It's then a quick jump to Nathan, who is currently working on some code with a friend. It looks like he's at home, but it's soon clear that he's driving on the LA freeway. Well, the car is driving. Technology is at a point of self-driving cars but Nathan can override the system with his coding skills so he can take control and drive at speed.

When he's pulled over, he gets out of a ticket as it looks like the car did suffer a technical fault.

We end up at Nathan's parents' house for Thanksgiving, where his coding friend and business partner Jamie joins them. This also gives us a chance to meet Nathan's entitled rich girlfriend, Ingrid.

That tells us what Nathan and Jamie are working on a free version of the digital afterlife. We also see him helping his niece with her "classical dance homework," which is definitely not classical dancing.

It all seems like a semi-normal Thanksgiving but without the arguing. It's on the way back to Ingrid's when it all gets interesting. Nathan's car malfunctions and he crashes into a truck.

During the episode, we also get to know about Nora's family. She lives alone with her dad and wants to help him get into Lake View. However, he doesn't want to go to a digital afterlife. Nora's mom never did and he wants to be in "Heaven" with her. It doesn't make sense, but this is what he believes.

The accident doesn't kill Nathan, but he is gravely injured. He needs to decide whether to risk surgery or go to Lake View, which is where Ingrid is pushing him. He chooses to be uploaded, which is where his digital life begins.

Nora is the one who is uploading him, giving us a chance to see the way the digital process is done. She has to draw it in and make sure all his memories are uploaded and categorized. When some files are damaged, she puts them in a folder to fix later.

It's clear this is something to keep an eye on. Those damaged files are linked to Nathan and Jamie's business. Uh oh!

We get a chance see Nathan try to get used to the digital afterlife. It's not easy at all, which is why Nora is there to help. Nathan has to get used to the idea of being dead and the idea of being in an afterlife that he may not have chosen for himself.

There are a lot of beautiful elements to the digital afterlife, with weather-changing settings, choices of food, and much more. However, there are annoying elements like in-app purchases and there are definitely some glitches here and there.

With life going on without him and it being clear that things aren't real, Nathan struggles to adjust completely. His hair is one of the biggest problems, with a bit that just doesn't sit properly. It gets so bad that he heads to the Data Torrent at the center of the afterlife where if he jumps everything about him will be removed. It's the end of his afterlife.

Nora gets into the system just in time to help prevent it. She talks him out of jumping into the Data Torrent. While anyone could have been there, it's Nora's pain and passion that stops him. Despite not being allowed to, she tells him her name, where she lives, and a little about her office. It's a chance for them to connect (and for her to fix his hair).

Of course, we have to finish with the murder mystery element. Someone is deleting some of the damaged files from the folder Nora created. It's not Nora but possibly someone who works the evening shift at the company.

The animal talks. Well, the digital animal is used as a device for a therapist to help Nathan talk things out.

Nathan realizes that he resents the afterlife a little. He had freedom and was gaining a life that he loved. The car crash brought that to an end, and he can't really accept that. He heads out on a mission to talk to five other uploads to get perspective, which is where he meets a young boy who has been in the afterlife for a few years. The young boy gives us that reminder that the digital afterlife may not be all that great as the years go on. People in life move forward and get older.

In real life, we meet a woman, Fran Booth, who is investigating the car accident. Nathan's family wants to find out the truth, clearly feeling like something isn't right.

The car has no memory of the night the crash happened, which shouldn't be possible. On top of that, the car doesn't believe there is any damage to report. The dashcam recordings from the night have gone, which further hint that Nathan was murdered.

Why would someone want him dead? When Nathan mentions to David Choke of the Choke Brothers, who co-run a major company and helped influence American politics in this world, that he and his friend wrote a program to allow people to upload themselves to a free afterlife, David comments that Nathan was murdered.

That brings us back to the memories that were damaged. Nora manages to restore some, which are definitely linked to the program. One person at a company that they pitched to sees Nathan and Jamie in secret, telling them not to take the freeware pitch to anyone else—and don't tell anyone else.

She heads to the convenience store Nathan went to before his accident for the security footage. It's not hard to get it, possibly by saying she's a part-time private investigator or because the store owner doesn't care, and that's when Fran finds out something incriminating. Ingrid tampered with Nathan's car the night he died.

Nora leaves Lucy's office with the threat of her rating dropping from a 4.8 average to a 3.8 average.

That's not all for Nora. Her dad is visiting Lake View. She desperately wants him to agree to be uploaded instead of die, but

he wants to be with his late wife. So, Nora thinks a tour of Lake View is Nathan as his guide will help. It's a great chance for Nathan and Nora's dad to meet and the tour goes relatively well, but in the end, Nora's dad makes it clear that he doesn't want to be uploaded.

With everything I've seen on this show, I'm kind of on his side. I don't think I'd want eternity in the digital space.

While that happens, Ingrid goes to an "After Wives" support group. These are women with husbands and partners in the digital afterlife. Ingrid wonders—after admitting she kissed and then later that she slept with Nathan's best friend, Jamie—whether she should freeze Nathan. She can live her life and unfreeze him when she's ready.

Nathan has become her plaything and it's clear Ingrid is a terrible human. Although, is that surprising when you see her family?

While Nathan guides Nora's dad around Lake View, Nora takes some time to snoop on Lucy's computer. She realizes that an unknown employee number has accessed Nathan's files. Not only is the number unknown on Lucy's computer, but it's absolutely nowhere in the system.

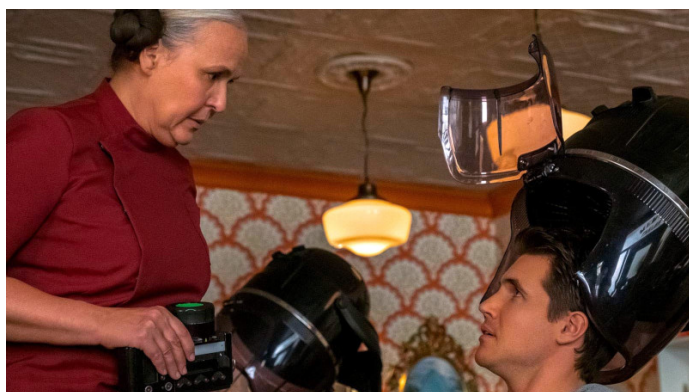
And it's clear that someone doesn't want Nora finding out the truth. Somebody puts a device in the server room that cuts out the power for a few minutes. It halts Nora's progress in finding out information, but she does manage to get some of the files downloaded to help her with her investigation. It helps her learn that Josh Prizer is dead.

