telling Benton details about the case and Scarpetta and Marino doing their own investigation.

We learn that Gwen's work involved 3D printing human organs and that she worked with a lot of highly sensitive information, collaborating with governments for the same. Her landlord reveals that she rented out the place for three months but the house is practically empty. He also says she had a boyfriend named Jinx Slater, a hacker who stalked her, as per her neighbours. As expected, Scarpetta wonders where her phone has gone.

In the past, Benton finds out that she might have met Lori at the ER when she got a small injury. Maggie enters the room at that moment and tells Scarpetta that someone has tried hacking into her computer to access the Peterson case. For some reason, Scarpetta suspects it might be Lucy but she adamantly refuses. Lucy's also upset because Dorothy called to say she's married a man in Hawaii.

At present, Officer Fruge calls Marino and tells him Jinx is a hacker. She hints that the police need outside help to find him. Over dinner, Lucy tells the others that she found Matt Person. He now goes by Yama Matthew Pete and lives on some sort of farm.

A closing scene shows the killer unwrapping a package in a motel room. Inside are Gwen's hands. The episode ends as he chops a finger off.

Summary: Present Scarpetta and Marino visit Matt Petersen at his Compound while Lucy and Officer Blaise Fruge team up to search for the murder victim's boyfriend. The past investigation takes a turn when Scarpetta is called into the Health Commissioner's office regarding leaks to the press.



The episode begins with a flashback to Miami, 1978. Dorothy dresses up and says goodbye to her parents, heading out to meet her boyfriend. By the time she comes home, their place is surrounded by police cars. Her mother is inconsolable and Kay is on the floor, next to a pool of blood.

At present, Dorothy is doing an interview for the 20th entry to her 'Dot the Dorkasaurus' book series. Scarpetta is annoyed when she walks in on the live interview. She complains about it to Ben-

ton, who asks her to help him shave. She does but then begins to see flashes of dead bodies and steps away.

Scarpetta and Marino then head to see Matt Peterson. They now know the skin graft on Gwen's is her DNA, which means it was likely 3D printed. They're hoping Matt has nothing to do with this because reopening the older case would open a can of worms they can't afford to have in the open.

In the past, Dorothy calls home and Scarpetta tells her off for telling Lucy about her remarriage over the phone. As usual, the argument spirals and both blame each other. Scarpetta says she's working on a really big case and shouldn't have to look after Dorothy's daughter.

She then goes to work, where a reporter named Abby tries to talk to her. She says it's personal but Scarpetta doesn't think it's appropriate for them to talk since Abby has been writing salacious articles about the case. At the lab, Scarpetta's team finds a glittery makeup remover which looks a lot like the shiny substance found on the victims' bodies. Health Commissioner Amburgay then asks to see Scarpetta.

At the commissioner's office, City Attorney Boltz and Benton are present as well. She is forced to tell them about her computer being hacked and the commissioner seems keen on firing her. In turn, she presents Lori's phone records that show she called 911. However, this has been hushed up to avoid a scandal for the government officials. As a result, the commissioner is forced to let her be.

At present, Scarpetta and Marino visit Matt at The Orchard, a place where he runs a grief camp. He invites them for lunch. Meanwhile, Officer Fruge, on Marino's directions, turns up at Lucy's place to get information on Jinx Slater. Lucy gives her Jinx's location and then insists on coming along to question him. As an ex-FBI agent, she says she's qualified and even insists on taking her car. On the way, Fruge offers her condolences for Lucy.

After they leave, Dorothy enters Lucy's cabin to leave her new book. There, Al Janet starts talking to her about her books. Fruge and Lucy go to Jinx's place, but he isn't there. They wonder if someone has taken Jinx and they're right — Jinx is in the custody of Benton and Sierra, who are questioning him as part of their case.

At the grief camp, Matt claims to not know Gwen. Scarpetta and Marino try to push further about his fingerprints but he doesn't entertain them. While there, Scarpetta notices that one of the girls has marks around her wrists, like she was tied up.

In the past, Benton visits Scarpetta at home and makes it clear he didn't know she was being summoned to see the commissioner. He says he's on her side and eventually, the two start kissing. They get an amusing interruption from Lucy after which he gets ready to leave. That's when they notice a car speeding away from the house. Was someone watching them?

At present, Scarpetta tells Marino that both Gwen and Lori's killers used Palomar knots. Marino learns about Jinx from Fruge, who also reveals they found invisible ink at Jinx's house. She also says that she and Lucy are having dinner together, which pleases Scarpetta. Meanwhile, Benton starts questioning Jinx about Gwen's work at Thor Labs.

