Summary: Barclay's ordinary life becomes a world of terror when an ancient species rises from the sea. As UNIT fights for control, the summit on the Thames reveals terrifying secrets.



As the episode begins, men are shown working on a fishing boat. One of them throws a plastic bottle into the water. When the net is pulled from the water, they hear a scream. A Homo Aqua emerges from the net. Barclay Pierre-Dupont receives a call in the middle of the night. He wakes up Kirby to tell her there's an oil spill in Scotland. She needs to go to her mom's place. In the car, they continue talking about the oil spill. Barclay drops off his daughter and briefly speaks to her mother about her party.

Back in the car, Sergeant Hana Chakri tells Barclay that he's going to replace Roger Trevithick. They meet General Austin Pierce before getting on the plane. Barclay is given paperwork to read and assess.

On the plane, Barclay speaks to Pip. General Pierce tells everyone that they're going to the island of Dragonera to a village called Cala Escondida. Pip shows Barclay a video of the Homo Aqua. Barclay tells Pip that he replaced Roger one time back in 2020. He got stuck on the list as Roger's replacement as a result. Barclay insists he's not Roger's replacement and he's only grade ten. He says he works in transport and just books the taxis. Once they arrive, they go through a decontamination process. Colonel Tariq Hashim greets them and shows them the monster that was killed. They saw it online and declared it a hoax. General Pierce says they used to call them sea devils, but they're better than that now. He wants to call Homo Aqua. Hana says they believe their species branched off from temnospondyls.

The correct name would be Homospondyl Erectus. It is difficult to determine the sex. General Pierce asks if there was a pearl. Hana confirms there was and it has nothing artificial. It is 60% aragonite and 40% calcite. General Pierce thinks they should return it to its rightful place. He says they always find a pearl at the base of the throat embedded in the skin. They believe it is placed there at birth. Hana talks about the history of jewelry and Cleopatra. The deep scan is next. Corporal Morgan is told to join the team there and liaise with Sergeant Brock. Barclay looks at the creature closely. He makes a cross sign across his chest. Outside, General Pierce says he wonders what they're doing here since the Mediterranean is a pond. Tariq says there was an avalanche underwater in January 2020. It severed communications cables and could be the monsters. Pierce says they're waking up. The world is two-thirds water. He believes it's us against them.

They send out a translation pulse to say hello. Later, Barclay is told they still cannot use their phones. Barbara messages him later to say they need to talk about Kirby's school. Elsewhere, a woman sinks into water. A man tries to help her, but she gets pulled under. The man calls for help. Hana and the others hear him over the radio. A Homo Aqua emerges from the ground and retrieves the dead body. General Pierce is told that everything is gone. Pierce, Hana, and Barclay step inside the room. They learn that Corporal Morgan and Private Abdalla are missing. Barclay pulls a chair from under the ground. Tariq enters and asks what is going on. Hana suggests searching the village. Pierce tries to get in touch with Morgan and Abdalla over the radio. He hears the radio under the ground below him. They dig and find a hand. Barclay talks to Hana about it outside.

General Pierce apologizes that Barclay had to see that. Barclay says he's there by mistake and he's only grade ten. Pierce believes that is how history is made. He believes Barclay is up to the task. Hana complains about having to work to get there while Barclay didn't. Barclay says he met the Doctor once. He says the Doctor was vivid. Hana says the Unified Intelligence Taskforce was created to deal with alien life forms, but this species is not alien. They are from Earth and were here first. They hibernated underground. The plant reformed around them and sealed them in. Hana says proof is sometimes found, but they hide it because the planet belongs to them. She suggests they might want the plant back. They learn that there's been a positive sighting. Barclay is given a camera and told to record everything. General Pierce wants to speak to it.

A translation system is used so they can do that. The Homo Aqua says the humans killed them. Pierce counters by saying they took two lives. He argues that they should stop. The Homo Aqua agrees. They agree to meet in peace and learn from each other. The Homo Aqua says they do not agree. They want to talk to all humanity. They all want to talk. More of them emerge from the water. One of the translators is told not to refer to the monsters as male. Pierce asks them to repeat the previous statement for translation. The Homo Aqua says they're talking to the whole world right now. Pierce wonders what they're talking about. They receive emergency alerts on their phones. Pierce realizes this is happening all over the world. Homo Aqua creatures emerge in London and elsewhere. Preparations begin for the first official meeting with Homo Aqua inside Imperial House. The Waterway is being constructed to make the meeting possible.