It's not a happy ending for Nora when her dad makes it clear he doesn't want to be uploaded. Something I love is that she accepts it, though. She's done pushing and asks him to say "hi" to her mom for her. Despite his best attempts to like it, Matt ends up coughing as the others laugh. Nora's father, Dave, however, wants more 'chillies.'

Pastor Rob interrupts and tells Dave that Nora needs to take things more seriously. Clearly, he was not happy about her kissing Matt. Nora defends herself before Dave assures the Pastor that Nora will work harder.

The dinner party then starts, as Mr. Choak (David) arrives with a programmed version of a woman who looks like his ex-wife. The AI Guy makes a gaffe over how the woman is Mr Choak's sex doll, which displeases Ingrid.

Nora/Tinsley then hugs Nathan, as Aleesha watches on, knowing the workplace policy of getting too close with clients as the episode ends.

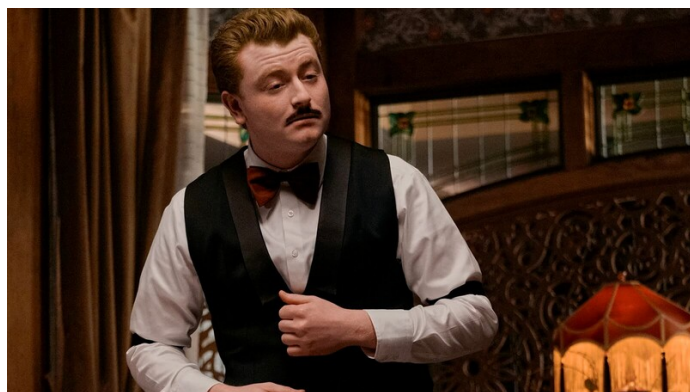

Moving back to the real Ingrid, she invites a 'Job Gerbil' to her house and requests that the 'Gerbil' pretend to be Ingrid in Lake View, as she is preoccupied with other things. She tells her everything about Nathan to make it convincing.

Thereafter, Agent Cheeto/Ivan, and Nora arrive at their apartment. Nora is not impressed with Ivan's sex bot, as she quietly sends Matt her location in dissatisfaction at what she is seeing. Suspicions are then raised over the missing data.

The same detective from the cyber crimes unit that had labeled the man, who had been killed by Nathan for attempting to kill Nora, as a case of 'potential homicide' in episode 1 arrives at Horizon.

Lucy is nervous, but to make matters worse, he has a warrant which makes Aleesha anxious too. Aleesha informs Lucy that they will be fine, as they have nothing to hide.

Lucy agrees before she hides the contents of her ring drive and tells Aleesha to put it in storage. The latter gets suspicious and looks into it.

It turns out that Lucy had been watching Luke, so much so that she has footage of him taking a shower naked, amongst other things.

Going back to Nora, she arrives for her interview. Nora enters and sees Batia in the lift, who assumes she has returned from her leave of absence. Nora comes back and is delighted to see Aleesha.

Tinsley (the temp) is immediately put in her place, as she gets up to let Nora sit down despite her desire to talk. Aleesha tells Nora that she has been promoted before she asks Nora where she has been.

Nora tells her everything is fine with Byron and nothing else. Clearly, Nora is lying. Back at the house, the 'Job Gerbil' is pretending to be Ingrid.

Nathan and Luke arrive at the house as they discuss how to steal more data. The Job Gerbil/Ingrid overhears them, and Nathan begs that she does not tell anyone about what they are doing.

The 'Job Gerbil' uncharacteristically promises not to, which does make Nathan curious. As they are both about to leave, Ingrid states she can help them 'brainstorm' over how to steal.

The scene then shifts to the 'Job Gerbil' /Ingrid wearing some revealing sports clothing, as she walks down the stairs. She grabs people's attention as Nathan steals everyone's data.

Then the real Ingrid arrives back to see the 'Job Gerbil' using the hug/sex suit and is pleased to see her do well. Then the roles are reversed, as Nathan takes his top off so that the 'Job Gerbil' can steal this time.

Meanwhile, Aleesha is in the background watching for suspicious behavior in light of the detective arriving. She is worried because the '2gig' members keep having data to spare. Aleesha tells Nora that Nathan is up to something.

Tinsley overhears and asks if she can date clients, specifically Nathan, which is ignored. Nora then jumps into 'Lake View' to see what is happening.

She sees that Nathan is stealing data but merely smiles. She does not tell Aleesha what she saw and is more outraged by Tinsley, who has been using her avatar, as well as getting a higher rating than her.

But before things can go any further, Nora has to go for her interview, which leaves Aleesha wondering why Nora wants a new job. Then a worker (Craig) comes in and tells Lucy that he has found irregularities in her department.

He informs her that someone has been stealing data and is giving it to '2gig' members after ten uploads complained about slow data speed. Lucy is relieved, as she thought it was about her having nude videos of Luke.

The scene shifts as the detective questions the two and ask if an upload could access coding in the real world. Craig denies that this is possible.

The detective is suspicious and then sees Nora in the building, which triggers his memory about the 'homicide case.' Meanwhile, Nora is placing ring drives in the different departments.

Craig then tells Lucy that he has a suspicion of how the data is being stolen, as one of their pen knives has gone missing. We then arrive at 'Poker Night' in Lake View as Nathan, Luke, and the Job Gerbil/Ingrid get ready to play in the hope of stealing more data and winning money.

Nathan has the penknife that will allow him to change the cards in Ingrid's hand to their favor, while Luke will be the lookout as 'Ingrid' sits at the poker table. Moving back to Nora's interview, Craig is asking her about her experience.

Lucy then interrupts the interview, as she tells Craig that the penknife that had gone missing is in use now. They both leave, as Nora is alone, who leaves a ring drive in the office.