At home, Dorothy is still talking to Janet. She asks Dorothy if she has to be so hard on Lucy for spending time with her. She promises that she would never do anything to hurt Lucy. While chatting, Al Janet says that Pete's always been in love with Kay, which takes Dorothy aback.

The episode closes with a scene from the past, in which City Attorney Boltz watches Abby from his car.

The episode begins with a flashback to New Jersey, 1978. A young Pete Marino gets beaten up by some boys. His father tells him to turn the other cheek, but his mother encourages him to fight back. Marino gives twice what he got in the end.

At present, Dorothy tells Marino that she's booked a lunch reservation at a Michelin restaurant for the two of them. Scarpetta asks Lucy for help in finding a connection between Gwen and Matt. While there, AI Janet reveals that another woman named Cammie Rammada died at

Dangerfield Island. The news reports say she drowned. Scarpetta and Marino call Officer Fruge, who reveals that she had a head wound as well. They talk to Wyatt, a security guard at Scarpetta's lab, who says that the case went to the old ME, Debbie. Mr Reddy offered to assist Debbie and turned up with several FBI officers as well.

In the past, one of Marino's contacts finds a jumpsuit in a dumpster and Scarpetta finds traces of the glitter goo found on the victims' bodies. Her colleague Wingo suddenly finds a piece

of evidence in their fridge from Lori's case. This is a big deal since all the evidence from that case has already been forwarded and this lapse could cost Scarpetta her job.

At present, Scarpetta speaks to Dr Kaminsky, who ruled Cammie's death as undetermined. She gets awkward and asks her to speak to Dr Reddy about it. Meanwhile, Dorothy takes Marino out for a fancy lunch and asks him to keep his phone on silent.

In the past, Dr Reddy learns about the mishandled evidence and Marino pretends he asked Scarpetta to test something for him. Benton join their investigation as well. They only find her fingerprints on the evidence and what's more, the UV light reveals that her fingers now have the shiny goo from the murder case. When Boltz arrives to keep a close eye on her, it's all a bit too much. Scarpetta takes her bat and goes to the incinerator, taking her frustration out on some burnt remains that are waiting to be boxed.

At present, Scarpetta confronts Dr Kaminsky and convinces her to do the right thing. She tells her that there was some argument over the jurisdiction of Cammie's case when she arrived on the scene. Dr Reddy arrived soon after and made sure the case went to their department. When Kaminsky was doing the autopsy, Reddy entered the room and made sure that she marked the case as an accident. Additionally, Kaminsky saw Maggie in the car with Dr Reddy at the crime scene.

In the middle of his lunch with Dorothy, Marino gets a call from Lucy who asks him to see what she sent. It's a picture that proves Matt and Gwen had met at a bar. Lucy realises she's made a mistake as Marino becomes furious and storms out of the restaurant to confront Matt.

Elsewhere, Officer Fruge and her colleague are trying to use their warrant to search Thor Labs. However, the institution refuses them and even calls in the Department of Defence.

Meanwhile, Benton tells Jinx that he knows he and Gwen were selling information to the Russians. He shows Jinx text exchanges between Gwen and another man and this causes him to finally confess that Gwen would add digital trails in Thor Labs' system and he would clean it up.

In the past, Benton finds Scarpetta using her bat on the remains. He helps her calm down and tells her to walk through her day. That's when she realises that she used the downstairs bathroom that day instead of her own office. Both of them and Marino head downstairs and find that the bathroom's soap has the glitter goo that was found on the jumpsuit and the victims' bodies. Scarpetta wonders if the killer has a metabolic disorder that leaves him with a strong smell, making him wash his hands obsessively.

At present, Marino confronts Matt and begins punching him. Lucy and Fruge arrive and pull Marino off of him. Matt says that he read an article about Gwen's work in 3D printing organs. He came across her at a bar and got to talking. They went to her house but nothing happened. Matt was more interested in the possibility of fully functioning synthetic organs — and using them to bring his dead wife back to life.

At her office, Scarpetta tells Maggie to gather all the paperwork for the Cammie Rammada case. At that moment, FBI officers come to Scarpetta's office and then fly her by helicopter to a location in the middle of nowhere. She's surprised to see Benton waiting to welcome her.

The episode begins on a farm. A farmer is checking his crops when a package drops nearby. Inside seems to be an artificial heart. Suddenly, similar packages and other objects begin to fall all over the farm.

At present, the FBI get Scarpetta to an area cordoned off by the FBI. Benton and Sierra are there and they say they need her help. Sierra explains that Thor Labs launched a space lab to test their 3D printing of organs. The ground office lost contact with the station and it soon

fell through the Earth's atmosphere and crashed. There were three men aboard, including a man named Jared Horton, who was supposedly in league with Gwen in selling information to the Russians. Two bodies were found inside the wreckage and that's why they need Scarpetta.