It was a demand from Homo Aqua. Barbara complains about Barclay and his job. Barclay gives her money to show that his job isn't useless. Kirby tells them that the creatures are called homospondyls and homo doesn't mean gay. Barclay doesn't tell them much about his new promotion. He goes to the meeting inside Imperial House. The Commander-in-Chief of the Unified Intelligence Taskforce, Kate Lethbridge-Stewart introduces herself to everyone. She explains that UNIT has been picked to lead this task force and will represent humanity and all life on Earth. She speaks to the Prime Minister and other world leaders. The Ambassador approaches. Kate asks Mr. St. Lewis about the Waterway. A press done is shot down. Roger Trevithick complains about not being allowed in the room because of Barclay.

They quickly encounter a problem with the Waterway and have to fix it. Kate tells Shirley Bingham that she did well. Then, the guests begin moving through the Waterway. There are four Homo Aqua, two unknown life forms, and one of a second unknown. There are three life forms in total. Everyone is surprised to see the unknown life forms. One group is called Piscimorpha Grandis or Big Fish. Colonel Christofer Ibrahim reminds Kate that they don't know what the third lifeform is. She tells him that they have to trust them. Barclay sees Salt among the creatures. The term Homomorpha Sapiens or Homo Amphibian is mentioned. Once the translations begin, Kate tells Sir Jonathan good luck. Salt says they do not need translation. Both speak Russian

briefly. Sir Jonathan brings them a gift. It is given with respect and the hope of peace between their species.

Salt says they have a gift, her children. Salt's children should've been born at the turn of the Third Cold Current, but they choked on oil, poison, and excrement. Salt reminds Ambassador, Sir Jonathan Hynes, that they do not know him. They want to speak with Barclay who isn't eager to get involved. Salt says he showed respect. A video shows Barclay making a cross in front of the dead Homo Aqua. Kate questions what is going on. Salt tells Barclay that they saw his kindness. He is asked to stand as the ambassador and talk on behalf of the human race. Barclay says okay.

Summary: Barclay becomes humanity's ambassador when the mysterious Salt emerges from the Tank. But his family's life is torn apart when Salt wreaks revenge upon all mankind.



As episode opens, Barclay Pierre-DuPont stands in a room alone. As the meeting is adjourned, Barclay turns and makes eye contact with Salt. Colonel Christopher Ibrahim tells Commander-In-Chief of the United Intelligence Taskforce Kate Lethbridge-Stewart about Barclay, a Grade Ten who works in logistics. He adds that Barclay and his ex-wife, Barbara Nyamai Pierre-DuPont, have a teenage daughter, Kirby Pierre-DuPont. Kate enters a room and introduces herself to Barclay. He tells her that he knows

because he books her taxis. She admits to being confused as to why Salt chose him from nearly eight billion people humans. He denies knowing, and having any contact with Homo Aqua. He informs her of his goldfish, Simon. Kate warns that experts are scouring through every inch of his life. Barclay's parents are deceased. He and Barbara married in 2003 and divorced in 2022. Elsewhere, Armed officers pick Kirby up at her school and Barbara from their flat. At the headquarters, Barclay defends his family and swears that he never asked for this, but agrees to help. He suggests Kate needs his help.

A BBC newsreader reports on the dismissal of H2O Ambassador Sir Jonathan Hynes. At the headquarters, Prime Minister Harry Shaw warns Kate that the HSO Commission will not permit a random civilian to represent them. Hynes orders Kate to inform Salt. Shaw tells them that he would do it but fears how it would look if he were present when war broke out. She assures that it would hardly matter when he could blame UNIT. He denies that is what he meant and suggests woman-to-woman would be best. He questions whether Salt is a woman and pleads with her to do it. Later, Kate introduces herself to Salt. She says the committee urges her to trust in Hynes and forget Barclay. Salt argues that she speaks of trust but insists on meeting her in private. She demands to hear from Ambassador DuPont. He joins Kate in the aisle. Salt asks him to approach. He reluctantly steps forward. She says, "Hello." He asks if she has a name and identifies himself as Barclay. He tells her that his grand was Scottish. She asks him to call her Salt. At a whisper, he explains that he is a regular guy who knows nothing of politics and diplomacy. She claims he was chosen for his compassion and humanity, not his expertise. Salt warns that his leaders would have him replaced and asks what he wants. Barclay assures her that he will accept their decision. Refusing his answer, she asks what he really thinks. He says the process is about everyone. Calling himself a nobody, he suggests it is time that others like himself had a voice. She says, "We hear you, Ambassador." Salt threatens to end negotiations if Barclay does not present tomorrow.