She then turns her attention to the computer screen and sees that Nathan is using the penknife. As we go back to the table, Ingrid raises 100,000 as Nathan changes the cards in her favor.

The hands are revealed, and she wins with 'three of a kind' compared to the two aces that Mr. Choak had. With Ingrid winning again, Mr. Choak is not pleased. The game is then interrupted by Lucy and Craig.

Luke, being the lookout, tries to stall them so that Nathan has some time to dispose of the knife, which he does on an old man who is sleeping. After having told Ingrid that this is the last hand, she accidentally states, 'all in.'

After trying to retract it, the dealer refuses. She then loses everything to Mr. Choak. The only way for Ingrid to win is if they get a flush.

With Nora overhearing everything, she edits the card to a 7 of hearts from the computer so that they win. After doing so, Nathan, Luke, and Ingrid celebrate as the old man is taken away for stealing, who protests his innocence.

Moving back to the interview, Craig returns and is impressed with Nora's passion. So much so she ends up getting a job in redesign.

Nora accepts in disbelief, as Craig disposes of a ring drive that he found on his desk that Nora had put after she denied it was hers. Thus, Nora has completed two missions: gotten a job and planted spyware.

Aleesha and Nora then celebrate the latter's new job over drinks. Nora then tells Aleesha that she was not away with Byron, but Nora refuses to tell her anymore. However, Aleesha does not mind telling Nora that Lucy has been watching nudes of Luke.

Aleesha then considers blackmailing Lucy before Nora suggests that she could help her with something else instead. We then see Aleesha giving the ring drive back to Lucy, as the audience is left to wonder what Aleesha and Nora are planning.

Back with Ingrid and the 'Job Gerbil', the former is impressed with her performance. So much so that Nathan loves Ingrid more. He kisses her passionately.

They have sex, and Nathan tells her that it was the best day he had with her before saying he loves her. Ingrid then feels guilty, knowing it was not her.

Nora is then going home on the bus, as Matt tells her she did a good job. Everything is set up for her to spy. She tells Matt that she got the job, and Matt tries to convince her he is happy. But it is clear he is not. He then tells her he has to go suddenly.

The episode ends with the detective reviewing some security footage of someone running, which grabs his attention. It could very well turn out to be 'Nora,' but the picture is unclear.

The episode begins with Matt, Nora, and Agent Cheeto/Ivan in a car. The car stops as they arrive at the following location: 'Sunny Purchase School Of Biomedicine.'

They go inside and discover various clones. Nora asks what they are to which Matt replies: 'the bodies of people who uploaded.' They remain empty until someone downloads back inside them.

Nora asks why someone would risk downloading (jumping from Lake View into a clone and then the real world). Matt suggests that it is the perfect way for someone to do something bad, keep a low profile in Lake View and then repeat it all again forever.

Matt and Ivan start unplugging the machines. Nora protests and states that some of them could be good people. They leave in case someone catches them, but Nora reconnects one of the machines with the name 'Jake Paul.'

Back at Horizen/Lake View, they have a product launch where they are testing their 'Protykes', giving digital babies to customers on a free trial as part of 'Lake View's Family Day.'

Nathan's mother Viv and his niece Nevaeh are there. Ingrid tells Nathan she wants one, but he is not so keen. He tells her that maybe she is sad because her father did not attend 'Family Day.'

As a compromise, Nathan tells Ingrid she can hang out with his family. As Viv and Nevaeh arrive, Ingrid tries too hard to fit in. She calls 'Viv' mum and hugs them, creating a moment of awkwardness.

Viv has a sly dig, as Ingrid uploaded for someone she is not married to but then agrees that Ingrid can call her mum. We then shift to Lucy, who tells Aleesha that 'Family Day' is a big deal.

She demands that Aleesha's Angels get good ratings. Lucy tells Aleesha to be harsh on them, but as Tinsley, Batia and Ivan overhear, they are not pleased.

We then see Nora making sure that 'Family Day' is going well. She notices Dylan, who is still stuck as a 12-year-old, as his mother tells him that the adult upload was too expensive.

To make things less awkward, Nora tells them that the archery game has a bug which means that the winners get paid twice as much, thus hinting they should play it to get more credits. Dylan's mother then thanks Nora.

As the day progresses, Nathan, Ingrid and his family team up for a game of catching hoola hoops blindfolded. Viv and Ingrid face off against Nathan and Nevaeh. The latter win, as Ingrid is useless.

Nora watches from a distance, but Nathan catches sight of her. Thinking that it is Tinsley, given she has used Nora's avatar before, he heads over. Nora panics, but she can't get away. Nora tells him that she is the real Nora, and that she has returned.

Nathan tells Nora he thought he would never see her again and asks if they can talk privately. Nora interjects and says he does not have to explain, as well as stressing that she is with someone: that is Matt.

Not wanting to admit their real feelings, they both talk up the benefits of their respective partners. Ingrid then chimes in and takes Nathan away, but before that, she can see that there is a 'connection.'

Nora watches the two walk off, feeling sad. She is immediately called by Matt on the phone, who tells her that he has a surprise. Matt informs Nora to meet him at the grey zone in Lake View at noon.

Batia and Tinsley then interrupt Aleesha to tell her that some bug is happening at the tennis courts. They do not know how to fix it, so Aleesha intervenes.

Aleesha arrives to see Luke playing tennis with his doubles partner Jessie from the army against two 'AI Guys'. She asks them what is wrong, but Luke says he is fine and did not ask Aleesha to come.

Jessie is then mesmerized by Aleesha and tries to woo her, but she is not impressed. Jessie tells Aleesha that Luke let him use his family day upload pass, and Jessie is impressed with Lake View.

After Luke challenges her to a game and hits her with a ball, Aleesha agrees, as the players win points by hitting the other in the crotch. She teams up with Jessie against Luke and the AI Guy. And Aleesha does very well, which annoys Luke.

Back with Ingrid, Nathan and his family, Viv does not like the digital babies. Ingrid disagrees by saying they give uploads an opportunity to be parents, but Viv states they are not real.

That makes Ingrid angry, especially since Nathan does not back her up. Ingrid storms off before Nathan and Nevaeh reluctantly follow her. Back with Ingrid, she is talking to Helen, the therapist from Horizen.

