Summary: When Meret and Simon are called away from their daughter's birthday to receive a wounded agent in their safe house, the man immediately raises red flags.



The episode begins with a mysterious man sitting on a public bench. He uses a knife to remove a small device from under his skin and then shoots himself in the leg.

The scene shifts to a house, where a young girl named Nina celebrates her 16th birthday with her parents, Simon and Meret Schäfer. Simon gets a call from an unknown number. The man from the first scene tells Simon that he's been stabbed and shot and needs help. He's willing to pay for his services.

Simon and Meret pick the injured man up and take him to a safe house. They treat him but remain a little suspicious about his identity. Soon, Simon heads back to be with Nina while Meret stays in the safe house. We then shift to the German Foreign Intelligence Service headquarters in Berlin, also known as the BND. The team lead, Ben, announces that they are looking into a Josef Kaleev, a high-ranking Russian official whose wife, Vera, will soon become the Russian ambassador in Berlin.

Since Josef is known for having many shady deals in his past, the German government wants to reject Vera's appointment. They need to start by looking into why Josef has entered the country before Vera. The previous head of the BND, Gregor Klein, arrives at the office on Ben's request. But he claims to not know anything helpful about Josef.

Back in the safe house, the injured man tells Meret that he used to work for a security company. He took something from them and they went after him, leading to the gunshot. Simon goes home and tells Nina that they had to go attend to a friend whose house was broken into. He explains that Meret is still there but Nina can go out for her birthday, as planned.

While Meret is away, the injured man takes her fingerprints from a glass of water. Meret later sees this on her security cameras. She calls Simon and tells him that the man assumed they were brother and sister. The only time they pretended to be brother and sister was during a mission in Belarus.

A flashback takes us to 16 years ago in Belarus. Simon and Meret are driving when Simon finds a fake passport for a woman named Katya hidden in the car. They have been sent by Gregor Klein and their mission is to help Katya escape. They reach the safe house and realise it's

compromised. Inside, they find Gregor, bleeding from a gunshot wound, and Katya, passed out from poison.

At present, Gregor tells Julika that Josef won't be doing his own dirty work here and advises her to find his middleman. The next scene introduces Jonas, a man who welcomes Josef Kaleev and they get in a car together. Turns out, they are the ones who sent the agent to the Schäfers. They don't know the Schäfers' identity but Jonas believes that these agents must be the ones Josef is looking for.

At the safe house, Meret tells the injured man that she is going out but spies on him from a different location. The man sneaks into the security room and uses the computer to contact Jonas. He sends Jonas a picture of Meret's fingerprint and that's when Meret fills the room with a gas that knocks him out.

Jonas receives the picture from his agent and scans the fingerprint, which identifies Meret. The database says she and her husband as killed in action. Josef recognises them as the people he is after and orders Jonas to execute both of them and Gregor as well. Jonas seems to hesitate — did he recognise Meret? — and then sends the order.

Gregor is at a bar with his friends when he realises something is off. He goes to the toilet and a woman follows, gun in hand. But she doesn't find him. Gregor is on the other side of a one-way mirror, watching her.

Elsewhere, Simon is on his way to get Nina when a man bumps into him. He suddenly gets dizzy and falls down. Meanwhile, the female assassin tells Jonas that she lost Gregor. Josef isn't happy with this development and tells Jonas he's fired.

Meret returns to the safe house and sees the kill order sent by Jonas on her computer. She ties the agent to a chair and starts questioning him. He gets loose and they engage in a fight. In the end, she manages to take him down. She then gets a call from the hospital and rushes to see Simon.

Based on what Gregor mentioned, Julika starts looking into the Belarus case from 16 years ago. She looks for the file but finds it filled with blank pages. At the same time, Josef leaves a voicemail for his mole in the BND. It reaches a phone which is taped to the top of an elevator in the office.

At the hospital, Simon tells Meret that he passed out due to high blood pressure and it's nothing to worry about. They head to the party where Nina is DJ-ing and then go home together. The next day, they meet Gregor, who tells them that Josef is trying to "clean up" before his wife becomes the ambassador. He advises them to kill Josef before he kills them.

A flashback shows that Katya was still alive when the Schäfers found her. They manage to save her baby through a cesarean delivery. At present, Meret picks up a phone call and realises it is Katya on the other end. She's alive! And in Berlin, in trouble with the police. Meret realises that Simon lied to her.

The episode begins with a flashback in Belarus. Katya is dying and Gregor needs to go to the hospital soon. Meret decides to go to the hospital with Gregor and the baby while Simon stays behind, being told to let Katya die and then clean everything up. He doesn't like it but Gregor says there is no other choice. However, after they leave, Simon saves Katya with a blood transfusion.