Armed officers escort a frightened Barclay to an armored vehicle. Seeing Kate, he asks if she is going to kill him. She pretends to have forgotten her gun and pulls back her jacket to reveal it. He swears that he isn't a spy and explains that his mouth goes into autopilot. She believes they can work together. He recalls that she just tried to get rid of him. She tells him that UNIT wants a peaceful settlement. She claims to have invested her life fighting for this planet. With his help, she can build a better world for everyone. Kate agrees to give him a chance. Upon arrival at the diplomatic hotel, armed guards escort Barclay inside. General Dominique Dussolier snaps his photo. Sergeant Hanna Chakri informs Barclay that diplomatic staff and delegates are being relocated as part of a security protocol. He asks how long he will be away from his family. A guard opens the door to his room. Kirby emerges and embraces Barclay. Elsewhere, Shirley Bingham questions how Salt communicates with her people. Ibrahim suggests they share the same consciousness. As the video of the recent meeting plays, Kate points out that Kate and the other H2O Aqua species inhaled simultaneously. Captain Louise Mackie says Kate is softening her language. Bingham describes Salt as extraordinary and the ambassador of her species.

At the laboratory, Dr. Kadie Bangura studies the remains. Marko Novak prepares the remains for imaging. At the hotel, Barbara is shocked to learn Barclay has been chosen H2O ambassador. Kirby is thrilled that he is famous. Barbara complains about being cooped up there. Kirby questions why Salt chose him. Barclay describes her as beautiful. Barbara says she is a fish. He disagrees. She accuses him of lying about his job and goes to take a bath. Elsewhere, Kate fears they may be putting too much pressure on Barclay. Colonel Ibrahim says Barclay has her by his side. He kisses her neck. She fears humans would be defenseless in a war. They kiss. At the lab, Marko slips a tissue sample into his pocket. Later, he gives it to Sir Keith Spears in exchange for his citizenship. Marko becomes upset when he realizes the deal didn't include his mother. Keith meets Esther Spears as she is leaving. He gives the tissue sample to General Oscar Gunsberg and Dominique. He warns that H2O Aqua will ruin the energy industry. She explains that war and pandemic simulations are being studied to determine the impact on Western economies. Gunsberg says they will go into a recession. She adds that people are already in a panic. Keith aims to protect his companies. Hunt fears Kate's influence with the H2O Committee and the prime minister. He assures her that Shaw will listen to him, his biggest donor. They laugh.

Kate learns Barclay's name was leaked to the media. The next day, the hotel is surrounded by reporters. Armed guards escort Barclay to an armored vehicle. Barbara watches from their hotel room. A happy Kirby watches a live news stream. At the headquarters, Bingham informs Kate that Dussolier sent Barclay's photo to the media. Kate condemns her for undermining NATO since birth. She authorizes 50 media personnel to access the hall. Later, a guard informs Dussolier that she has been banned from the hall. En route to the hall, Mackie prepares Barclay. Kate tells him that everything goes through the commission. General Austin Pierce urges Barclay to calm down. Barclay enters the hall. Min Tso monitors his vitals from the control room. Bingham opens the seals. The water gushes in and fills the chamber. Awed, Barclay doesn't hear Kate asking if he is all right. Salt emerges. He says hello. Kate corrects him. Reading from a

script, he apologizes for what happened to her children. Salt asks if he is a parent. Kate prompts him to reply. He says yes. Salt appreciates his apology. He returns to the script. She asks for a glass of river water. Armed guards rush out to retrieve the water. She insists on waiting. An official hands the glass of murky water to Barclay. Salt orders him to drink it. Bingham pulls up a report, which reveals meningitis, dysentery, E. Coli, and Legionnaires' disease. Kate warns him against drinking it. Barclay tells Salt that the water is contaminated.

Barclay reads the explanation. Cutting him off, Salt demands an explanation from his own words. Kate prompts him to stick to the script. Removing his earpiece, he says they were stupid and didn't understand the consequences. She asks if they now understand. He says yes. He stresses that water companies are pumping out poison and paying their bosses big bonuses. He insists that everyone is to blame and responsible for fixing it, starting today. Salt believes he is her favorite human. He sniggers and turns to see that he is the only one. Kate smiles. At the hotel, Barclay is hyped up. Kirby and Barbara laugh. They watch a breaking news report. He boasts of being a historical figure. Barbara calls him a fishy ambassador. He accuses her of being jealous. At the headquarters, Pierce tells Kate that the H2O Committee has created new models for environmental regulations. She says the Greens have tried to achieve these targets for decades. He warns that the French consulate demands that Dussolier be reinstated to the hall. Kate reluctantly agrees. TSO tells them that they are studying oceanic mycelium networks, the fungal threads that connect specific trees and plants. Mackie suggests that Homo Aqua, Grandis, and Amphibia are interconnected. Kate compares them to children playing guessing games.

Barclay looks at classified photographs until Kirby interrupts. She joins him and says she read his big speech again. It made her proud. Kirby asks if he's going to be safe. Barclay insists he will be. Kirby will be moved to a safe house tomorrow. The next day, Hana tells Barclay about the move while he's hounded by members of the press. Prime Minister Shaw prepares for the meeting. Barclay begins speaking to Salt. He claims they can guarantee a 50% reduction in ocean pollution by 2065. Further reduction will be exponential. Salt asks him to explain that. Barclay says it would take time to gather the resources to tackle the problem, but world governments are committed to making it a priority. Salt argues that 40 years is unacceptable.