She tells her that she is angry with Nathan. Helen replies that perhaps Ingrid confuses anger with loneliness, and it is maybe the latter that she struggles with. After all, no one came to see her on 'Family Day.'

Ingrid informs Helen that it is Nathan's failure to agree to have a digital baby. Helen claims Ingrid has to get to the root cause of why she wants a baby and suggests it could be because Ingrid thinks she is unlovable.

Ingrid cannot take it any longer, as she tells Helen she is a terrible therapist. We then move back to Nathan and Nevaeh playing table tennis before they stop as the latter sees Ingrid's dad, Oliver.

Nathan wonders why he would be here. Viv suggests maybe it is to see Ingrid, but he does not trust him. He tells Viv and Nevaeh to wait for him, as he goes to find out.

As he goes to find him, Tinsley arrives with her real avatar. Nathan, having no time to lose, brushes her off to her dismay and goes to Nora by saying they need to talk privately.

Nathan tells Nora that Oliver is here, but she says it could be just to see Ingrid. She suggests that Nathan ask Ingrid the truth about his 'murder' before Nathan states she does not know anything and suspects that it is the Luds.

Nora claims it is impossible for it to be Luds, given that she is undercover with them after all. Nathan declares they attacked 'Freeyond' and hate digital technology. In addition, Nathan believes they used Oliver to get his code and then had him killed.

Nathan asks Nora why she is adamant that it is not the Luds, after which she tells him that she is dating a Lud: Matt. Nathan is not impressed and tells her that Luds are crazy.

Nora is not having it, as she has a dig at him by saying the Luds sacrifice things for what they care about. Nora adds that she trusts Matt before leaving. However, she promises to keep an eye on Oliver and tell Nathan if she finds anything.

We then see Matt trying the AI Guy avatar that Nora helped to build. It worked, as he joins her in Lake View to give her the surprise. They go off together in a discreet location. The surprise is a hyper-worm that would destroy Family Day.

He tells her what to do with it, but Nora does not agree as it would destroy the families. To convince her, Matt/AI Guy states that her father, Dave and Pastor Rob think she is too kind/soft to do it.

In order to prove Matt and the Luds wrong, Nora releases the worm. We then arrive back with Viv, Nathan and Nevaeh as they watch some videos of Nathan playing with his niece.

The hyper-worm then infects the system and destroys 'Family Day.' A voice emerges, saying this is an attack and revolution by the Luds. With Aleesha unaware of what is going on, she continues to play tennis.

Until she sees the AI guy relay the same revolutionary message. Aleesha leaves the match in panic, knowing she has to fix this. Nathan's quality time with his family is then interrupted, as he sees a message saying, 'Abolish Lake View. Delete the Rich.'

Nathan tells them to leave, and as they do so, Viv announces to Nathan that a digital baby is not a bad idea. However, Nathan confirms he is happy being an uncle.

Aleesha tells everyone in the office to stay calm. With Nora regretting what she has done, she fixes it. They get suspicious over how she worked things out so fast, but Nora responds with it being a 'lucky guess.'

Nora then ignores Matt's call. As she is leaving, the whole office claps her for what she did in stopping the virus as she attempts to downplay it.

Jessie and Aleesha then talk privately. The former tells her that Luke was his commanding officer in the army and was never worried. Jessie praises Luke by saying his bravery got a lot of people through some tough times, which shocks Aleesha.

Jessie then disappears before saying that Luke mentions her a lot in a positive way. Aleesha wants to know more, but Jessie has gone. The day ends, as Ingrid gets into a lift and is angry at how the day turned out.

The AI guy then hugs her, and she does the same. She opens up to him and says Nathan does not value her efforts. She asks the AI Guy if she is loveable, and he says yes.

Ingrid arrives home to see Nathan and tells him she is tired after a hard day. Nathan tells her that they could get a digital baby. Ingrid is delighted and hugs him.

The episode ends, as they tease each other about when they should get the digital baby before sharing a kiss.

The episode begins with Nathan and Ingrid lying in bed before a huge alarm wakes him up. He asks her, 'hey, what is that?' But she does not respond. The scene then shifts to Ingrid eating on the sofa, as she watches a show about bringing up babies.

Having still not woken up, Nathan goes to investigate. We see that the 'AI Guy' is the one making the alarm. He tells everyone to 'head to the nearest exit.'

Tinsley arrives and tells Nathan it is just the new security system that has malfunctioned. She struggles to get it under control, despite her best efforts as Nathan goes back to sleep.

We then arrive at Agent Cheeto/Ivan's apartment. Nora has doubts about Pastor Rob and asks Matt if he can be trusted. Nora stresses that uploading should be run by families.

But Matt doubles down on his beliefs that 'Lake View' has to be destroyed. Clearly annoyed, she tells Matt they need some space. He goes to sleep in the hallway, as Nora retells the story to Aleesha.

Nora informs Aleesha she will not dump Matt, as well as Nathan's belief that the 'Luds' tried to kill him. She drops a bombshell that, according to Matt, Horizen may have been behind it, much to Aleesha's shock, who denies that this could be possible.

Moving onto breakfast, we join Nathan and Luke. The latter is shaking his sausage, as he looks nervous. Nathan asks if he is fine, to which Luke replies: 'what was that?' Luke has not slept in three days and feels he is being watched.

Luke summons Aleesha to declare that Horizen are spying and taking his dreams. However, she tells him that he is crazy before leaving. Moving back to Ingrid, she has a meeting with Lucy.

Ingrid tells her that she wants a digital baby before Lucy asks if she has Nathan's consent. Ingrid has his 'blessing' which is an attempt to hide the fact that she has not agreed to this with Nathan.

Lucy tells her she has to start at the lowest level with a baby simulation, to which Ingrid threatens to scream unless she is given the highest level of a digital baby. Ingrid screams to the top of her lungs, as Lucy exits.

Shortly after, Lucy jumps into a meeting with Craig. He tells everyone that the government has relaxed the privacy guidelines governing uploads following the Lud attack on Lake View.

This means they can screen-grab without consent and have a new software, 'MindFrisk', which allows Horizen to search uploads' thoughts in real-time.