In the past, Scarpetta tries to speak to employees of Borowash (the soap with the glitter material) and learns that they have clients in over 70 cities in the country. It's Friday evening, which means that the killer could possibly strike that night.

At present, Lucy and Officer Fruge discuss Marino losing his cool with Matt. Lucy has taken Marino's words about death to heart and Fruge tells her she's allowed to grieve however she wants. She asks Lucy to stay and hang out but Lucy heads home. To her cabin, where Dorothy is currently venting about Marino to AI Janet. They go inside the wreckage of the space lab, which features more biosynthetic organs. Scarpetta figures out that the astronauts were killed 10-12 hours ago, which means they died in orbit.

In the past, Scarpetta takes Lucy out for a movie. Abby is also at the cinema and tries to speak to Scarpetta about the case but Scarpetta shuts it down quickly. Lucy steps out of the theatre to go get popcorn and sees Benton with another woman and two kids. But she doesn't say anything to Scarpetta. Elsewhere, Marino follows Matt Peterson around and watches him go to a bar and then get kicked out.

At present, Al Janet tells Lucy about the issue with Marino. Luckily, Marino comes home by then and Dorothy is delighted when she sees the flowers. Marino tells Lucy that he said all those things about dead people staying dead to Matt just because he was angry. He admits he misses Janet too and Lucy gives him a hug.

Scarpetta notices wounds that look like bullet holes in the two dead astronauts. At that moment, Sierra and her team learn that a spacecraft holding Jared Horton has now landed in Russia. Scarpetta and Benton deduce that Jared killed his crewmates and then escaped to Russia.

On the way home, Scarpetta and Benton argue about him not telling her the truth. The fight spirals and we learn that Benton was married. He left his wife and kids for her. Scarpetta pokes him further and he explodes, saying he agrees with Dorothy about Scarpetta's codependent relationship with Lucy. Scarpetta ends the discussion by saying there is something emotionally wrong with Benton.

At home, the opposite is happening with Marino and Dorothy, who make up for their fight over lunch. Dorothy confesses she felt bad about not getting to know Janet well enough. Lucy video calls Fruge and they seem to get along. Scarpetta comes home and Marino tells her what he learned about Matt being innocent.

Elsewhere, Benton opens up a trapdoor and goes down the stair to an empty room in which there is just one single armchair. He sits in the chair and reaches down to pick up a newspaper clipping about a woman's murder. It's a bit unclear if this is the same house with Scarpetta and the others or if they went their separate ways after the fight.

In the past, Lucy and Scarpetta come home from the movies. Lucy tells her about Benton and asks her if she knew he was married. She says she did and tells Lucy that life is complicated.

The episode ends with Abby going home and realising something is wrong. She calls out for a woman named Henna and finds her dead body in the bedroom.

He goes to the basement through the trapdoor that we saw in the previous episode and goes through his mother's psychology books. One of them has the clipping of the murdered woman we saw in Episode 5.

At present, Benton wakes up in the same basement and goes to work. Scarpetta conducts the autopsy on the other two astronauts and gives Marino the update.

In the past, Scarpetta arrives at Abby's house after the murder of her sister, Henna. Scarpetta says the death was between 8 and 11 pm, which rules out Matt Peterson, as Marino was following him the whole time. City Attorney Boltz comes by and Abby yells at him to get out. Boltz tells Marino that they went on a date and slept together once. However, Abby tells Scarpetta that she thinks he drugged and raped her that night. Scarpetta admits that Boltz asked her out too and she got a weird feeling. Scarpetta goes home and tells Lucy to stay inside for a while, since she's worried about the situation.

At present, Lucy is arguing with AI Janet about talking to people other than her. Dorothy comes by and tells Lucy that she and Marino are moving out and she wants Lucy to move with them. In the conversation, Lucy accidentally reveals that Marino attacked Matt, which riles Dorothy up once again.

Elsewhere, Marino tells Scarpetta about the attack and apologises for it. They arrive at Benton and Sierra's office and give them the bullets from the bodies. She asks Benton and Sierra for information on the Cammie Rammada case but they claim to not have anything. Scarpetta is determined to get to the bottom of that case and tells Maggie that she will be ordering an exhumation of the body.