Salt asks if this is the final offer. Salt questions if they should wait while scores of them are dying every day. She questions why they should live like this one day longer. Barclay says he's sorry. Salt asks if his leaders are sorry. She questions whether they wish they could achieve this sooner. She asks if they want to accelerate the process. Barclay says they are committed to undoing the harm they've inflicted on the planet. Salt asks how committed they are. Barclay says it is their greatest desire. Salt says they shall grant it. She says it is happening as the sky changes outside. Kirby and Barbara don't know what's going on. Kate tells the others that there is no storm. Plastic bags and bottles begin littering the street. Barbara screams for the driver to get them out of there. Shirley and the others realize what is happening.

Hana tells Barclay that they need to leave. Kate arrives and tells Salt that they need to stop, but Salt says they're cleaning up their mess. Barclay speaks to Barbara about the pollution being returned to them. He tells her to come to Imperial House. An object smashes into their vehicle. Barbara tells Kirby that they have to run for it. She tells Kirby to go first. Barbara checks on the driver who doesn't respond. Barclay steps outside to look for Kirby and Barbara. Both get to safety. General Pierce believes they're declaring war. The Titanic has reached its destination. The cleanup begins with the damage bill in the hundreds of billions. Former Albion party leader, Felix Gladstock, has branded Storm H2O as a "call to arms". Felix says they're at war and it is time to unite against Homo Aqua. Barclay prepares for another meeting.

He tells Salt that they approached this congress in good faith, but their actions have jeopardized the diplomatic process. Barclay says they don't want war, but Salt claims the war began a long time ago. She says it was started by humans. They have simply returned what is theirs. Barclay gets tired of reading the prompt. He admits the Homo Aqua are cleverer than they are. Barclay says this was a mistake because people were hurt. Now, it is worse because people are scared. When humans are scared, they do terrible things. He insists he's not threatening them. Kate urges him to get back to the script. Barclay says the United Nations demands an armistice agreement. Salt lays out their conditions. The pollution of oceans and waterways will stop with immediate effect. They also want a formal designation of borders.

Homo Aqua wants all water. Transport across water will not be permitted. The humans begin complaining about this. Salt seems to morph into a male before saying they will only take

questions from the ambassador. Barclay urges the others to shut up. He tells Salt that people fear what they don't understand. Barclay says they'll need time to handle these proposals. While they negotiate, they insist on a formal armistice to maintain peace. Salt says there is a third condition. The next meeting will take place in the Atlantic Ocean. Barclay realizes Salt wants them to meet underwater. Salt wants them to prove their commitment to peace and equality. The Romanche Trench is one of the deepest waterways on the planet. It is 25,000 feet and five miles down. Manned submersibles have imploded in less than half that.

Barclay is told not to agree to anything. Salt asks Barclay if he'll meet them at the bottom of the ocean. Barclay says okay.

Kate asks why Spears is there. His companies are still pumping sewage into the waterways. Kate also complains that General Dussolier leaked confidential information to the press. Prime Minister Shaw explains that they need industry and leaders on their side. Meanwhile, Ravi worries that they'll be taken as hostages. Barclay tries to calm everyone. He is adamant that his kid is not living through a war. Louise wants to get out and call her brother since they haven't spoken for 20 years. Ravi wants to take his 19 family members out for a meal. The descent continues. Prime Minister Shaw and the others wait for news. Keith Spears and Gunsberg tell Shaw that this is catastrophic and they cannot surrender control of the planet. Dussolier says UNIT is looking out for its own interest. She believes it is their duty to stop Aquakind no matter what. Shaw believes he should be with Alison since she has tests today.

Spears says they can guide him and take the pressure off. Prime Minister Shaw says he promised his grandchildren he would leave the country better than he found it. Gunsberg says there will be no grandchildren if they don't win this war. Spears believes there is a way through this. They have a new strategy they're calling Severance. Elsewhere, Colonel Christofer Ibrahim gives Kate coffee and biscuits. He thinks she needs a break. Kate is worried that they're going to shut UNIT out. Kate learns the submersible is reaching the deepest part of the trench. She wants to speak with Captain Gaitz. General Pierce tries to get in touch with someone on the surface. The submersible begins moving again. Kate is told the readings don't make sense. It seems they're being dragged. Min says the pressure on the hull is similar to the pressure on land. Barclay questions whether they're inside something.