Any thoughts that could comprise the security of Lake View can now be detected. Nora and Aleesha look on with a worried look on their faces. Nora immediately messages Nathan and informs him that they need to talk.

She tells him about Horizen reading uploads' thoughts. She believes Ingrid's dad, Oliver, was here to meet someone other than Ingrid, perhaps the executives of Horizen.

This explains his brief appearance on 'Family Day.' In and amongst that, they ask each other about their respective relationships. Nora lies and states everything is fine with Matt.

Nathan suggests Oliver could read his thoughts, if he reached an agreement with Horizen. Nora replies that once 'MindFrisk' is on, Nathan could be deleted given he has his memories.

As Nora's boss 'Craig' programmed it, they agree to work together to see if they can hack it. Meanwhile, Aleesha discloses Luke's spying concerns to Lucy.

Lucy says they have been spying, as recordings of uploads' thoughts can be sold for money. Aleesha is shocked that Luke was right all along. Lucy then rejoins Ingrid, as she is still screaming. Lucy agrees to Ingrid's demands and gives her a baby.

The spying concerns still continue, however. It turns out that Lucy has been doing it, as she makes a screenshot of Luke, which he overhears. Luke screams 'get out of my head' as he is losing his mind.

Lucy asks Aleesha to put Luke to 'sleep' in case he has a 'system failure.' Aleesha drops in and tries to convince him to sleep. He refuses to do so, citing that they want to steal his dreams.

In the process of trying, Aleesha accidentally pushes Luke out the window, as opposed to the bed, as he runs off. Much in the same way, Ingrid's role as a mother is harder than first thought.

She tries to put the baby to sleep, but she is struggling. Mildred says she always has the 'Angels' if she needs help. In an attempt to make the baby sleep, Ingrid buys some 'nap tokens' for 99 cents, but they do not work.

As Craig finally leaves the office, Nora enters and gets Nathan on the phone. However, his computer has a biometric password. Nathan tells her to download an app that will allow her to detect his DNA through things he has touched in the office.

Nora finds Craig's hair that allows her to get in. Once inside, she searches for 'MindFrisk.' Nora enters inside the folder: Craig's VR office is the same as his real one except for a poster of a woman in a bikini on the wall.

It turns out that Nora is in 'Lake View,' where 'MindFrisk' is located. Meanwhile, Aleesha has ended up on 'Dream Hub' while she is in Luke's dreams, as someone recognises her.

Aleesha immediately phones Lucy and tells her that Luke is having sexual dreams about her. Lucy states that Luke will 'die' tomorrow unless he goes to sleep before hanging up.

Back at Lake View, Nathan joins Nora in the office. Nora discovers a file on Nathan that Horizen have, which showed they knew about his 'Beyond' project.

They then open 'MindFrisk', and test it out. Nathan suggests they search his thoughts. They agree, and it works as they are both left mesmerised as 'MindFrisk' knows everything that Nathan is thinking.

Back with the baby, Ingrid is exhausted. However, her baby has grown up to be a toddler. They get along as they play 'peekaboo.' Still being exhausted, she tries to get him to sleep.

A short while after, the baby has grown into a young boy. This time, he is demanding his father and other mother. The boy tells Ingrid that she is not a good mother.

Back with Nora, she asks Nathan if he can practice controlling his thoughts to bypass 'MindFrisk.' They try once again, but this time on audio mode.

Nathan cannot control his thoughts, as Nora hears him thinking, 'My God, look at her, she is so beautiful. I still wanna kiss her so badly' as Nathan turns 'MindFrisk' off in a moment of awkwardness.

Nora is left in shock, while Nathan tells her it doesn't mean anything. They agree to disable 'MindFrisk.' But before they do so, Nathan requests that Nora search who is thinking about him. The results show one person: Mr. Choak.

Nathan wonders why Mr. Choak would be doing that. To make matters complicated, he has paid for the highest levels of privacy so that no one can see his thoughts. Nora disables that, and they hear Mr. Choak talking to someone.

Nathan and Nora want to know who it could be. The camera then shows us that Mr. Choak is talking to the man that Nathan killed to save Nora's life.

The man looks to have told Mr. Choak that Nathan killed him. The man tells Mr Choak that he did not see Nathan's face but only heard his voice.

The man tries to negotiate a deal that would allow him to be upgraded to Lake View, so he can get his revenge on Nathan. Mr. Choak's thoughts reveal that he was not impressed with the man.

After all, the man let Nora, his target, go and died in the process while requesting to be upgraded to Lake View. Mr. Choak's security shows him out, but in the process of hearing the thoughts, Nora and Nathan know who Mr. Choak was talking to.

It turns out that Mr. Choak and the man had been working together. And because Mr. Choak believes Nathan does not have his memories, he believes he is in the clear.

After all, it is implied that Mr. Choak had Nathan murdered by backing Oliver and got away with it. All the while, Nathan and Nora overhear his thoughts.

Nora is puzzled why Mr. Choak would be involved. She tells Nathan to calm down, but he is not having any of it. Nathan states he has to go to the memory parlour and enhance his memories.

Nora puts Mr. Choak's thoughts on mute and tells Nathan it may be wise to remove his memories, as she will hold them for him. This way, Nathan cannot think about something that could get him in trouble with 'MindFrisk.'

Nathan does not want to do that, as he likes being the person that he is now. Nora and he agree they must stop 'MindFrisk' before it goes live.

Meanwhile, Ingrid's child has grown into a man. He has locked her out of the house, as he blasts some music. She begs him to allow her to enter.

In contrast, Luke looks to be snorting cocaine to deal with his problems before Aleesha jumps in to stop him. Luke breaks down and starts crying.

Aleesha confronts Luke about his sex dreams. In a final ditch to convince him to sleep, she suggests they get in bed together. After all, if it is on 'Dream Hub', she wants it to look good.

As he joins her on the bed, she quickly puts him to sleep remotely and leaves. However, he has begun dreaming about her as she gets a notification from 'Dream Hub', much to her annoyance.

Back at Lake View, Ingrid wakes up to find her child as an old man. She tries to reverse the ageing process, but it fails. He looks to be dying, as he thanks her for everything she has done.