In the past, Marino doesn't believe that Boltz raped Abby and Scarpetta argues with him about it. Scarpetta examines Henna's body and realises the killer raped her with a knife. Scarpetta and Benton discuss the killer's mentality and wonder if they could flush him out by humiliating him. They talk to Abby about publishing an article revealing his metabolic disorder. Abby seems to agree. She then reveals it was her in the car outside Scarpetta's house the night that she was with Benton. She wanted to warn Scarpetta about Boltz since she had heard they were dating. But she agrees to keep the secret about her and Benton.

At present, Marino and Scarpetta go to the jogging path where Cammie was running before her death. They wonder what made her get off the path and reach the riverside. On the banks of the river, Scarpetta finds a penny — same as in Gwen's case!

At home, Dorothy stirs things up with Benton by telling him about Marino being in love with Scarpetta. Benton doesn't believe it and Dorothy hints that he doesn't know why Scarpetta is so afraid of her first case coming undone. At the same time, Scarpetta and Marino discuss her relationship with Benton as well. Marino tells her to get off her high horse since she's also hiding something pretty big from Benton.

In the past, Dorothy comes home. Apparently, Scarpetta called her since there is a murderer on the loose. The earlier plan was for Lucy to go with Dorothy but they now decide to stay here so that Lucy can help Scarpetta track down who hacked into her computer.

At present, Al Janet tells Lucy to be nicer to her mother. She gets a call from Fruge and they chat for a bit. When Scarpetta comes home, Benton asks her about her secret regarding the Matt Peterson case. She says there's no secret to tell and Benton storms off. He goes to a motel room, where he uses a mosquito racket to catch a bug. He then watches it slowly die.

The episode ends with a clip of the killer leaving the very same motel.

She goes to see Janet and she helps her calm down, both of them professing their love for each other. The wedding goes well and that's also when Dorothy and Marino get together. All three couples seem very happy.

At present, AI Janet tries to talk to Lucy about Fruge and their growing connection. She tells Lucy that maybe Dorothy was right and Lucy should live

her real life. Lucy doesn't agree and forcefully shuts AI Janet down.

Scarpetta confronts Dorothy about the meddling in her marriage and Dorothy, in turn points out that Marino prefers Scarpetta's company to her own. She then suddenly brings up Janet and how bad she feels about her death. She doesn't want Scarpetta to die or just fight all the time. Dorothy initiates a hug and Scarpetta meets her halfway.

Scarpetta goes to see Lucy and ends up talking to AI Janet instead. AI Janet tells Scarpetta that Janet made this program for her work but she and Lucy swore to never use it. Scarpetta then asks Janet to do something. On the way to work, Scarpetta tells Marino that Benton was asking about Greystone, but she didn't tell him anything. They then get a call from Fruge, who tells them that a finger was found at Thor Labs. Benton and Sierra are already at the scene.

In the past, Scarpetta watches a clip from one of her lectures where Lori attended and asked a question about work-life balance. Meanwhile, Lucy adds something to Scarpetta's files that can

help trace any person who tries to hack her computer again. Dorothy sees Scarpetta's investigation and persuades her to call the sister of one of the victims, Cecile. After speaking to the sister and noting that she has a nice voice, Scarpetta realises that all the victims had a similar voice. Scarpetta shares this with Benton and Marino and they decide to look at pizza delivery places while also checking if any other victims called 911.

At present, Scarpetta has Cammie Rammada's body exhumed despite Dr Reddy having called her for a meeting. Cammie's family members turn up there and thank her for looking into the incident. The body arrives at the lab and Scarpetta finds that Cammie had a skin graft, just like Gwen.

Suddenly, a detective named Stan arrives on the premises and arrests Marino for assaulting Matt. Maggie informs Scarpetta about this and says that the health commissioner has given her permission to kick Scarpetta out of the building. At the bunker in the middle of nowhere, Benton shows Jinx Gwen's finger. He continues to protest his innocence.

In the past, Marino drops Scarpetta off at the radio station that keeps a log of all 911 calls. She goes through hundreds of records and finds calls from Patty, Cecile, and Lori. Scarpetta also finds Borowash at the centre and notices that all the calls were taken by a man named Roy McCorkle. She inquires about him and learns that he's at home with an ailing mother. She calls Marino and tells him to meet her at Roy's home address, at Greystone Avenue (she finds the address on Roy's desk).

At present, Scarpetta is removed from her office. She meets Lucy at the police station to wait for Marino. Scarpetta has a serious talk with Lucy about Janet and her own enabling of Lucy's methods. She tells Lucy to move out but Lucy doesn't take it well.