The system goes down. Ravi worries they're going to kill them. Eventually, the hatch is opened. Barclay asks who is going first. General Pierce steps out with Barclay. The temperature is 21 degrees Celsius which should be impossible. The atmosphere is perfect. The others are told they can come out. Salt eventually welcomes everyone. She says they're deeper than any human has ever been. They can remove their helmet because the environment has been prepared for them. Salt asks Barclay if he'll trust her. Once he says yes, Salt removes his helmet. Ted decides to keep his helmet on, but the others remove theirs. Christofer tells Kate that she's shaking because she's running on empty. He says she'd be escorted from the building if he reported her. He wants her to be on form when Barclay and the others get back.

Kate says she'll go home and work from there. Salt tells Barclay about where they are. She says they're nomad so they don't live there. Fish, titans, dolphins, and Homo Aqua live together. Salt and Barclay end up alone together. Barclay says he feels like he's known her forever. Salt understands. Salt touches Barclay who asks if he can touch her. Barclay touches Salt who questions what he feels. He says strength and beauty. Barclay doesn't know why Salt picked him for any of this. Salt says the tides have drawn them together and the undercurrents are pulling them closer. If he calms his mind, he will feel their power. Salt says his thoughts are noisy and human emotions are loud. They cannot help but listen. Barclay doesn't want to mess this up. Salt believes they could make a difference together. Agent Pierce interrupts seconds later and checks on Barclay. They are taken to many other Homo Aqua. Salt welcomes them to their domain.

Kate talks to Christofer about them being down there with no support. He asks if they will have to hide their relationship forever. He's sick of hiding it. Kate says they don't matter because the future of the human race depends on what happens tonight. Christofer asks if she can stop being commander-in-chief for just a few hours. Kate admits she doesn't know how. He asks her to ignore a phone call. Kate asks and learns from Shirley that there is no news from the delegates. She obtained intel from the people in the COBRA meeting and found a repeated word, Severance.

Kate admits that it doesn't mean anything to her. Shirley says it's been used 14 times in the last two days. Christofer pushes Kate out of the way when someone tries to shoot her from outside. Ted presents the globe to Salt. Kate checks on Christofer who has been shot in the chest. She says she is going to get help.

Ted tells Salt that her war is lost. Someone tries to shoot Kate again. Barclay knocks the globe out of Ted's hands.

She grabs her phone and asks Shirley to send help. Kate says the target is in India House across the way. Corporal Jane Hart tells Shirley Bingham that the delegates are dead. Shirley orders all stations to be on Red Alert. Police reach the scene and take out the suspect. Kate questions who he is. Shirley says they don't know who he

is. They have a major incident in progress. A news report confirms there was an underwater explosion at the site of the diplomatic meeting. Barbara and Kirby are together when they see the news report.

Salt brings Barclay to the surface. The news report says the Homo Aqua ambassador issued a statement claiming responsibility for the deaths of the H2O diplomats. In the video, Salt tells the human race that the diplomats are dead. Salt threatens that the same fate will befall anyone who dares to enter their waters. Steve Chesney tells Shirley that the video could be a deepfake. Once Barclay is back on the ship, he says the device was exploded by Ted Campbell. He tells Shirley that they were all crushed right in front of him. Barclay believes they knew they were going to die. Shirley says the most important thing is for Barclay to get back. Kate arrives and asks Barclay how he survived. Barclay isn't sure he did. Kate asks if he survived because of Salt.

Barclay says she held him, but he doesn't know how or why. He also insists the broadcast is fake.

Barclay wants to talk to Salt, but Kate says that won't be possible. In the eyes of the world, Salt has taken responsibility. As a result, she is a prisoner of war. Salt is shown inside an asset container. A news report identifies those killed. Jane and Shirley talk about the deaths and the possibility that they'll never recover the bodies. Kate says she'll take Louise's belongings to her mother in person. Shirley suggests getting a personal guard, but Kate doesn't want to be followed. The assassin is identified as Miklos Constantinos. He was born in Athens and was relieved of command from the Hellenic Army in 2010. He showed up as a mercenary with pro-Gaddafi forces in 2011. He's been invisible since 2019. Kate begins crying. She wonders who hired Miklos. Prime Minister Harry Shaw asks General Oscar Gunsberg whether this had anything to do with them.

Gunsberg denies being involved. General Dominique Dussolier says they have evidence that this man was employed by the Institute of Las Clementi which sent Ted on his mission. As a result, they might be in trouble. Ted has stage four pancreatic cancer and was happy to give his life for the Institute. The Prime Minister learns that the Institute is a private think-tank founded and supported by billionaires. Their motives are clear, The Great Replacement Theory. They're terrified that Homo Aqua will replace mankind. Shaw questions whether there is a connection to them. Gunsberg says he can close the Institute going in with force within two hours. Then, he can hand them over to UNIT. One problem remains. Ted Campbell was an associate of Sir Keith Spears. Keith also invested money in the Institute in 2015. Gunsberg doesn't think he's connected to the explosion, but he knows the authorities will find the link.