Her son's final wish is that she gives him a name. Ingrid says 'No eer' as she is not keen. However, he interprets this as 'Noah', which he likes before he dies and disappears as Ingrid is left crying.

He notices that the bikini woman poster has been ripped off the wall, while Mr. Choak's thoughts can be heard by everyone, given that Nora had disabled his privacy access.

Now the residents of Lake View stare at Mr. Choak, as they can hear his bad thoughts about them. Mr. Choak demands Craig's assistance, who then is met with a message on his computer saying: "You were hacked by Robin Hood and Black Widow."

Craig is in a panic, as he bangs his head on the desk as the episode ends.

And that is precisely what happens, as the camera flicks to the following message, 'David Choak is downloading off the system to 'Baskin Robots in Manhattan,' on Nora's computer.

She decides to investigate and calls Nathan to see if he wants to go on a 'guided virtual tour,' without telling him why. He agrees, and then Nathan asks Luke, who also comes, as Aleesha has to 'unfortunately' guide him.

The audience is then introduced to Ingrid. Ivan, AI Guy, and Tinsely have arrived to conduct a 'home inspection' to see if she is suitable for her getting a digital baby.

Her prior experience resulted in her having a baby that died within 24 hours. Ingrid disagrees with them judging her, but after realizing they are scoring her, she lets them in.

The day out begins, as Aleesha and Nora are on the subway. An advert for 'Freeyond' plays stating it will launch in five days. Aleesha is annoyed by Luke, who wants to see out the window, which prevents her from sitting.

As a compromise, she shows him her cleavage. Meanwhile, with Luke preoccupied, Nora tells Nathan about Mr. Choak downloading and how she has been tracking him via Twitter with #RobotofGreed.

Mr. Choak is then seen making his way to 'Choak Tower' in a robot form. Nora informs Nathan that maybe he is up to something.

With Aleesha and Luke unaware of why they are really on this trip, Nora tells Aleesha that Nathan wants to see 'Choak Tower.' Nathan confirms that to keep their motives hidden.

Back at the inspection, Tinsley is in awe of Ingrid's collection of shoes and clothes. Ingrid asks why that is relevant for her parenting, to which Ivan states it shows the balance between materialism and compassion.

Thus, he gives Ingrid a score of 1 out of 10. Meanwhile, Nora, Aleesha, Nathan, and Luke arrive at 'Choak Tower.' Luke is bored and tells Aleesha to go to 'The Empire State Building' while Nathan tries to convince them it is a good idea to stay here.

Aleesha walks off with Luke, while Nora and Nathan remain. On the signboard, Nora sees 'Freeyond National Office.' Nora wonders why Mr. Choak would lease his office space to a non-profit organization.

In response, Nathan states perhaps it is for publicity. However, Nora suggests maybe Oliver and Mr. Choak took Nathan's code and sold it to 'Freeyond,' given that the program is similar to Nathan's 'Beyond.'

Aleesha returns to 'Choak Tower' after refusing to pay \$150 dollars per person to see 'The Empire State' building. Shortly after, Nora gets a Twitter notification showing Mr Choak heading towards the 'High Line.'

Nora and Nathan convince Aleesha/Luke to go there for a stroll. However, as they walk, a camera from the New York Police Department's Cyber Crime Unit picks up Nathan's image to a database by the same detective, investigating the death of the man who tried to kill Nora, and brands him as a 'person of interest.'

The detective wonders how Nathan could be in Manhattan given that he is dead, but he zooms in to see that Nora has him there virtually, which intrigues him.

We return to Ingrid's inspection, which is not going well. But then it is interrupted, as she freezes suddenly. To the audience, it is revealed that Ingrid pretended to be dead and uploaded herself via a hug suit.

She only froze as in the real world her mother, Mrs. Kannerman, and brother Jack Kannerman, came to visit her apartment, which shocked Ingrid.

In and amongst that, the AI Guy suspects that something is up with Ingrid. Meanwhile, Ingrid's mother tells her to stop pretending to be dead and get out of the bathtub from her hug suit, as it is humiliating.

Ingrid has not washed in ages. She disagrees but then gets dressed and tells her mother/brother to leave. Mrs. Kannerman informs Ingrid that she has no one to see, to which Ingrid responds by saying she will have her own family one day and be the mother that she never had.

Ingrid states how she wants to be a kinder mother, who then hints that Ingrid was not the worst child in the world, in fact, it was Jack.

Back with Nora and Nathan, they see Mr. Choak having dinner with someone. Nathan tries to convince them all to go in, but it is too expensive for Aleesha's taste. She goes off to find somewhere cheaper.

Aleesha and Nora are then enjoying the food, while the AI Guy serves Luke and Nathan some, so they don't miss out.

The AI Guy notices the real world through Nathan and Luke's virtual screen during that time. He marvels at it and walks away in shock.

We then switch to Aleesha, who dreams of renting a bigger place, but this is impossible unless she gets promoted at Horizen. Suddenly, Nora gets another notification on her phone about Mr Choak.

In response, Nathan suggests they all go to 'Queens.' Luke agrees, so Aleesha has no choice but to go along. Once they arrive, Nora and Aleesha discuss their time in high school.

Nora was a self-professed geek, while Aleesha claims to have been athletic. In and amongst that, Nora discovers that Mr. Choak has stopped at '12300 Jamaica Parkway.'

Nathan suggests they go there, but not before Aleesha shows Luke one of her high school dance routines which Luke is impressed by.

Back at Lake View with Ingrid, she unfreezes, but the others have gone except the AI Guy. Ingrid asks where they have gone, and the AI Guy responds by stating they had gone to check her settings to see if there was an error.

To round things off, the AI Guy knows that Ingrid is pretending to be dead and asks her directly as to why she has uploaded herself.

Ingrid asks how he knew and states he must not tell anyone. He agrees, and Ingrid informs the AI Guy that she is doing it because she loves Nathan.

With that sacrifice, it proves Ingrid is ready for a digital baby, which he approves, much to her delight. Finally, Nora and Nathan track down Mr. Choak as he drives by in a car.

It turns out he came to a location with the sign 'Freeyond coming soon' advertised. After further research, Nora finds that there is only one Freeyond store in New York, which works against the idea that it is for poor people.