At present, Meret asks Simon why he lied to her. Simon says it was best for them and for the baby — so Nina is

Katya's baby! Elsewhere, Josef is on a call with a senior official of the Russian government, who tells him to hire Jonas again since he's the best.

Simon and Meret end up leaving the assassin's body on a public bench. Meret keeps an eye on the location from a nearby rooftop, waiting to see who will arrive to see the body. After the police and the BND arrive, she sees Jonas and seems to recognise him. At the same time, Simon heads to the hospital to get Katya.

At the BND, Ben tells Julika to investigate the body found on the bench, which has been identified as an MI6 agent. She enlists the help of her colleague and ex-girlfriend, Alice. Elsewhere, Vera arrives in Berlin and Josef welcomes her to their new apartment. She asks him about the Belarus case and he's pretty cagey about it.

At the hospital, Simon disguises himself as a janitor and slips Katya a pill. She takes it and begins to have a seizure. Now disguised as doctors, Simon and Meret take Katya away on a gurney, all the way to a van in the parking lot. While Simon goes to the safe house with Katya, Meret stays back to delete the CCTV footage. While there, she checks Simon's patient logs and realises that he didn't pass out because of blood pressure but because of a brain aneurysm.

Back at the safe house, Katya says she came to Berlin to show Josef Koleev that she's still alive. She is still bitter about him killing her baby. A flashback shows Simon getting a call from Meret while at the Belarus safe house. She tells him she's fallen in love with the baby and has given her the name Nina. She wants to be a family. When Katya wakes up, Simon lies to her, saying her baby died and showing her a fake grave as proof.

At present, Meret argues with Simon, saying he shouldn't have lied to her and to Katya either. To protect Nina, they decide to send her on a trip to Paris with her friend.

At the BND, Alice tells Julia that she found a fingerprint on the dead body and has identified it as belonging to Helena Kohn (Meret's original name). She was married to Karl Brehme (Simon's original name) and both of them are listed as killed in action.

Elsewhere, Josef approaches Jonas and says he wants to hire him again. When Jonas is reluctant, Josef threatens to kill his three kids. Josef then leaves a voicemail for his mole, threatening them to reveal Gregor's location.

Meanwhile, Julika and Alice find CCTV footage of Gregor from the bar where the female assassin tried to attack him. In the footage, Gregor tells the agents to look for the girl and find Josef Koleev. Ben knows of one of Gregor's safe houses but refuses to tell Julika. Soon after this, Josef receives Gregor's location and sends it to Jonas.

Julika takes matters into her own hands and finds the location of the safe house from Gregor and Ben's mission a few years ago. She goes to the house and finds two mercenaries attacking Gregor. Gregor tells her to run and she does so.

Meret and Simon send Nina off at the train station. She knows something is up but they don't reveal anything. After she's gone, the couple argue about the situation again since Meret is still upset at being lied to. She brings up his aneurysm and he gets angry that she looked into his medical records.

On the train, Nina decides not to go to Paris and instead find out what's happening with her parents. Elsewhere, the mercenaries take Gregor to Josef. He tells Josef that his daughter is alive.

Back home, Meret confronts Simon about his aneurysm in front of his employees at the restaurant. This includes Yul, a staff member who is close to Nina. Yul receives a voicemail from Nina, who says she didn't go to Paris and asks him to meet her. Yul does so and tells Nina about the aneurysm. Nina assumes this is the issue her parents have been worried about.

Meanwhile, Vera speaks to her father and realises she is only a cover for Josef to be in the city as a handler for the BND mole. Unwilling to lose her position, Vera decides to take things into her own hands.

At home, Meret tries to understand why Simon doesn't want the surgery to remove the aneurysm. He admits he's afraid of dying on the operation table.

Ben and Julika approach Jonas and question him about everything, but he doesn't give anything up. Ben gets frustrated when he realises that Julika and Alice found dash cam footage of Josef meeting Jonas but didn't report it to him.

Jonas meets Josef again and threatens Vera to return the favour of Josef threatening his kids. Josef then sits down with Vera, who tells him that the committee has given him the green light and that he doesn't need to worry about Belarus anymore. She says she sold their apartment and bribed the committee members.

Simon and Meret go to see Katya at the safe house and tell her to leave the country. But she is reluctant to go without confronting Josef.

At the BND, Alice tries to talk to Julika about getting back together but Julika doesn't want to. Later, Ben talks to Julika and tries to make up for their earlier spat. Alice watches them from afar.

Meanwhile, Josef gets the password out of Gregor. He stabs Gregor in the thigh and sends a picture to Meret. Meret and Simon know that it's a trap but decide to go there anyway, even giving Katya a chance to confront Josef.