If they investigate Keith, they will find that he's part of Severance. Keith creates a link back to them. Prime Minister Shaw realizes how serious this is. He questions what they should do. Gunsberg says Spears is a major investor in the privatized water companies. A lot of people blame the water companies for polluting the ocean. Gunsberg asks the Prime Minister if he has permission to deal with this. Shaw wants to make sure there will be no connection to him. He tells Gunsberg to do it. An assassin visits Sir Keith Spears at home and shoots him dead. Next, Sergeant Hana Chakri tells Barclay that they will look after Salt. He's being taken to UNIT Tower. Barclay isn't confident that she'll be safe. Barclay speaks to a former colleague about Salt and his new job. His friend believes Salt killed those people and that she'll be killed as a result.

Barclay asks for the keys. He eventually gets the keys and decides to make his move. Hana questions what he's doing. Barclay turns on the truck. Points are pointed at him. Hana tells him not to do this. Barclay doesn't think they're going to shoot him in front of the press. He reverses causing the container to fall into the water. The door opens and Salt swims free. Barclay jumps into the water before Salt grabs him. Hana tells everyone to search the river. Kate can't believe what Barclay has done. Kirby and Barbara learn about Barclay's actions. Shirley tells Kate that the Americans have taken down the Institute. She asks Kate if her daughter knew about her relationship with Christofer. Kate thought no one knew about them. Shirley says they were all happy for her. When Kate is asked about the assassination of Keith Spears, she says it's an act of terrorism.

Then, she changes her mind and tells Jane to investigate it. The alarm goes off. Life forms are approaching. Kate agrees to be the ambassador since Barclay is missing. Eight Homo Aqua and a new life form approach. Kate speaks to the warrior. The warrior asks why they're all insane. He claims they came to their world and killed themselves to make everything that is happening worse. Kate takes out her earpiece and goes rogue. She admits no one of them can answer that question. Kate explains and apologizes. Ambassador Tide accepts the response. Tide asks about Salt. He says Salt decided to save a human life and left Aquakind to die. They were murdered while Salt helped Barclay. The fate she must suffer exists under the sea. Tide demands to know where she is. Salt and Barclay emerge from the water together. Tide learns that they've lost Salt because of Barclay.

Kate tells Tide that she can't hand over Salt if he intends to punish her. Tide says they are at war then. He realizes Kate is full of new despair. He believes she will strive to prevent future losses. Tide says they're tired of waiting. If they have to escalate, they will. Tide tells them to be aware of their third ambassador, Rust. They can make a weapon to create rust. It will eat at the cities, cars, and missiles. Tide says the negotiations are over. He wants them to find Salt and return her. The humans are also ordered to advance the plans to change their world within five years. Tide also wants them to change the name of Earth. Gunsberg tells Prime Minister Shaw

that they need to find Salt. They've tested the samples, but they've never tried Severance on an adult Homo Amphibian. If they can use Salt, Gunsberg can end the war tomorrow.

Meanwhile, Barclay complains while Salt breaks a glass window. Salt tells Barclay he is always so scared. She insists he won't die. Barclay says Salt saved his life when she kissed him. Salt explains the purpose of the kiss down there. Barclay tries to keep Salt quiet since they're hiding. Salt talks to Barclay about her life underwater. They mate at random and spawn in thousands, but they're capable of more. Salt talks about their passion for the water. She admits they never went to the stars. Their pride in the water might've weighed them down. Barclay asks what would happen if Salt went back. Salt says she would swim alone. It would be worse than being executed. She would live with a dead soul. Salt thinks Barclay would understand that because there is a loneliness in him. Salt talks about humans being so constructed. Salt admits they've watched them for so long under the sea.

She believes they would've always found them because their heat is irresistible. Barclay talks about nearly dying and everything felt better when Salt pressed her lips against his. Salt finds Barclay unique. They kiss more. Kate walks past a memorial for all the victims, including Christofer. She cries in her car. Salt says the name she picked was appropriate because he tastes of salt. Barclay says she tastes of horizons. They hear a helicopter outside. Salt asks if there is anyone he can trust in the Army. Barclay says they're beyond the army and the police. Salt asks about Kate who she says is a good soul. Barclay isn't sure how to get to her. He tells Salt that she doesn't have to stay with him. Salt says they'll know the moment she enters the water. They will find her and punish her. Barclay says they need to get out of the city. He suggests going to North Wales because he knows a guy there.

Salt asks Barclay to live with her in a waterfall. They question how they're going to reach North Wales. Barclay remembers that it is lawless out there. They scare a guy and take his phone. Once Barclay gets the guy's phone, he lets him run. Barclay says Kirby has a secret phone. Barclay calls her to say he's fine and she needs to be very careful. Barclay wants Barbara to call him back from the bathroom. Barbara calls him back and learns he's with Salt. Barclay tells her what she's going to need, including a permit to get through the city. He tells her that she can get through the Festival Bridge. Law enforcement is already with Barbara. Nevertheless, Barclay thinks they've pulled it off. Meanwhile, Kate learns about the rendezvous at Festival Bridge in 20 minutes. Kate sends Hana.