It turns out that Freeyond is mostly in swing states, and with uploads not being able to vote, this could be a power play. Thus, if you get enough poor people to upload in a particular area, then it can influence an election.

Aleesha overhears Nora's conversation with Nathan and confronts her over why they have been heading to random locations. Nora confesses that it was for a good cause, that being tracking Mr Choak.

But Aleesha is angry. She tells Nora that she should have told her the truth rather than pretending it to be a fun day out. Nora responds by saying she only did that because Aleesha would have declined if there was nothing in it for her.

The conversation ends with Aleesha taking Nora's comments to mean that she is selfish. She walks off in anger and leaves Nora.

Luke reassures Aleesha that she has every right to be angry, given that she works so hard at Horizen. That is something that Aleesha appreciates, as it made her feel better.

With Nora left alone with Nathan, she tells him to stay positive. Back in the real world, Ingrid arrives at a place called 'Neckgen', a regeneration and long-term storage facility.

It turns out that she is preparing a clone of Nathan in the hope that he can be downloaded into it and thus be in the real world as the episode ends.

Nora leaves and says she will bring Ivan to help. The scene then switches to Lucy showing Aleesha around an apartment. Lucy informs her that she has been promoted and will make 100k a year.

Moving to Ingrid, she is at the hairdresser's getting her hair done by the AI Guy. His mission is to make Ingrid look nice for her digital baby doctor appointment.

Ingrid wants Nathan to agree to a digital baby, which would show his commitment, and then hopefully, she can take him to the real world and have a real baby.

Nathan and Luke are now talking, as the latter is rehashing Nathan's reluctance to have a baby with Ingrid. Nathan feels guilty, but not about that.

It is over sending Nora back to the Luds. Meanwhile, Luke has his own issues. Aleesha has sent him to 'G Dream' where he can only dream about kittens and rainbows, amongst other things.

Nathan feels maybe he should have a baby with Ingrid, given that she uploaded for him. However, Luke tells him to come clean, follow his heart and break up with Ingrid.

They arrive at the doctor's appointment. Nathan and Ingrid are in the waiting room, and we see a poster saying the digital baby can be carried by either partner.

That is when Ingrid tells Nathan that she wants him to carry their child. The doctor arrives and asks if they have questions.

Ingrid requests sparkly eyes for the baby, but she and Nathan both refuse to carry it. The doctor states he only needs 1 percent of Nathan's DNA to create the baby.

Despite Ingrid's persistence, Nathan tells her that he does not want a baby and breaks up with her. In a moment of desperation, she reveals all and states she has grown his body to 98 percent. Therefore, he can download and come home.

Clearly in shock, he says that this is not possible given that Ingrid is dead. That is when she tells him that she has been using a hug suit the whole time.

No longer feeling any guilt about Ingrid uploading for him, Nathan is delighted and leaves. We then see a car with Ivan and Nora sitting inside. He tells her that he is proud of Nora's leadership, as they arrive at the Lud camp.

As they get ready to go inside, Nora gets a call from Nathan. She tells Ivan it is her sister and that she must take it. It is actually Nathan who tells her that he has broken up with Ingrid, that she is not dead, and the fact that Ingrid is growing his body which he must try to get into.

Nora tells him it is too risky to download, given the number of failed cases involving blown-up pigeons. Nathan tells her that some stayed alive for 24 hours. And one such pigeon then blows up immediately in Aleesha's face, as she waits at the bus stop.

Back with Nora again, Nathan stresses that 24 hours would be enough to use his retina and break into Freeyond. In any event, Ingrid would not hand the body over.

Thus, they would have no choice but to steal it. The whole time, however, Ivan was listening to the conversation. He interjects and tells Nora he knows how to get his body.

He says they must convince Pastor Rob to help. Nora tries to do so, but Pastor Rob hates downloading more than uploading. Pastor Rob cites Jesus as the only example of uploading, dying for his sins, and then coming back to life.

However, Nora states Christians must follow in Jesus' steps. She tells Pastor Rob that Nathan is willing to sacrifice heaven in 'Lake View' to save the rest.

One member of the Luds joins Nora, along with Matt after some reluctance. Pastor Rob wants to destroy all the Freeyond buildings, but Nora says that it is only possible if Nathan is in the real world. This must be done by recovering his body from LA.

We then see Nathan's mum, Viv, at a Freeyond location in LA. It looks as though she is saying goodbye to Nathan's niece, Nevaeh, as she gets ready to potentially upload and join Nathan, which the latter does not know, of course.

Back in Lake View, Nathan has now moved in with Luke, who is happy to have him. Nathan tells Luke he might be leaving soon by downloading, however.

Clearly sad, Luke asks if he will return before he hugs him. Luke then gets his house perfect in case Nathan comes back. As he sleeps, he is still in 'G Dream' and unhappy.

Meanwhile, on the subway to LA, Matt and Nora are sitting together. He wants to talk about their relationship, which Nora avoids by quickly watching a movie.

The Luds, Ivan, and Nora have now arrived at the location, Netgen, of Nathan's body. Matt enters and tells the receptionist that someone is spray painting the walls of the premises, as a way to get him out of the building.

Unbeknownst to the Lakeview residents, Nathan's backup copy has been restored and is reactivated by Tinsley. This clone enters the digital afterlife without any memories of the last few weeks. The backup wonders where Ingrid is, still believing that they are together.

He calls her up, just as she is considering moving on from Nathan herself. They reconnect back at Lakeview, hugging and kissing. Ingrid may have wanted to concentrate on herself and forget about Nathan, but this new copy's adoration for her brings Ingrid right back into this toxic relationship once more. She even agrees to make a new clone of Nathan back in the real world.

Meanwhile, in reality, Nathan and Nora enjoy their first day together. The couple go for a lovely walk but seem to be followed and filmed at every turn. Detective Sato then shows up, eager to swap information with the resurrected coder. Sato leaves his contact details with Nathan.

Next, Nathan and Nora break into Freeyond disguised as cleaners. Nathan enters Freeyond's virtual afterlife system with plans to shut the entire project down. He can't gain full access to the system though. Nathan does however find the address for the servers, which are based in New Jersey.