In the past, Scarpetta goes to Roy's house and waits outside for Marino. But she starts hearing screams from inside the house and rushes over to help. Unfortunately, the sounds are coming from a video recording of one of the murders. And as Scarpetta is searching for the woman, a man wraps a cord around her neck and drags her inside. She uses a piece of glass to stab him in the neck and the man goes down. Marino arrives by then and shoots the man in the neck, covering the stab wound with bullet holes. He tells Scarpetta to pretend she was never here.

At present, Marino gets out of jail and Scarpetta tells him that he always goes too far. They talk about the good and bad things they've done and Marino tells her they could simply drive away from all this. Scarpetta says they could. Then they quickly change the topic and Marino heads inside the house. Scarpetta then tracks Benton's phone location and sees that he's near the house.

Meanwhile, Lucy goes to Fruge's place and they have sex. Afterwards, she avoids kissing Fruge and tells her that she's a messed up person and needs to leave. She doesn't show much remorse even when Fruge says she got suspended for letting Lucy come with her to search for Jinx Slater. Elsewhere, Maggie speaks to Dr Reddy. She says if Scarpetta is right about the serial killer, then it's on them. They seem to be arguing for once.

In the past, everyone celebrates Scarpetta for her help in finding the killer but she's, naturally, quite uncomfortable. Benton goes looking for Marino and learns he's being questioned by internal affairs. At home, Lucy finds that someone from Scarpetta's office has been hacking her computer. At that moment, Scarpetta comes home and breaks down in her room. Dorothy is the one who comforts her and tells her she's done nothing wrong.

At present, Dorothy has had enough when she hears about Marino's arrest and tells him they should move into a hotel room that night. She also brings up what Janet said about Marino being in love with Scarpetta. He denies it but she confronts him further and tells him to choose between her and Scarpetta.

As for the doctor herself, she follows Benton's location to a truck sitting on the mansion's grounds. Benton tells her that this is where they held Jinx all this while. He's now being charged for Gwen's murder and Benton tells Scarpetta to stay away from the Gwen and Cammie case.

Benton starts telling her about his behaviours and that he enjoys watching some creatures suffer. She tells him she's just as messed up and asks him to give her his worst. Instead, he tells her he wants a divorce.

A very drunk Lucy goes to her cabin and starts talking to AI Janet, admitting that Fruge makes her feel like there may be a life outside. However, AI Janet doesn't reply and Lucy realises that the program isn't on her device anymore. She breaks down just as Dorothy comes in. Dorothy thinks it might be Scarpetta who did it but Scarpetta insists it wasn't her. Lucy yells at them both about never truly seeing her.

Things get worse for Scarpetta when she realises Marino and Dorothy are leaving. She says she needs Marino for the investigation right away since Dr Kaminsky has information for them. However, he elects to go with Dorothy to the hotel.

In the past, Scarpetta accuses Maggie of hacking into her system and tells her she's fired. Benton meets Scarpetta and asks her what happened with the case. Instead of explaining, she pulls him into a locked room and they have sex. Afterwards, she tells herself that she can never tell him the truth. At the same time, Marino gives up his police badge. When the announcements are made, he isn't up on stage with Scarpetta and Benton.

At present, Scarpetta and Marino arrive at their hotel. Lucy goes to see Matt Peterson of all people. Benton visits Sierra. Scarpetta gets a surprising visit from Maggie, who gives her a sample of the skin graft and says it was the same material on both Gwen and Cammie. She says that it was Reddy who hacked her computer, in order to make sure Scarpetta never trusted Maggie. He then dragged her into all of his bad deeds but she's now ready to turn on him. She has proof and, in turn, she promises to keep Scarpetta's secret — she knows she killed Roy. After hearing her out, Scarpetta agrees to work together to take Reddy down.

Back home, Scarpetta gets a call from Fruge who says that Gwen and Cammie were part of a test group at Thor. That's how they had the same skin graft. She says there was someone else in the test group but the network is bad and Fruge's voice cuts off. That's when Scarpetta sees the flattened penny sitting on her dining table.

We then see that the murderer is standing behind Scarpetta. It's Officer Ryan! The sweet-faced police officer who has been present in all the cases from the timeline in the past. A flashback shows a man telling his young nephew (a young Ryan) to place a coin on the train tracks and wait till it's flattened. While the boy focuses on this and even gets his skin burnt on the hot train tracks, the uncle messes around with young girls.

At present, Ryan tells Scarpetta that Lori's murder inspired him. He confesses to making a mess with Cammie but he says that Gwen was perfect. And he did it all to impress Scarpetta. Scarpetta runs and he follows, attacking her by placing cords around her neck. After a scuffle, Scarpetta throws him down the stairs and uses her bat to beat him up, letting all her rage out. The show ends as someone opens the front door and sees Scarpetta standing over Ryan's dead body.