Gunsberg learns about the meeting. He wants Salt. Steve tells Kate that it has been confirmed that Salt's confession was a deepfake. It is coded. He says Las Clementi. Barclay sees a car stop on the bridge. He tells Salt to come. The car is watched by law enforcement. Captain Khumalo stops communicating with UNIT. Barclay and Salt approach Barbara who tells them to run. Barclay and Salt are cornered. Kate learns that this is General Gunsberg's doing. Kate tries to get him to stand down, but he refuses to do so. Hana tries to get Salt and Barclay to come to her. Barclay approaches Barbara and gets detained. Gunsberg says they only need Salt's body. Kate wants to stop him from killing her. Barclay yells for Salt to go to the river. Salt screeches and stops everything. Barclay tells her to go. Salt jumps into the river. Barclay yells that he'll find her and she'll never swim alone.

The episode opens with Homo Aqua emerging from the sea, looking out at the city, and blowing a conch. Dogs throughout the city race toward the sea. More Homo Aqua emerge and hold up a net. During a meeting, Sir Jonathan Hynes accuses Homo Aqua of eating their dogs. Tide says they eat their fish. Irate, Hynes demands that they not their domesticated dogs. Tide argues that their fish are family. The Vietnam ambassador is offended by Hynes' words. Kate Lethbridge-Stewart believes the diplomatic talks are

a distraction by Aquakind. She imagines seeing Colonel Christopher Ibrahim. During a therapy session, Kate tells her psychiatrist, Elizabeth, that the visions make her happy, although Ibrahim is dead. She attributes the visions to PTSD and requests to double her Paroxetine dose. Elizabeth declares her unit to work. Kate threatens to expose her pregnancy during an affair with her best friend. She adds that her best friend moved on to Gillian. Kate promises to keep her secret. Elizabeth writes her a prescription for Paroxetine 40mg.

The police evacuate the beaches. During a phone call, Kate and a woman discuss Barclay's psychiatric evaluation. At the headquarters, Shirley Bingham watches from a live stream. During the evaluation, Barclay complains of headache, rash, whistling noise, and leg pain. He emerges from the pool and removes gear. Dr. Bannerjee warns Barclay that nothing survives eight kilometers under the sea. Barclay disparages his father for drinking his earnings away. He attributes his posh surname to getting a position with the UNIT. Bannerjee informs him that people say he is the most famous man in the world. Barclay mutters that she made him special and now,

she is gone, and no one knows what to do with him. The scene switches to outside the hotel. A mass of fans cheer when Barclay arrives. Armed guards escort him to his room. He describes the evacuated hotel as a prison. A servant delivers his meal. Barclay is required to scan all food and beverage before consumption. He lifts the lid, drops it, and yells, "Very funny." At the lab, he tells Bannerjee that the water is the only place he feels good.

Sergeant Hana Chakri informs Kate that Severance triggers a red flag. Kate thanks her. Chakri urges her to go home and rest. Professor Inko Bello barges in and requests that she grant him access to the computers and the T&P database. She authorizes his access. He says she was right because while Aquakind kept them distracted, they were melting the ice caps. The melting ice caps appear on a screen. He describes their scheme as clever. Bello explains that Aquakind used a layer of ice crystals at three kilometers to hide the heat. Kate asks how he figured it out. He says they unveiled it and Antarctica's loss will double to 300 billion tons of ice per year. Bello tells her that the Prince Friedrich Ice Shelf melted in six hours, a process that should have taken decades. Bingham questions what will happen if all the ice in the world melts. Bello warns that sea levels will rise and all carbon will be released into the atmosphere. Kate says they will drown. He insists that Aquakind has won the war.

During a session, Kind tells Hynes that Aquakind is restoring ice to its normal state. He insists that humans started it before they woke. From his hotel room, Barclay watches the live stream. Hynes tries to respond, but Kind cuts him off. He announces that five years from now, all water will be free. Prime Minister Harry Shaw watches from a remote location. Kind argues that this is an inconvenience, not a war, and all humans will be cleansed. At the headquarters, Chakri says they can't clean a single river in five years. Armed guards escort Barclay to a pub. Kirby Pierre-DuPont embraces him. He apologizes and assures her that it is okay. Barbara Pierre-DuPont fears drowning and criticizes Barclay for being useless. She tells him that UNIT has offered to relocate them to a gated community, where they will be safe for the rest of their lives. She claims to have demanded that he be permitted to see Kirby whenever he wants. Barbara accuses him of falling in love with Salt. Weepy, he believes she can hear him. Barclay admits to overriding the CCTV, slipping out of the hotel, and driving to the coast every night. He submerges his head in the water and calls for Salt but never hears anything. He breaks down sobbing. Barbara and Kirby comfort him.