Before leaving, Nathan and Nora spy a suspicious meeting taking place in Freeyond Headquarters. David Choak is there, as is Oliver Kannerman. They record this meeting, but little do they know that Choak has actually spotted them as well. And because of this, he is forced to fast-track his own diabolic plan in return.

Nathan and Nora show Matteo their footage. Nora thinks that David Choak is working with the other Upload companies on something sinister. They send this recording to Detective Sato. Nathan and Ivan then head to the server farm, whilst Nora and Matteo try to dissuade the general public from uploading themselves to Freeyond's system.

Ivan and Nathan make it to the server farm, easily gaining access to the building. They find one solo computer in the entire place. Nathan is confused by this setup, worrying that the company doesn't have enough data storage for an entire digital world.

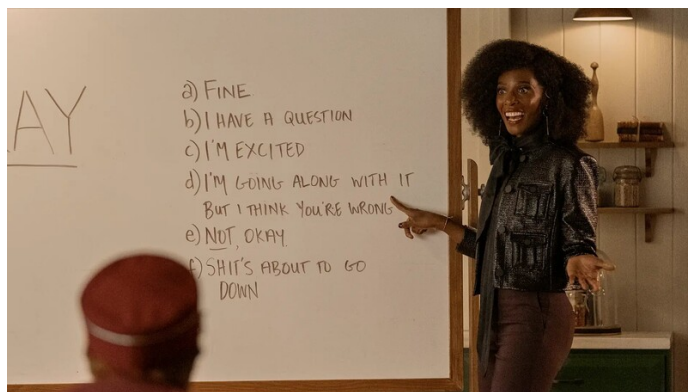

Tinsley confesses to the truth; she lost Nathan and rebooted him with a backup copy. Ingrid understands the ramifications of Tinsley's actions. The new Nathan has no memory of what happened in the last month. Ingrid now has a fresh start with her ex-boyfriend.

Ingrid decides to make the most of this mistake, ordering Tinsley to change her look and offer them a free wardrobe of clothes. Tinsley surrenders. Later, Ingrid gossips with her hairdresser, deciding to go for a new look. The stylist gives Ingrid a new hairstyle, one that closely resembles Nora's.

As they go to celebrate the good news, Dr Kapoor is assassinated by the very same criminal who attacked Nora in a previous installment. With Dr Kapoor dead, they have now lost their key witness.

Interestingly, Aleesha is listening in on this conversation. She talks to Luke in private about her concerns with Karina. Aleesha is scared to leave Karina, believing that if she does, she could lose her job in the process.

After Dr Kapoor's assassination, the gang needed a new star witness, someone who can confirm the corruption. Ingrid seems to be the perfect candidate. Nathan and Nora decide to ask Ingrid to testify, but plan on wining and dining her first, to lure her into agreeing to this difficult task.

The couple dress for the occasion and attend a fancy meal together. Backup Nathan phones just before Ingrid arrives though. He informs them that he is going to propose to Ingrid that very night. Real Nathan and Nora are annoyed by this ironic setup. It seems real Nathan was also going to propose tonight and has now changed his mind.

Ingrid soon arrives but refuses to testify. Nora works her magic and manages to convince Ingrid to change her stance. Ingrid then returns to Lakeview for a less-than-romantic proposal.

Backup Nathan chooses an over-the-top location, which upsets Ingrid greatly. She wanted it to be perfect, but backup Nathan has failed miserably. Ingrid says no.

Elsewhere, Aleesha and Luke plan to take down Karina and Freeyond. With Tinsley and Al Guy's help, they work together to distract Karina and steal her incriminating computer files. They get Karina's login details first, and then Aleesha makes copies of Karina's files while she is distracted.

Back in the real world, Ingrid ditches backup Nathan and agrees to testify in court. All she has to do is link David Choak and Freeyond, but she's still an emotional wreck. Ingrid is questioned and falls apart. She defends Nathan but is quickly caught out, confessing to there being two Nathans out there, who she is in love with.

Aleesha and Luke's mission works a treat. They celebrate afterward and accidentally kiss one another. Aleesha panics and exits Lakeview instantly. Now in the real world, Aleesha sends the incriminating files over to Nora. Hopefully, they can save the court case, which Ingrid has nearly ruined.

In Lakeview, backup Nathan tries a different approach and pulls off a much more romantic proposal. Ingrid says yes, this time around. Later she invites Al Guy to her wedding. She now has an extravagant party to organize.

Back at the court case, Holden reads through Karina's files. It looks like they have enough evidence to bury Freeyond. Once again, Nora and Nathan are optimistic about their future. They discuss marriage licenses in Canada. Nathan isn't even subtle anymore.

Holden then announces that they have won the court case thanks to the last-minute additional evidence. Each family who lost a loved one to Freeyond's scheme will be compensated with \$1 million. Nora asks to take this news public, but they are unable to do so. Holden was only representing her own clients, not the Uploads in general. Uploads are still not seen as legal people, the laws haven't been changed. Nora is heartbroken.

Aleesha updates Luke on this bad news. They won't be going public with Freeyond's lies. Aleesha realizes that she will be fired for her betrayal. She will be unable to see Luke ever again. This couple has finally gotten together and it looks like they will just as quickly be separated from one another.

Nathan and Nora are less optimistic again. They destroyed Freeyond and gained some real justice for all those mourning families, but they didn't fix everything. Nathan wants to concentrate on his relationship now that the court case is over. He says that they can't make their marriage official, but they know in their hearts that it is so.

They kiss each other. Unfortunately, this (sort of) happy ending is short-lived. Nathan is subsequently arrested by the Horizen security guards and then whisked away from Nora's side.

As the season draws to an end, we are shown a new advertisement from Horizen. They are changing their name to Betta, after all the controversy. And Horizen (or Betta) is also introducing a new system where Uploads can work within Lakeview. This is called Workload. It would appear that the evil bosses finally got their way in the end.

In the final sequence, backup Nathan is chased and shot at in Lakeview. Both of the Nathans have gone missing and cannot be reached. The gang tries to get in touch with the two Nathans once more, but are fresh out of luck. Eventually, they get a phone call from one of the Nathans, who informs them that the other Nathan has been destroyed. But which Nathan are we left with?