Jonas and his team are part of the trap. When a car rolls up towards them, Katya gets out, taking Josef by surprise. Josef orders them to bring Katya in alive. As Simon gets out of the car as well, Meret takes down one of Jonas' snipers and attacks all his men. She and Simon take them all down, while Josef comes down to the street to see Katya. As they are looking at each other, Simon and Meret get back in the car and Meret drives them away from the scene. Simon asks her what she's doing, since this was not the plan.

A flashback takes us to Morocco, 17 years ago. Meret is on a mission to target a sheikh but she's also having an affair with Jonas. While on the phone with Gregor, she tells him she wants two extra weeks in Morocco after this mission. She sneaks into the sheikh's residence and copies his phone just as the alarm bells start ringing. The sheikh's head of security is none other than Jonas, who ends up chasing Meret and holding her at gunpoint.

At present, Meret heads out to get information from Jonas. She rings the fire alarm at Jonas' office in order to bring him out. He confesses that he didn't know she was the mark and that he's tried to walk away but hasn't been allowed to. She sneaks him a paper with the name of a hotel on it.

Back in the past, Simon confronts Gregor about Meret needing two more weeks in Morocco. Gregor tells him that Meret asked for it and bluntly says that Simon's marriage is dead. Right then, Simon gets a call from Gregor, who was able to hail a young boy passing by on his bike. Simon gets his location and they arrive to see Gregor bleeding out.

At the hotel, Meret and Jonas are in bed together. Meret asks him to help her take Josef down but he refuses, saying that Josef's father-in-law Sasha, is even more dangerous. At the same time, the BND tap the phone call between Gregor and Simon and gets a pin on his location.

When Simon and Meret get back to the safe house, they get into a long argument. It starts with Gregor's death and moves towards her affair with Jonas — she claims she was just getting information — and ends with Simon accusing Meret of only caring about herself and not about him or Nina.

In the end, Simon, Meret and Katya make a new plan. Katya calls Josef and offers to work together to get their child back from Meret. She tells him to meet her alone and he agrees. Katya waits for Josef on a pier by a beach while Meret points a sniper gun towards the area.

Unfortunately, when Josef arrives, Katya decides to attack him herself instead of letting Meret take her shot. Of course, Josef stops her easily and escapes on a boat. From another vantage point, Jonas shoots at Katya and Meret as they run towards their van. He ends up hitting Meret's shoulder.

Elsewhere, Vera makes her first speech as ambassador. She gets a surprise visit from her father, Sasha, and learns that there seems to be a problem with Starfish — their mole.

The episode begins with Simon showing Meret the tracker bullet. They know Josef is coming and decide to make a stand in their safe house while sending Nina and Katya to a safe place. But Nina has had enough of the secrets and demand they tell her the truth. They give her a flash drive, saying it has a few answers, and tell her to go down the back staircase with Katya and Yul. They go down to the parking lot but Nina is worried about leaving her parents behind. So Katya agrees to wait in the parking lot.

Inside the apartment, Simon and Meret get ready for the attack as Jonas and his people start looking through the huge apartment complex. Someone slips a note under the Schäfer's door that says "I am not your enemy."

Vera arrives at the location as well and confronts Josef about his actions in Belarus. He lies and says he didn't kill his own child but rather that he's going to save her now. Vera tells him he can't do this as the ambassador's husband. But Josef isn't deterred. He gets a message from Jonas saying that the location is secured and goes up to the apartment.

At first, it seems like Jonas has Meret and Simon at gunpoint. But Josef realises they are all actually working together and at gunpoint, orders him to kill Meret. Afterwards, when Josef finally returns home to Vera, she informs him that he will be going back to Moscow while she stays here and continues working as the ambassador. Sometime later, Josef comes to see Vera and is taken to a room where Sasha is waiting for him. Sasha claims Josef has lived 16 years longer than he should have and orders his men to shoot him.

While her husband is being assassinated, Vera meets with the real Starfish — it's none other than Ben! He seems to regret killing Alice and tells Vera that he's done being their mole. But Vera just recorded his confession and uses it as blackmail to keep him working with her. She says they're going to have a lot of fun.

At the hospital, Katya calls Julika and says she wants to make a deal. A doctor tells Meret that the surgery went well and she reunites with Simon. He admits that he stole a child to save their marriage and that being with her brings out the worst in him sometimes. He says they should have split up back then and they both agree that they should split up now.

When Nina gets back from the cafeteria, Katya tells her that Josef is after them again. She says that her parents are talking to BND and takes Nina outside, where Julika meets them with her car. Meret sees the car going away but gets ambushed by police officers, who hold her down and get Simon too. They are arrested for the murder of Jonas.

With Katya having taken Nina away, it's clear that the story is not over yet and that plans for a second season must be underway. The Schäfers will need to bring their daughter back and deal with Katya as well. While a second season hasn't been confirmed yet, keep an eye on our website for more updates!