General Dominique Dussolier shows General Oscar Gunsberg a video of Barclay at the beach. She explains that he calls for Salt nightly. She believes the government is creating interference with Aquakind communication signal and considers asking for a pause. She considers He asks what she knows about Severance. She insists that her name not be attached to it. Elsewhere, Kate confronts Harry about his and Sir Keith Spears's communications mentioning Severance. He offers to find a way out of his situation. He declines. Upon leaving, she assures him that she will be there waiting when an anti-Aqua government takes over. Elsewhere, Gunsberg and Willem receive alerts. At the hotel, the guard delivers Barclay's meal and switches out his scanner. When Barclay scans the food, it doesn't pick up anything unusual. He sips the beverage. In the hallway, the guard overrides the CCTV. A team wearing Hazmat suits enters, installs a barrier, and enters Barclay's room. He is asleep on the bed. Someone injects him with something, finishes up, and leaves. The guard returns to his post before Barclay emerges.

Barclay speeds to the coast, enters the water, and calls for Salt. The next morning, she arrives. He enters the water and kisses her. She admits to knowing about the ice but not the tides. She says he can still help humanity. He insists that no one listens to him and she made him special for a moment. Salt orders him to tell his people to ask Aquakind for Accord and humankind may survive. She kisses him and reenters the sea. At the headquarters, Barclay relays the message to Kate. Steve Chesney explains that his eye-tracking could be used to embed Accord into the information that is sent to Aquakind daily. He doubts any translator would notice it but warns of the risk. Kate says rumor has it that 195 countries are contemplating nuclear strikes on the ocean. Barclay is willing accepts the risk. Chakri and Chesney send the message. Several days later, the seas are calm. At Dragonera Island in Spain, soldiers find dozens of Homo Aqua washed up on the beach. More are discovered on Browns Bay and Antigone Bay. Homo Aqua are dying in mass numbers.

A news report says the bodies of Homo Aqua have been discovered. Barclay asks if it is all of them. He asks about Salt. Kate is told they suffered from some sort of viral infection. It's like their gills got blocked. The Homo Aqua shed scales, but the shedding has stopped. The excess

scales built up and they drowned. There is no danger anymore. Kate believes this was a part of warfare. The virus was likely human made. She says Severance was the virus. Hana reveals that the death rate worldwide is 90%. Kate learns they've received a signal in deep Aquanese. Steve believes it is an SOS. Hana arrives and tells Barclay that he's needed at the Empress Hall. Barclay learns that Salt may be alive. He rushes to the hall to meet Kate and the others. Hana tells Kate that there's a message from Dr. Bannerjee.

Kate tells her to stay with Barclay. Moments later, Barclay is glad to see that Salt is alive. She tells them that the war is over and humans have won. Barclay apologizes to Salt and asks her what it's like down there. Salt says they are destroyed. The virus brought fire to the world of water and they burned. Salt says she's one of the ten who survived. She claims it was like it was done by design. Salt knows there are creatures in this room who want a prize for winning the war. She says they want their technology, but there are oceans unknown to them. They have sunk their prizes deep below to ensure humans cannot get them. Salt mentions the virus. She says water will find them one day. In a separate scene, the Prime Minister takes a show. His water is abruptly cut off. Water is shown spewing from his mouth.

Oscar Gunsberg and Dominique are shown drowning in a car. Salt tells Barclay that the Accord will never happen. It was a way for two species to join, share, and celebrate, but it is now lost. Kate tells Barclay to make the first offer on page 15. Barclay says they will offer them land. It can be their home. Humans will protect their boundaries from pollution, sound, and viruses. They can rebuild their relationship. Salt says they will accept the offer if they give the land its real name, a hunting ground. She says they will do whatever they want because they are terrified of them. That ends the way. As Salt begins leaving, Barclay admits there is more to say. He asks whether he'll see her again. Salt leaves. Kate isn't sure whether they should be congratulated or shamed. The glass begins breaking. Kate urges everyone to abandon the hall. Barclay doesn't budge.

Hana ushers him away from the tank. Barclay tells a reporter to tell people they've won the war. Kate talks to Shirley about finding somewhere to live. They talk about the Doctor. Kate learns there is a message from Dr. Bannerjee. Barclay finds himself surrounded by protestors. He's ushered into a vehicle with Kate. Dr. Bannerjee talks to Kate about Barclay and the Accord. Barclay runs into the water and yells for Salt. Kate watches as Salt arrives and approaches Barclay. They kiss. Barclay dives into the water and swims with Salt. Kate waves goodbye to them. It looks like Barclay has gills.
